FIG. 11 is a front side view thereof;

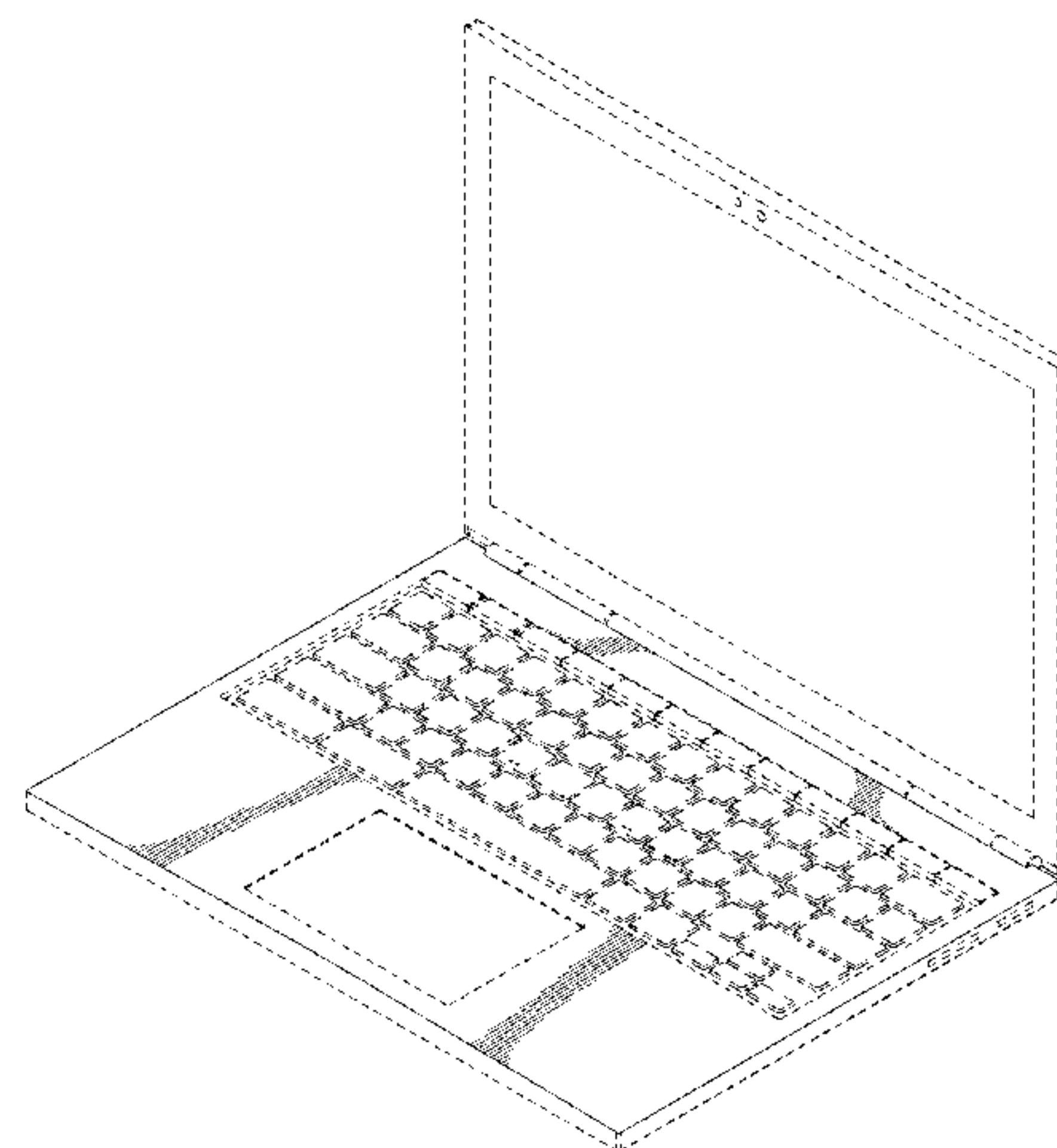
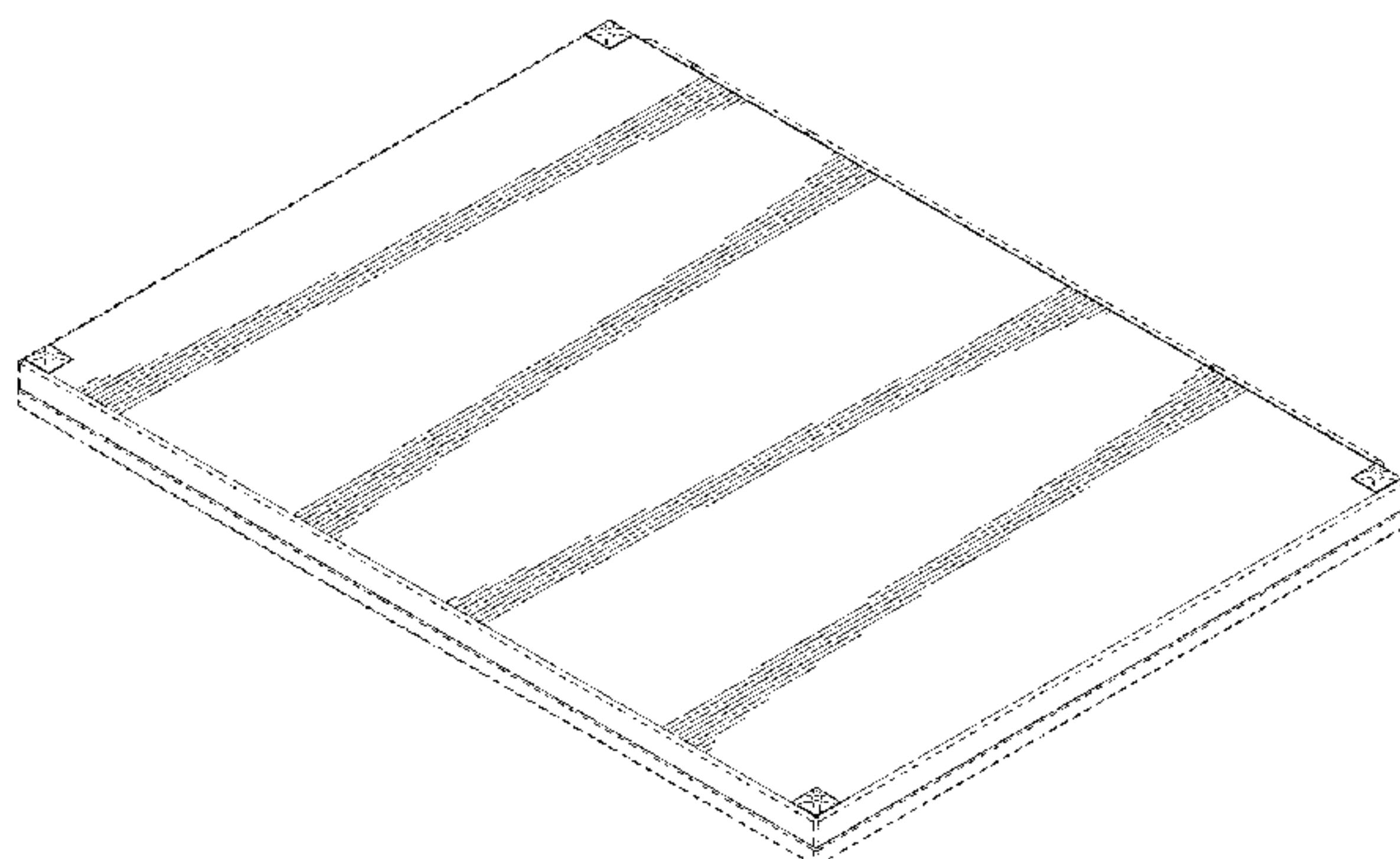
FIG. 12 is a back side view thereof;

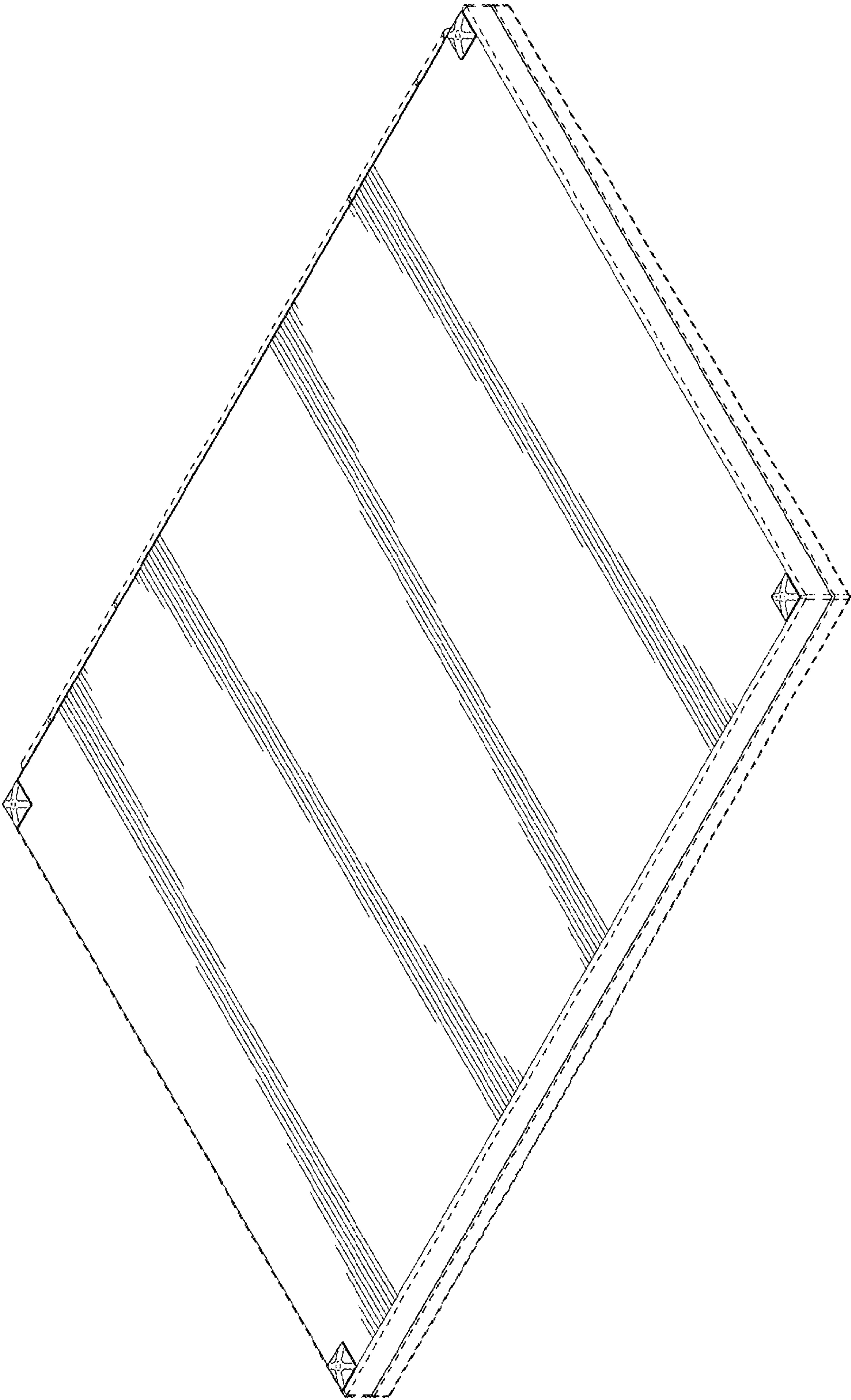

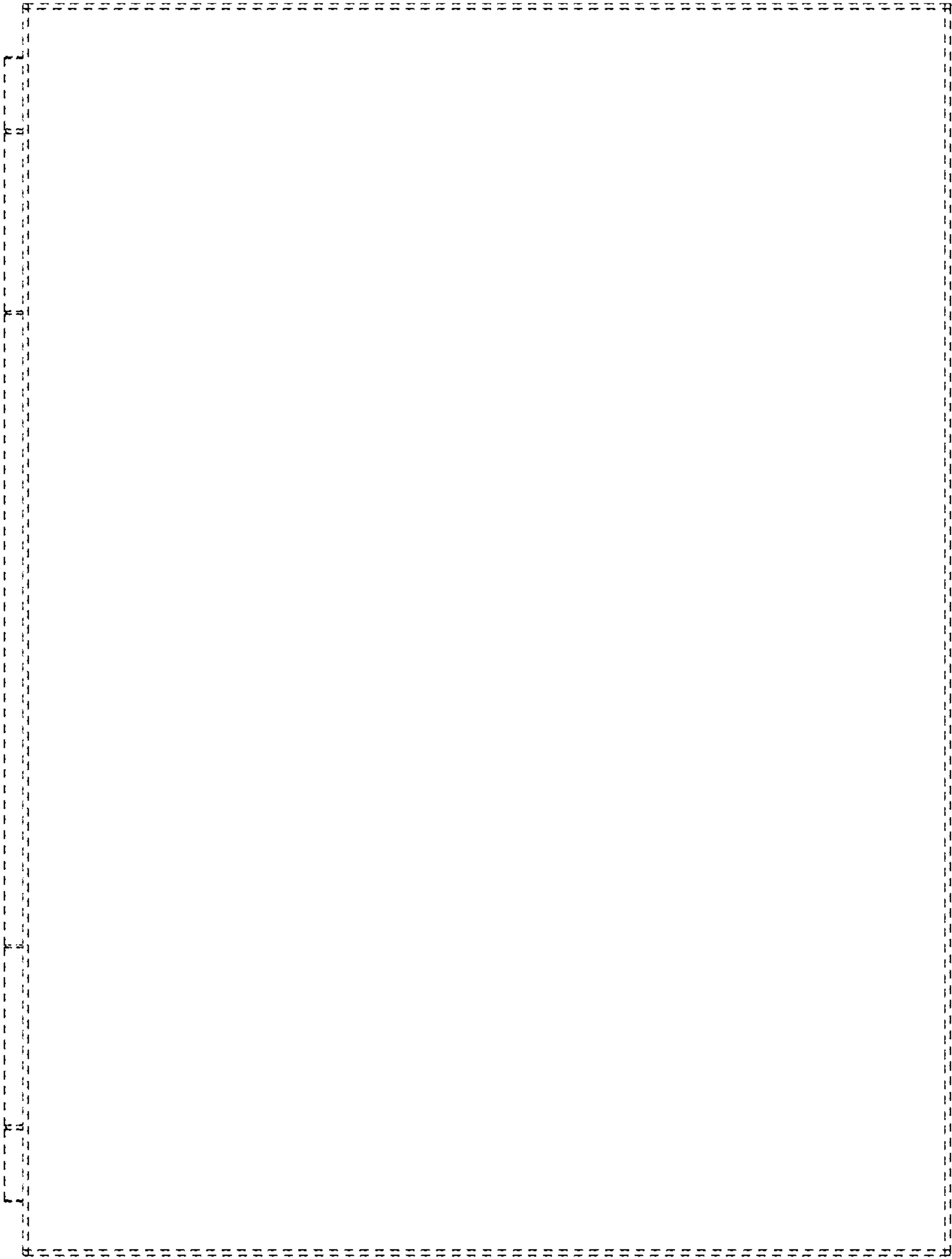

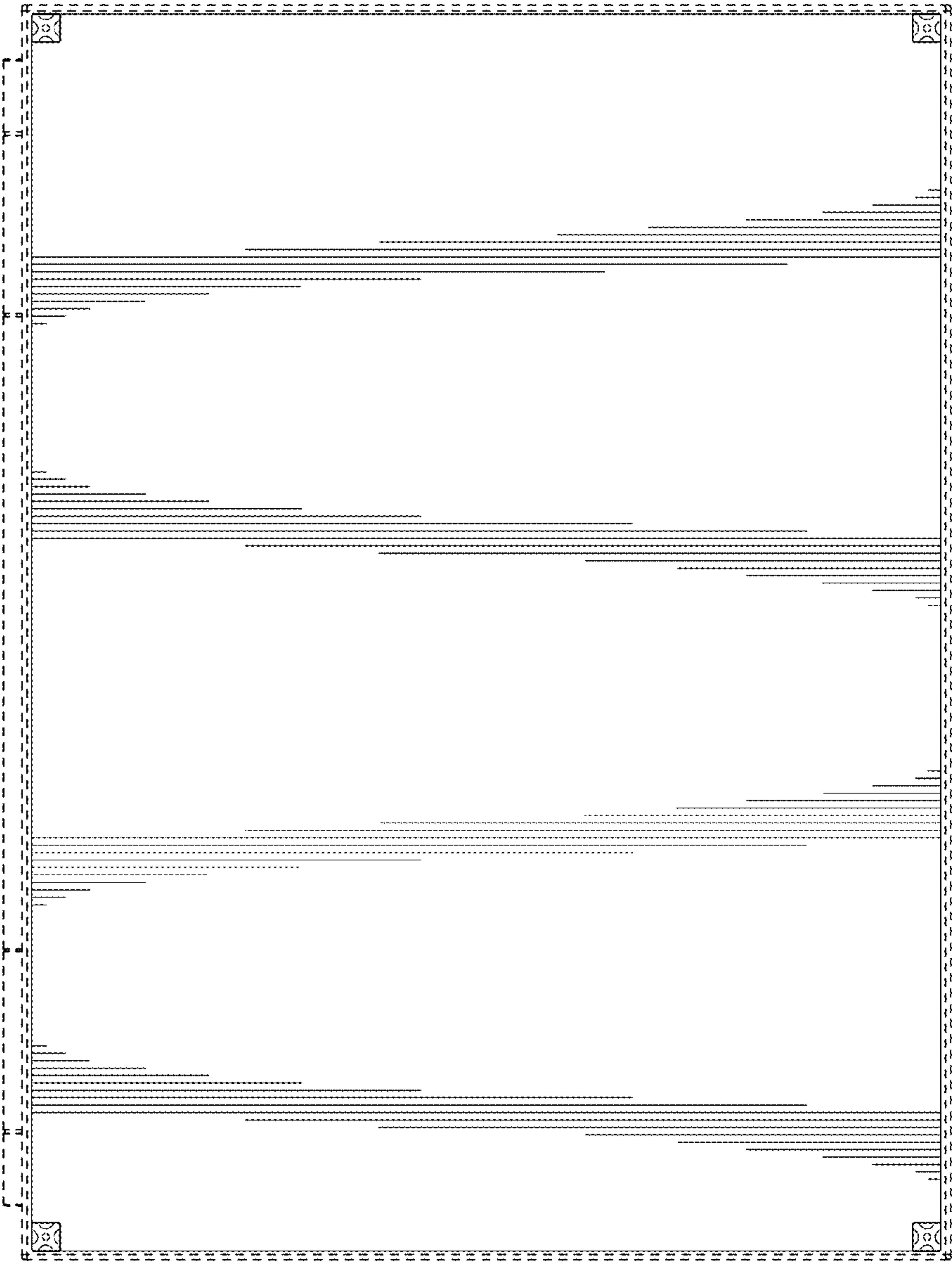

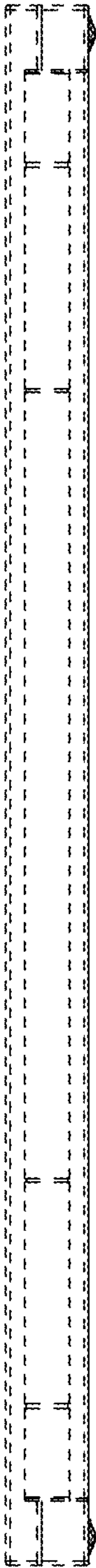

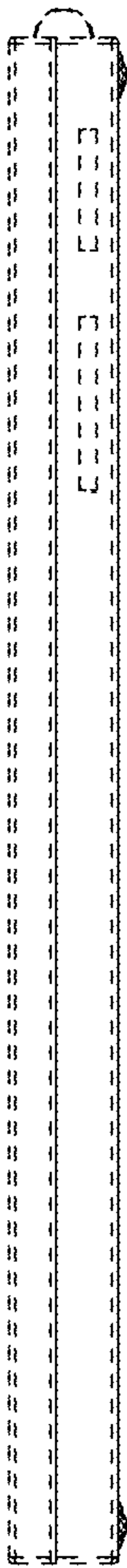
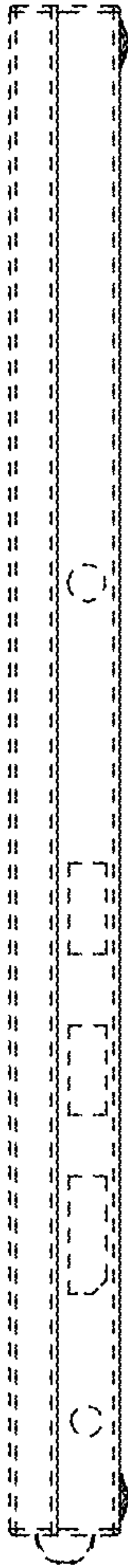

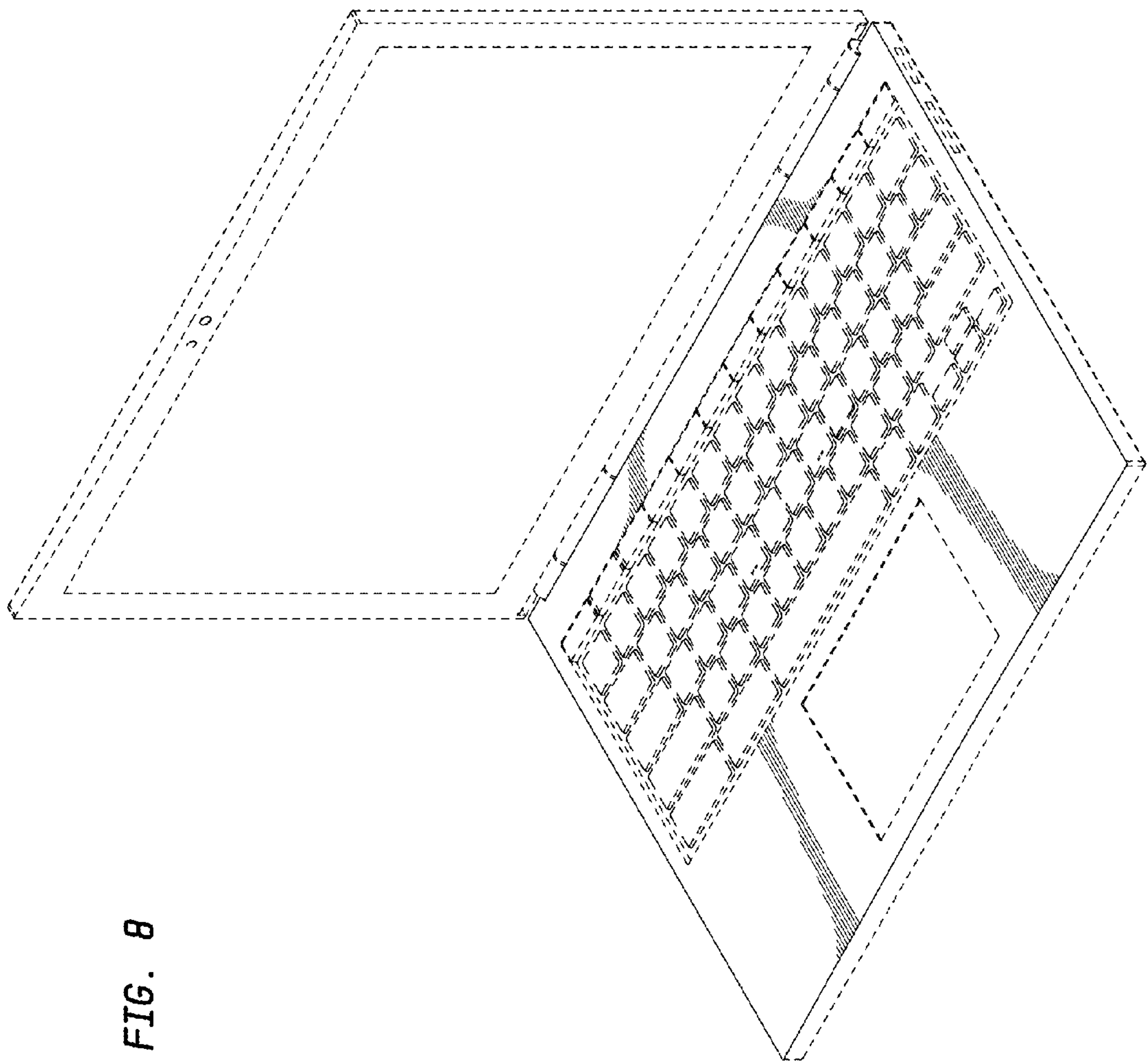

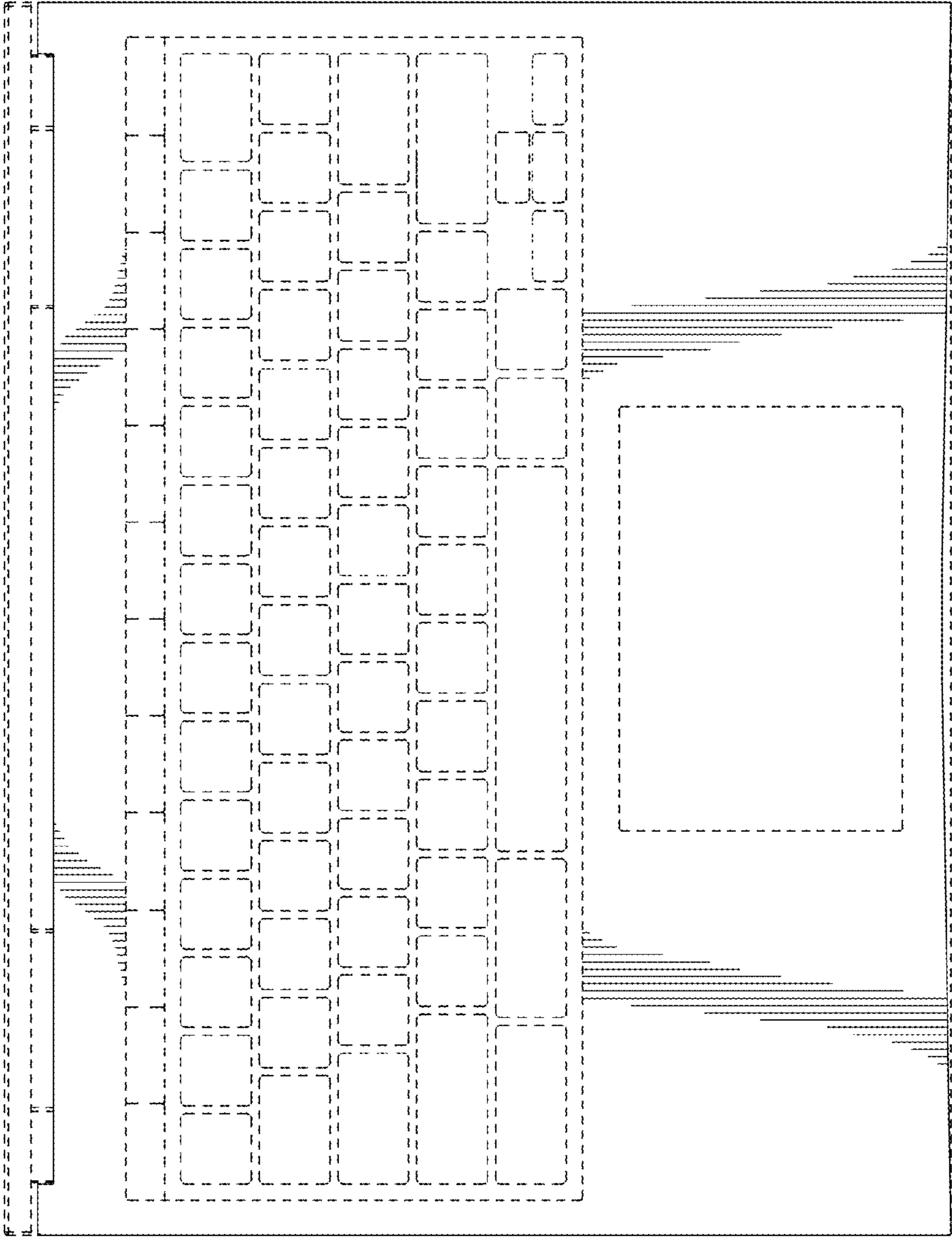

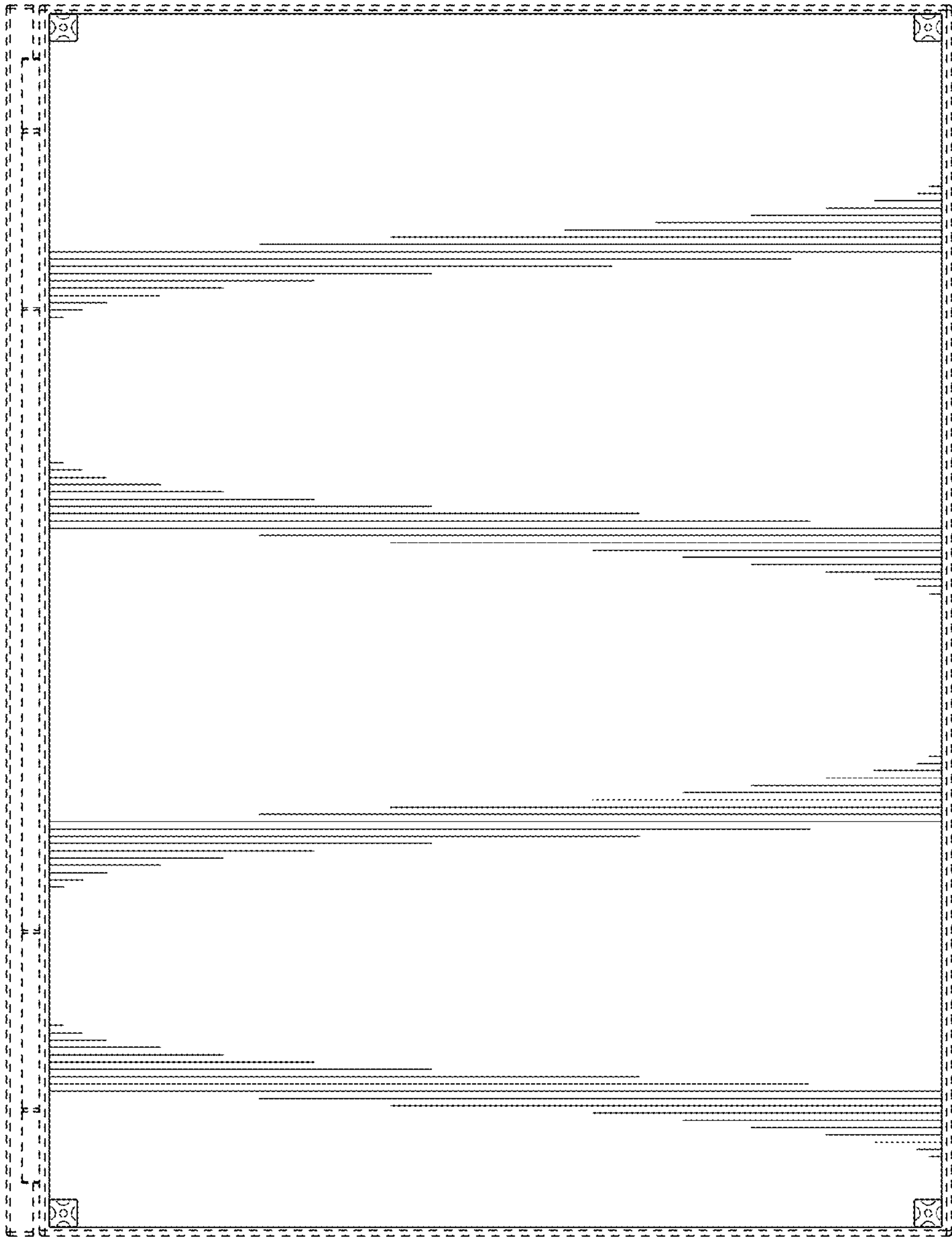

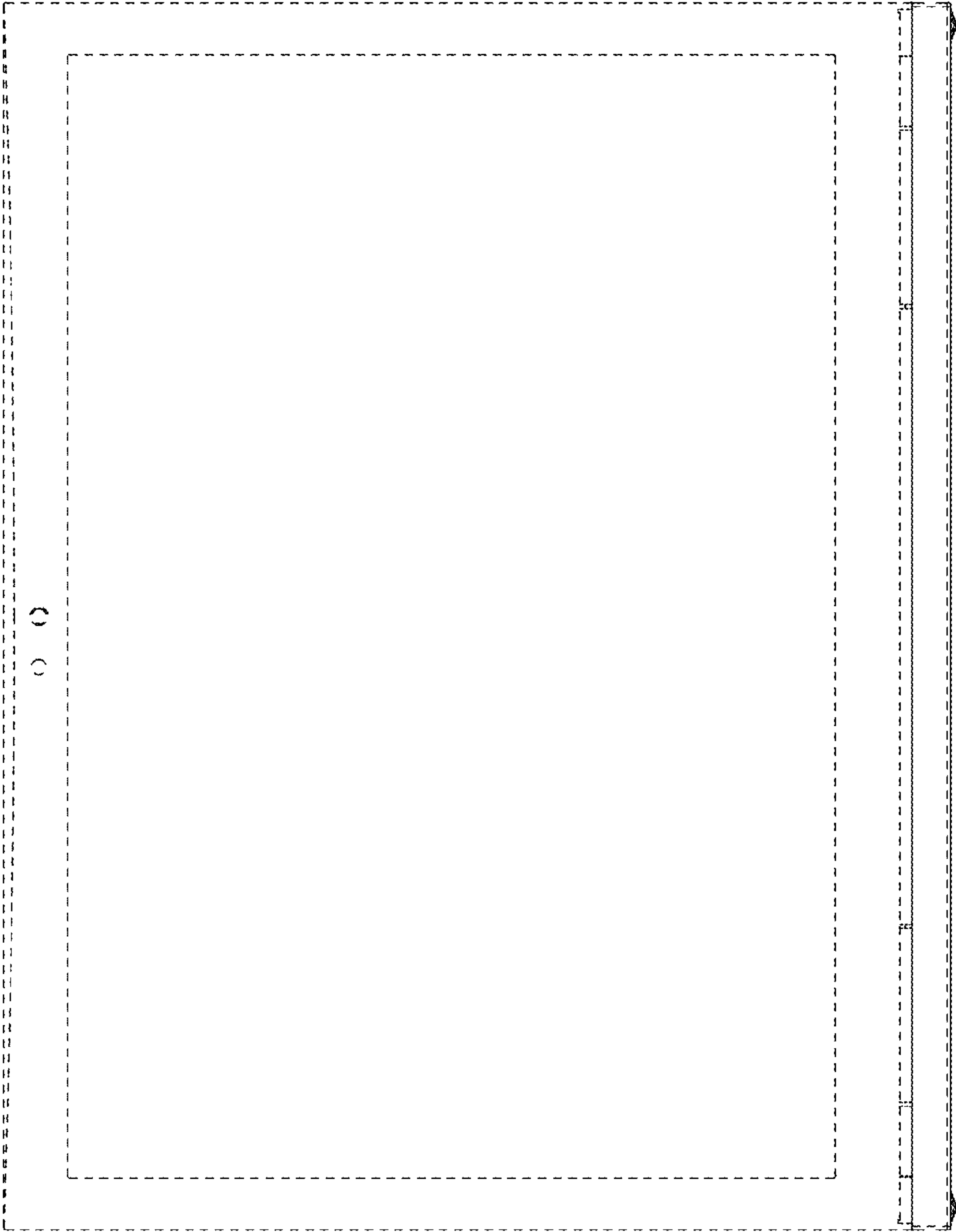

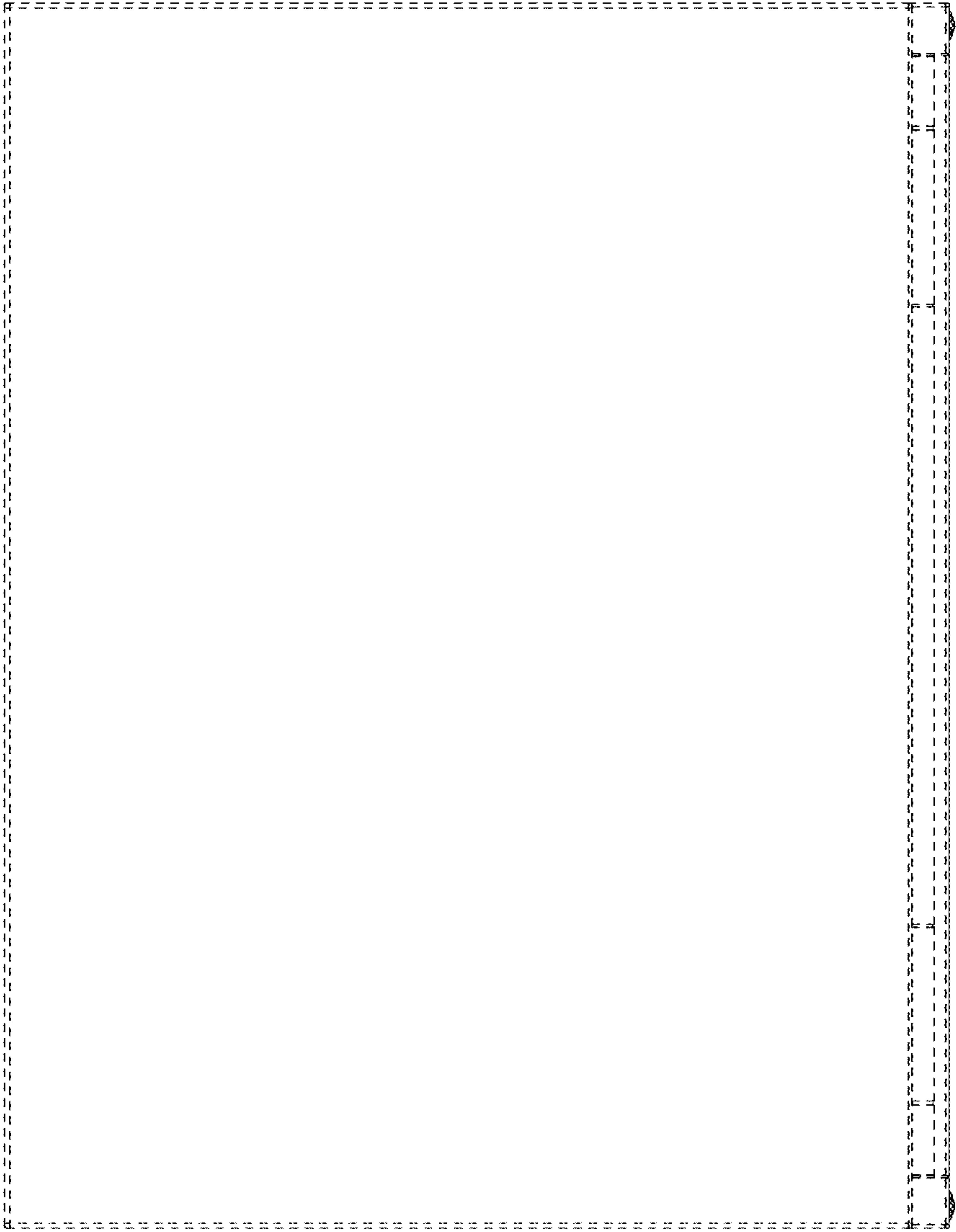

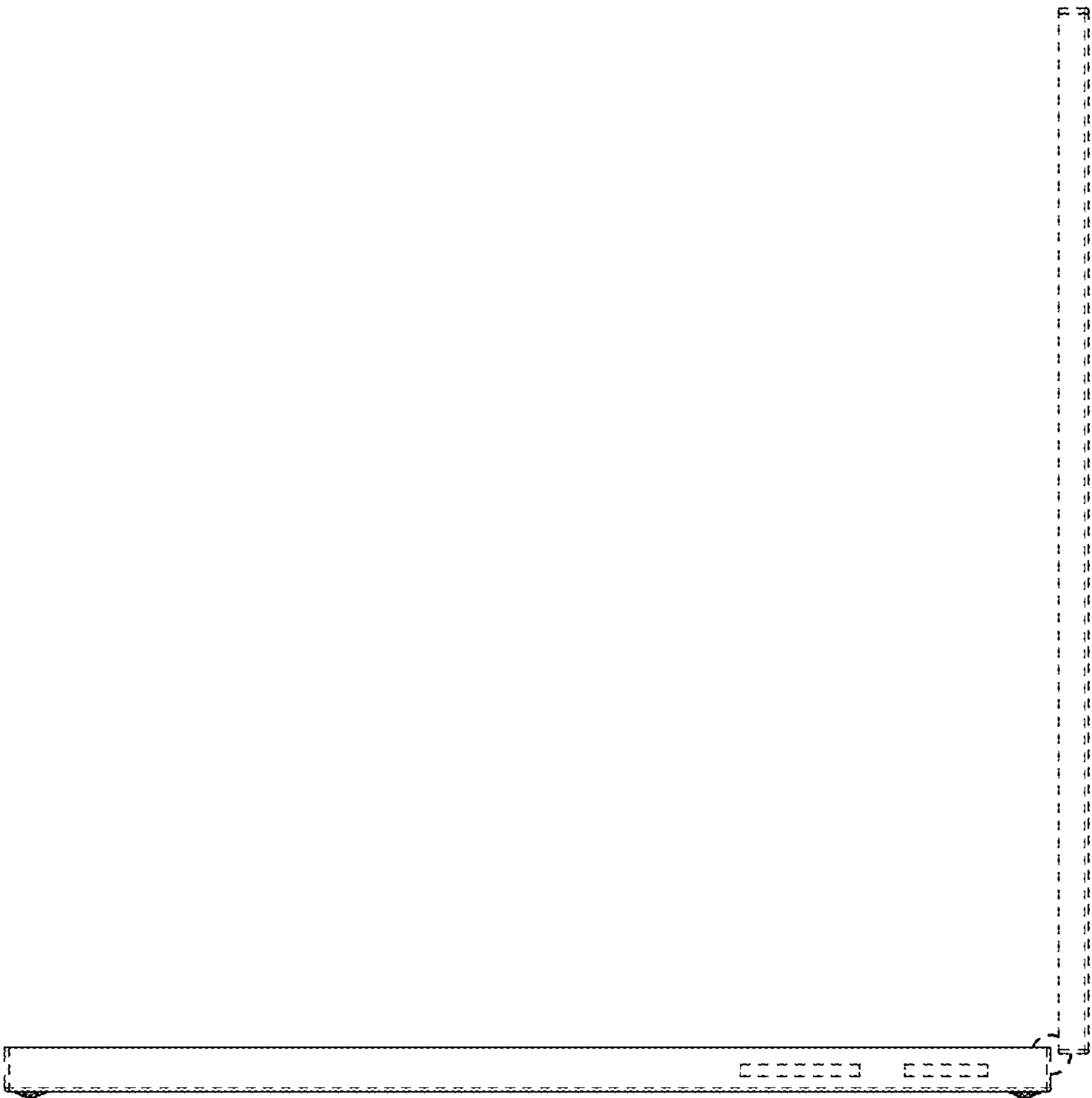
