(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an occupational therapy garment, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an occupational therapy garment showing our new design applied in an exemplary environment;

FIG. 2 is an outside view shown open and spread flat thereof; and,

FIG. 3 is an inside view shown open and spread flat view thereof.

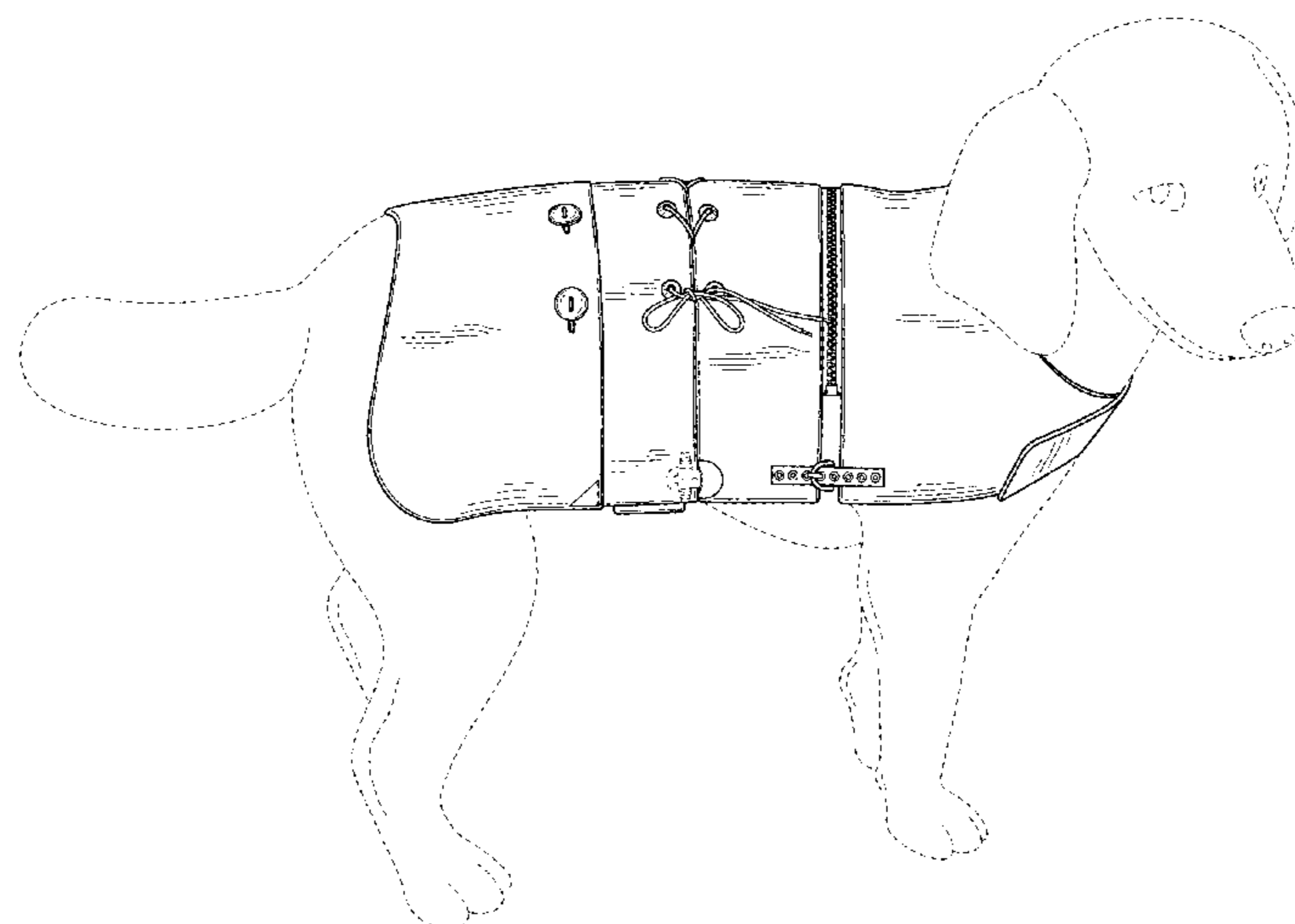

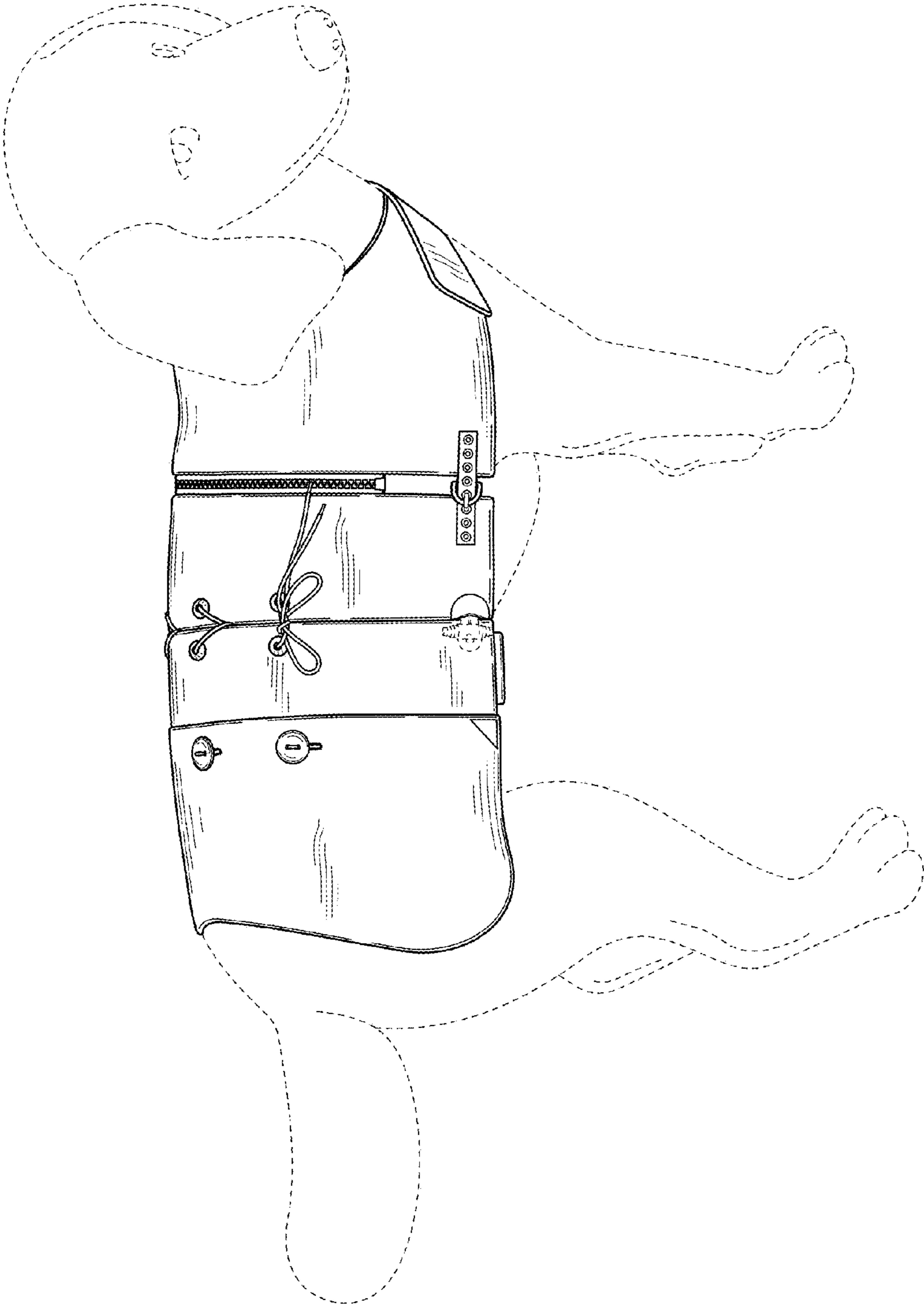

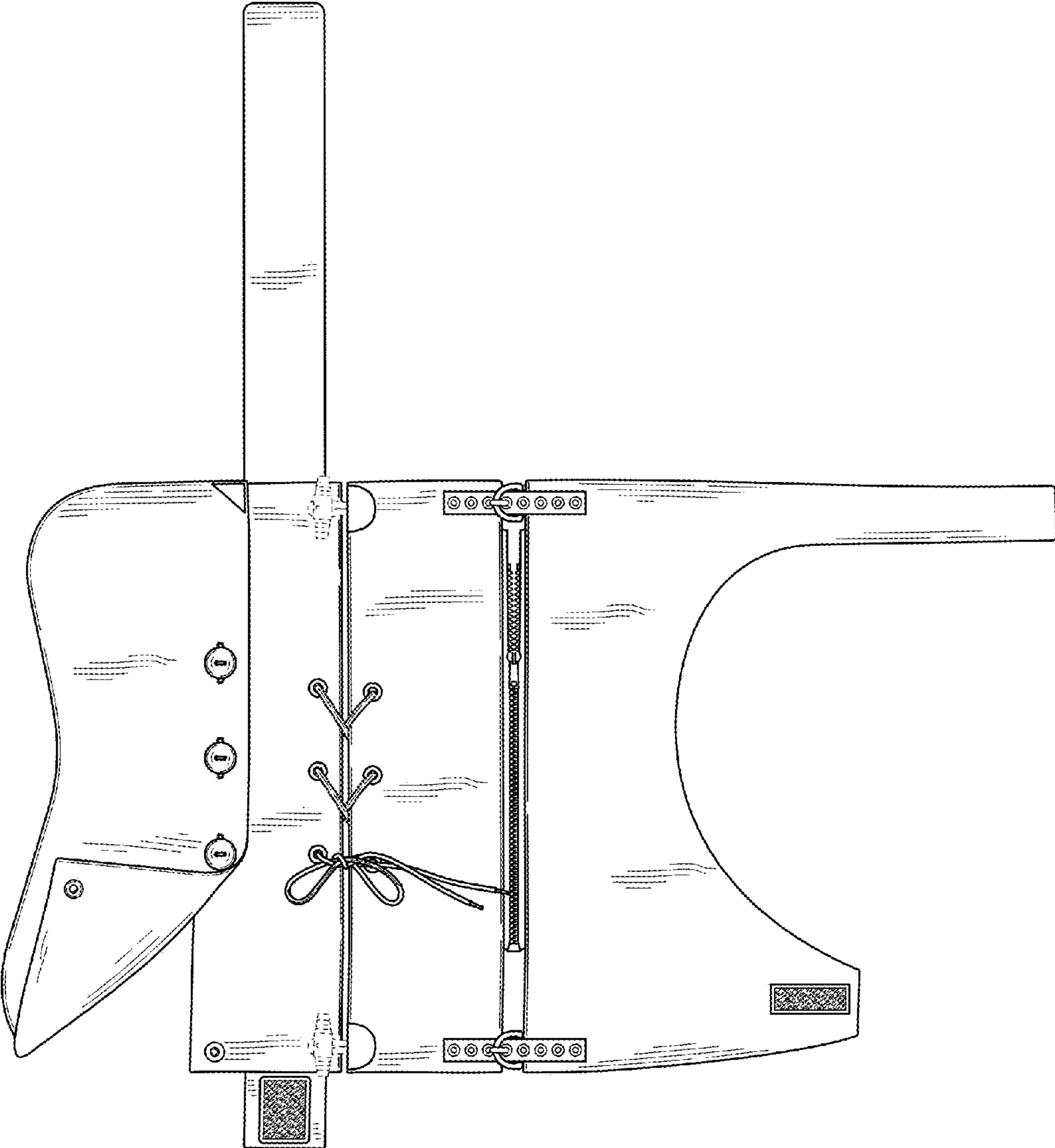

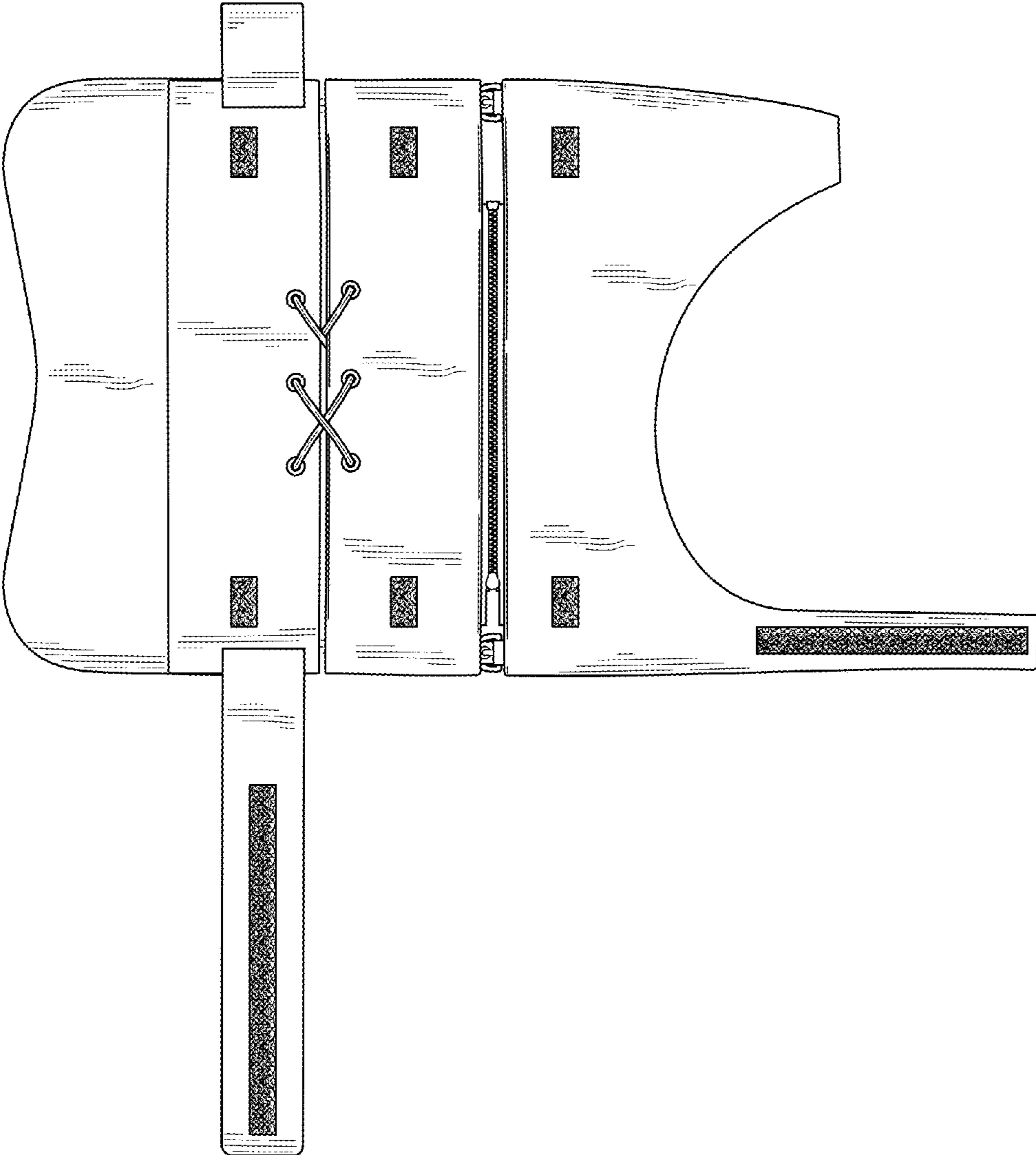
