FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

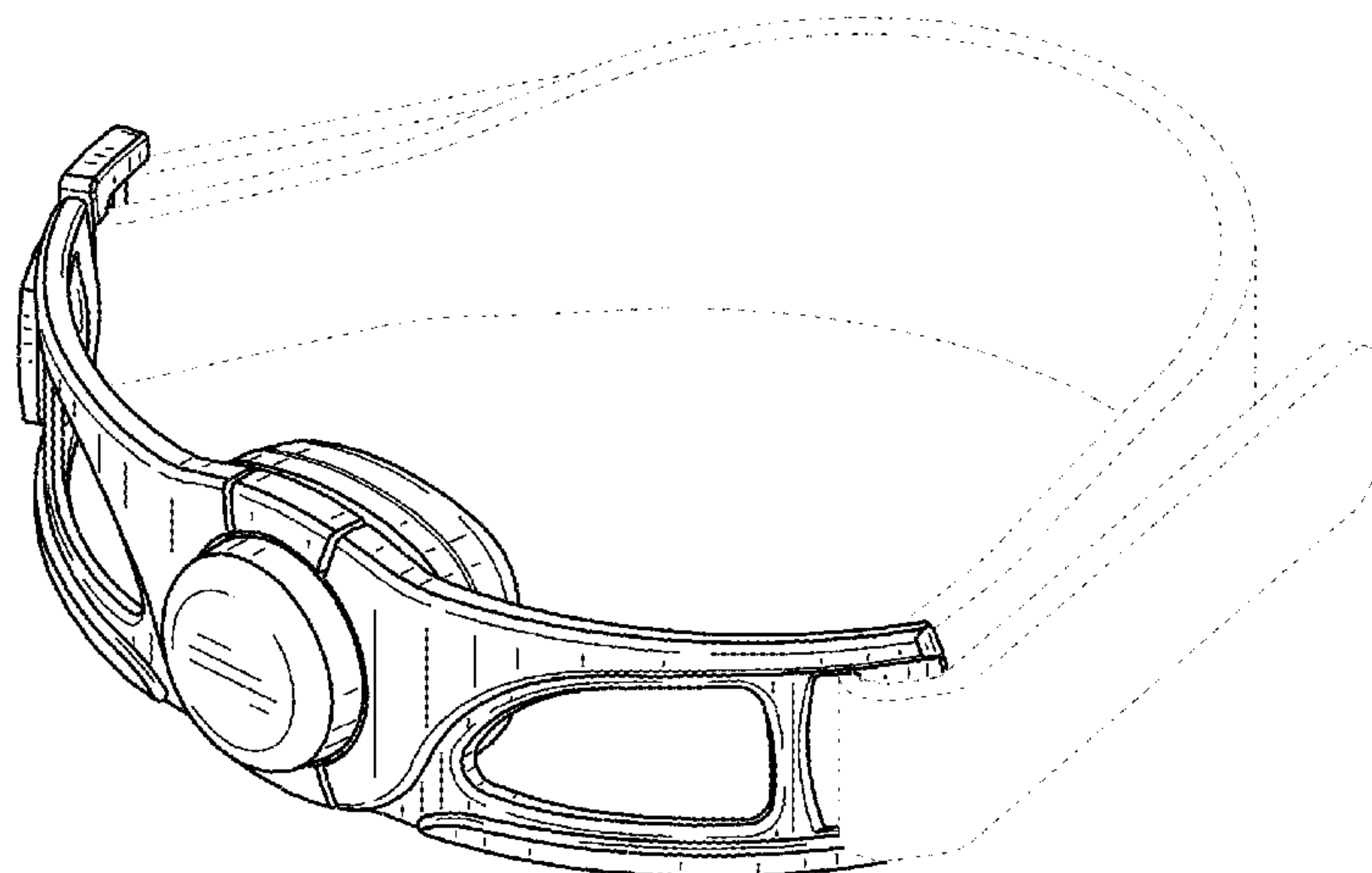
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and,

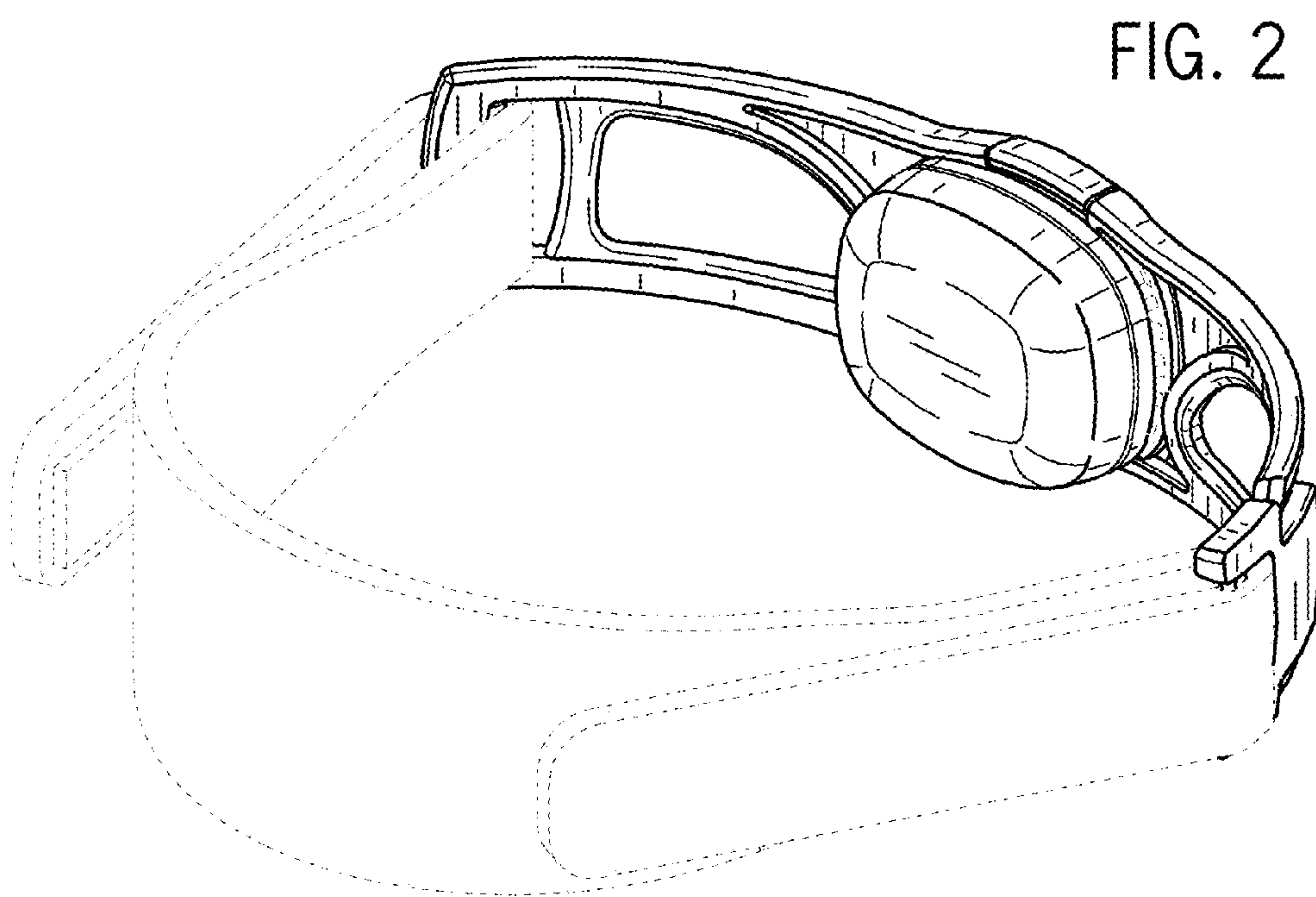
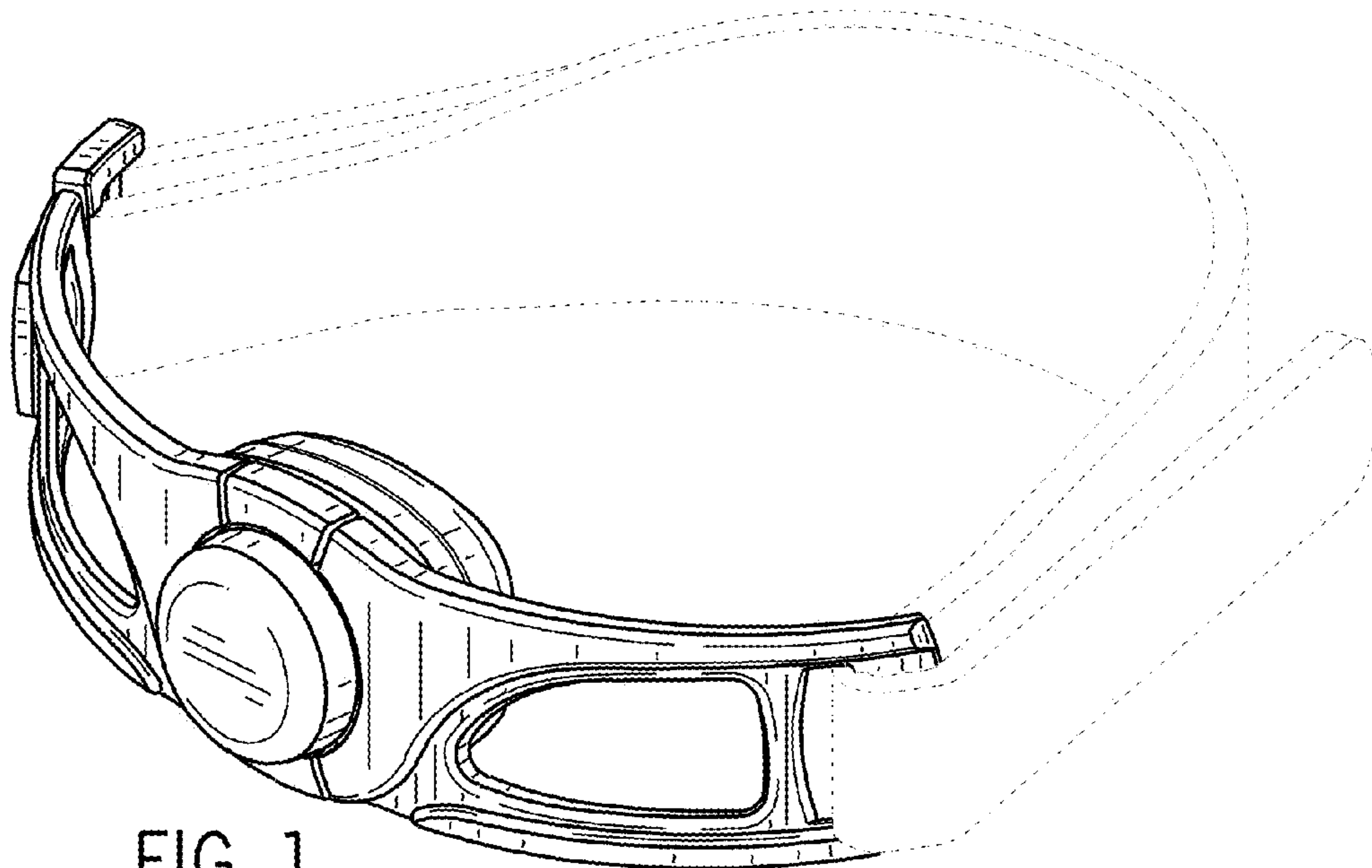
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

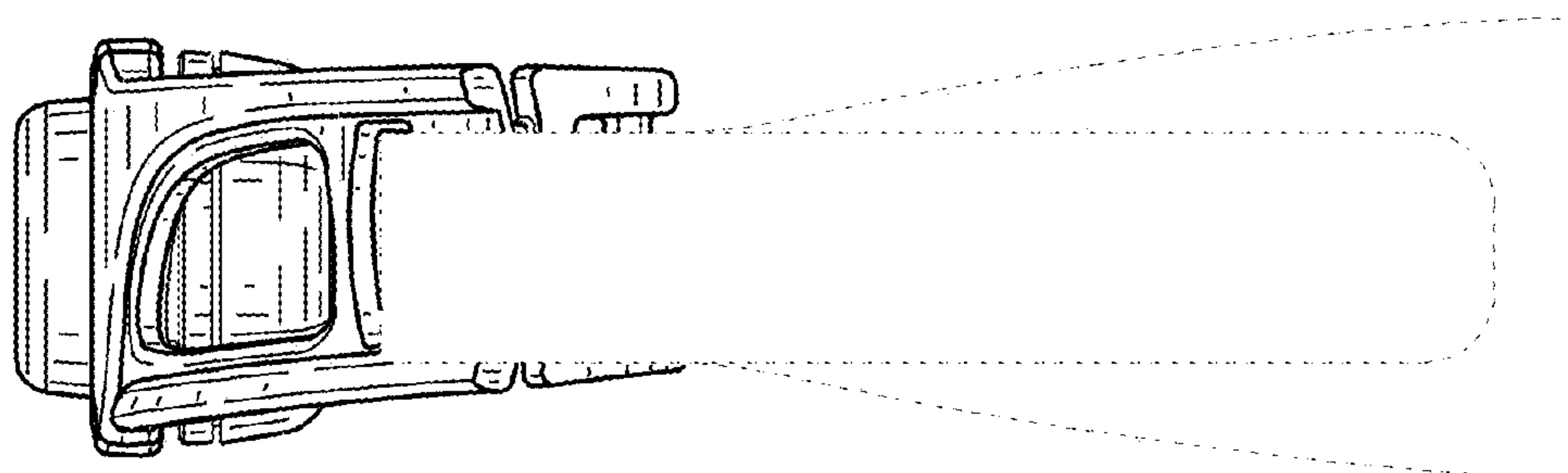

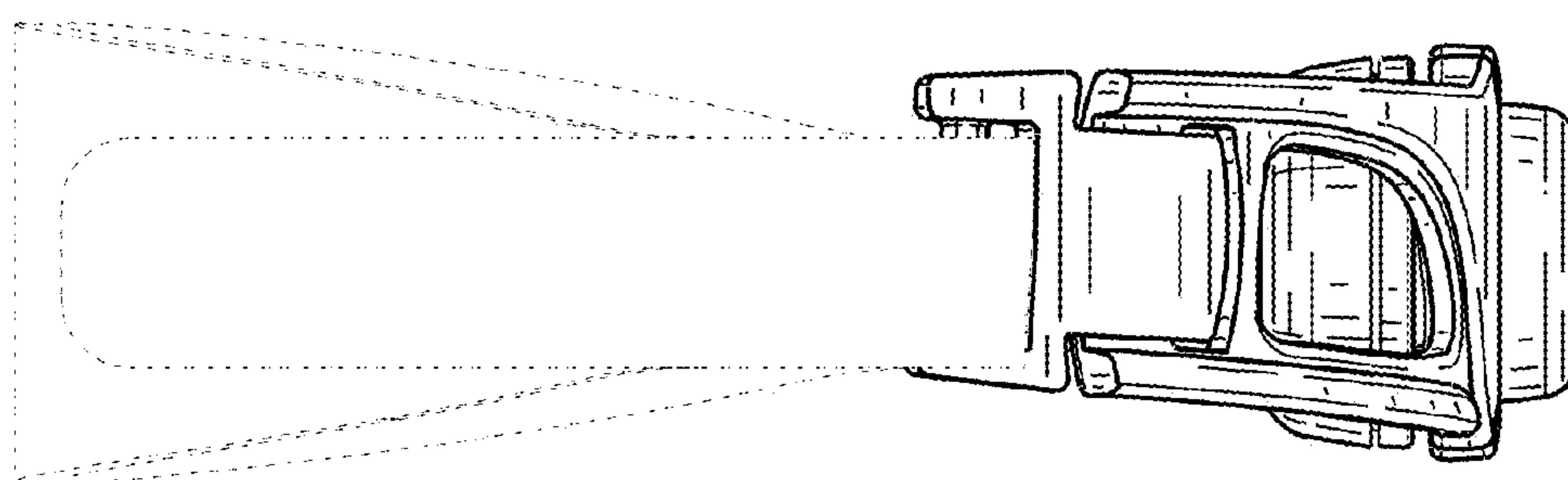

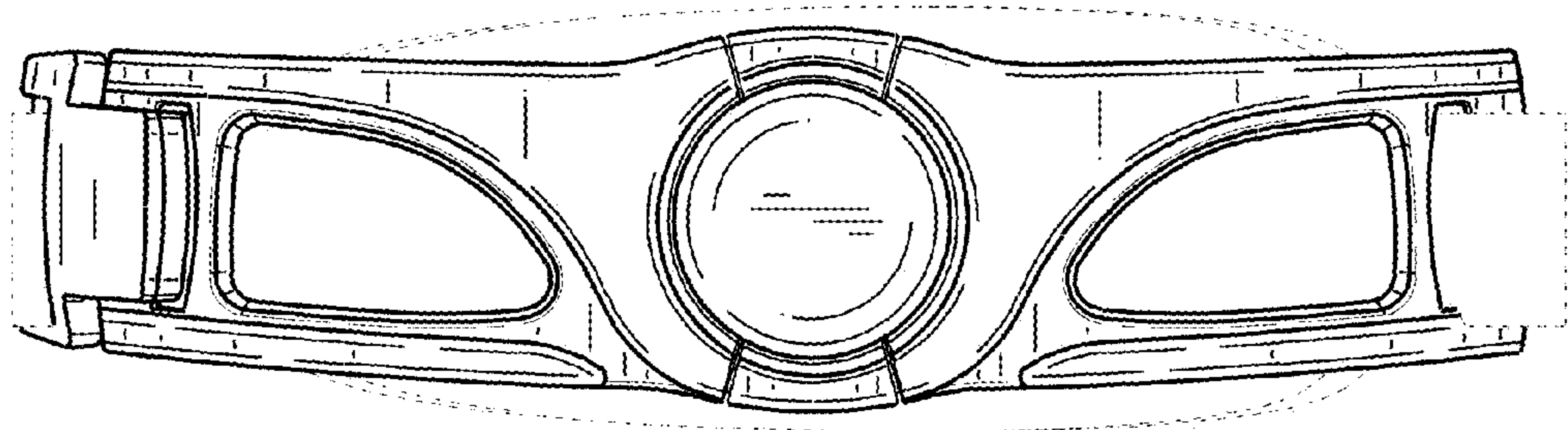

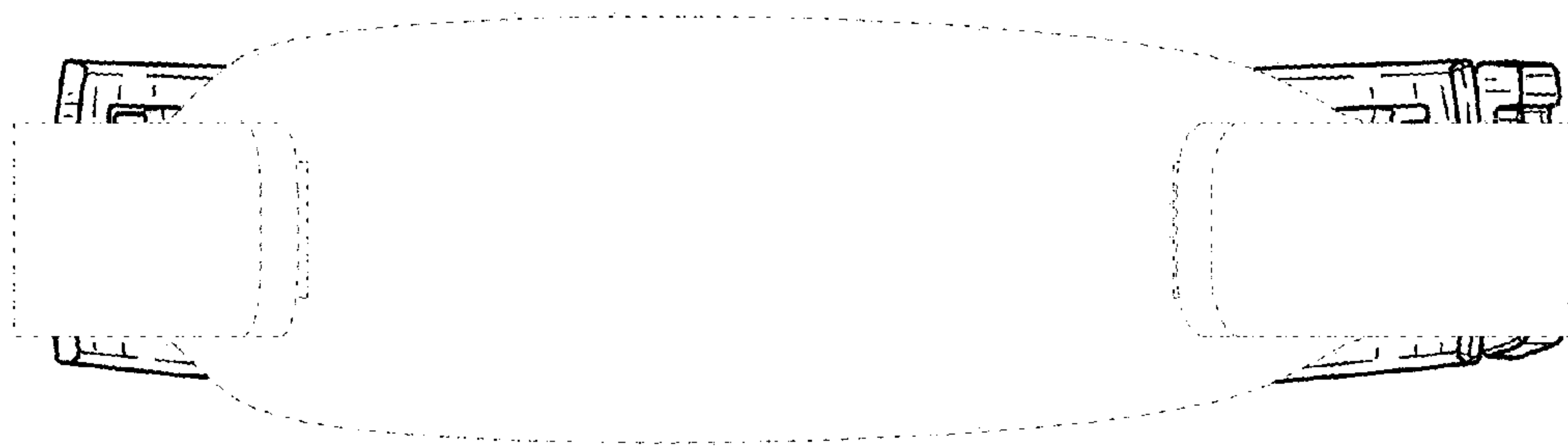

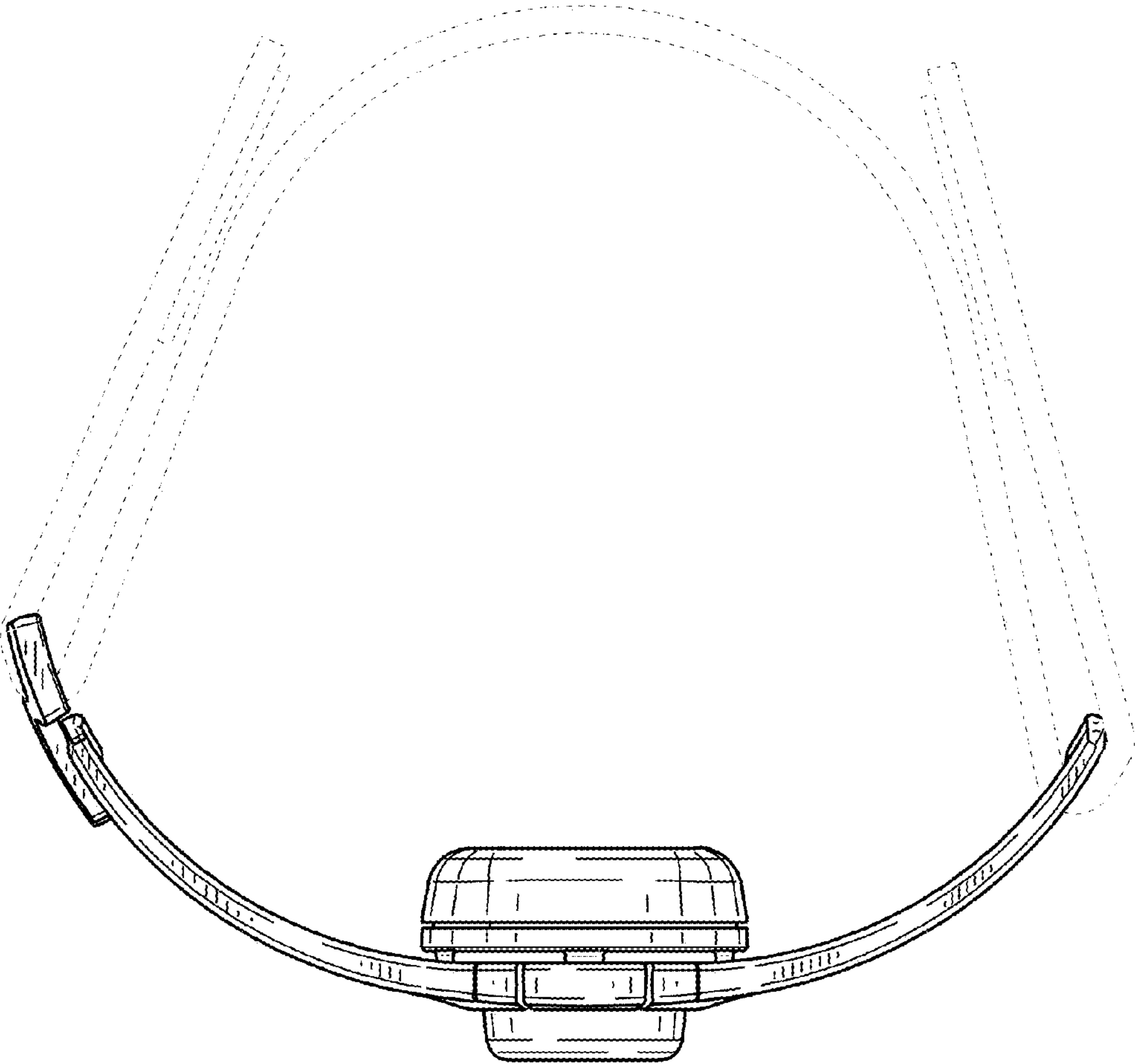

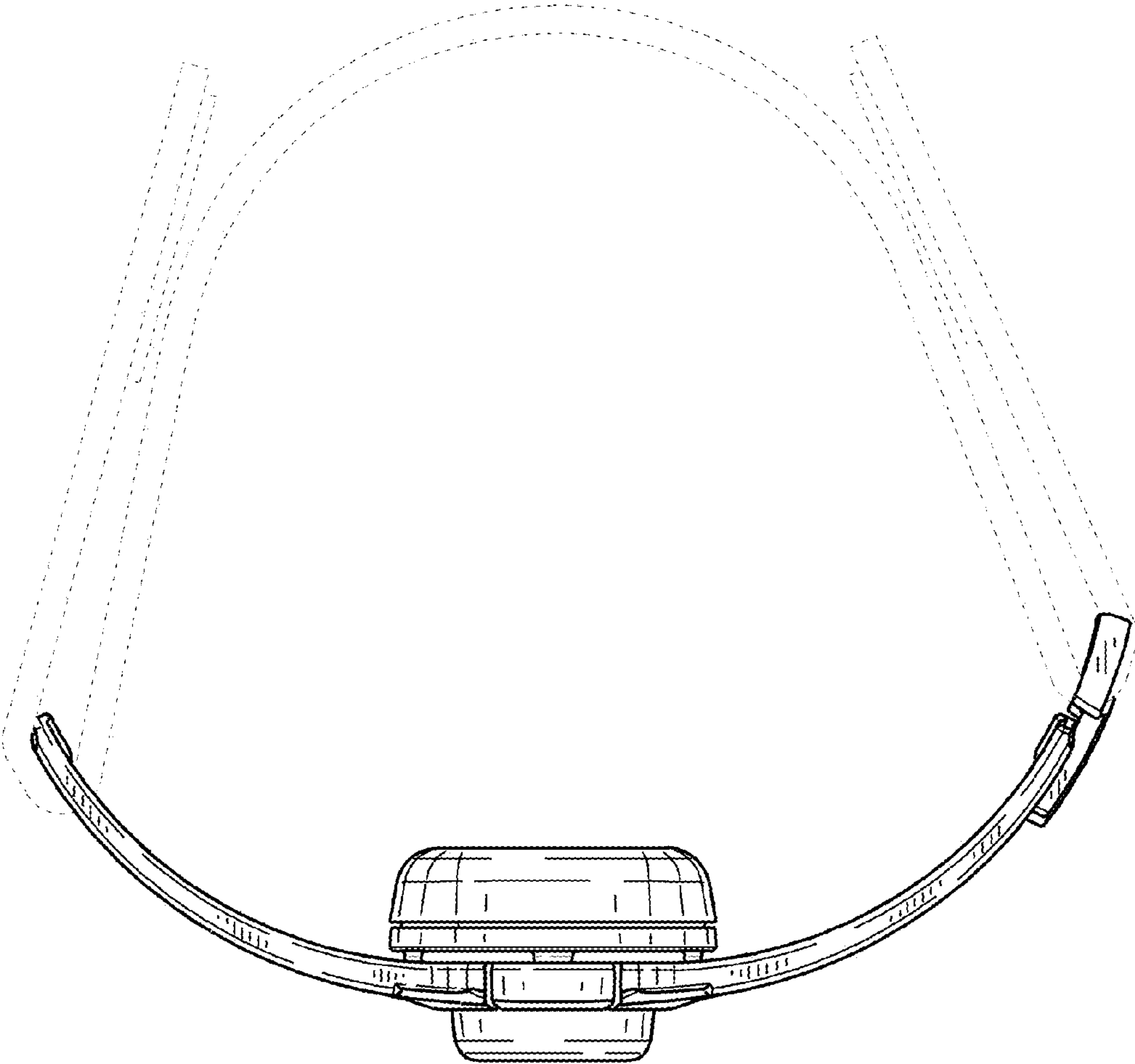
