of FIG. 1;

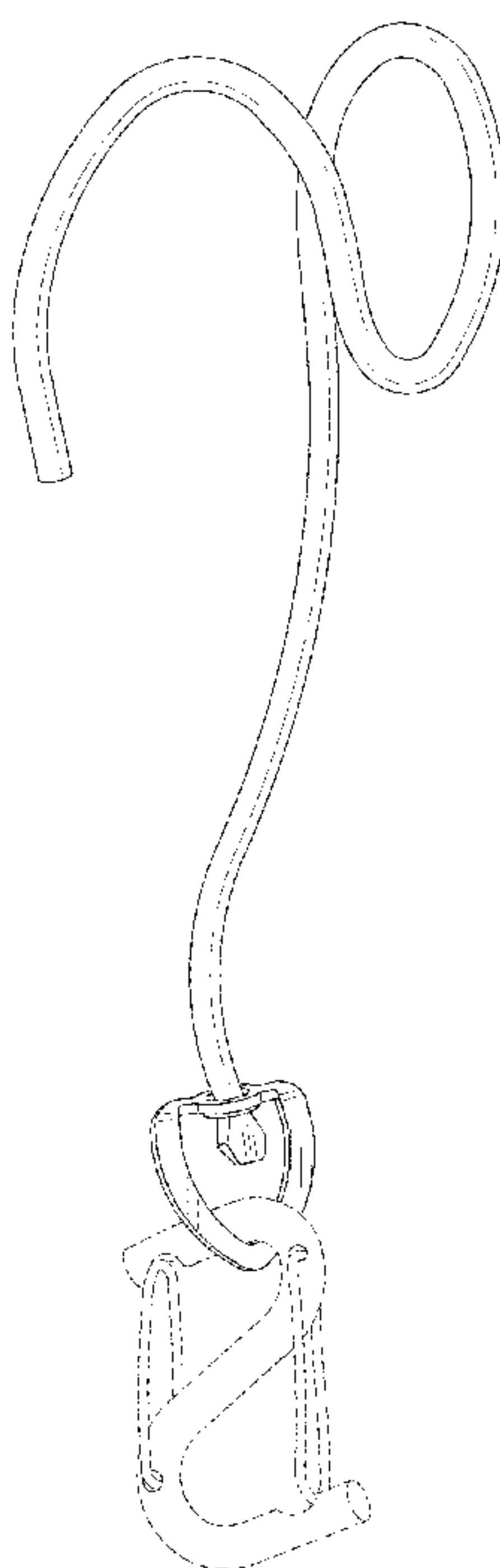
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the painting accessory support

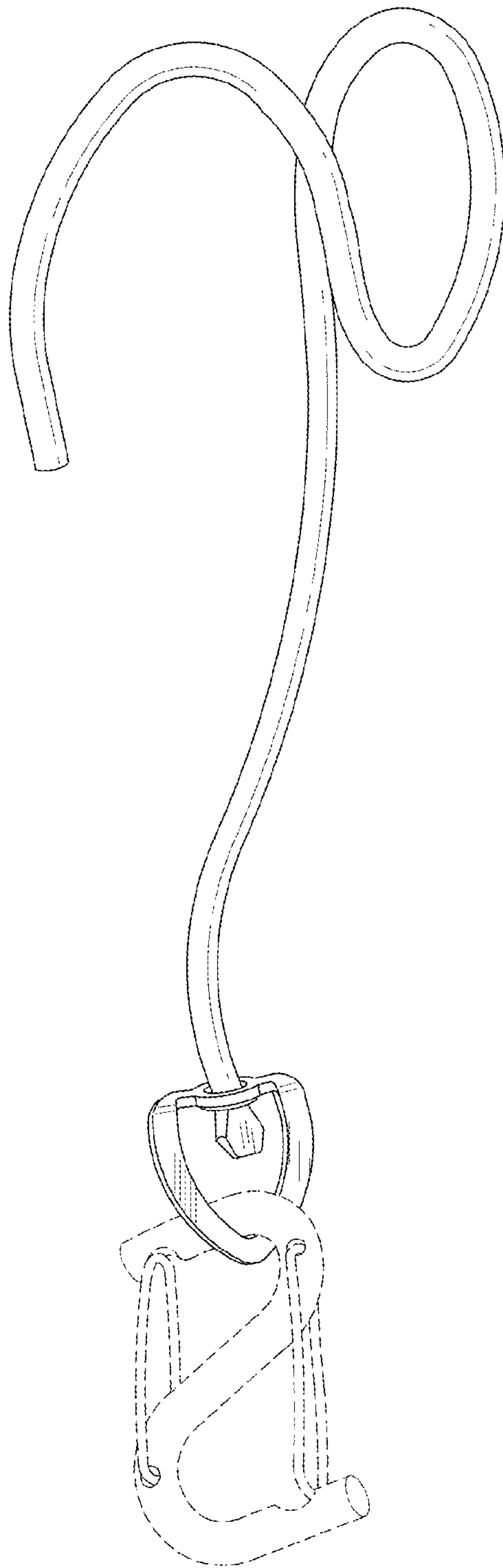

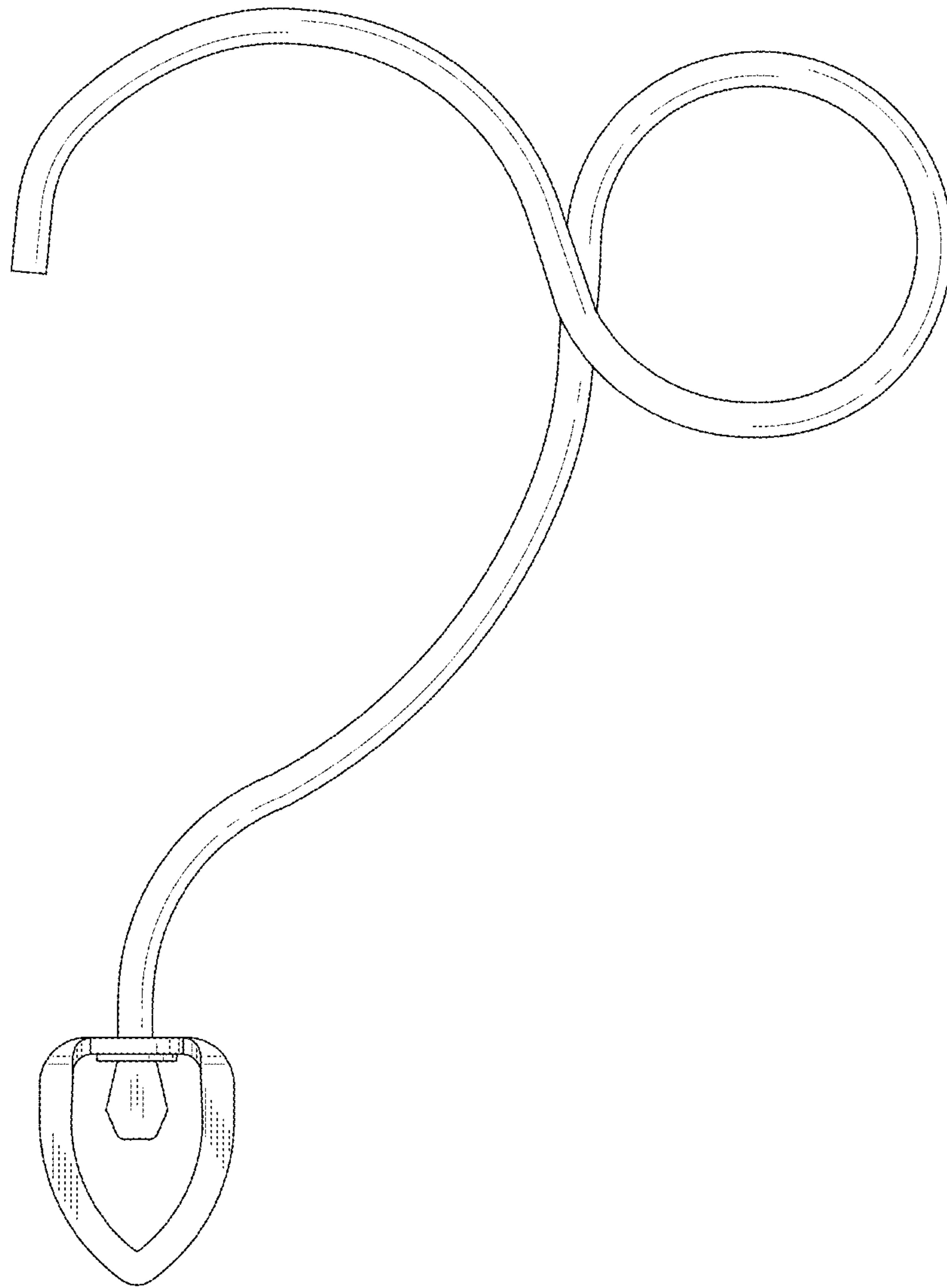

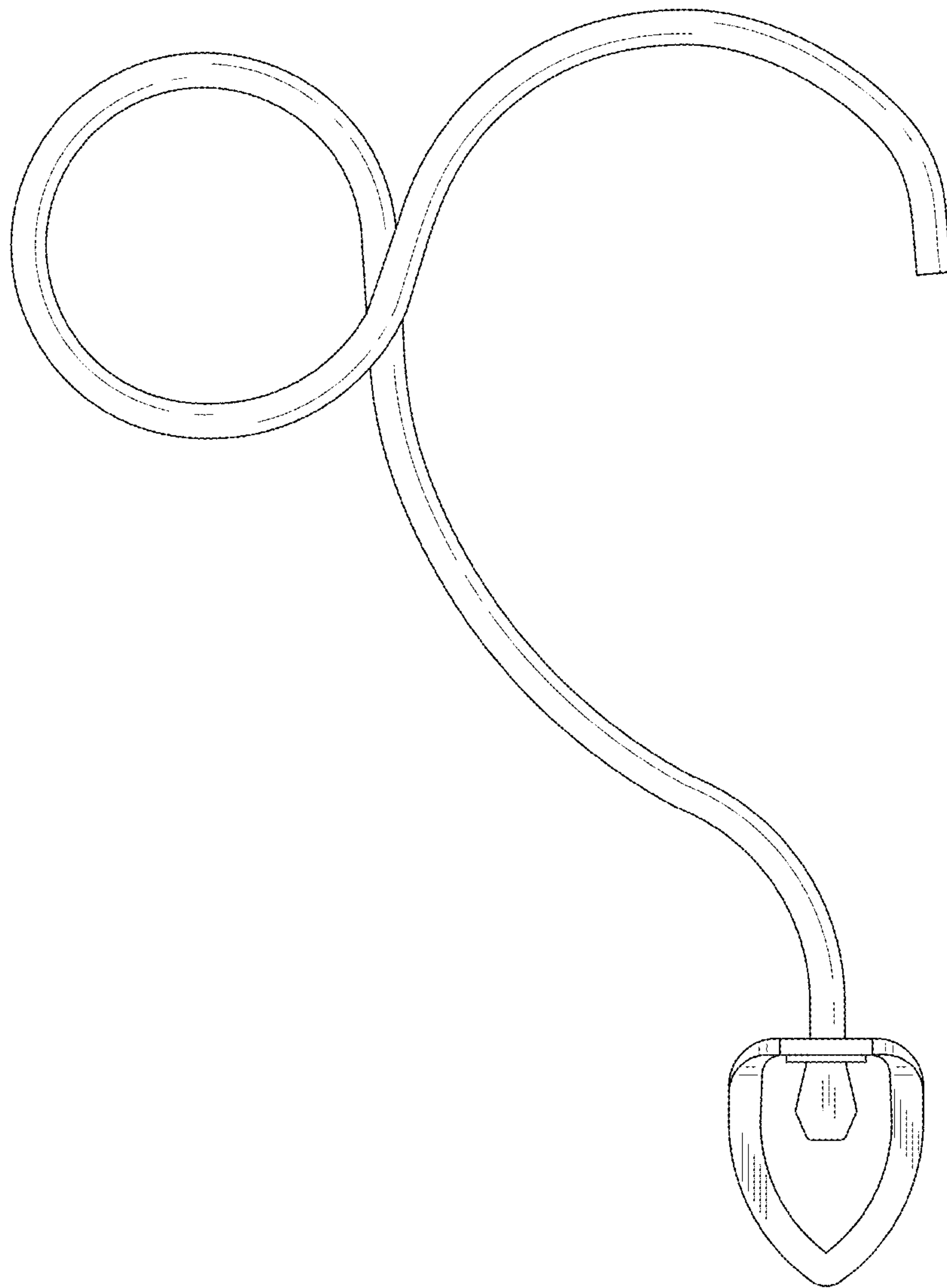

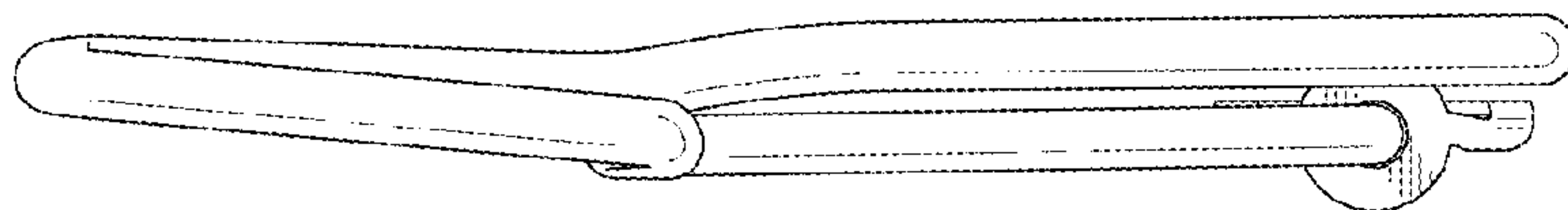

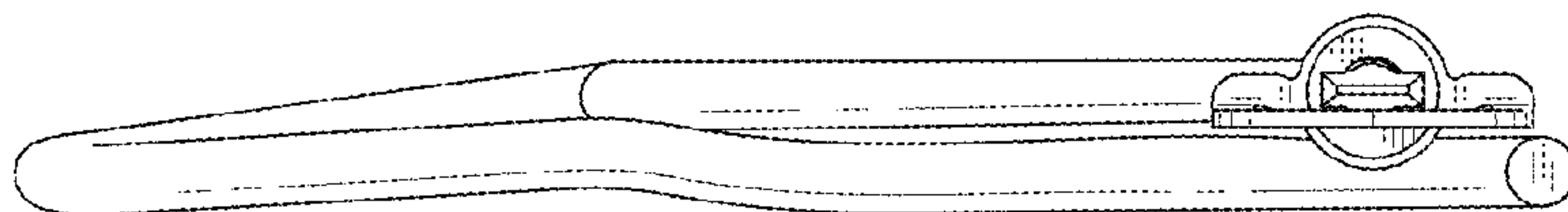

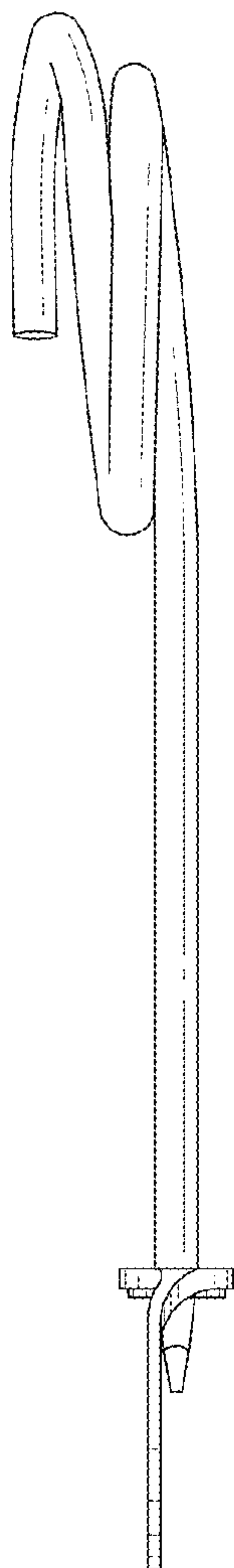

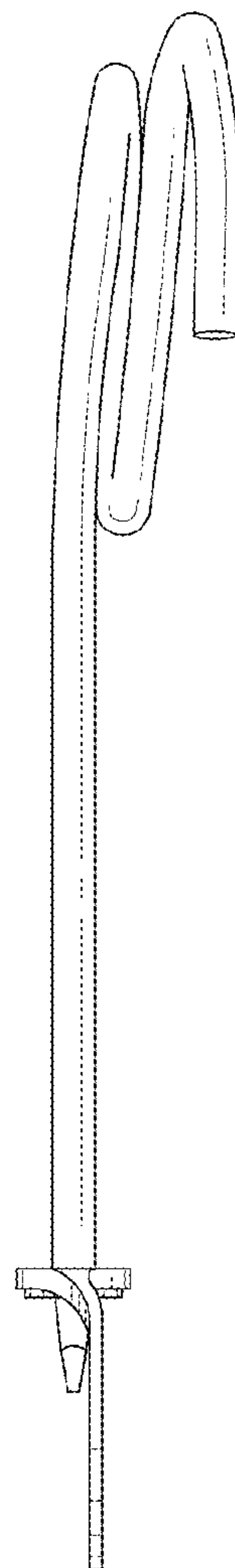
