(57) **CLAIM**

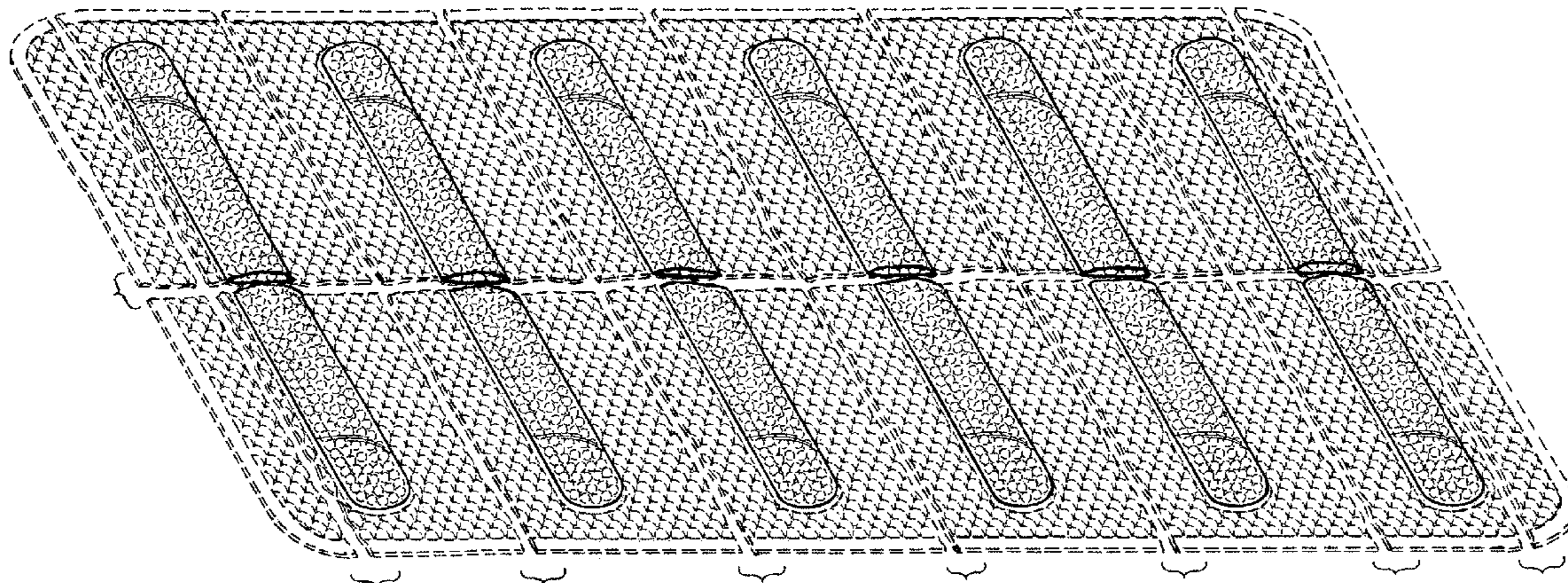
The ornamental design for a bath mat with protruding strips, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a first embodiment of a bath mat with protruding strips;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the bath mat with protruding strips shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the bath mat with protruding strips shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the bath mat with protruding strips shown in FIG. 1, the rear being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the bath mat with protruding strips shown in FIG. 1, the right side being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a second embodiment of a bath mat with protruding strips;
 FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the bath mat with protruding strips shown in FIG. 6;
 FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of the bath mat with protruding strips shown in FIG. 6;
 FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of the bath mat with protruding strips shown in FIG. 6, the rear being a mirror image thereof; and,
 FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view of the bath mat with protruding strips shown in FIG. 6, the right side being a mirror image thereof.

The broken lines depict unclaimed portions of the bath mat with protruding strips and form no part of the claimed design. The bath mat with protruding strips is shown with symbolic breaks. Any portion of the bath mat with protruding strips between the symbolic breaks forms no part of the claimed design. The color and surface finish of the bath mat with protruding strips form no part of the claimed design.

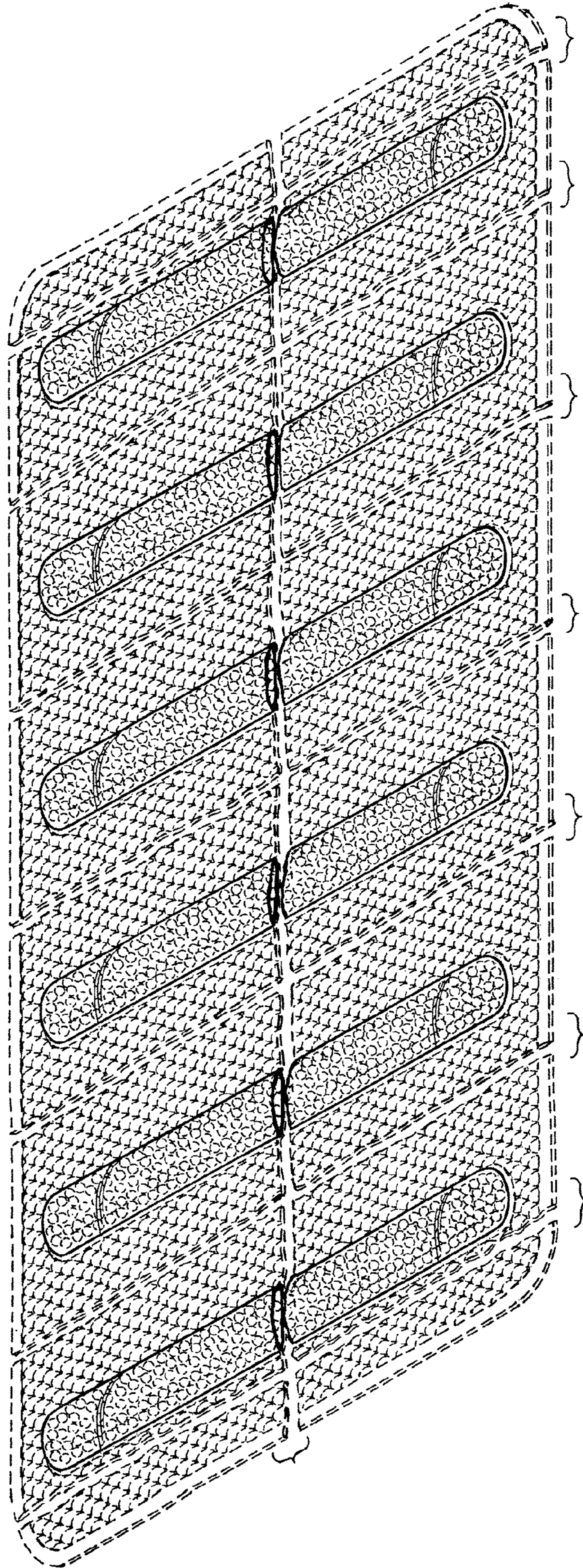

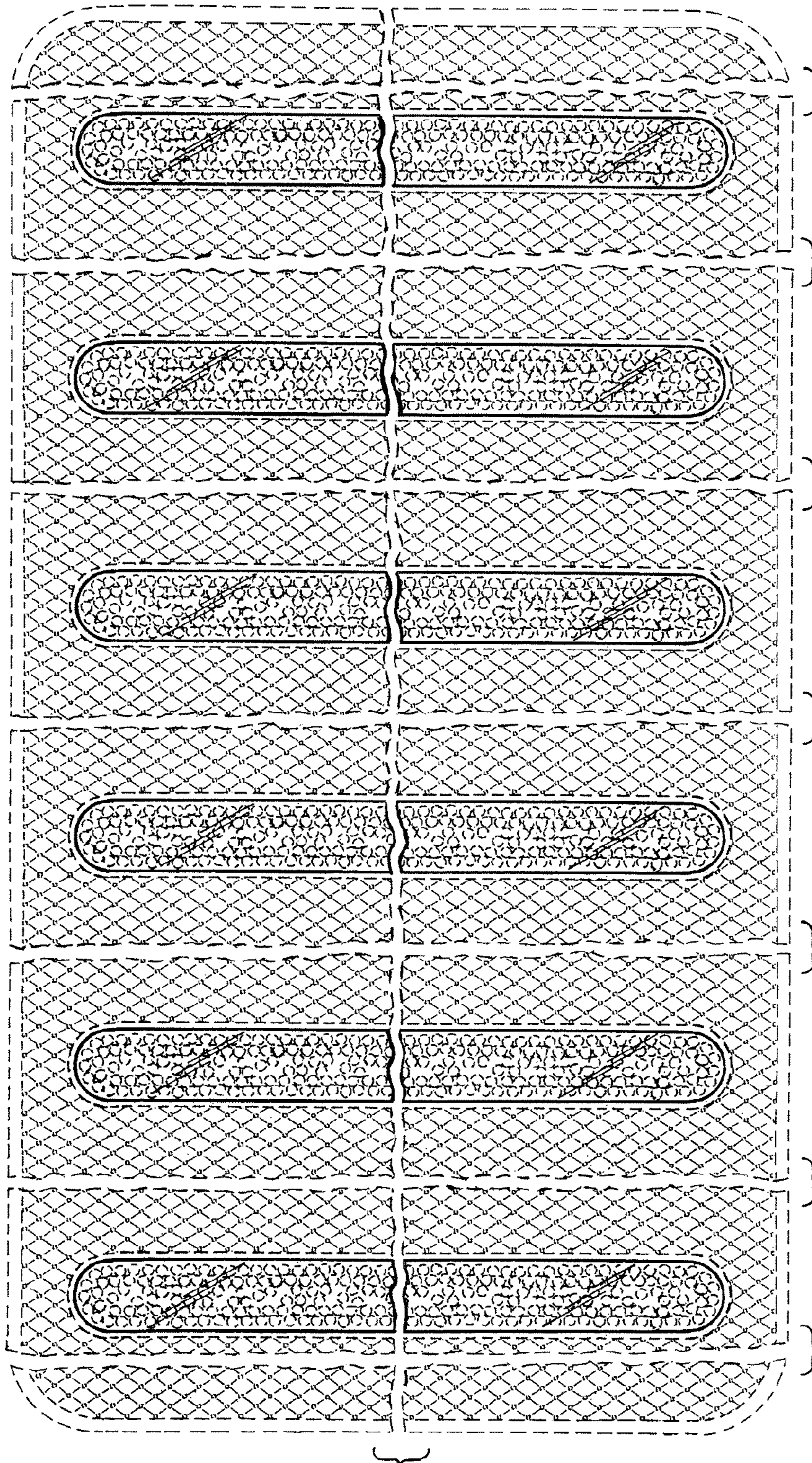

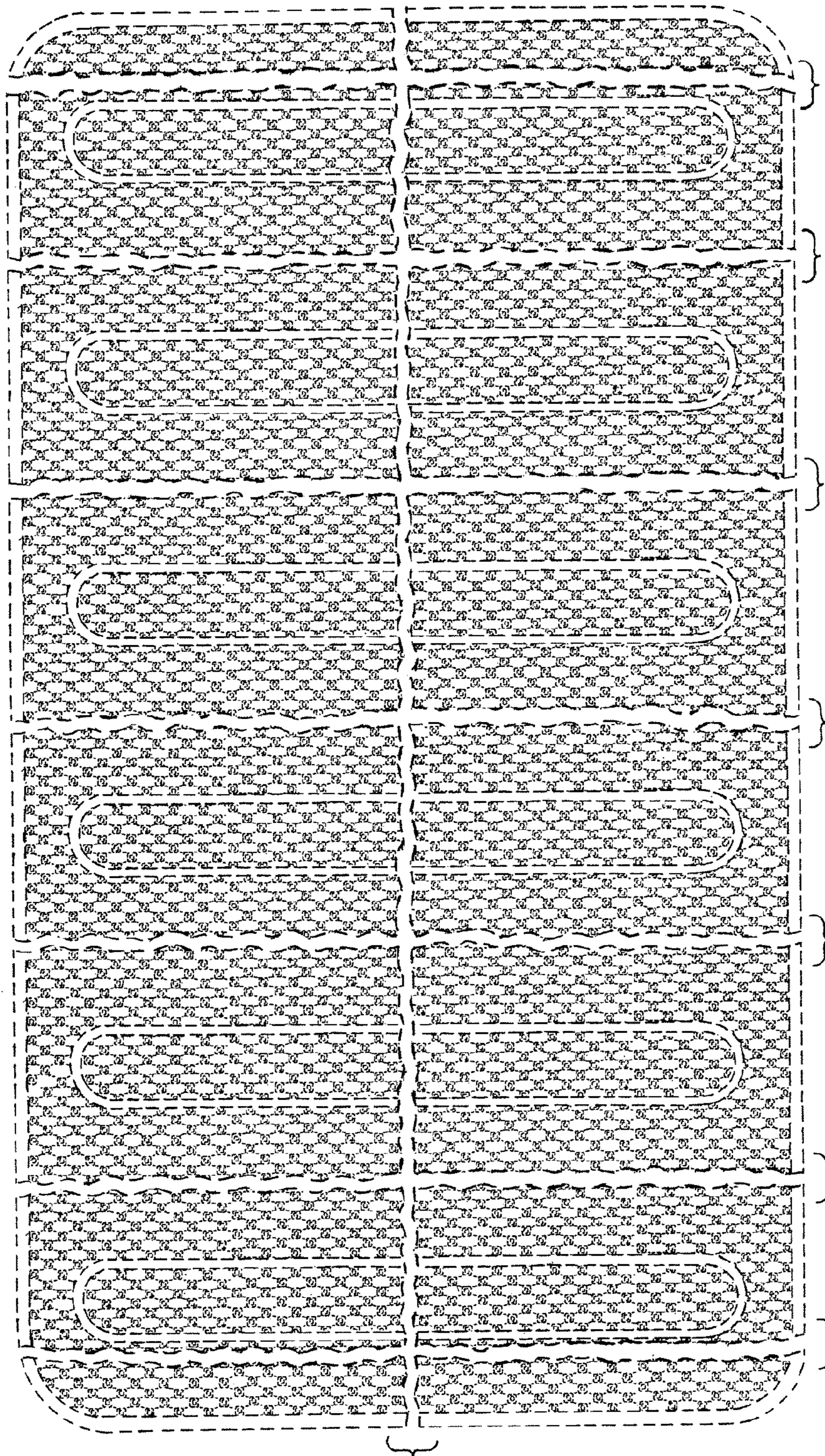

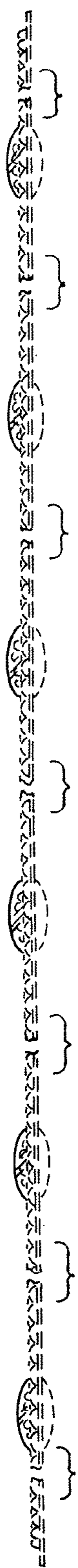

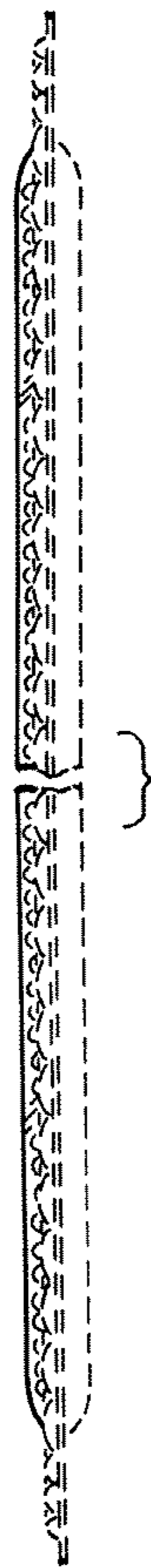

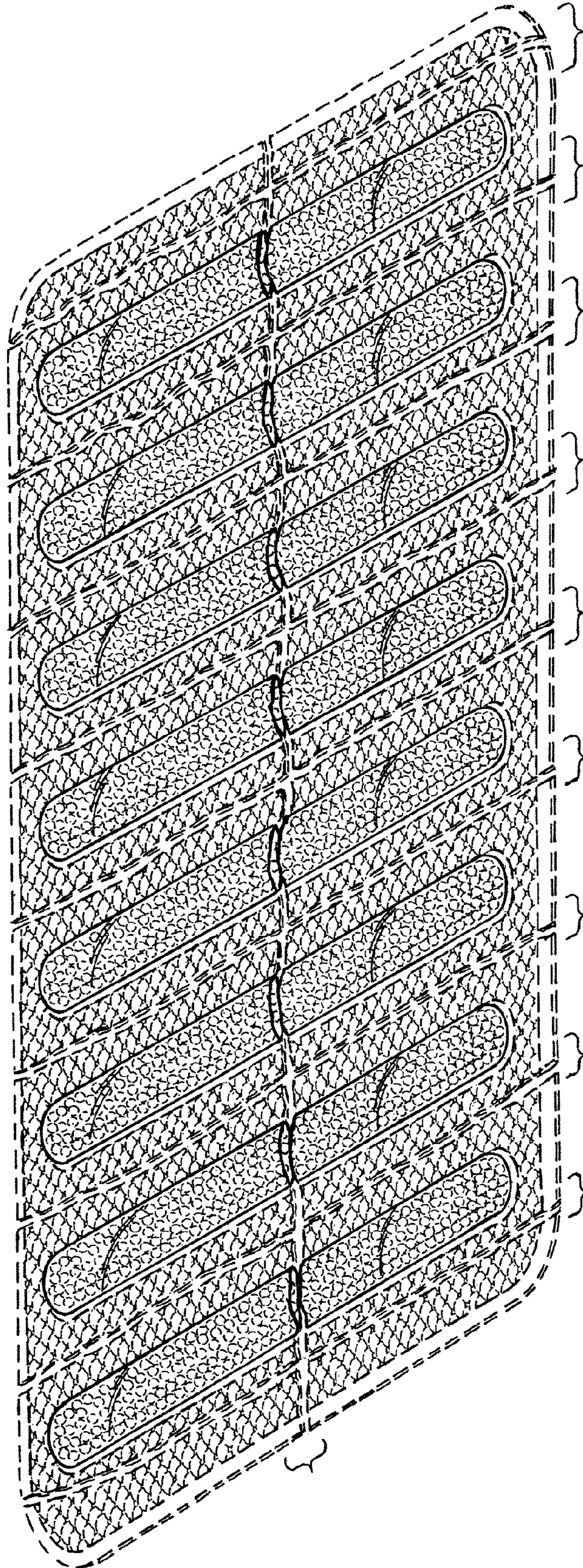

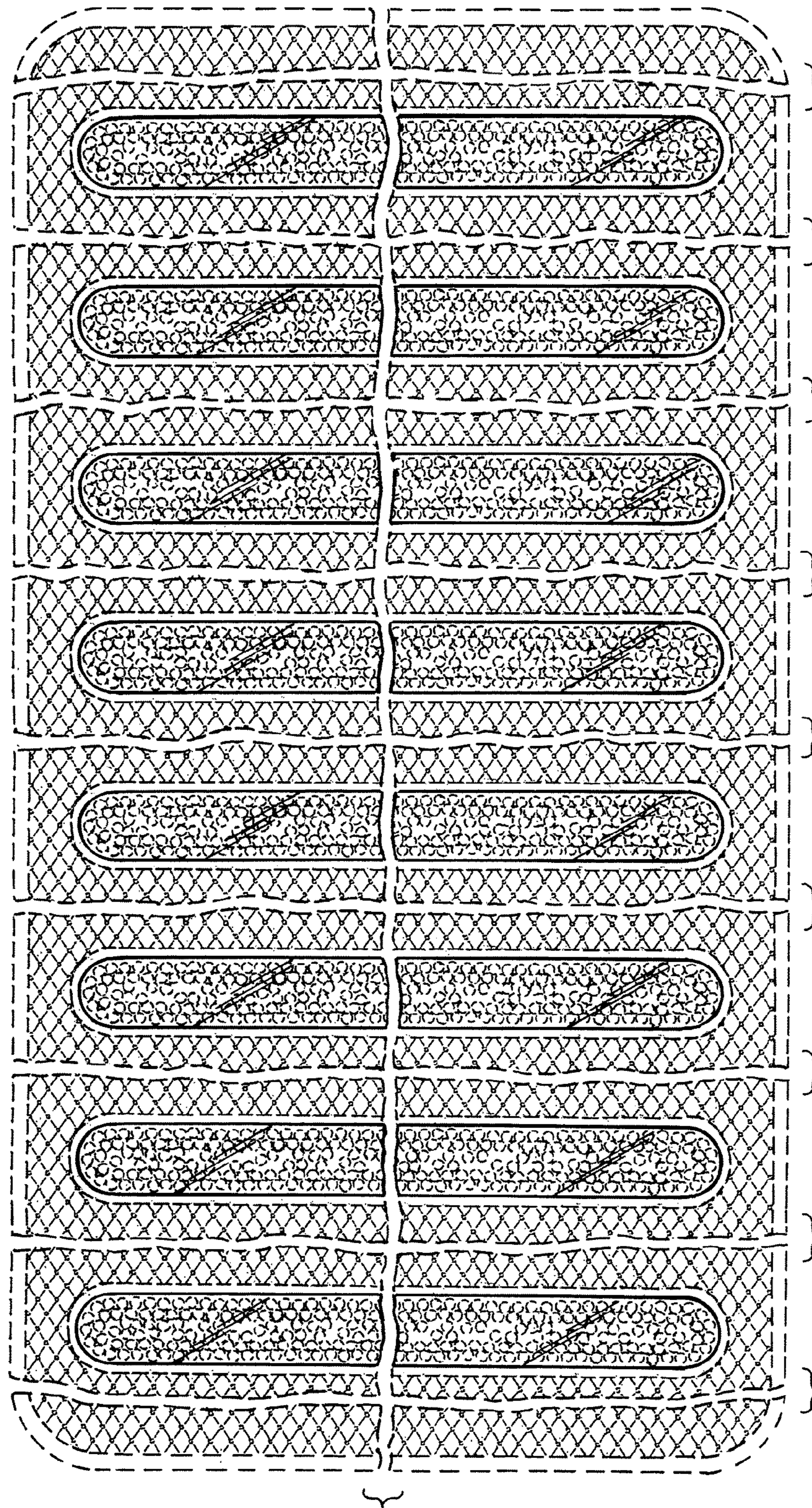

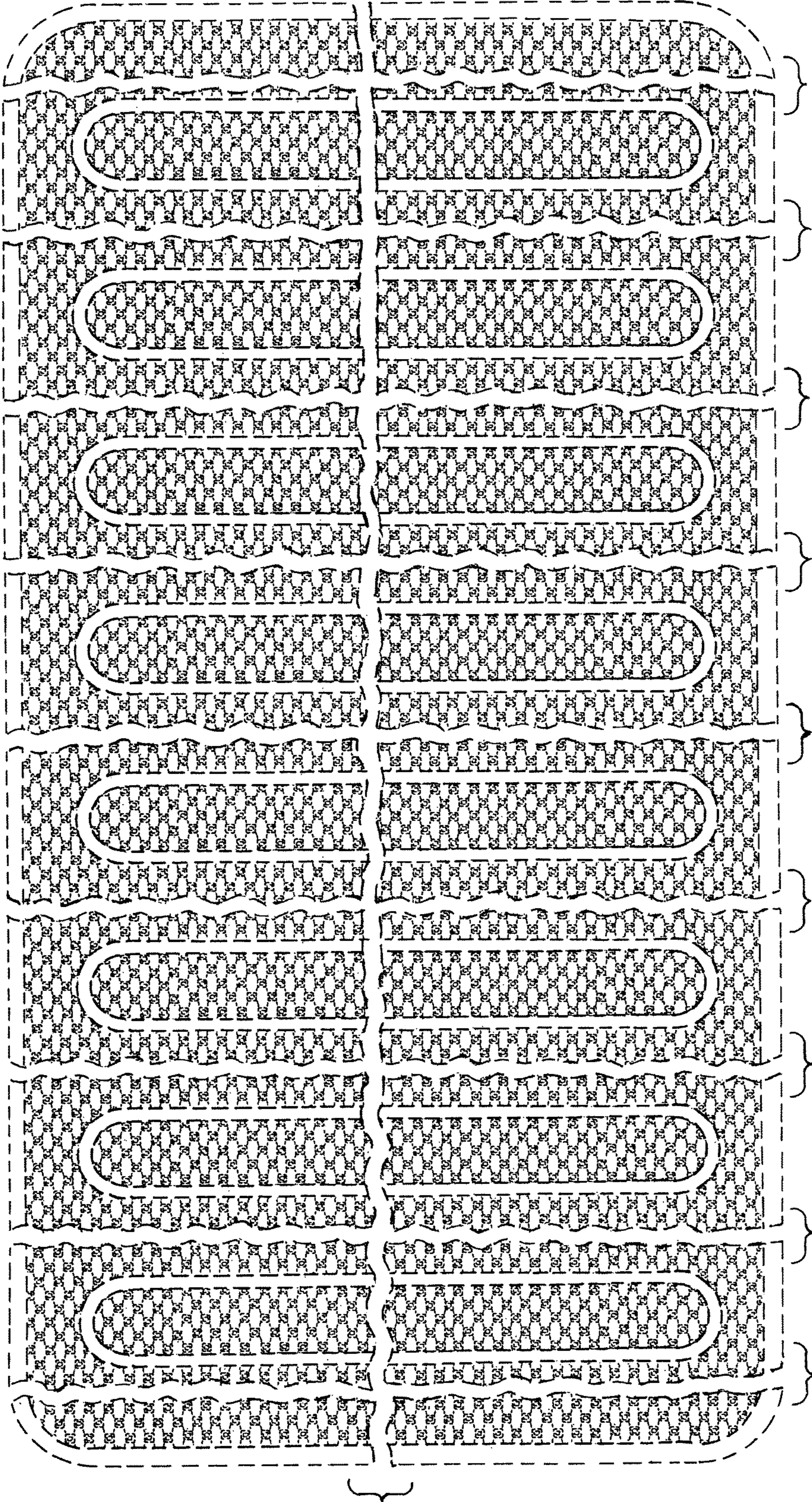

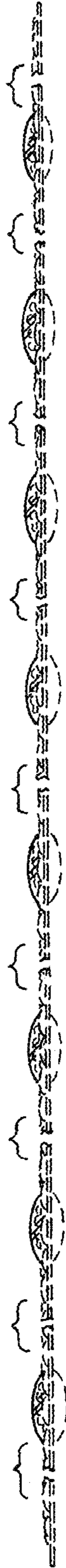
