FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

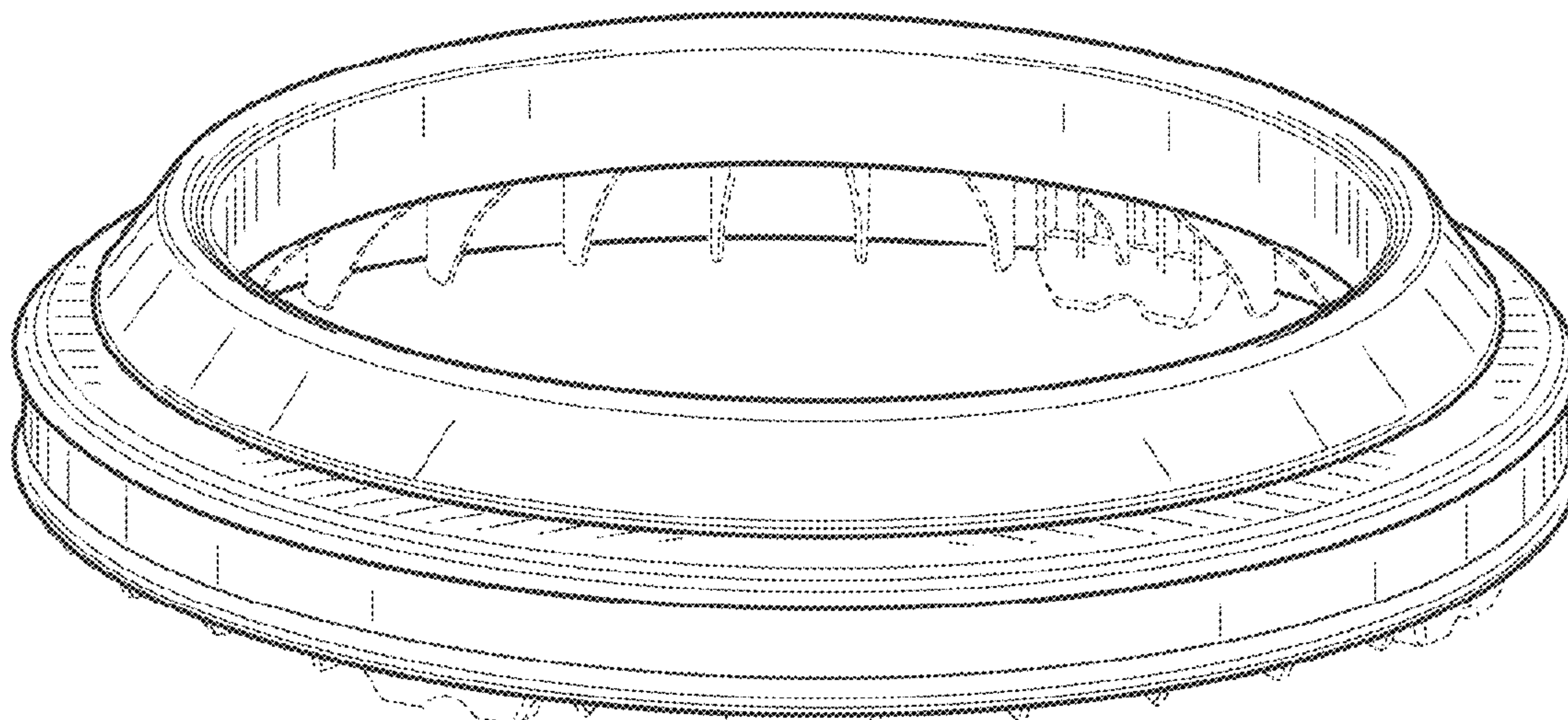
FIG. 3 is an elevation view thereof.

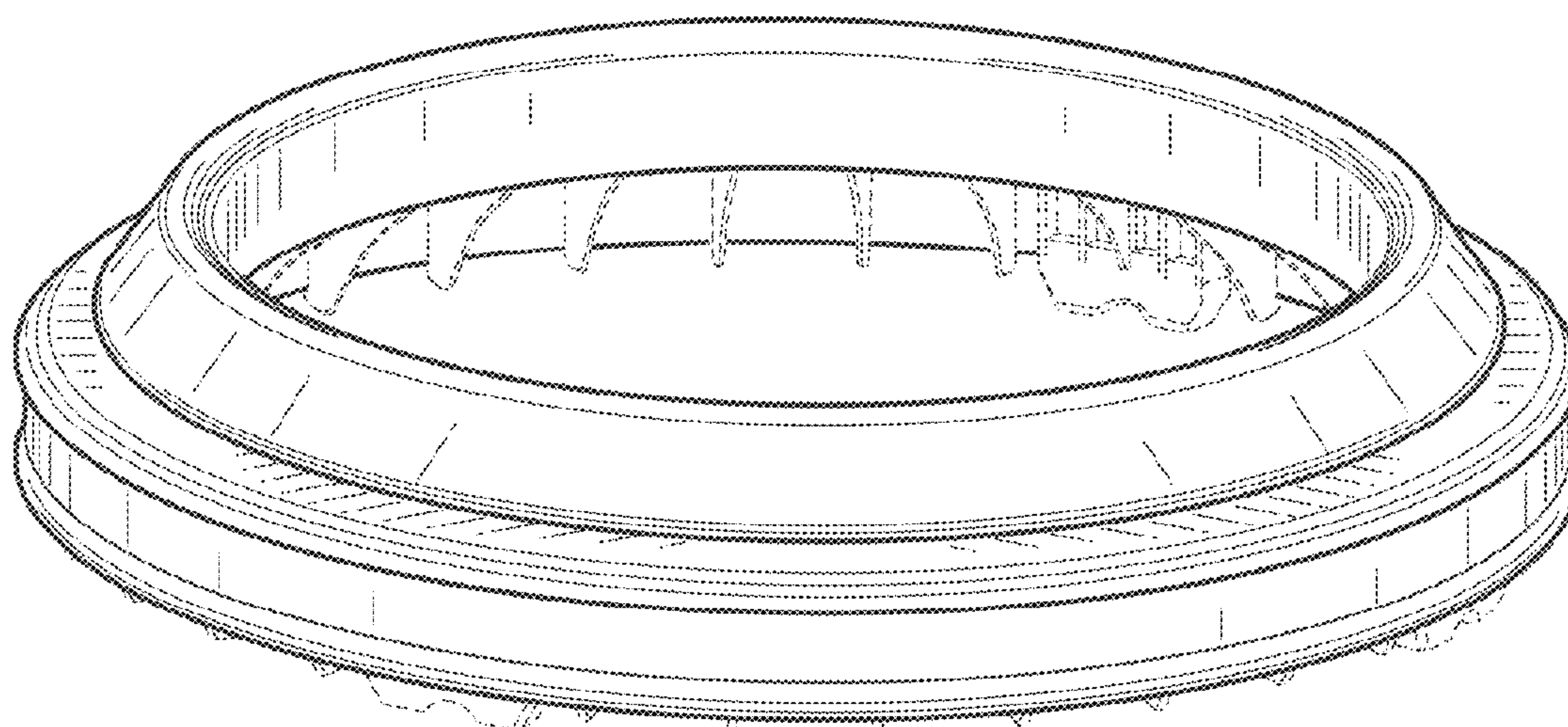

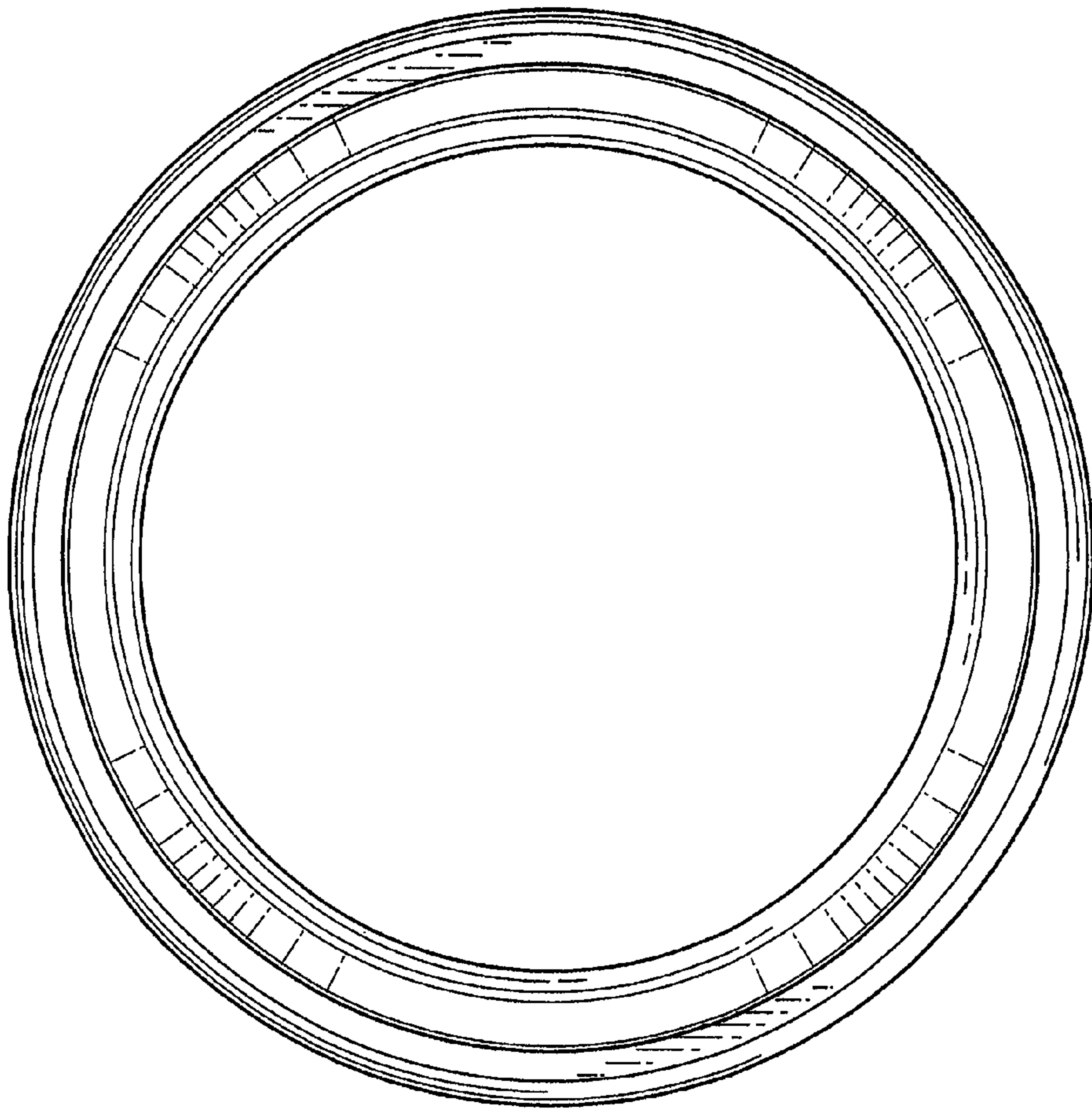

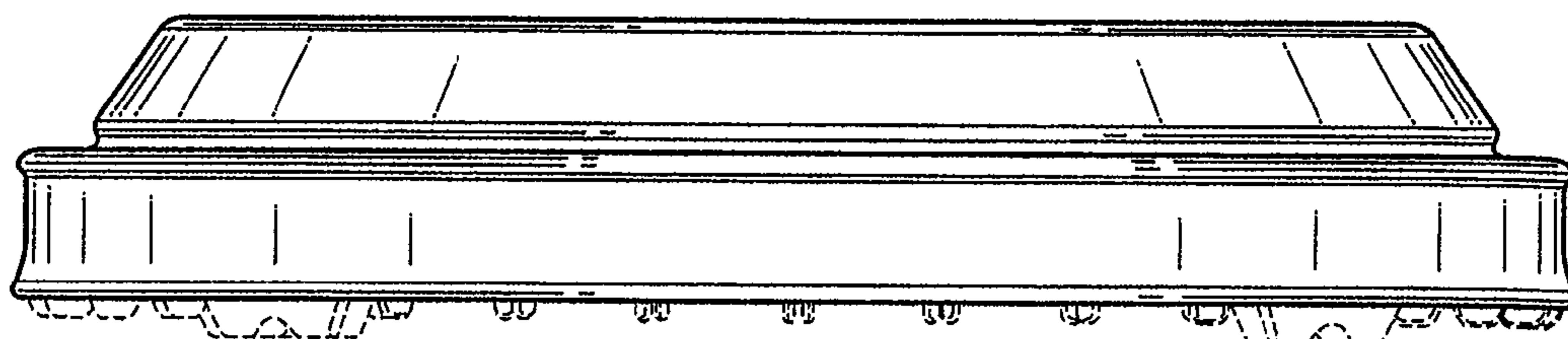

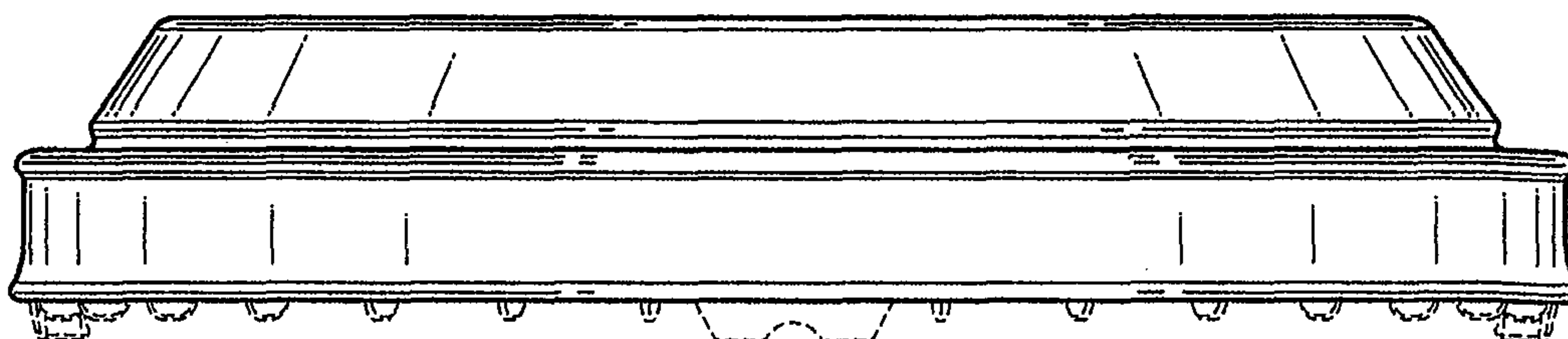

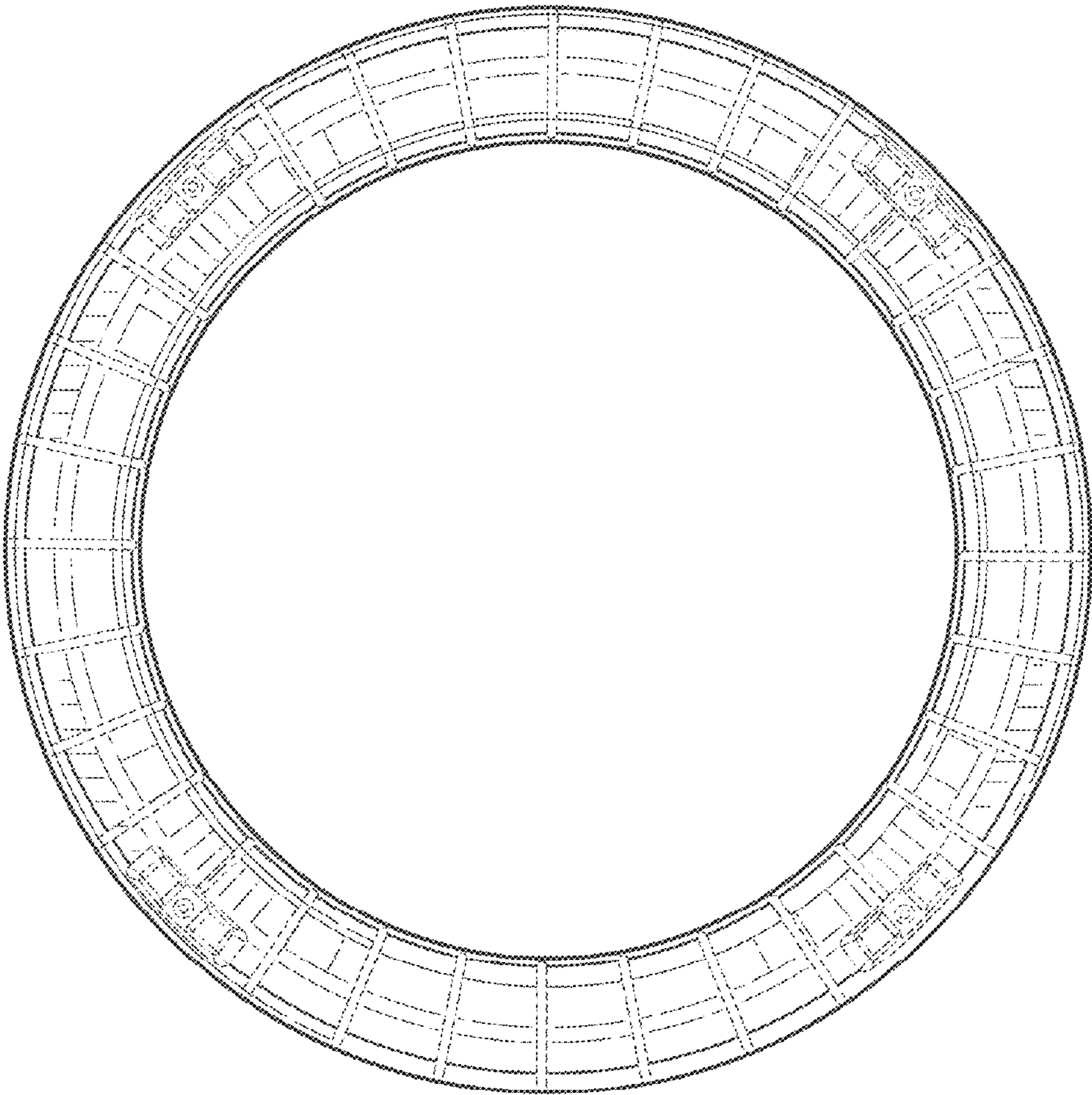
