(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined surface for a shipping box and shipping box, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a view of a shipping box showing a first embodiment of the new design, wherein the portions of the drawings shown in broken lines, i.e., the broken line edges of the box, the "TM" symbol in broken lines, and the broken line encircling the design, are to show environmental boundaries that form no part of the claimed design.

FIG. 2 is a front view of a shipping box of FIG. 1, wherein the portions of the drawings shown in broken lines, i.e., the broken line edges of the box, the "TM" symbol in broken lines, and the broken line encircling the design, are to show environmental boundaries that form no part of the claimed design. FIG. 3 is a rear view of the shipping box of FIG. 1, wherein the portions of the drawings shown in broken lines, i.e., the broken line edges of the box, are to show environmental boundaries that form no part of the claimed design.

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the shipping box of FIG. 1, wherein the portions of the drawings shown in broken lines, i.e., the broken line edges of the box, are to show environmental boundaries that form no part of the claimed design.












