(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bait mask fishing lure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of the bait mask fishing lure having printed indicia as shown on a bait fish environment;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the first embodiment of the bait mask fishing lure having printed indicia.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the bait mask fishing lure of FIGS. 1 and 2.

FIG. 4 is a front view of the bait mask fishing lure of FIGS. 1 and 2.

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the bait mask fishing lure of FIGS. 1 and 2; the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear view of the bait mask fishing lure of FIGS. 1 and 2.

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the bait mask fishing lure of FIGS. 1 and 2.

FIG. 8 is a front view of a second embodiment of the bait mask fishing lure in which the bait mask fishing lure of FIGS. 1 and 2 has barbs which extend from the sides of the bait mask fishing lure.

FIG. 9 is a rear view of the second embodiment of the bait mask fishing lure in which the bait mask fishing lure of FIGS. 1 and 2 has barbs which extend from the sides of the bait mask fishing lure.

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view of the bait mask fishing lure of FIGS. 1 and 2 without the printed indicia; the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 11 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of the bait mask fishing lure having printed indicia;

FIG. 12 is a top plan view of the bait mask fishing lure of FIG. 11.

FIG. 13 is a front view of the bait mask fishing lure of FIG. 11.

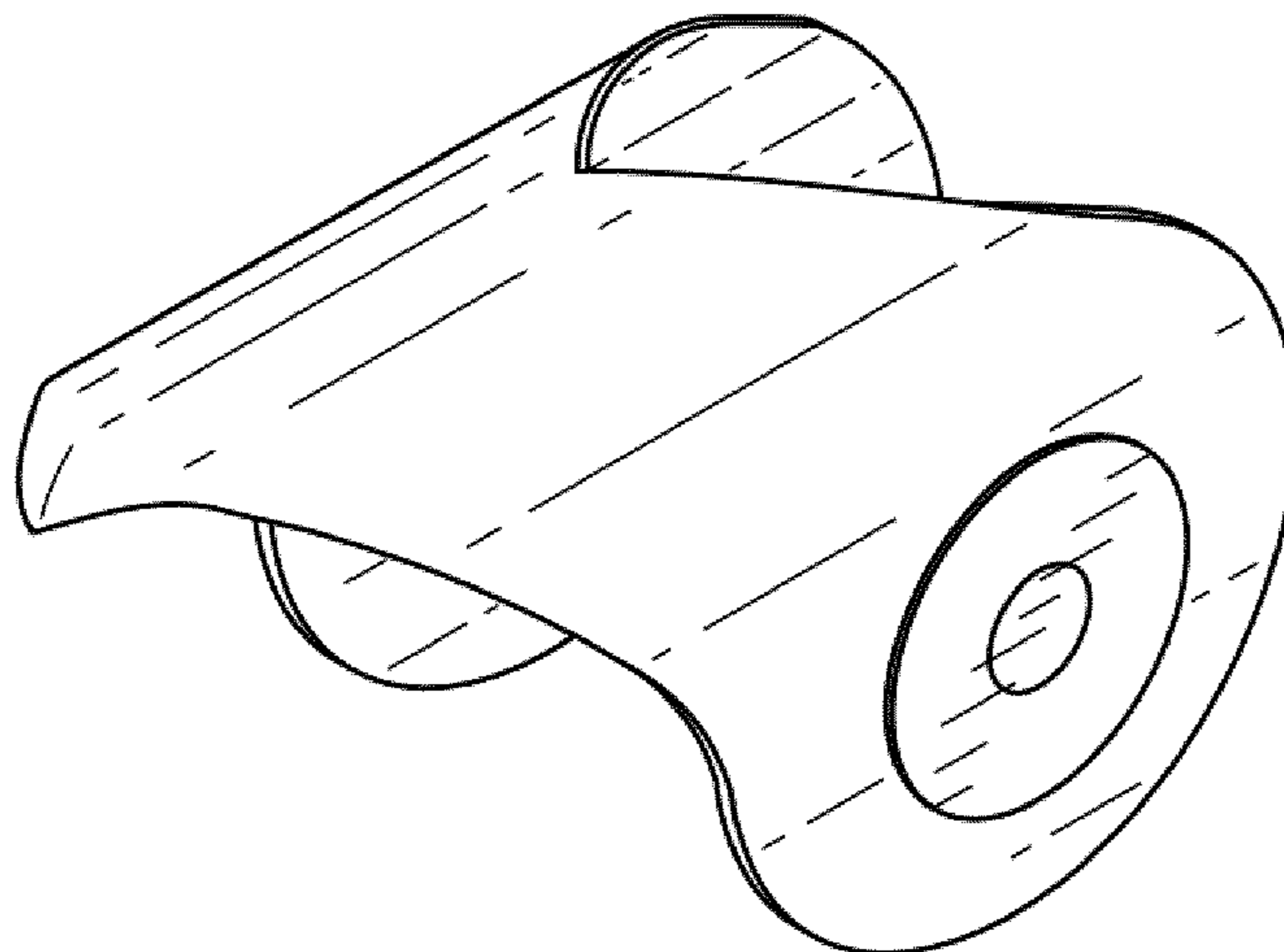
FIG. 14 is a right side elevational view of the bait mask fishing lure of FIG. 11; the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

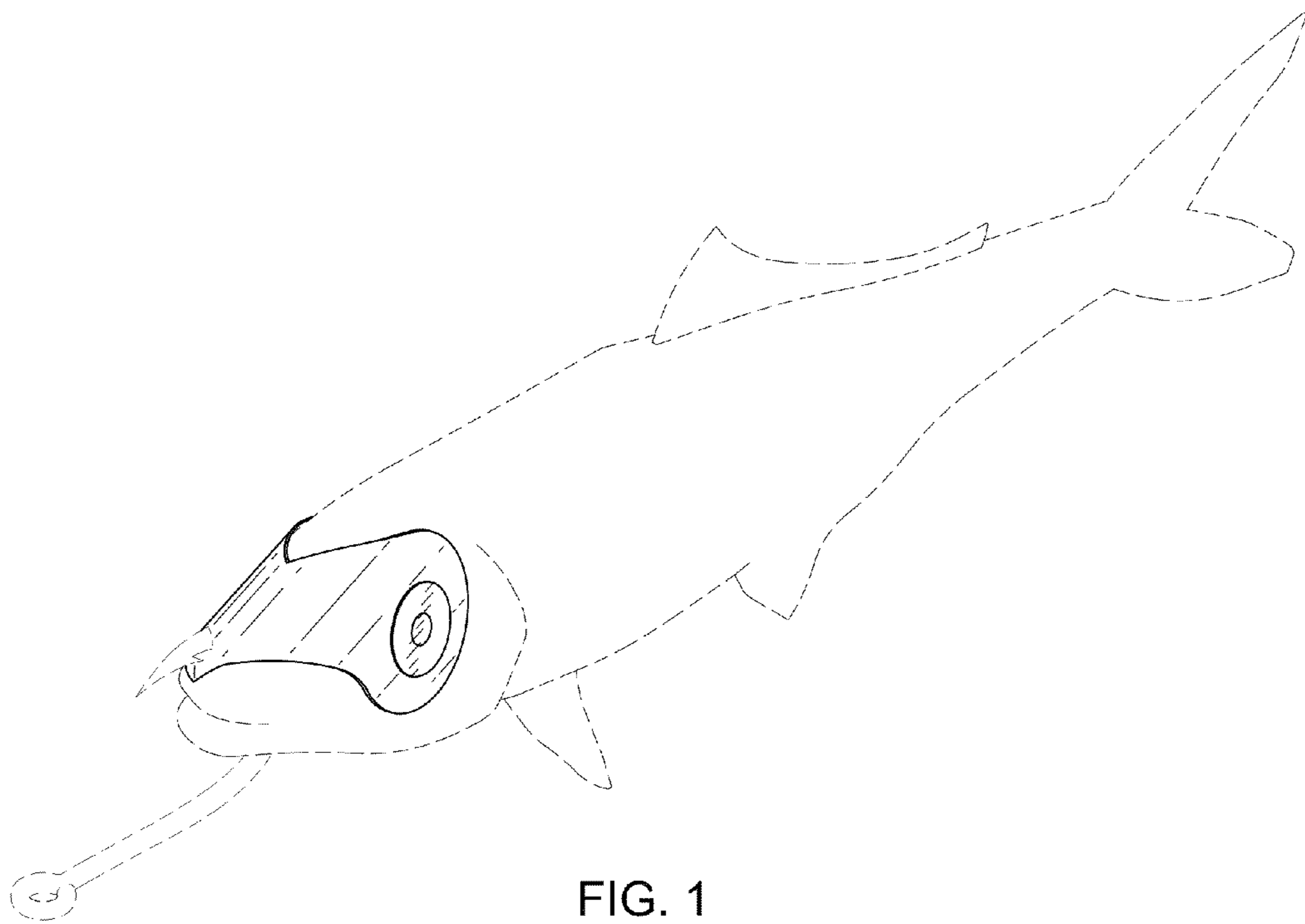
FIG. 15 is a rear view of the bait mask fishing lure of FIG. 11; and,

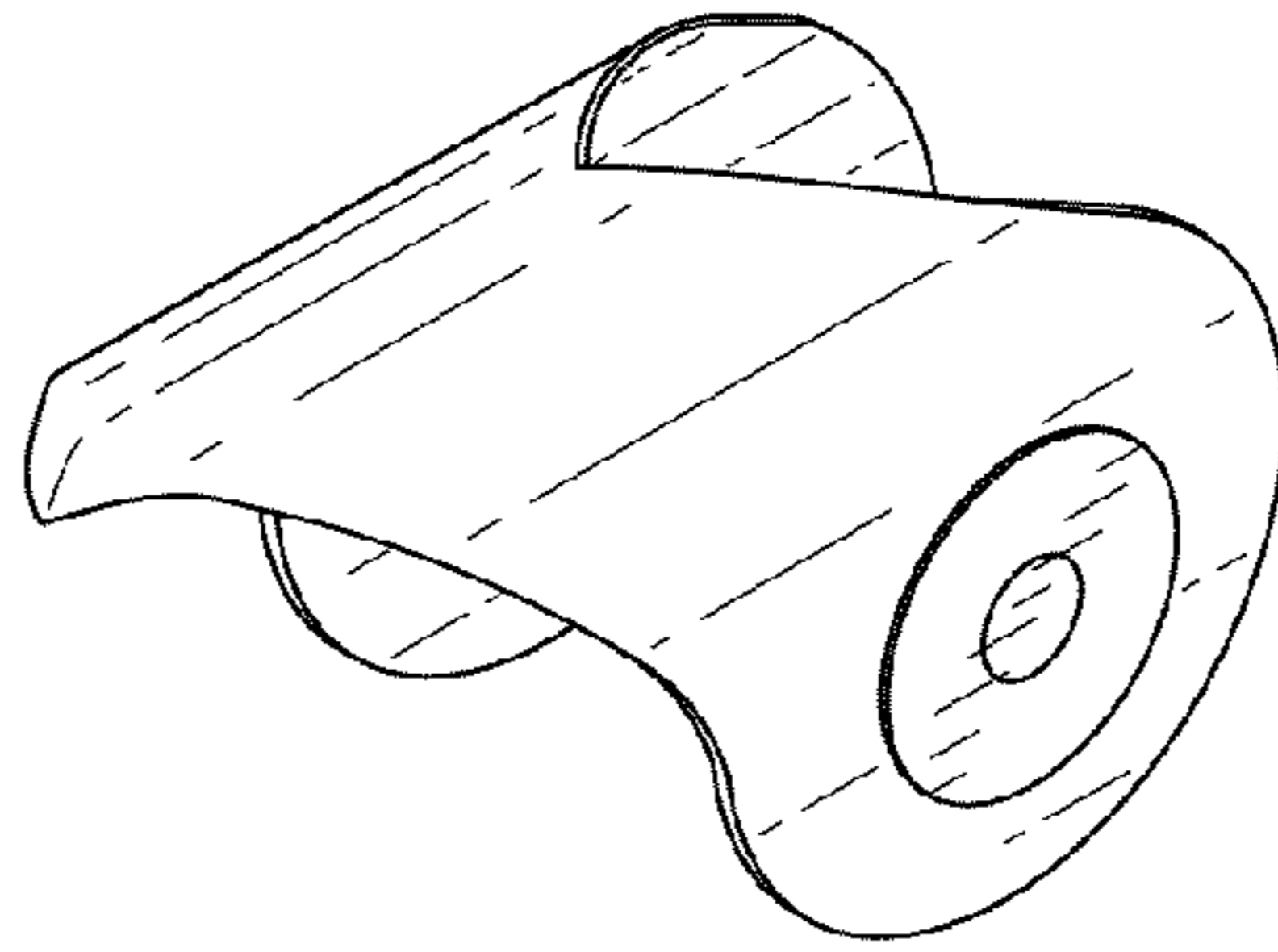

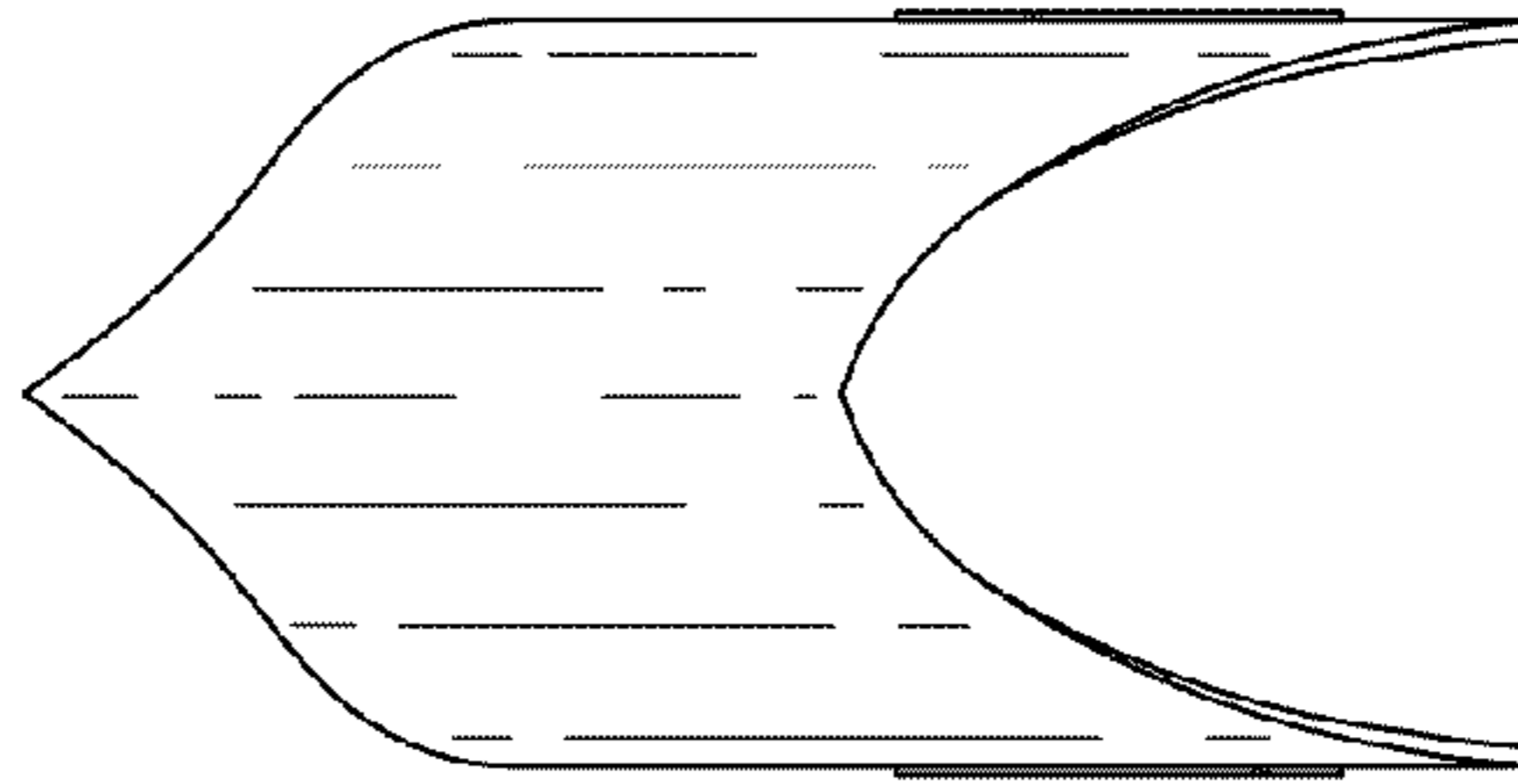

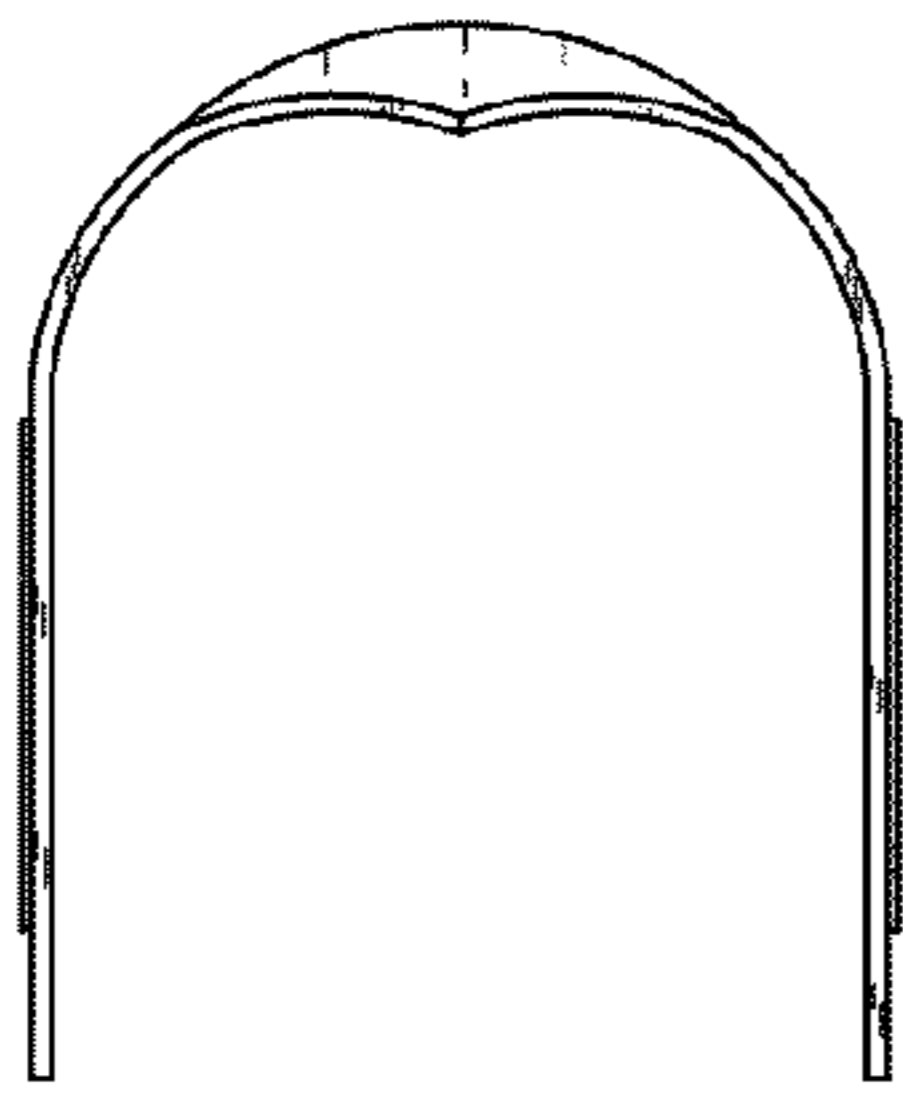

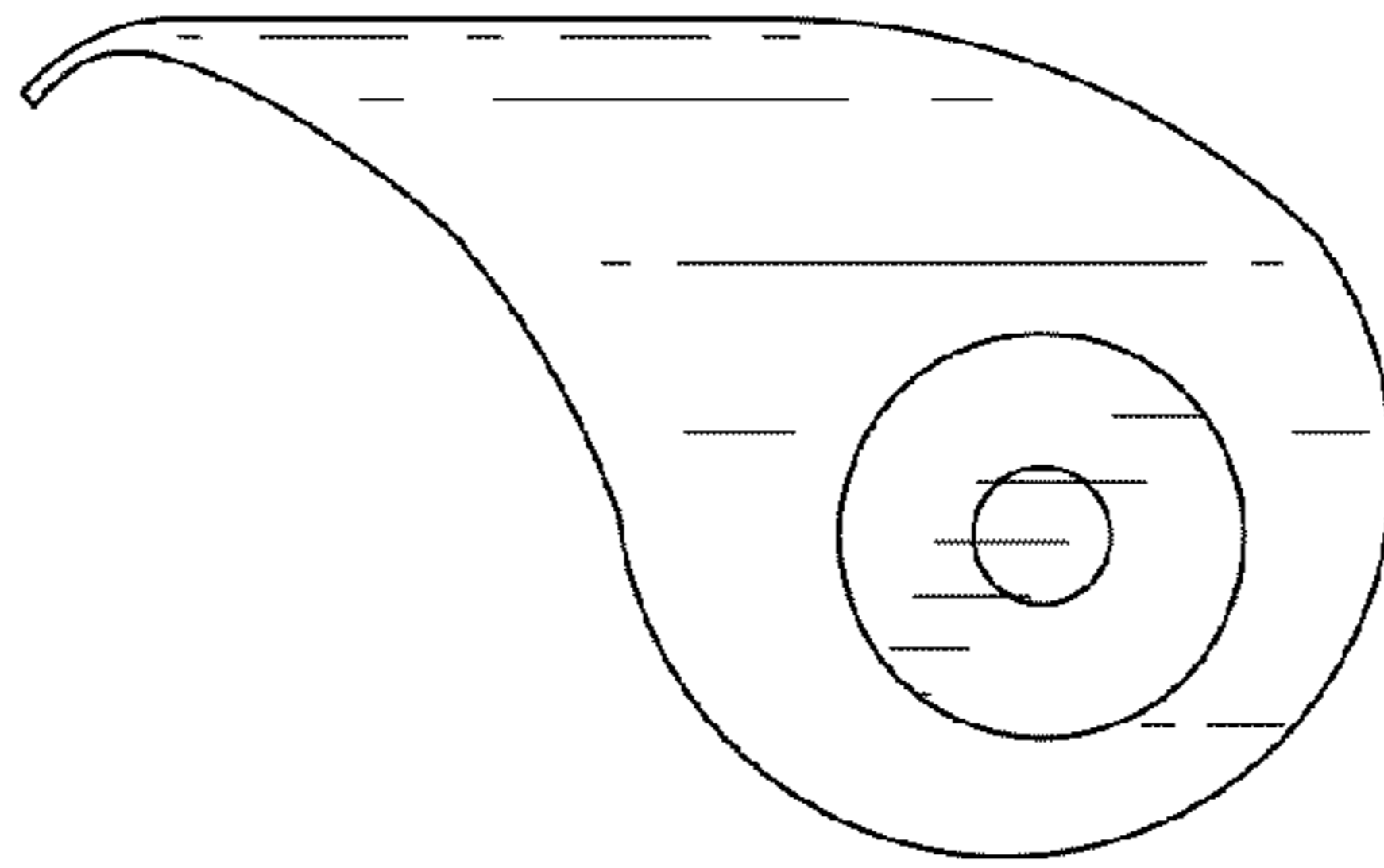

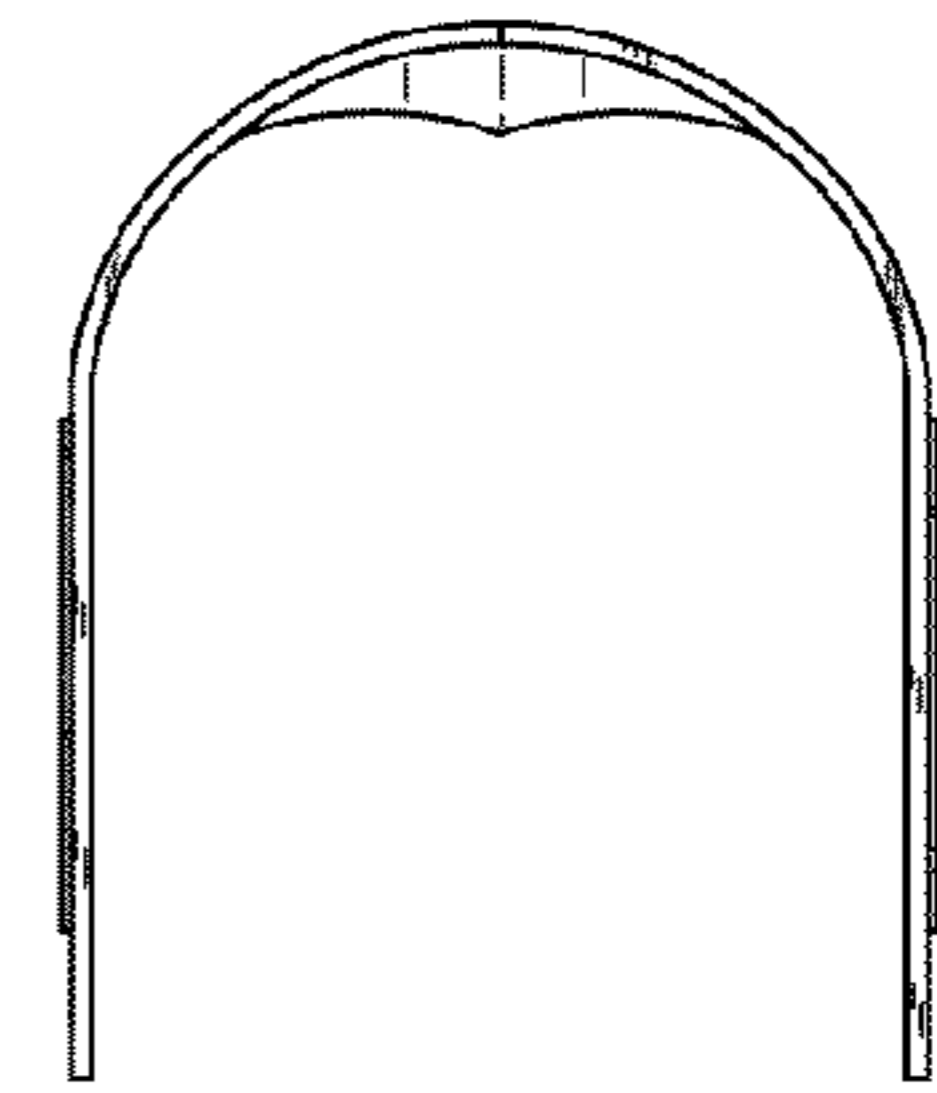

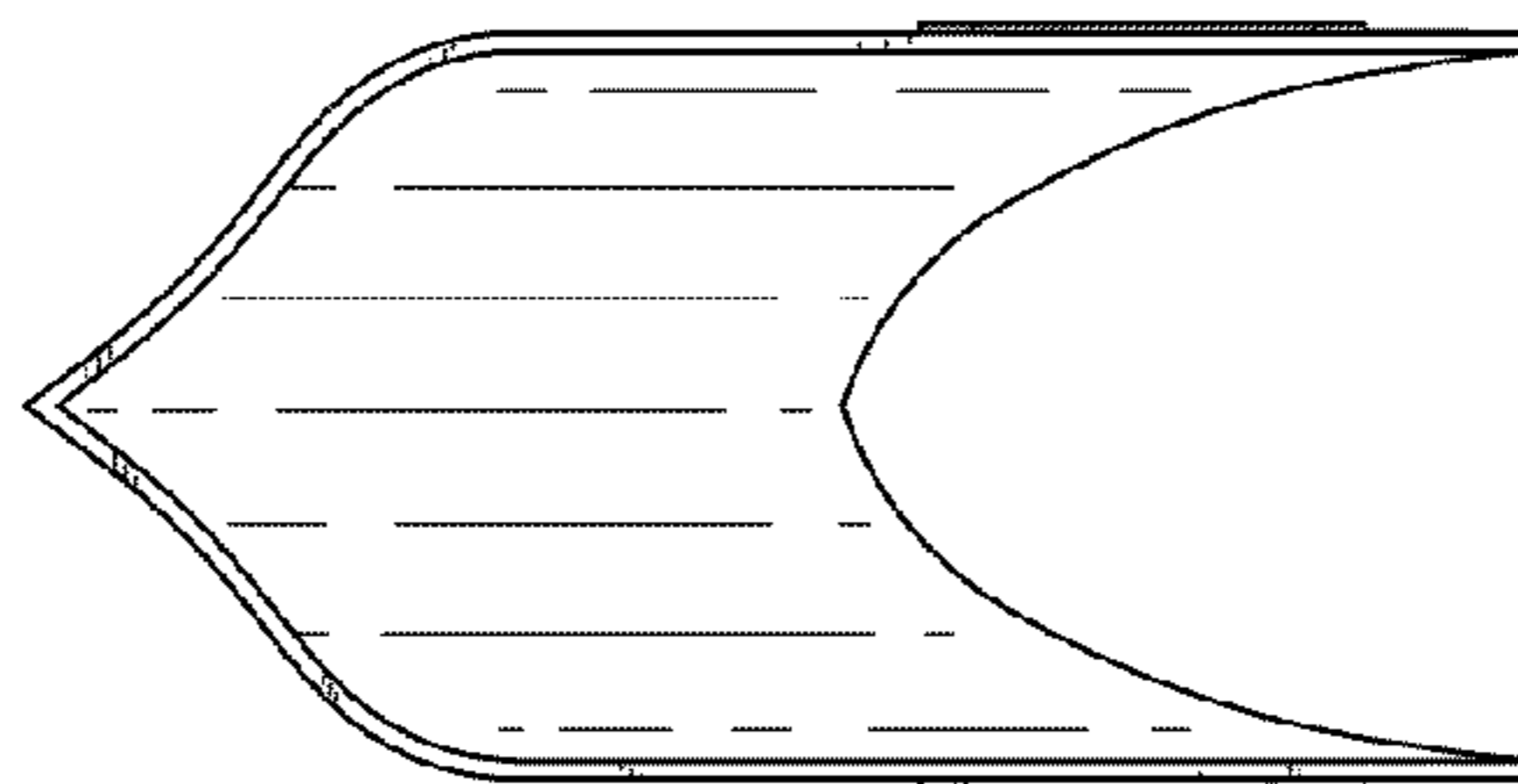

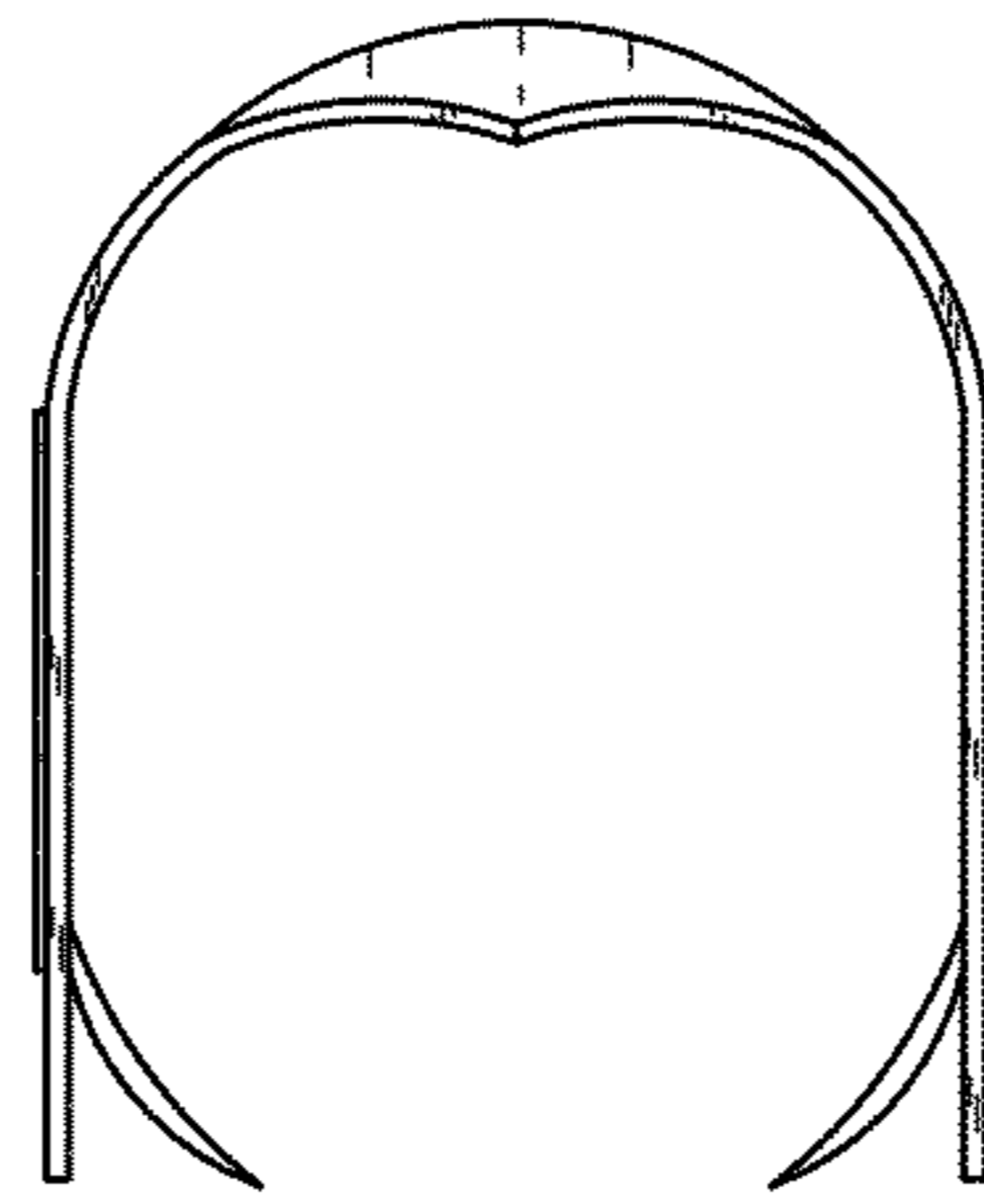

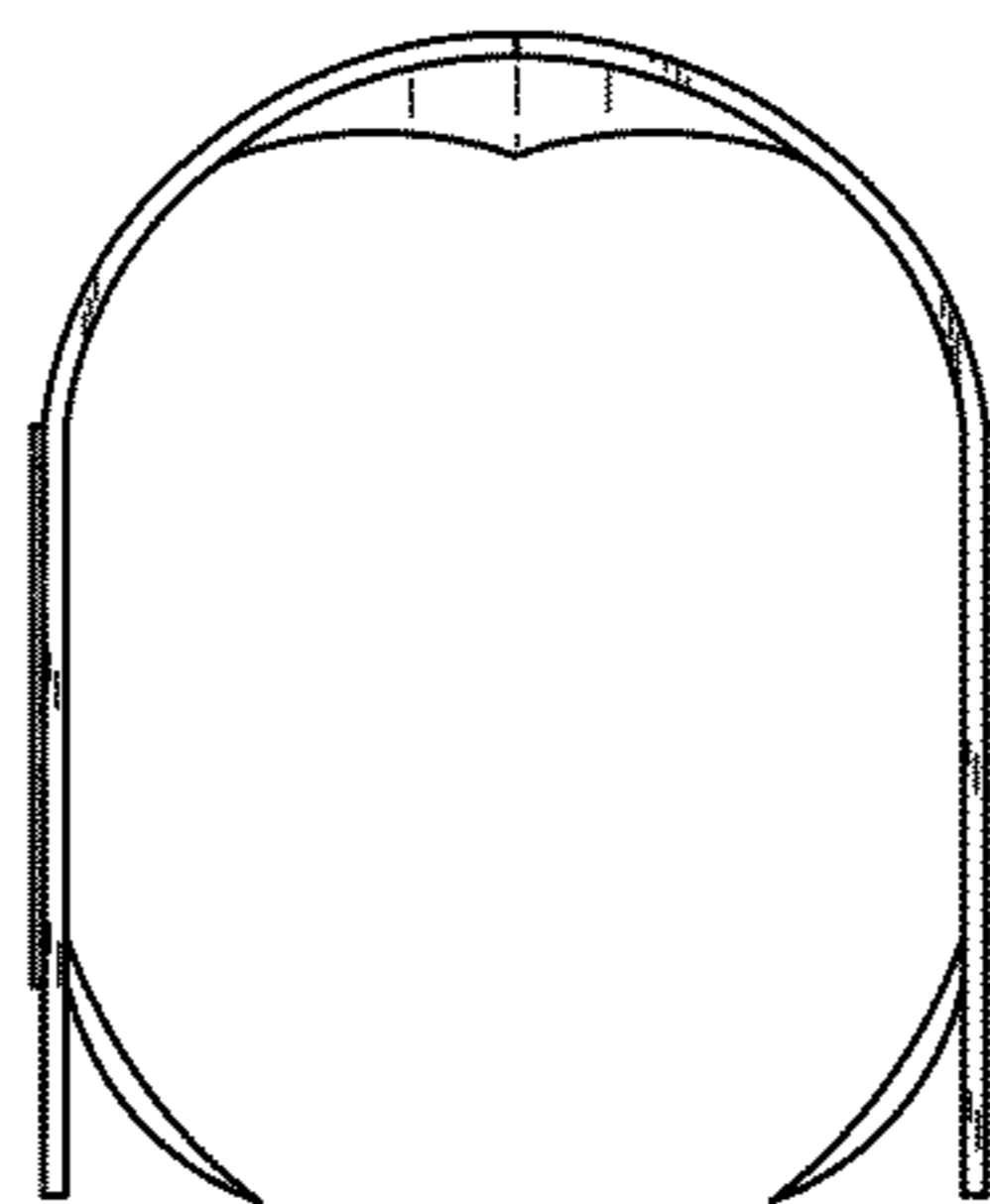

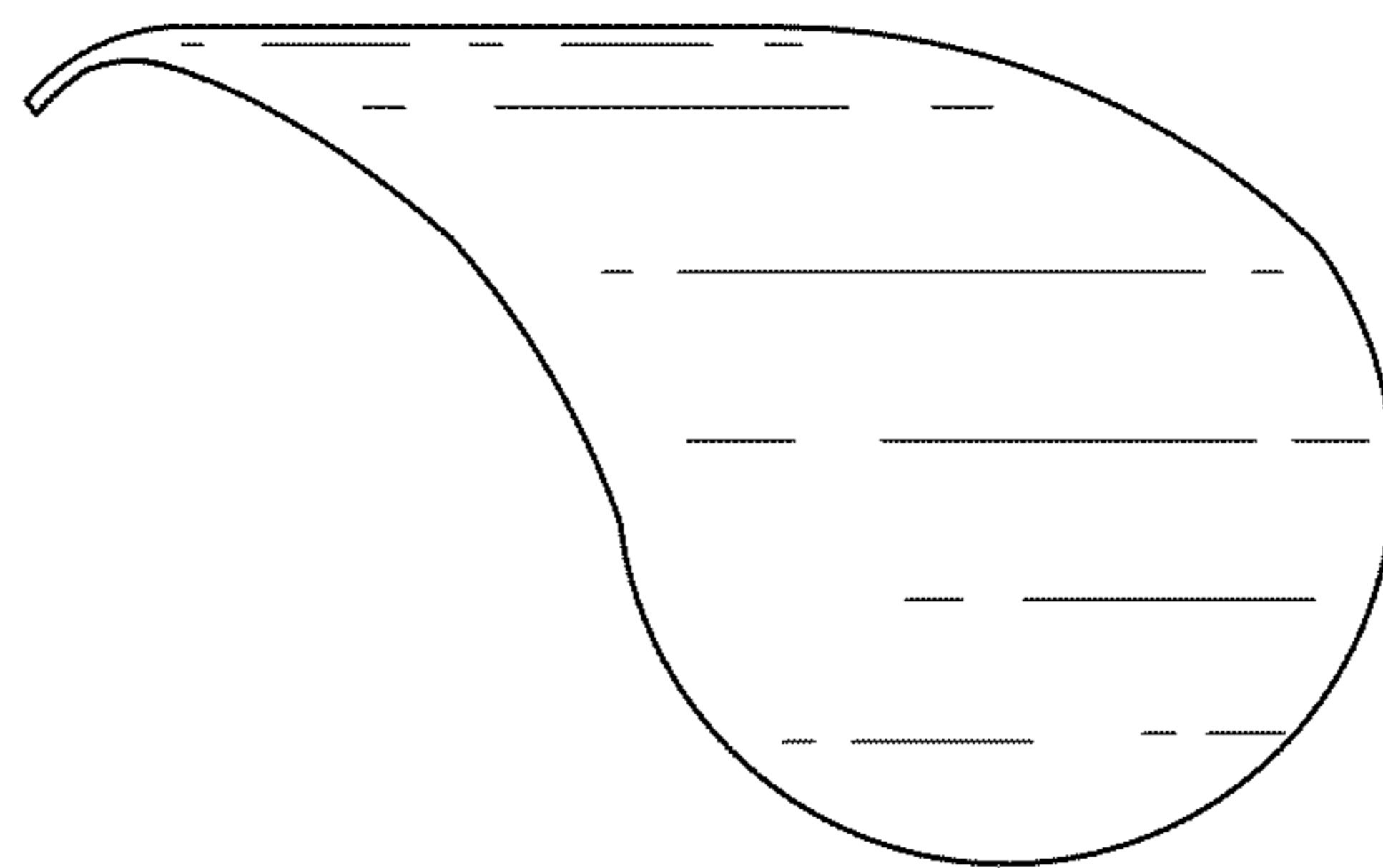

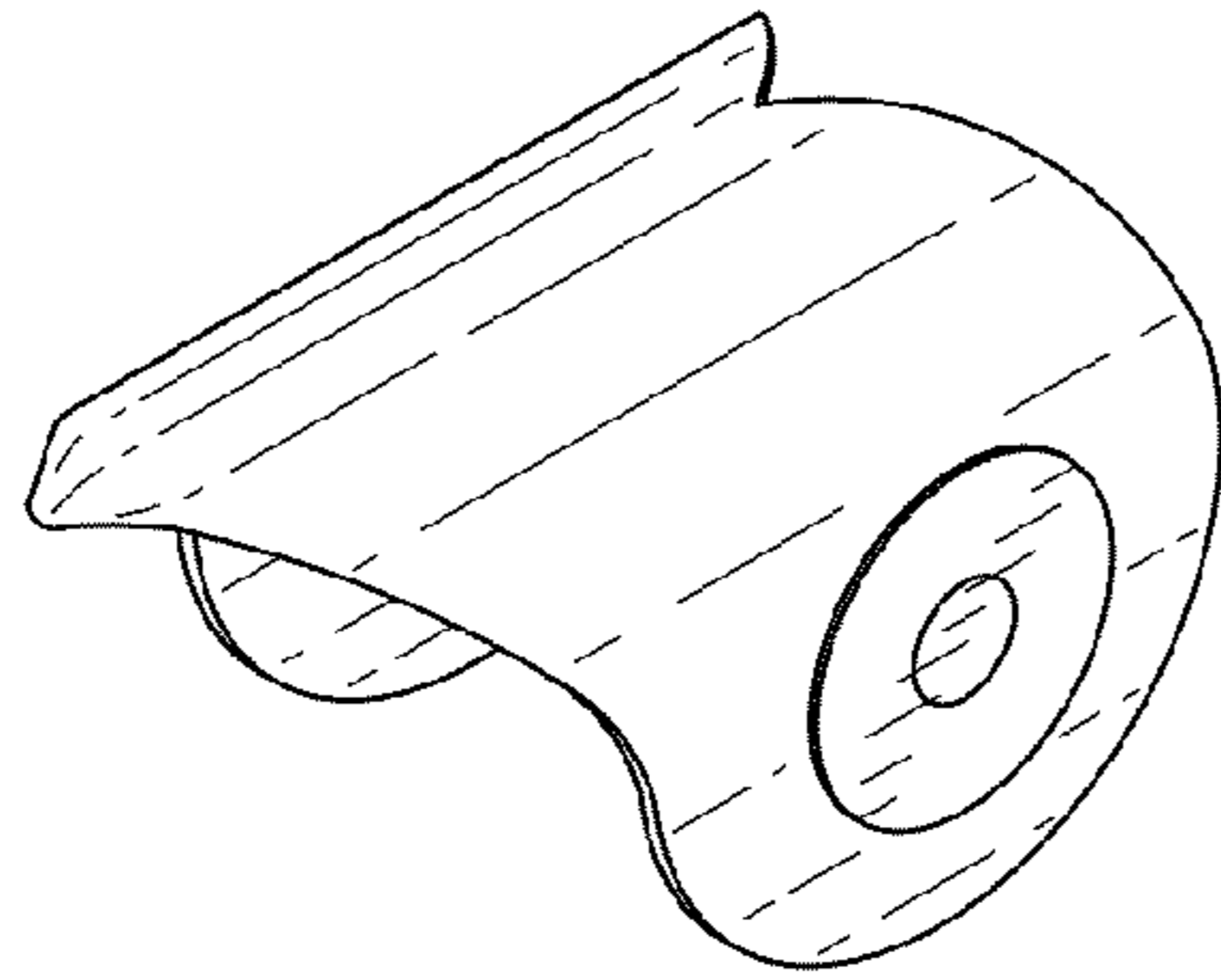

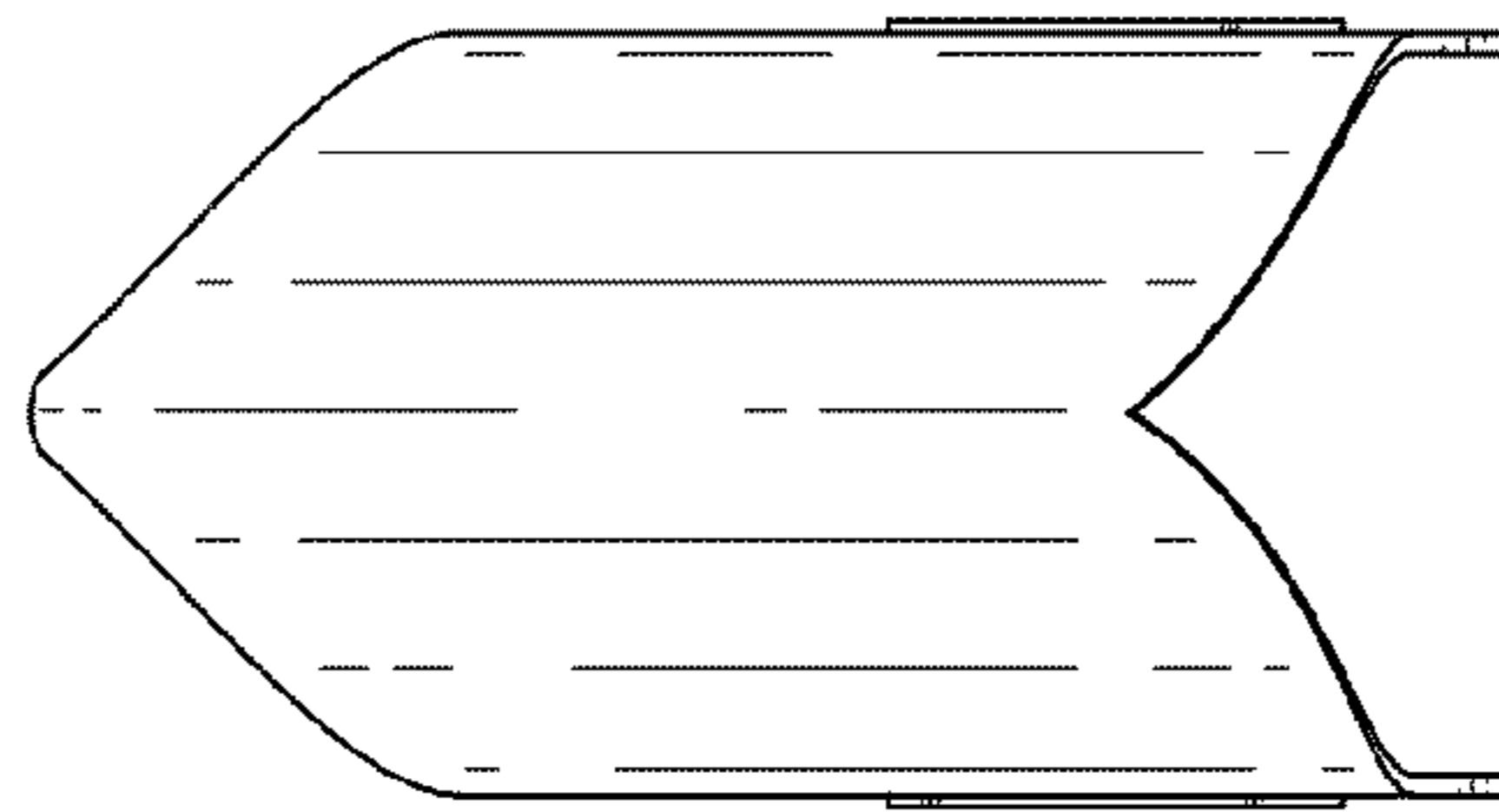

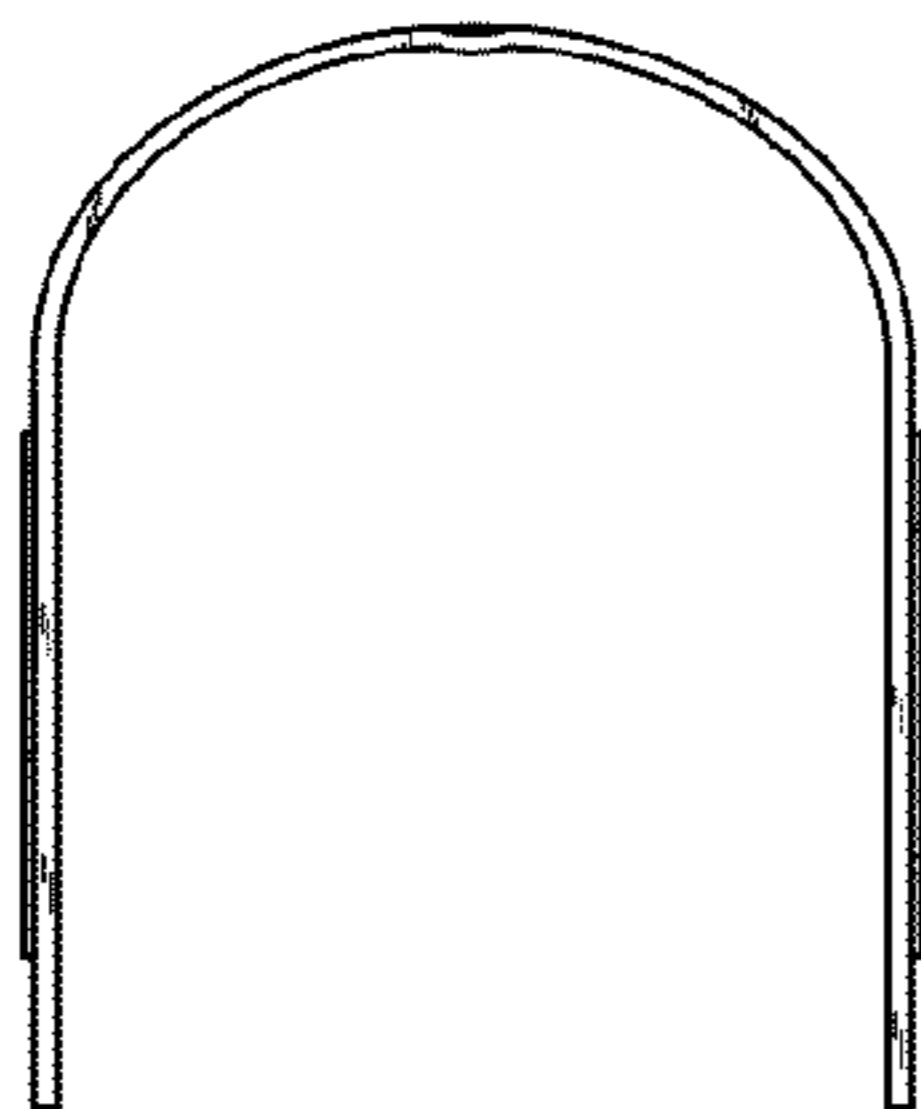

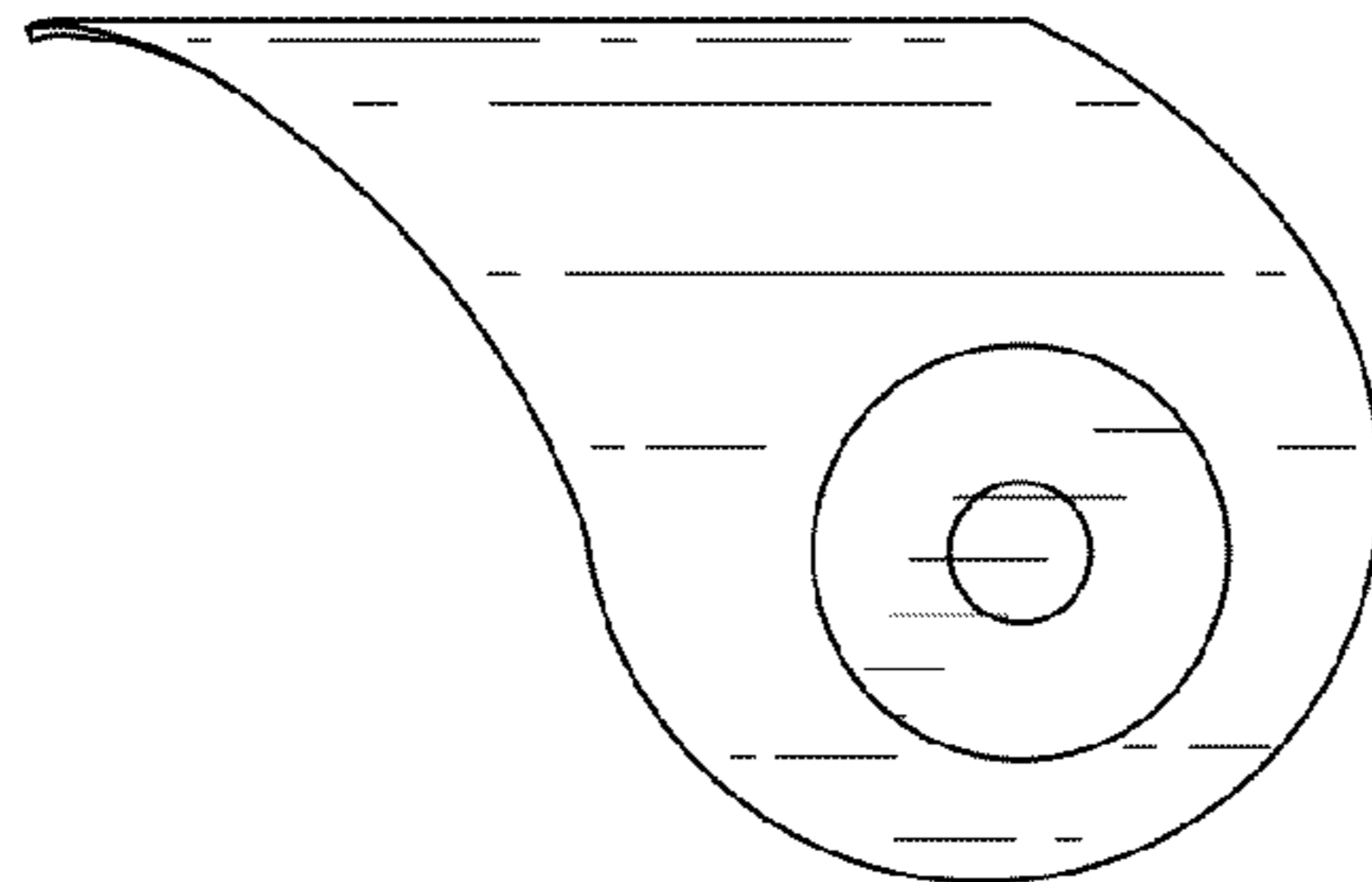

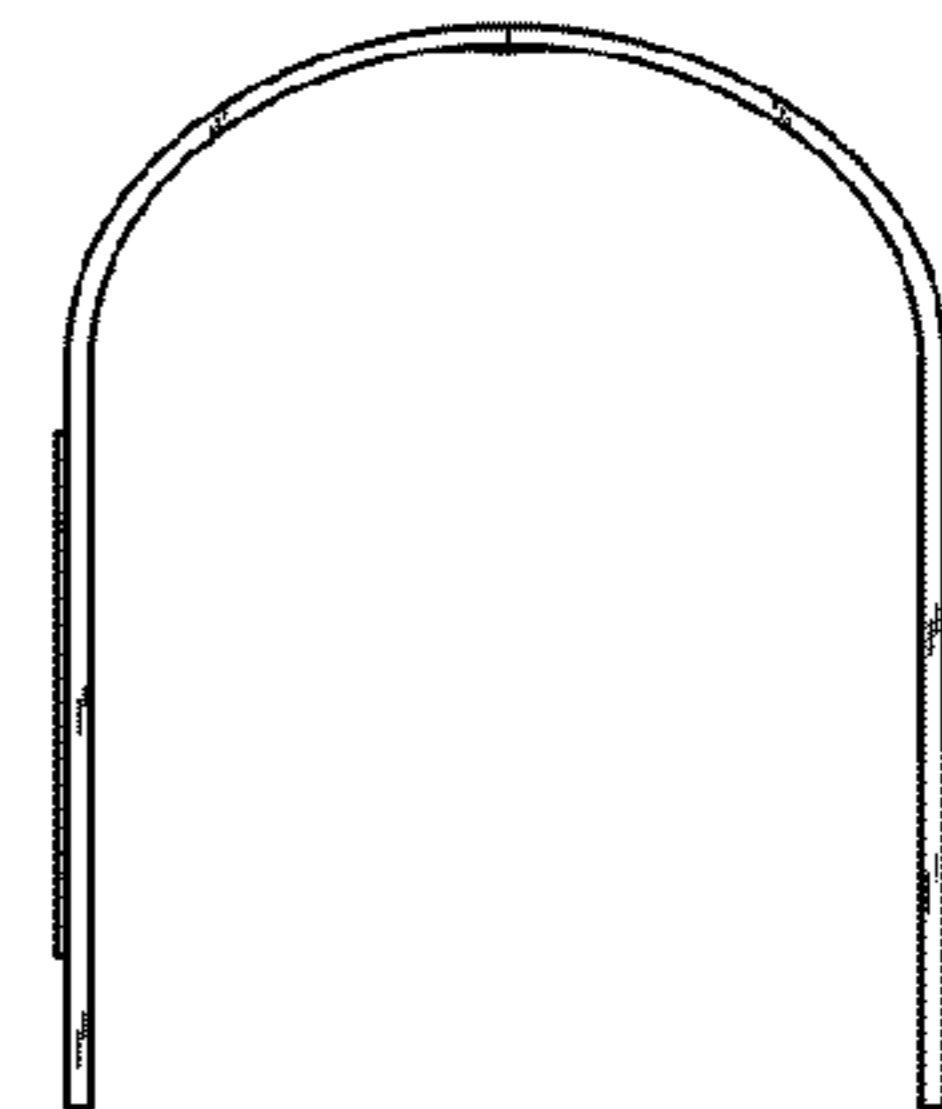

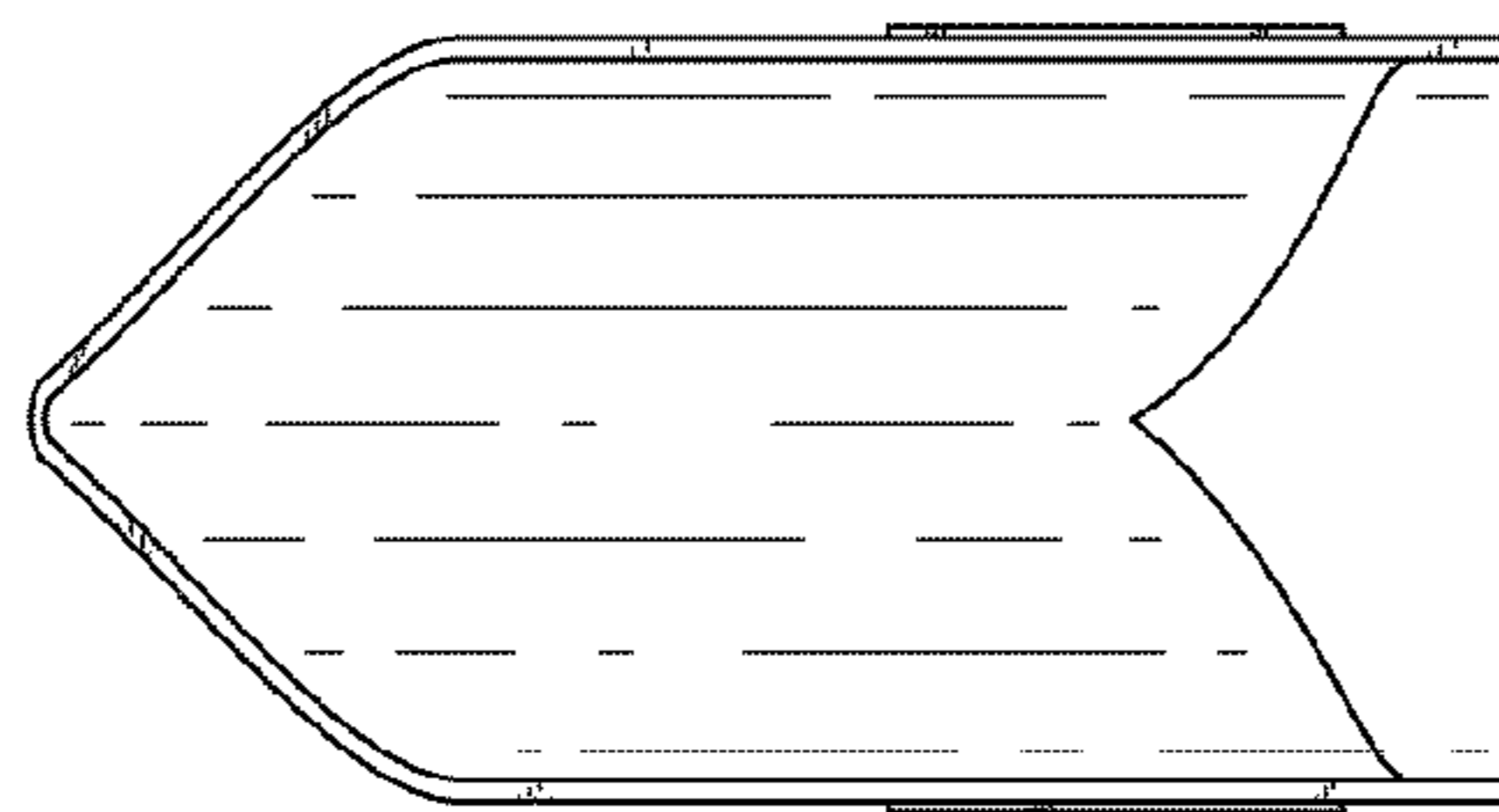
