FIG. 5 is a left side view showing the design;

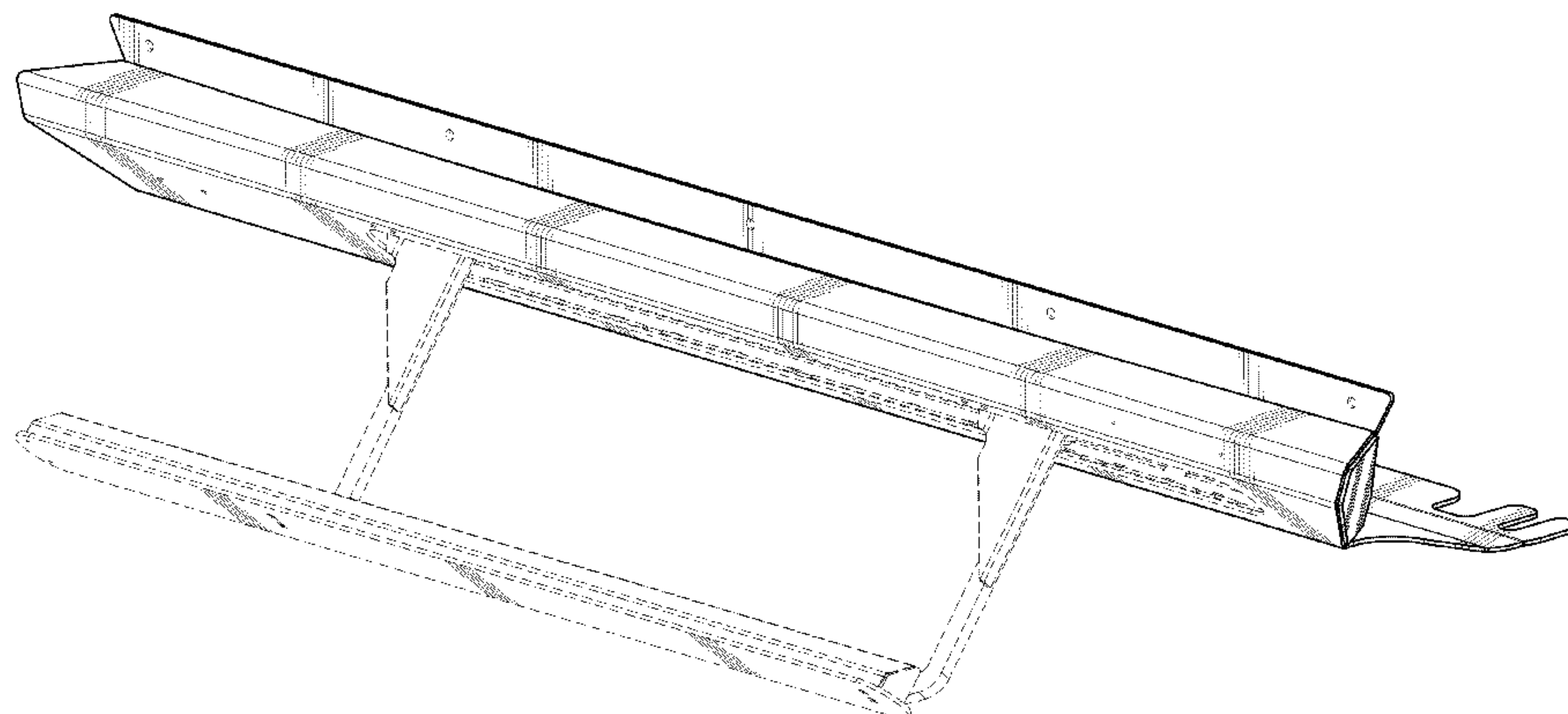
FIG. 6 is a top view showing the design;

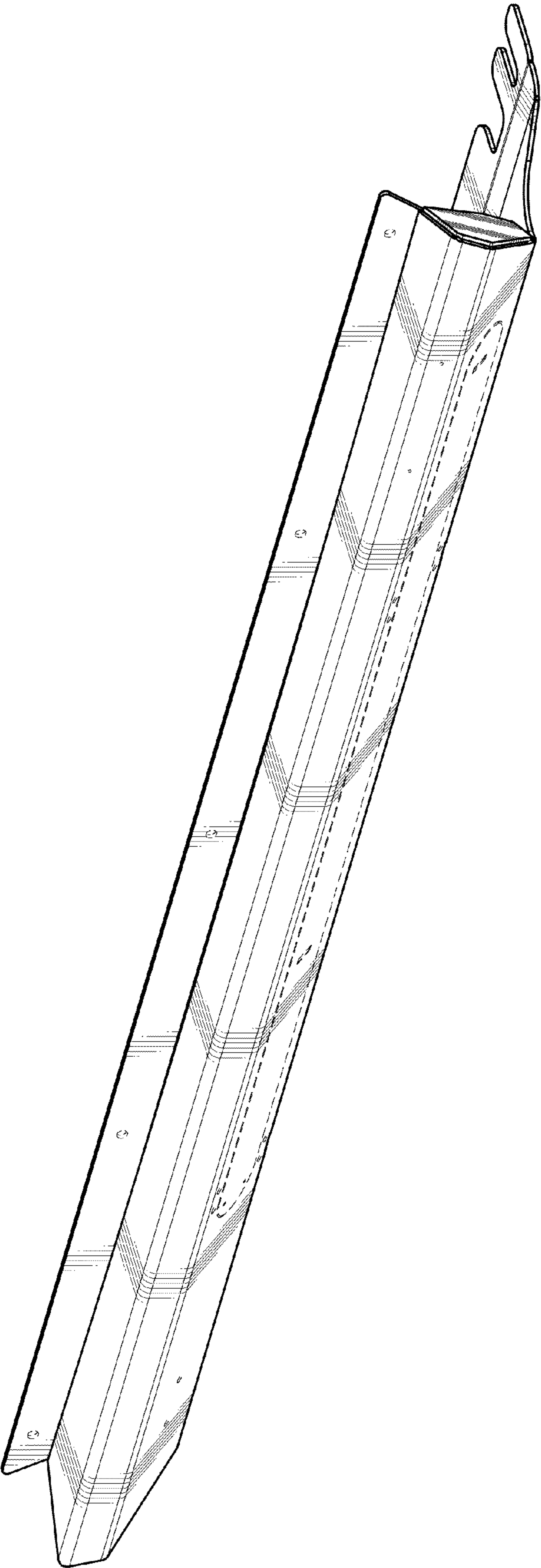

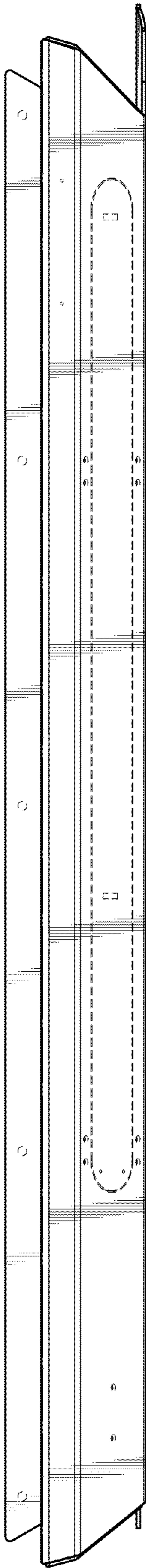

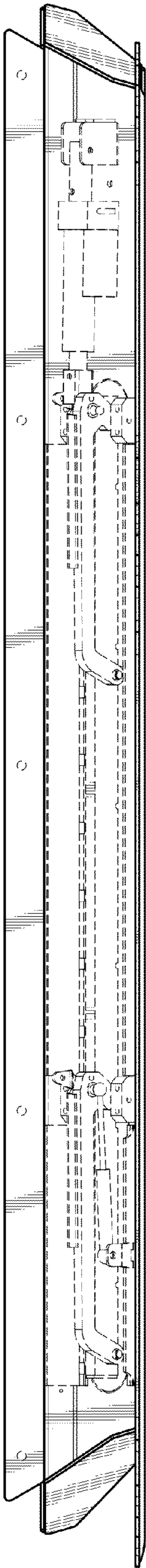

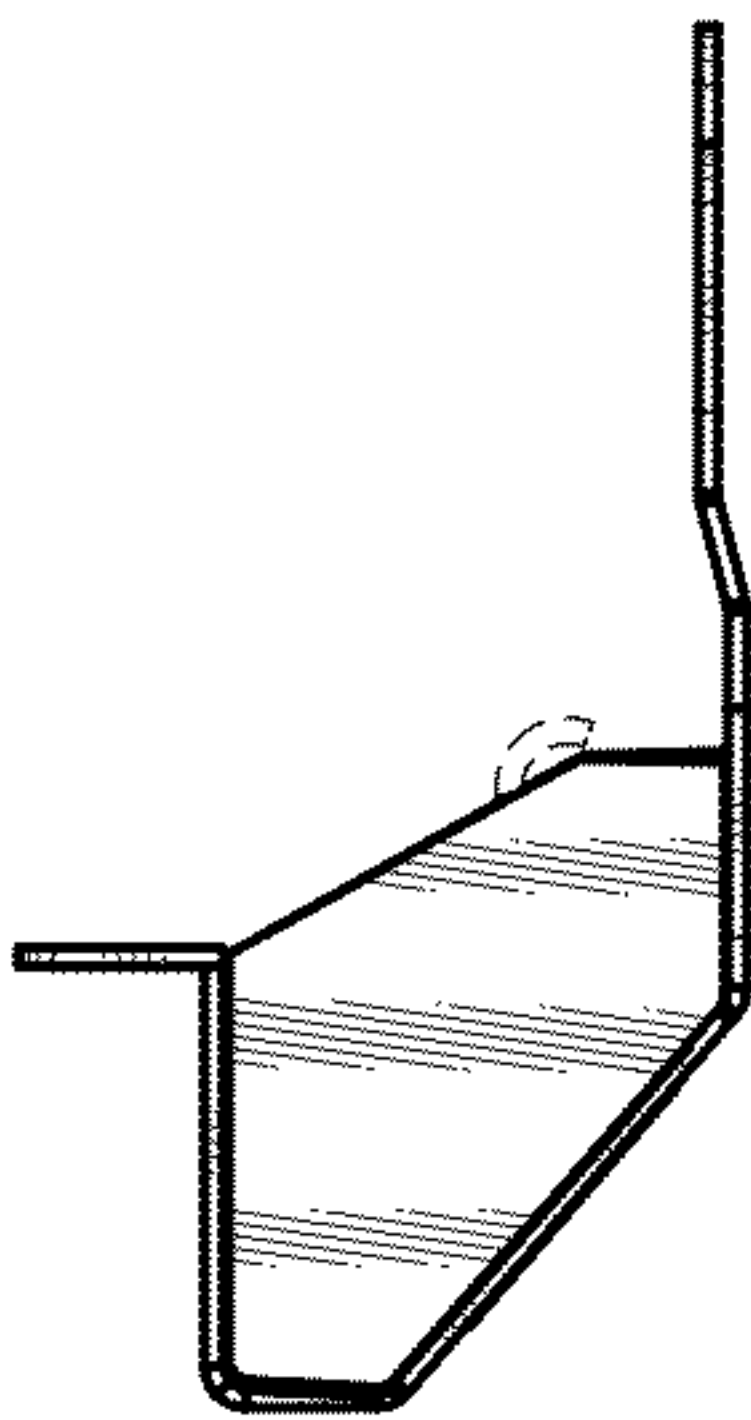

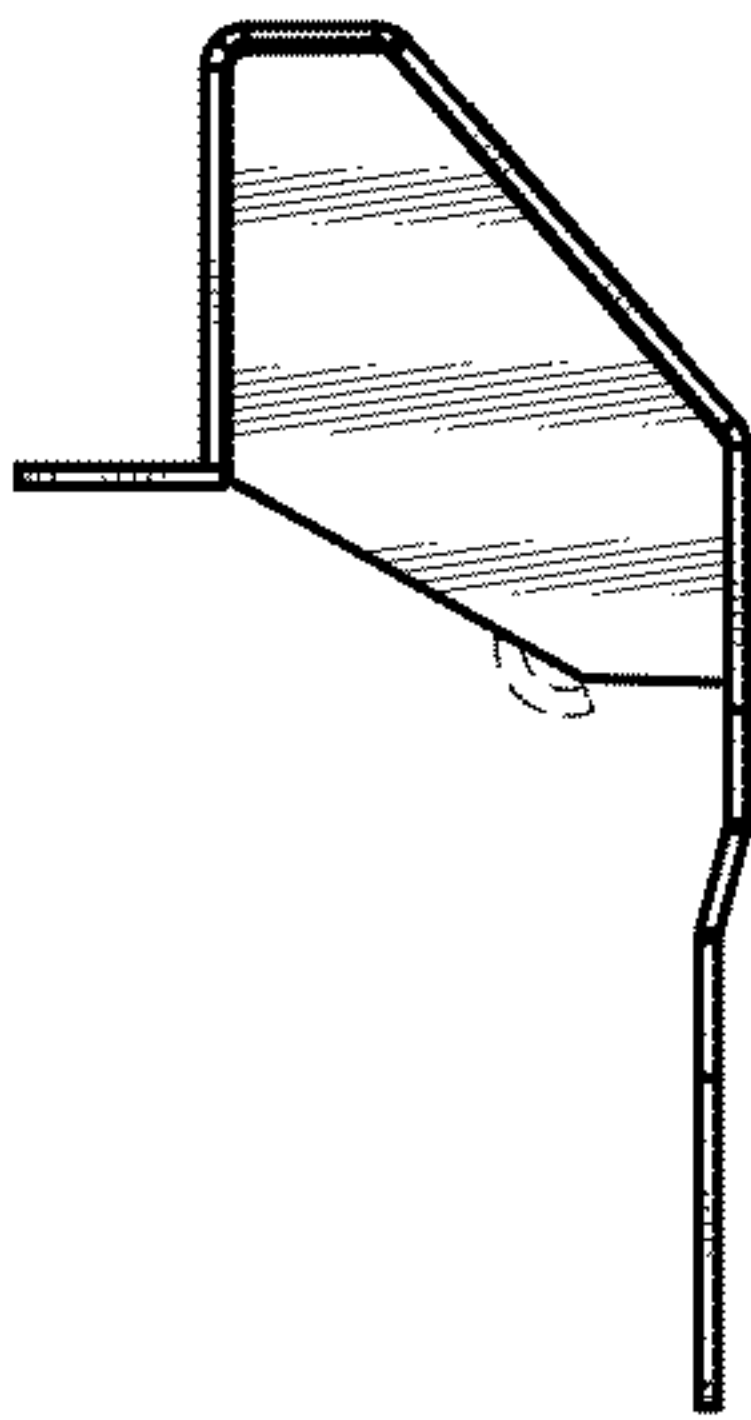

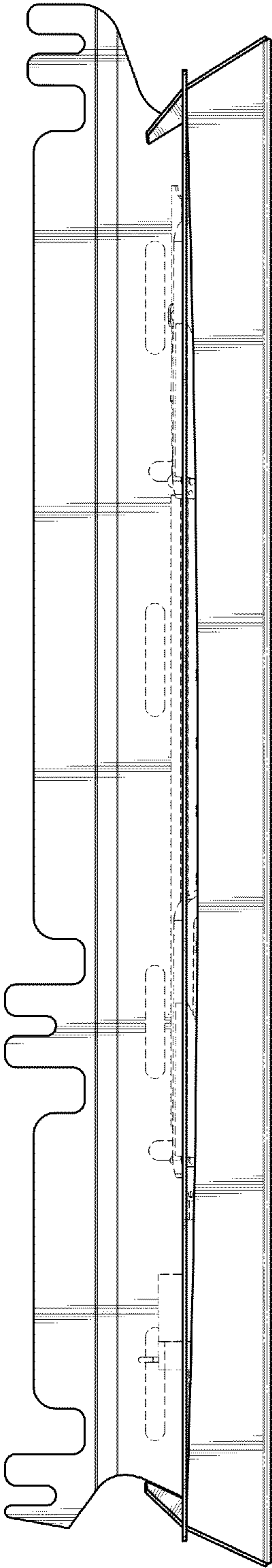

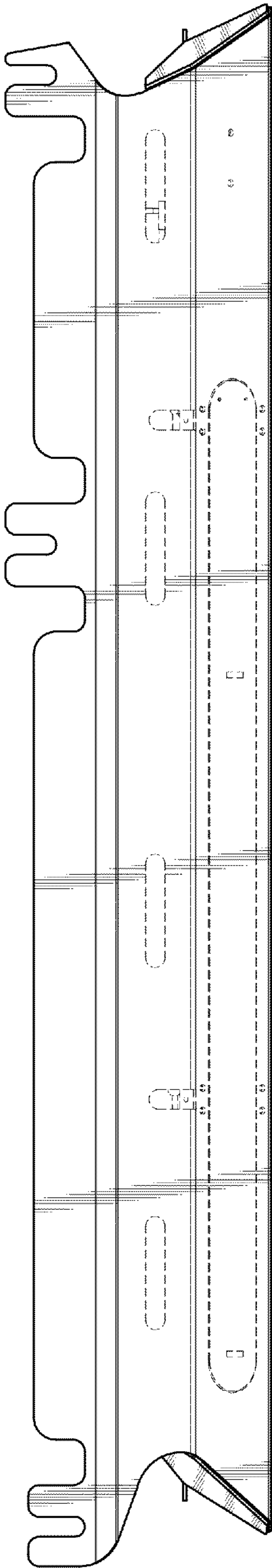

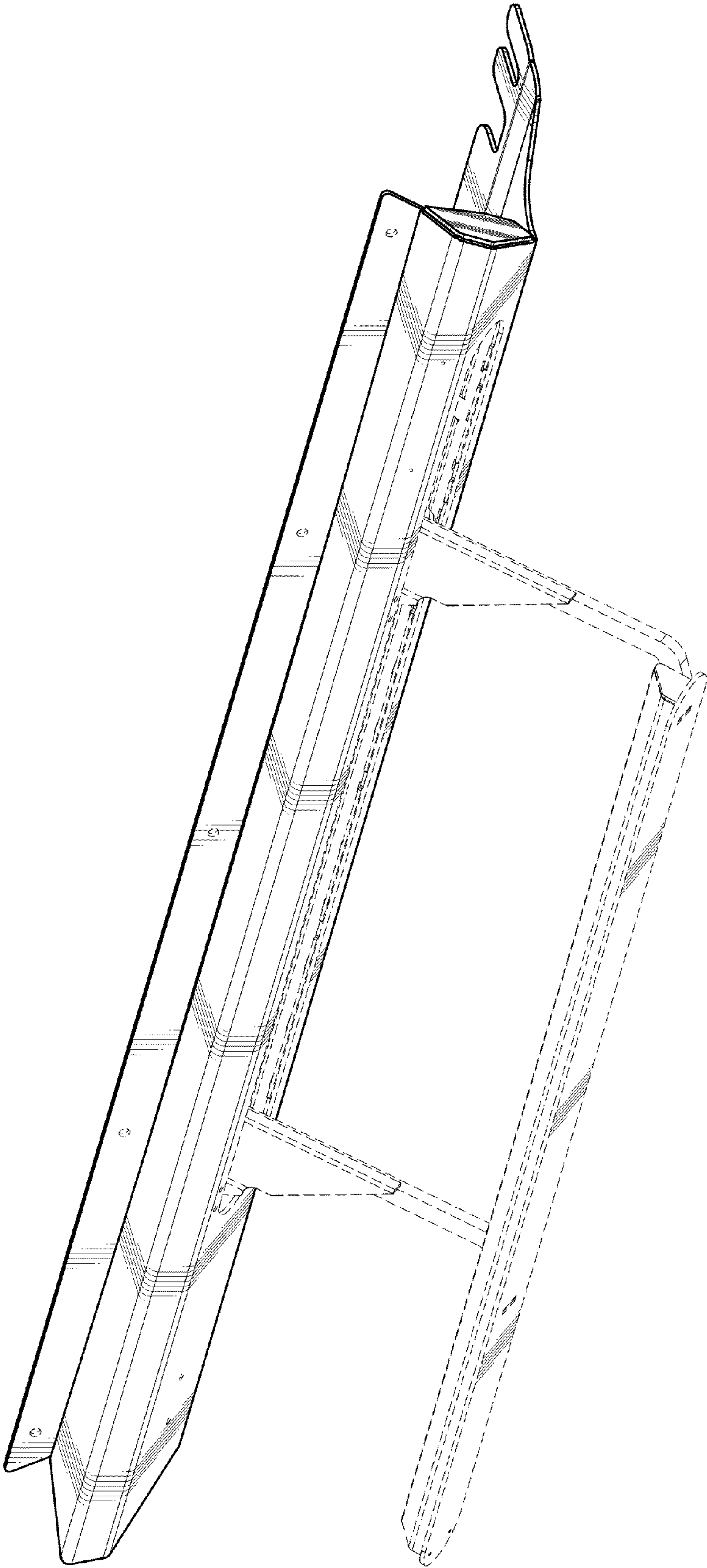
