DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric top view of a soft tissue implant showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a front end view of the soft tissue implant of FIG. 2;

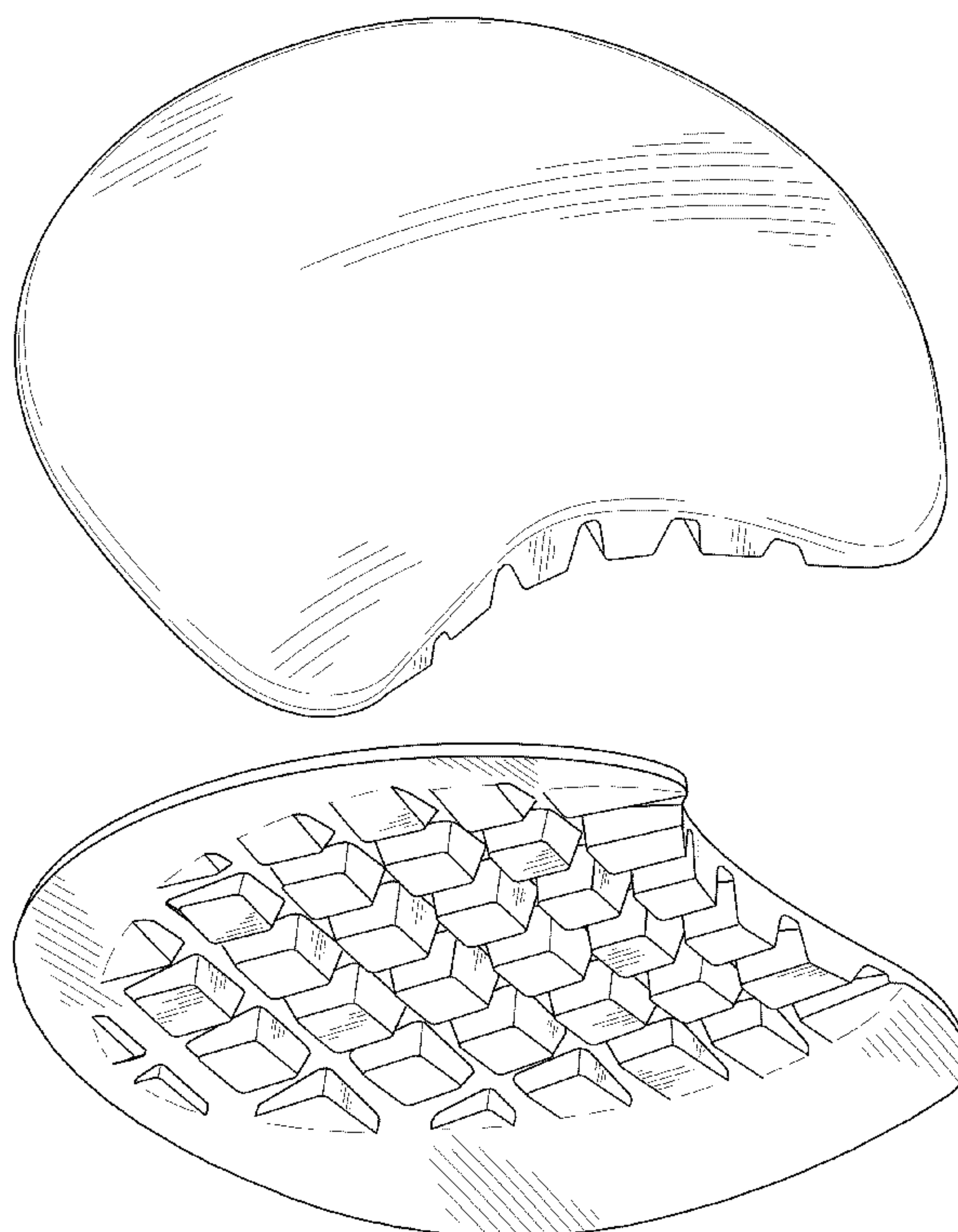
FIG. 6 is a rear end view of the soft tissue implant of FIG. 2;

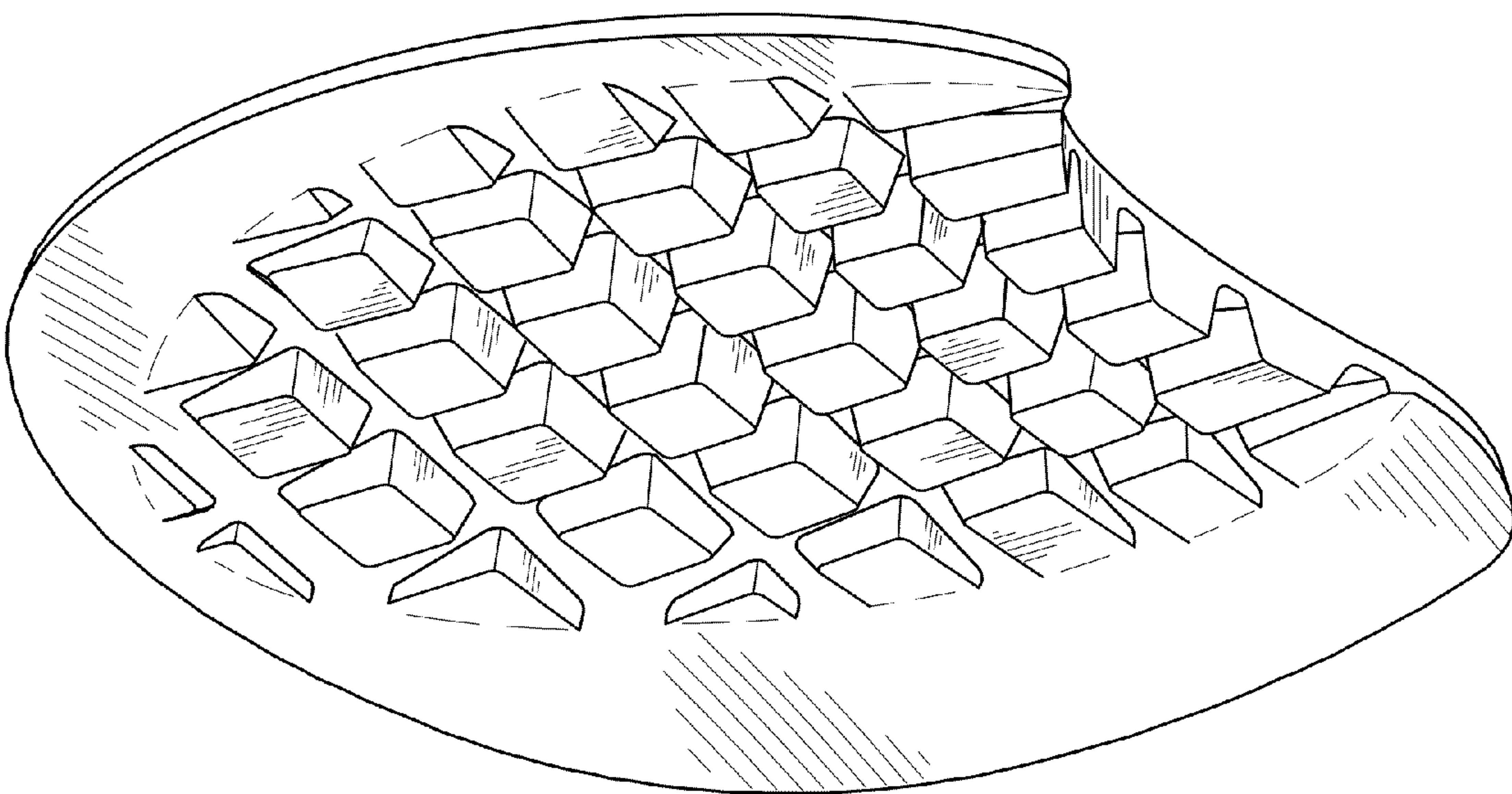
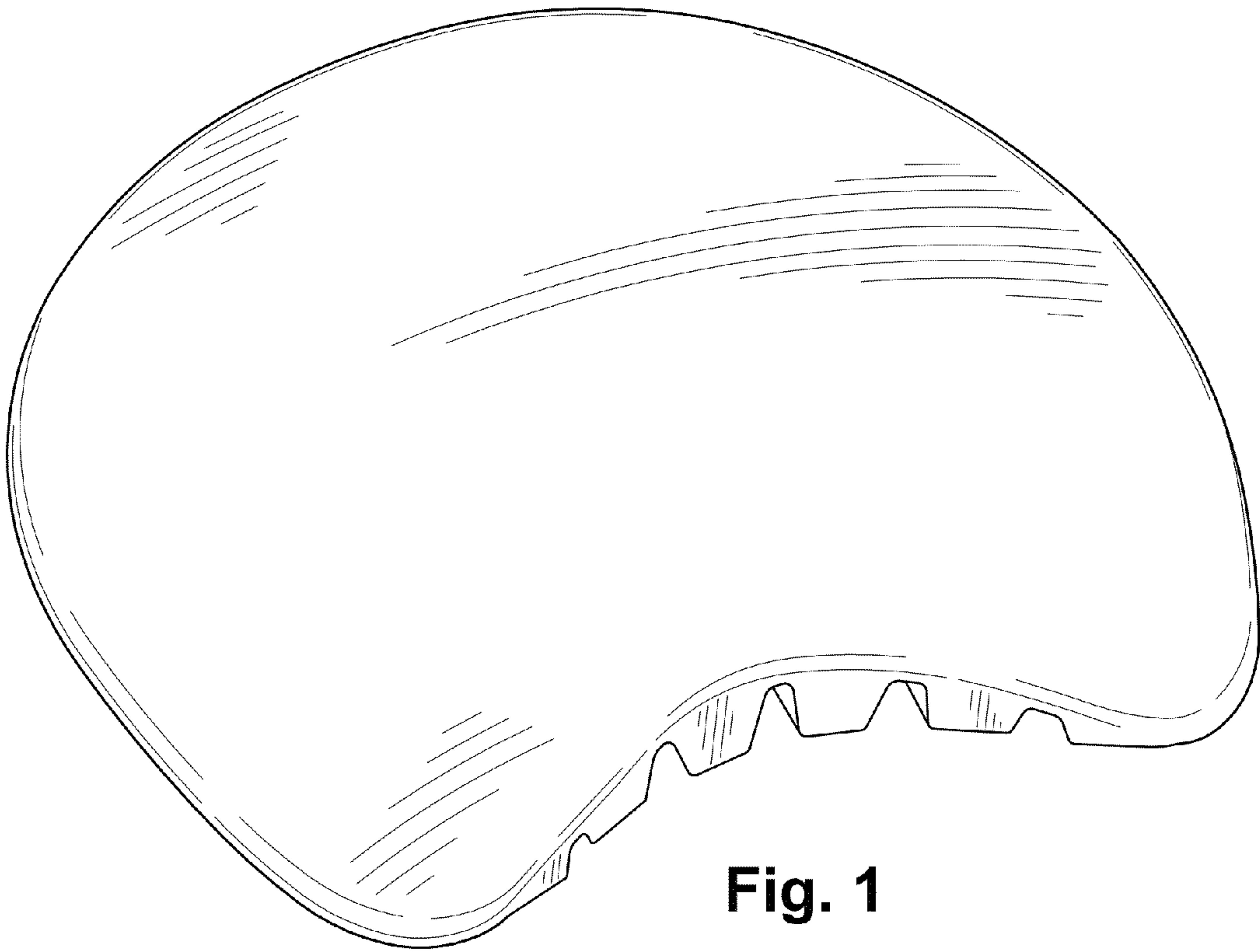

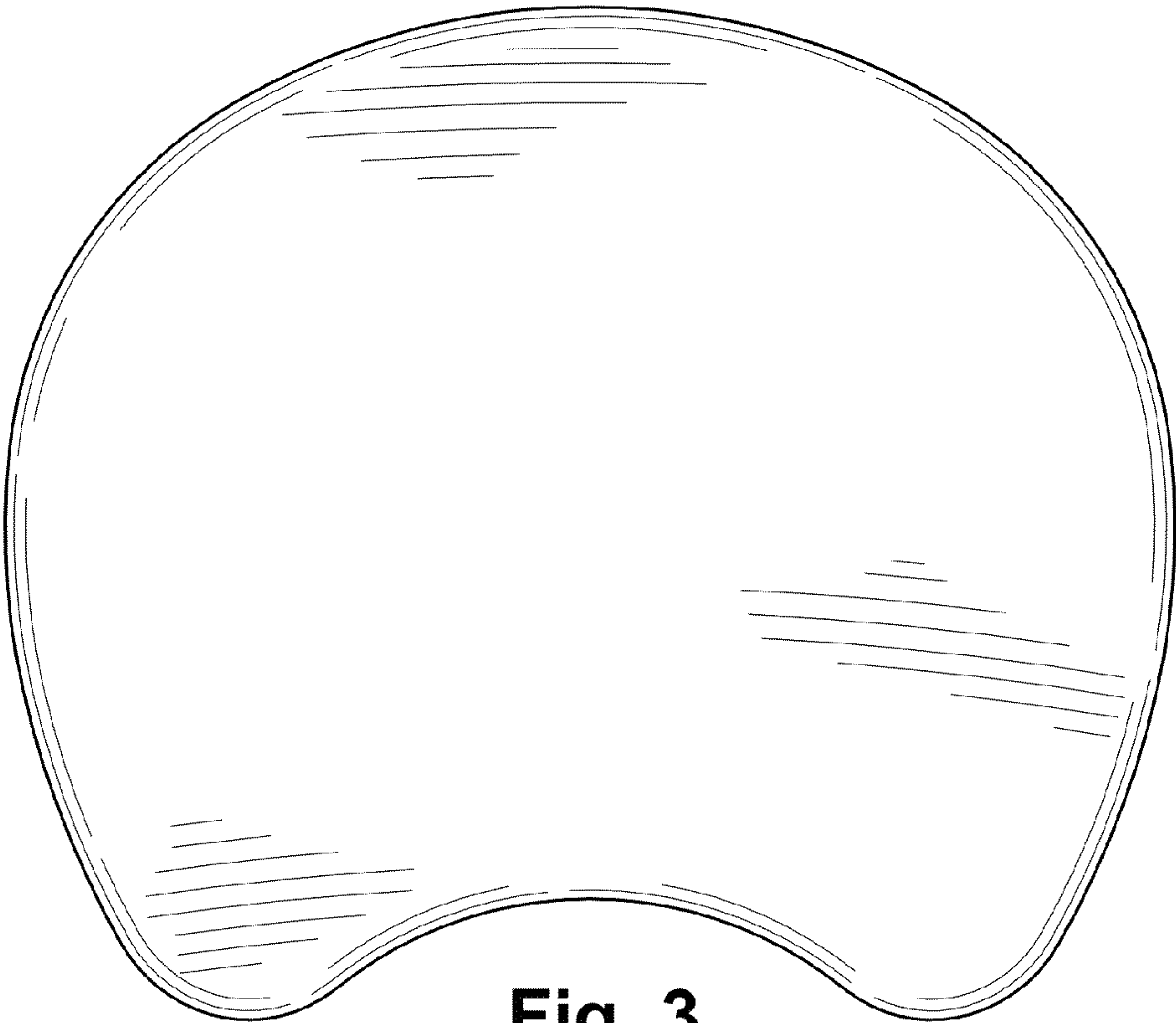

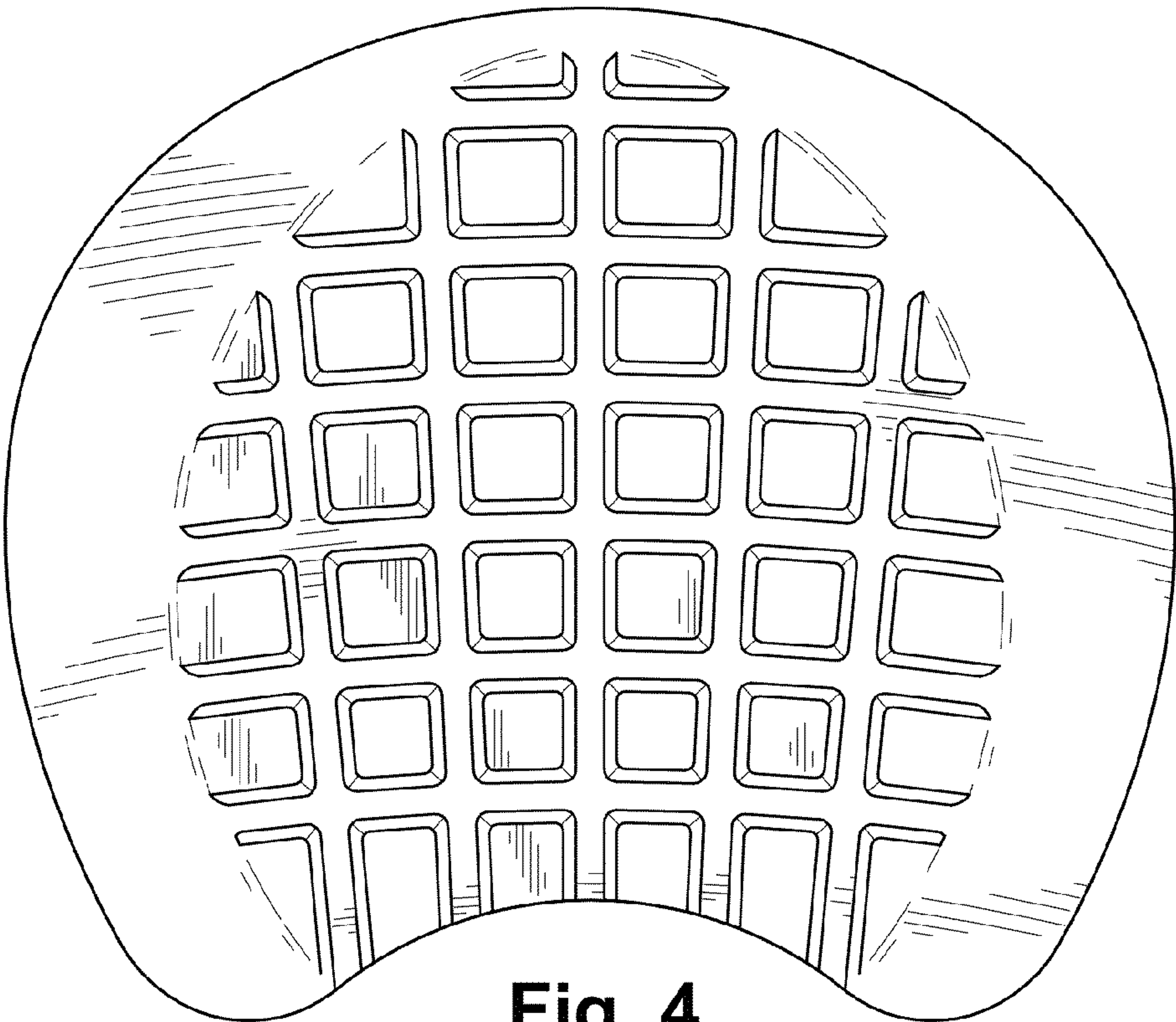

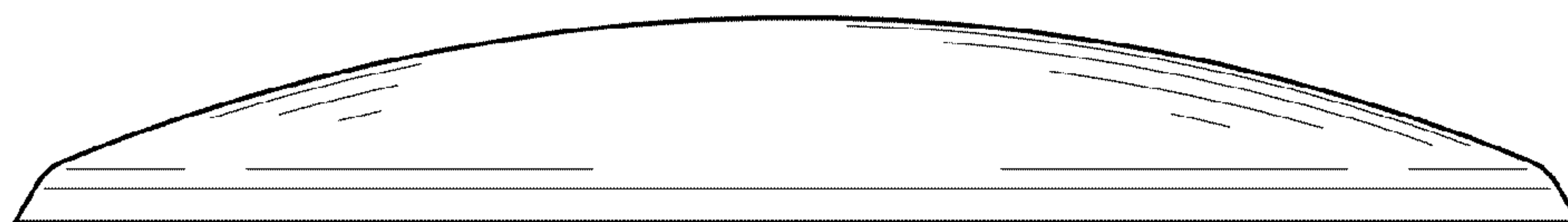

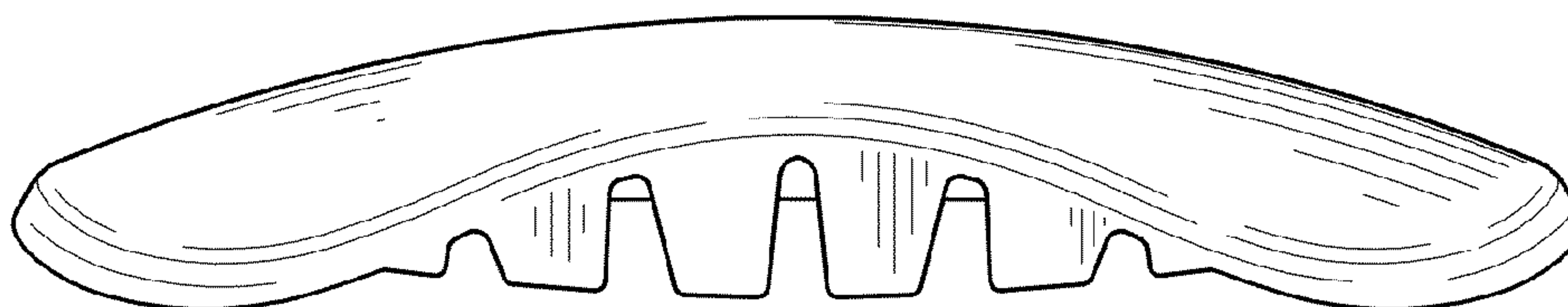

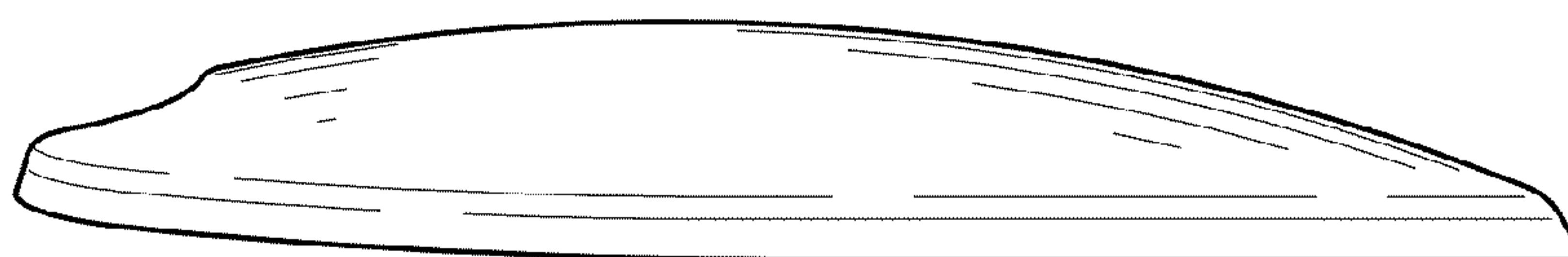

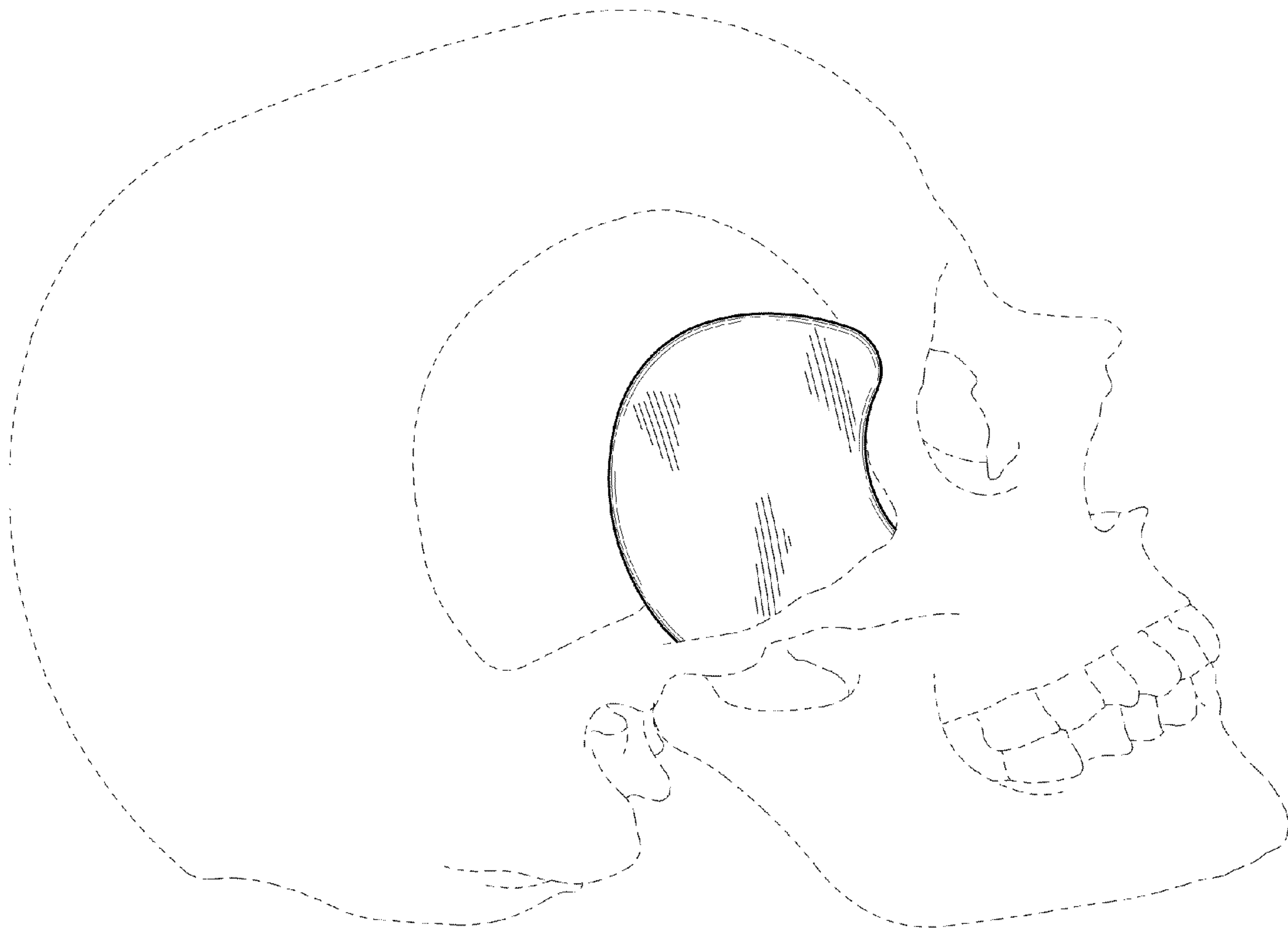
