FIG. 2 is a front view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown herein;

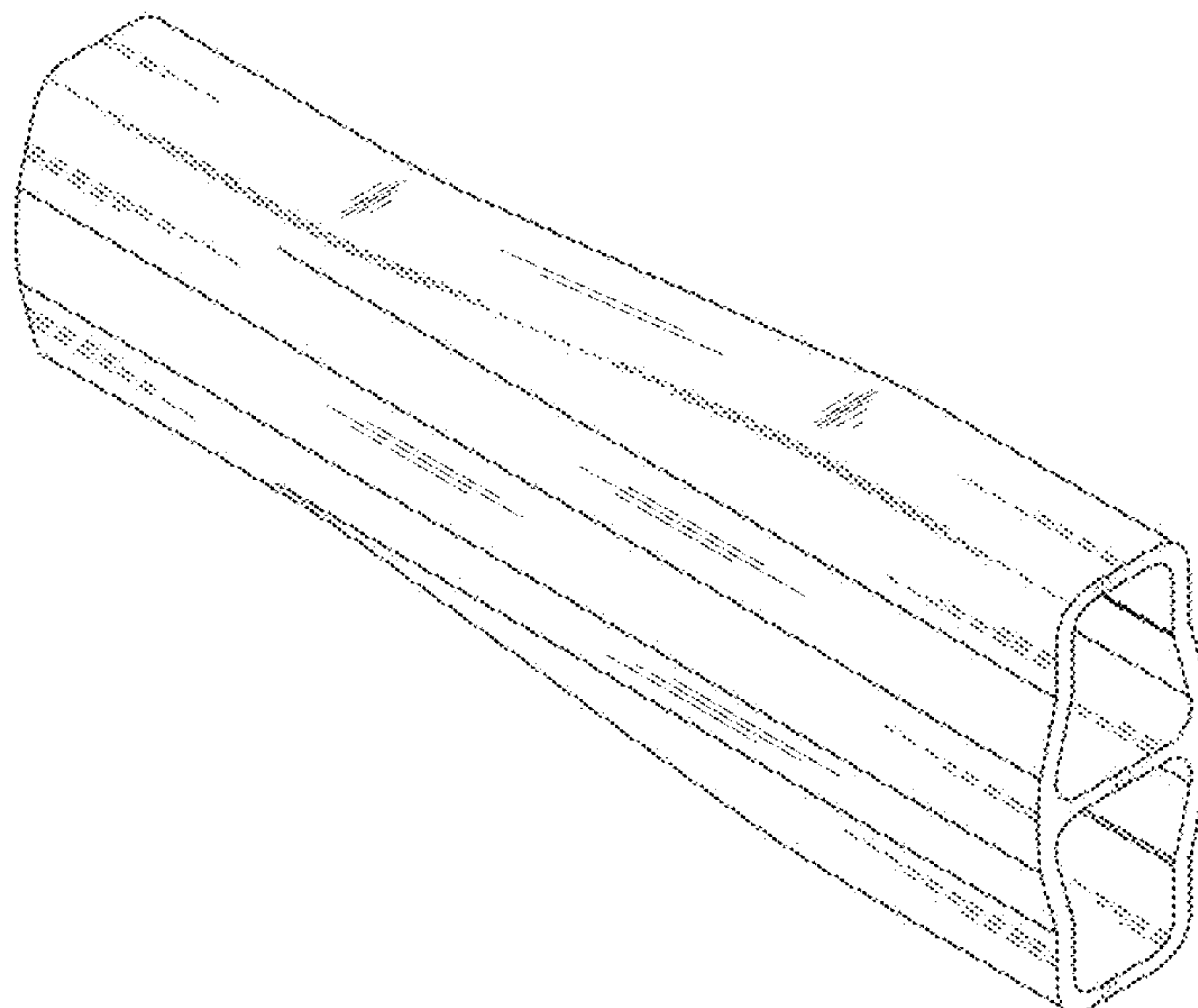
FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof;

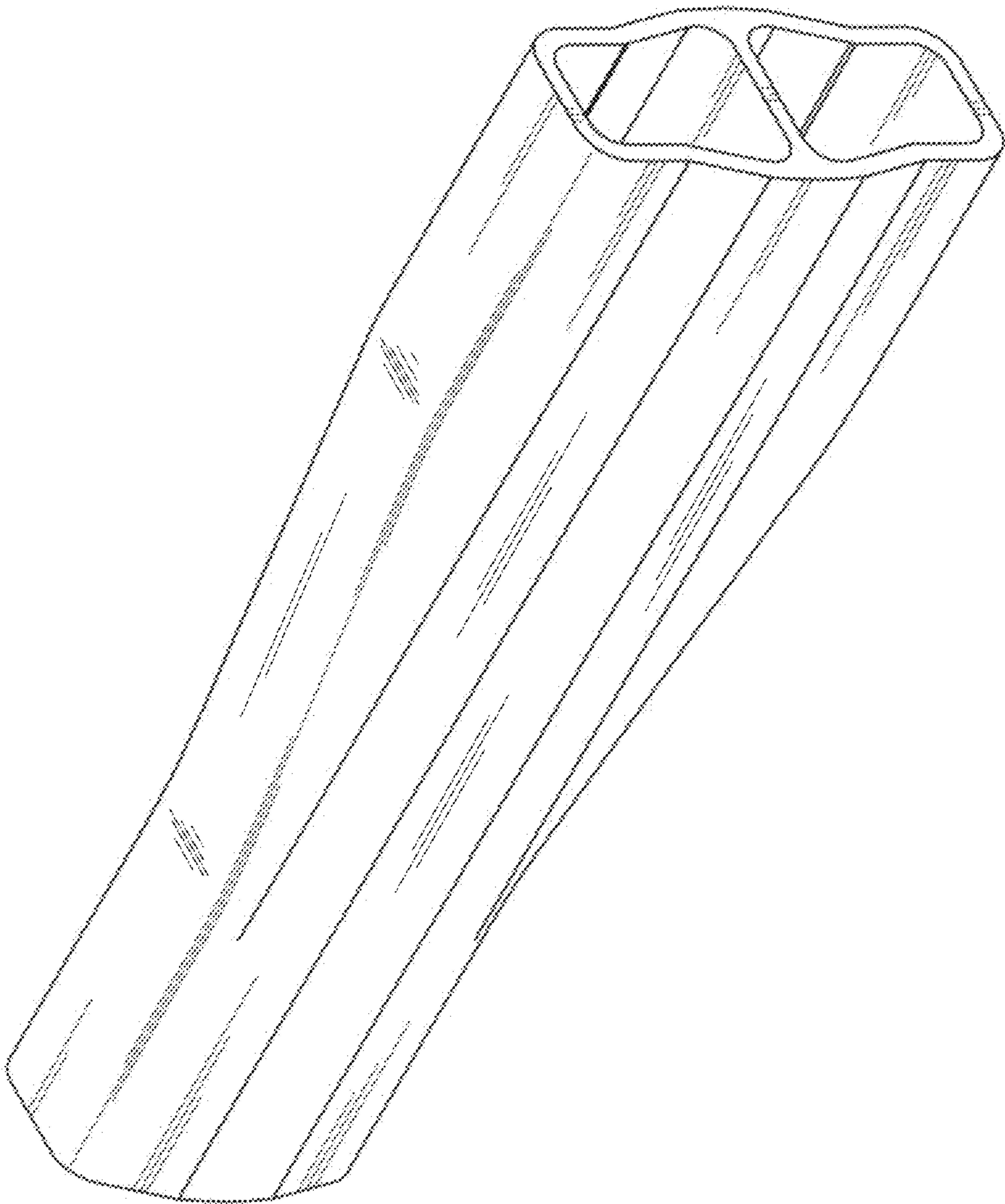

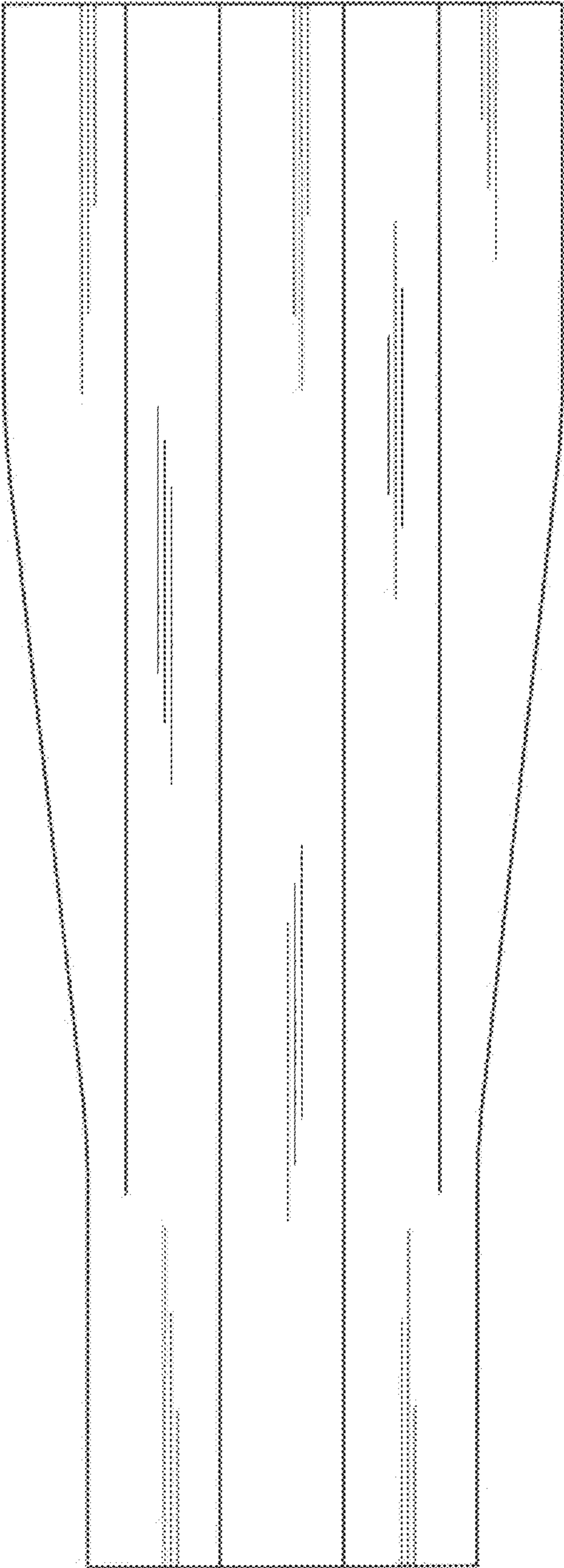

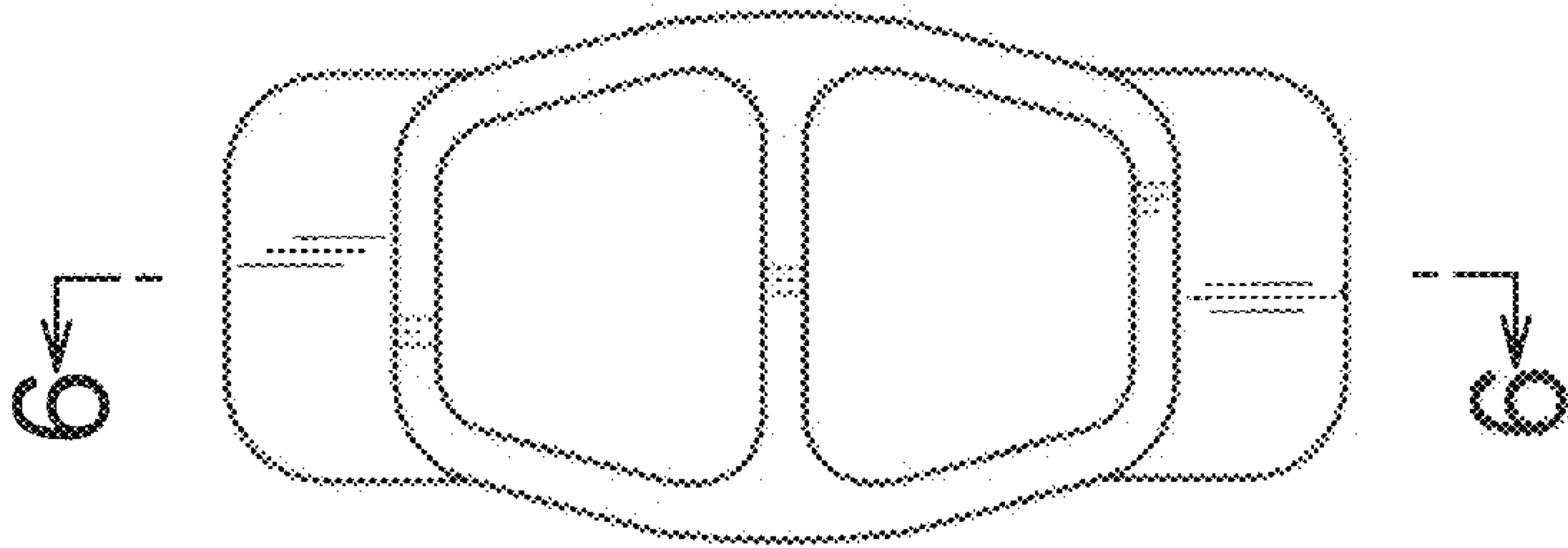

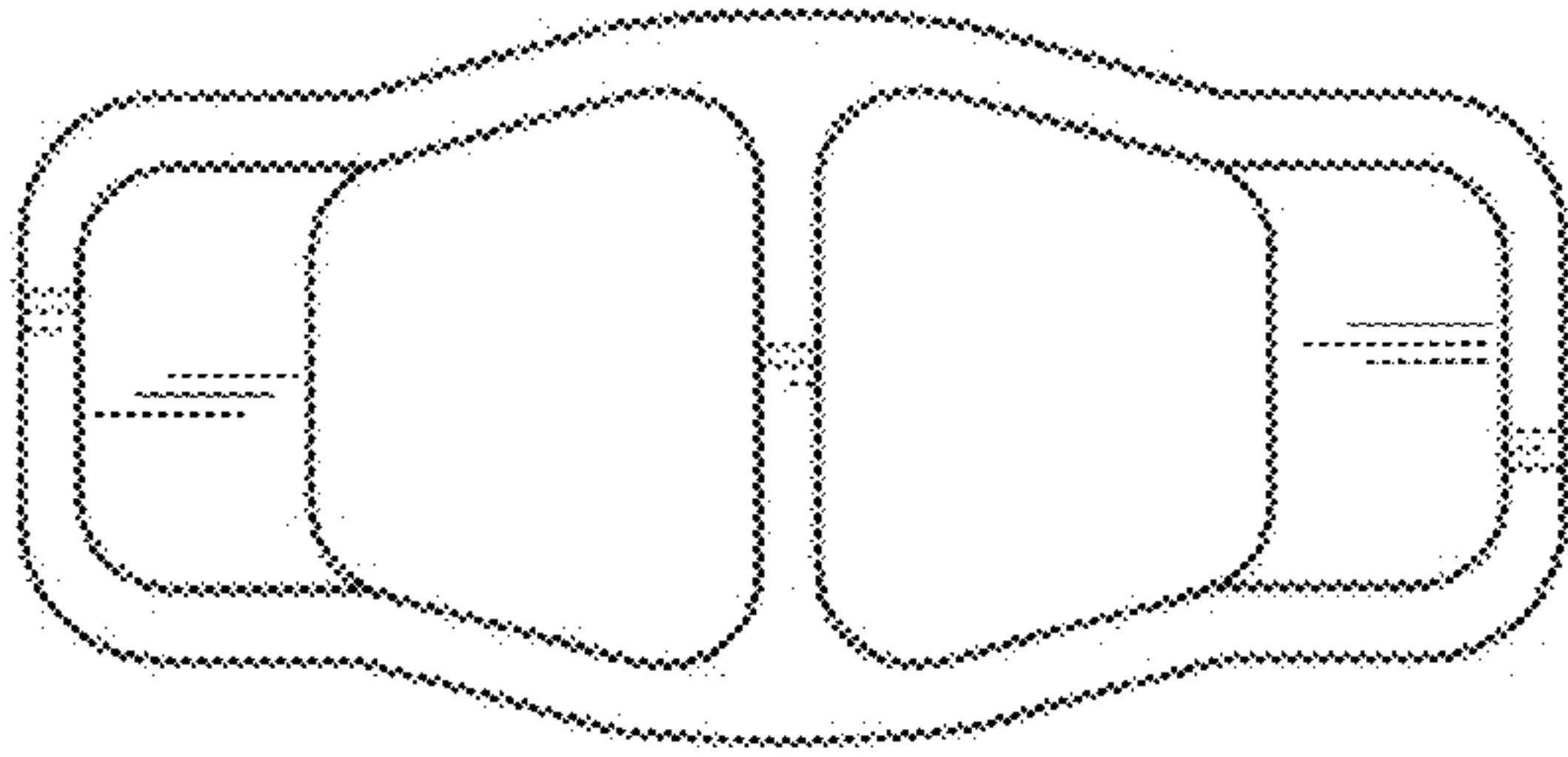

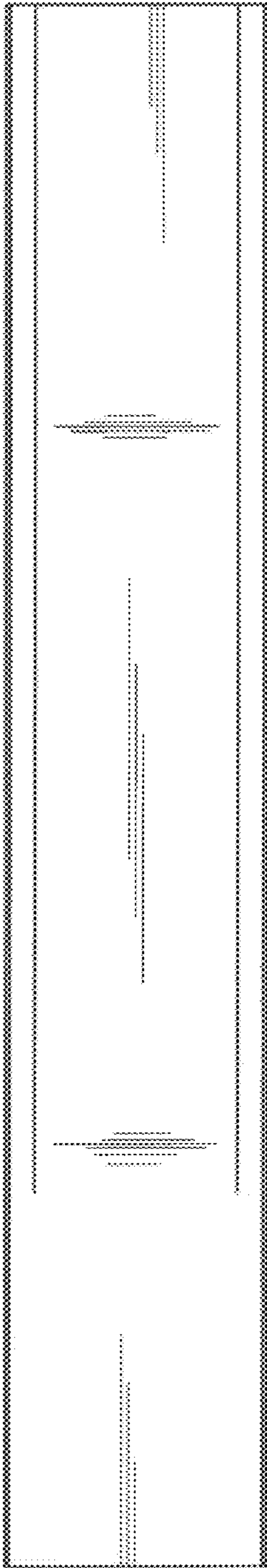

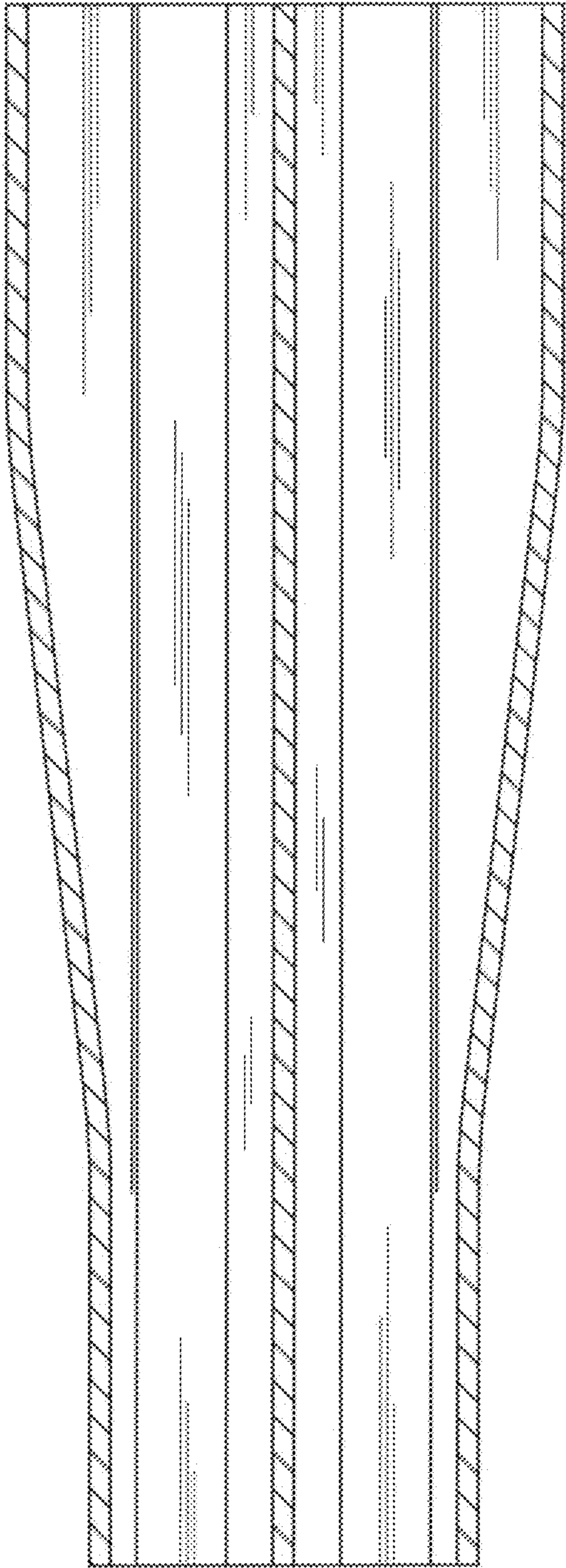
