DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front isometric view of a tablet mount showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear isometric view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom side view thereof;

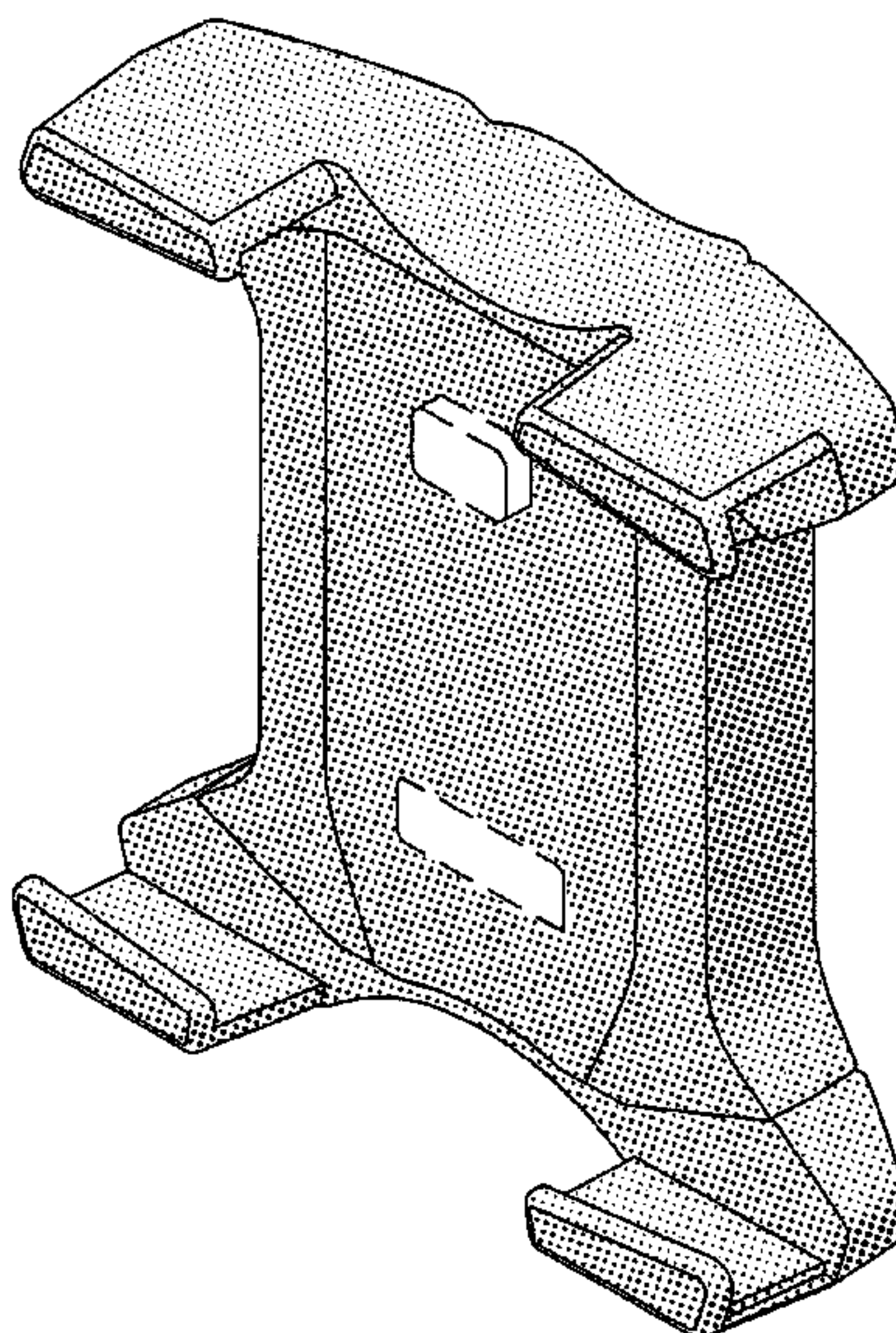
FIG. 8 is a front isometric view of the tablet mount in an extended position;

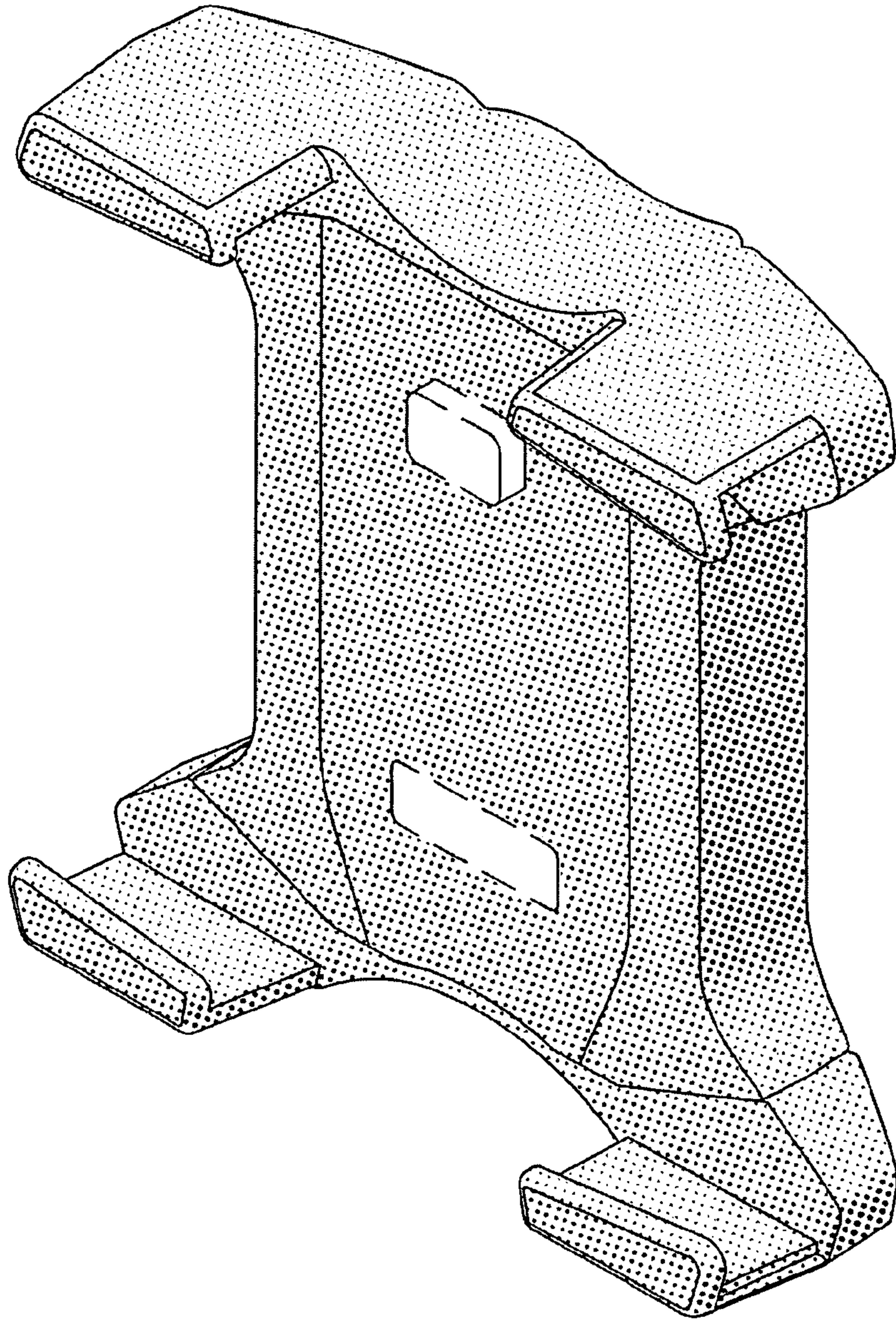

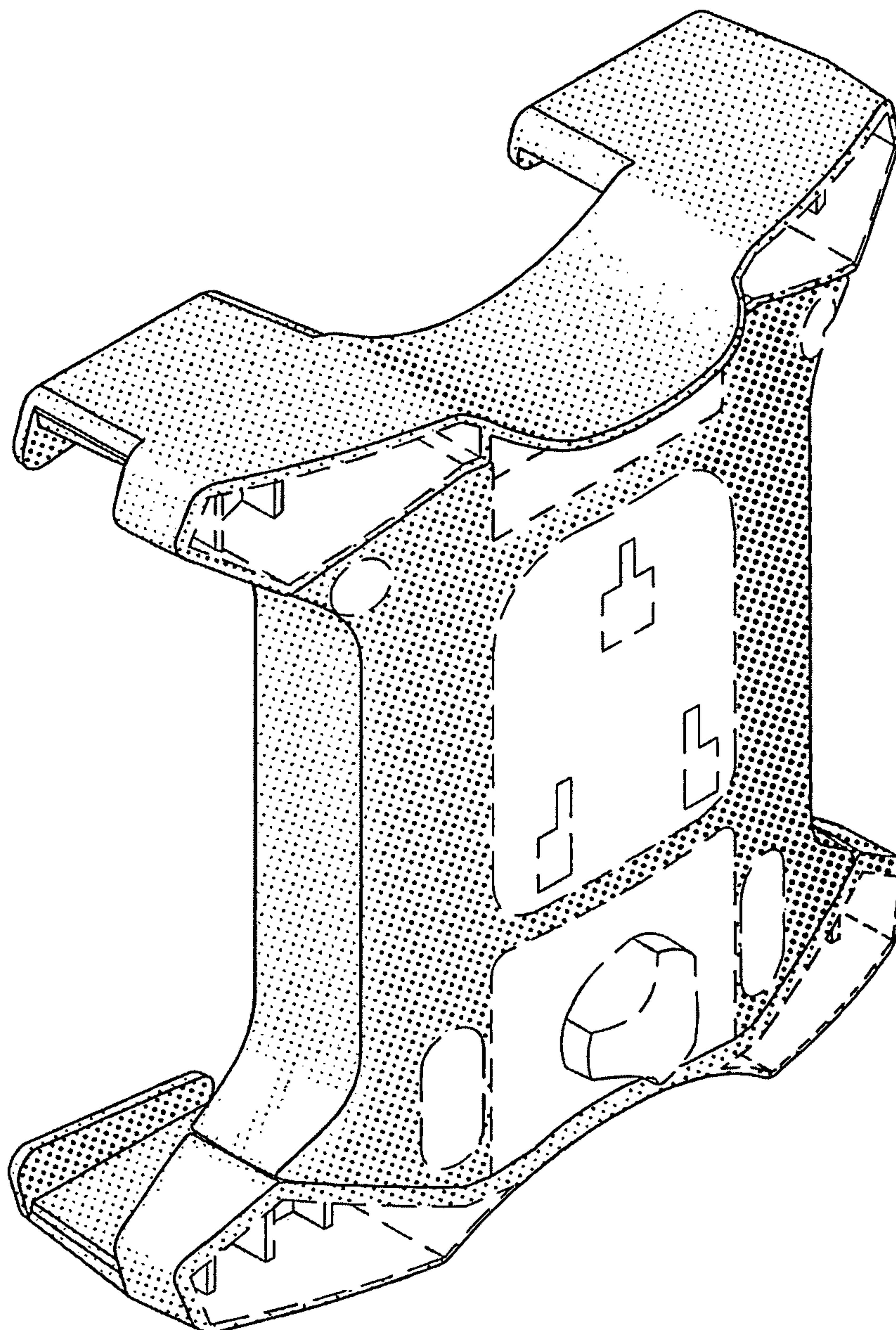

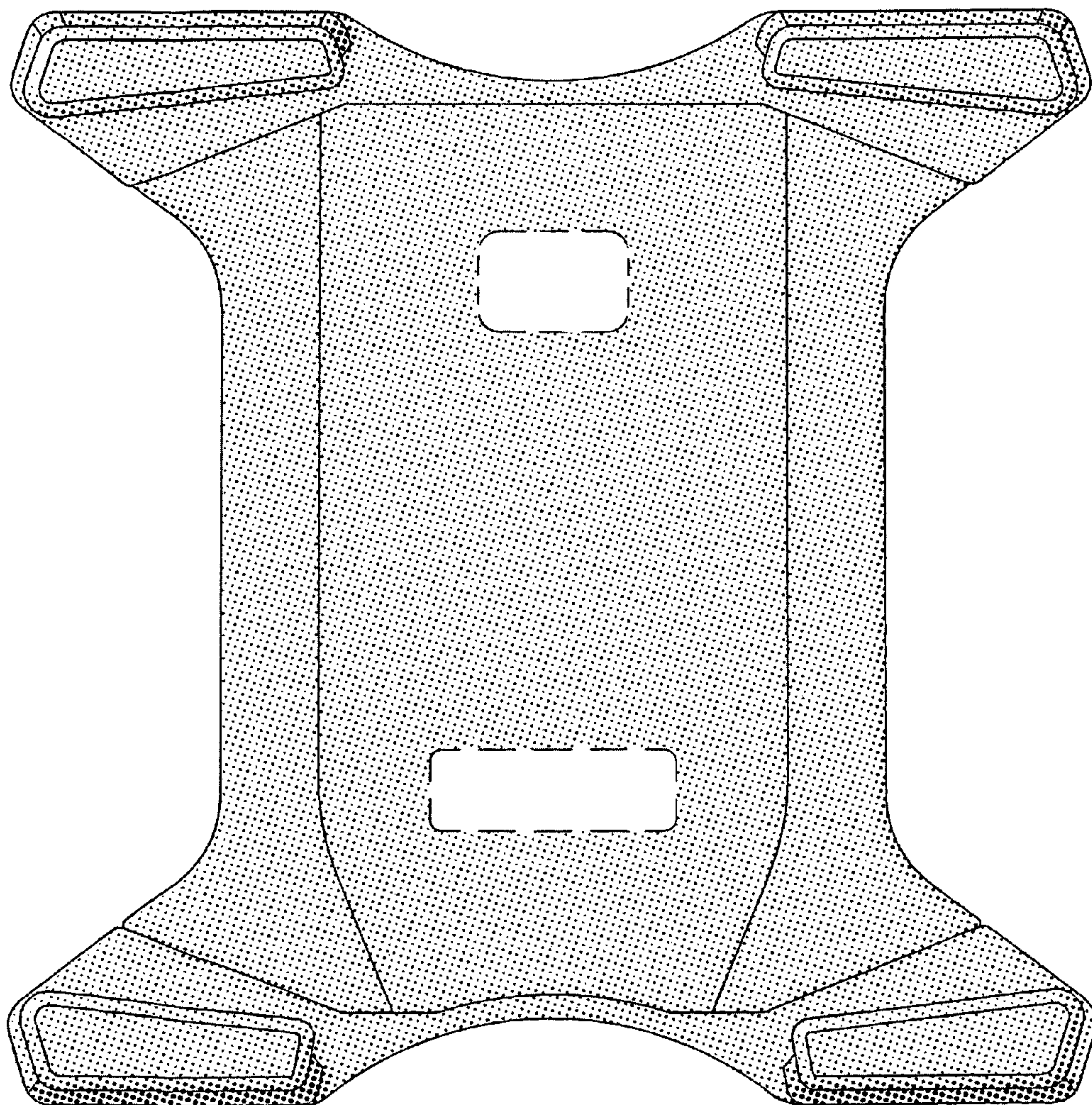

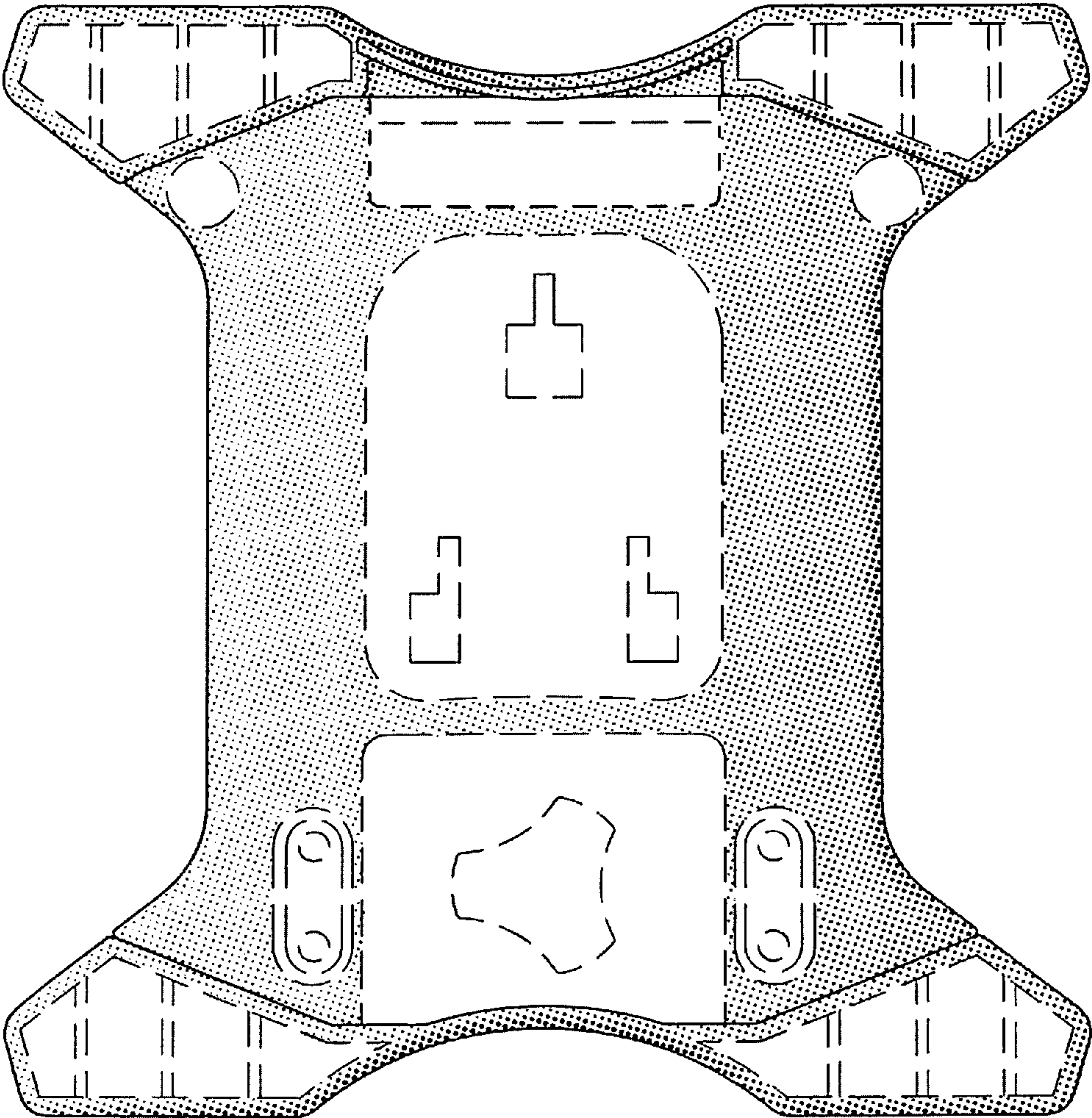

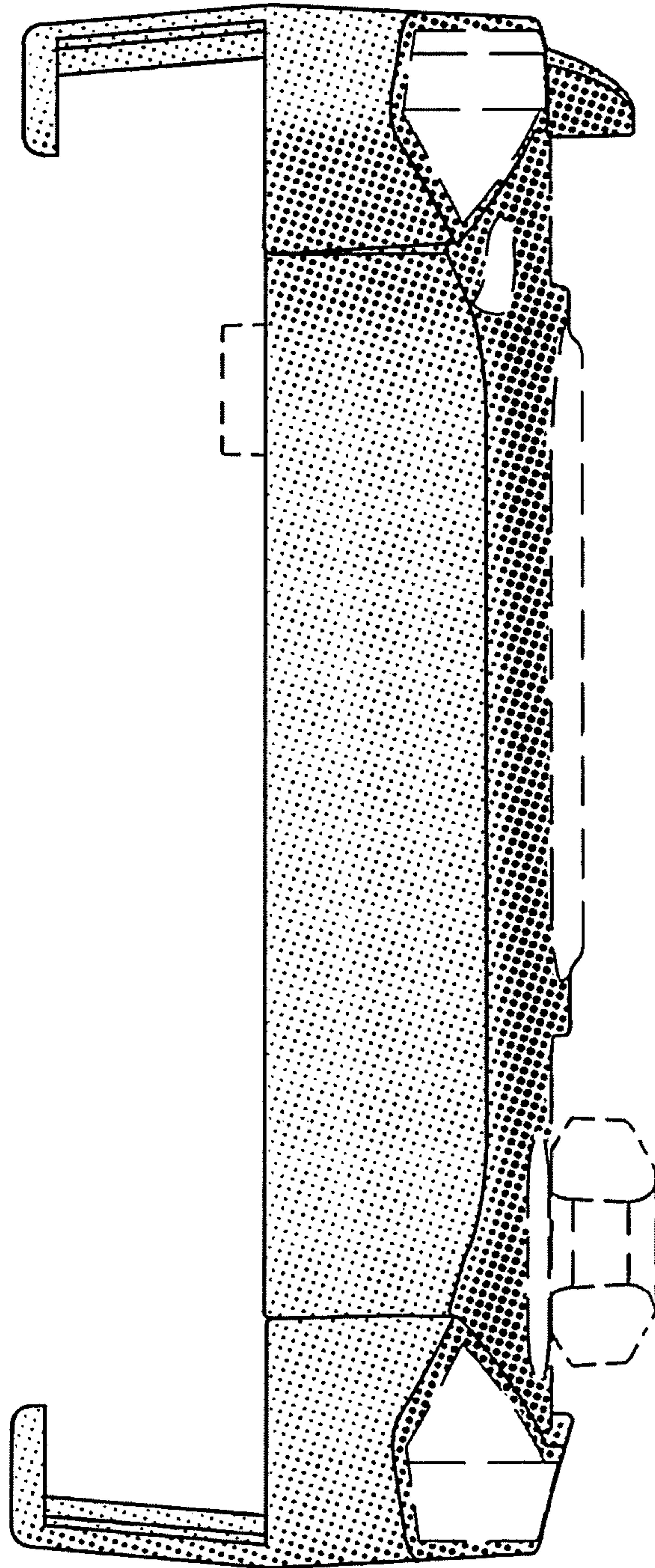

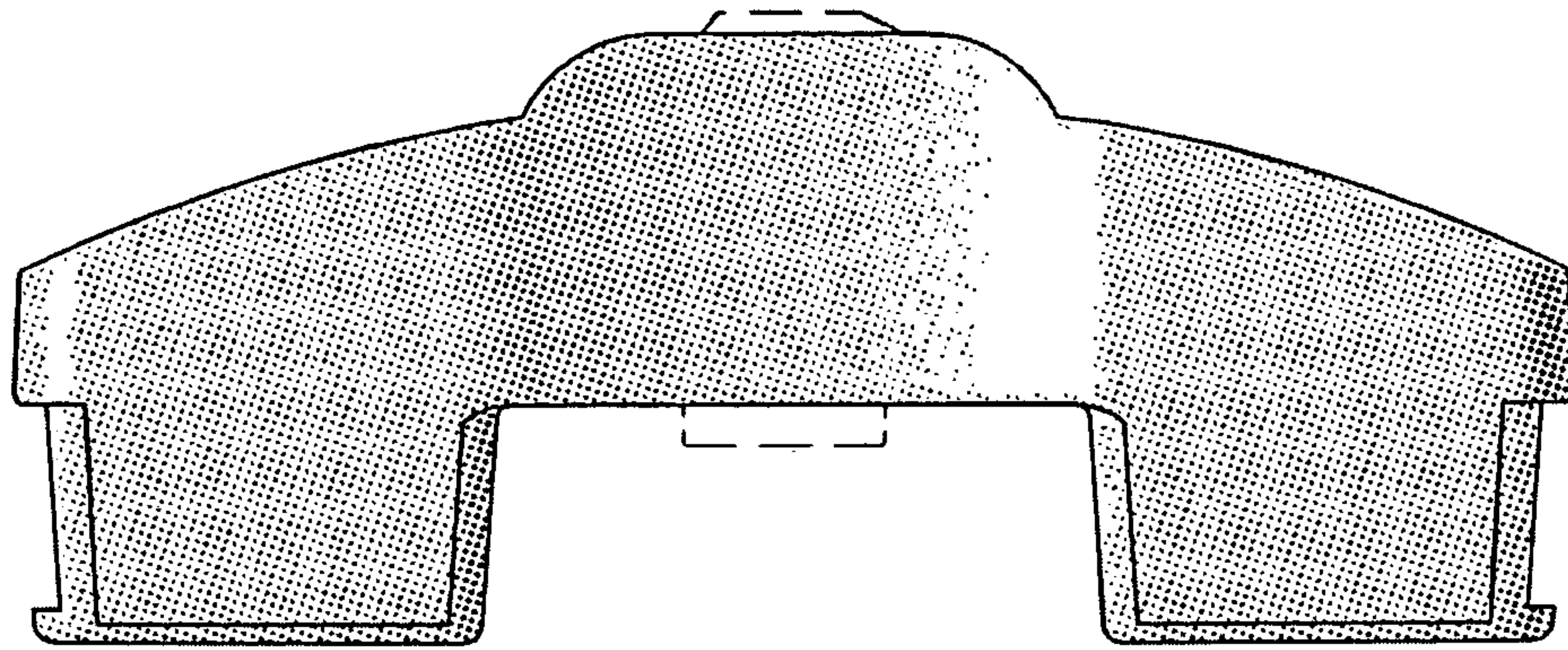

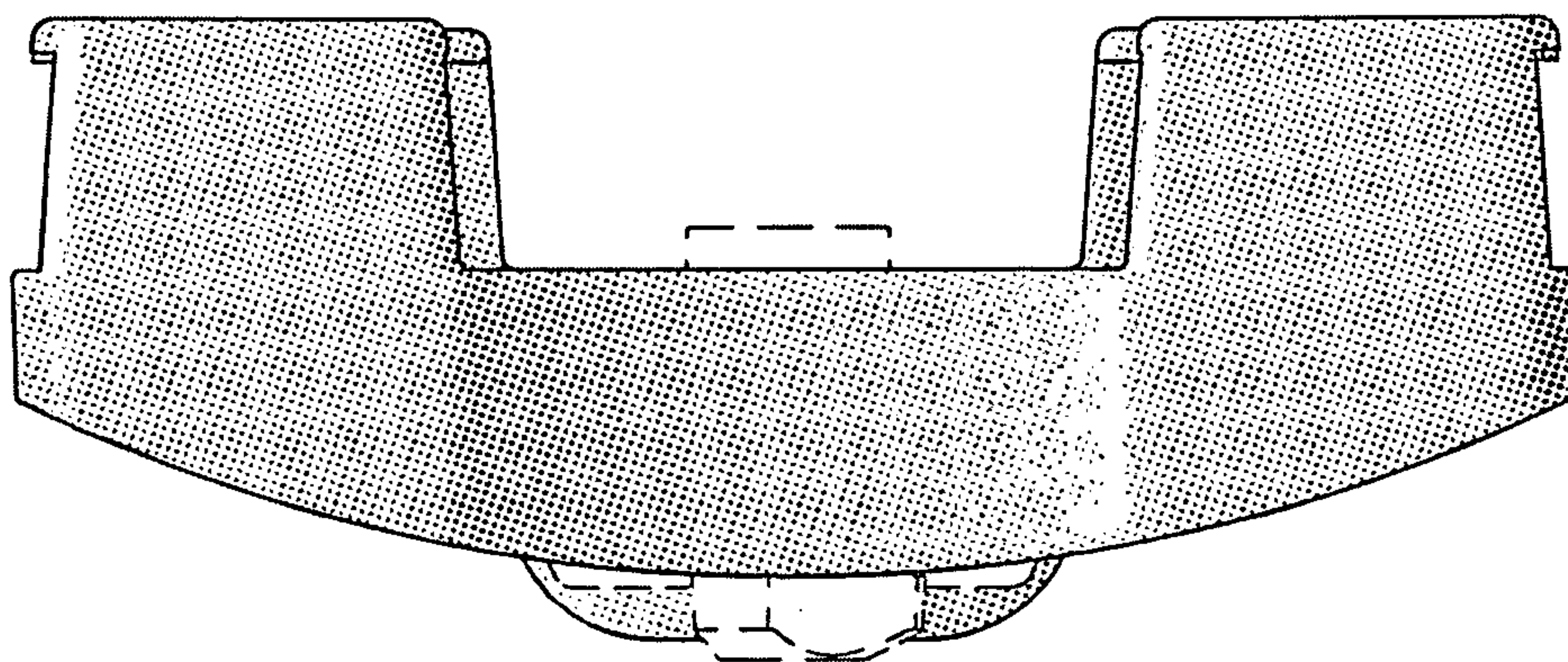

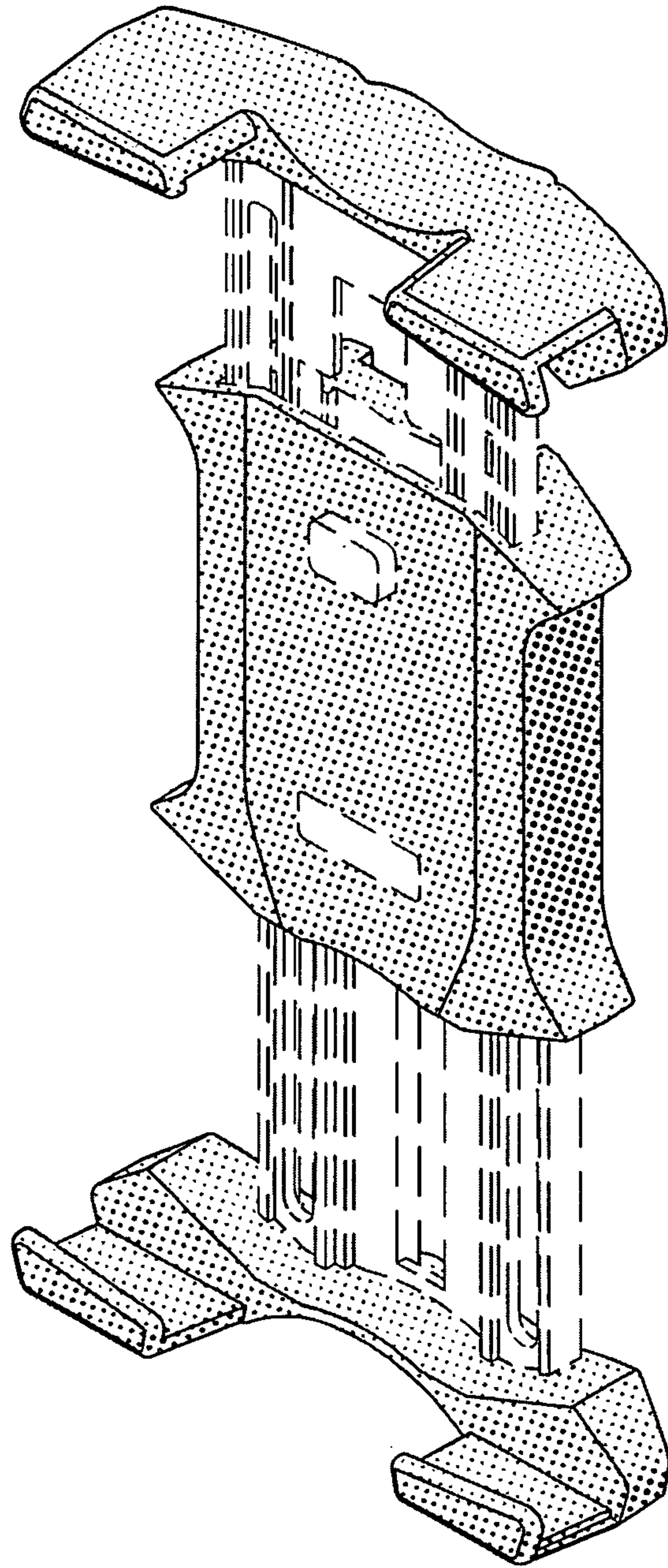

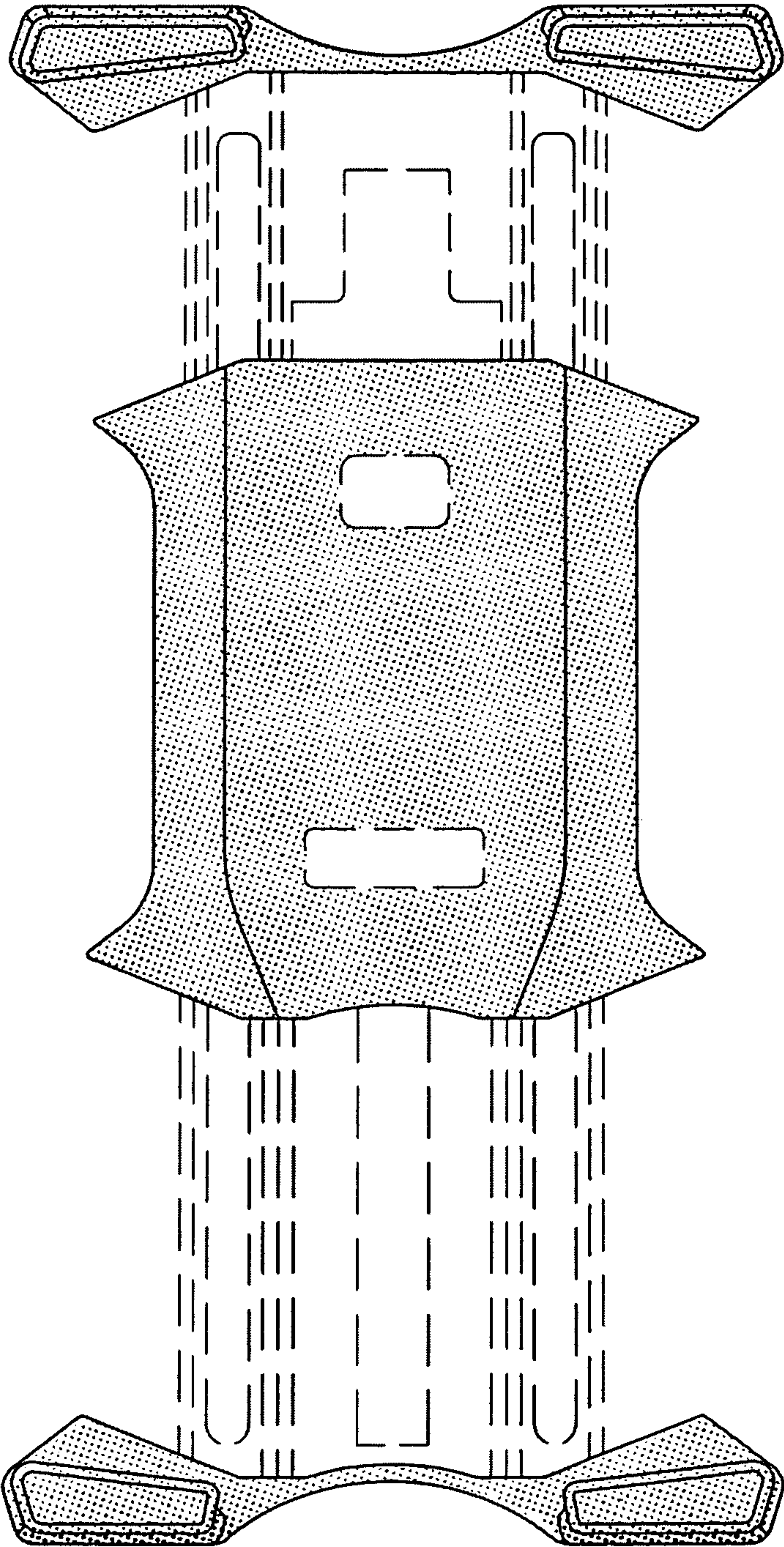

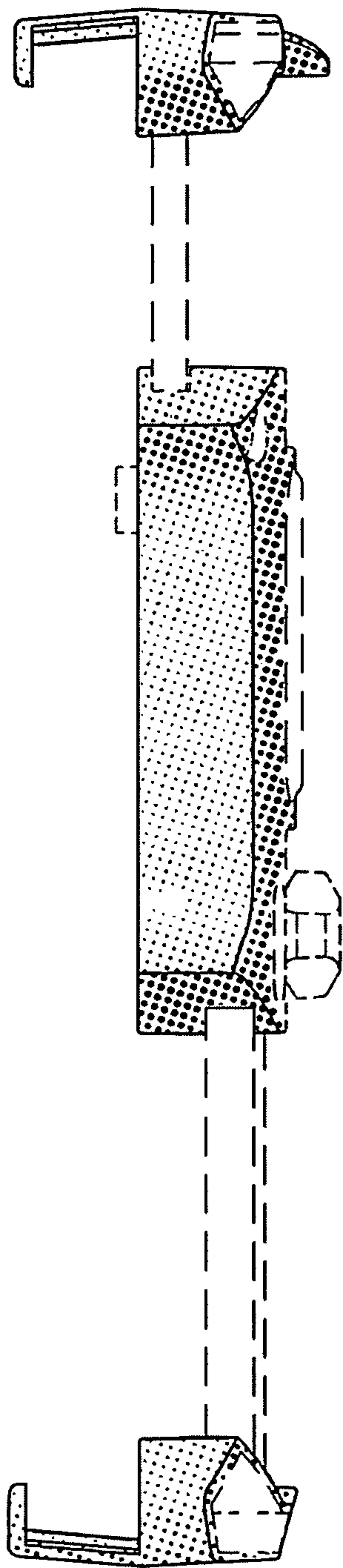
