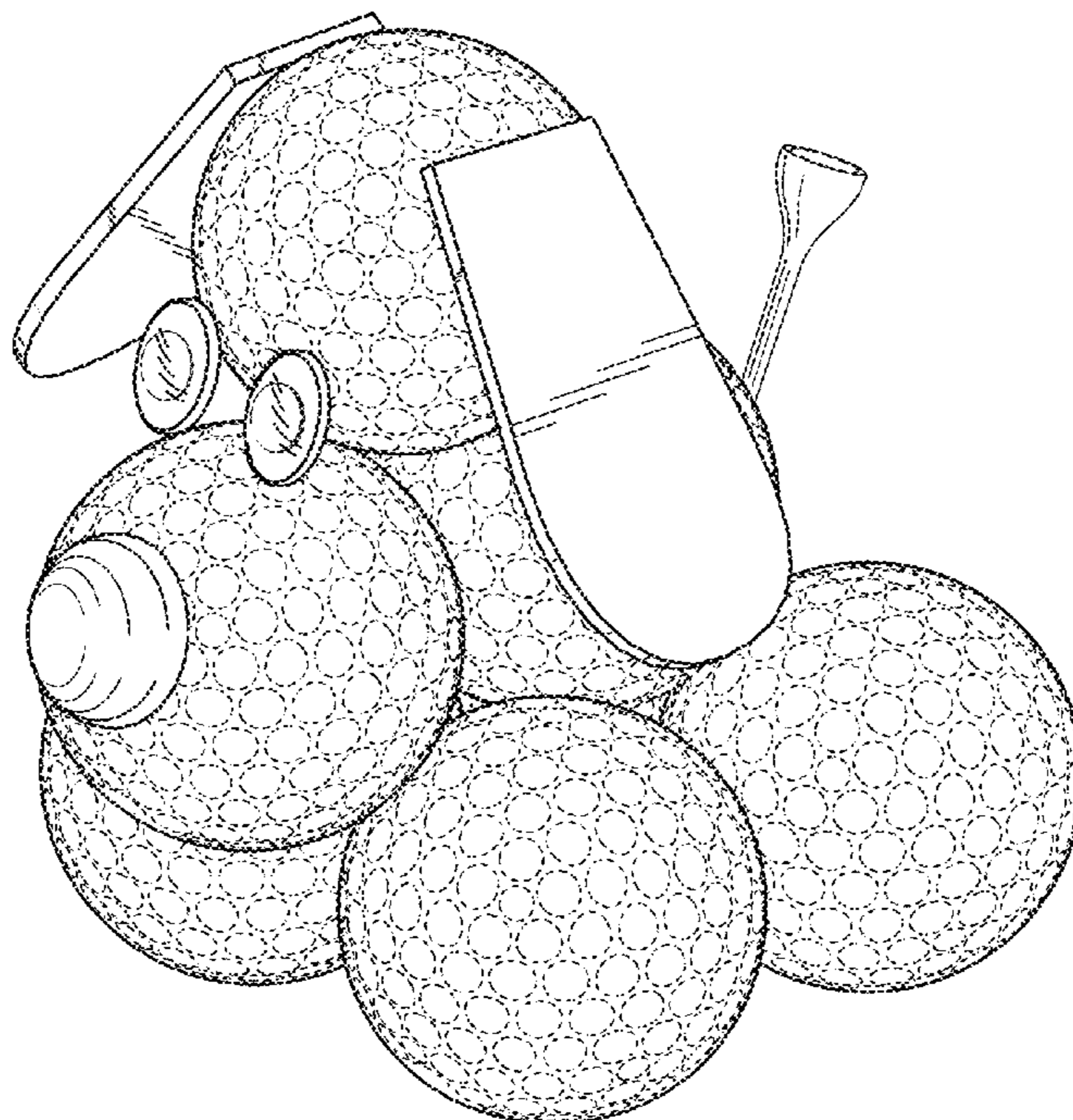
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a decorative desk ornament, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an upper perspective view of a decorative desk ornament, as shown and described;
FIG. 2 is a front side view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left-hand side view thereof, the right-hand being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.
The broken line depictions illustrate surface features of the spherical members and tee member and form no part of the claimed design.

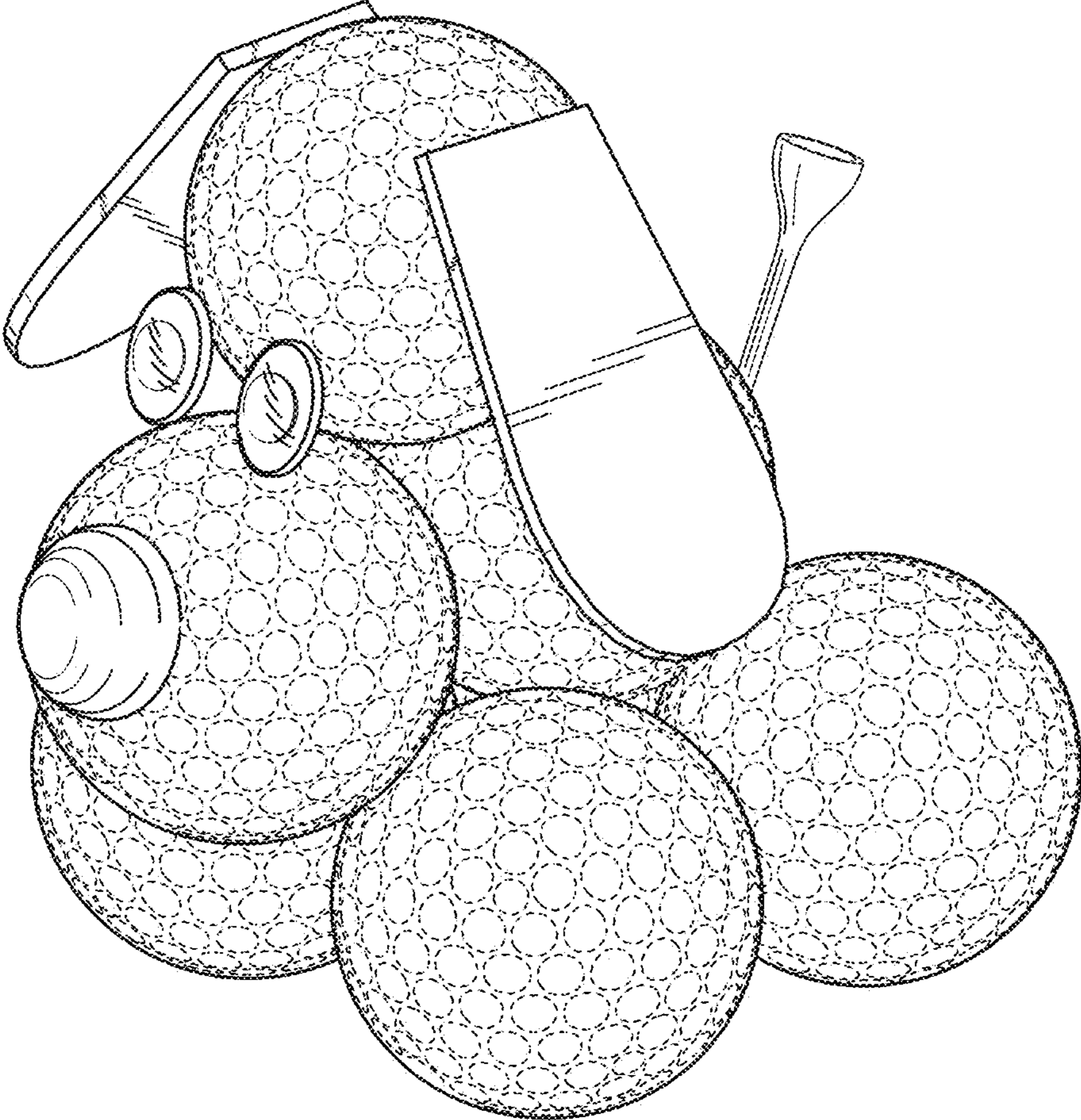

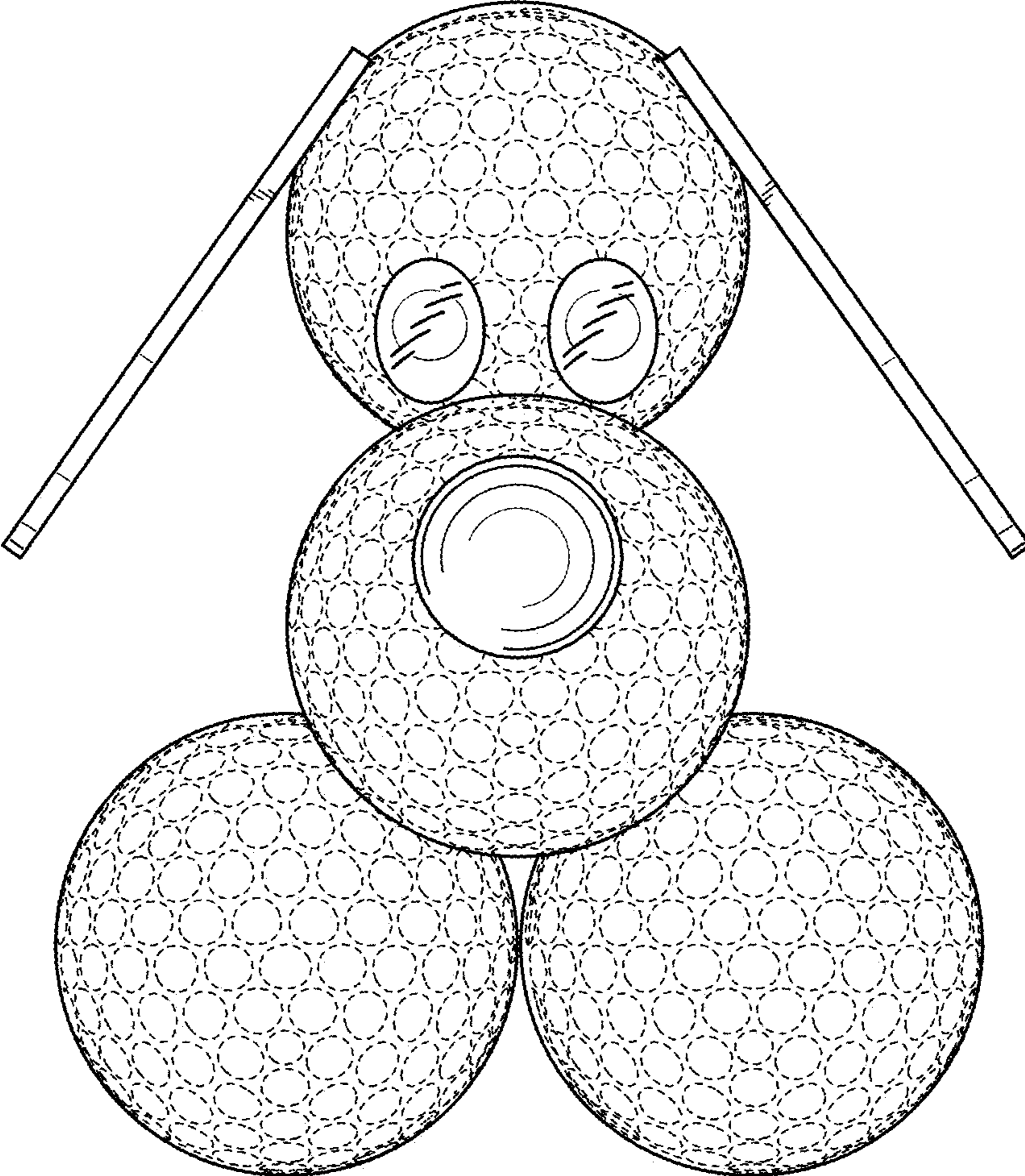

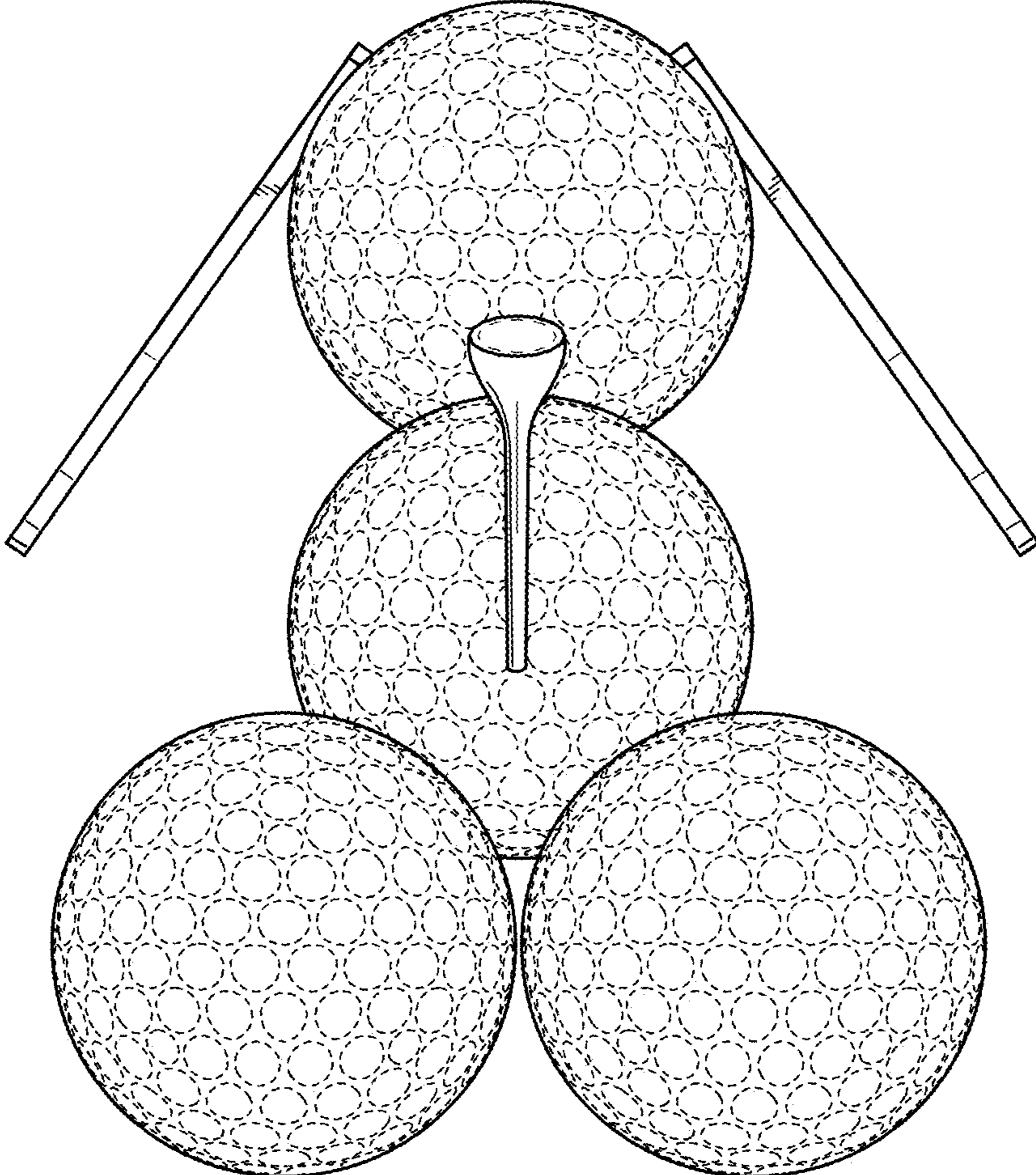

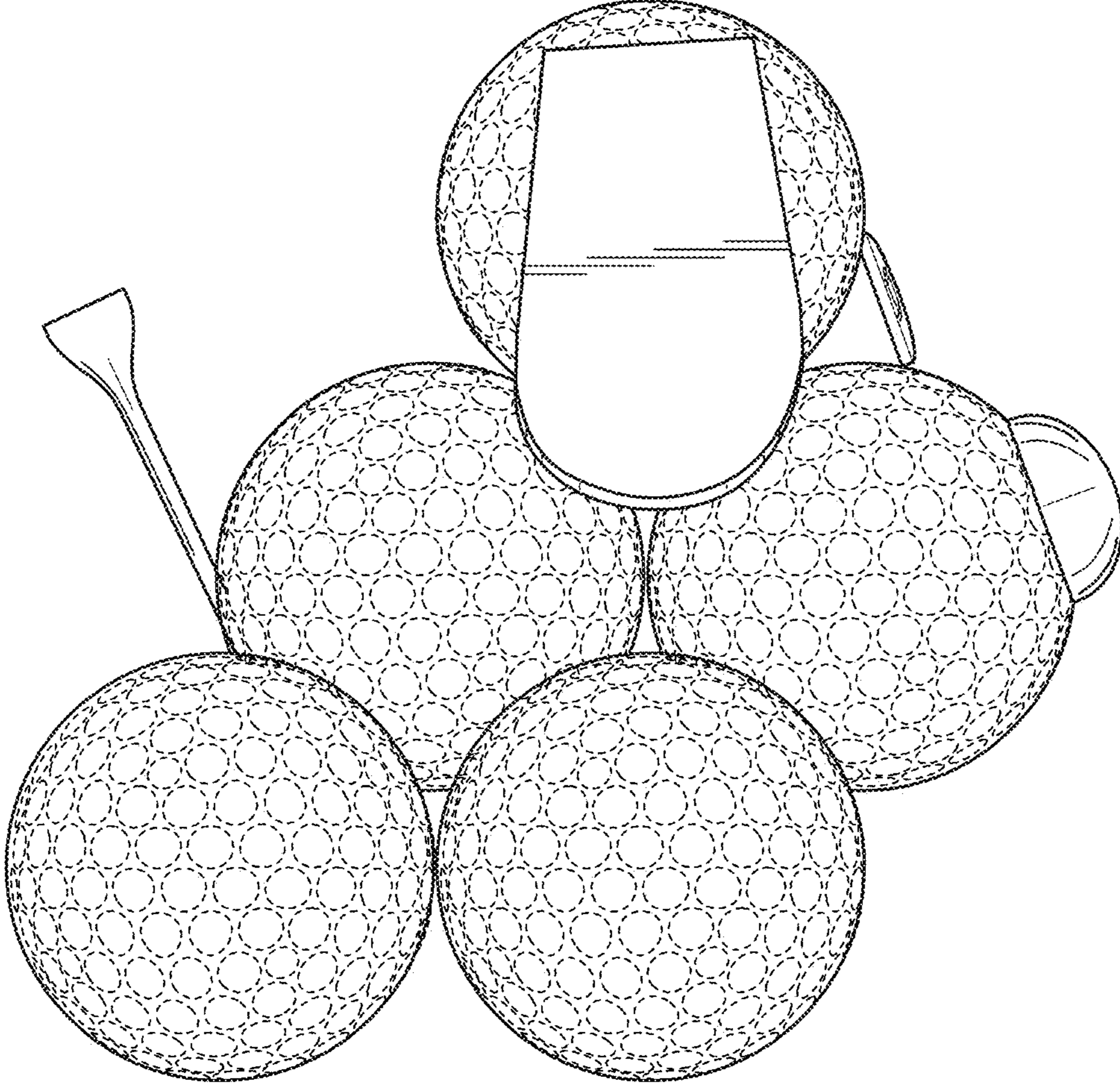

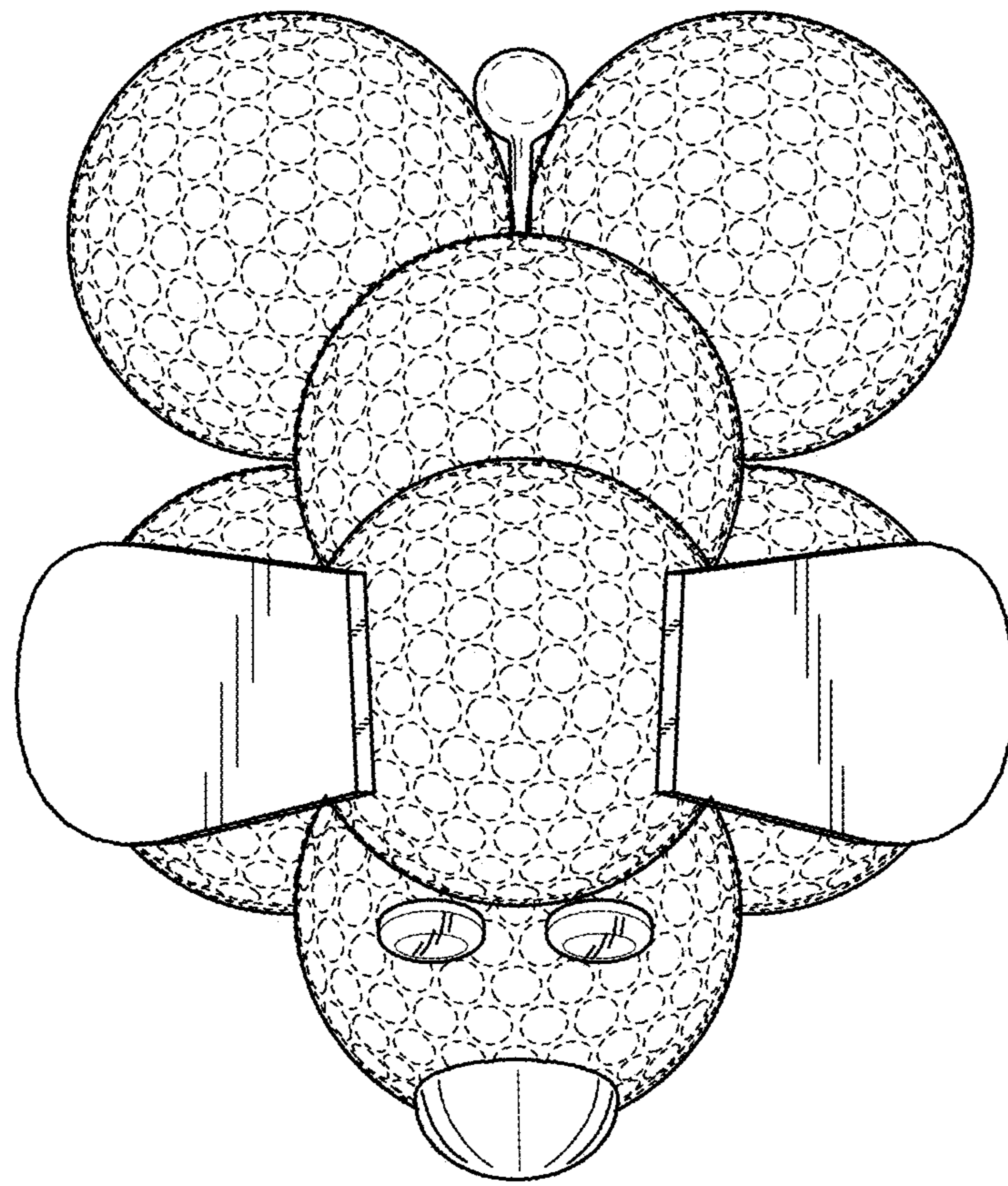

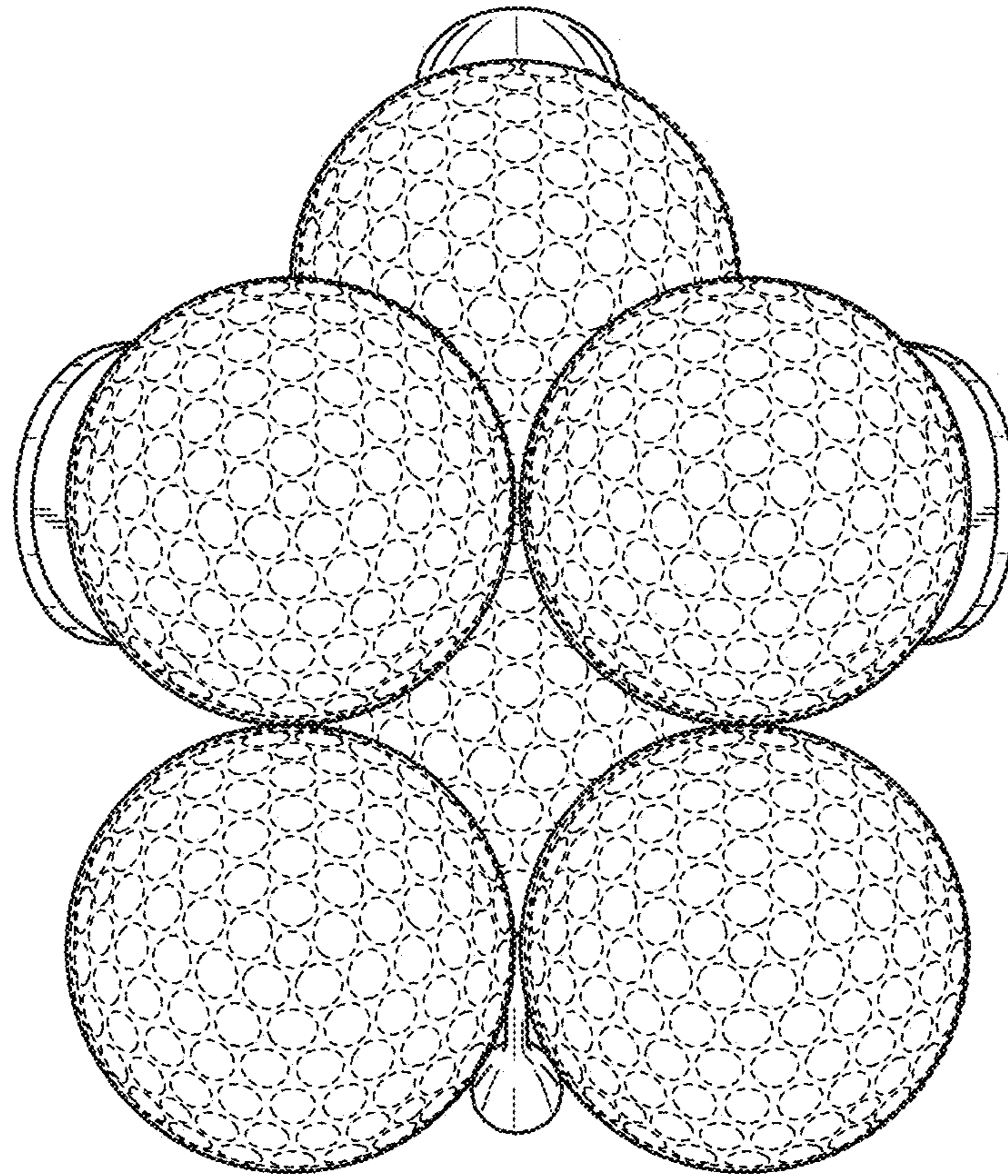
