FIG. 9 is an environmental elevation view of the stackable toy block in a stacked condition;

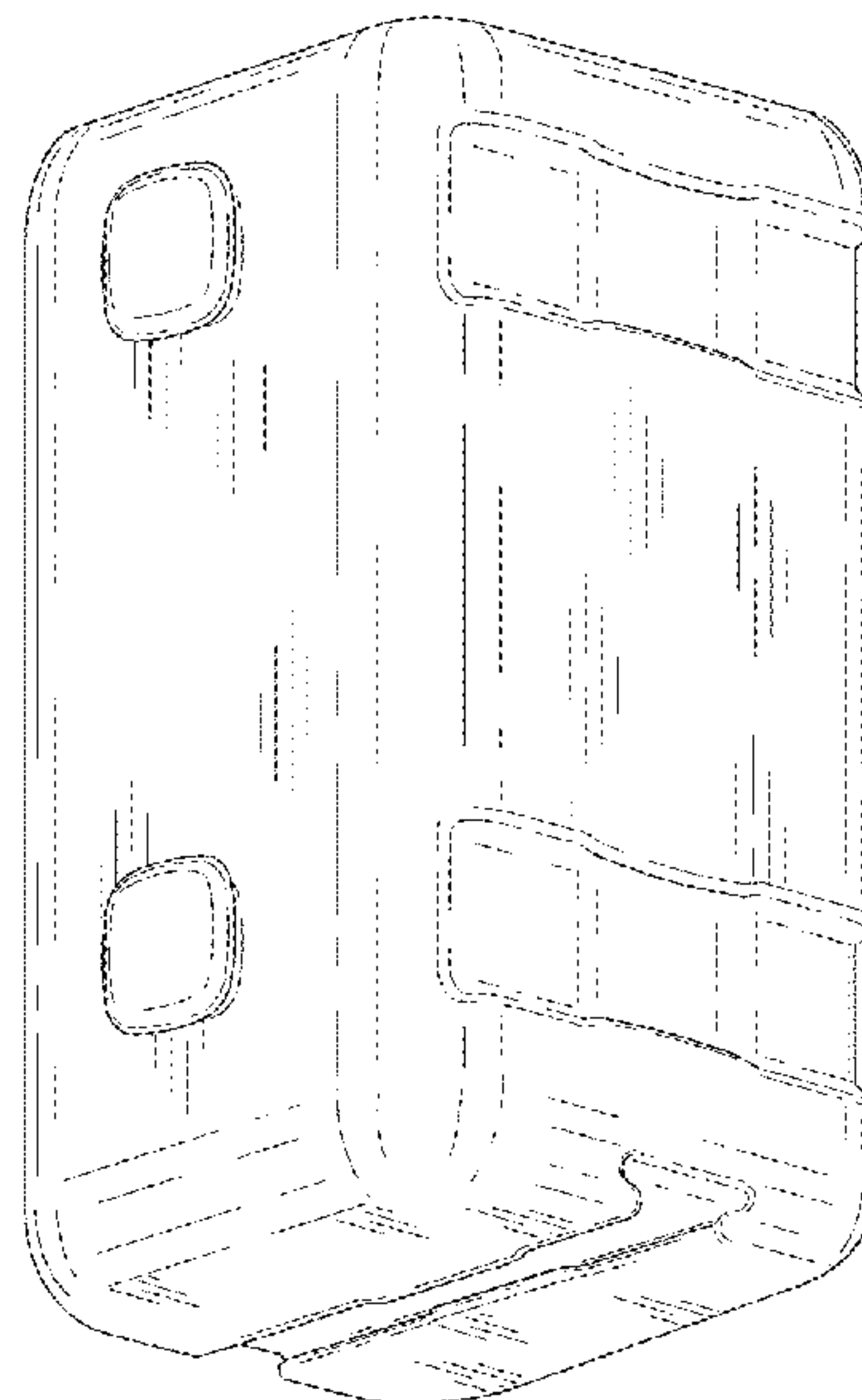
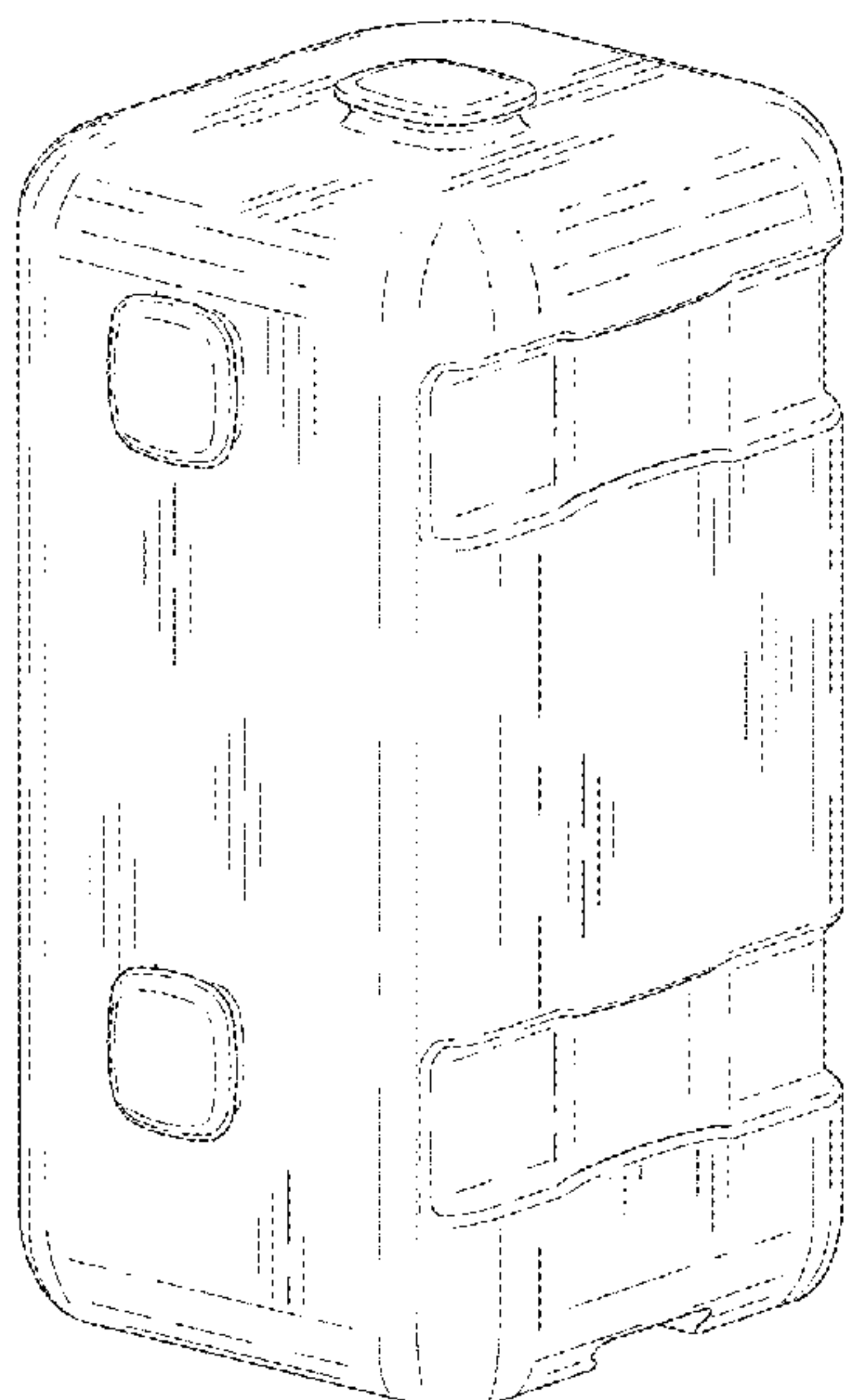
FIG. 10 is an environmental top perspective view of the stackable toy block in a stacked condition;

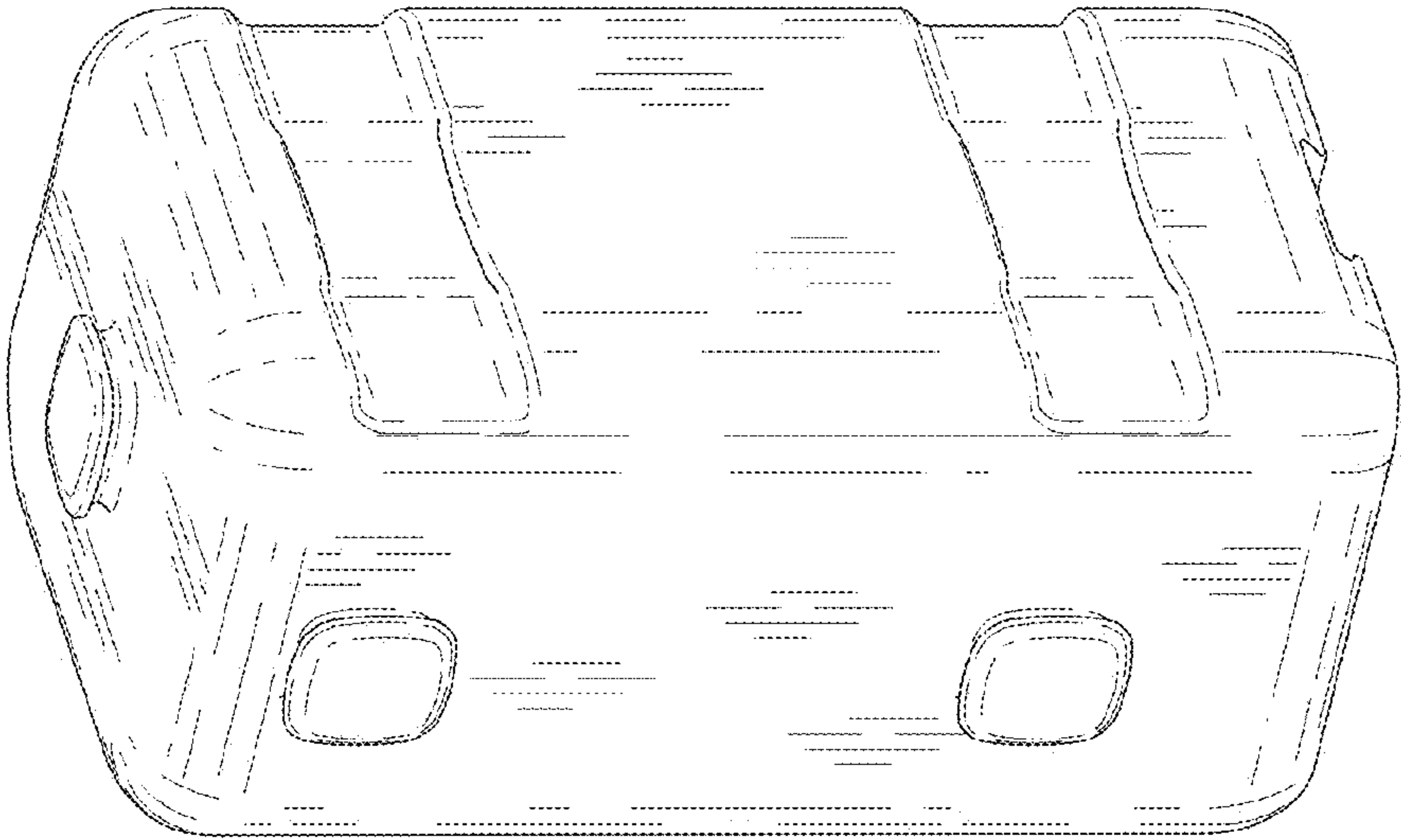

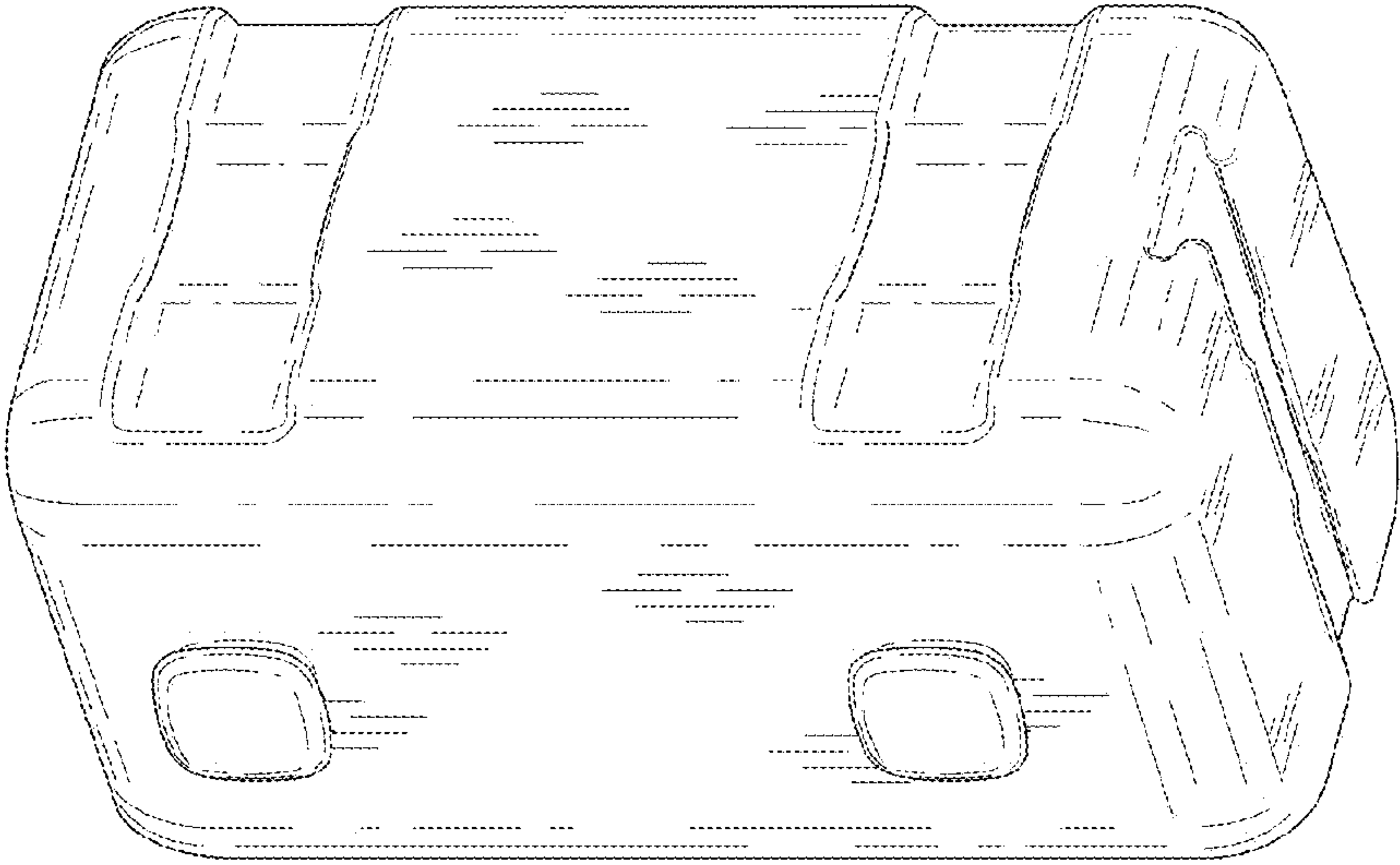

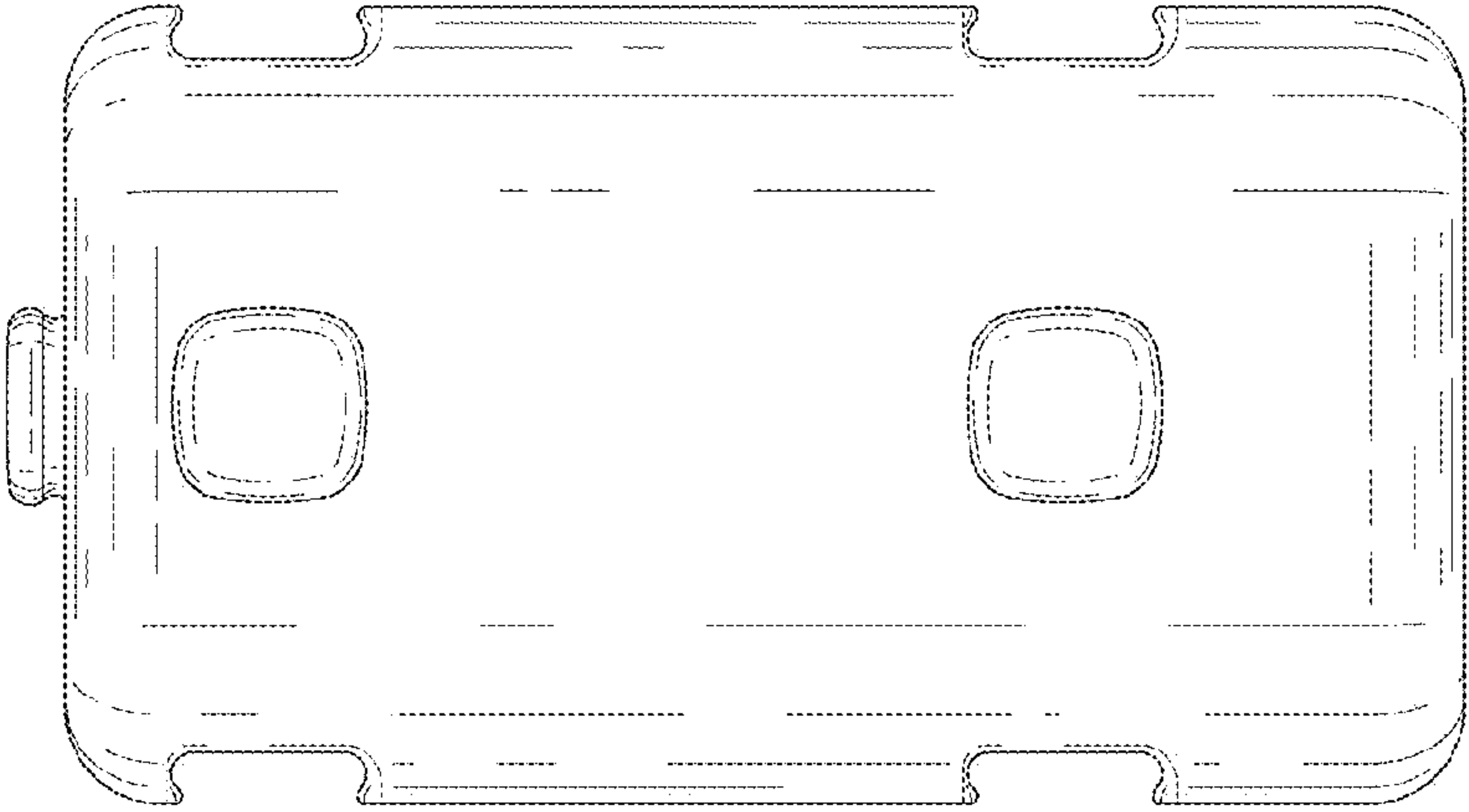

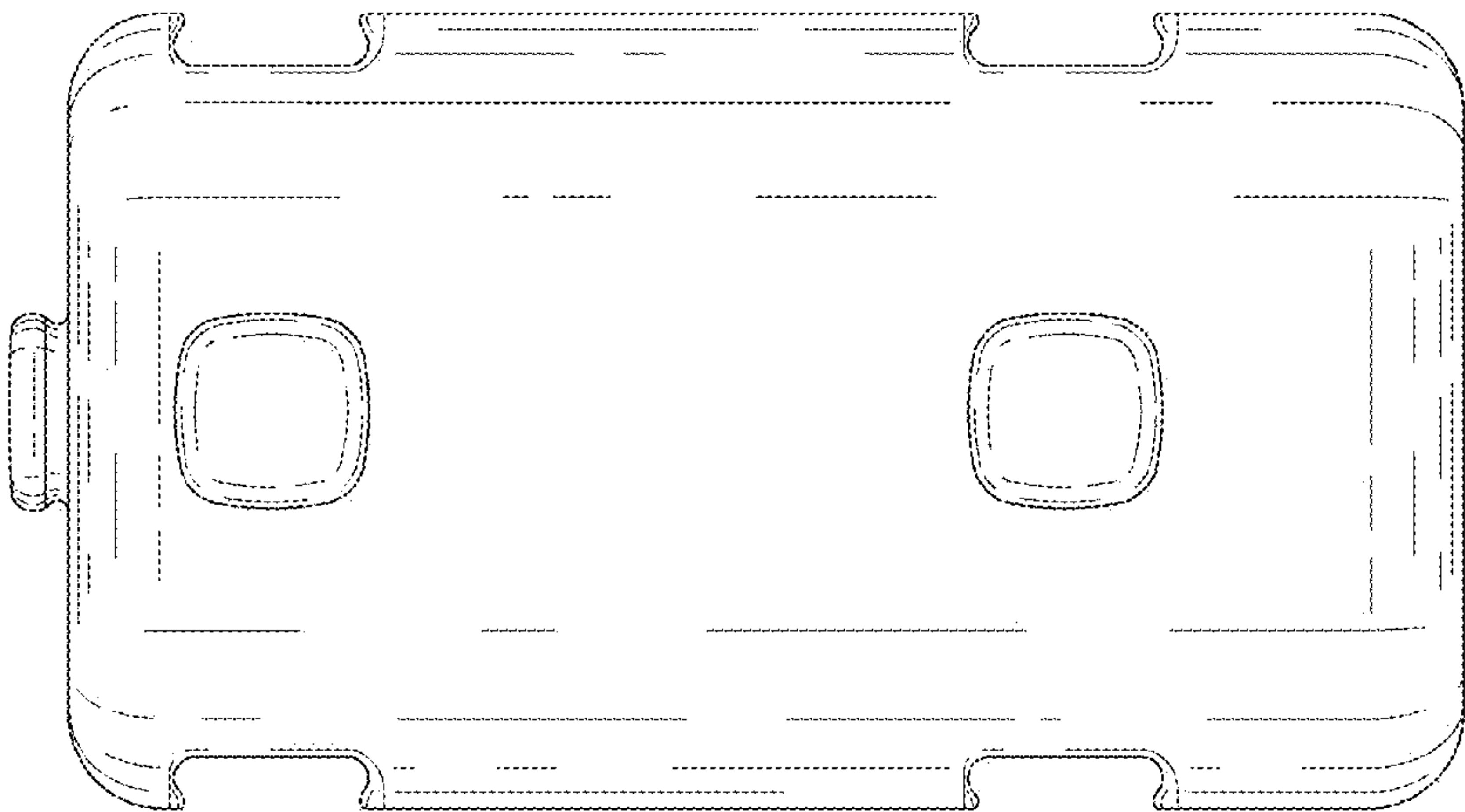

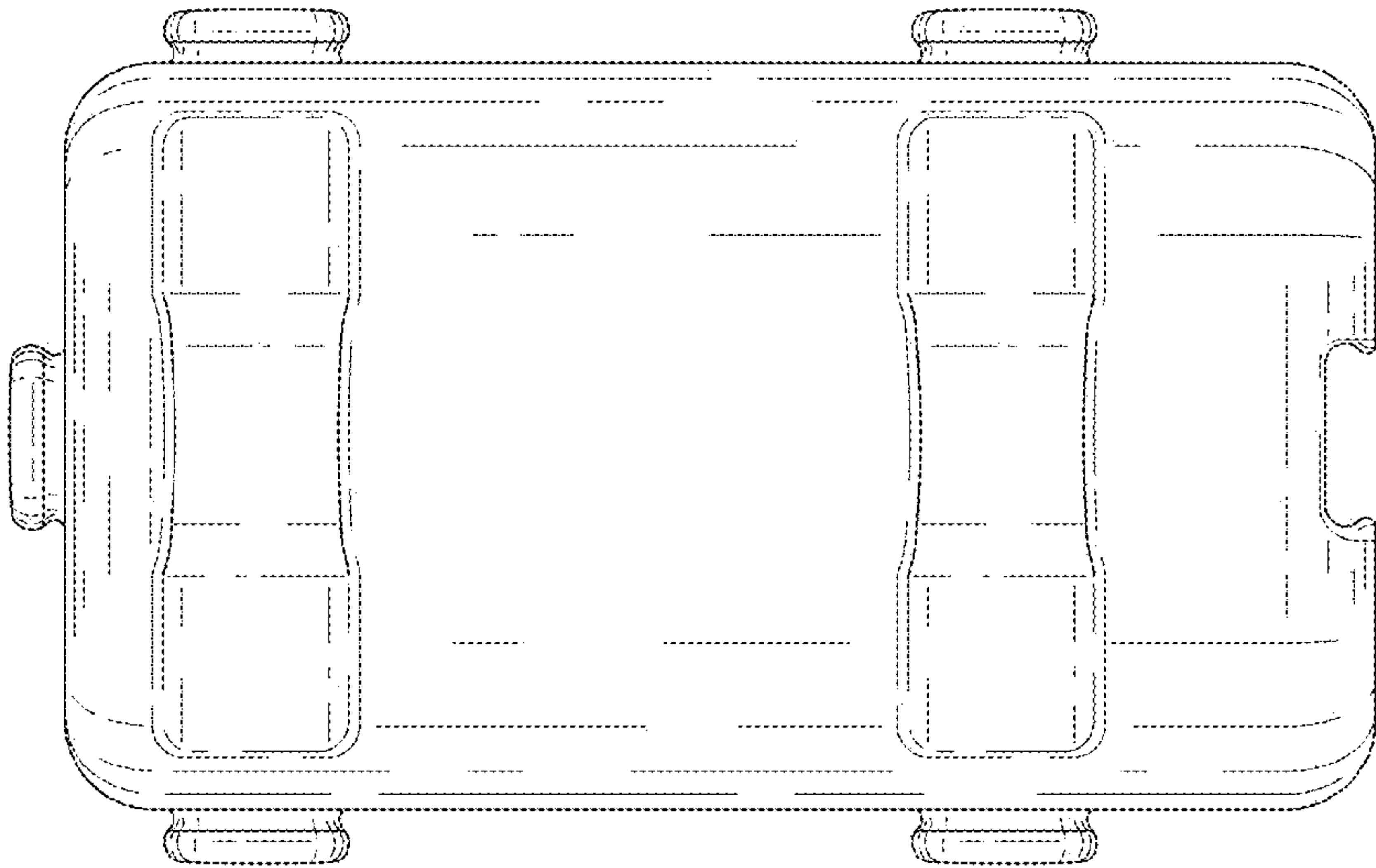

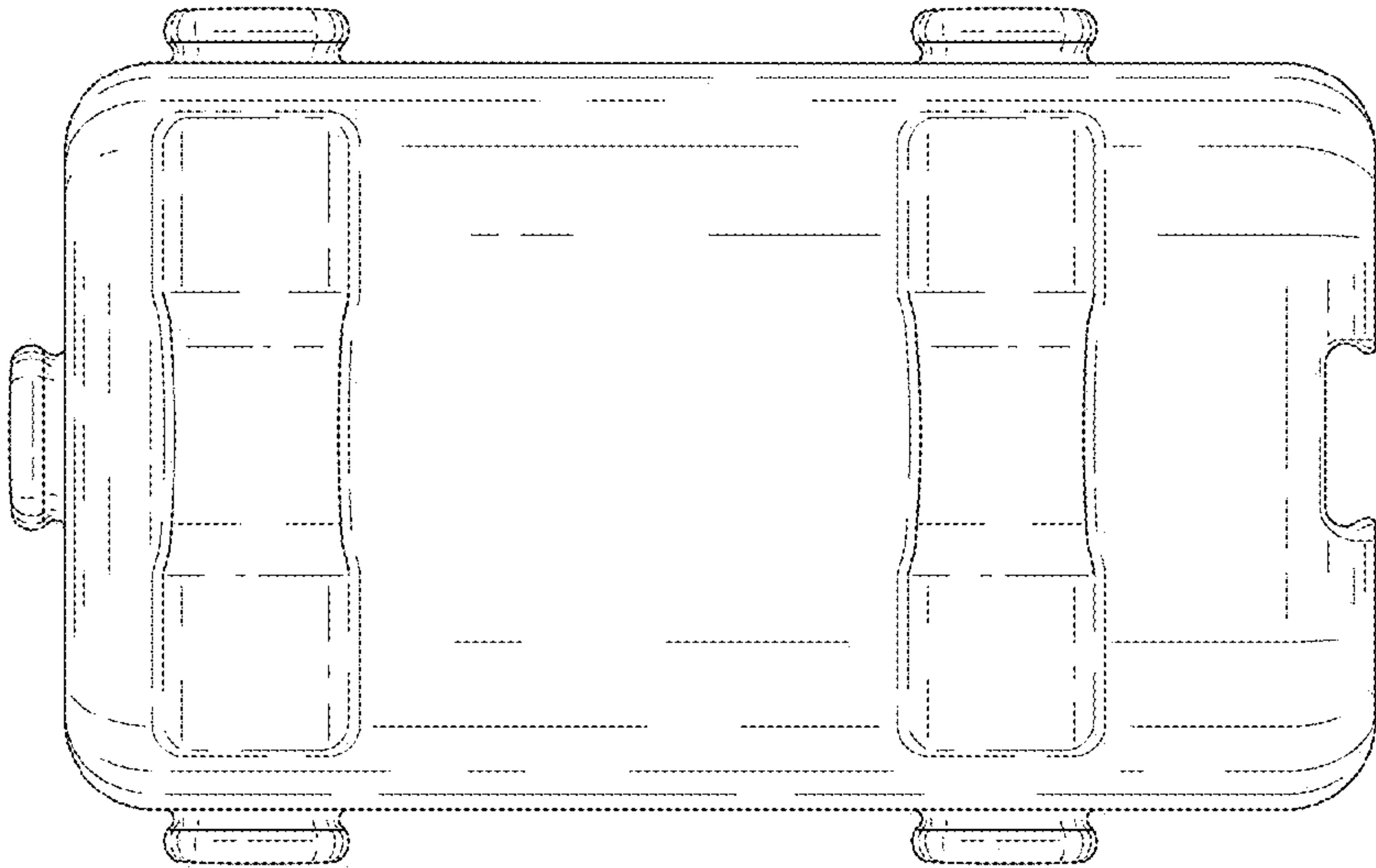

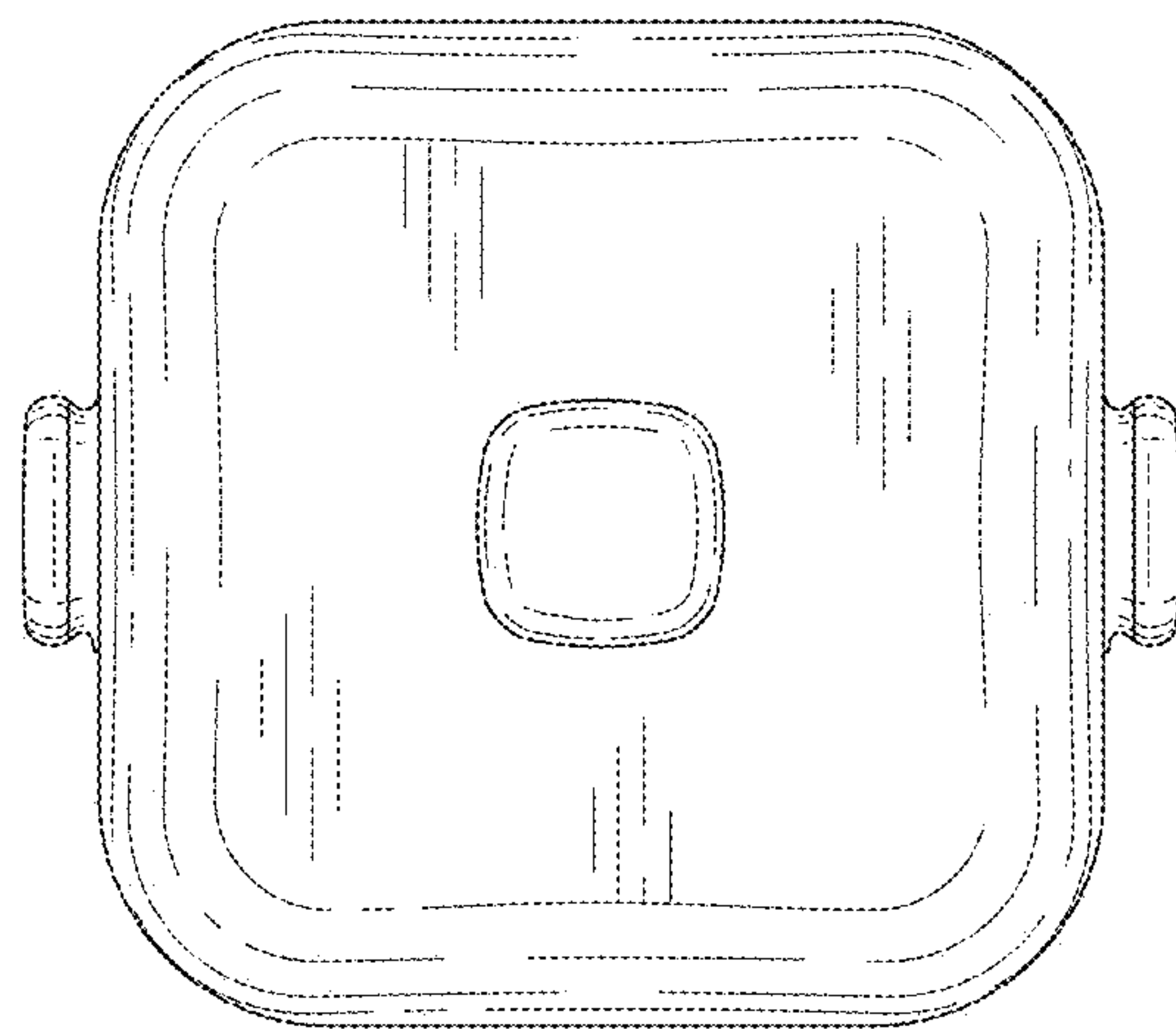

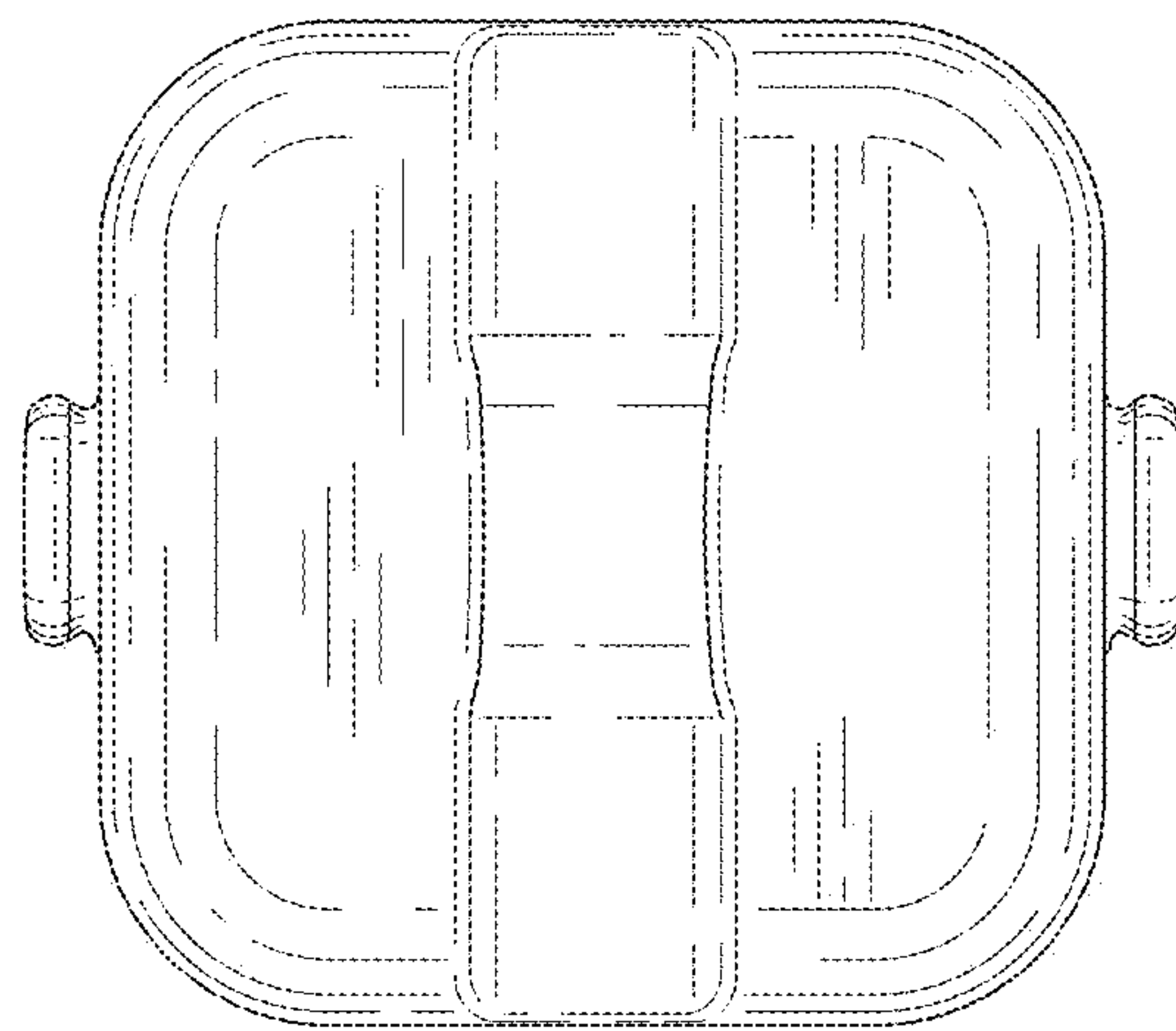

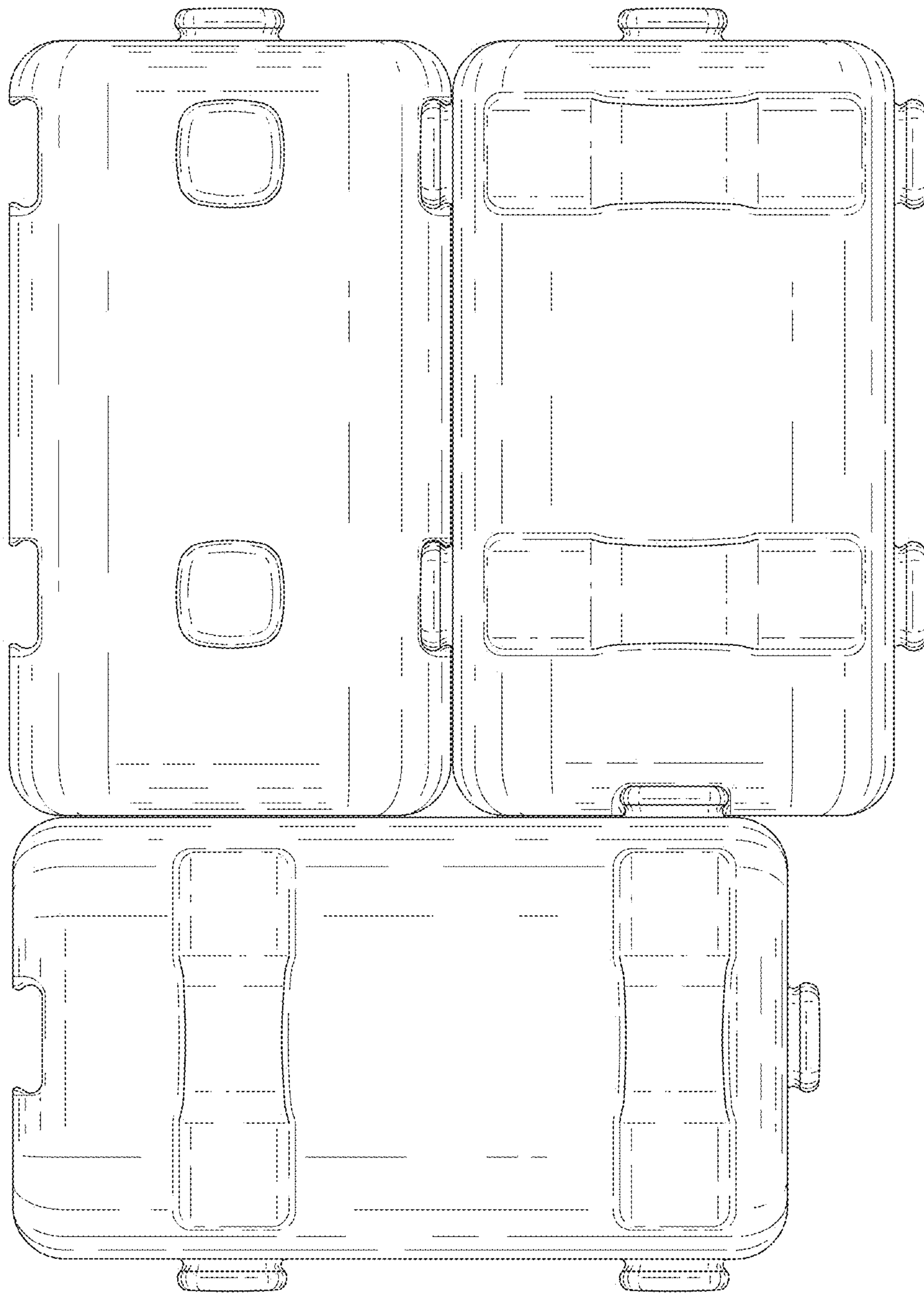

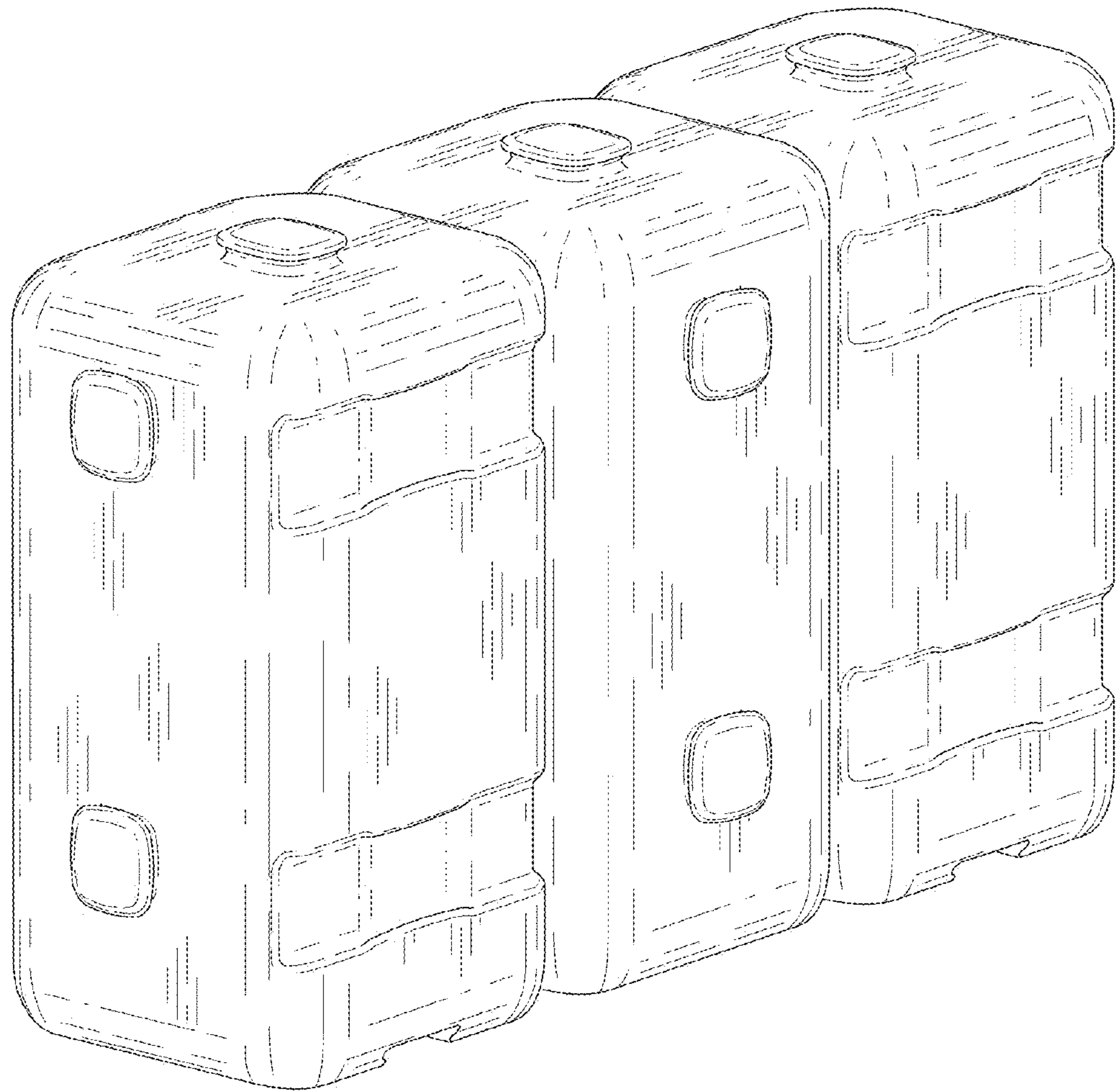

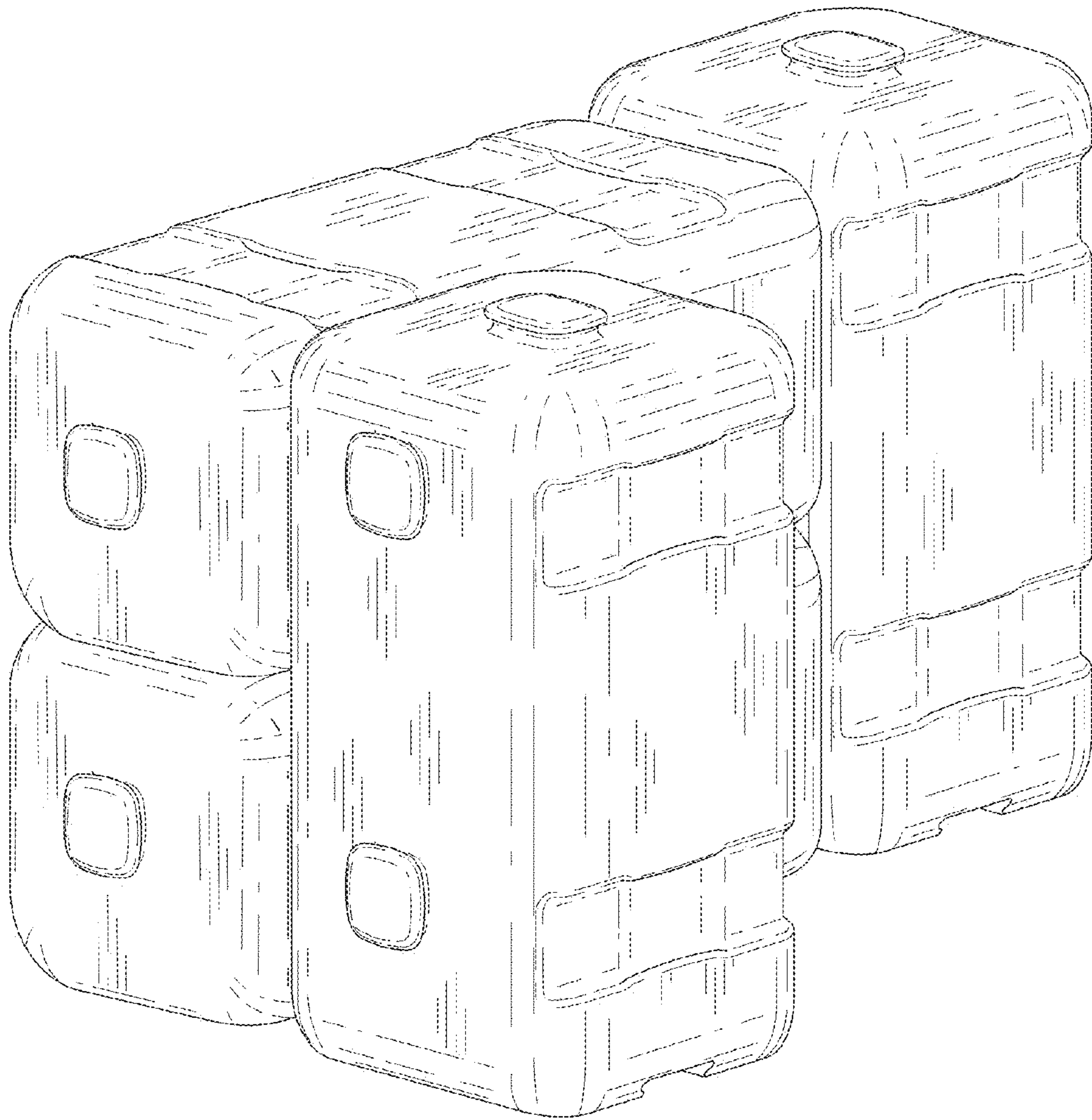

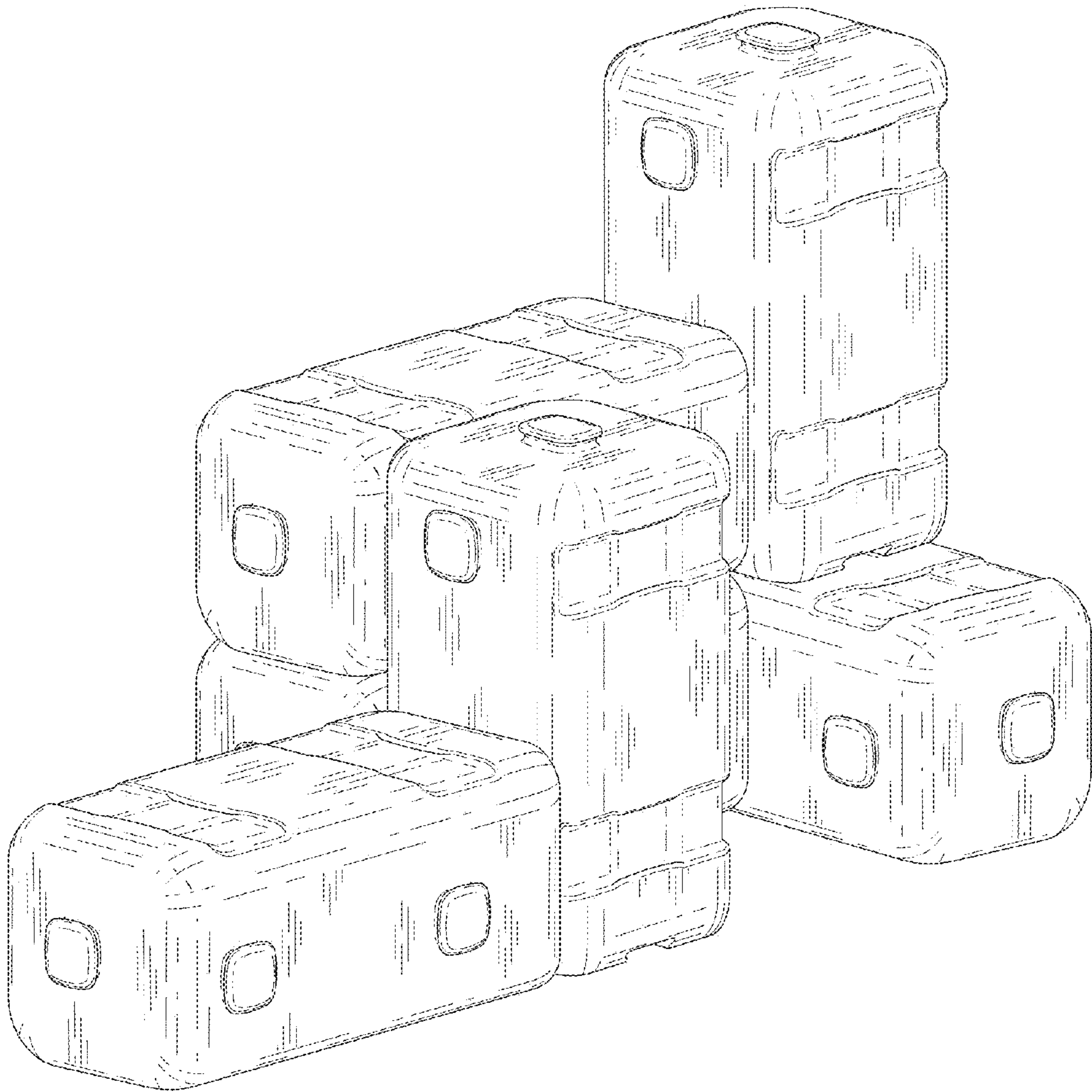
