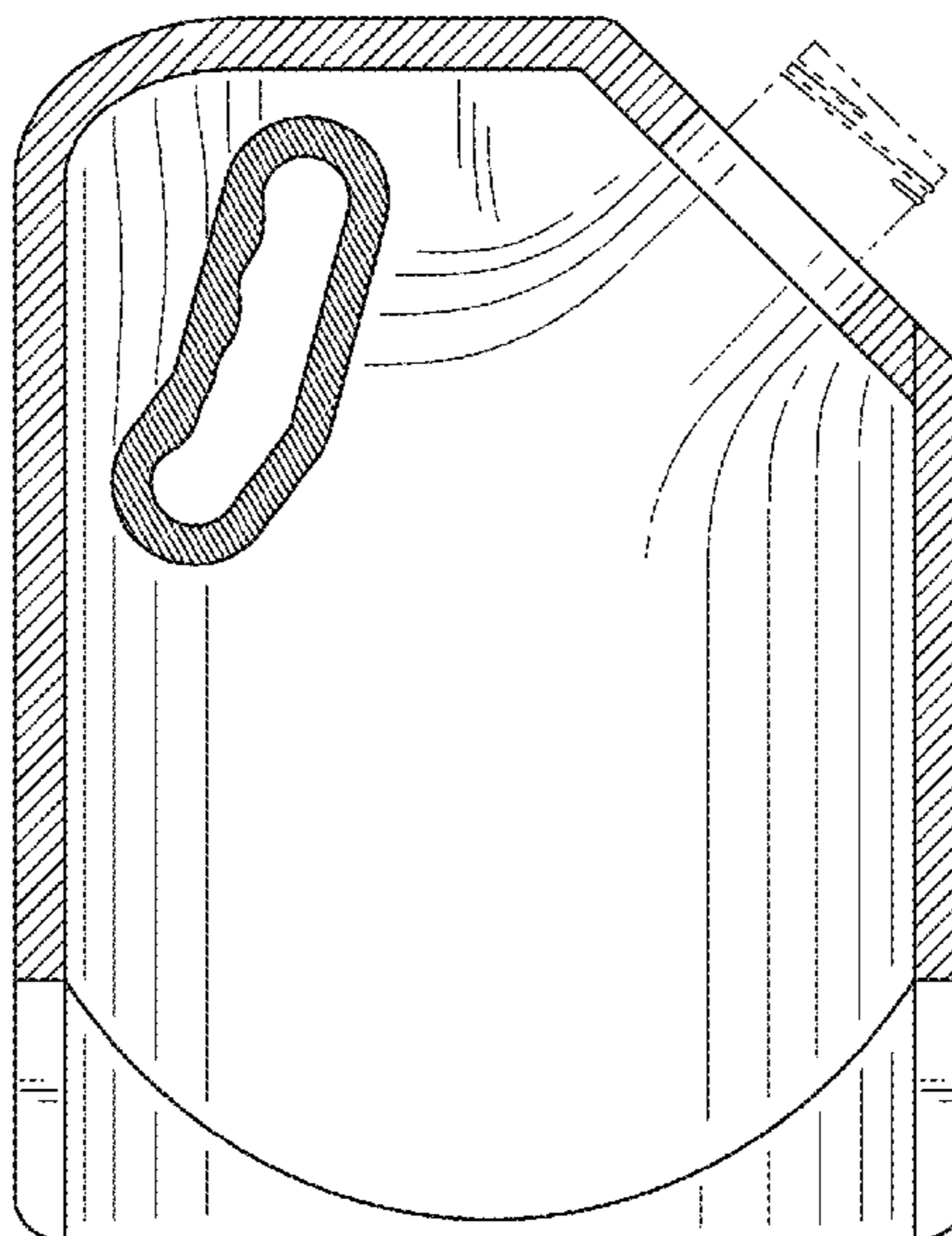

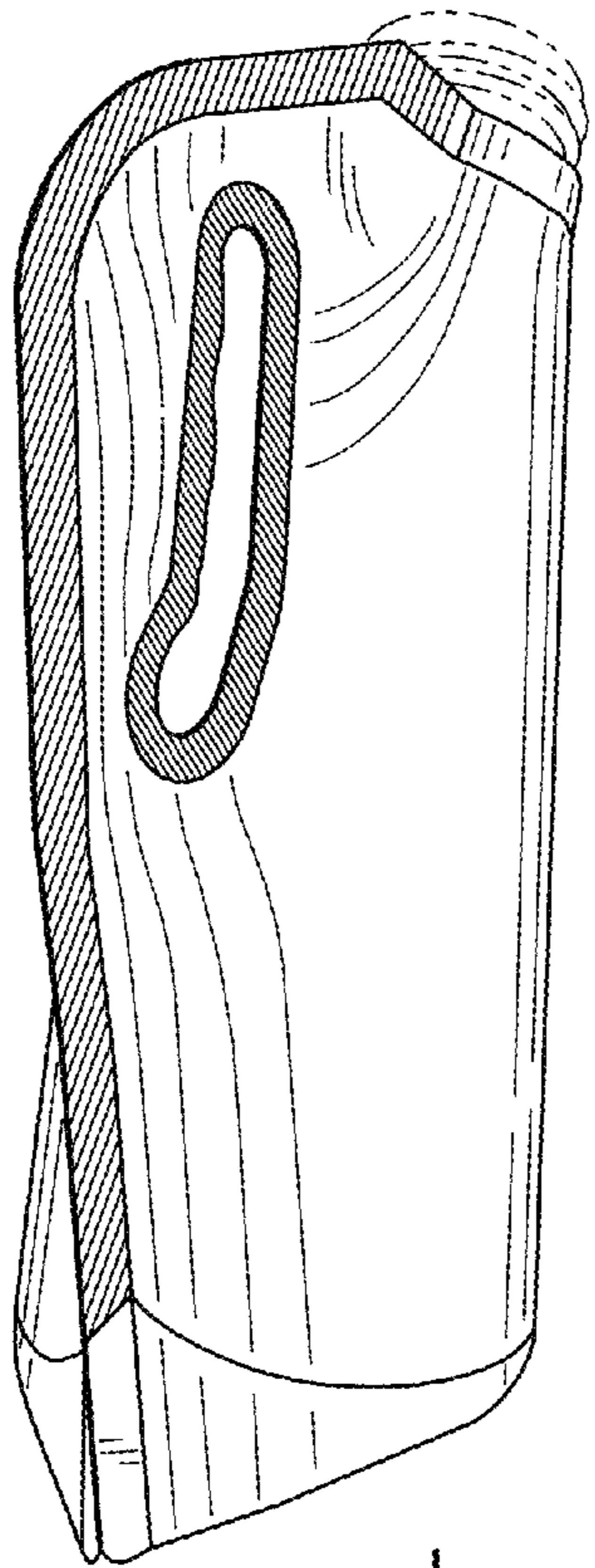
The ornamental design for a flexible pouch, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

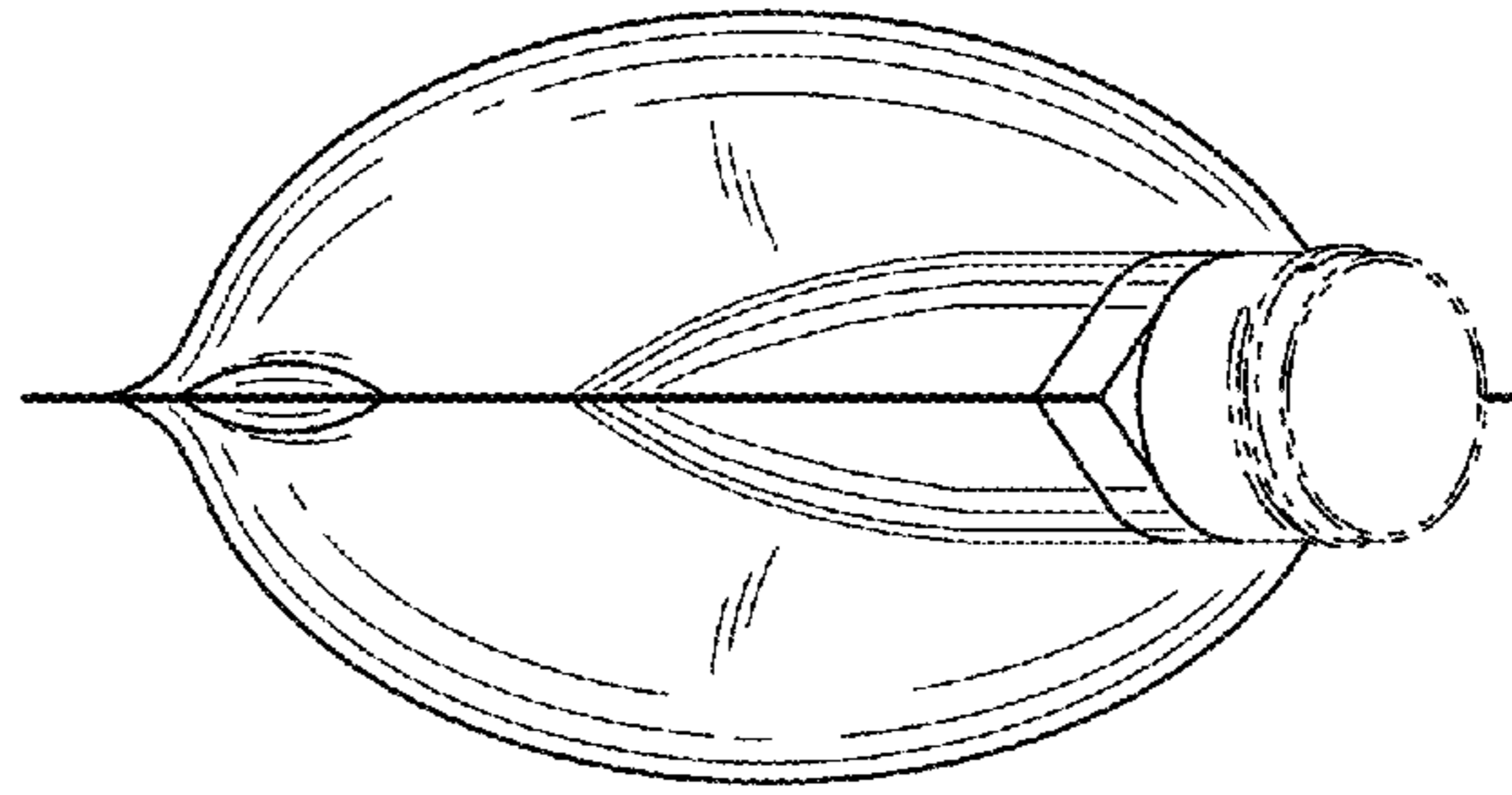
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the front and side of a flexible pouch;

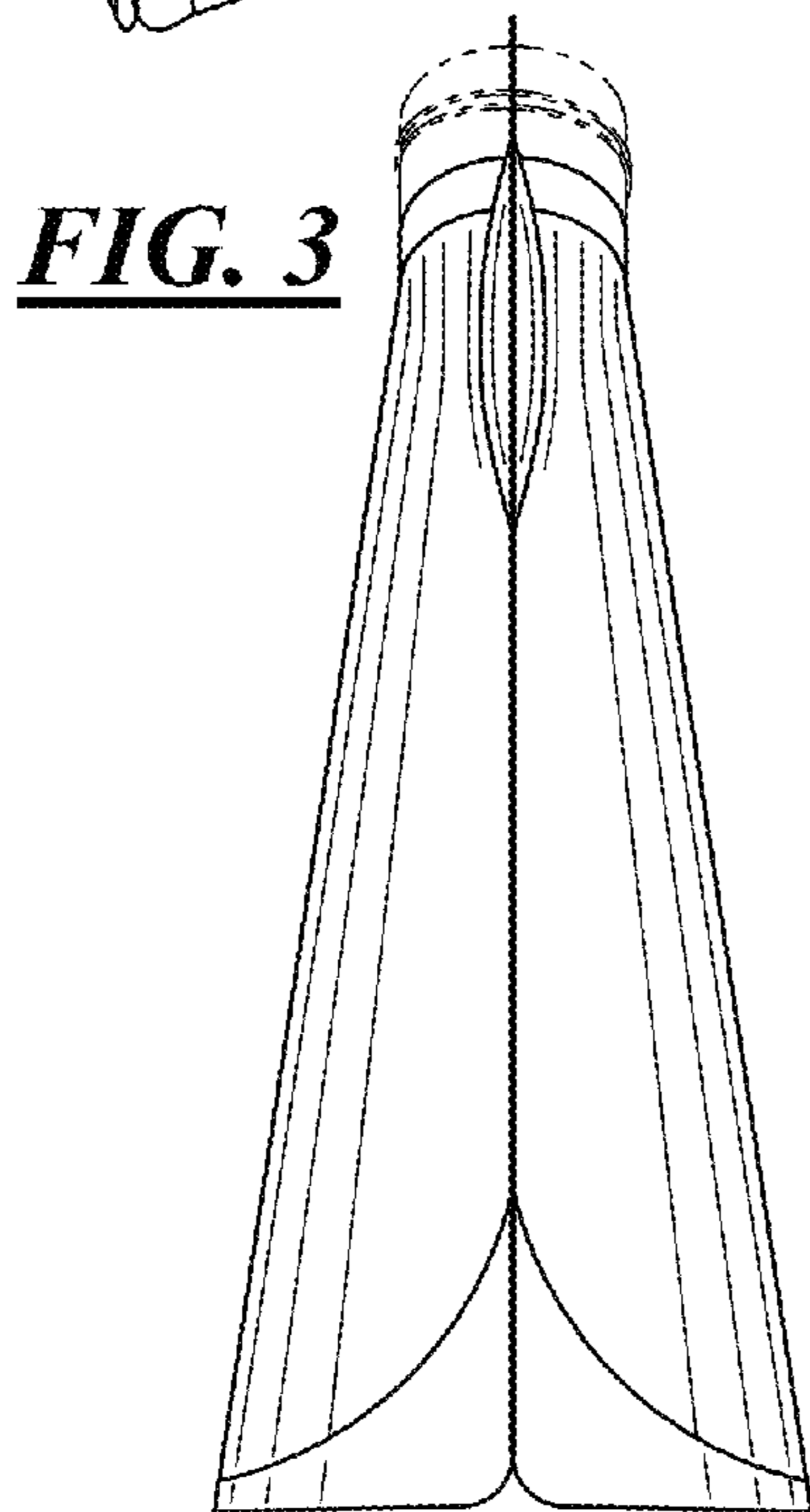




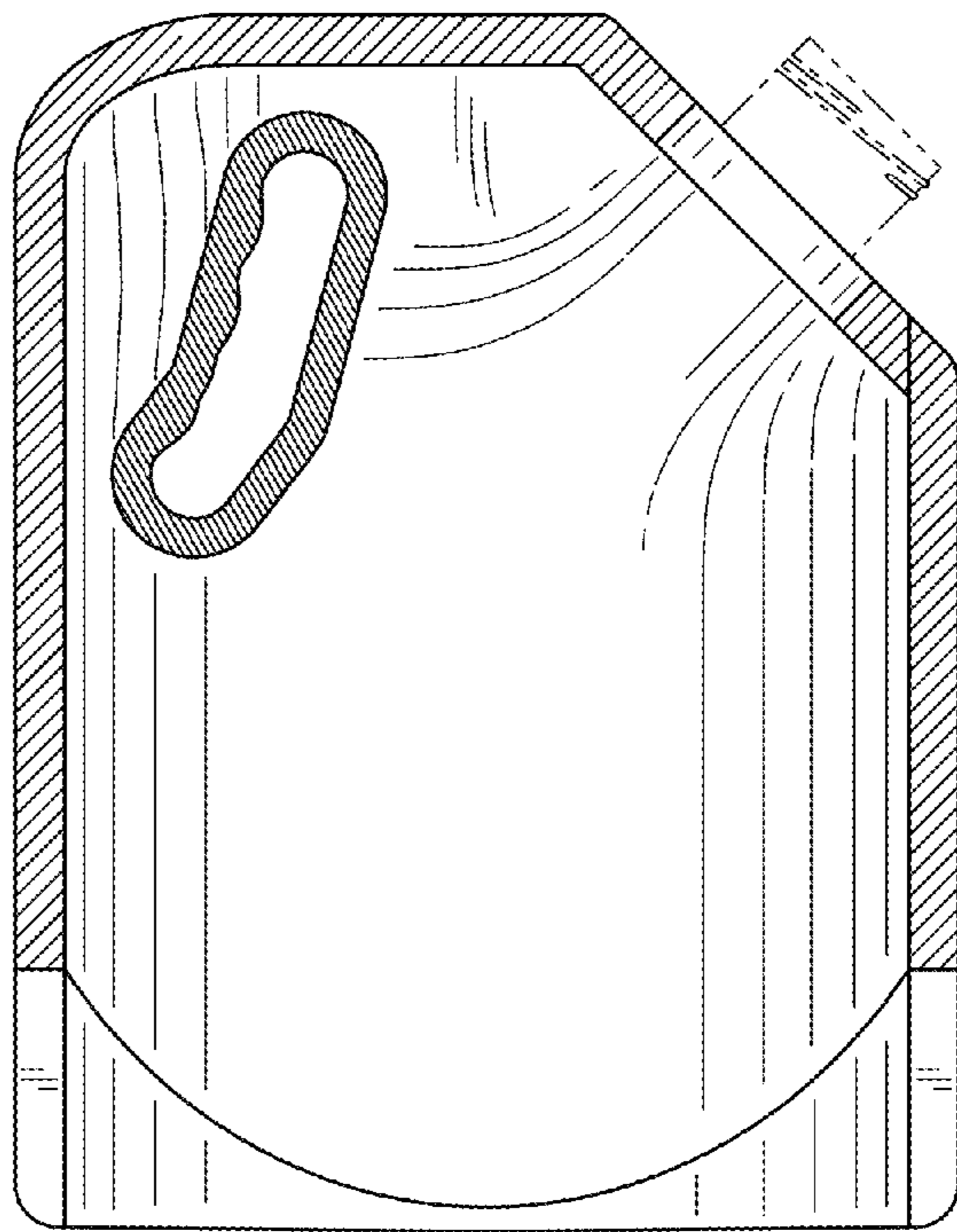

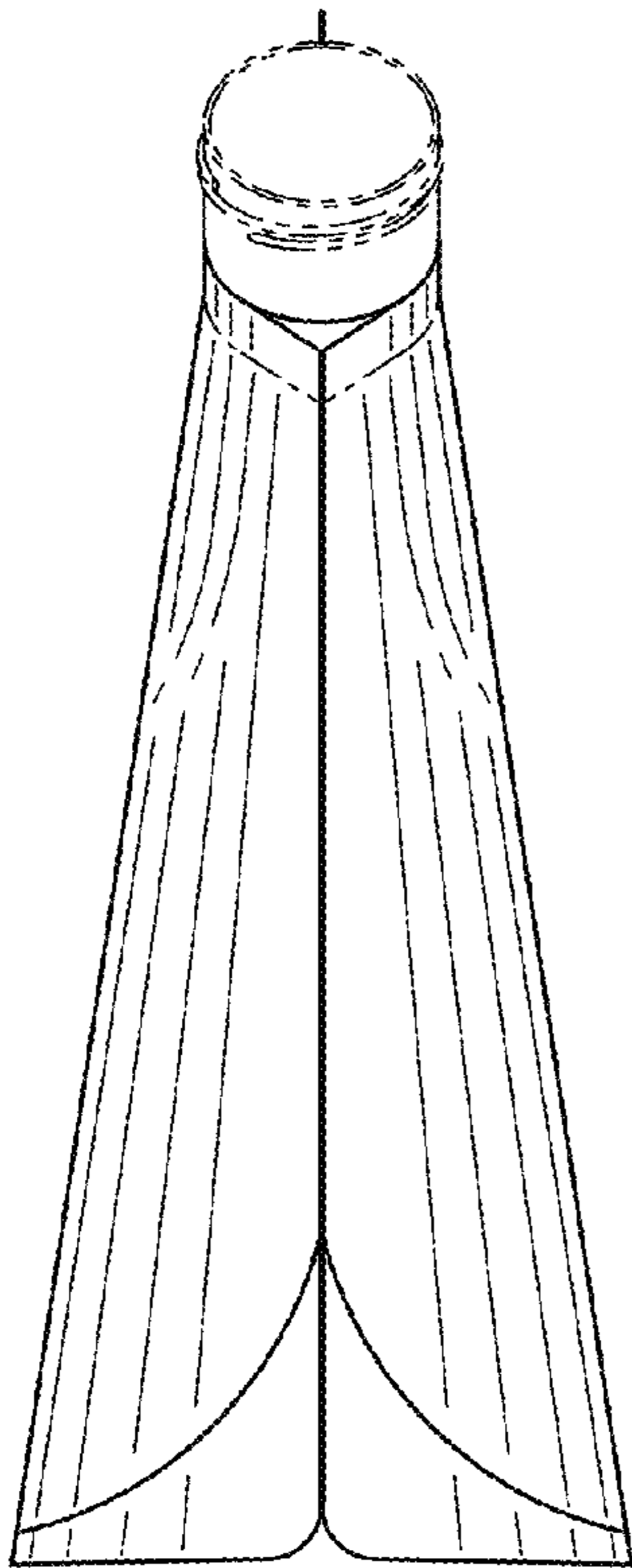

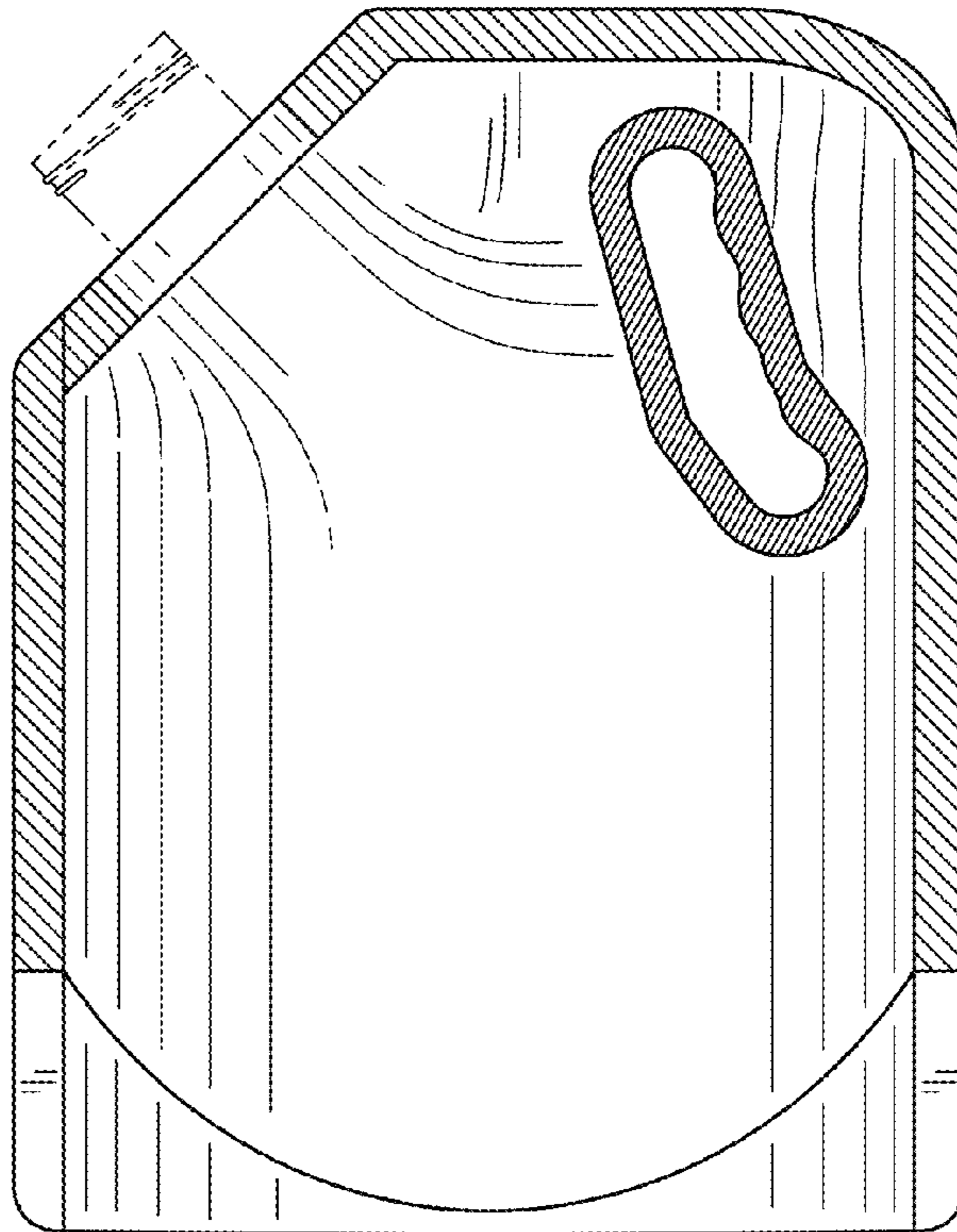

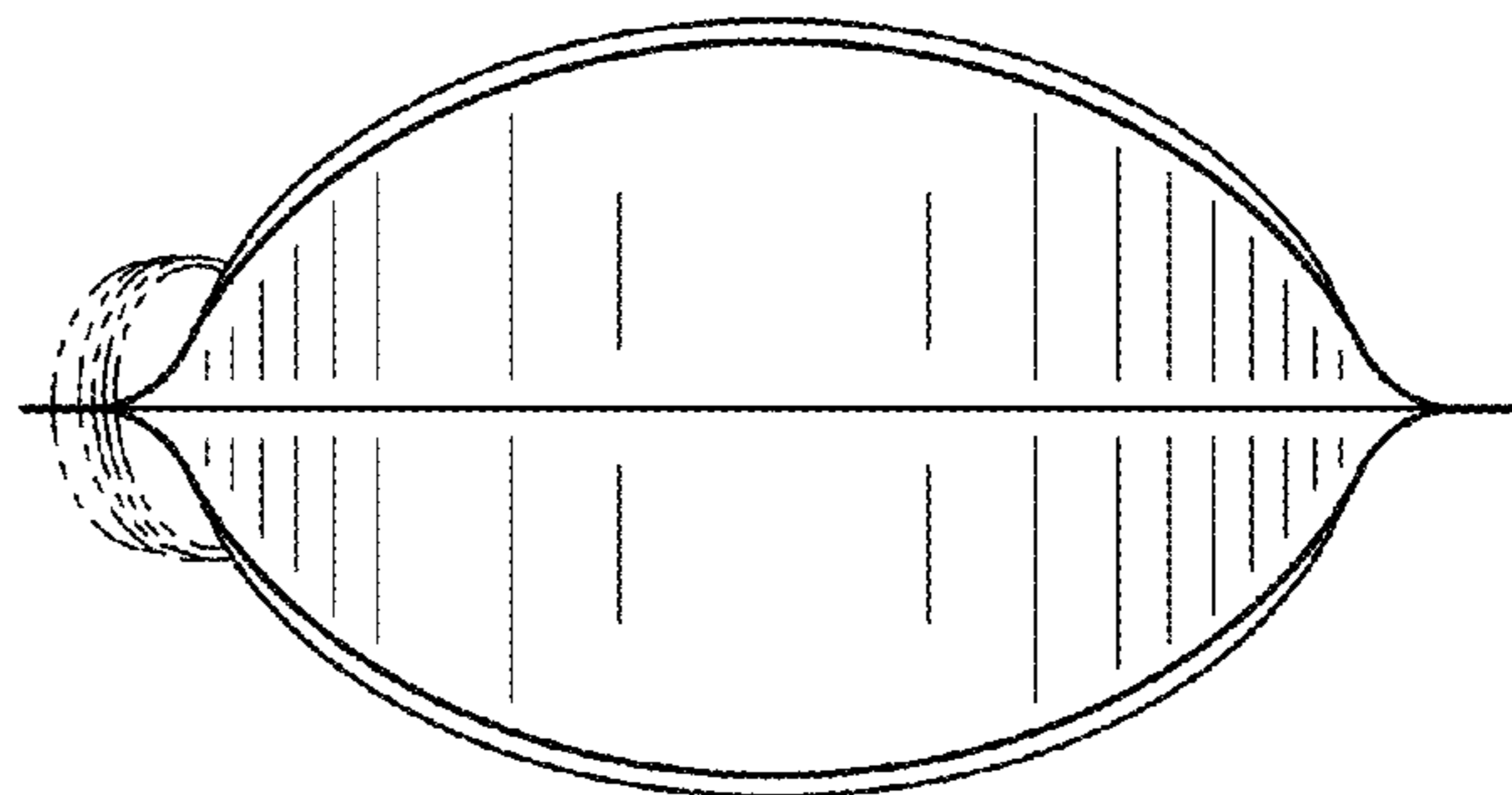
