I claim the ornamental design for a bed skirt adhesive pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTIONFIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bed skirt adhesive pad.
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the bed skirt adhesive pad of FIG. 1, the bottom surface having adhesive.

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the bed skirt adhesive pad of FIG. 1 shown in a position of use within an unclaimed environment of use.

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the bed skirt adhesive pad of FIG. 1.


FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view of the bed skirt adhesive pad of FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a left side elevation view of the bed skirt adhesive pad of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a rear elevation view of the bed skirt adhesive pad of FIG. 1.

The broken line(s) shown in the drawings represent an unclaimed environment of the bed skirt adhesive pad and form no part of the claimed design.

The stippling shown in FIG. 2 depicts the texture of the adhesive surface of the bed skirt adhesive pad.














