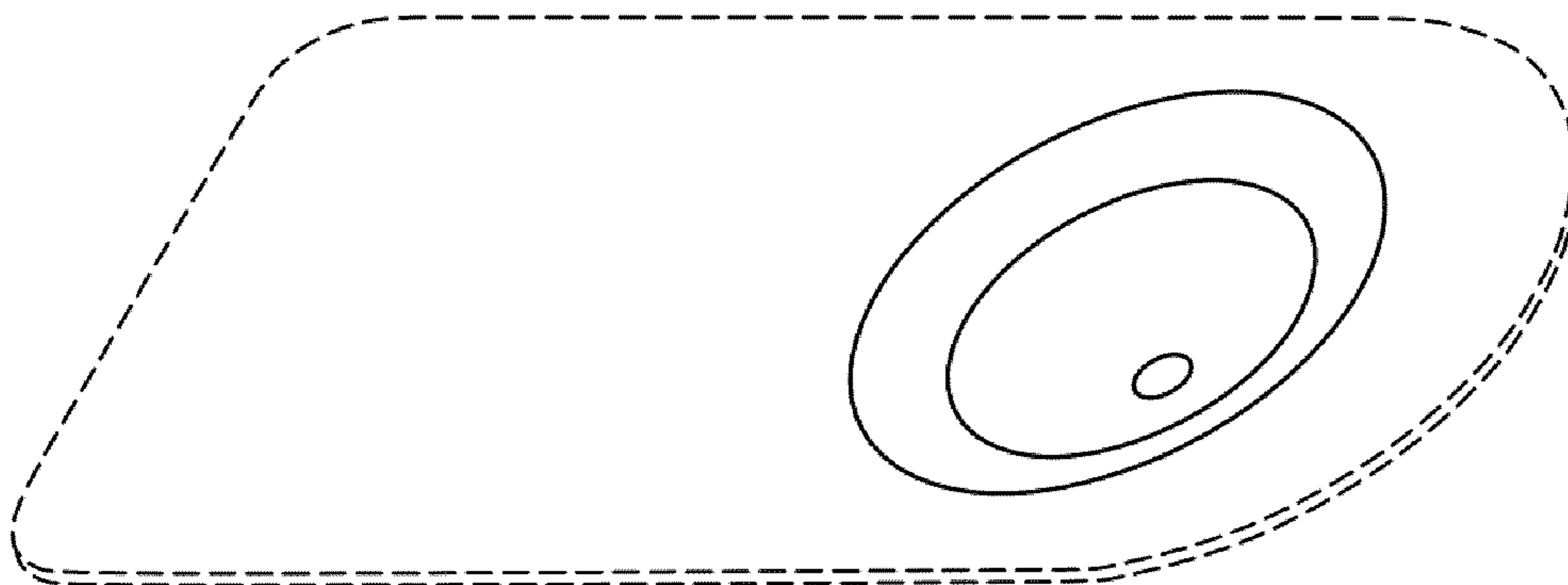
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a neck, spine and spinal cord support device for newborn baby and infant, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective top view of the new design for a neck, spine and spinal cord support device for newborn baby and infant;
FIG. 2 is a top planar view of the support device of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side view of the support device of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 4 is a front or rear side view of support device of FIG. 1.

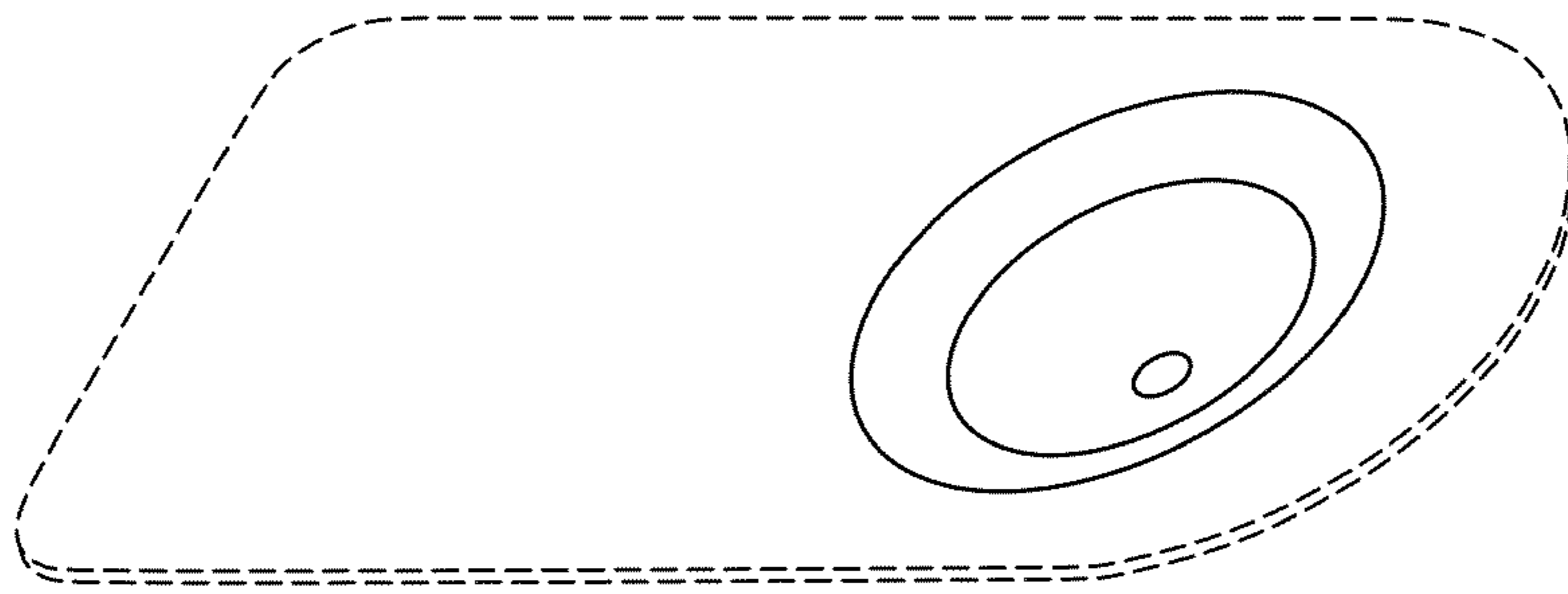

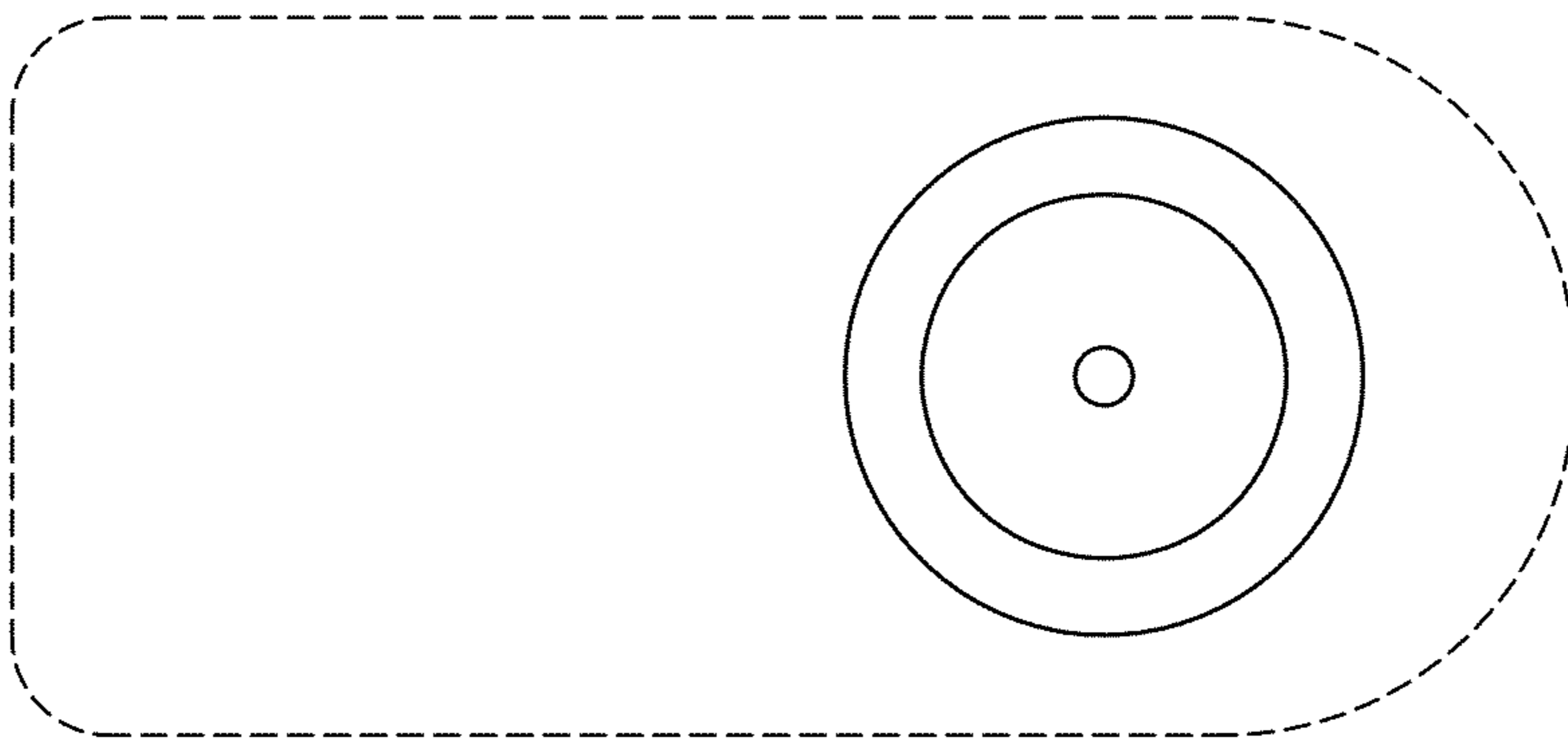

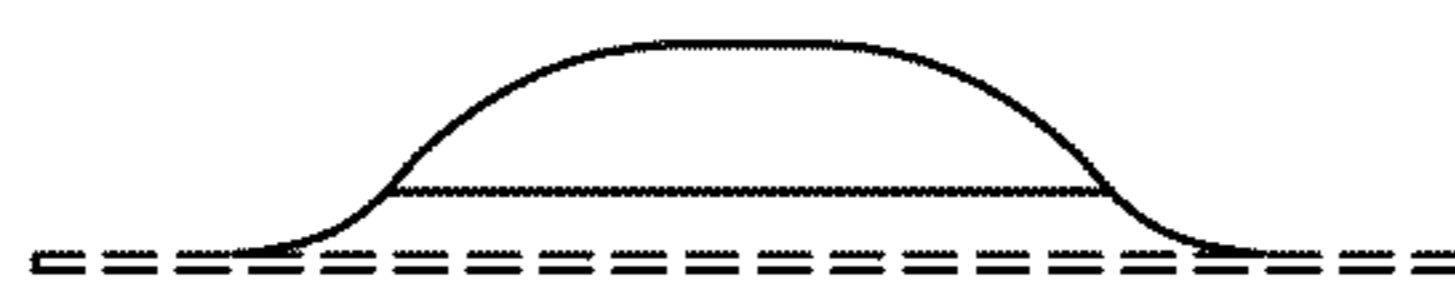
