(57) **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for a license plate frame, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective front view showing our new design for a license plate frame.

FIG. 2 is a magnified view of a portion of the license plate frame shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a front view of the license plate frame of the present invention.

FIG. 4 is a back view of the license plate frame of the present invention.

FIG. 5 is a right side view of the license plate frame of the present invention, the left side view being the mirror image thereof.

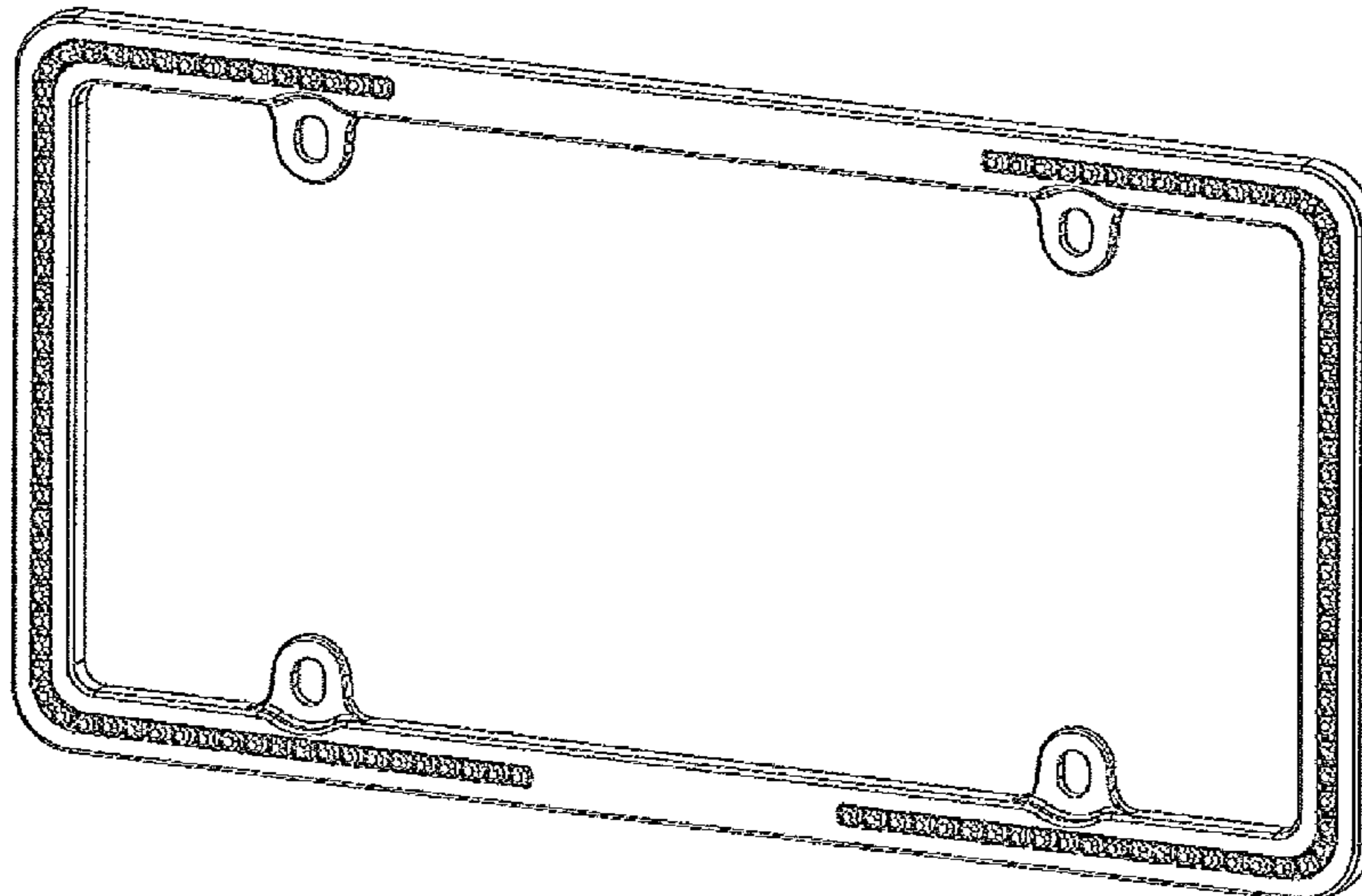
FIG. 6 is a top view of the license plate frame of the present invention, the bottom view being the mirror image thereof.

FIG. 7 is a front view showing a second embodiment of our design for a license plate frame, with holes to accommodate the placement of an emblem added to the bottom bar of the design shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 8 is a front view showing a third embodiment of our design for a license plate frame, with holes to accommodate the placement of an emblem added to the top bar of the design shown in FIG. 7.

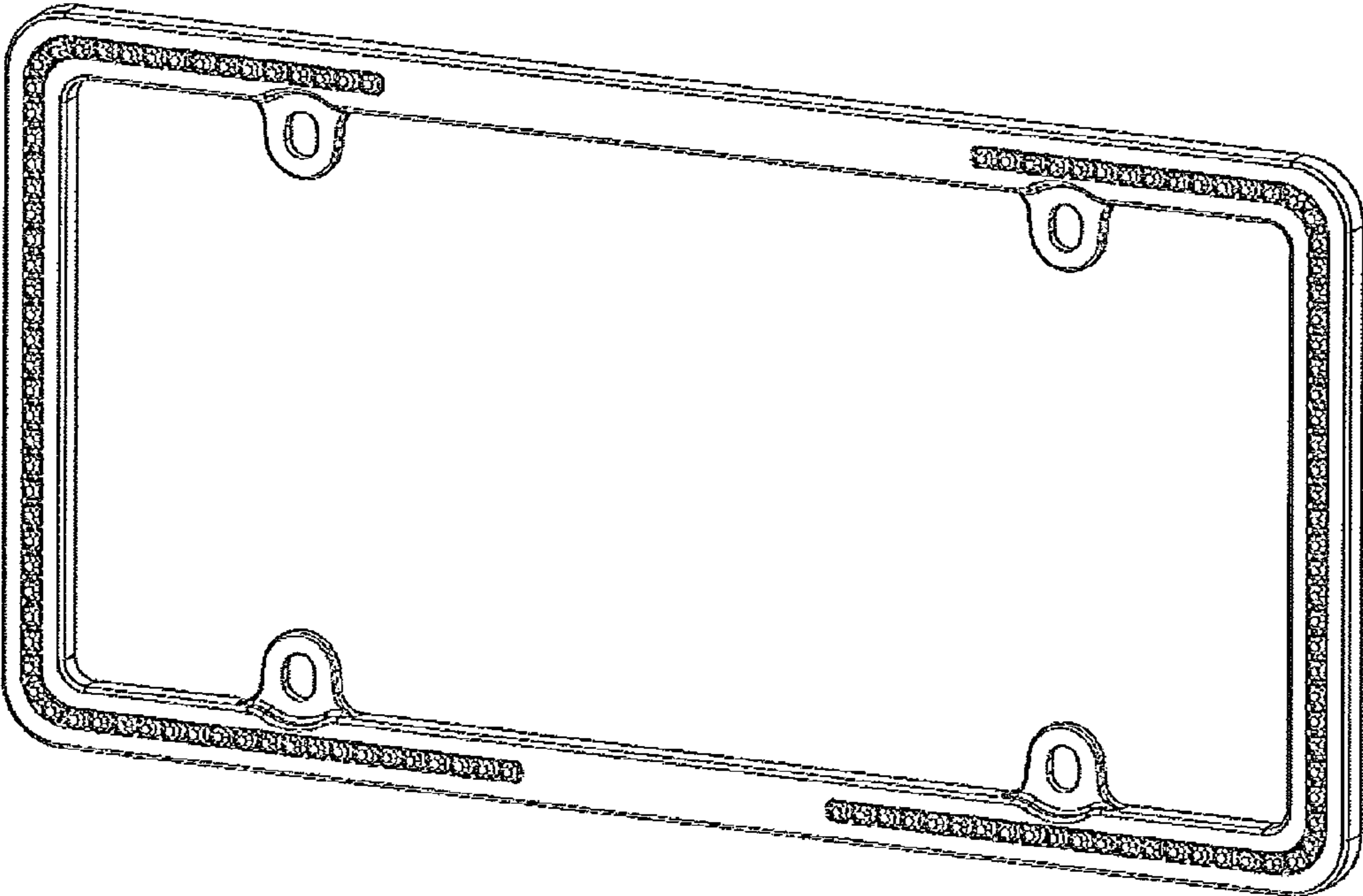

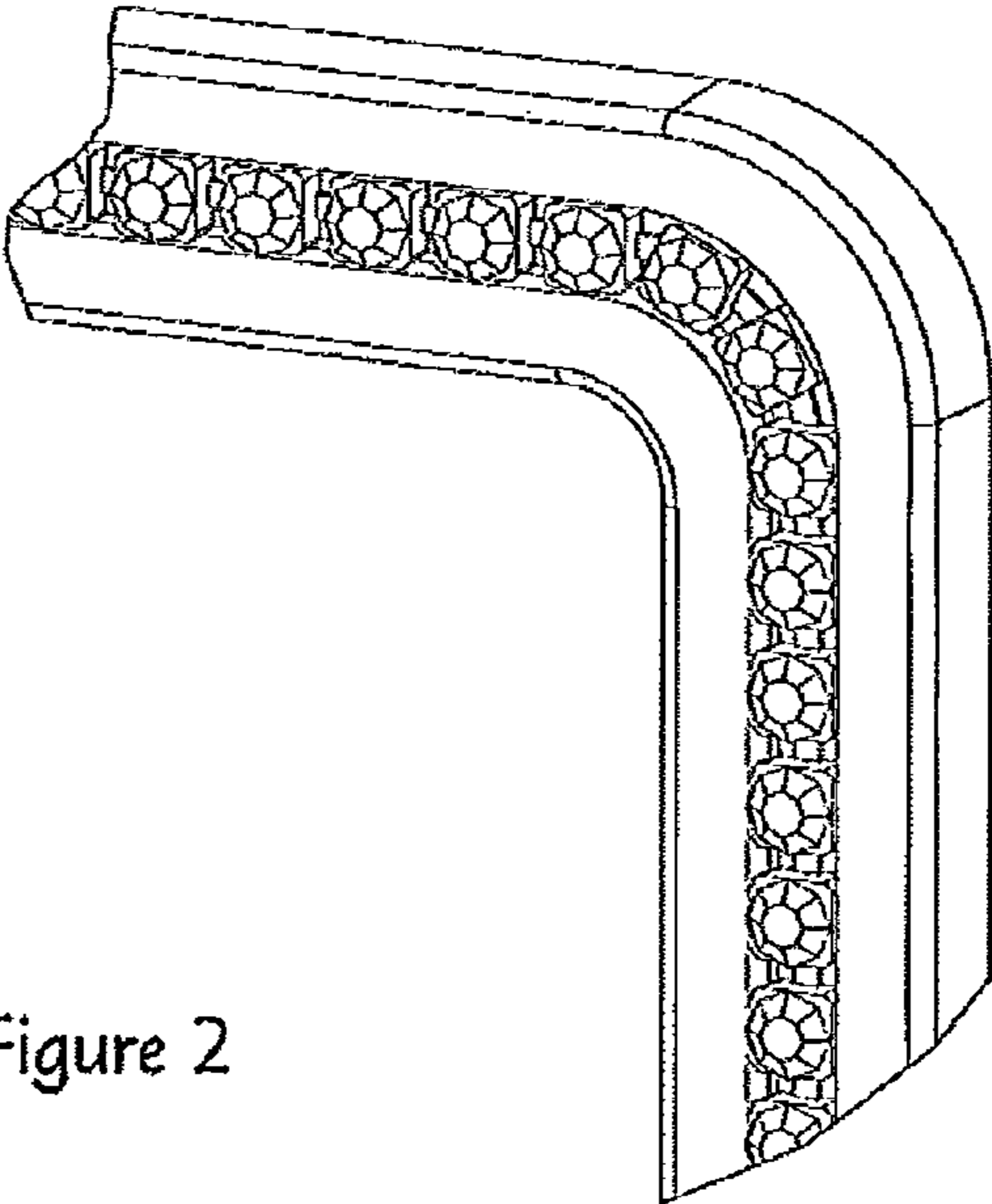

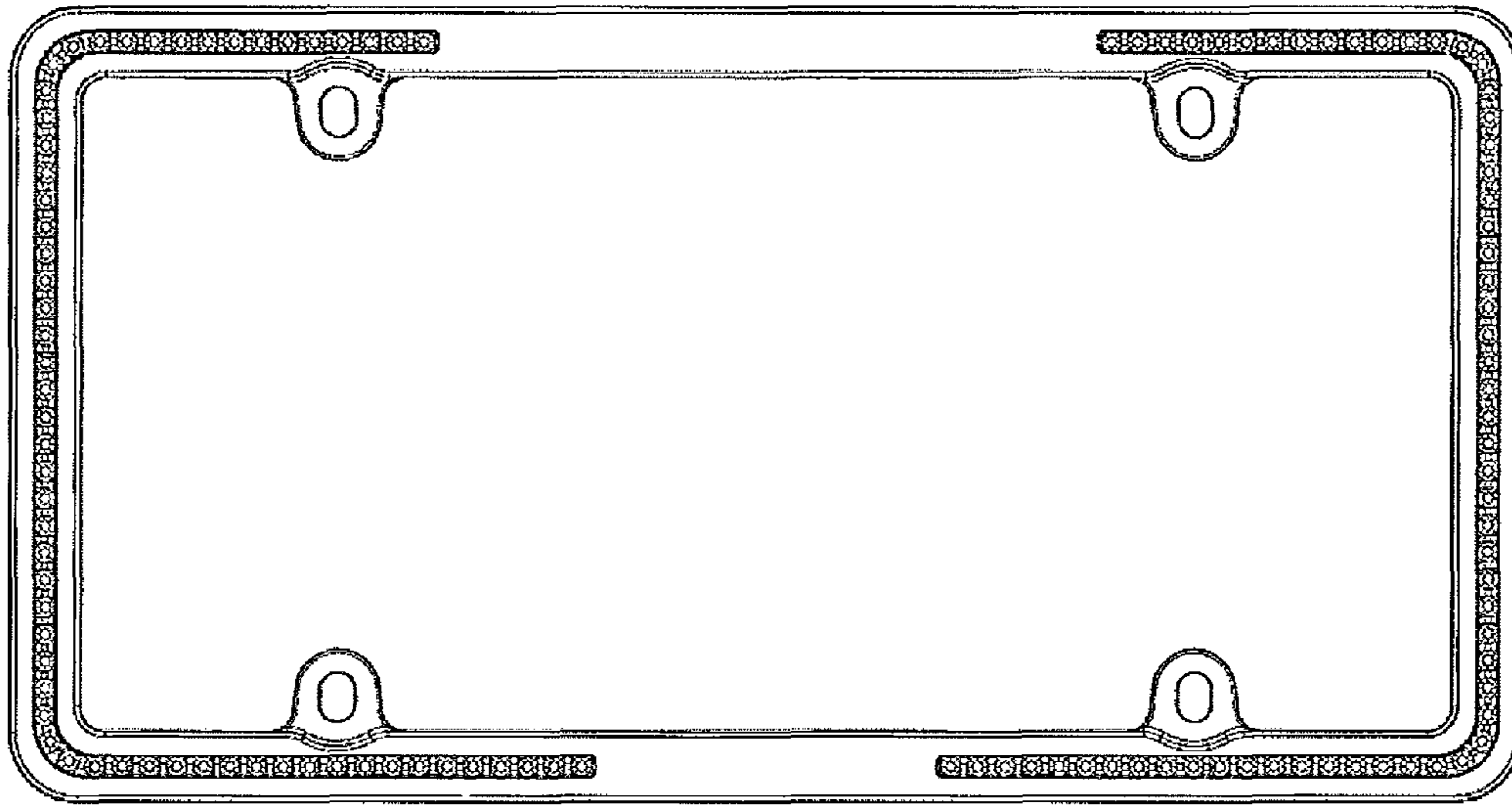

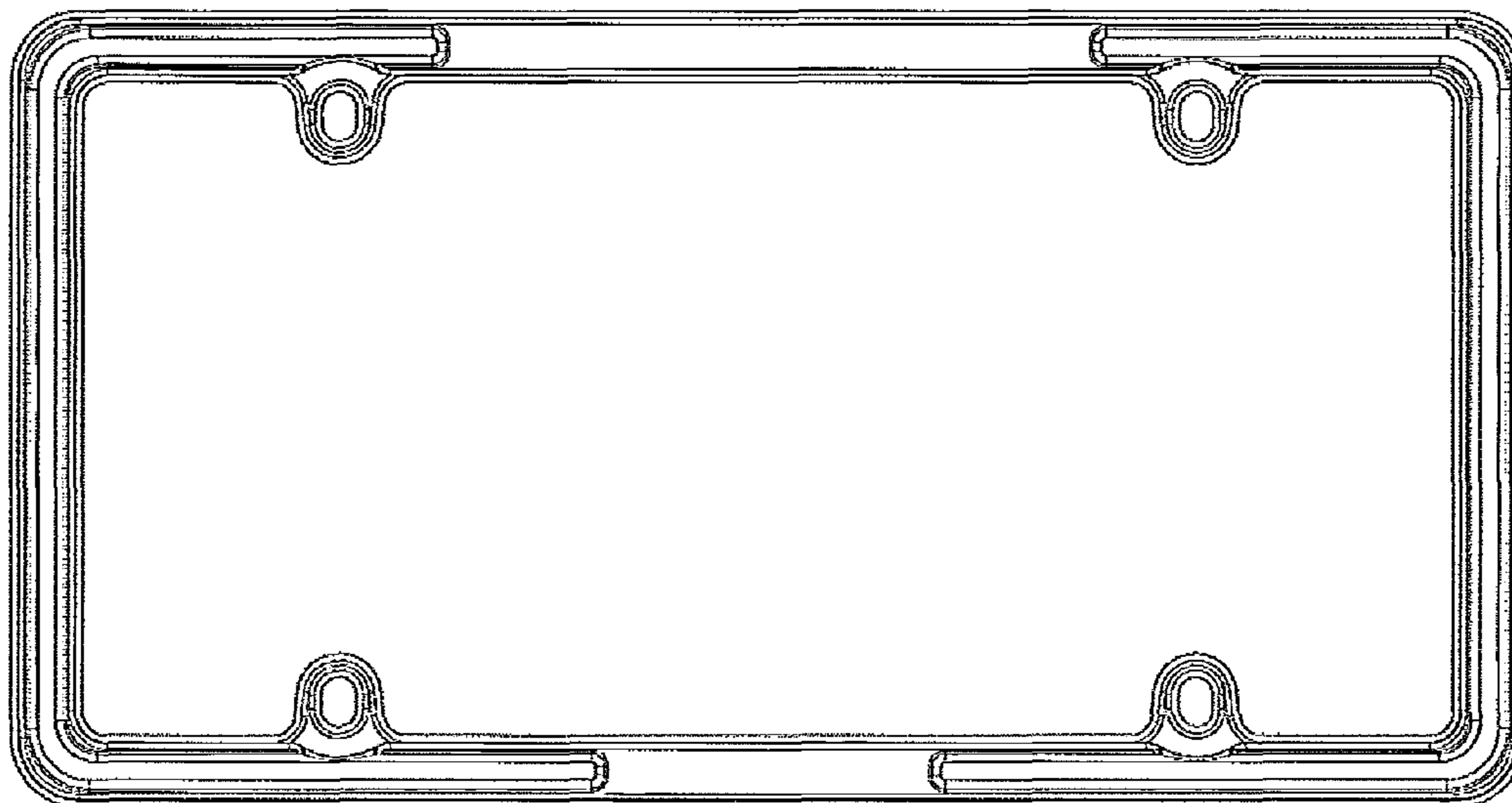

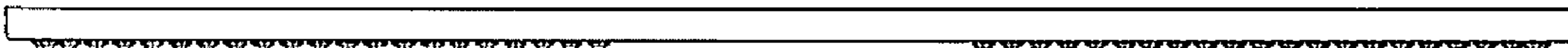

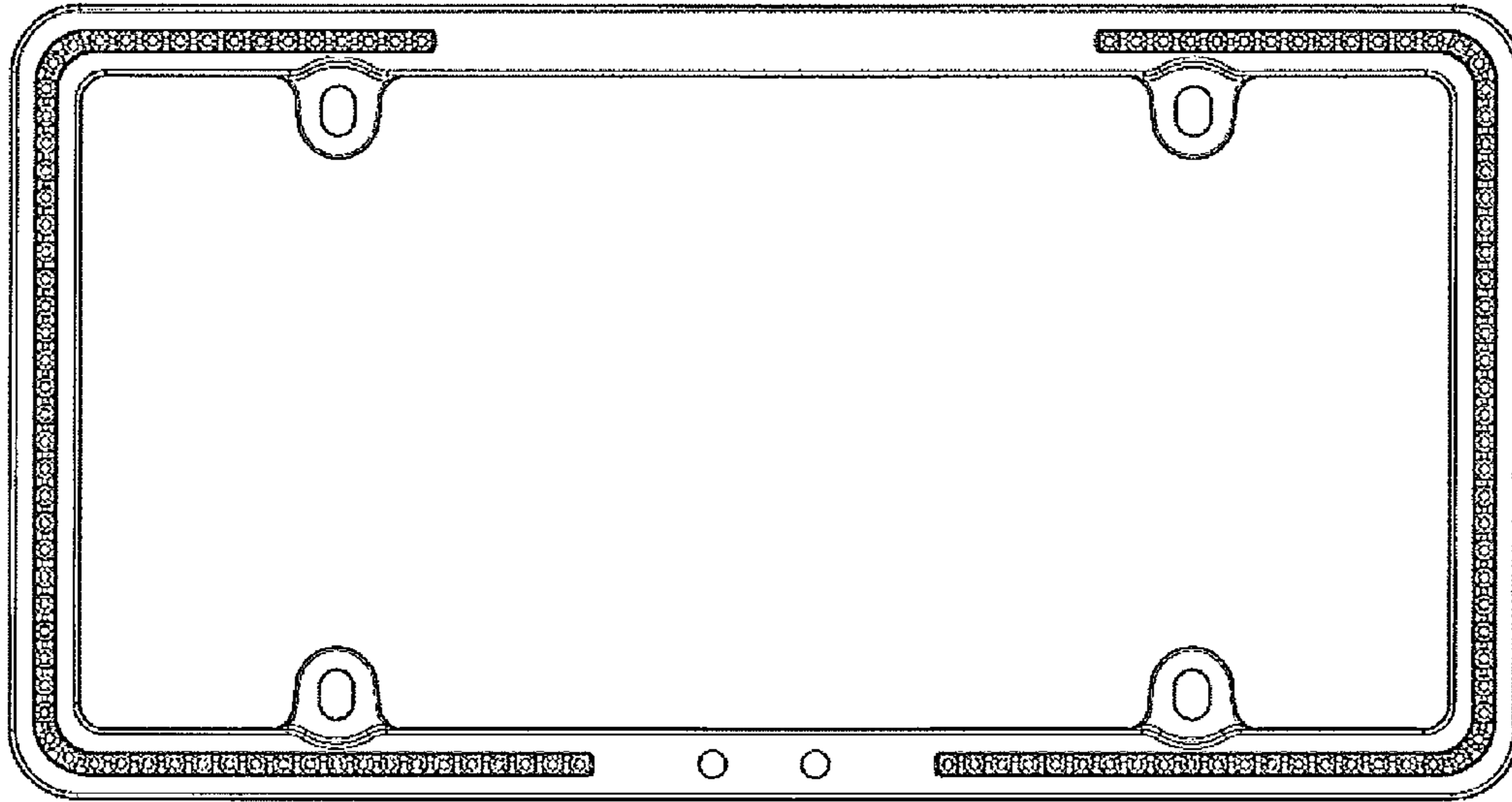

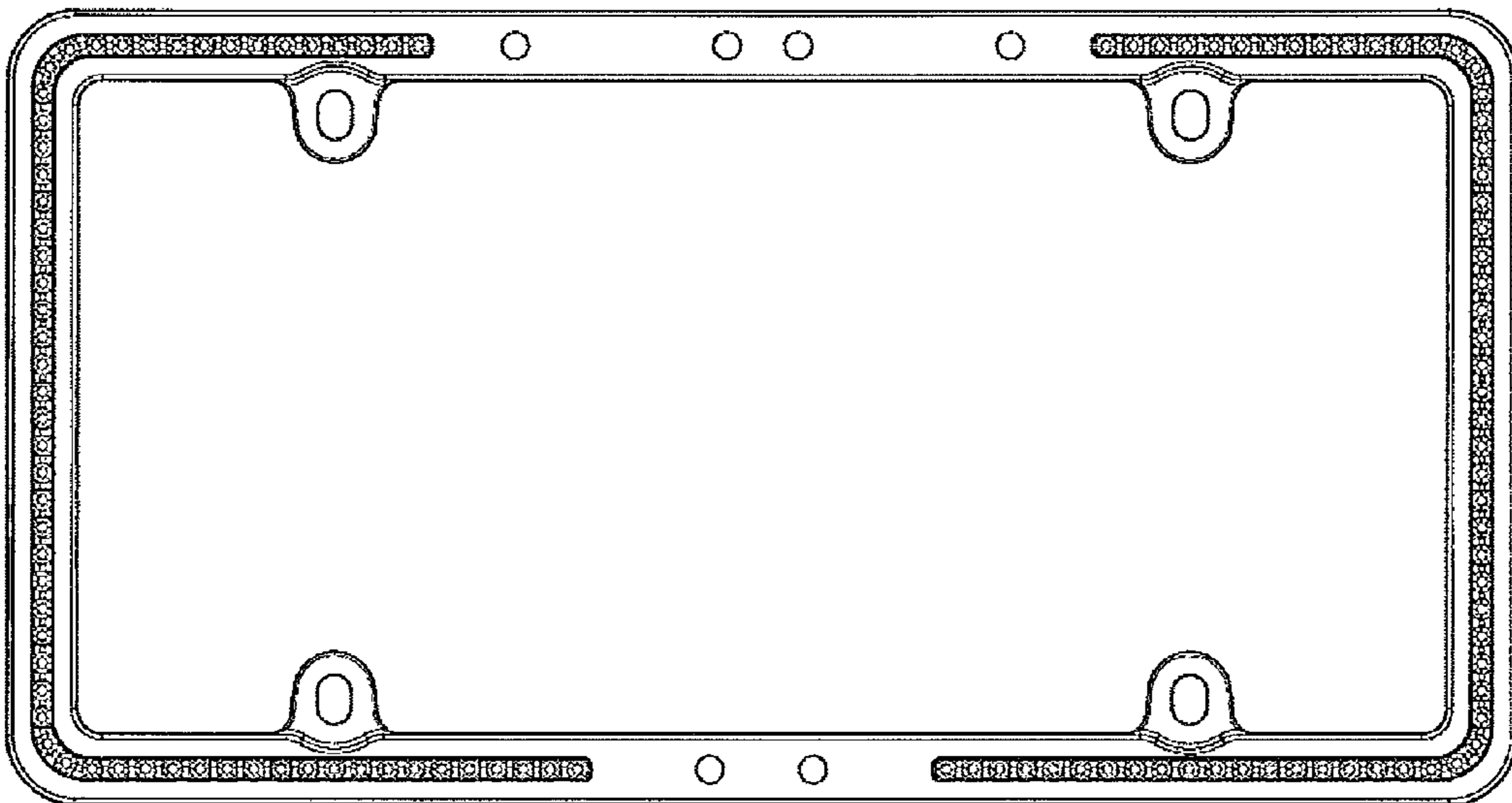
