The ornamental design for a tool for rotation, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a tool for rotation showing our design;

FIG. 2 is another rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front perspective view thereof taken from the opposite end;

FIG. 5 is a front view of the tool for rotation of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a right side view of the tool for rotation of FIG. 5, which is a mirror image of the left side view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top view of the tool for rotation of FIG. 6; and,

FIG. 9 is a bottom view of the tool for rotation of FIG. 6.
