(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen for a digital camera with a transitional graphical user interface, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

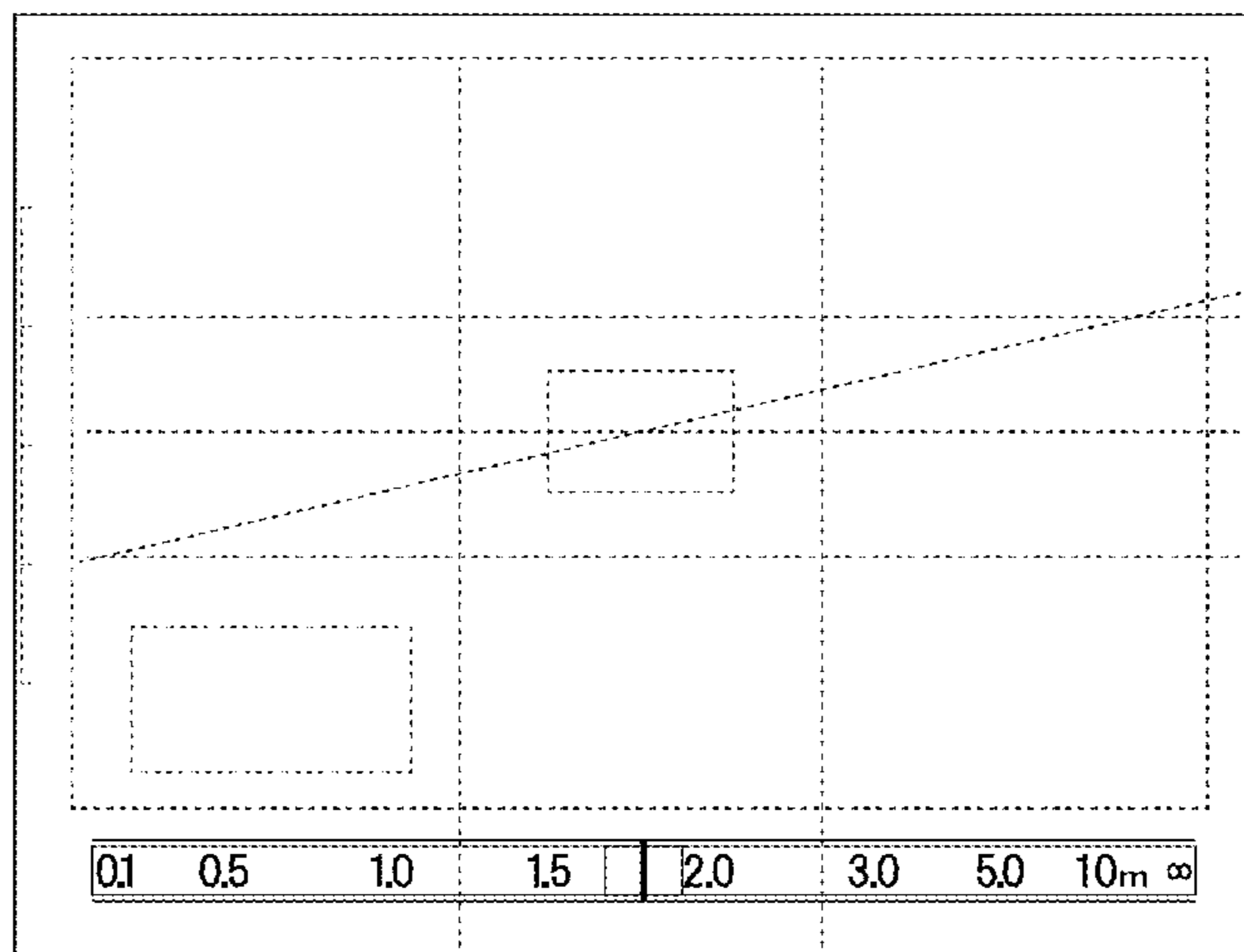

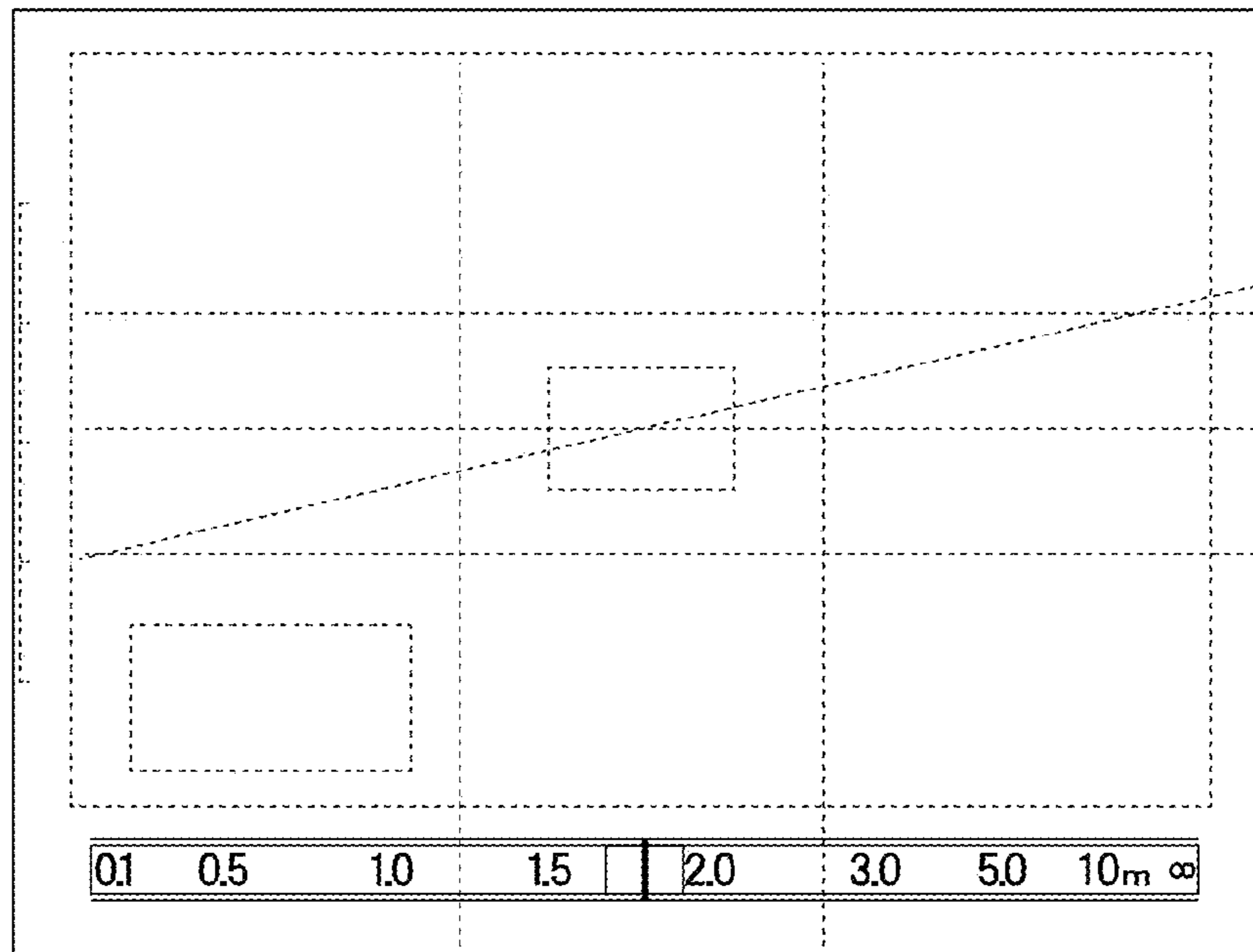

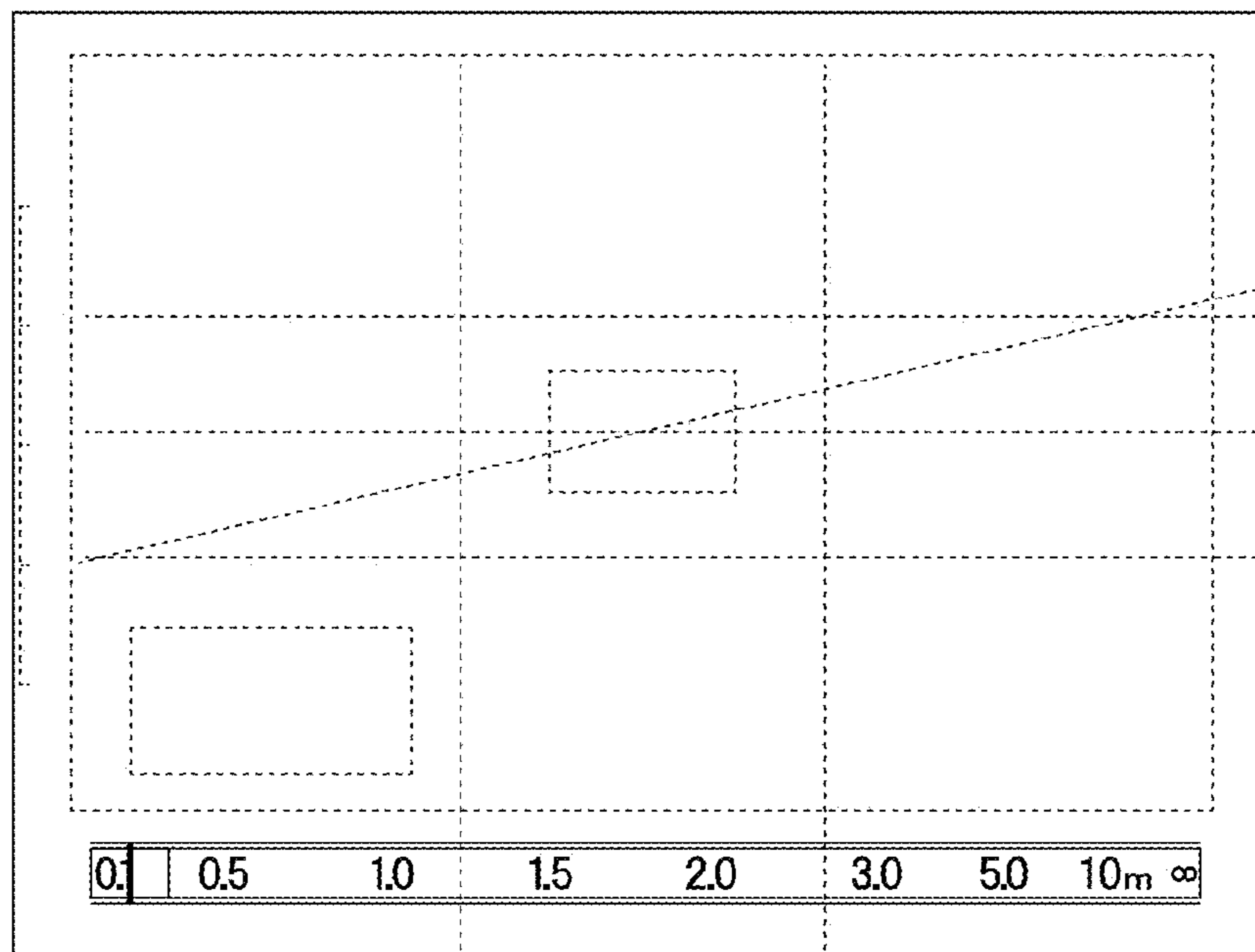

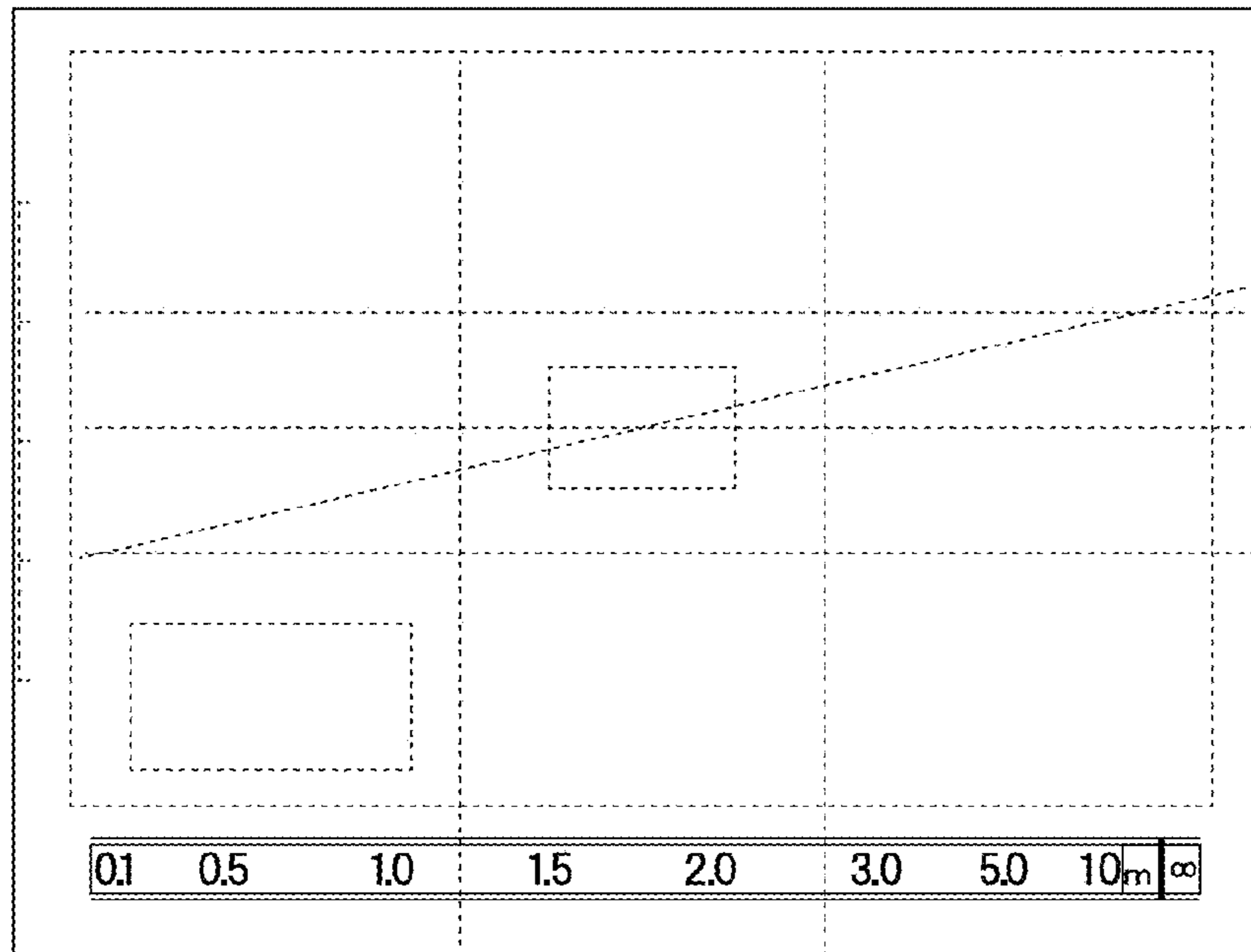

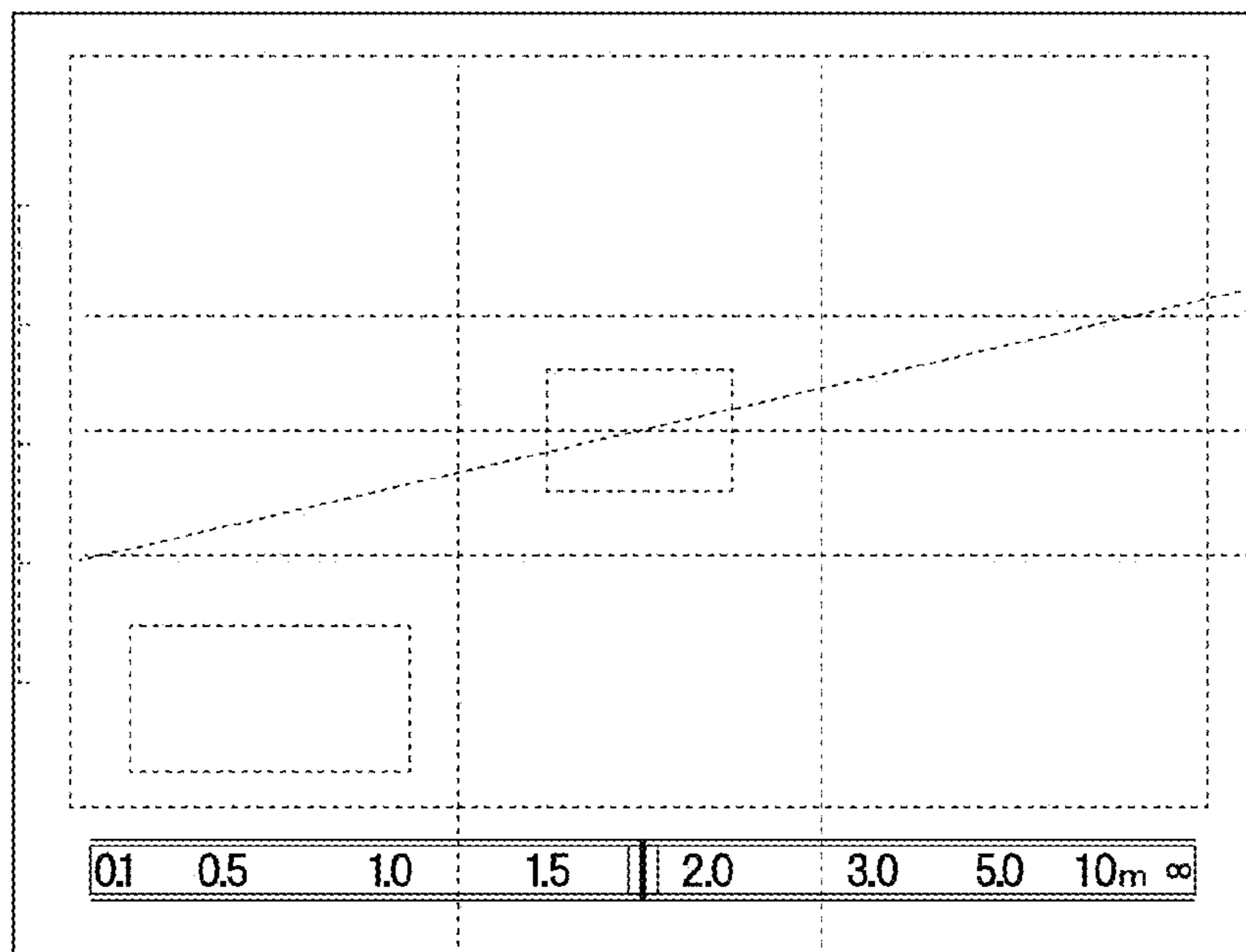

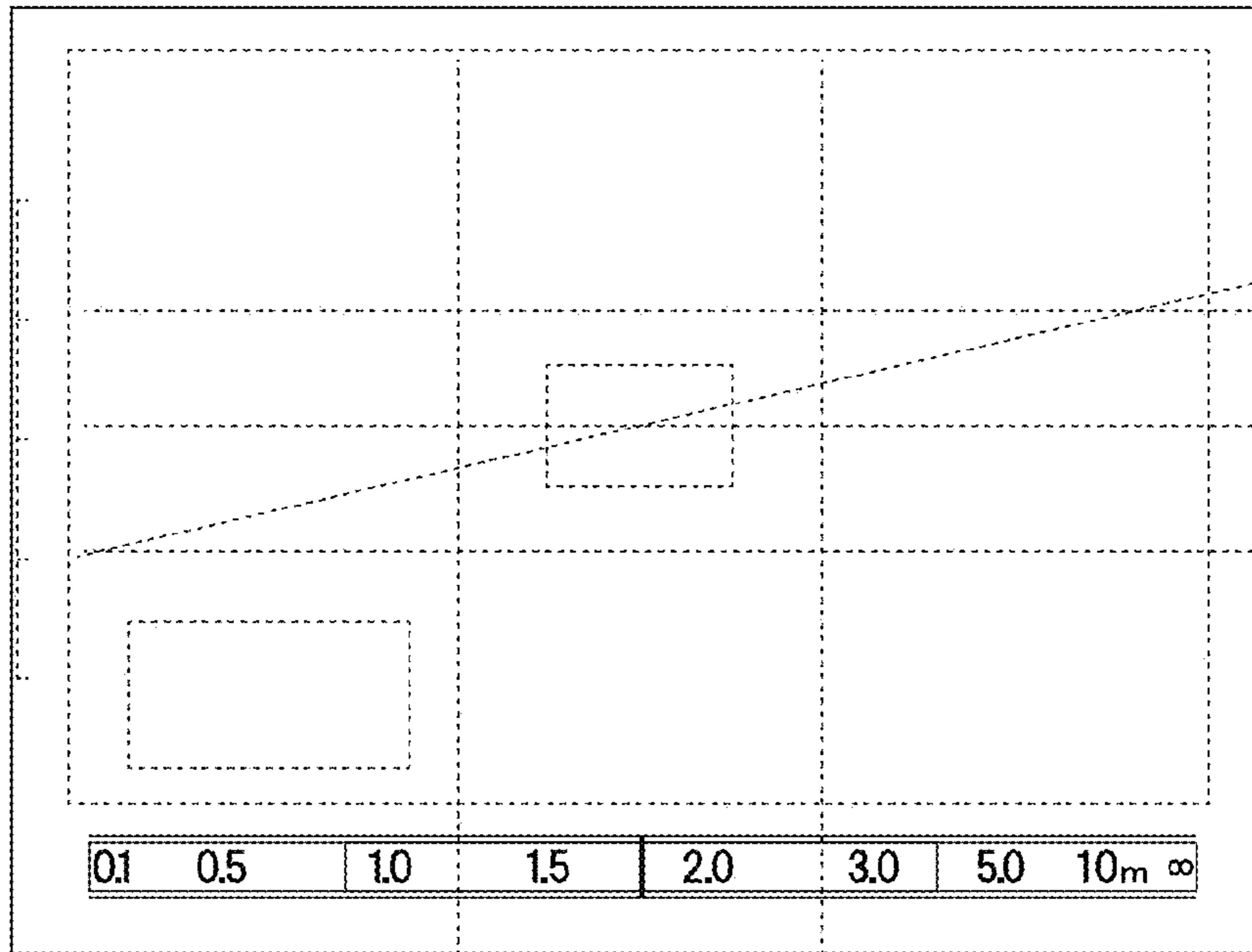
