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(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a bracket for concealing holiday lights, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bracket for concealing holiday lights, showing my new design in an open position; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, illustrated in a closed position;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 3, the left-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

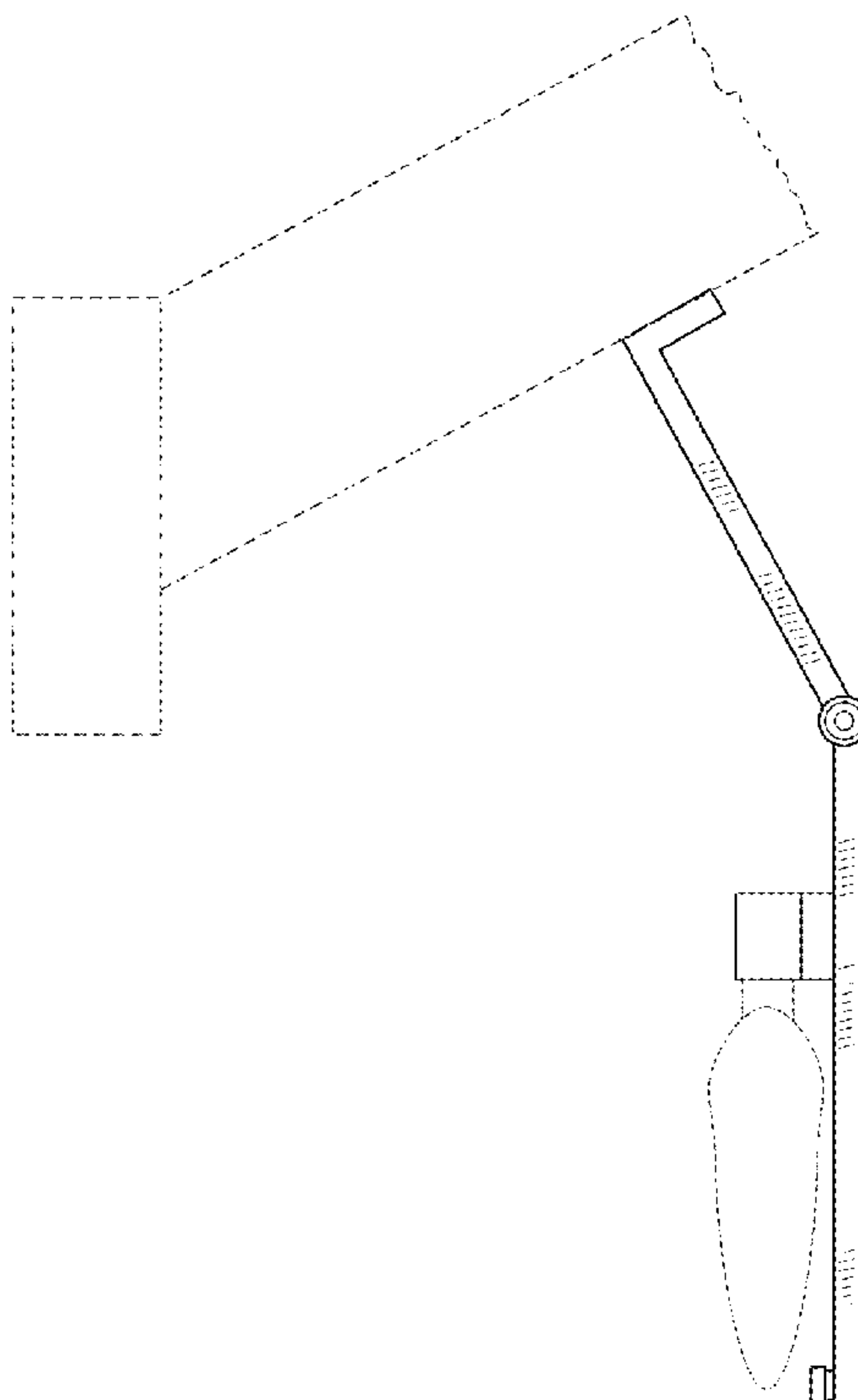
FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 1, the left-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

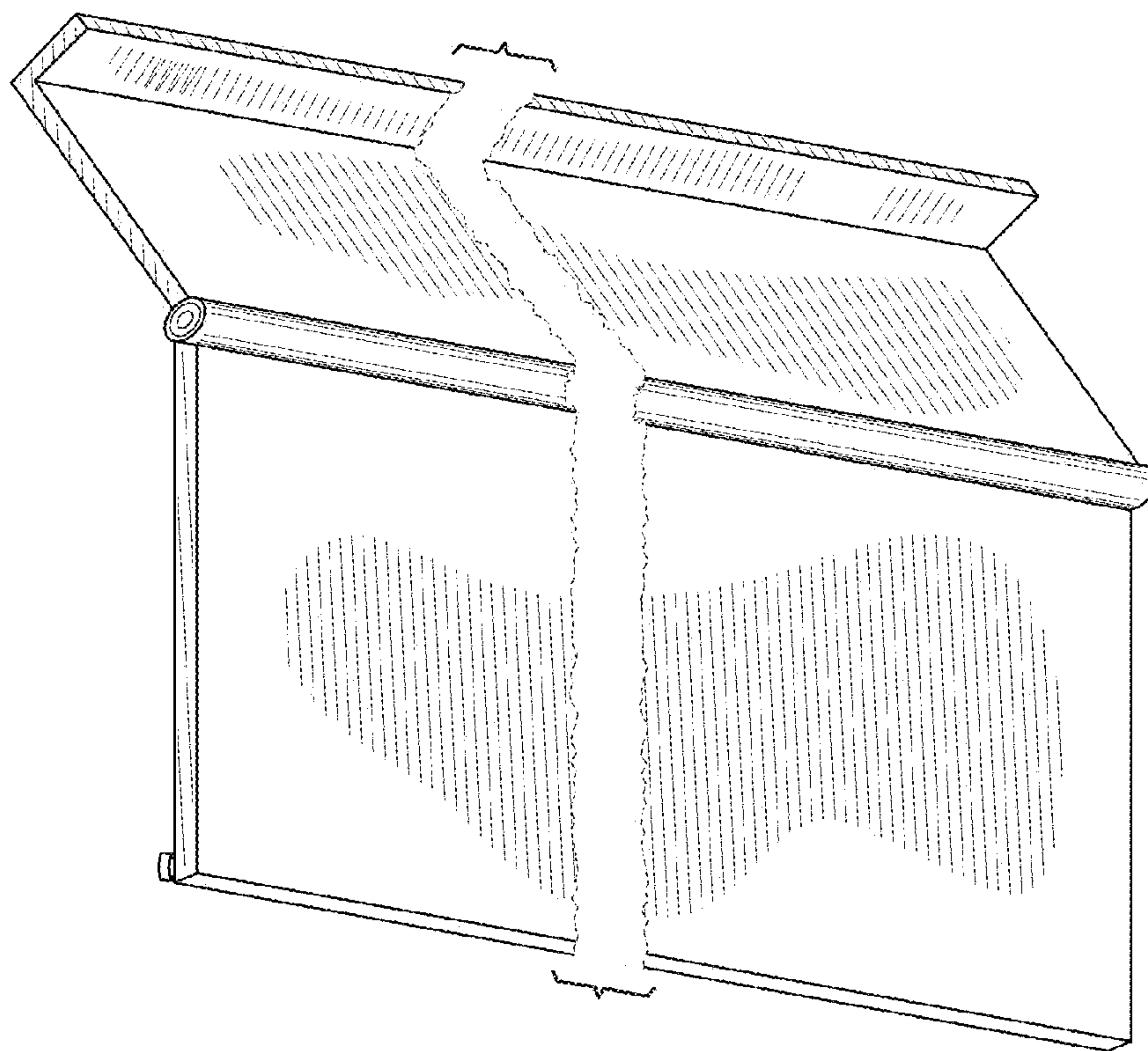

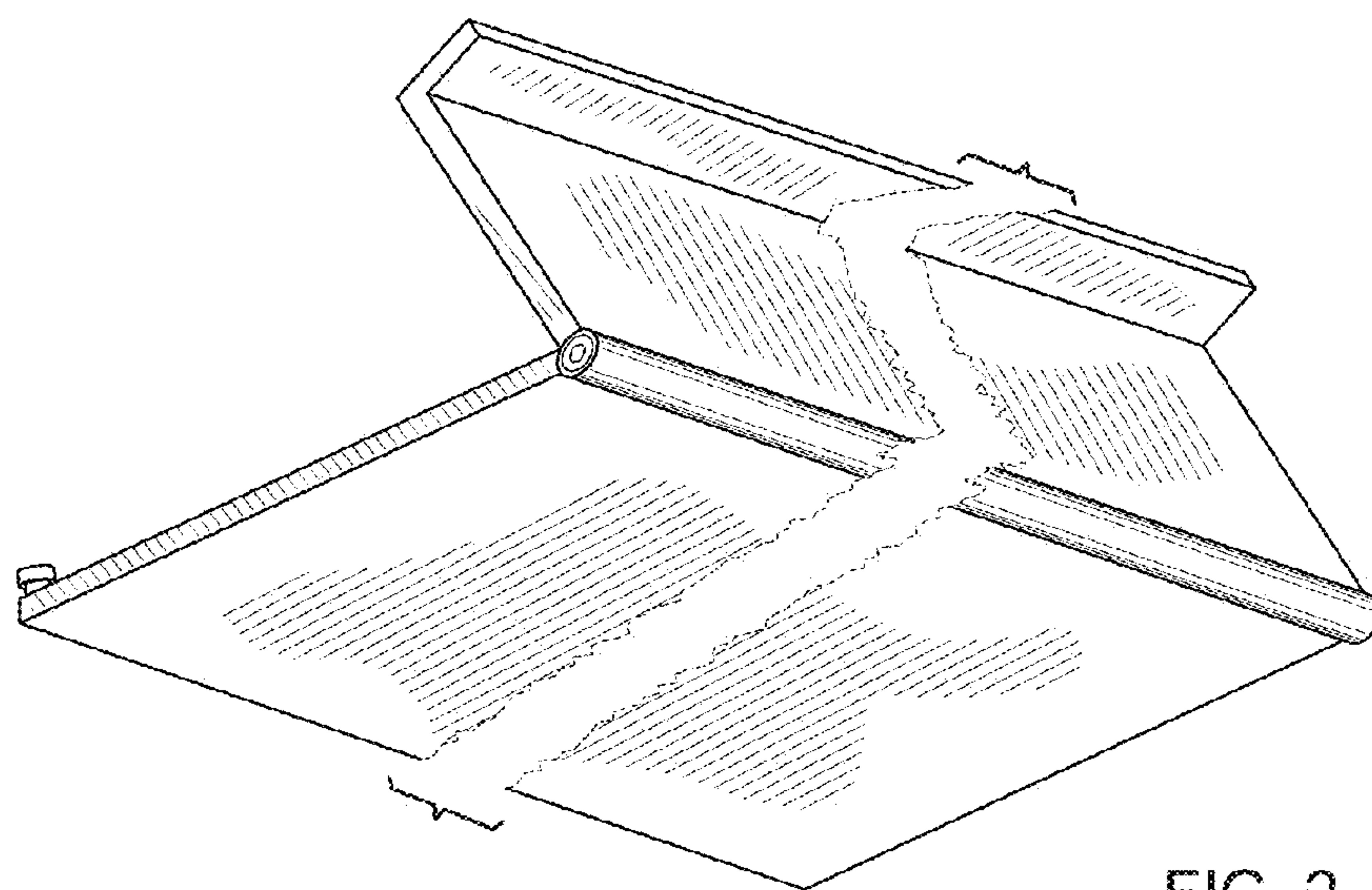

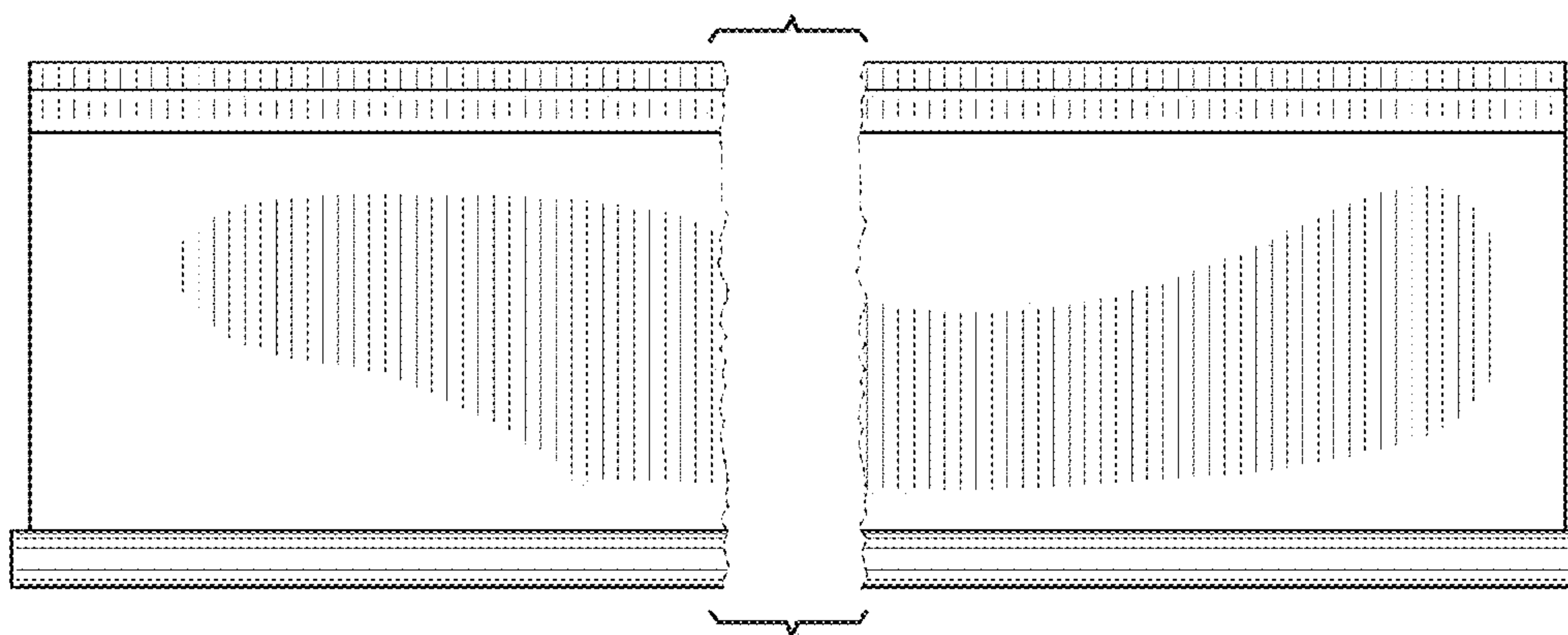

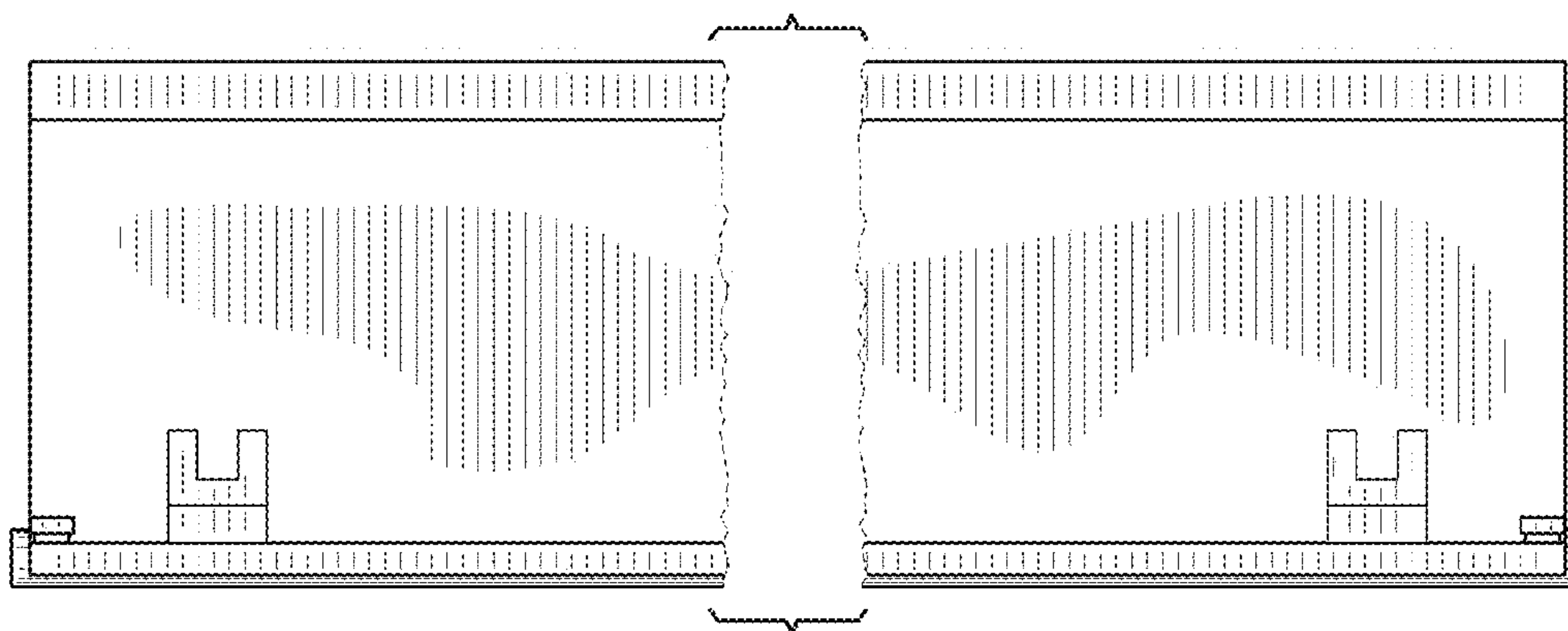

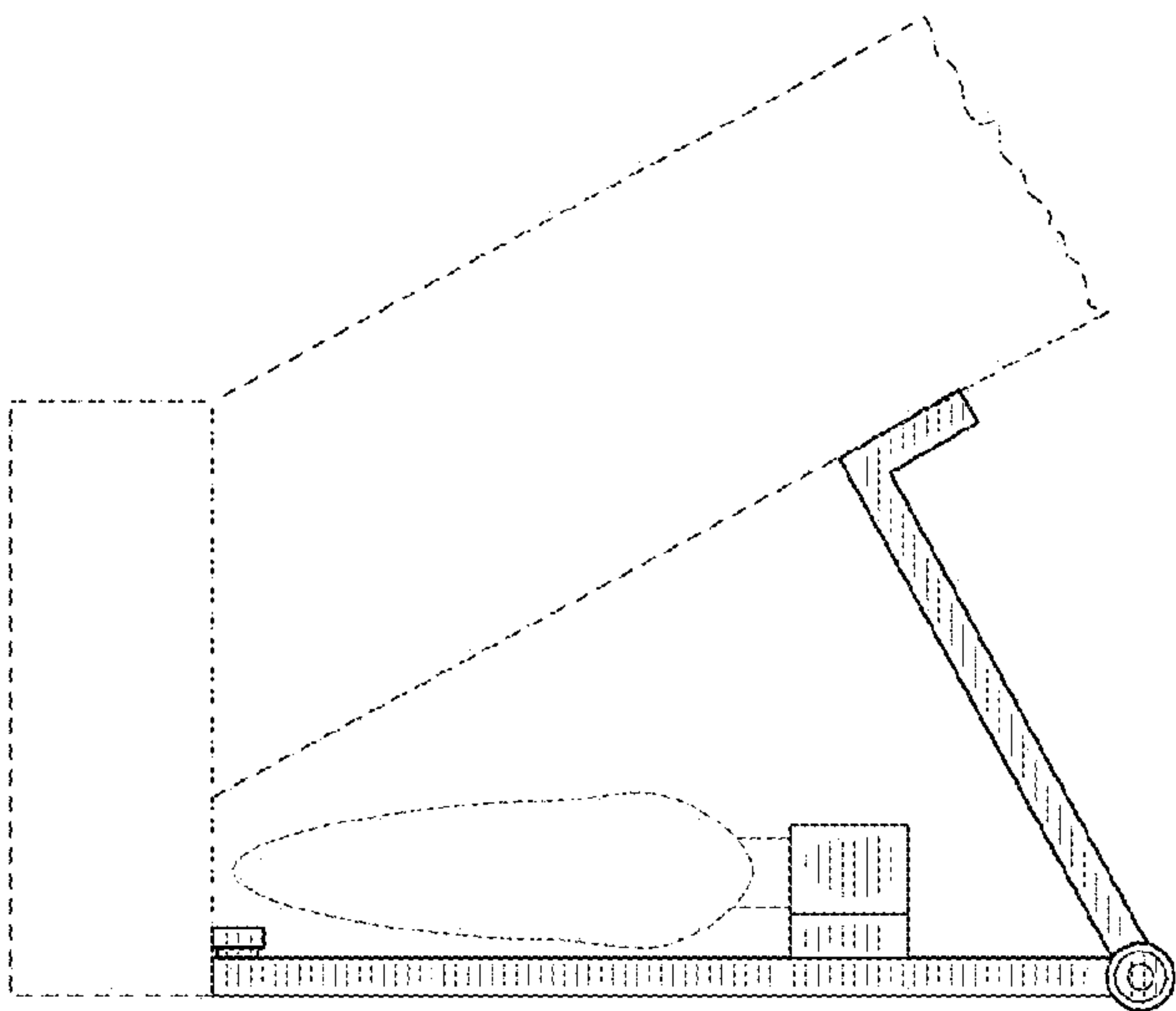

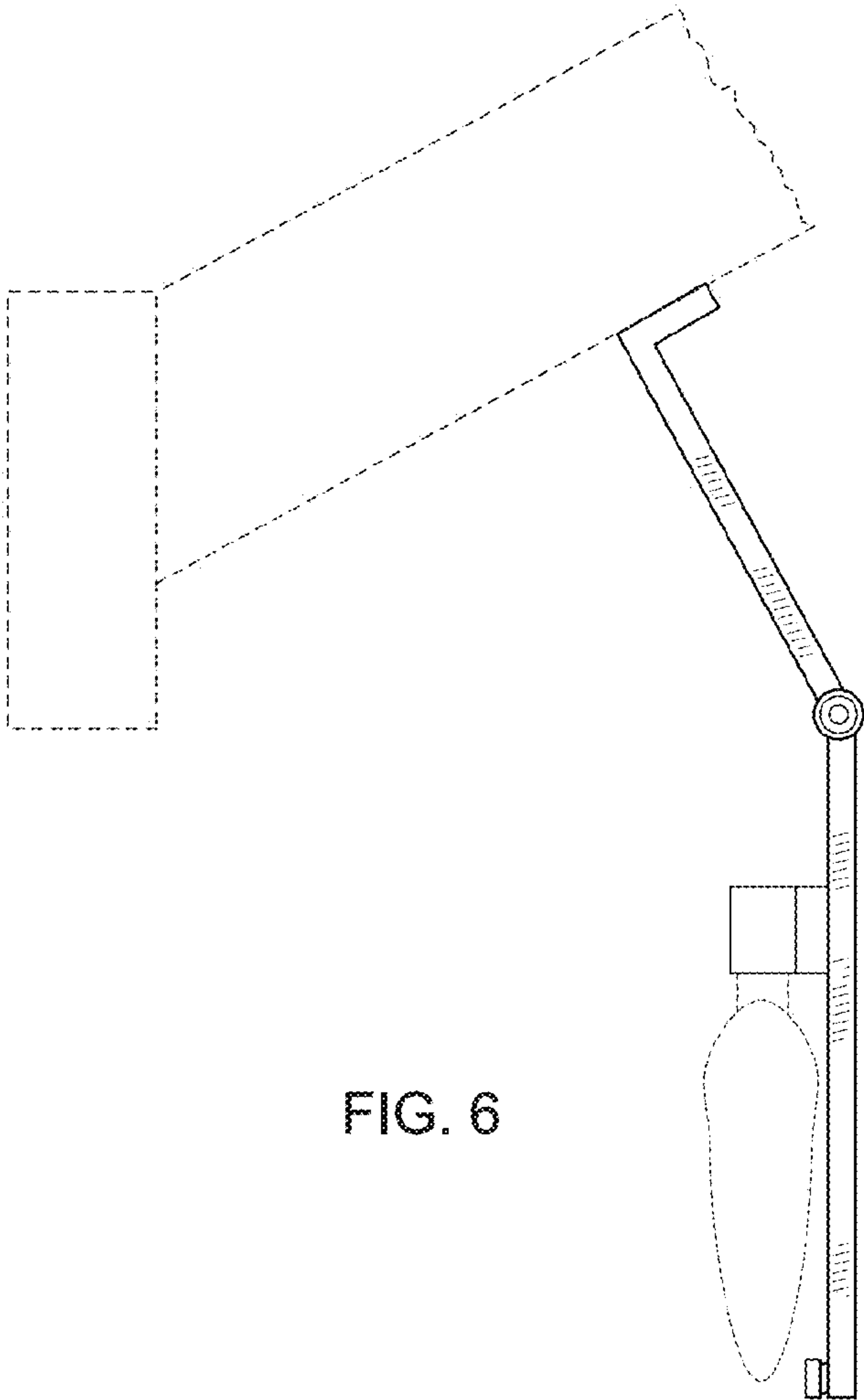

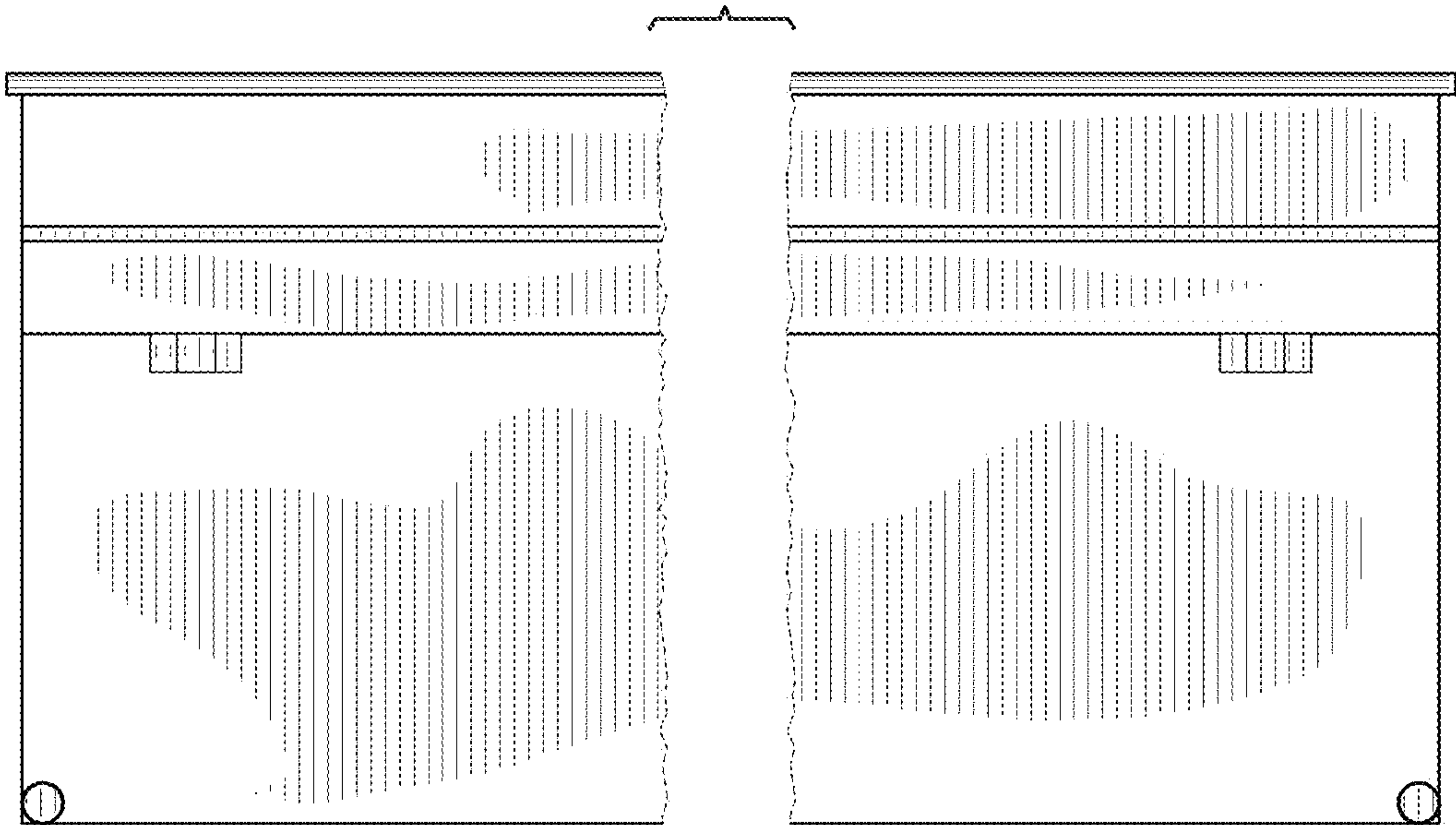

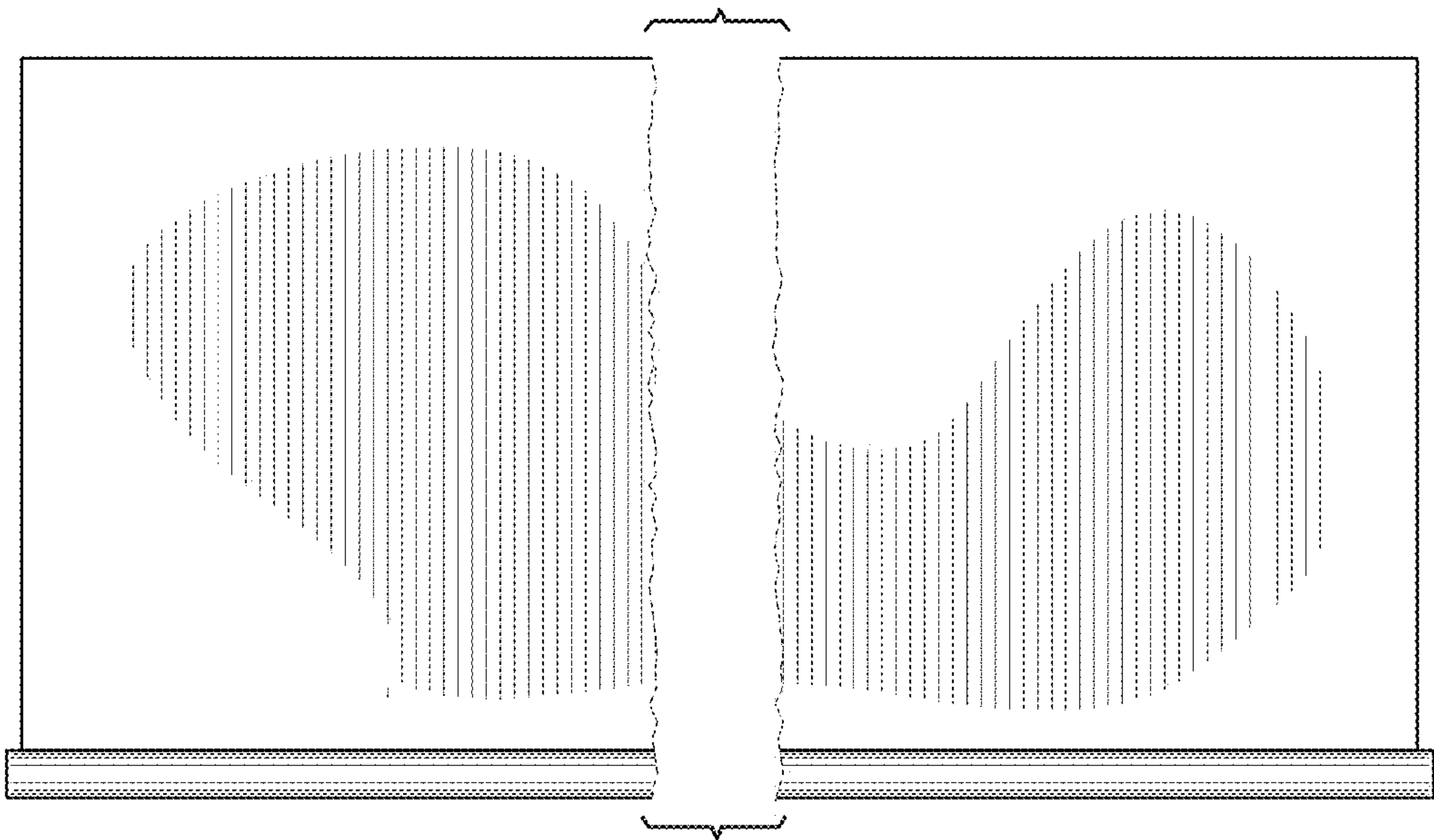
