We claim the ornamental design for a door knob, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embodiment of the claimed design;

 FIG. 3 is a rear view of the embodiment of the claimed design shown in FIG. 1; and,
 FIG. 4 is a side view of the embodiment of the claimed design shown in FIG. 1.

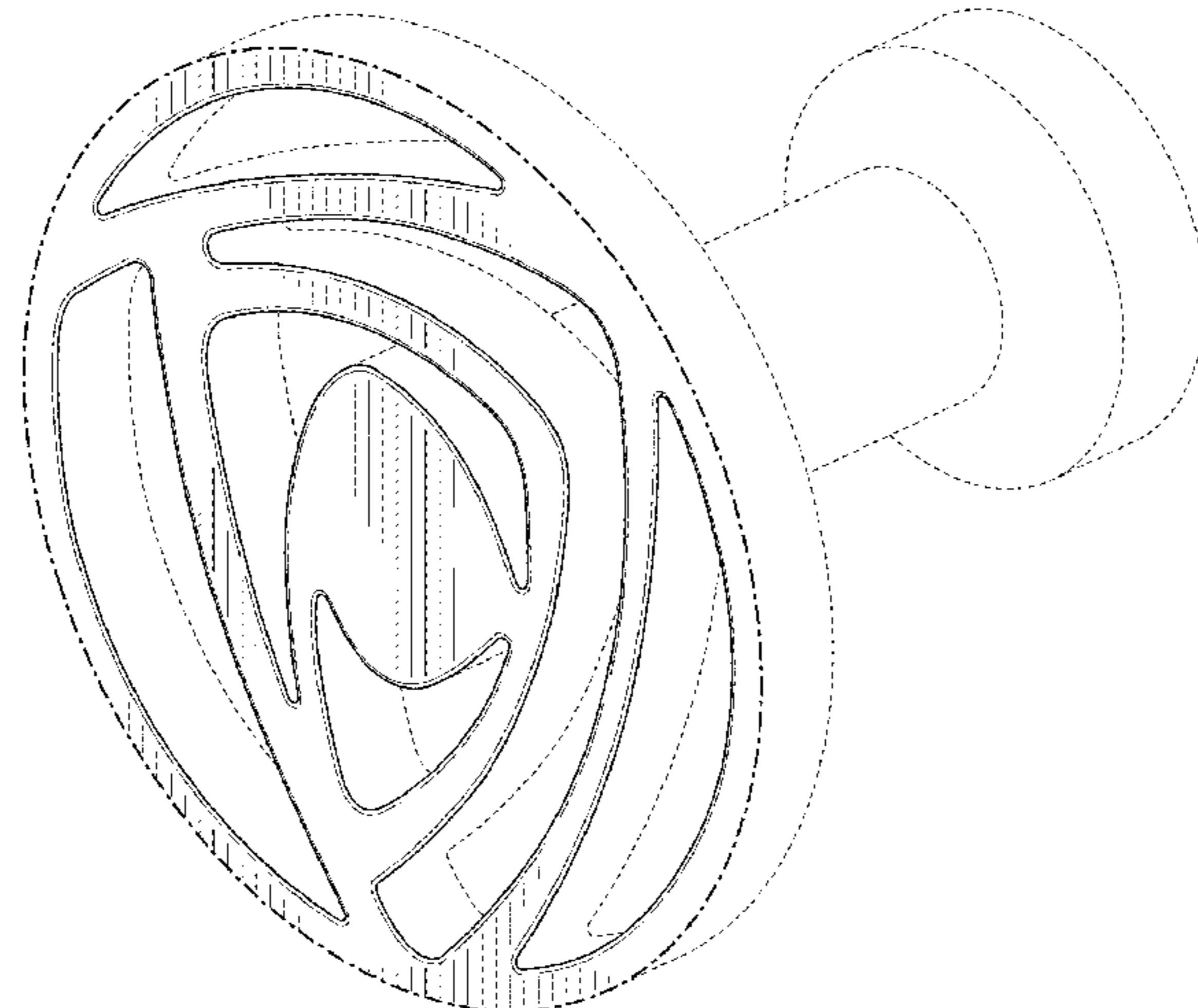

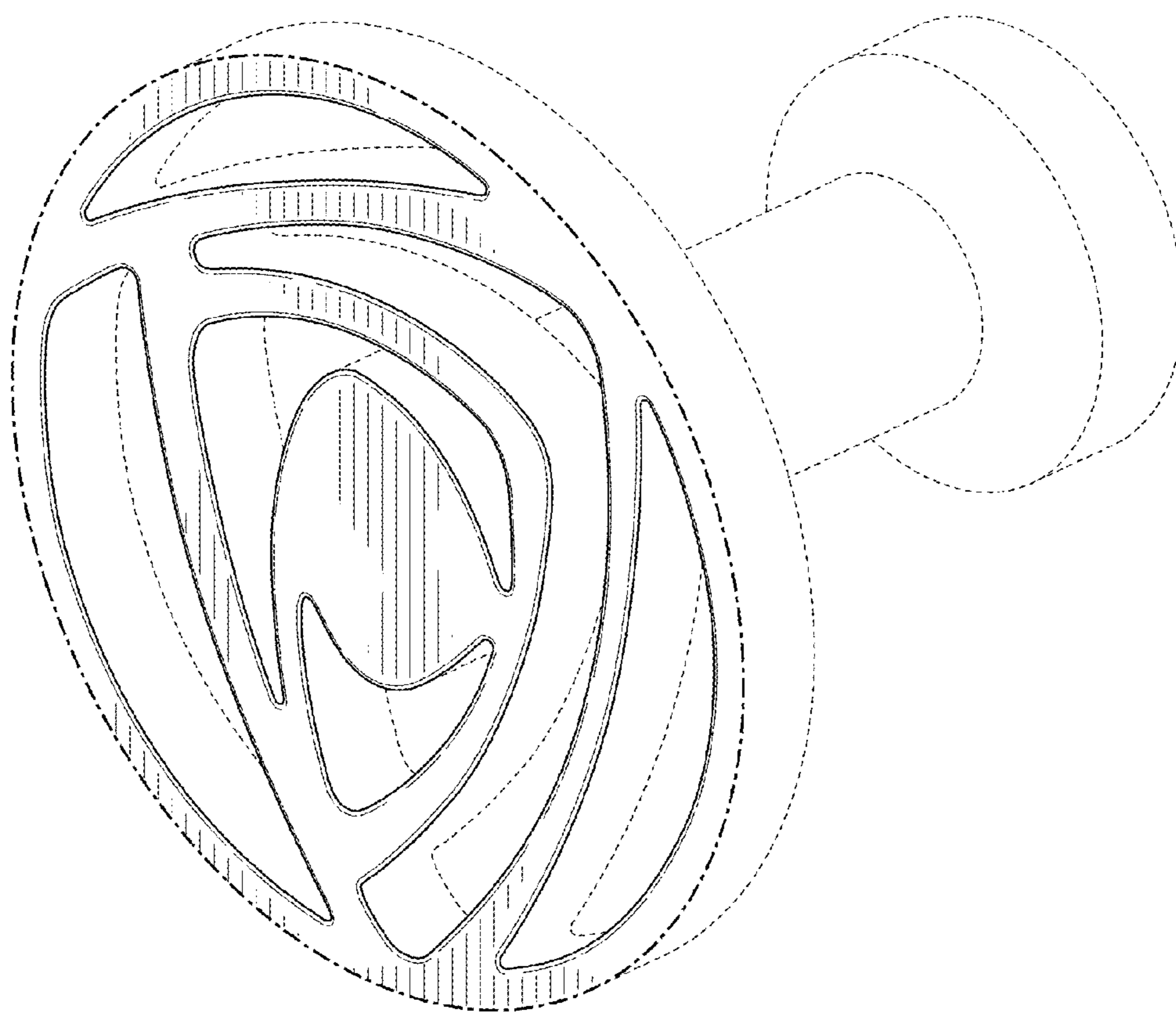

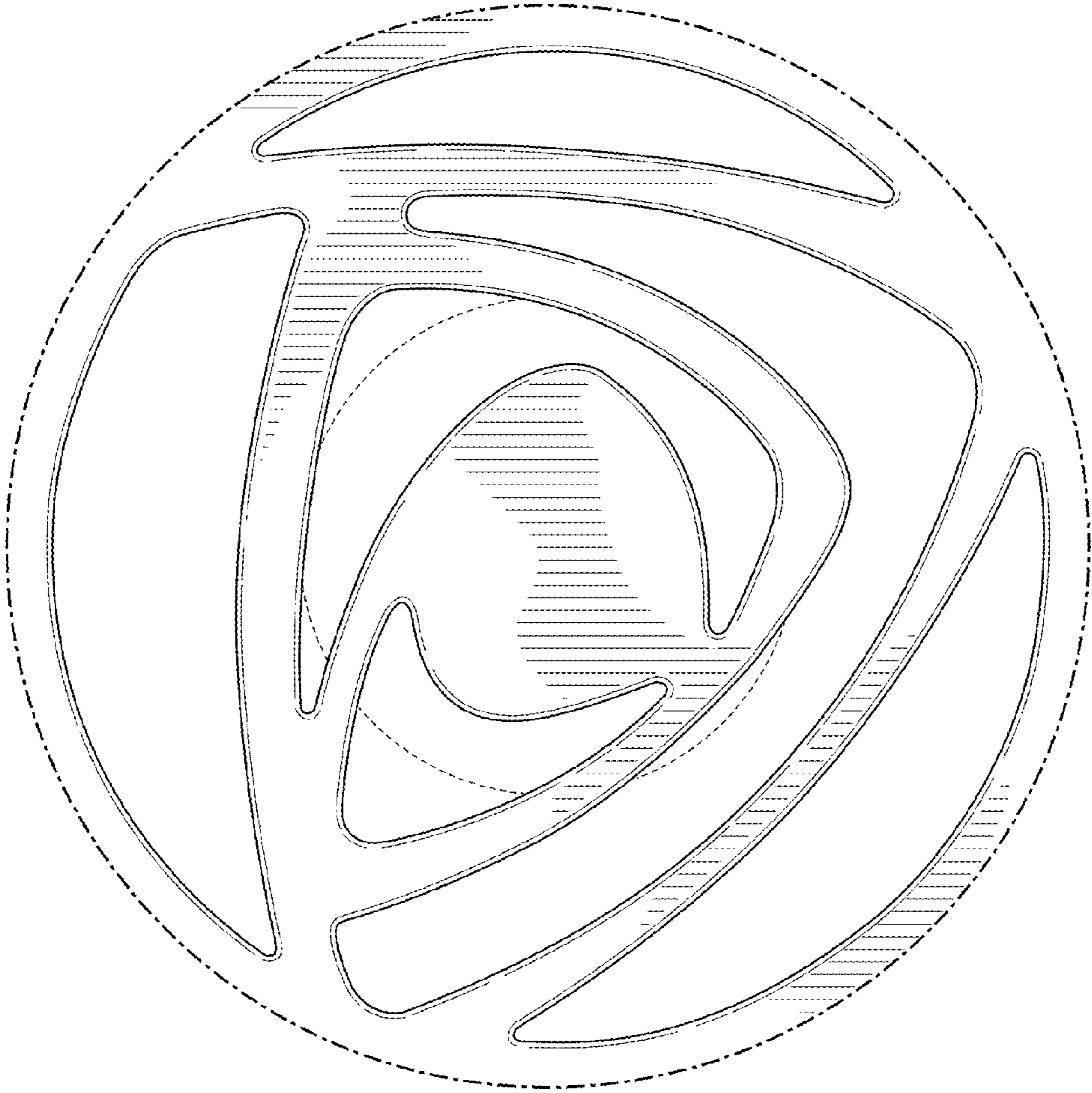

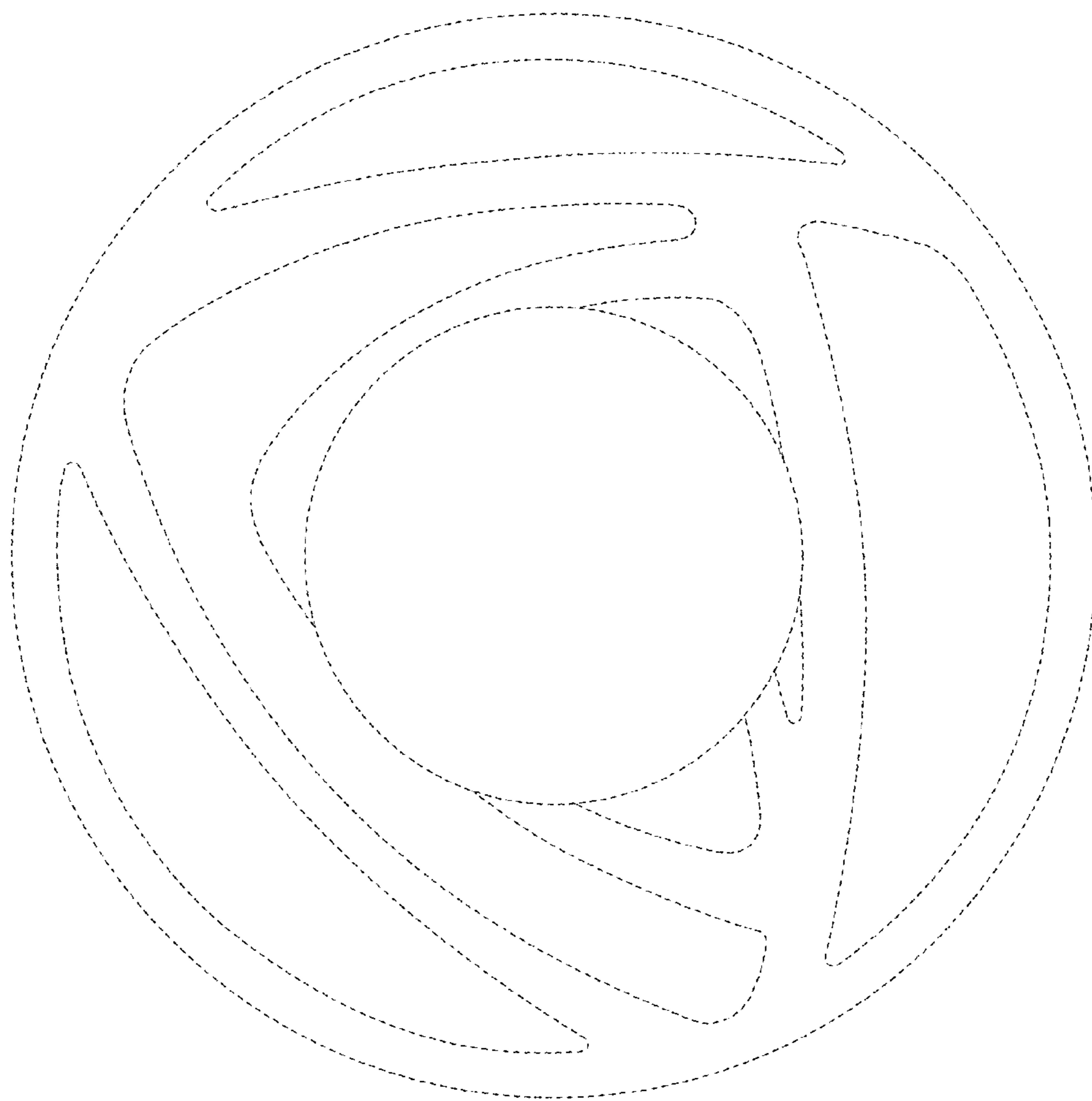

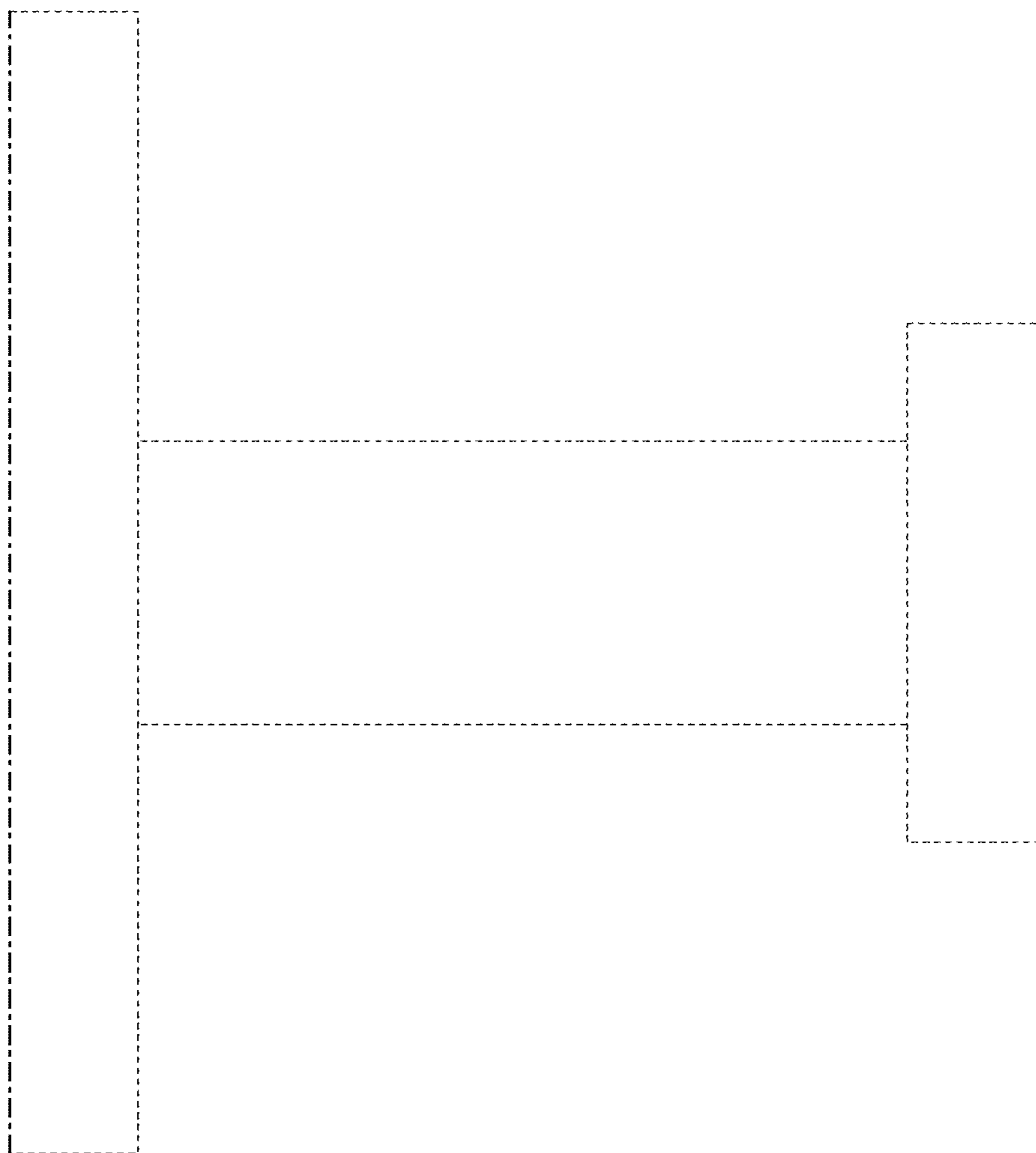
