(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen or a portion thereof with graphical user interface, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

The sole FIGURE is a front view of a display screen or portion thereof with graphical user interface showing our new design. The dash-dot-dash-dot broken line immediately adjacent the solid-line portions of the design represents an unclaimed boundary of the design.

The short dash-dash broken lines represent portions of the graphical user interface and form no part of the claimed design.
