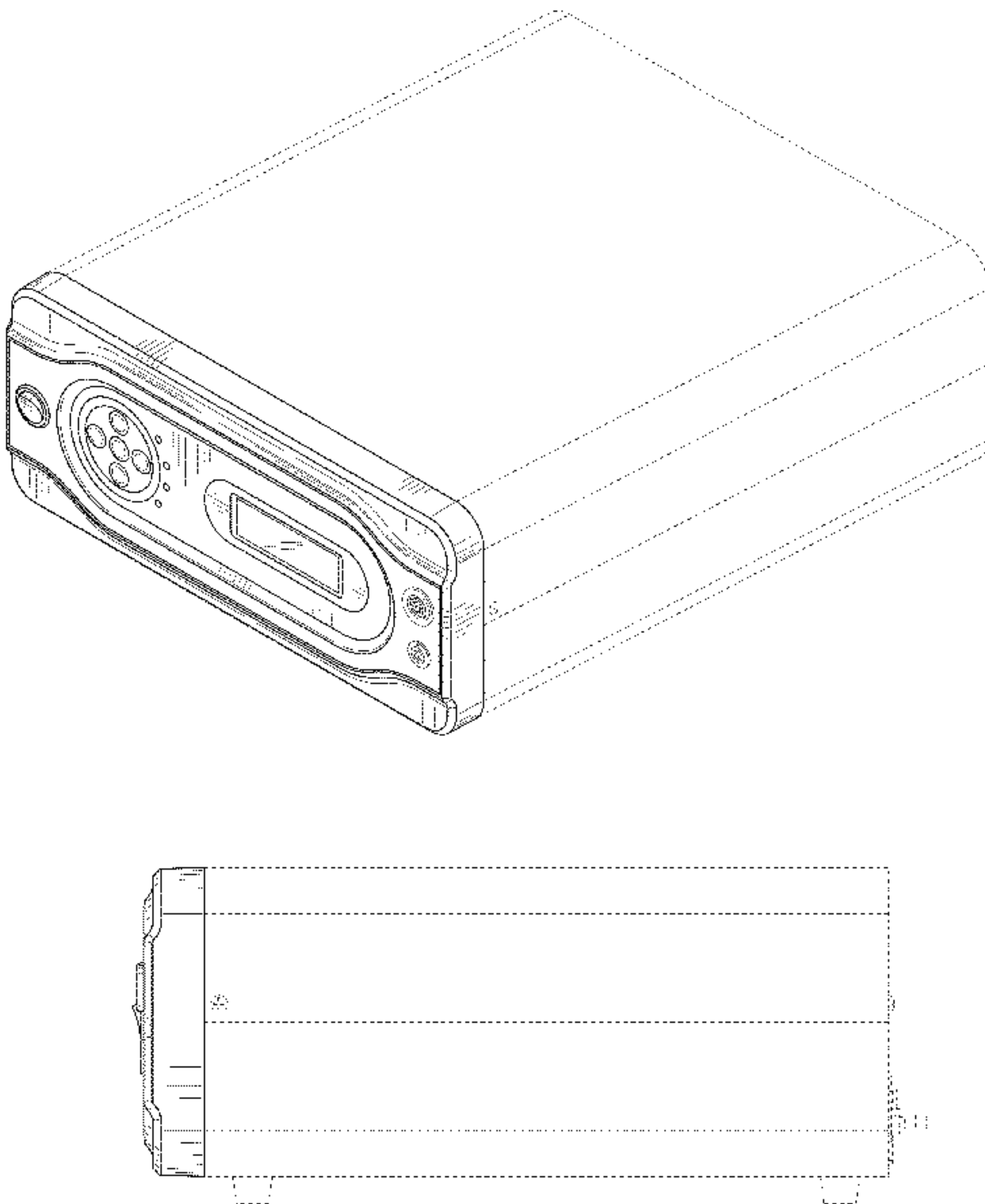
CLAIM

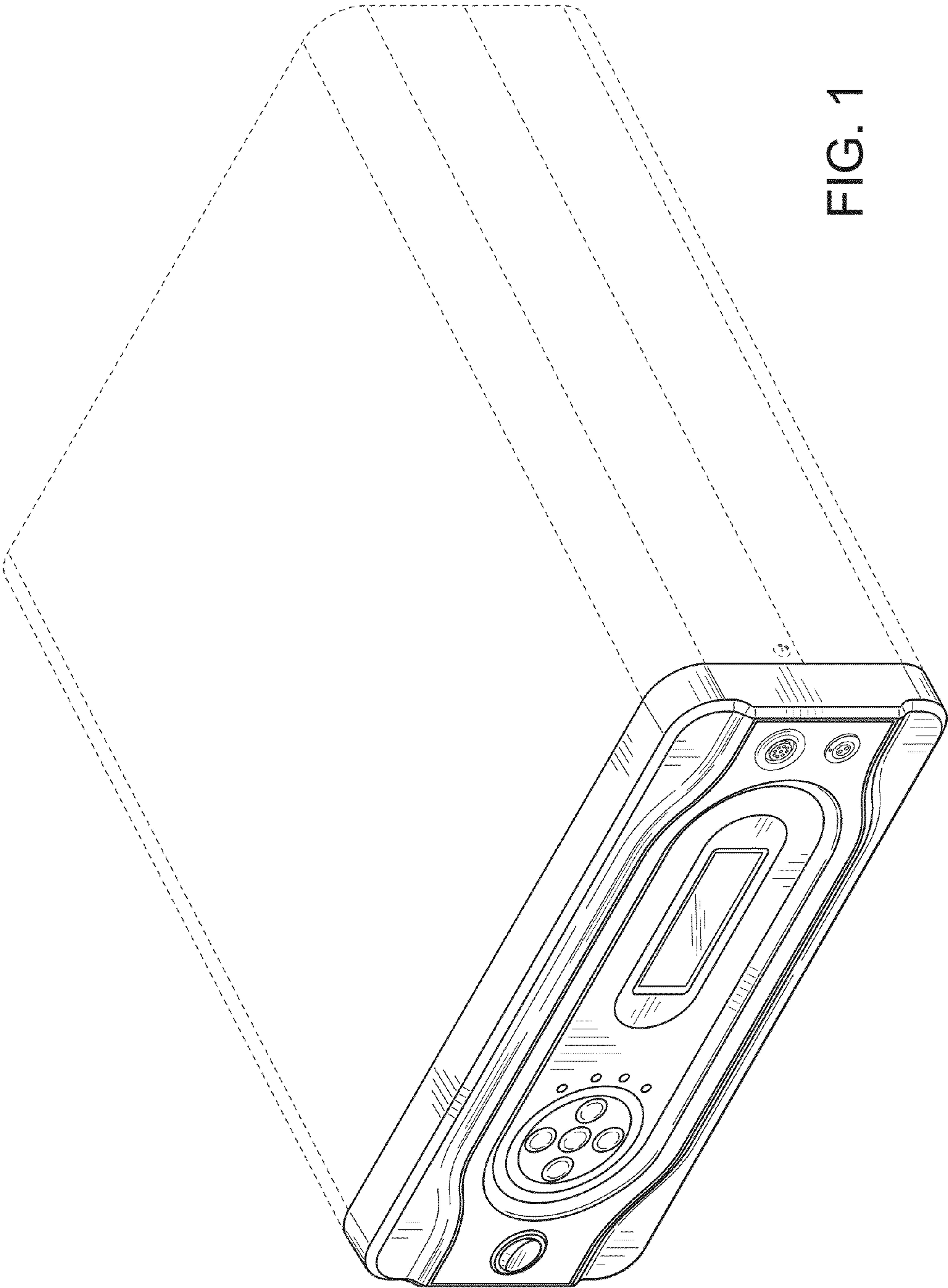

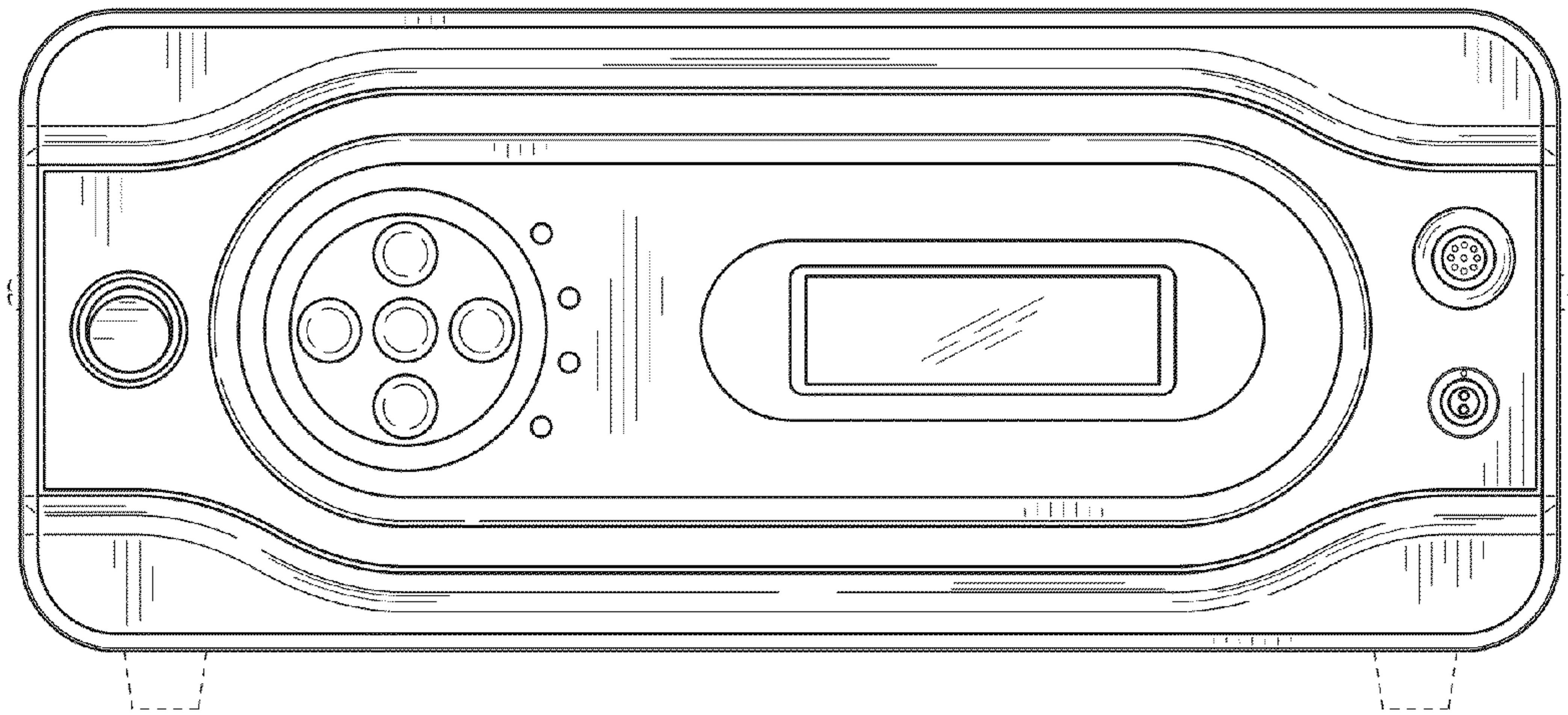

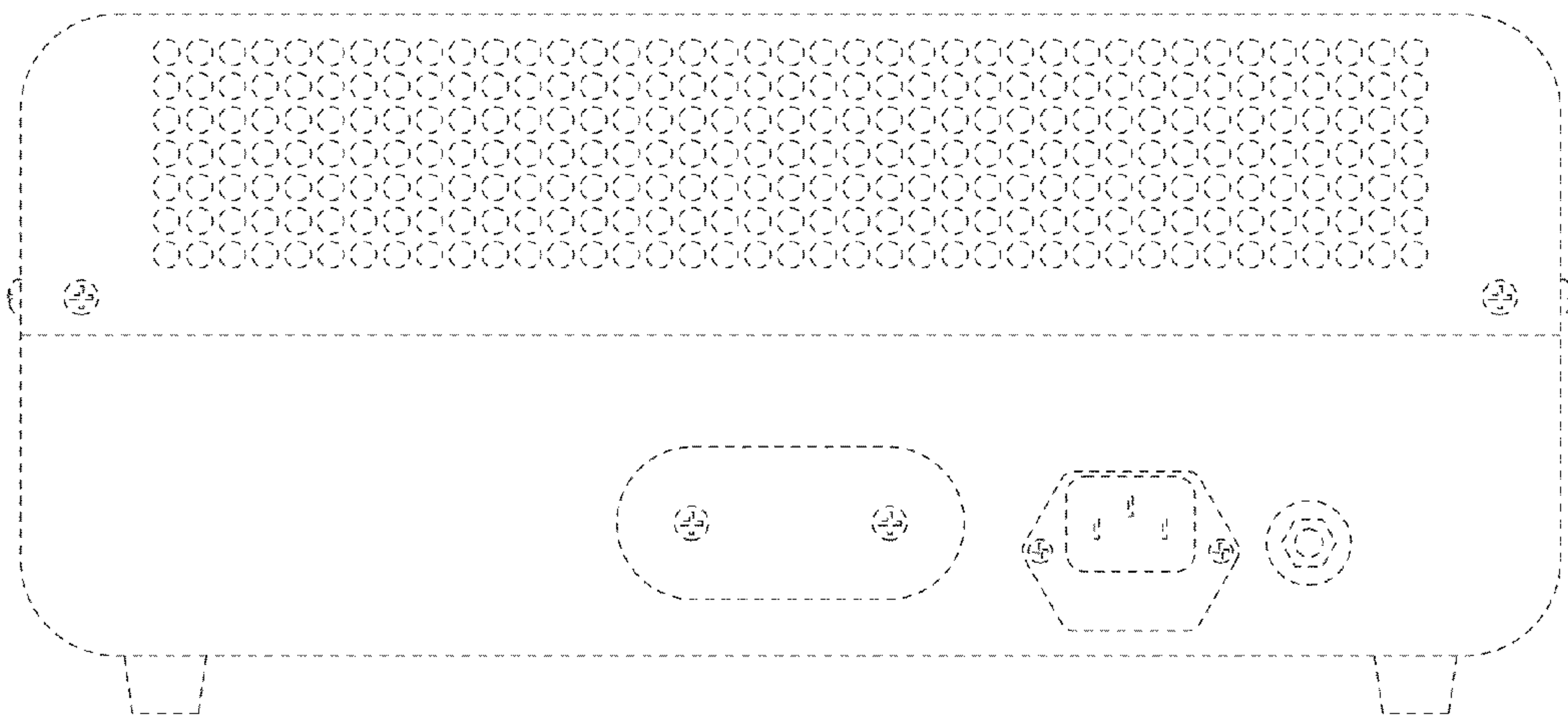
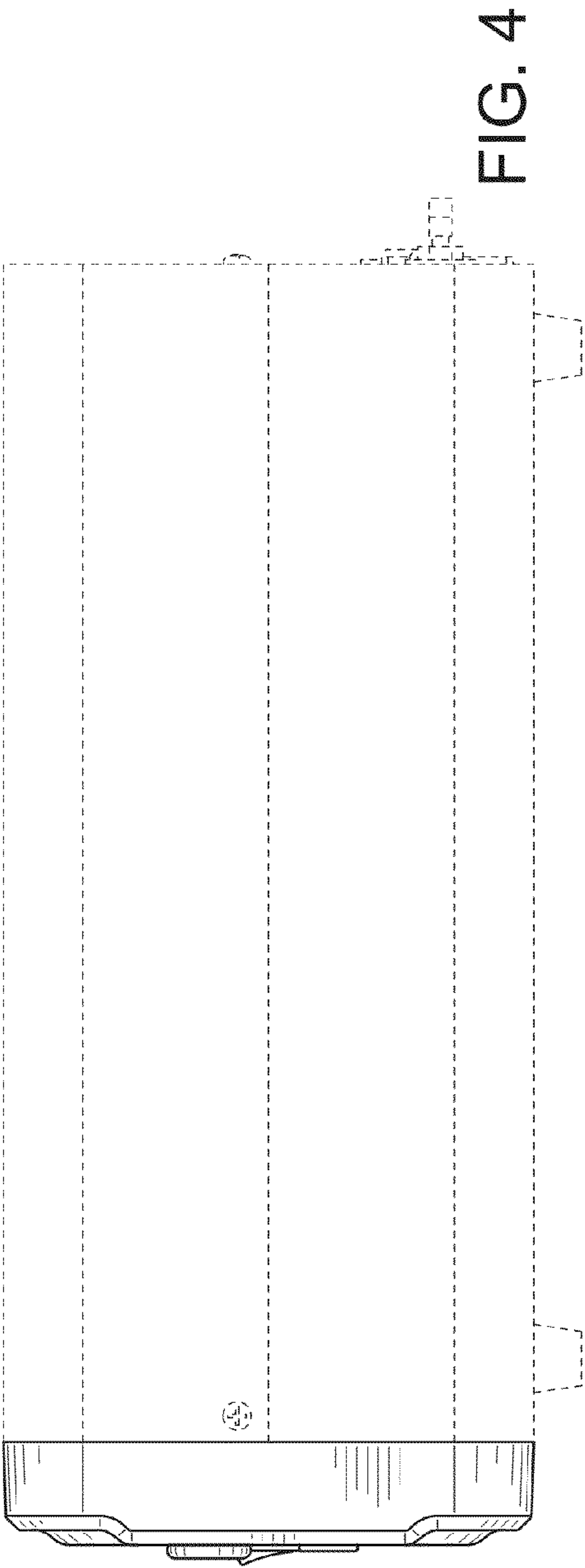

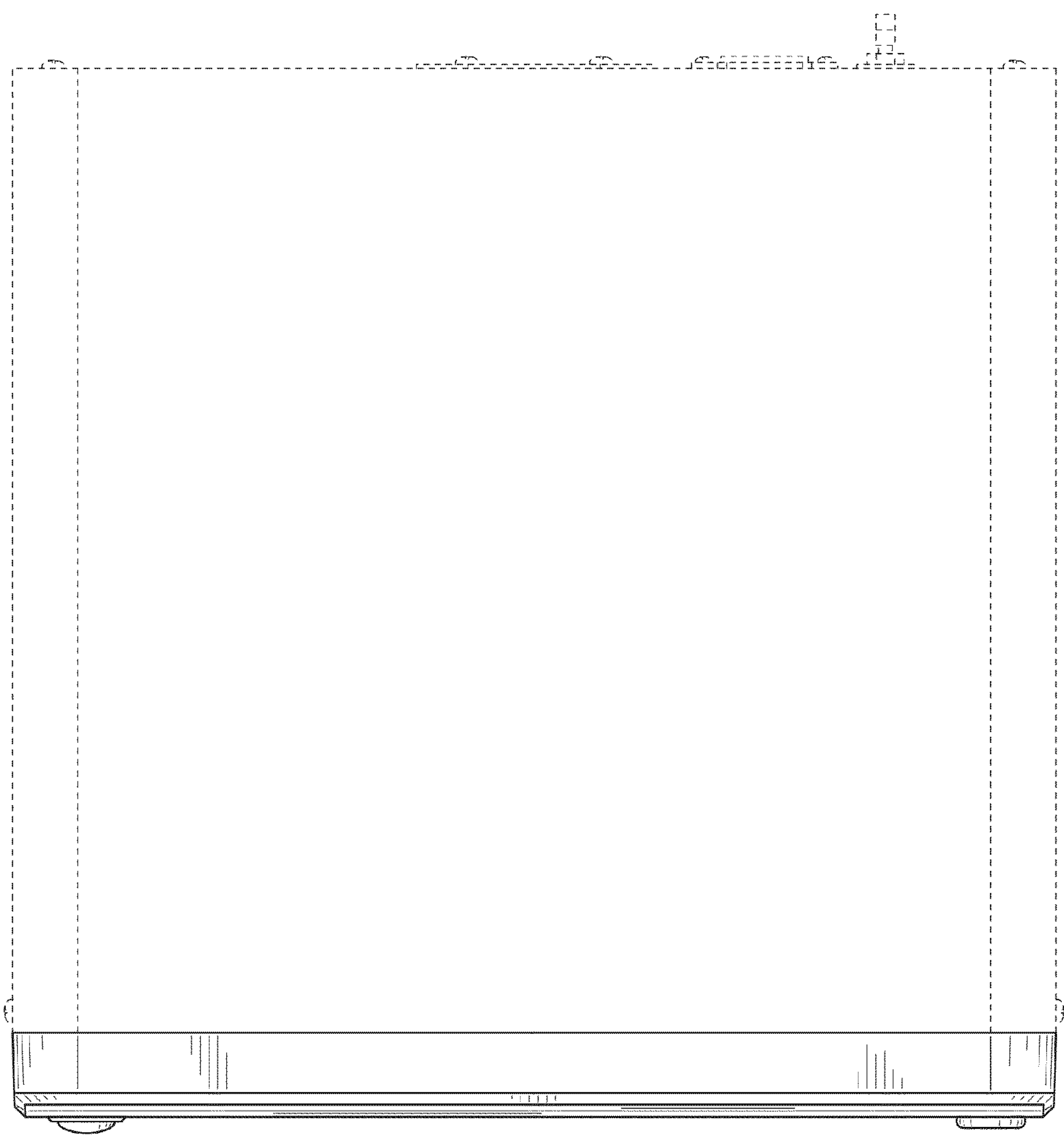

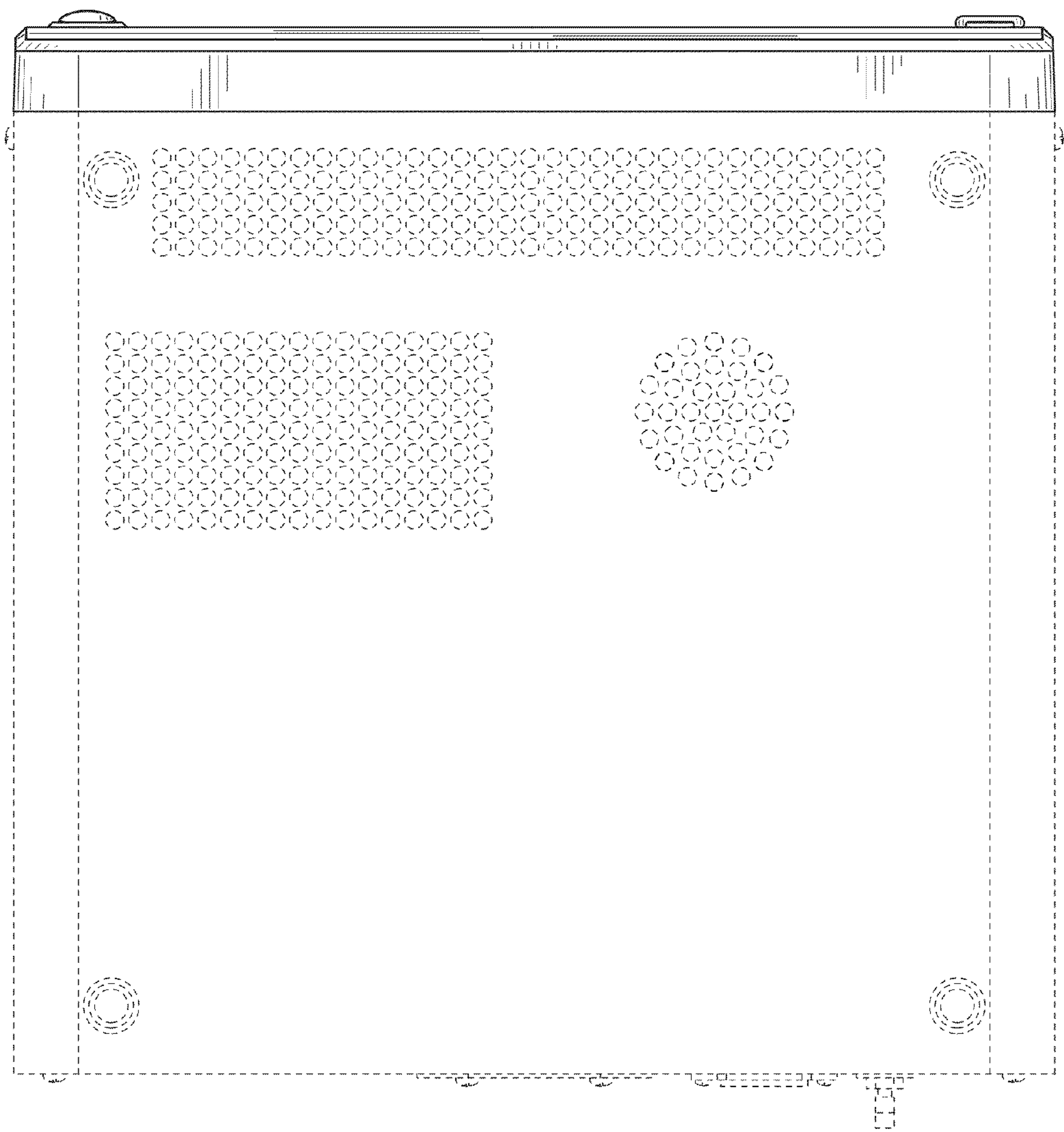
