(57) **CLAIM**

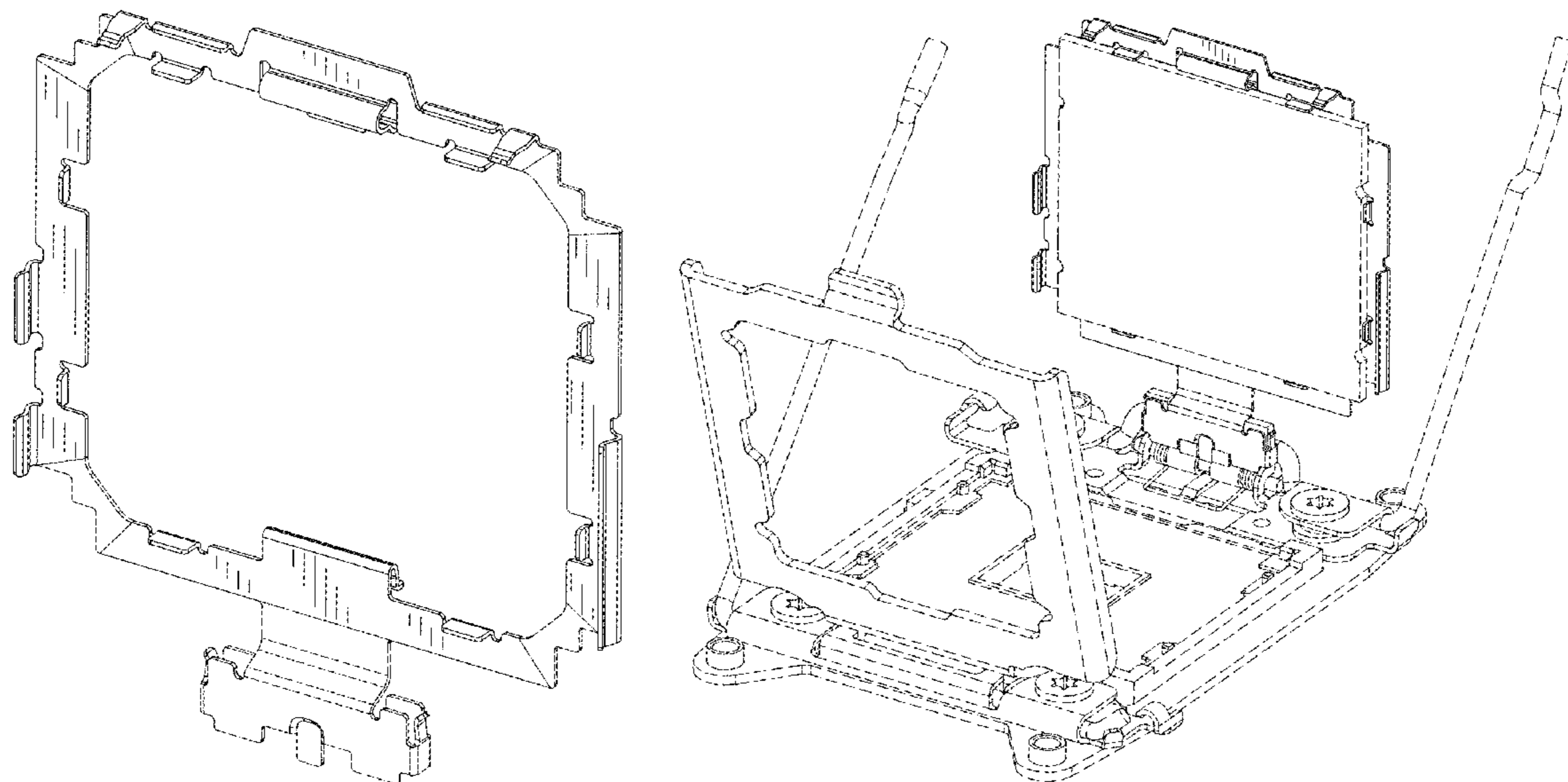
The ornamental design for a CPU carrier assembly, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a CPU carrier showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

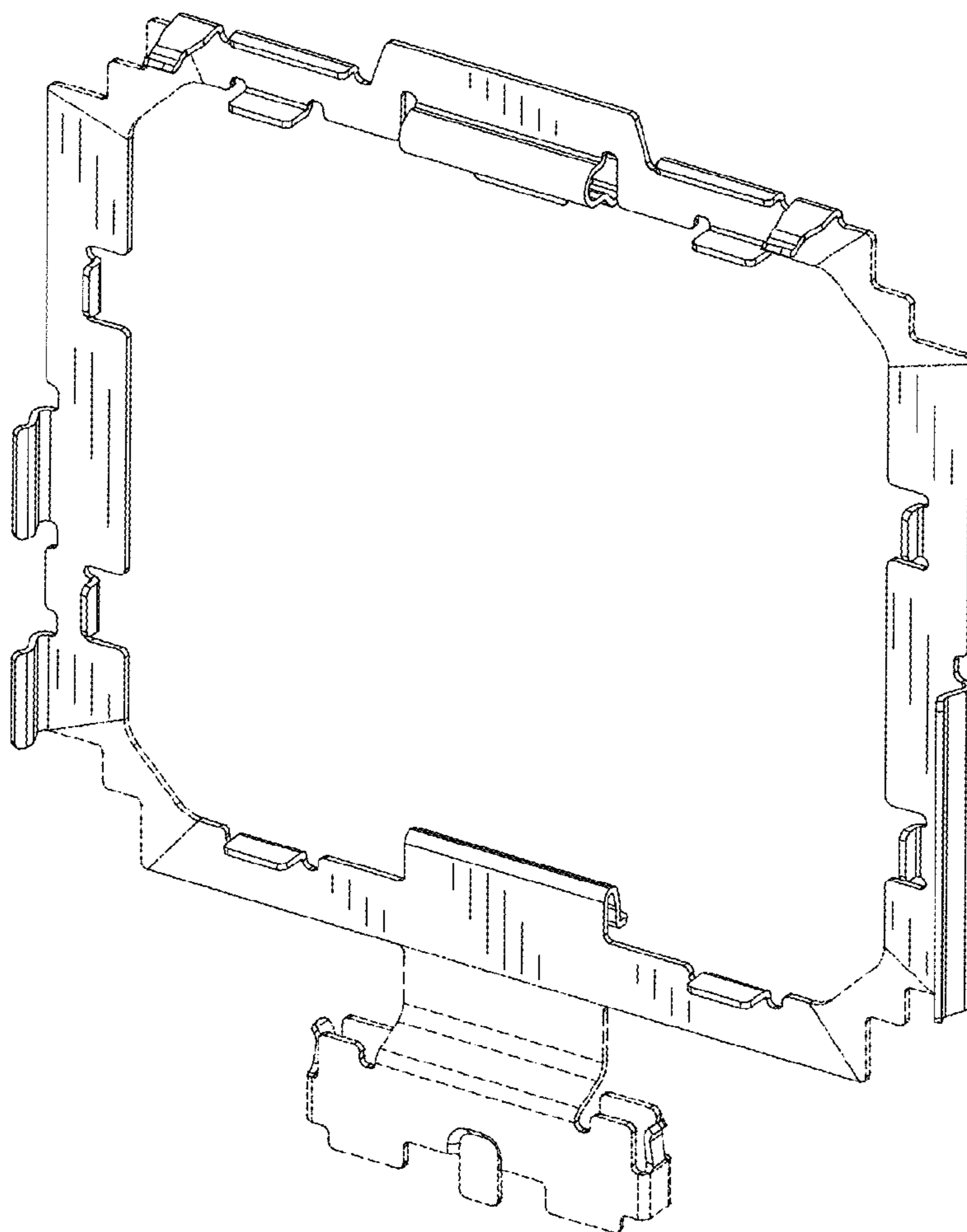

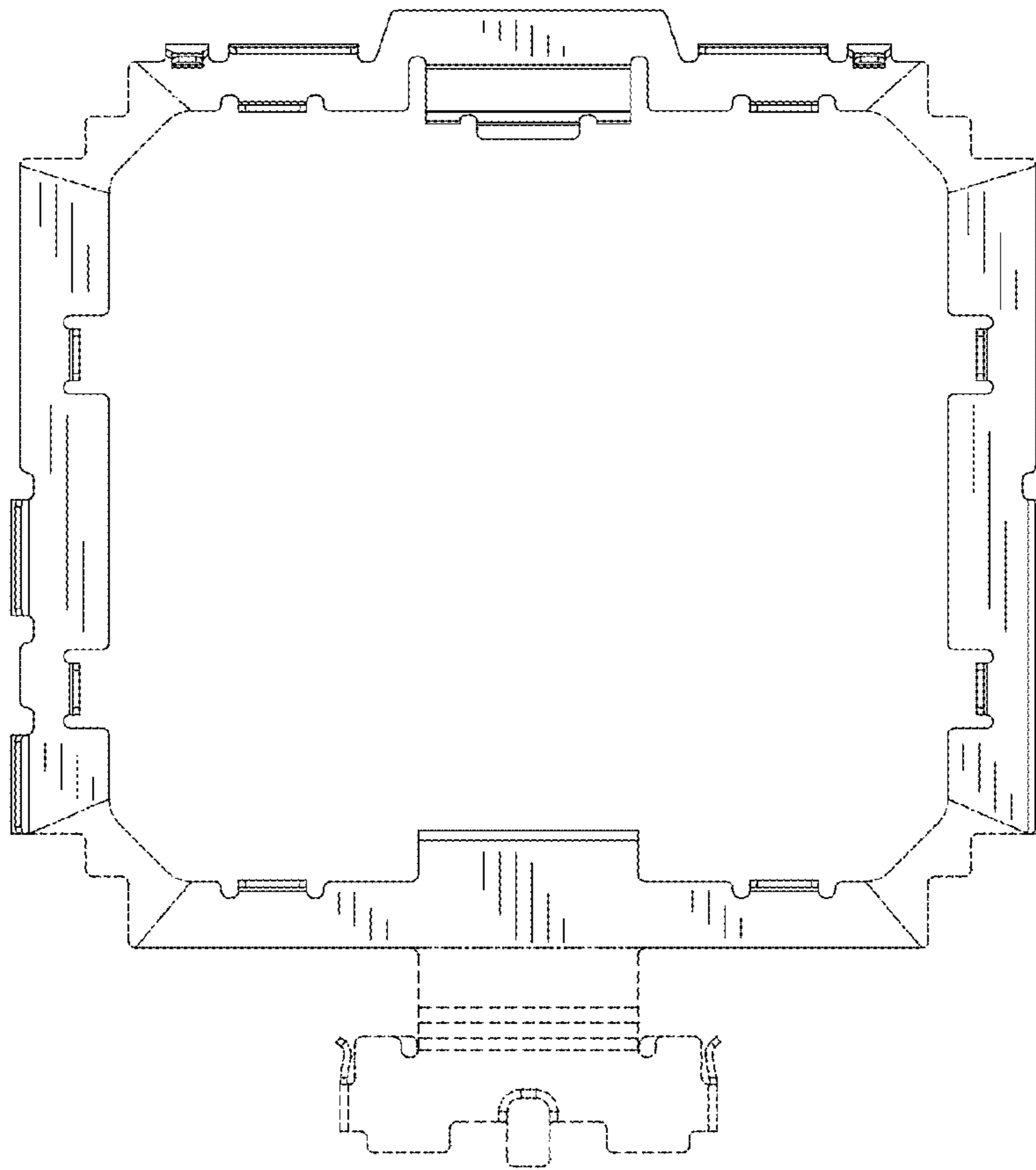

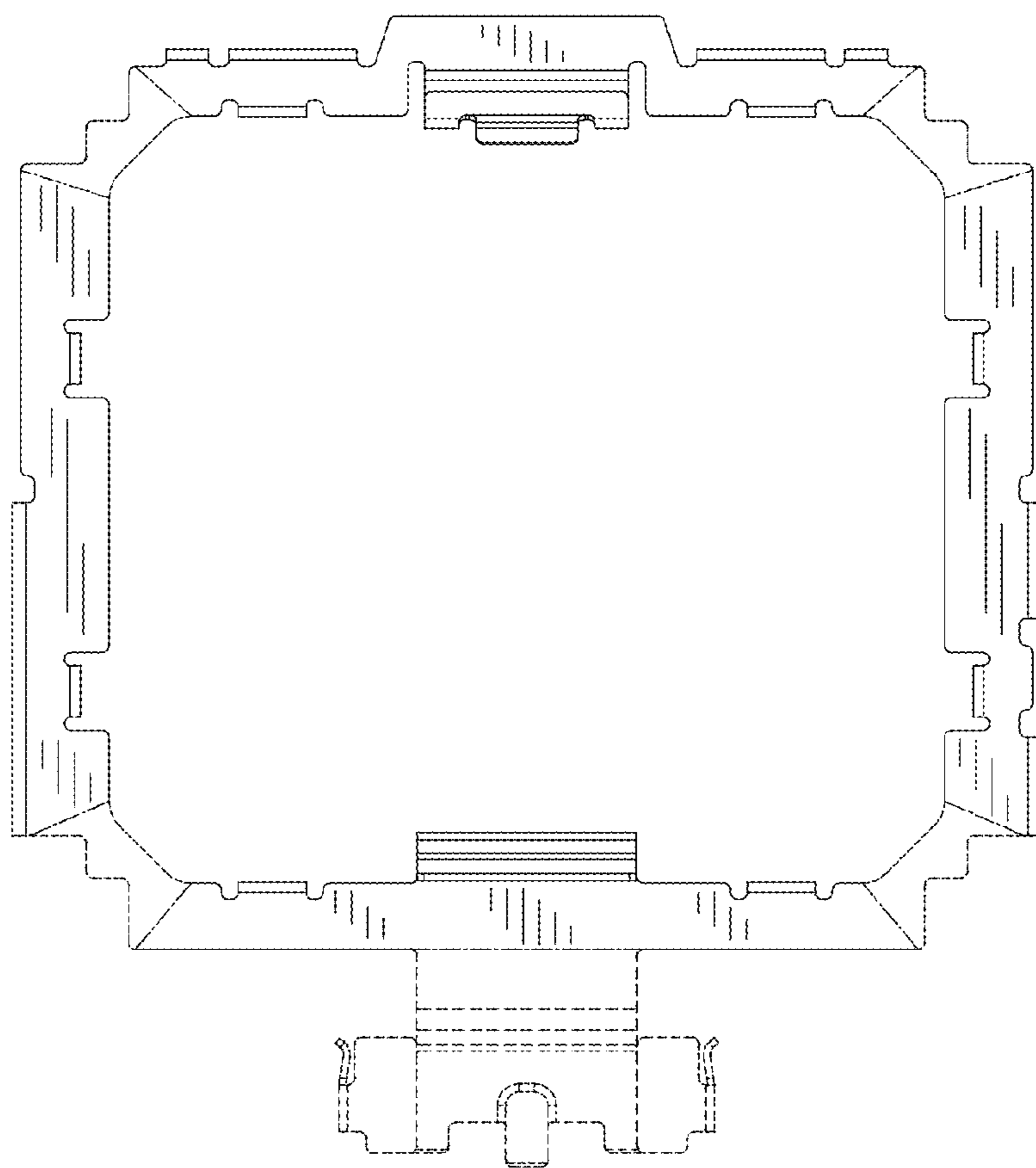

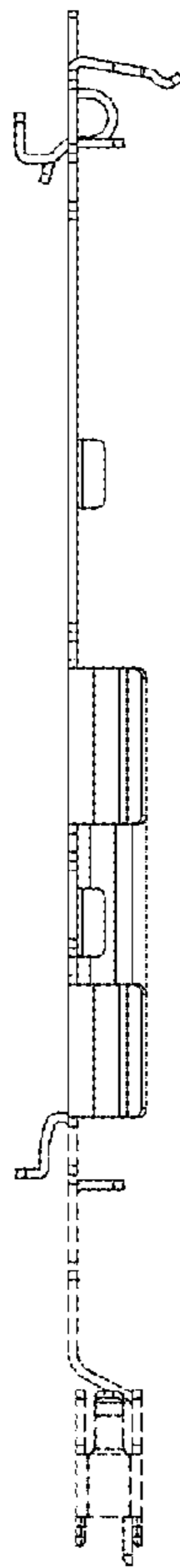

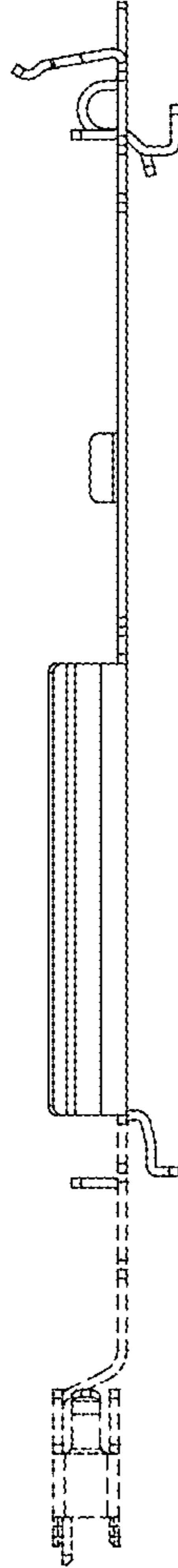

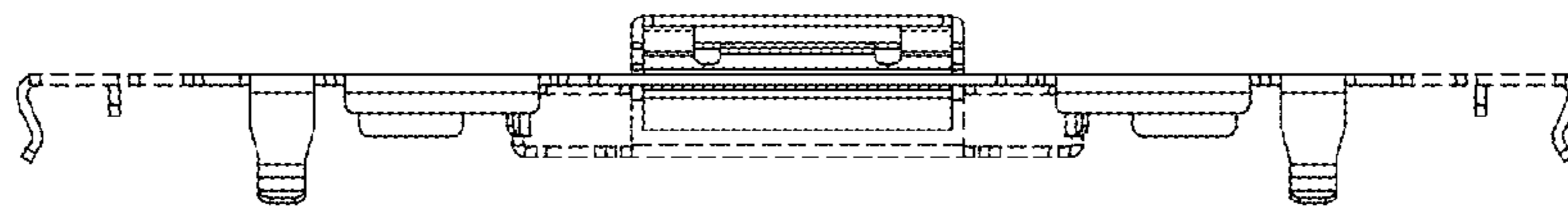

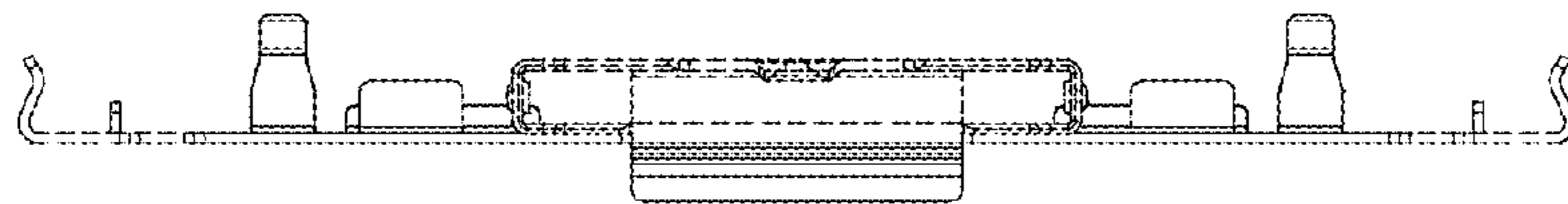

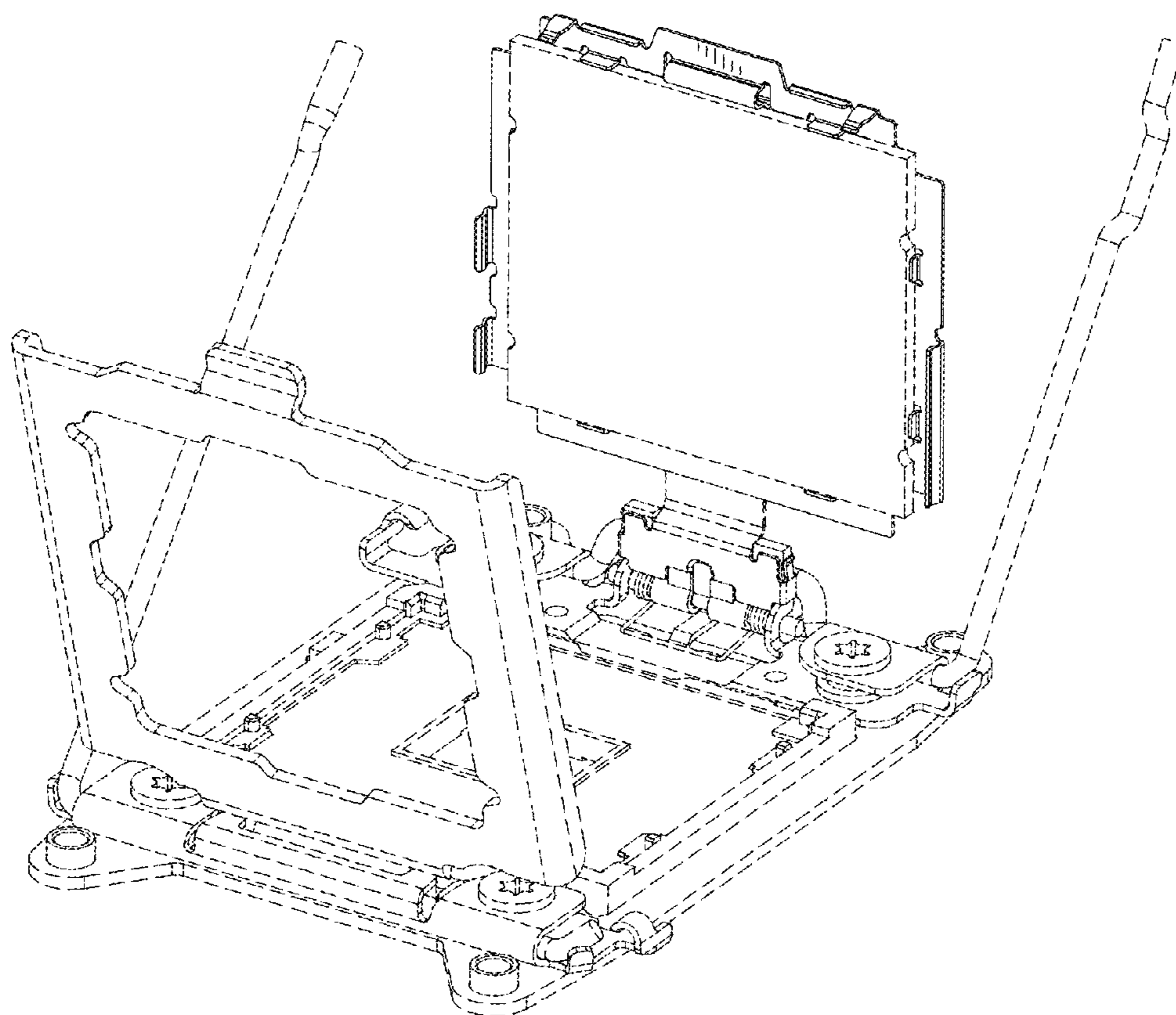
