DESCRIPTION

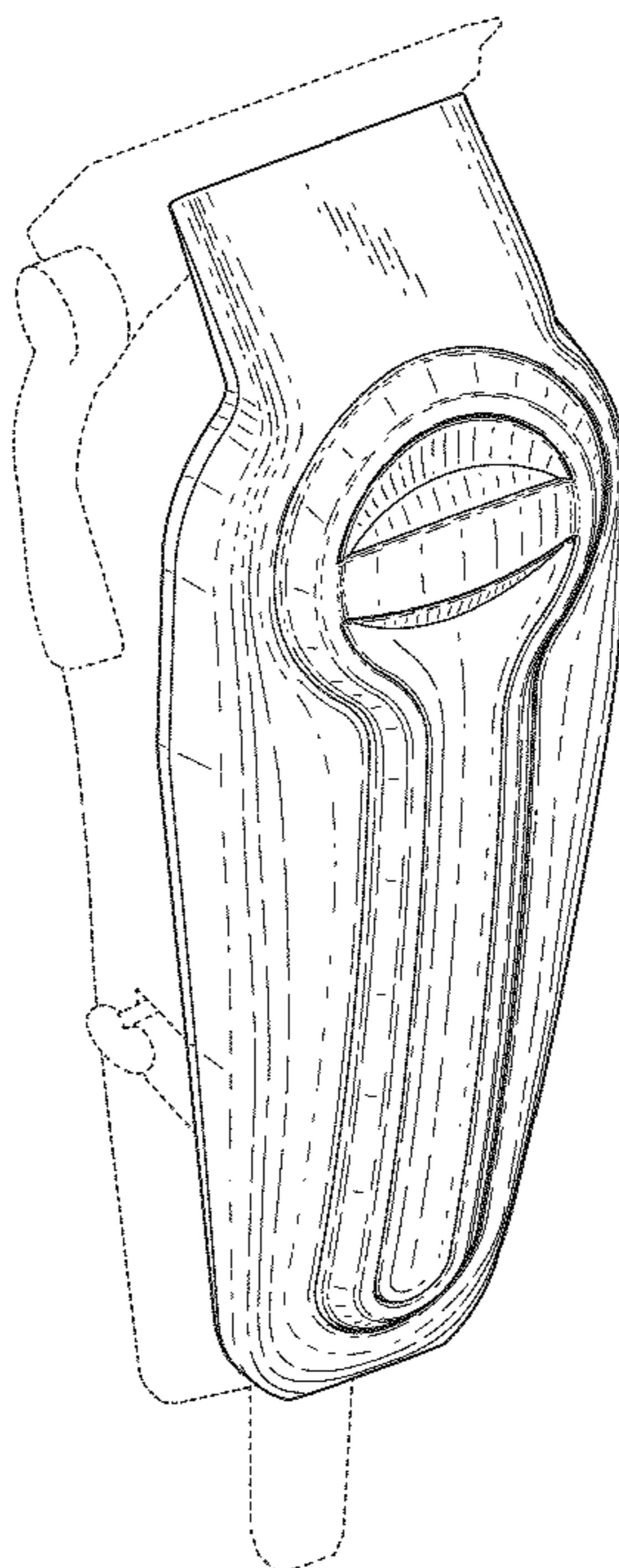
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the present hair clipper housing lid;

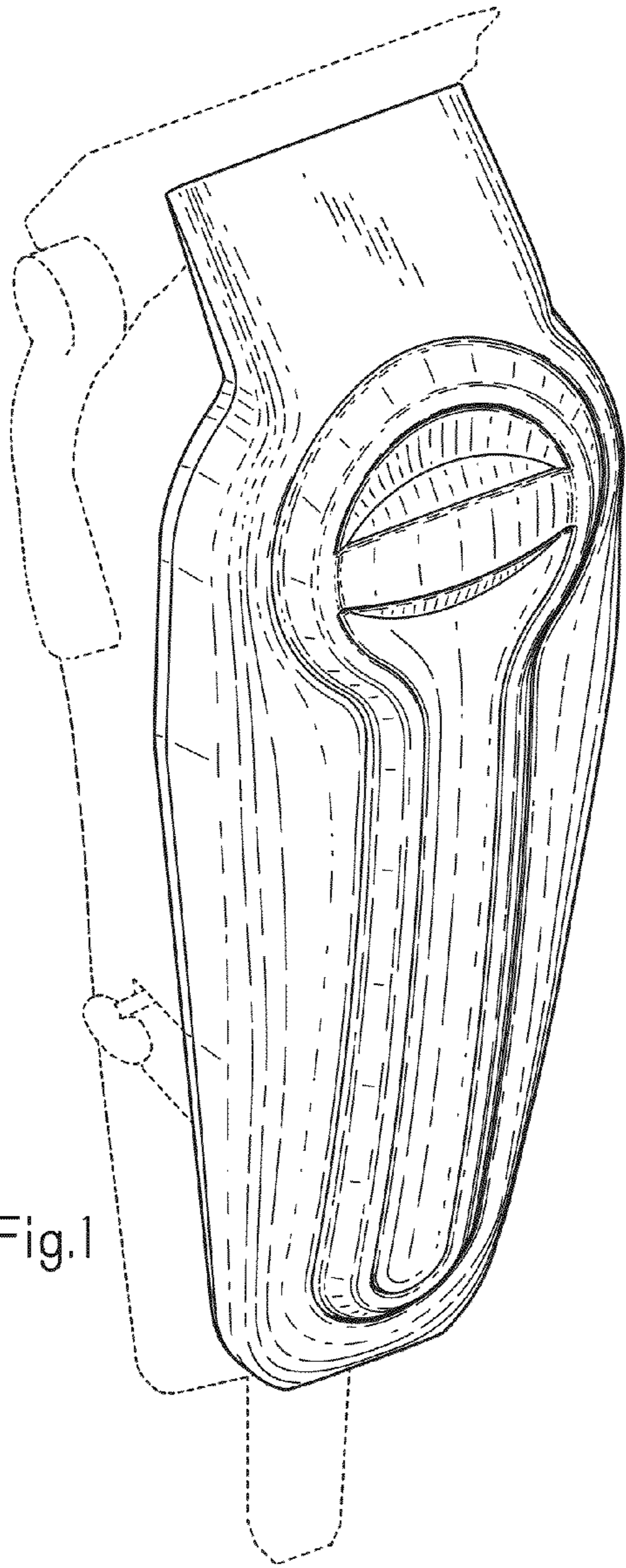

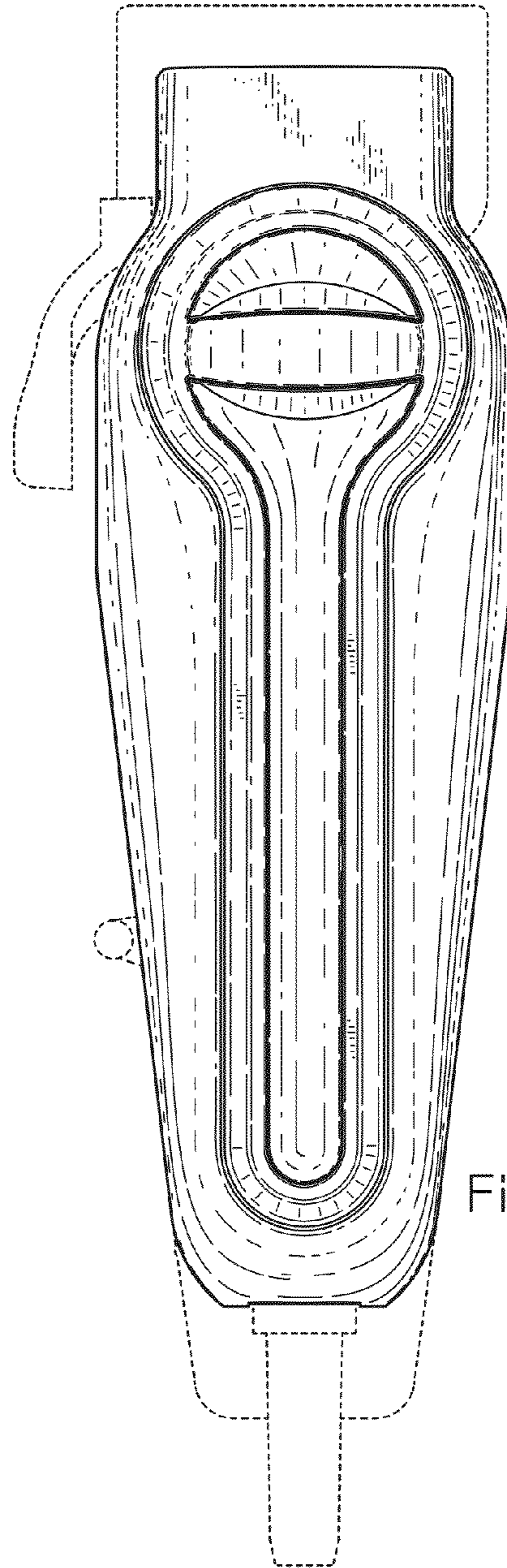
