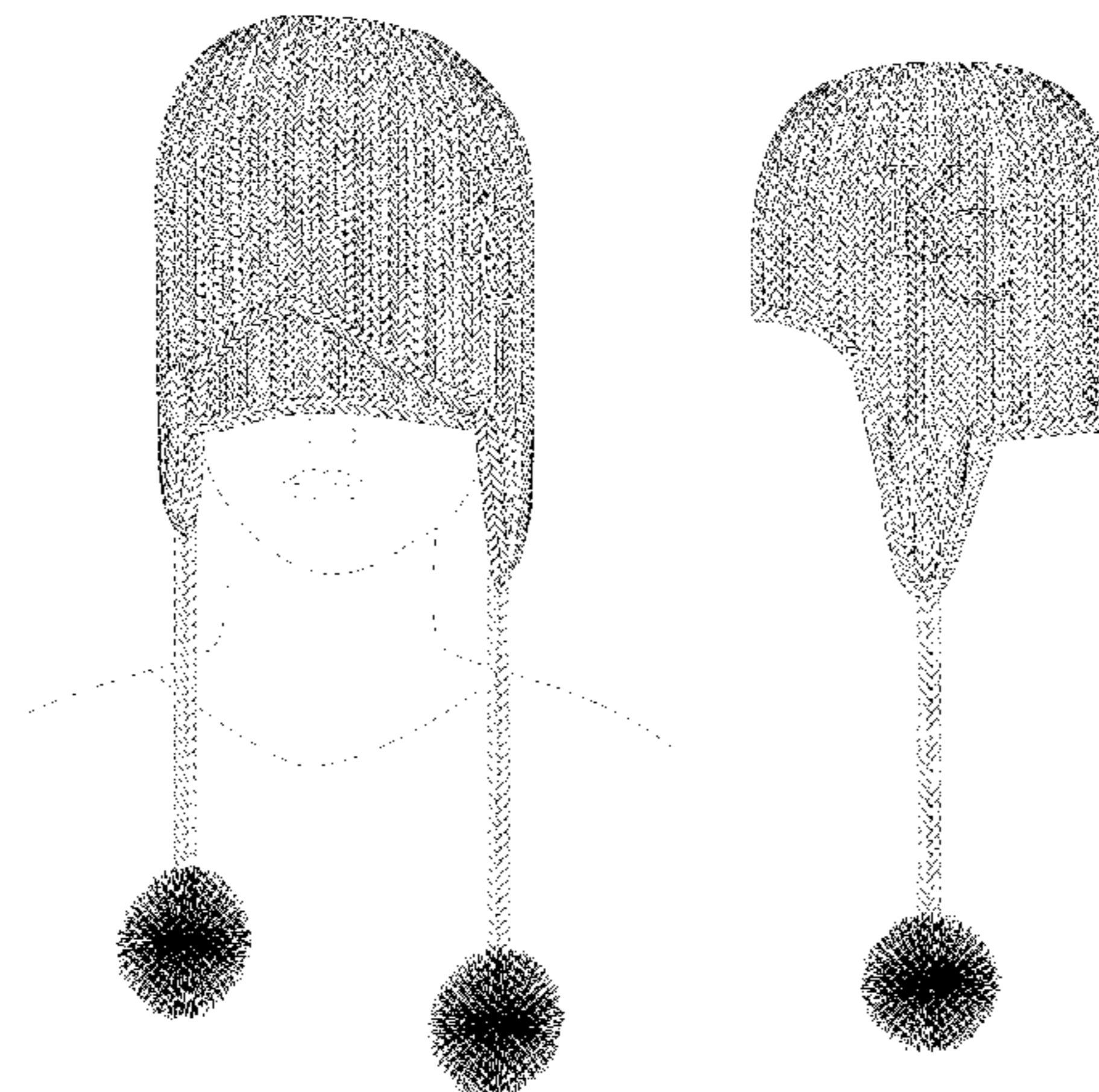
(57) **CLAIM**
I claim the ornamental design for a helmet-shaped knit hat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a helmet-shaped knit hat, showing a first embodiment of my new design;
FIG. 2 is a showing of exemplary broken line subject matter, namely team logo for “Chiefs”, shown in FIGS. 4, 6 and 7, and in partial perspective in FIGS. 1, 4, 5 and 8;
FIG. 3 is a showing of exemplary broken line subject matter, namely team name and player number for “Chiefs”, in FIG. 5, and in partial perspective in FIGS. 6 and 7;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the design as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the design as shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view of the design as shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a left-side elevational view of the design as shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 8 is a top plan view of the design as shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the design as shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 10 is a perspective view of a second embodiment thereof;
FIG. 11 is a showing of exemplary broken line subject matter, namely team logo for “Cowboys”, shown in FIGS. 15 and 16, and in partial perspective in FIGS. 10, 13, 14, and 17;
FIG. 12 is a showing of exemplary broken line subject matter, namely team name and player number for “Cowboys”, in FIG. 14, and in partial perspective in FIGS. 15 and 16;
FIG. 13 is a front elevational view of the design as shown in FIG. 10;
FIG. 14 is a rear elevational view of the design as shown in FIG. 10;
FIG. 15 is a right-side elevational view of the design as shown in FIG. 10;
FIG. 16 is a left-side elevational view of the design as shown in FIG. 10;
FIG. 17 is a top plan view of the design as shown in FIG. 10;
FIG. 18 is an exemplary enlargement of the detail of FIG. 17 taken along the line 18-18;
FIG. 19 is a perspective view of a third embodiment thereof;
FIG. 20 is a showing of exemplary broken line subject matter, namely team logo for “Colts”, shown in FIGS. 24 and 25, and in partial perspective in FIGS. 19, 22, 23 and 26;
FIG. 21 is a showing of exemplary broken line subject matter, namely team name and player number for “Colts”, in FIG. 23, and in partial perspective in FIGS. 24 and 25;
FIG. 22 is a front elevational view of the design as shown in FIG. 19;
FIG. 23 is a rear elevational view of the design as shown in FIG. 19;
FIG. 24 is a right-side elevational view of the design as shown in FIG. 19;
FIG. 25 is a left-side elevational view of the design as shown in FIG. 19;
FIG. 26 is a top plan view of the design as shown in FIG. 19; and,
FIG. 27 is an exemplary enlargement of the detail of FIG. 26 taken along the line 27-27.
The broken lines showing football team logos, team names, and player numbers in the figures as well as the human head and upper torso in FIGS. 1, 10 and 19, depict environmental matter that forms no part of the claimed design.

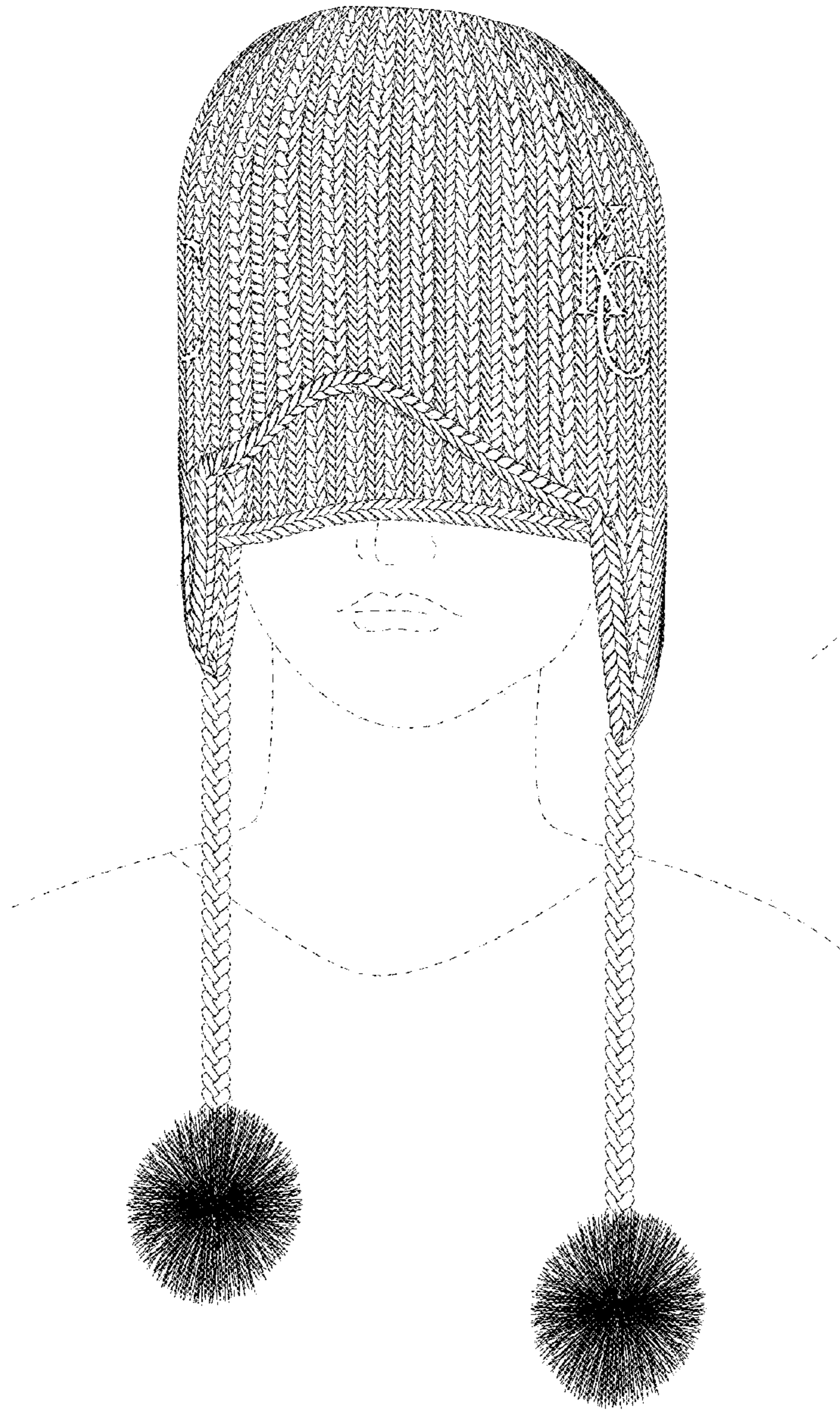

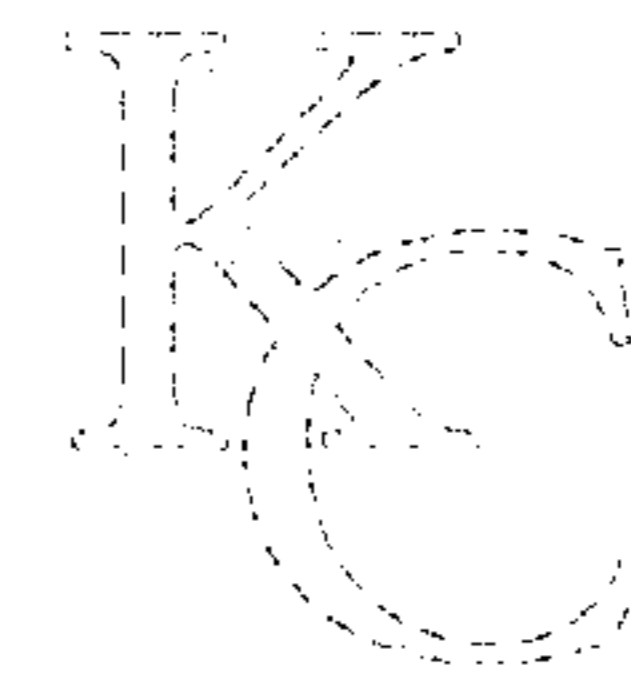

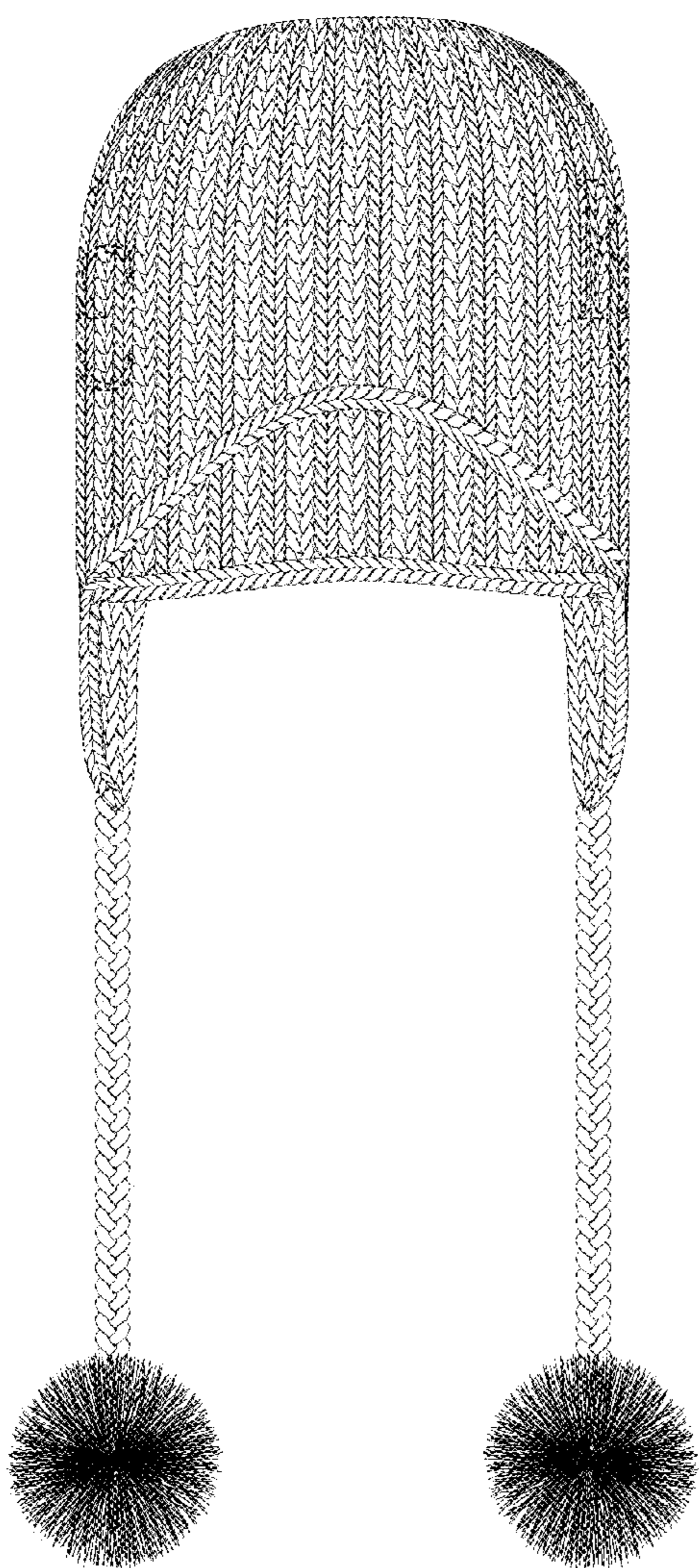

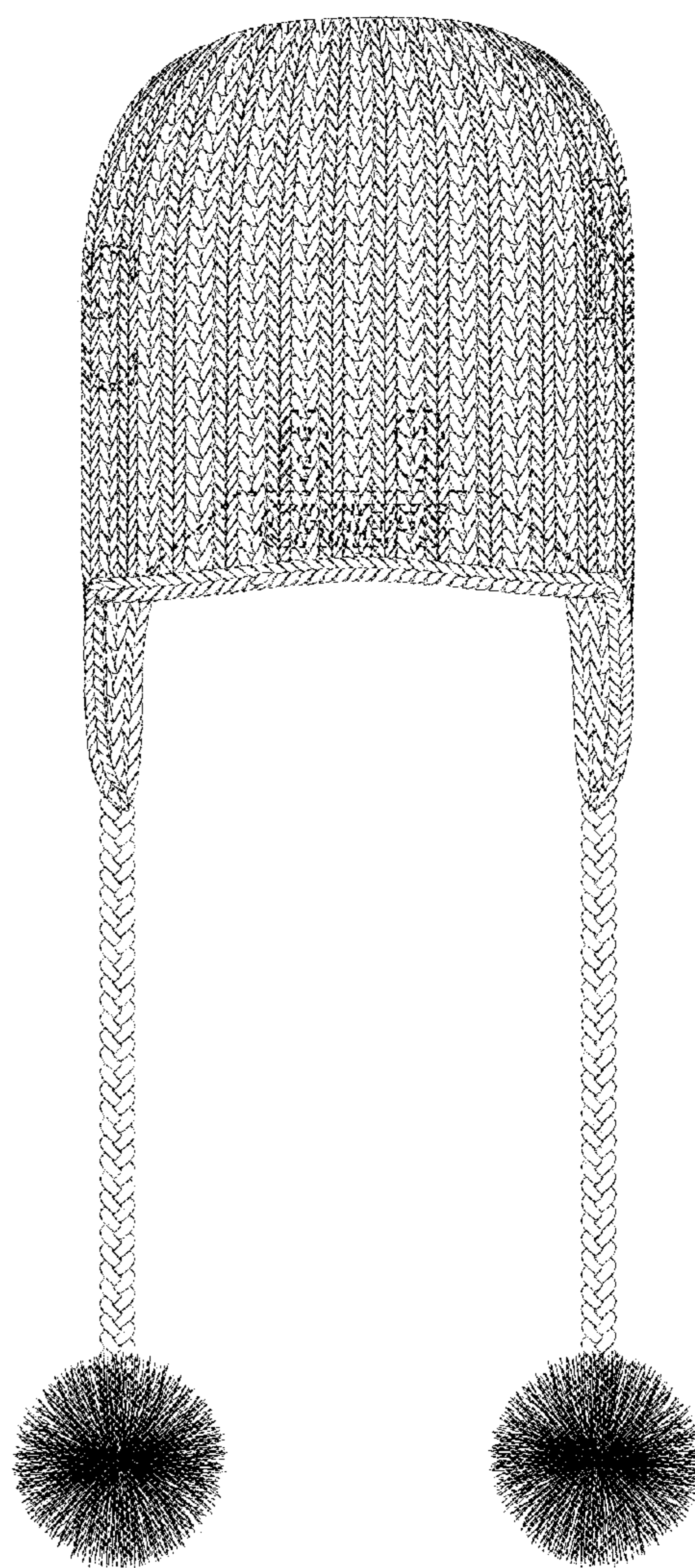

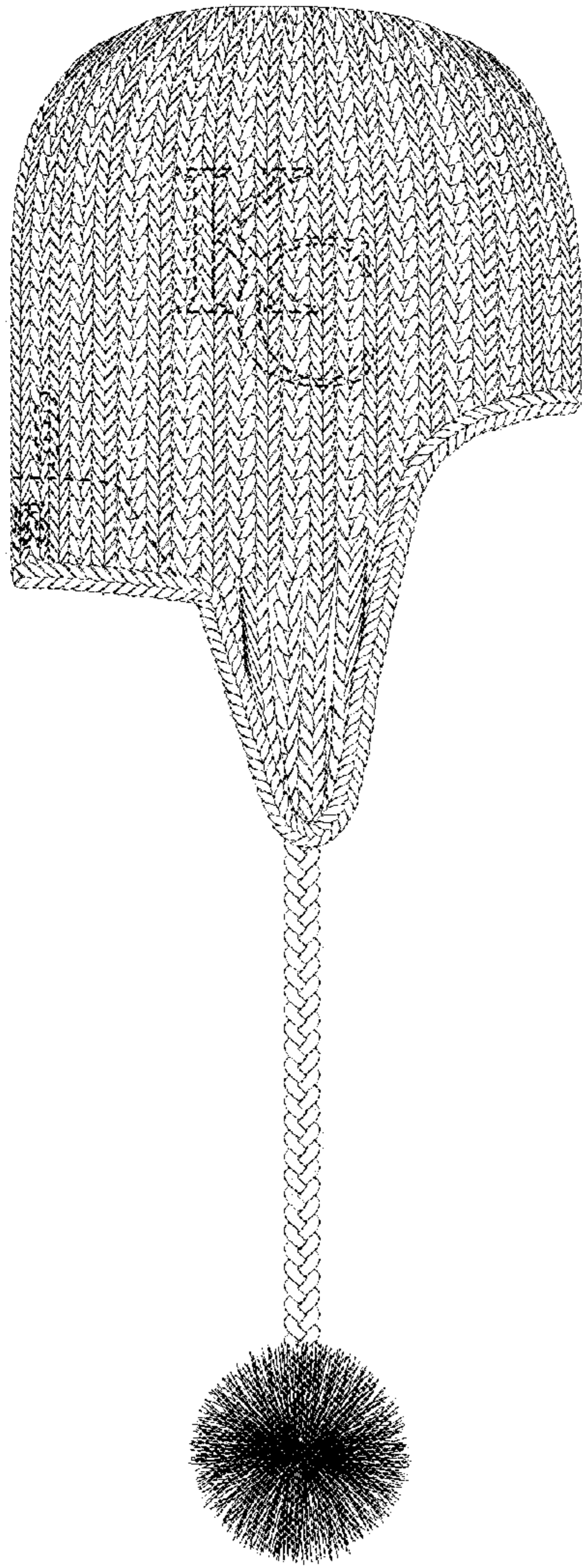

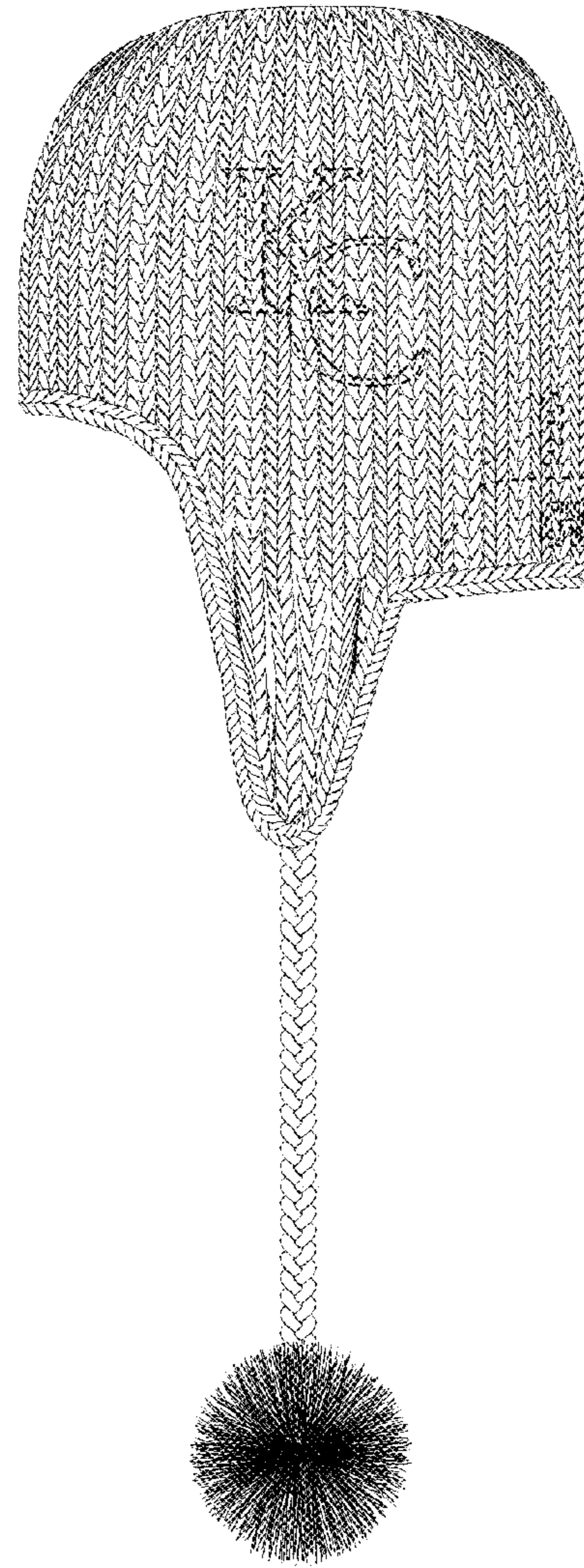

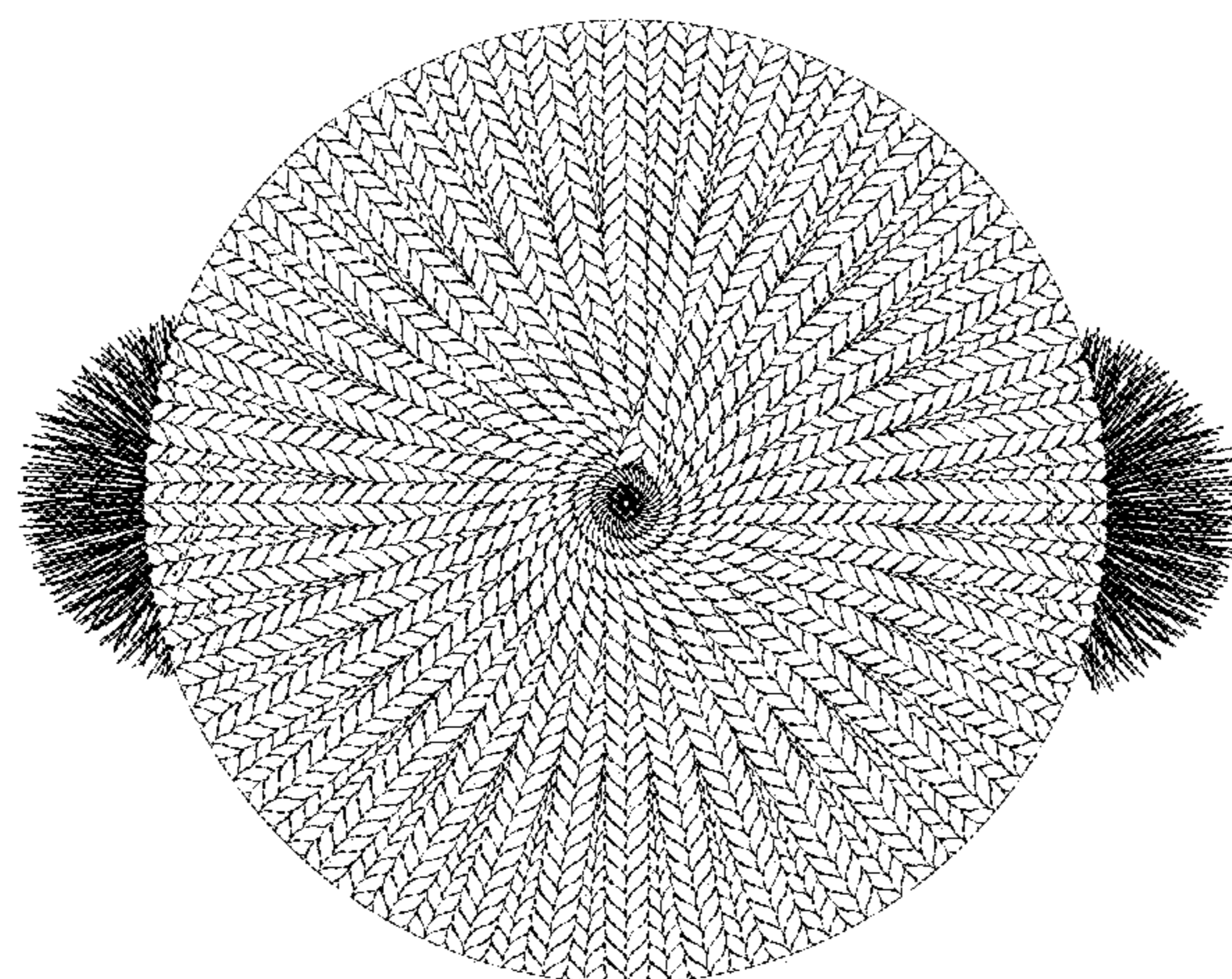

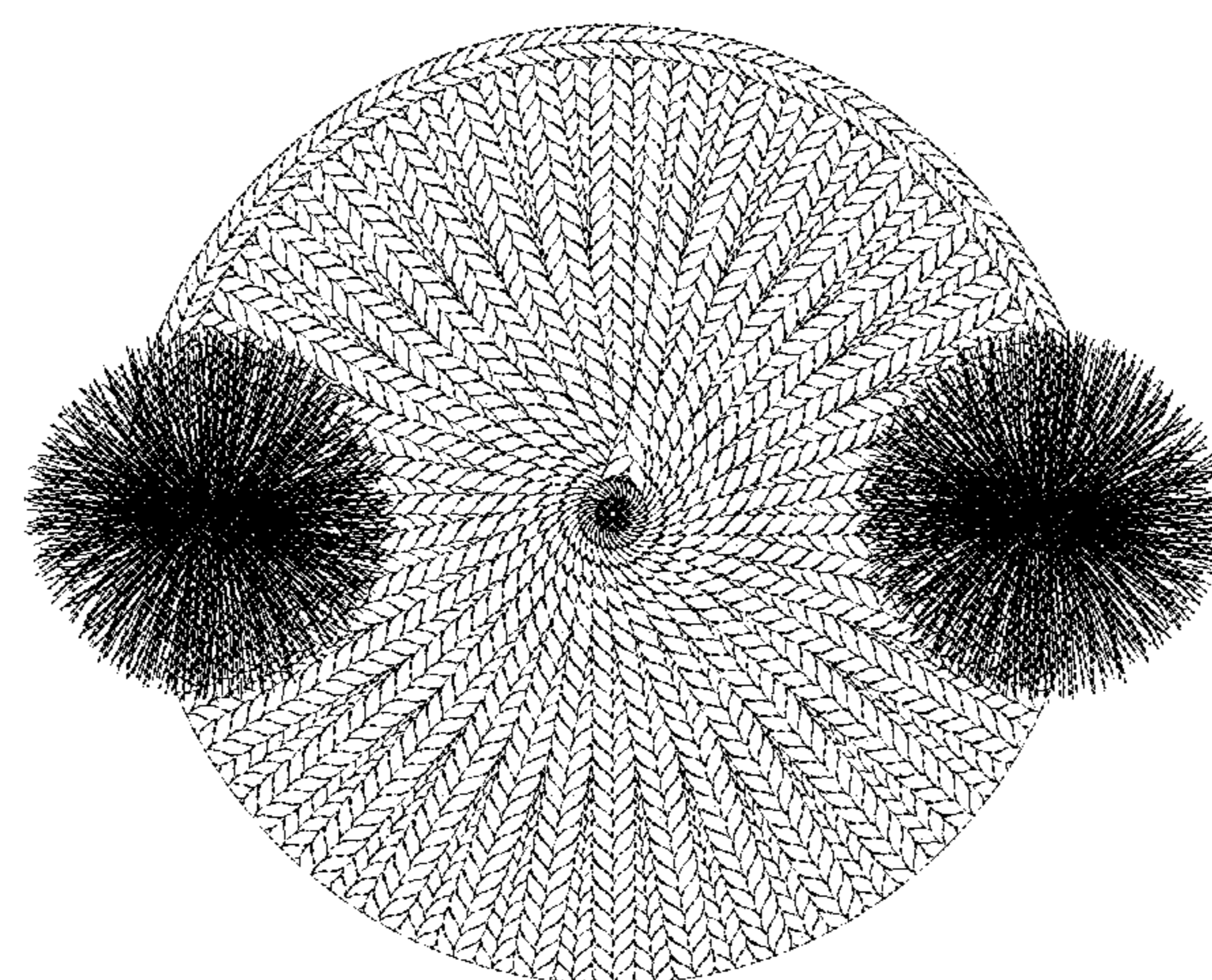

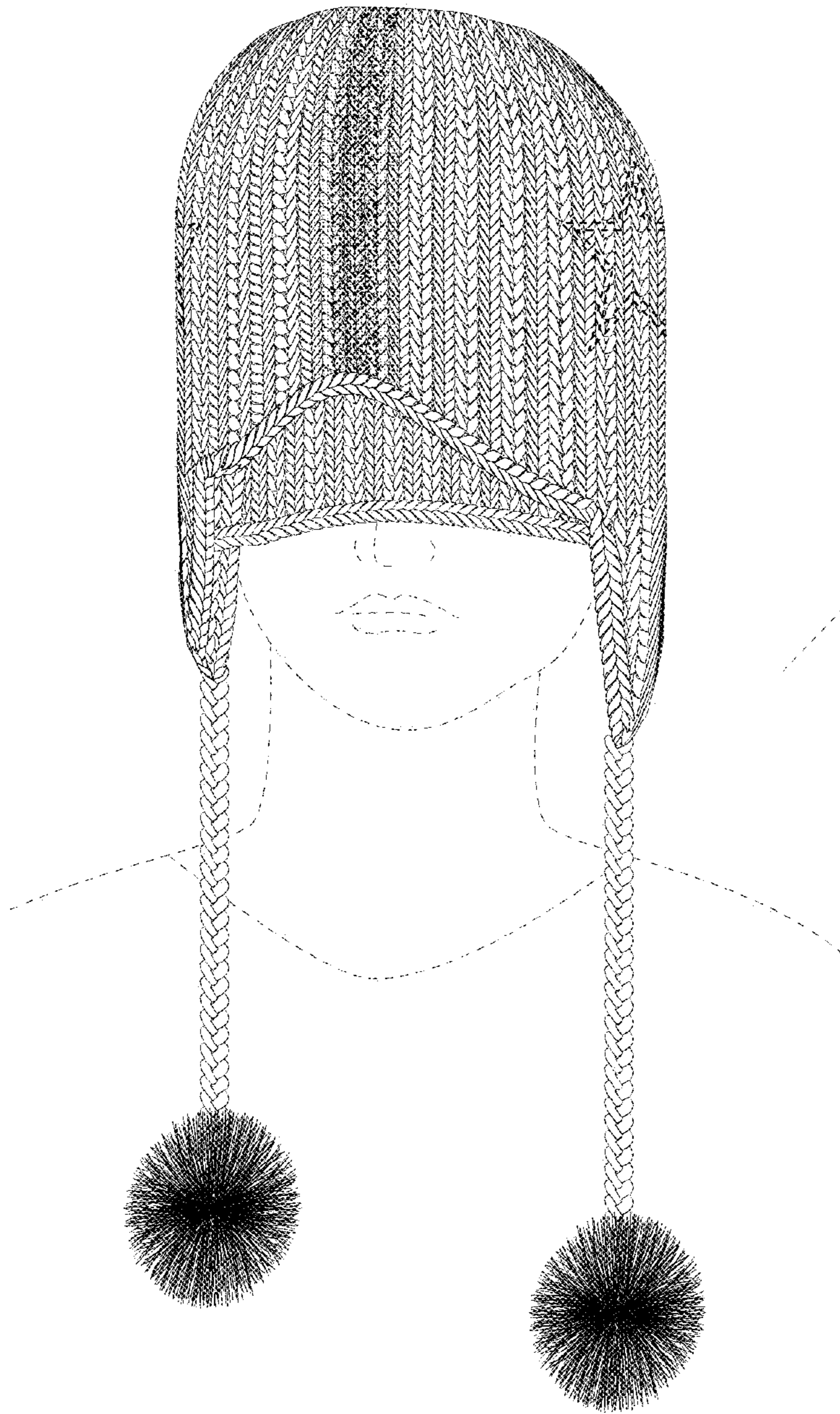

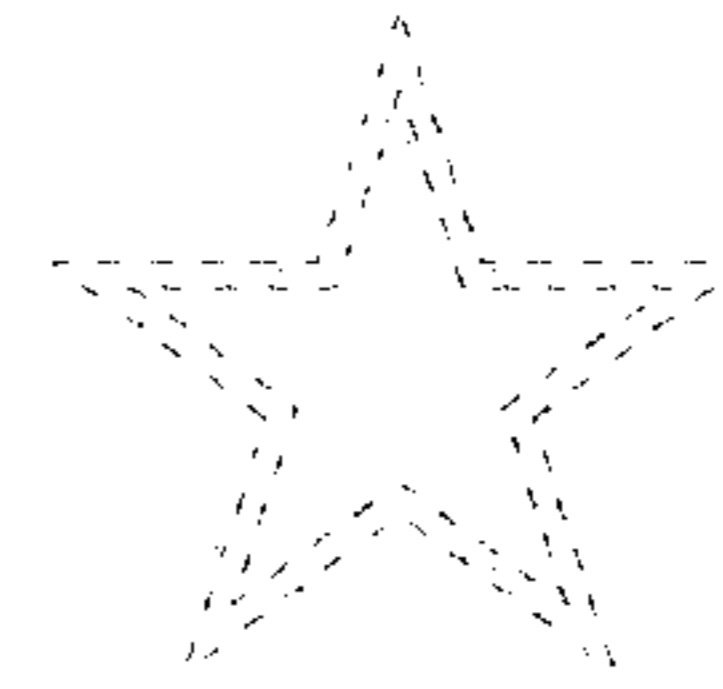

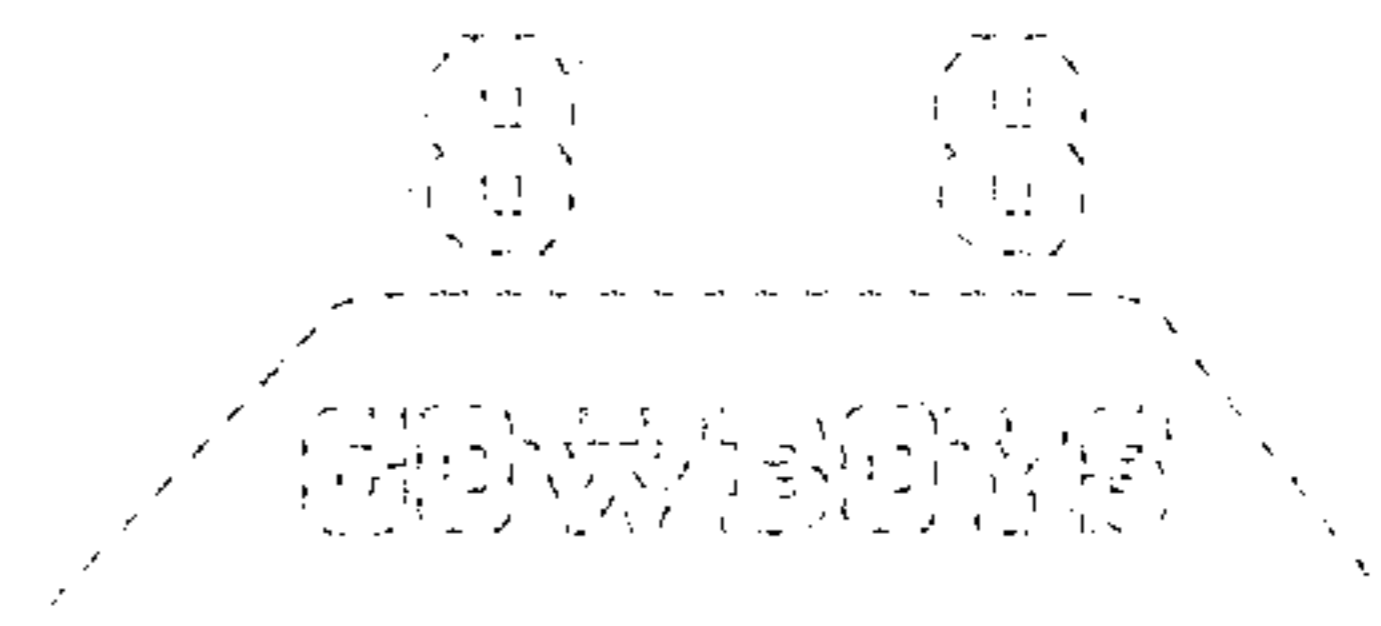

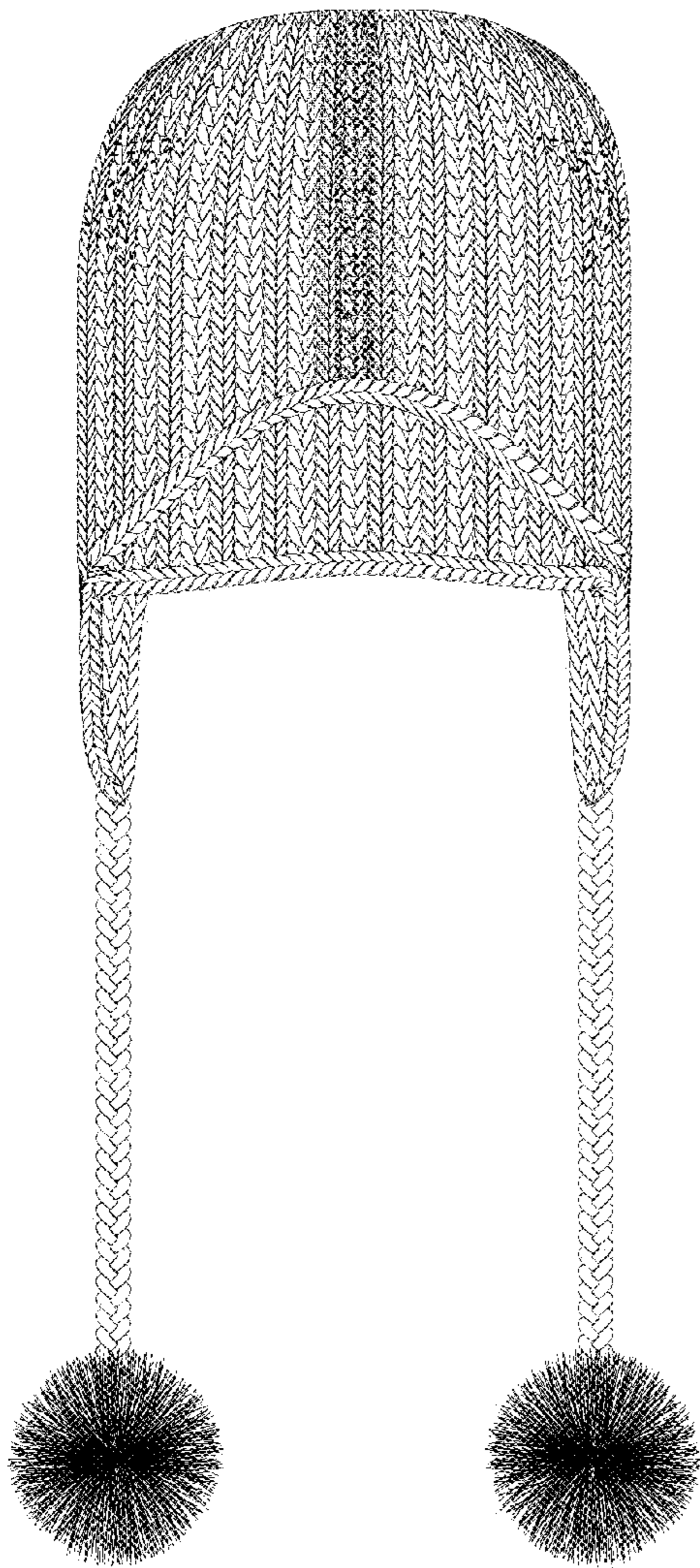

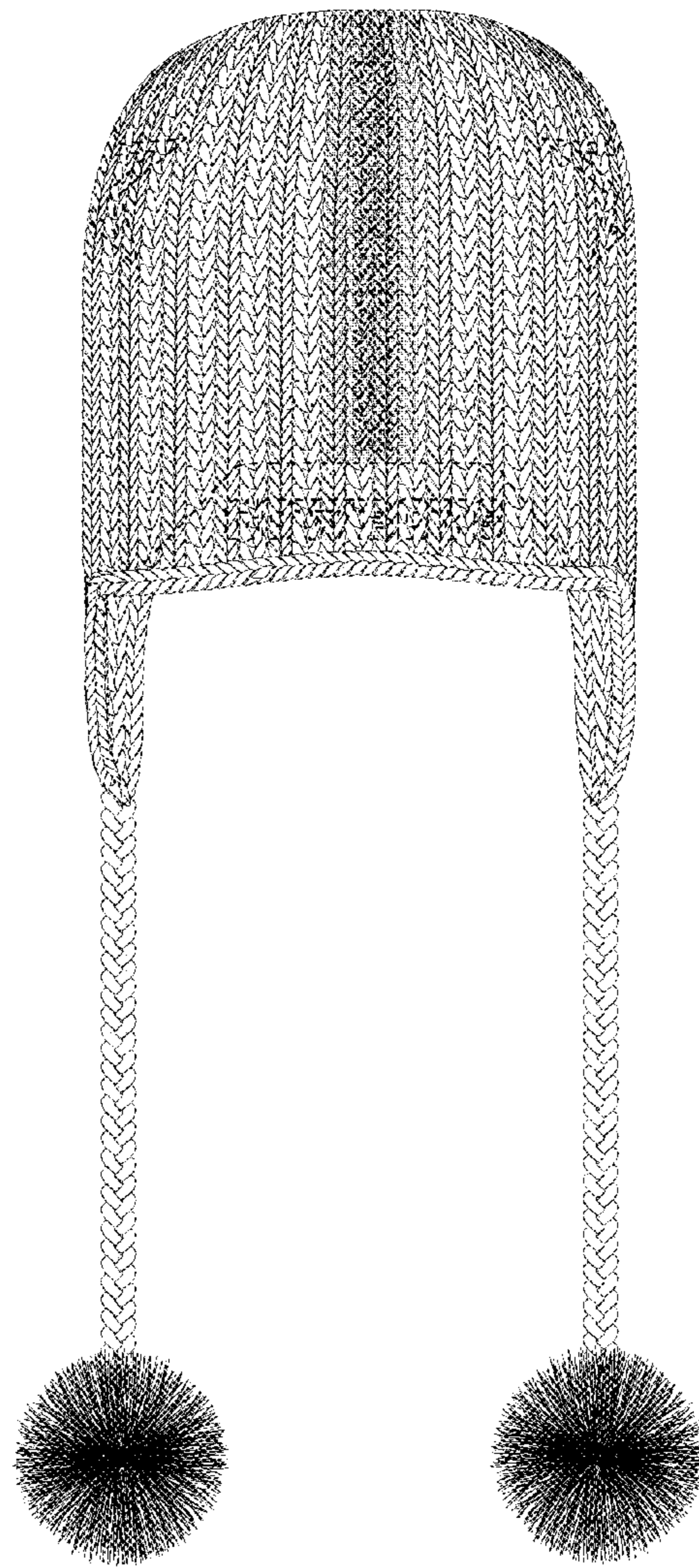

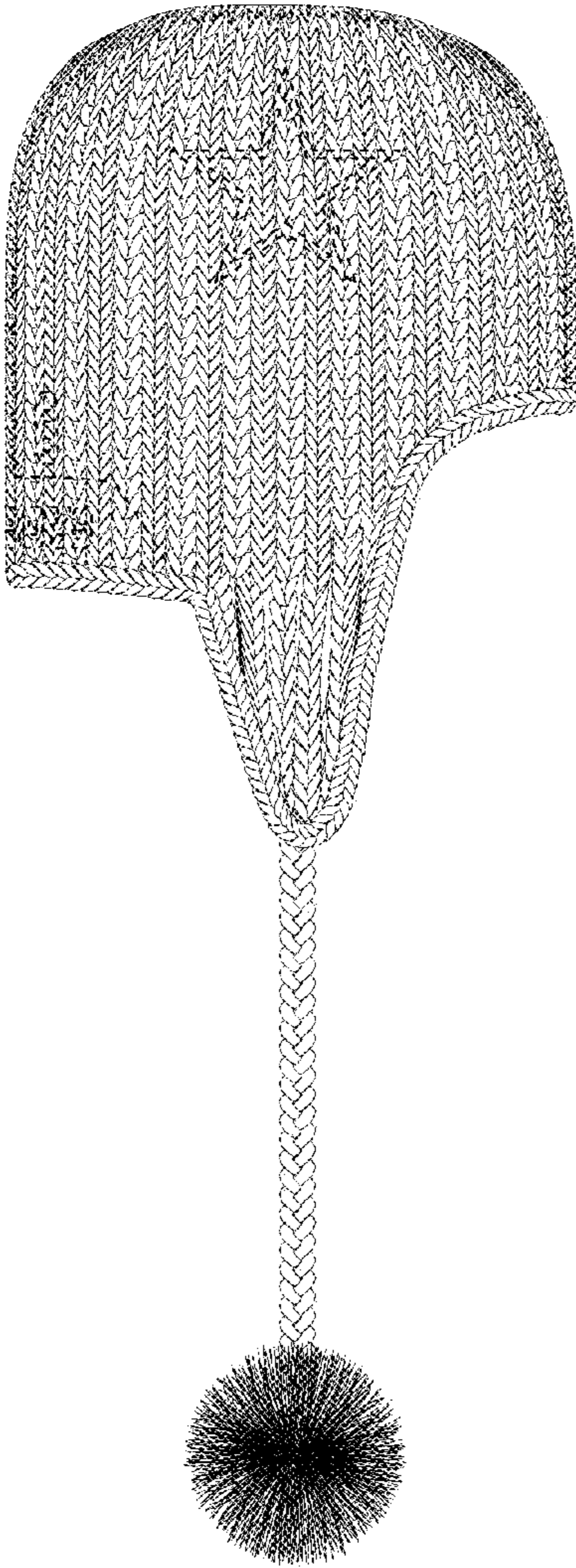

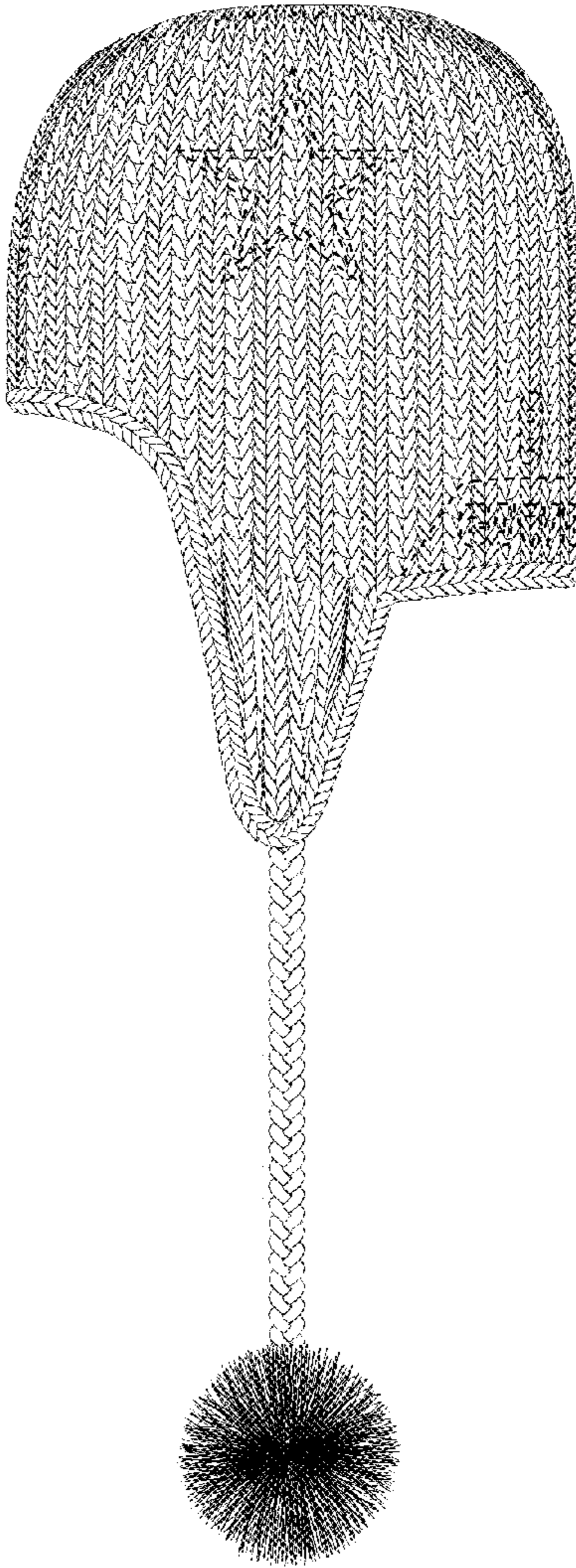

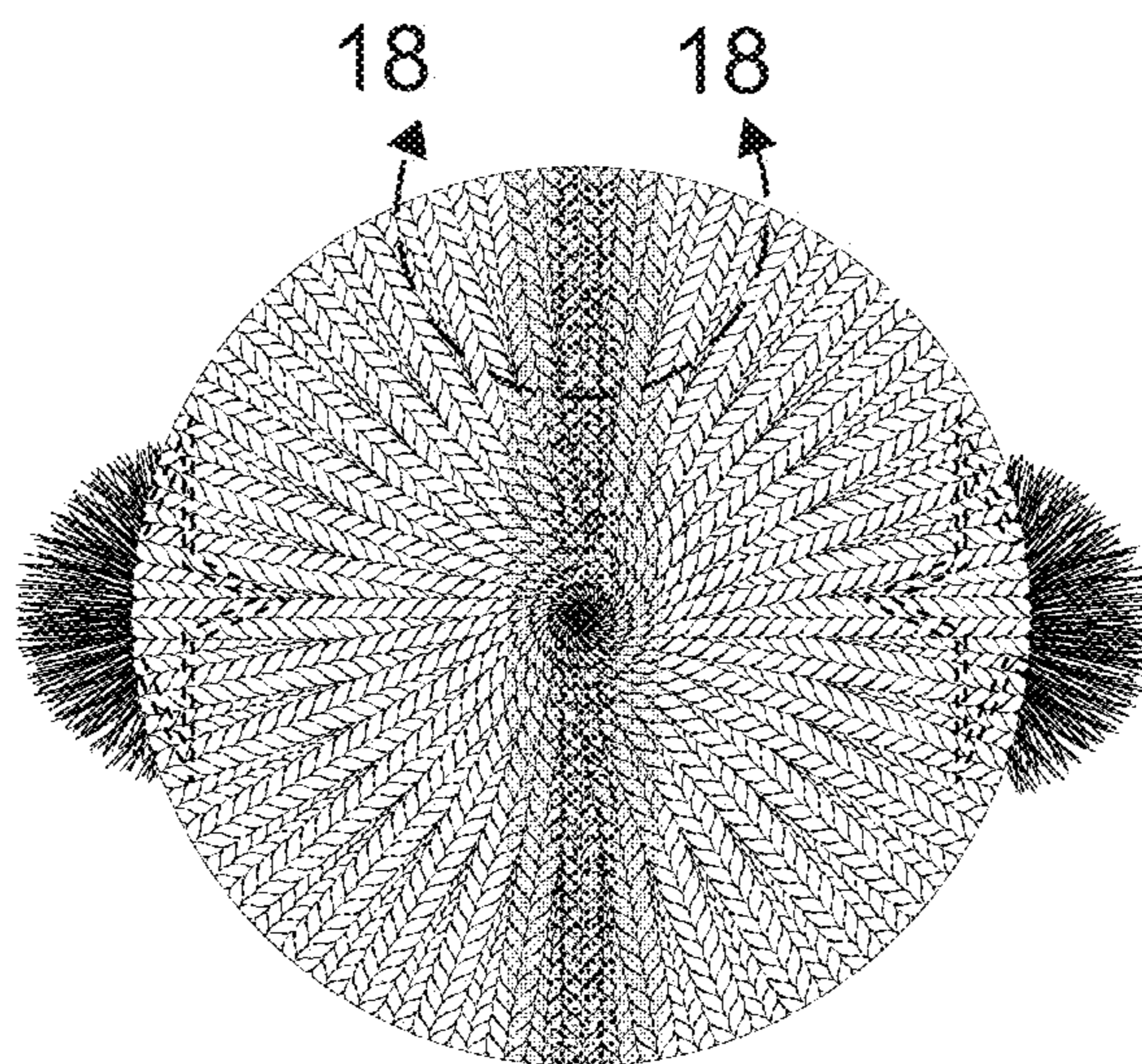

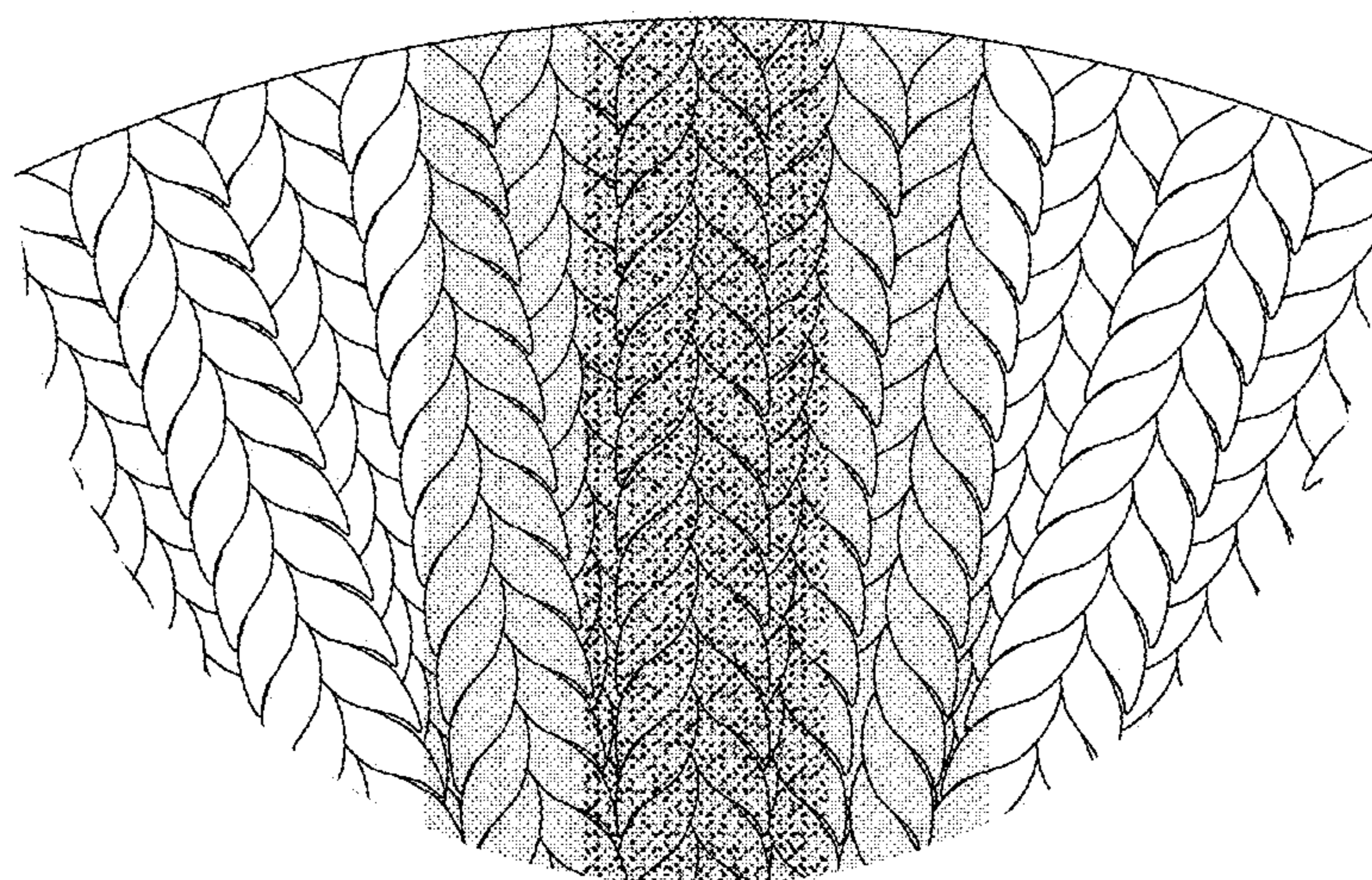

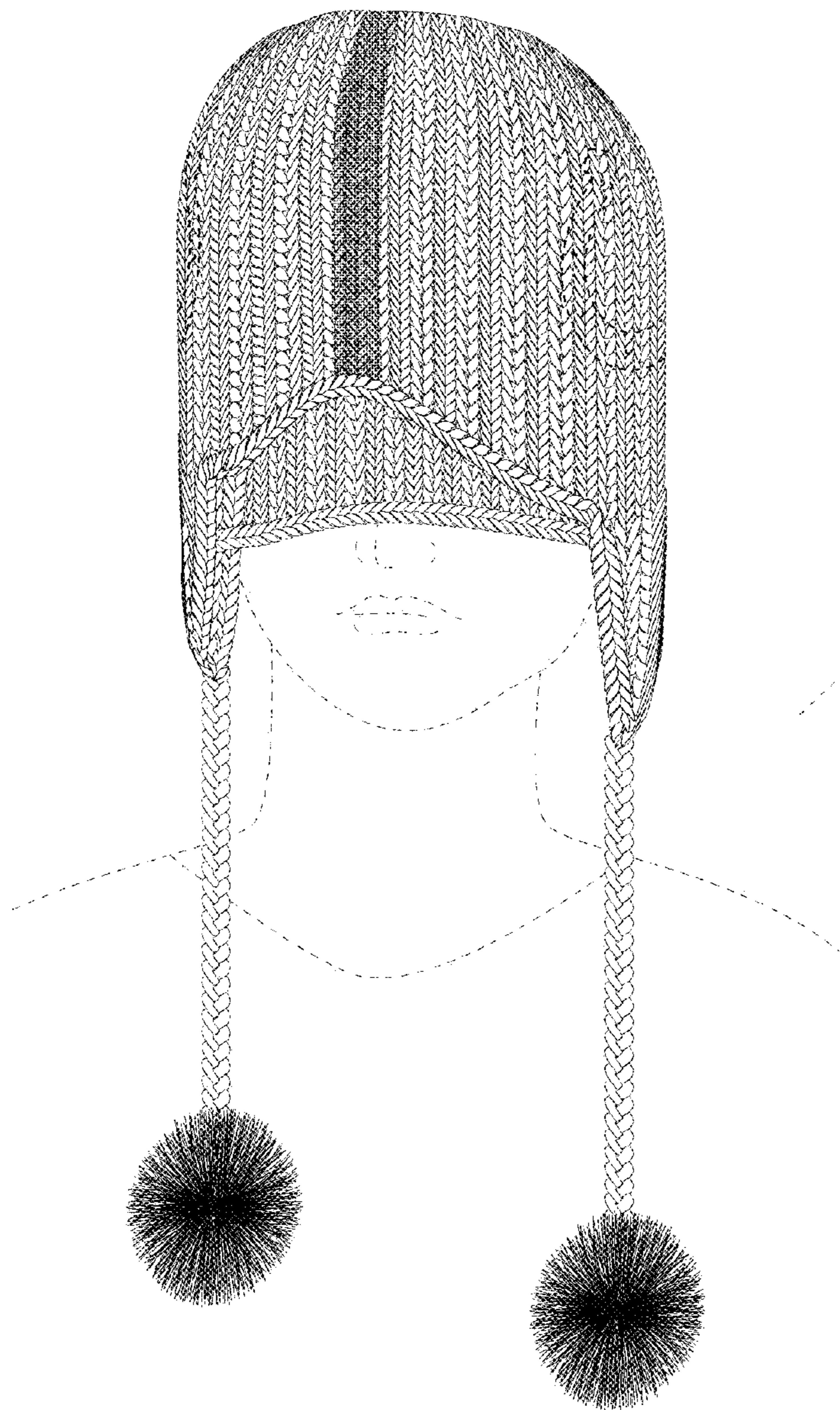

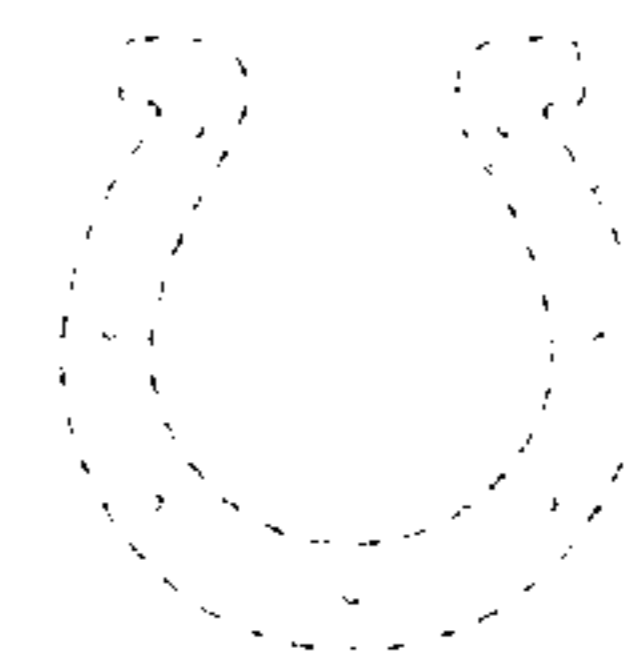

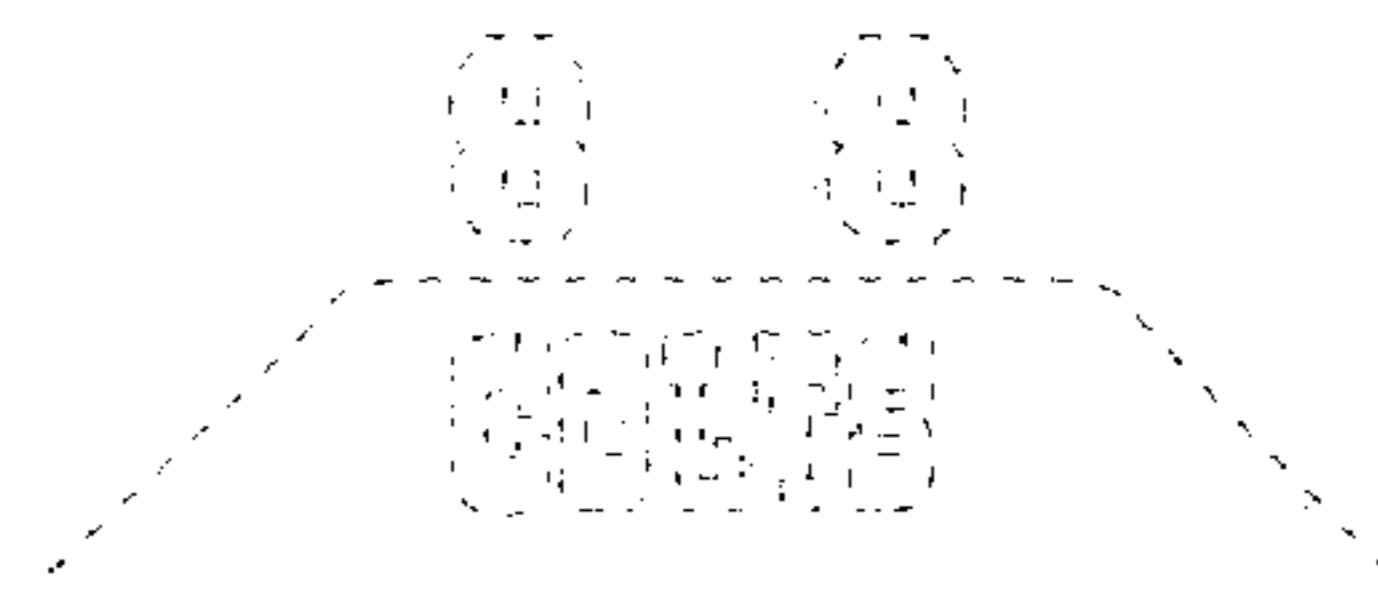

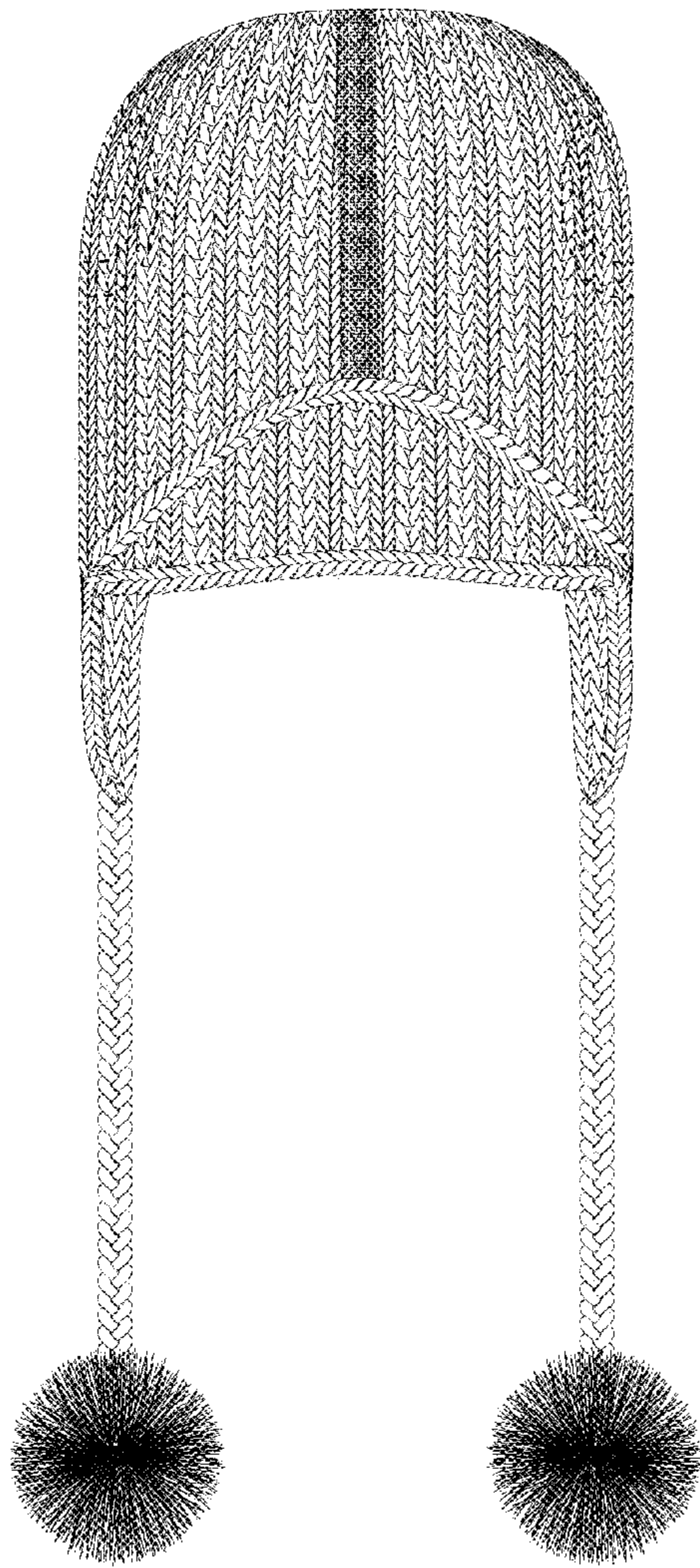

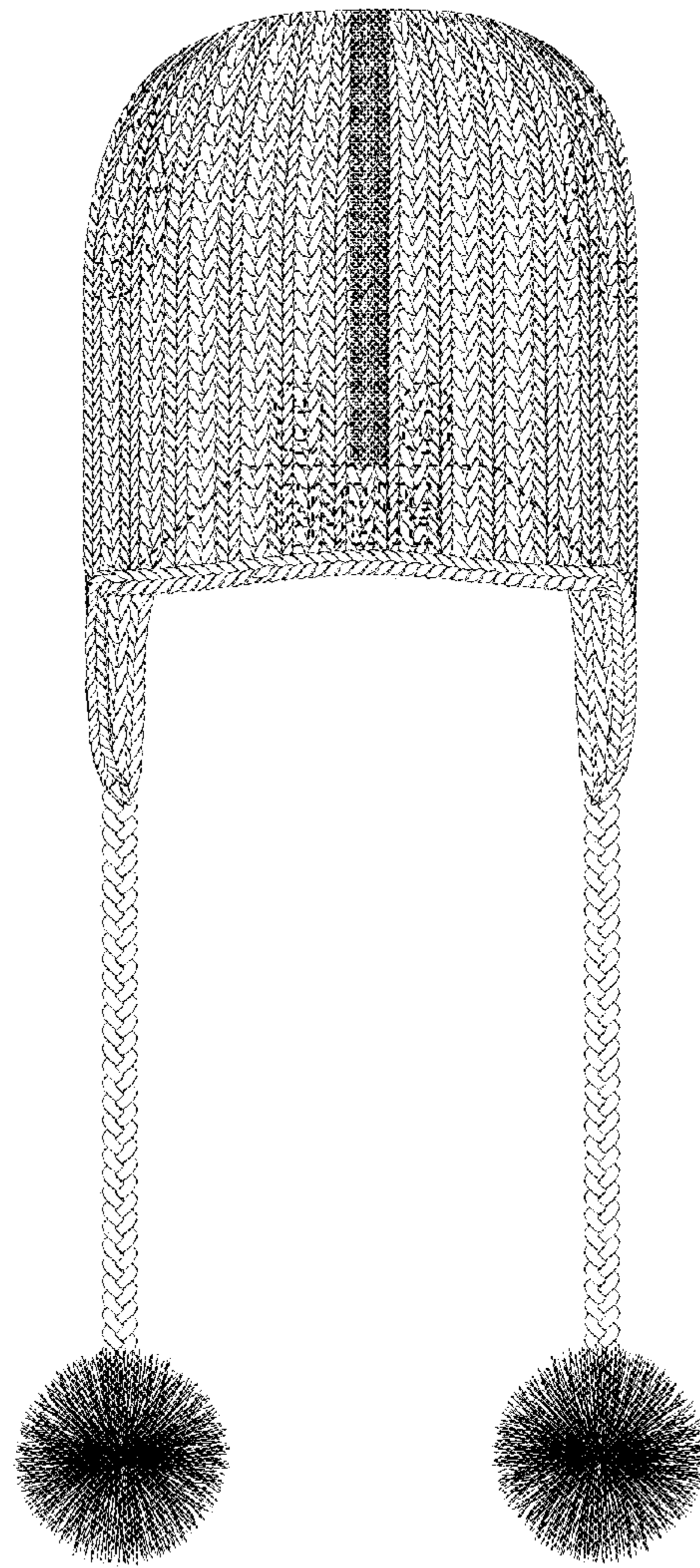

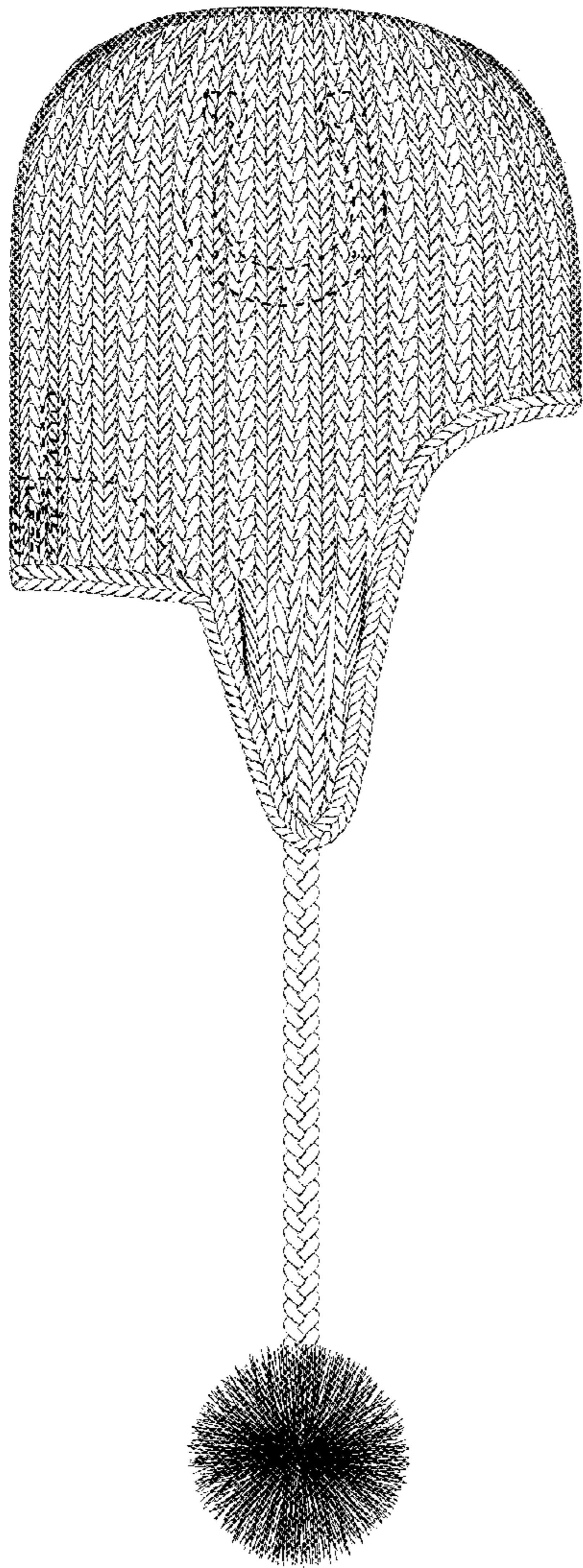

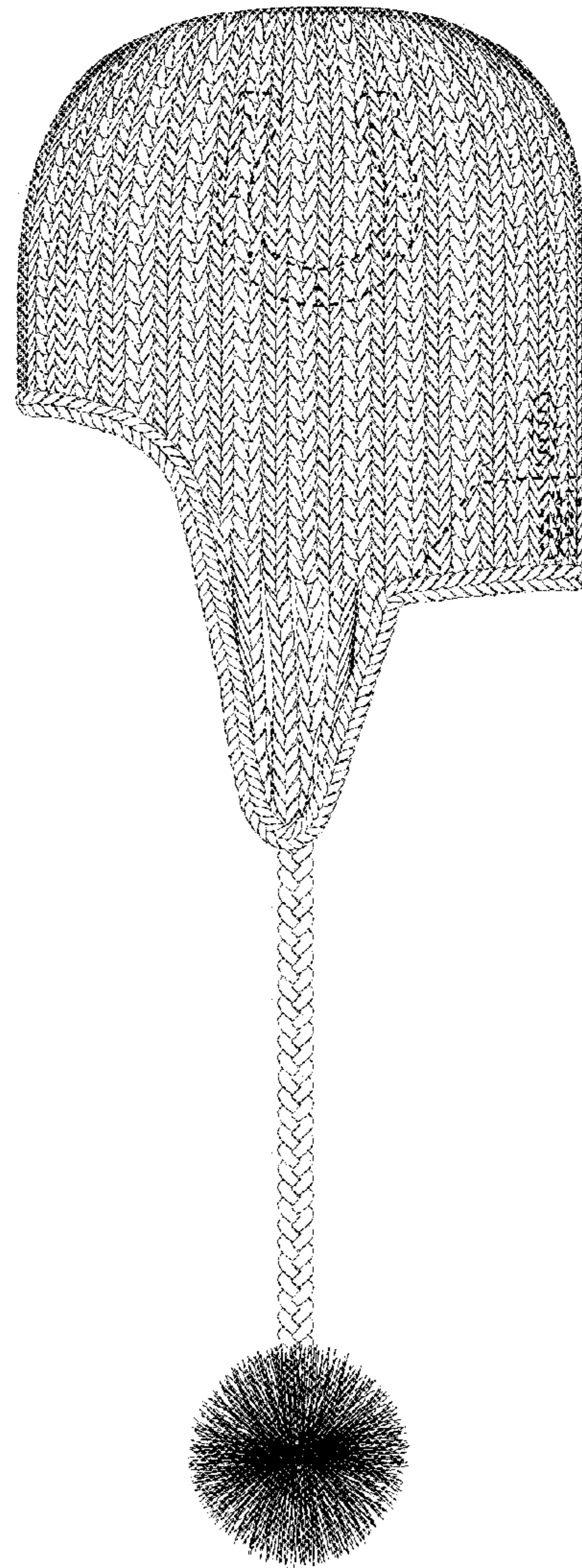

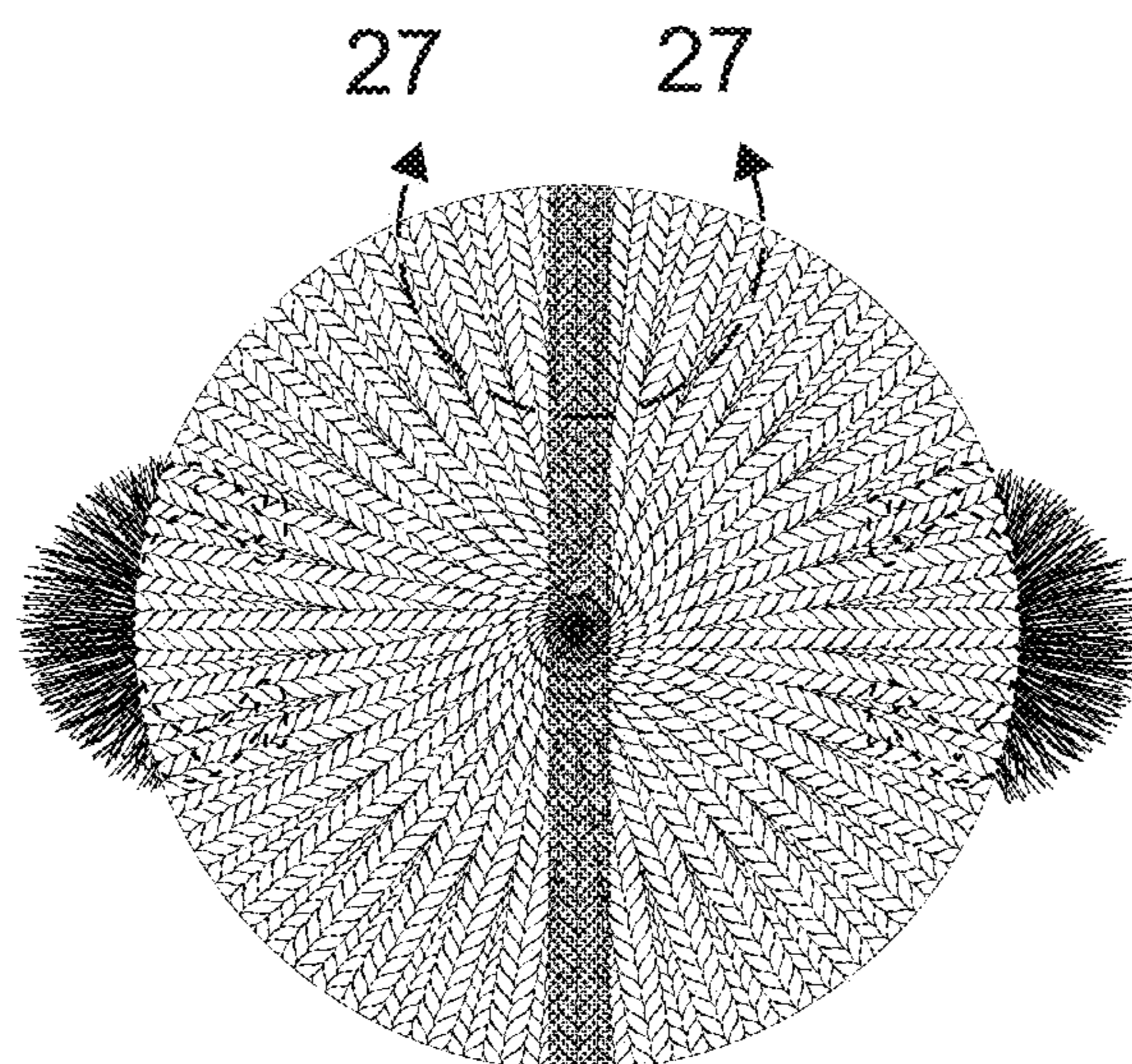

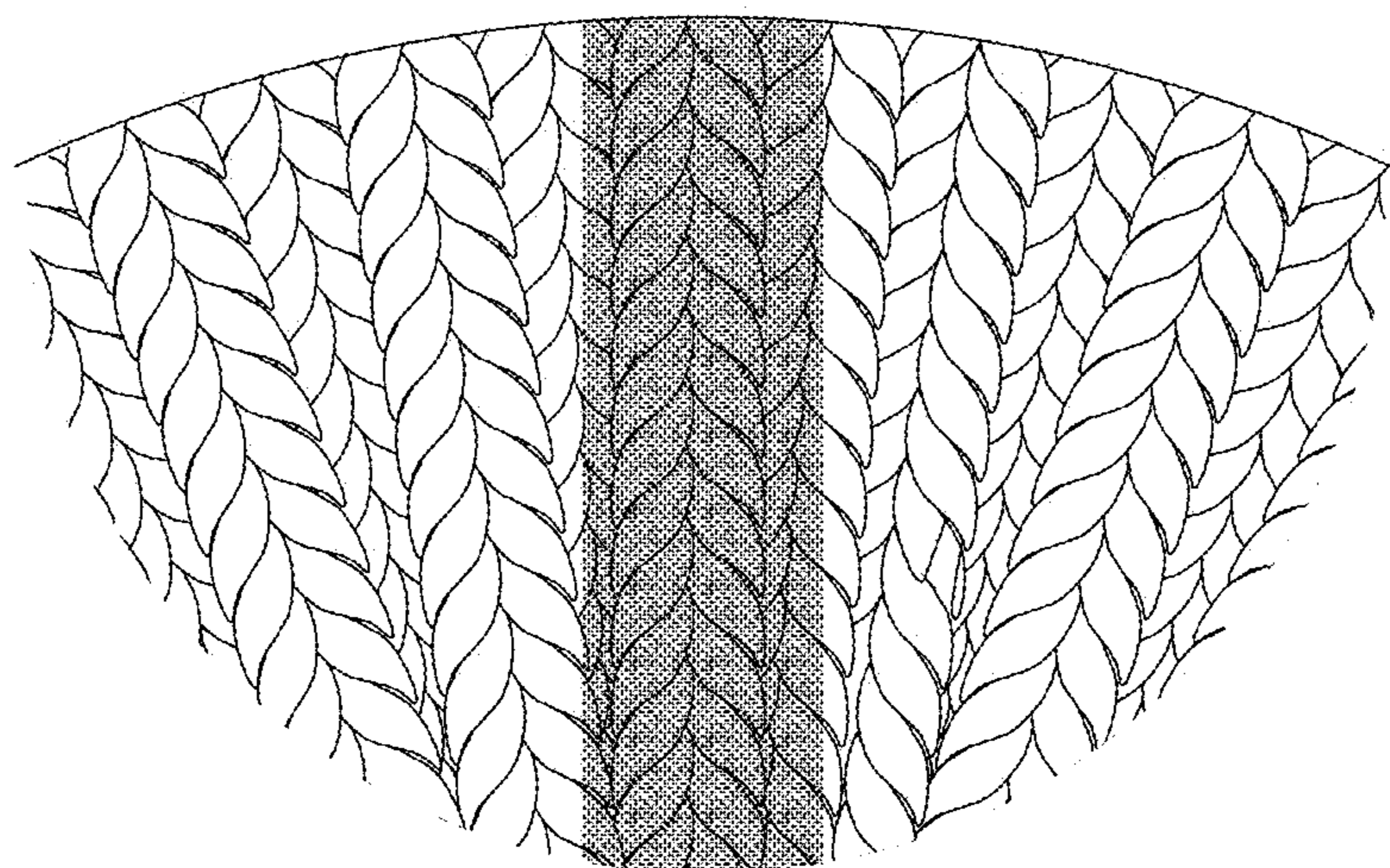
