(57) **CLAIM**

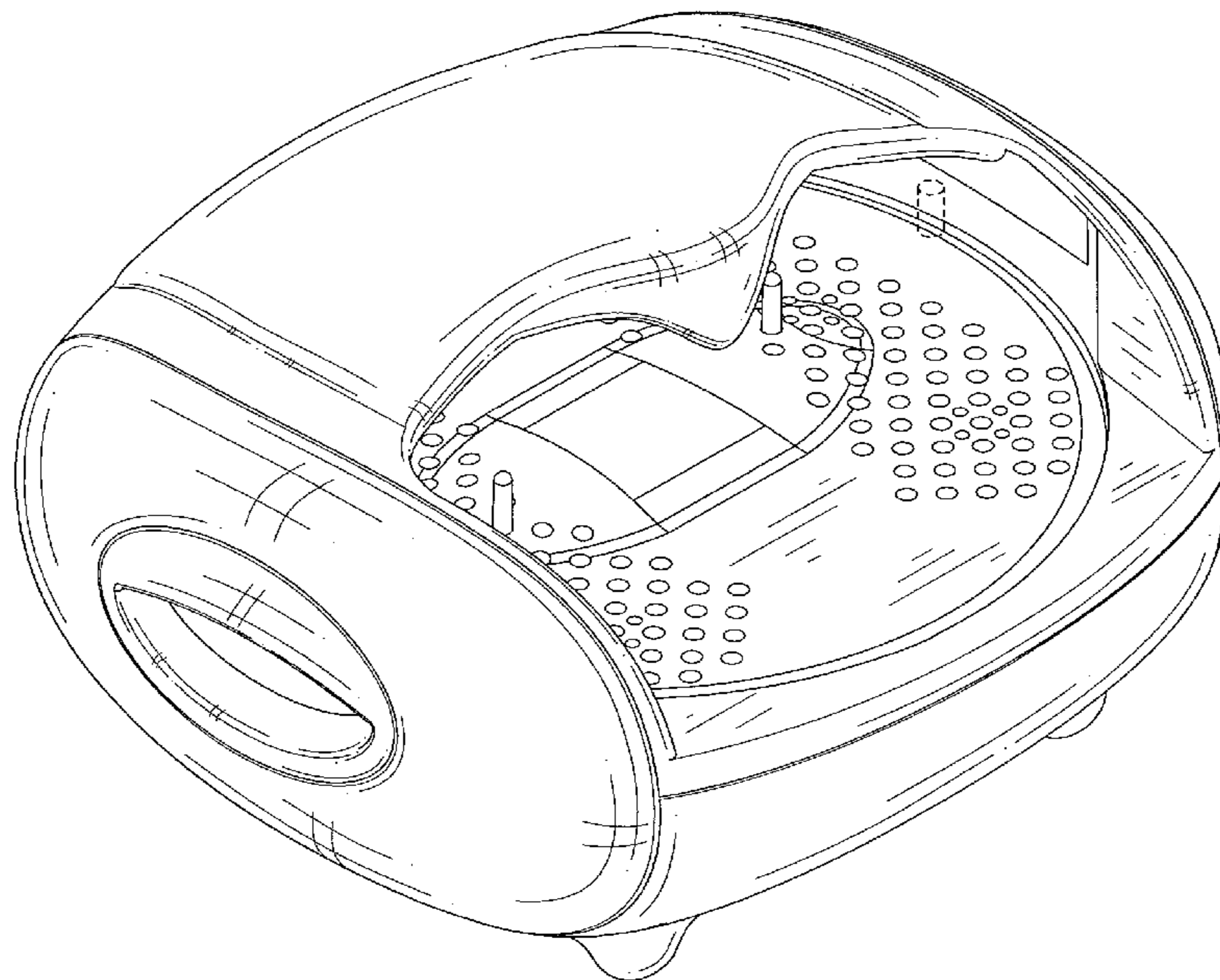
The ornamental design for a foot massager, as shown and

DESCRIPTION

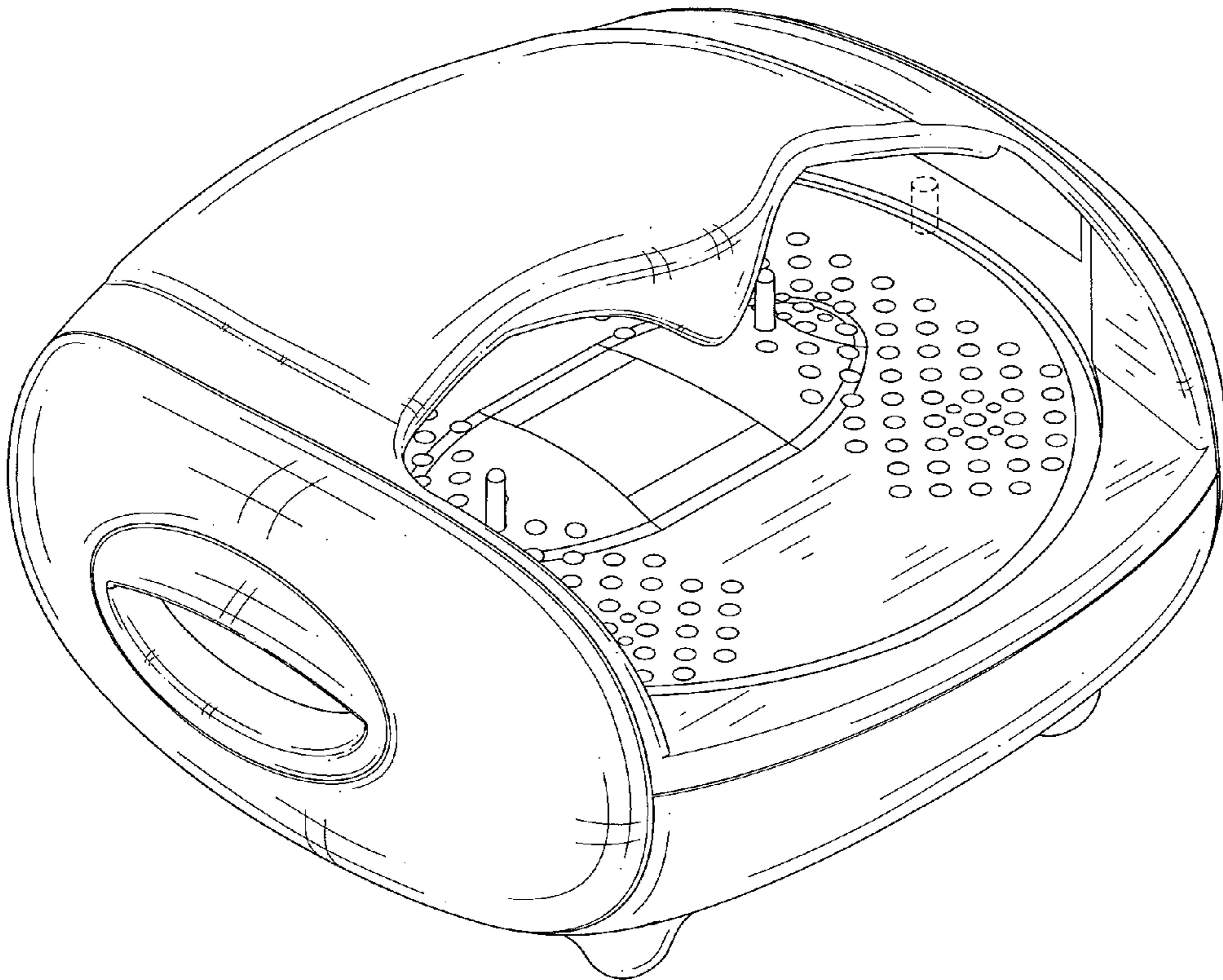

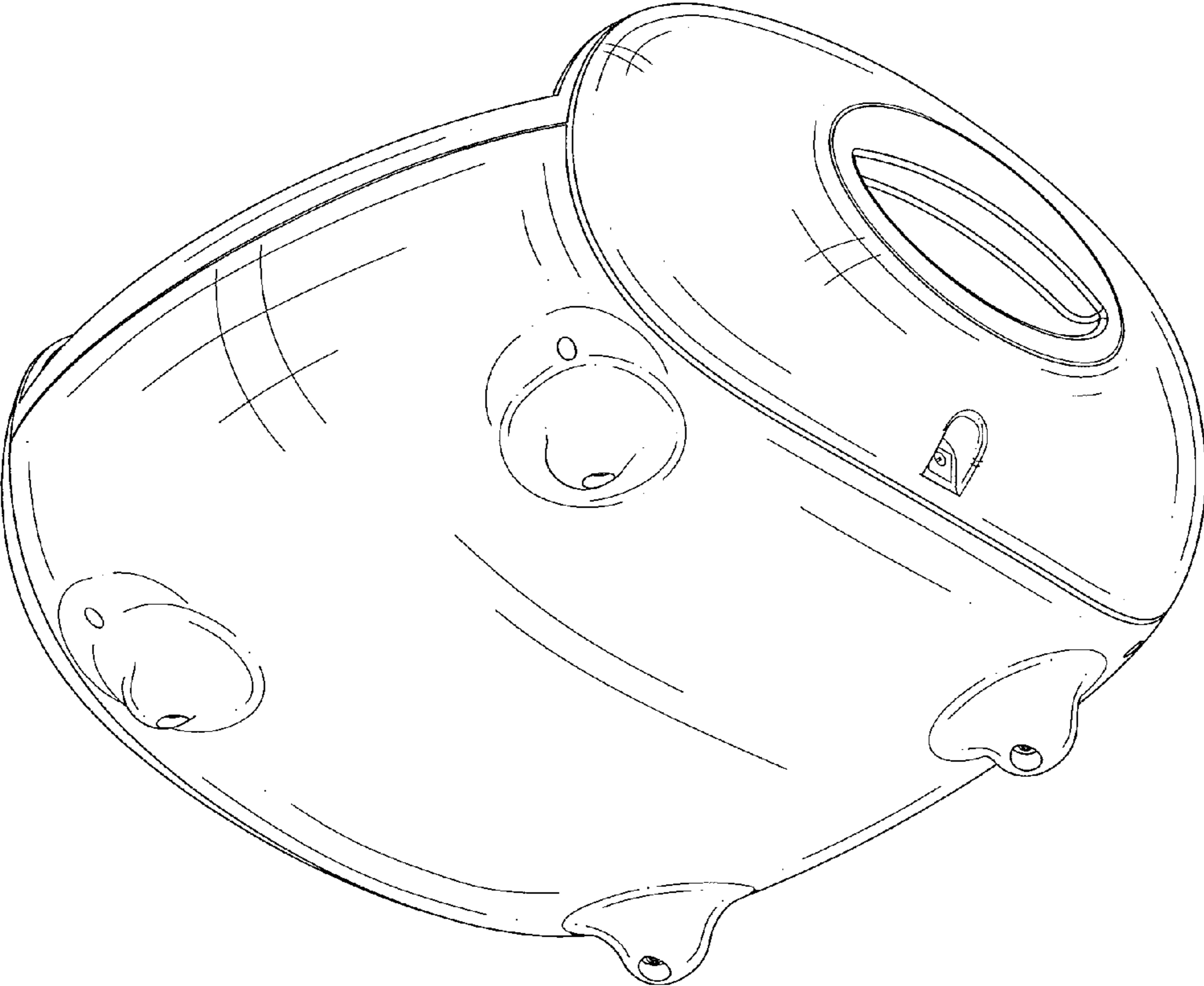

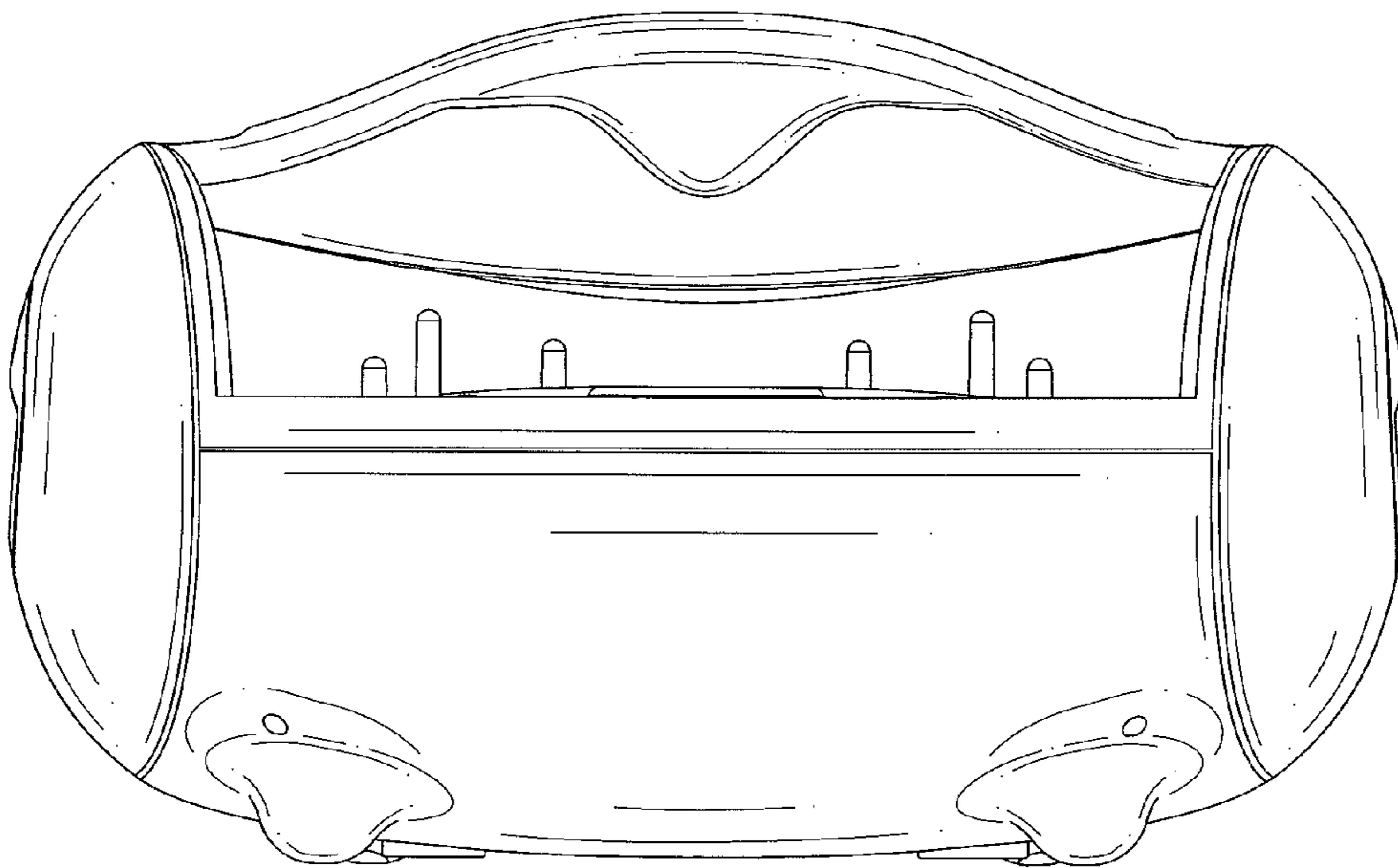

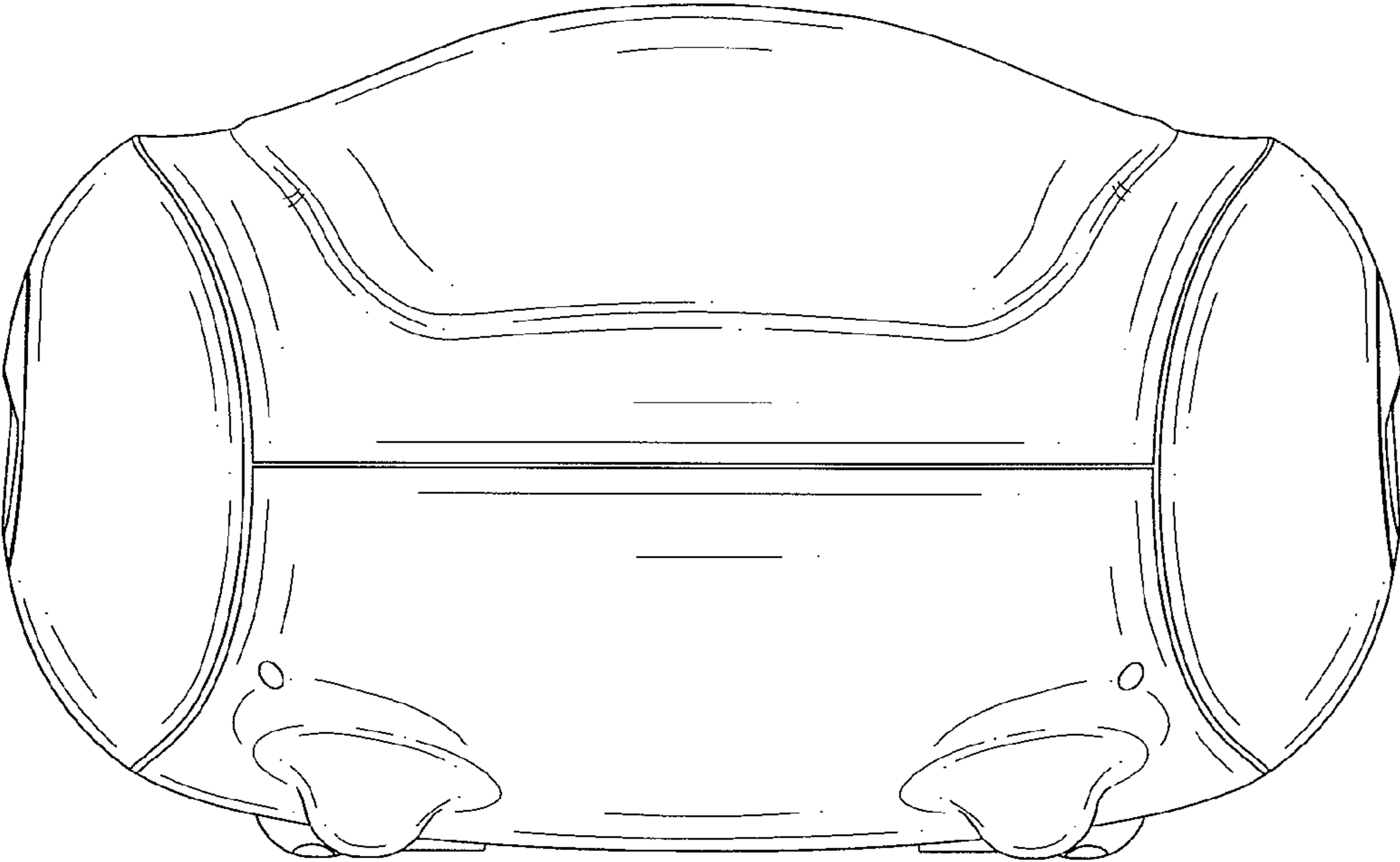

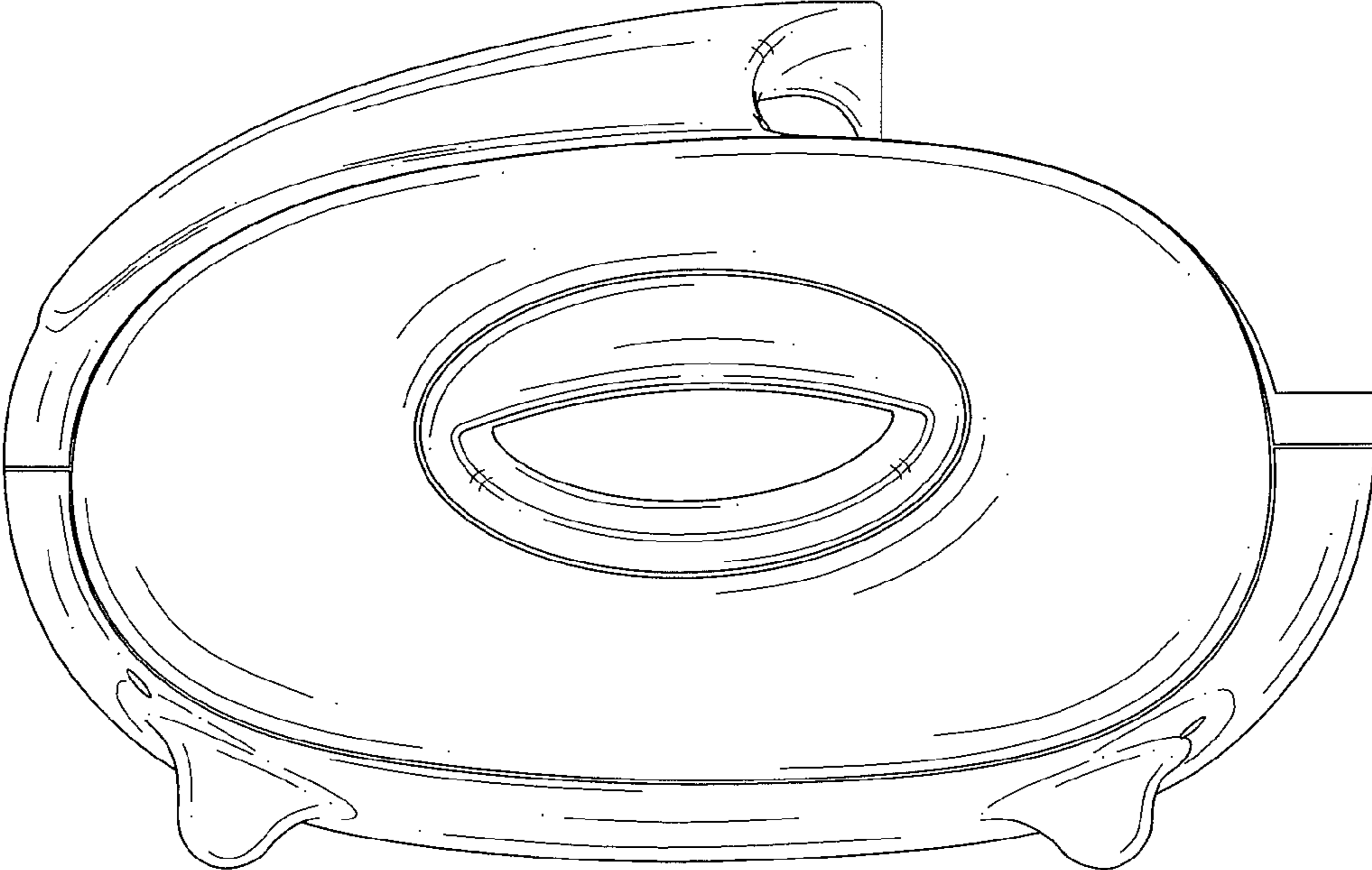

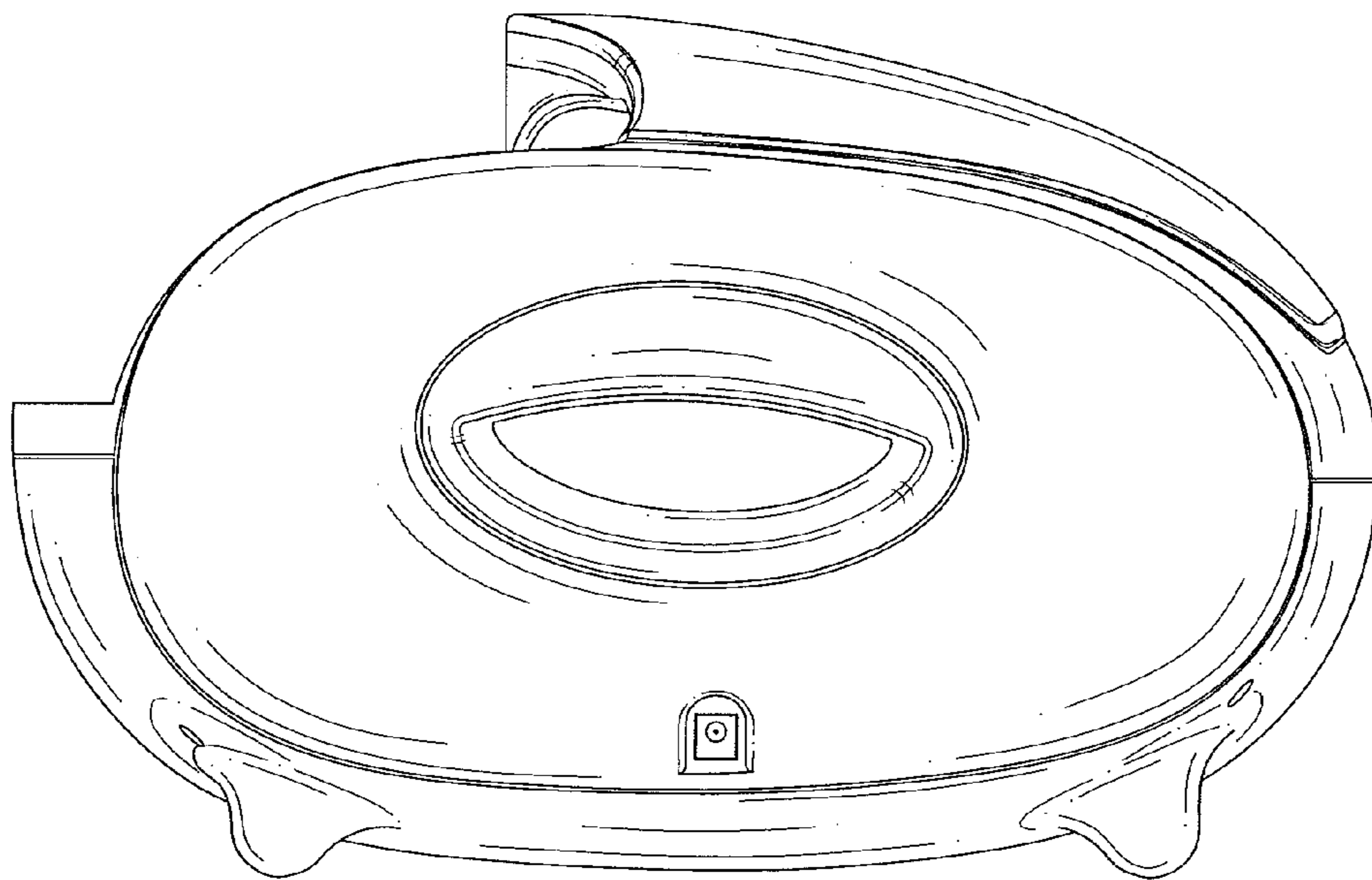

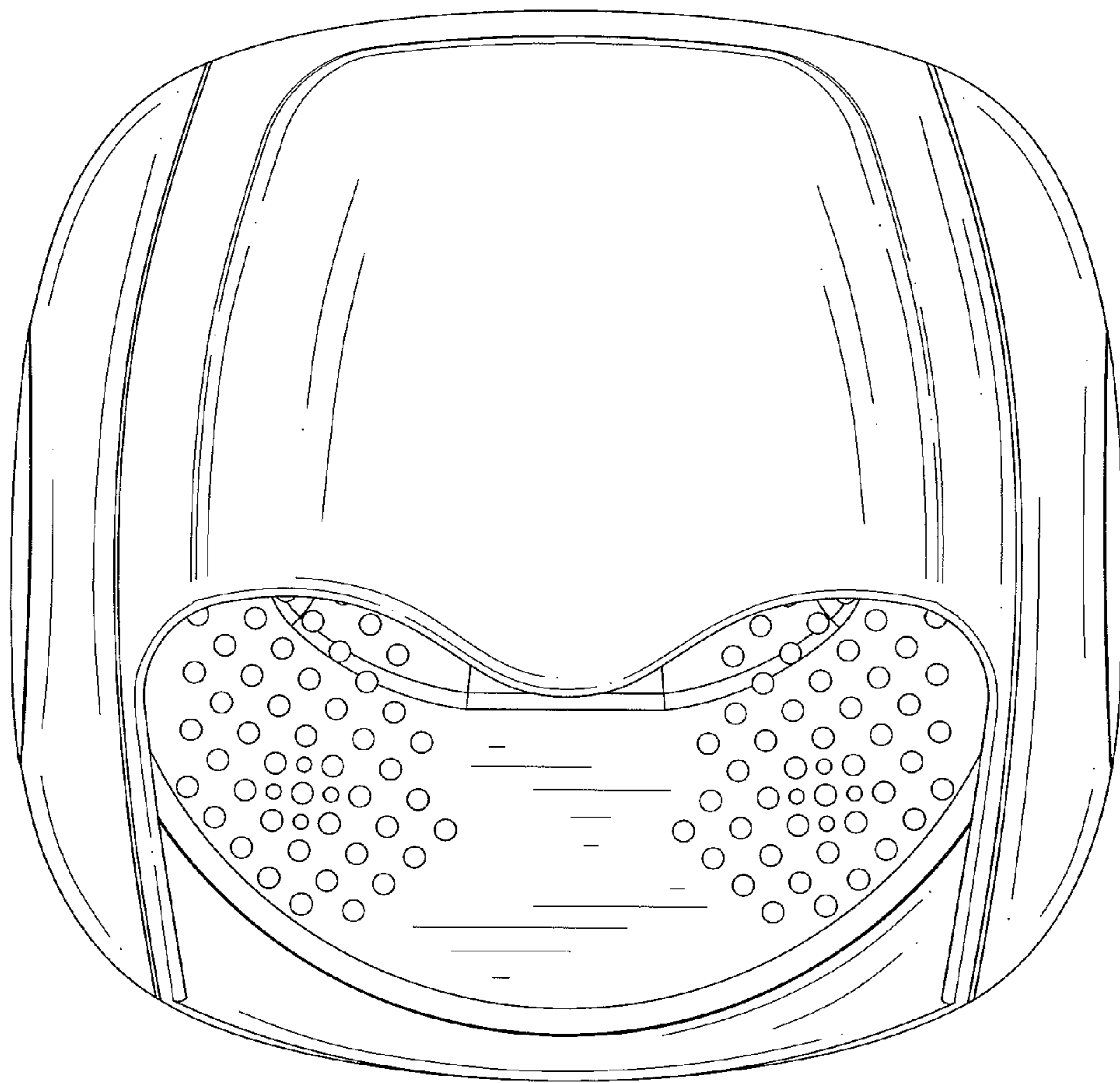

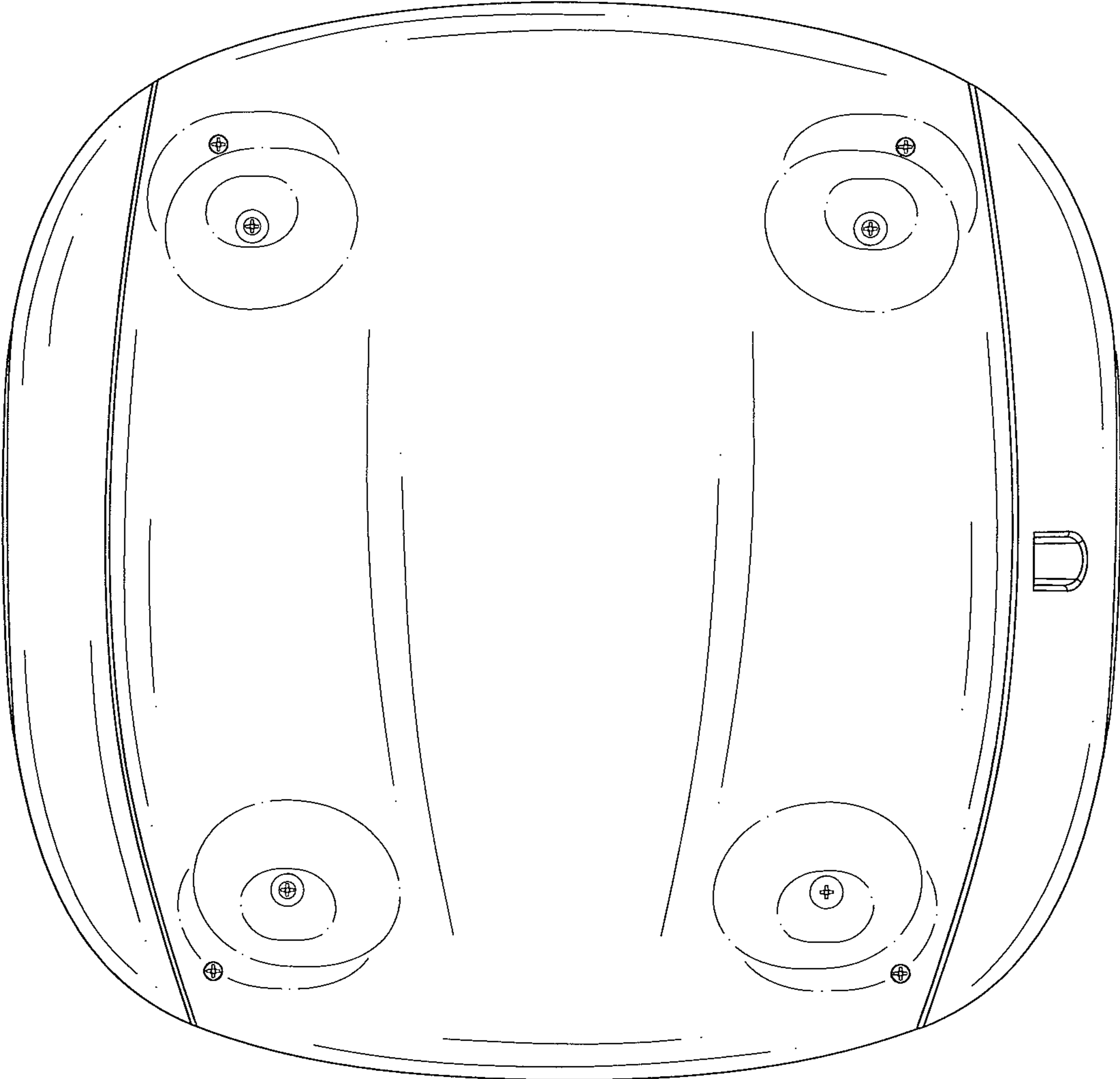
