FIG. 3 is a rear view of the goose neck foregrip of FIG. 1;

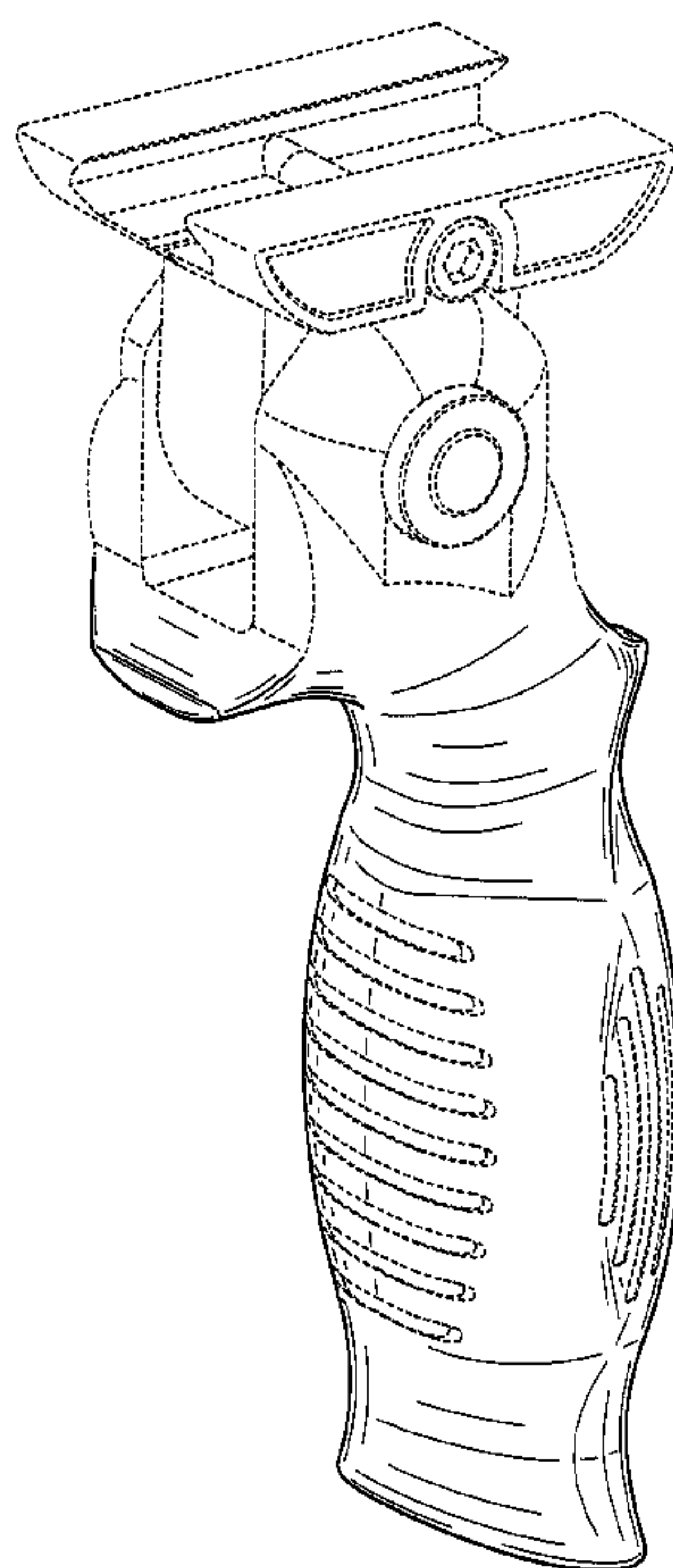
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view of the goose neck foregrip of FIG. 1;

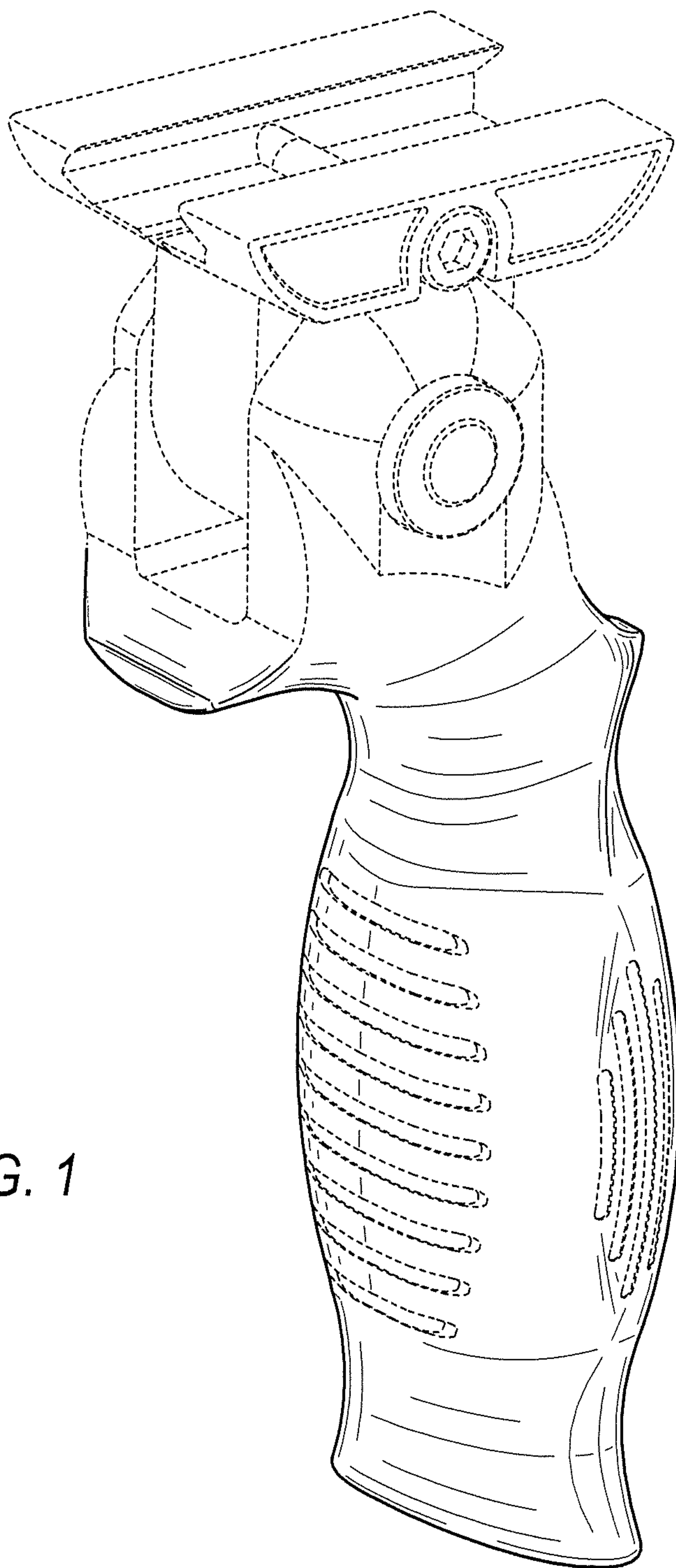

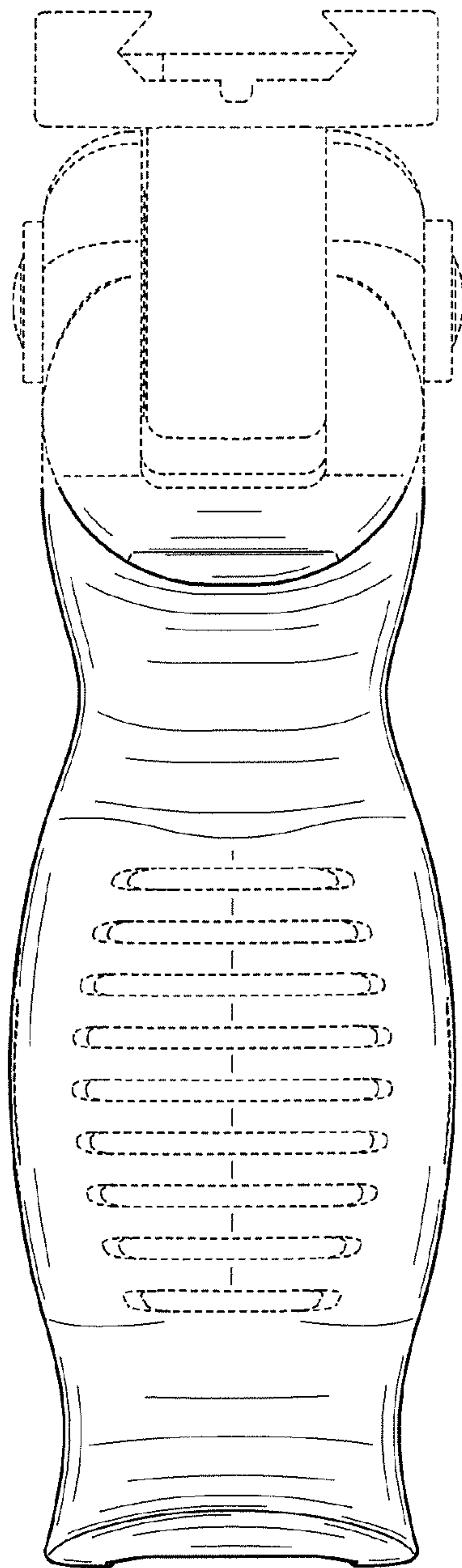

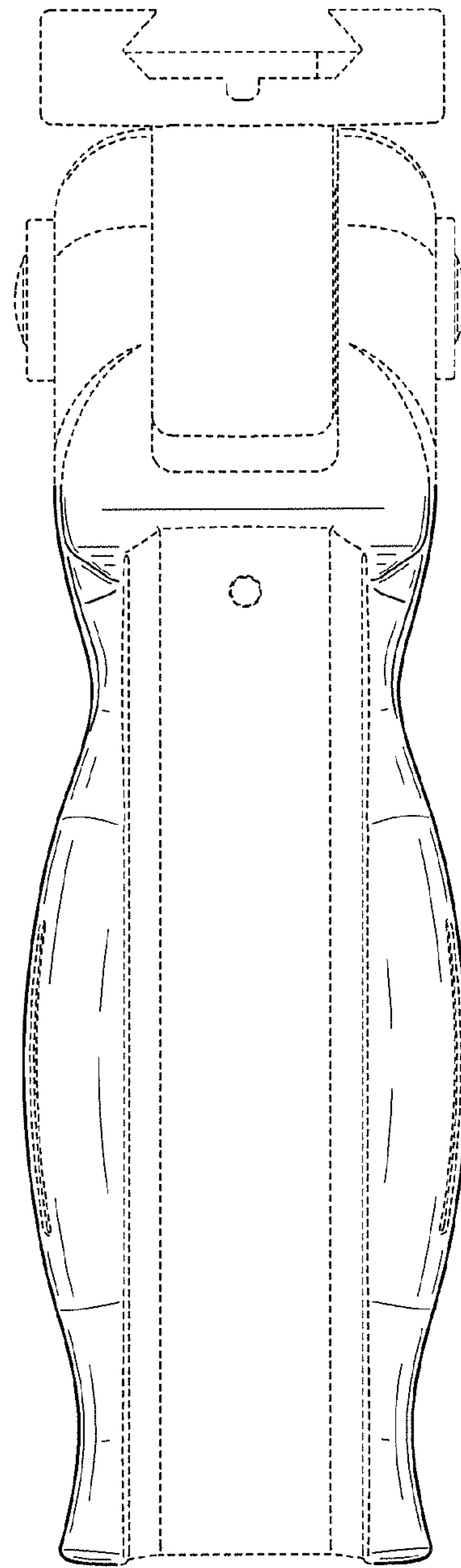

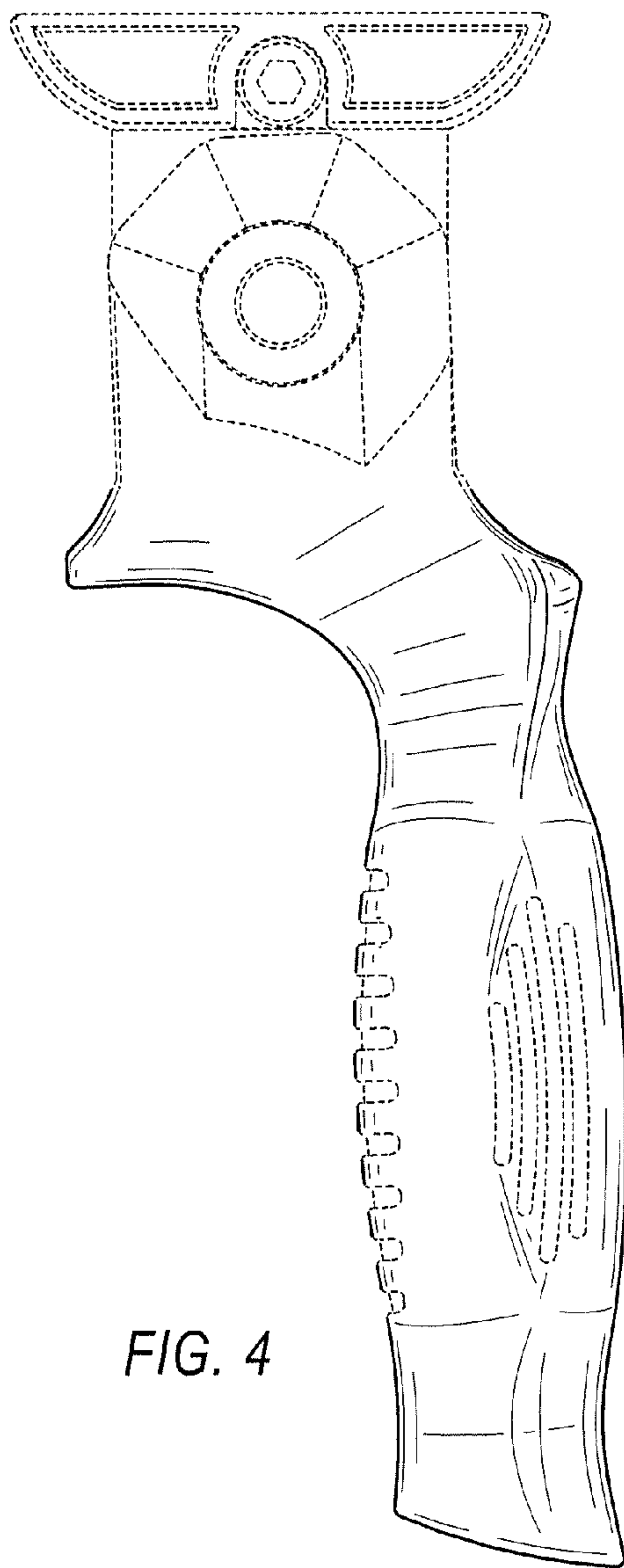

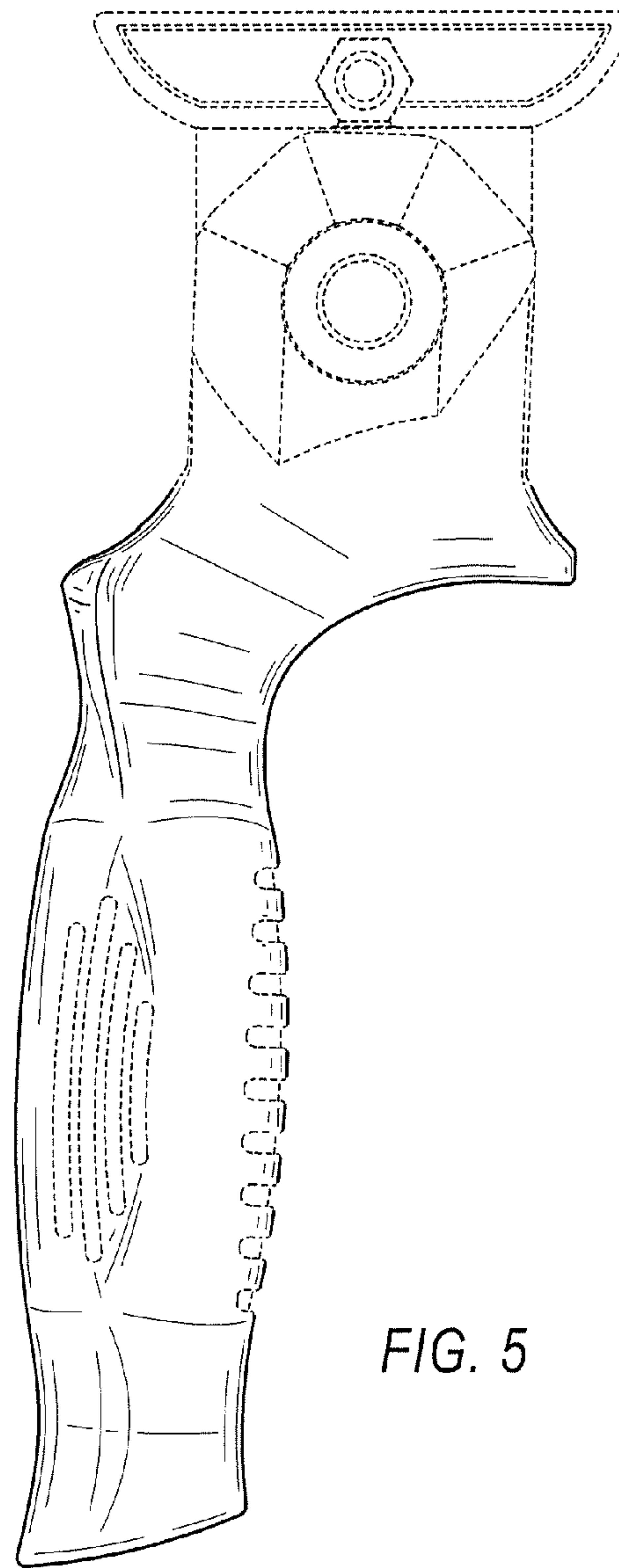

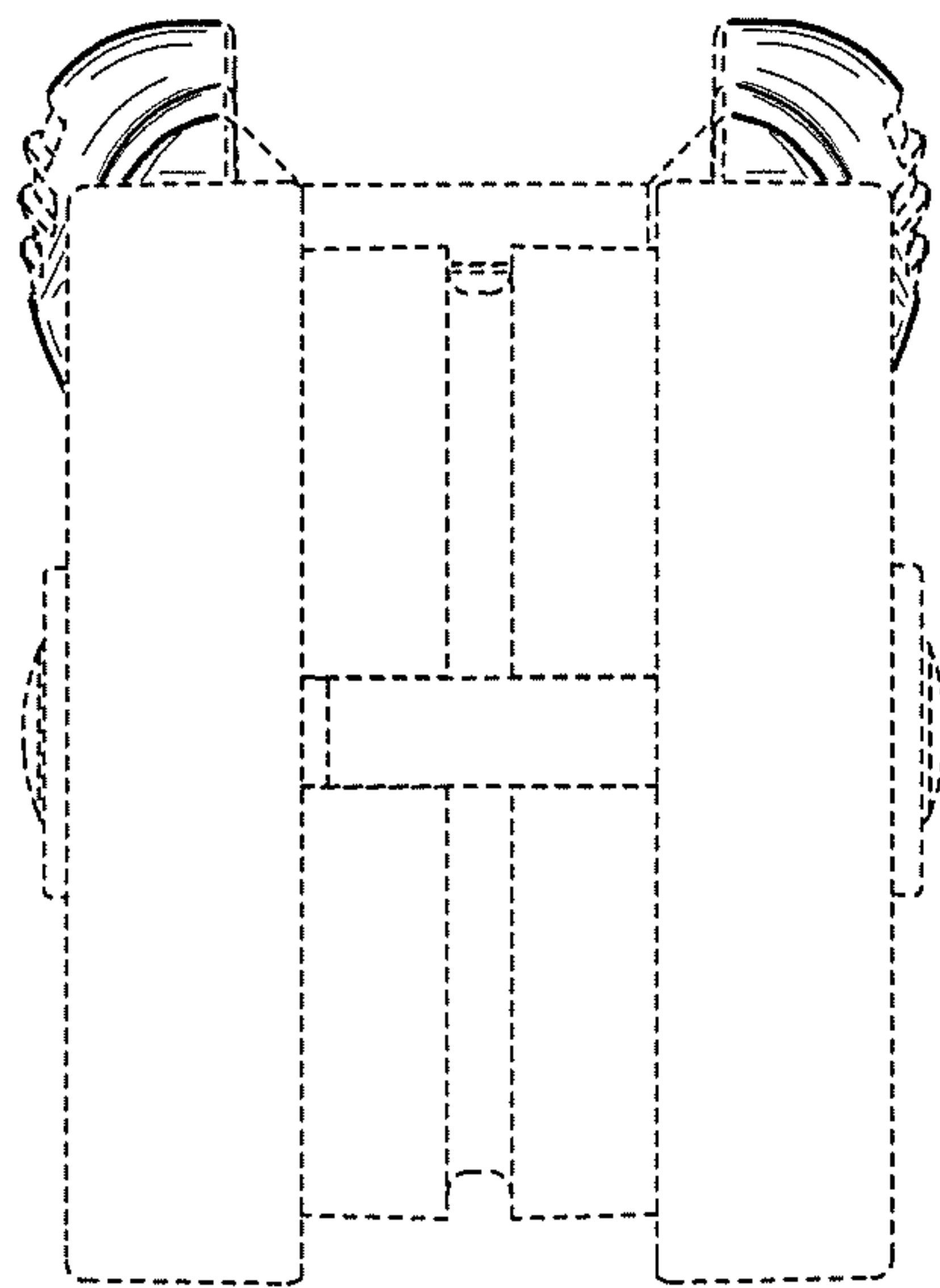

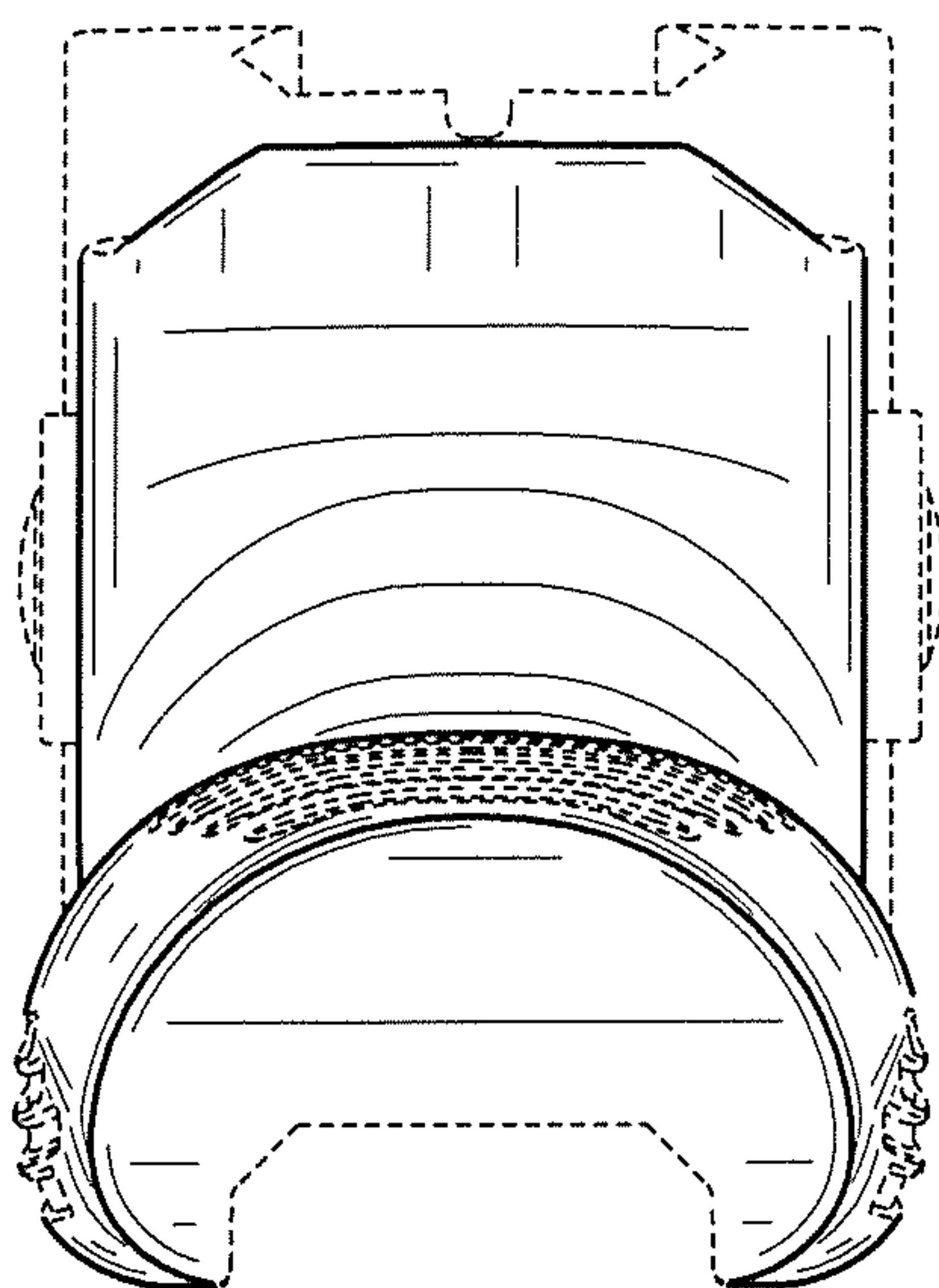
