The ornamental design for a casket, as shown and described.

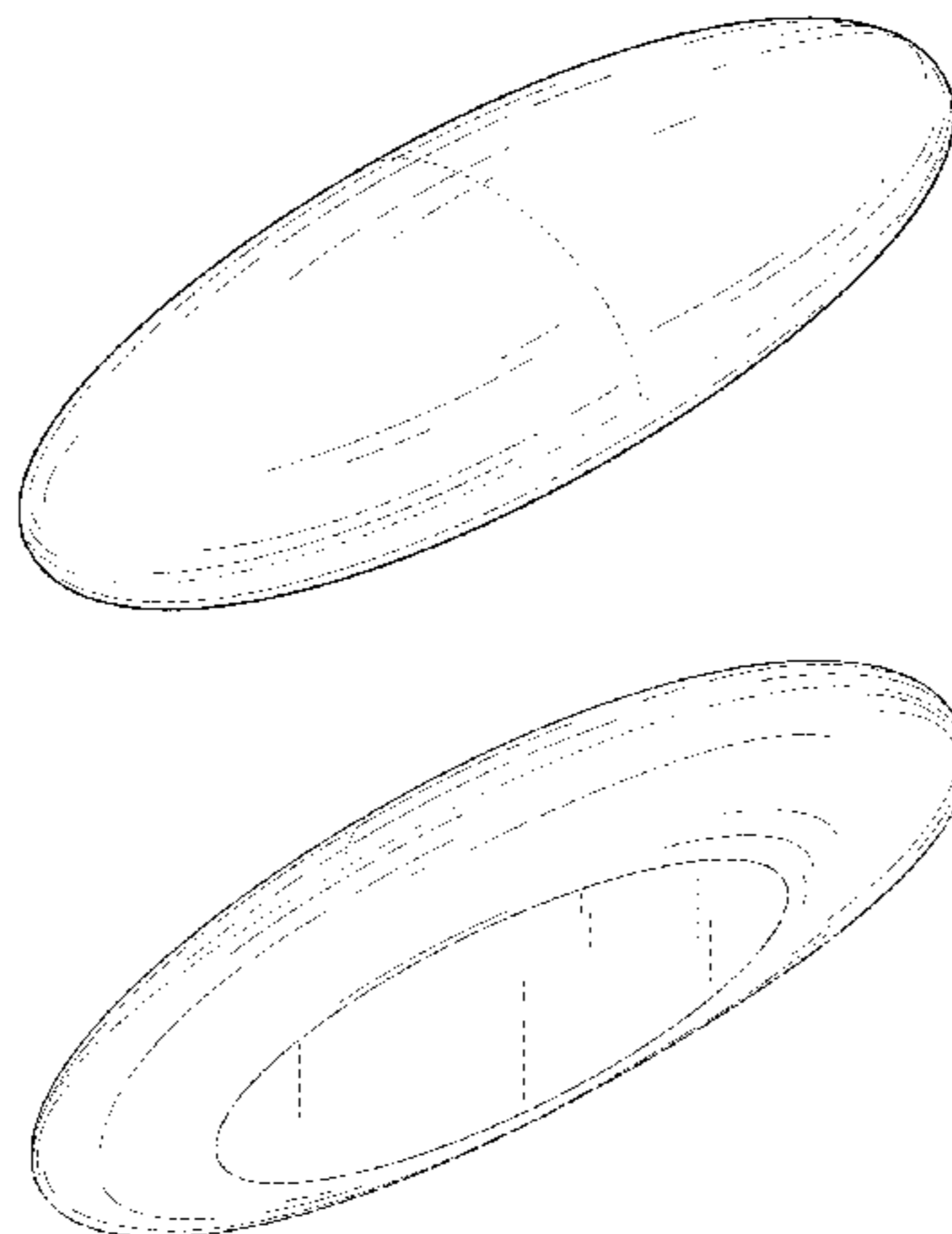
DESCRIPTION

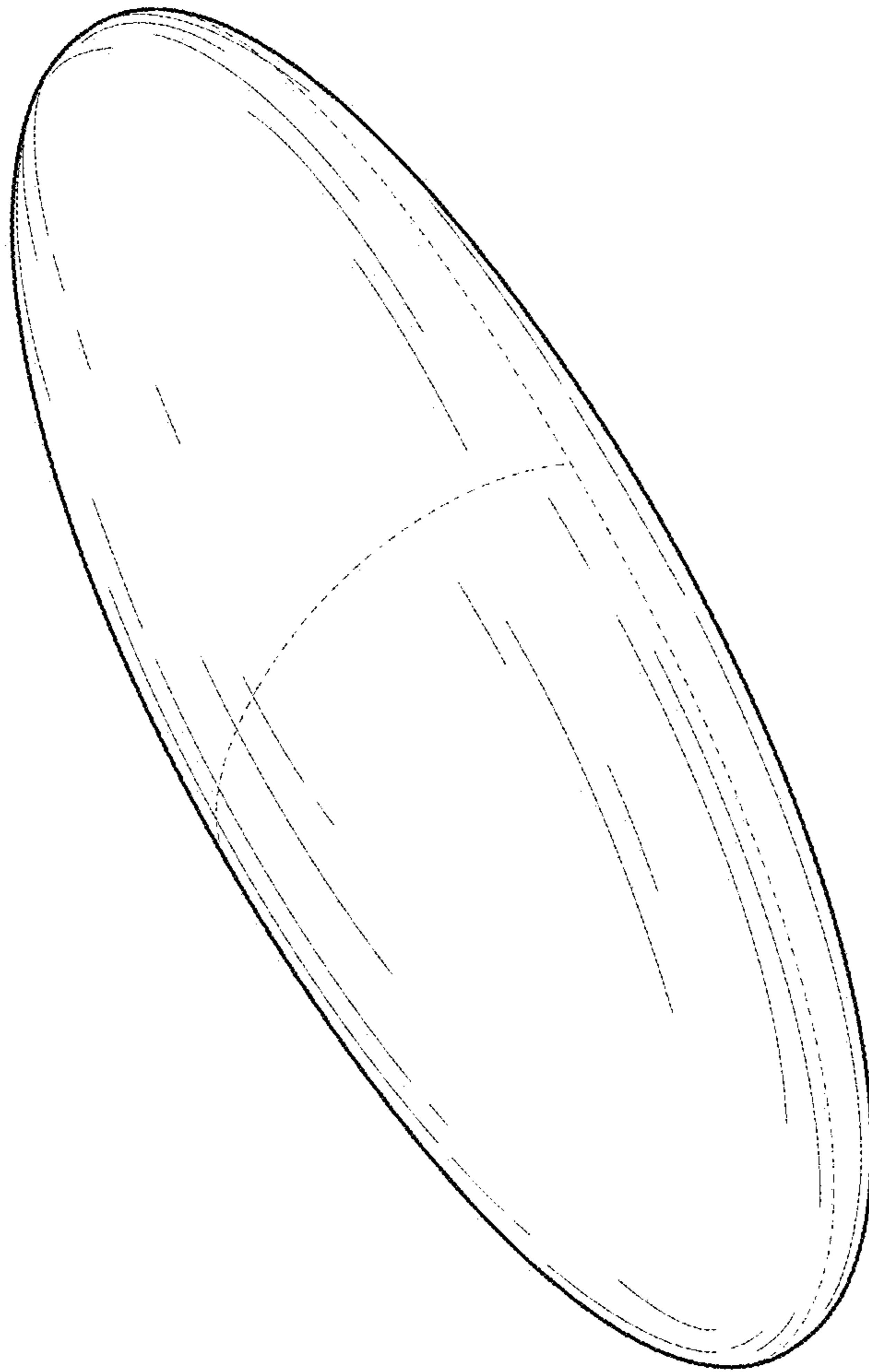

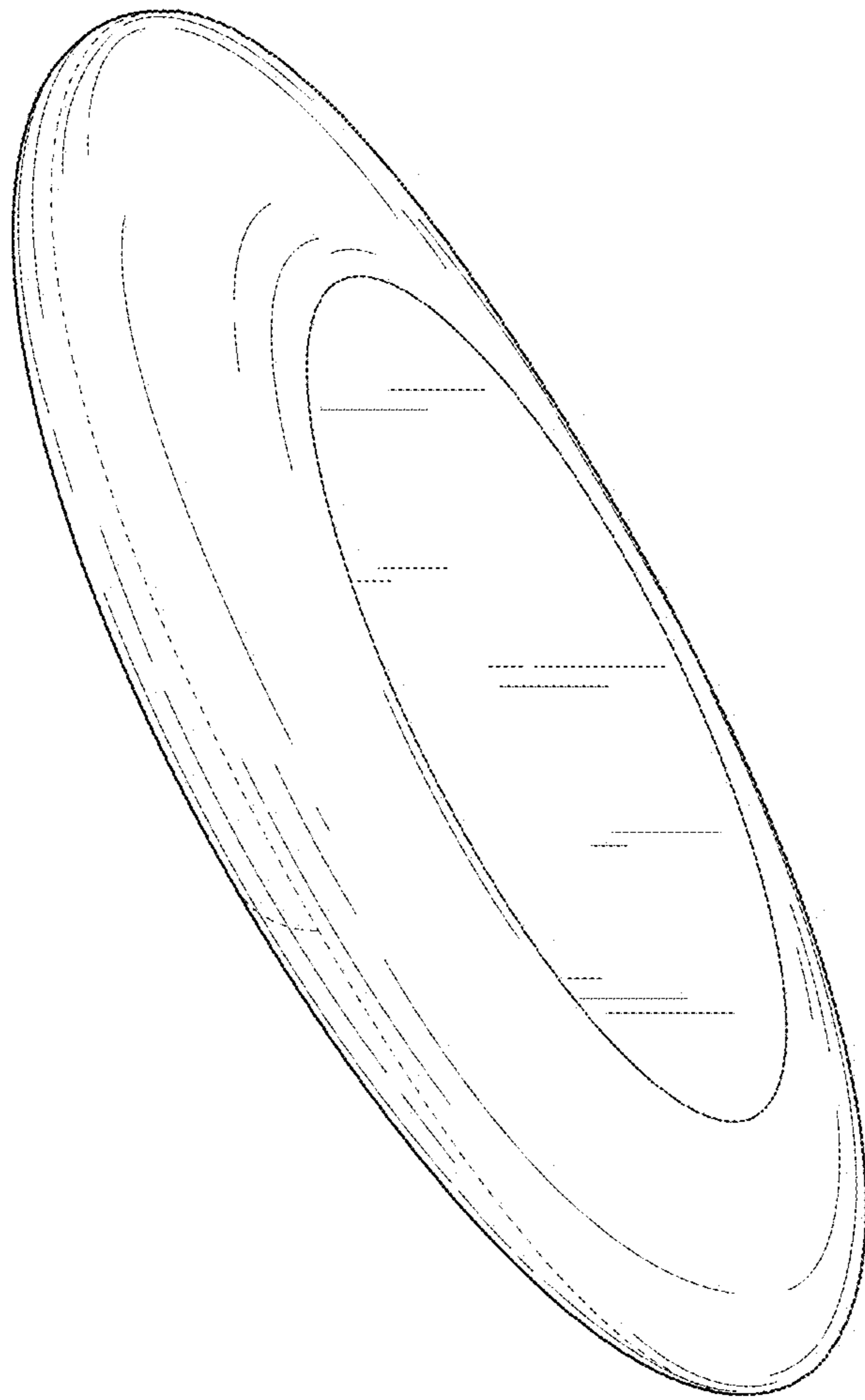

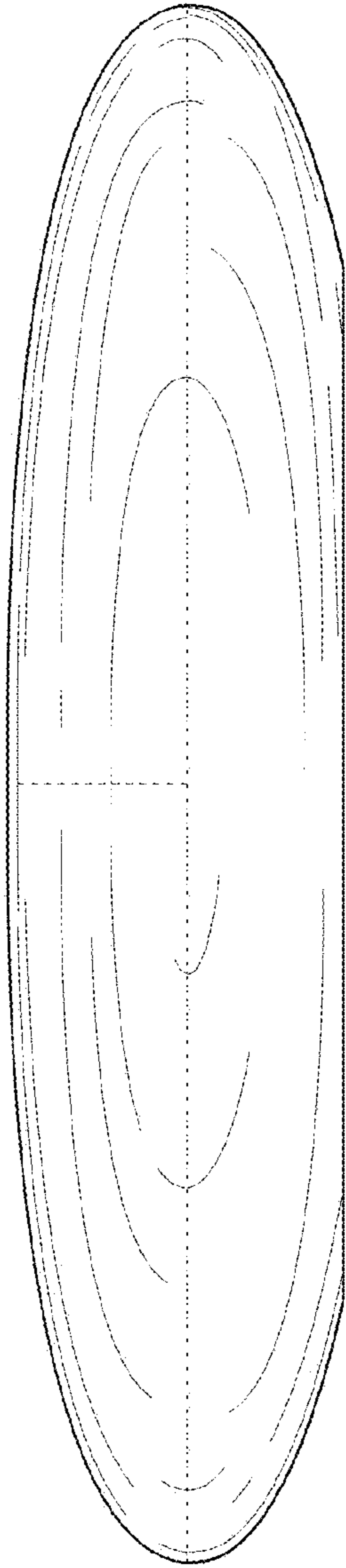

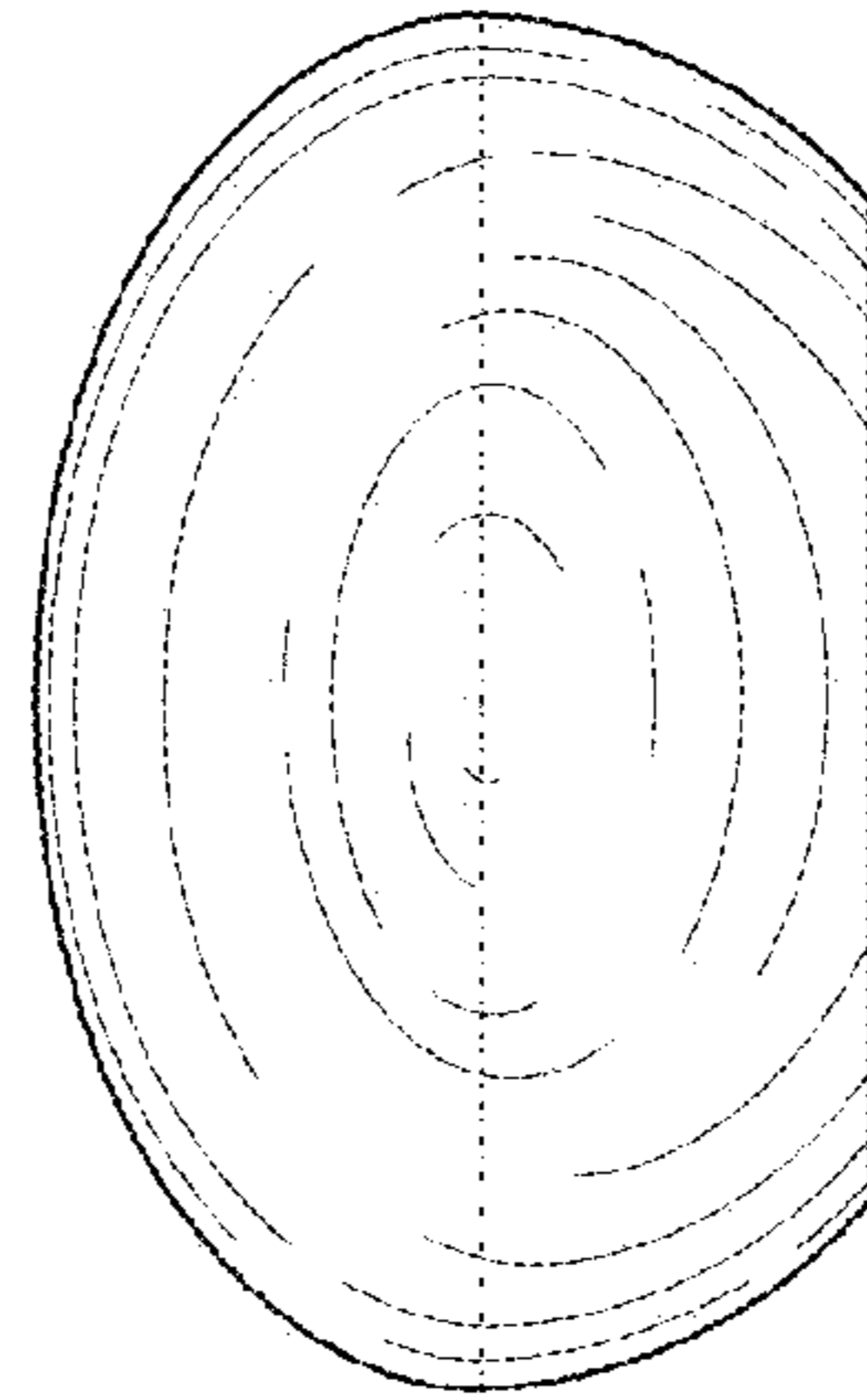

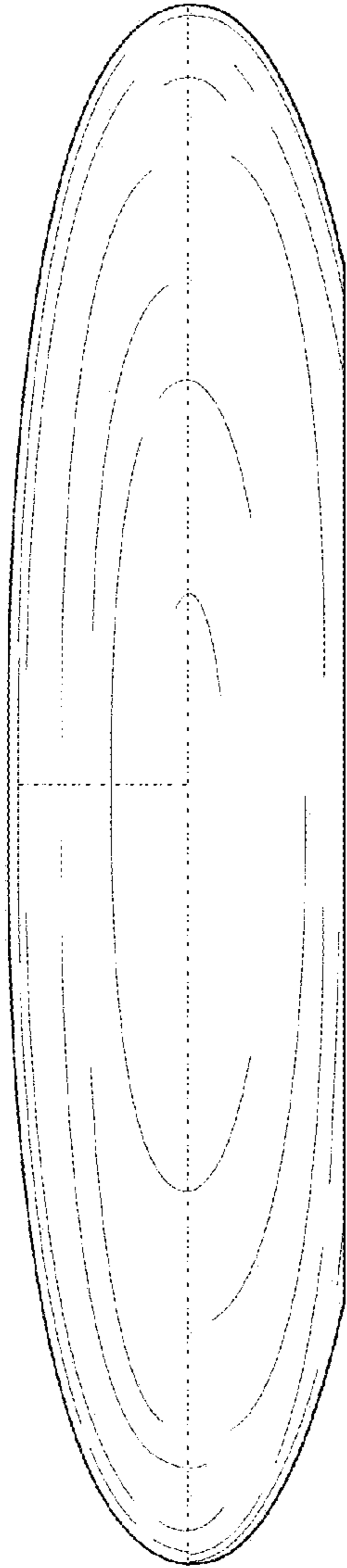

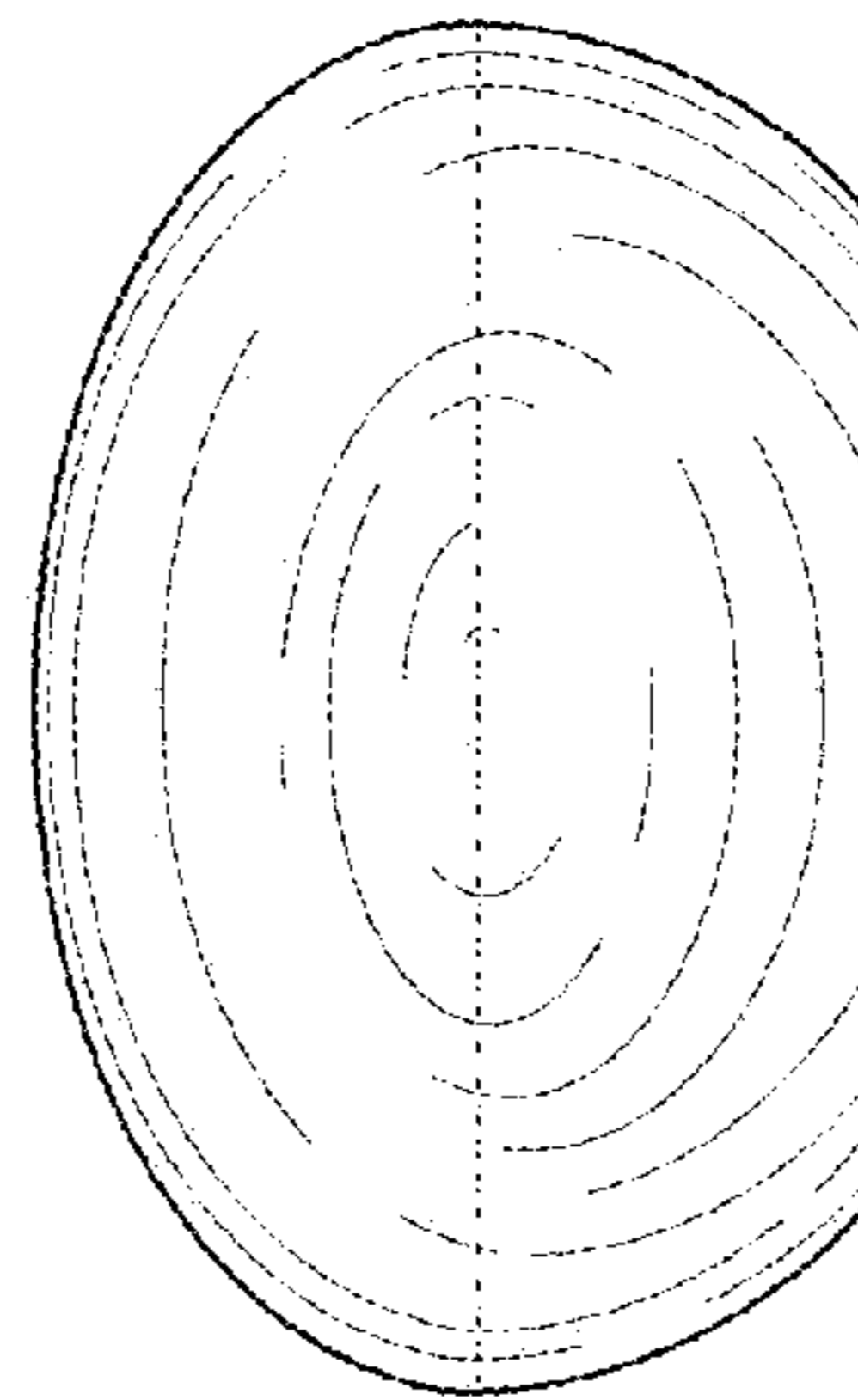

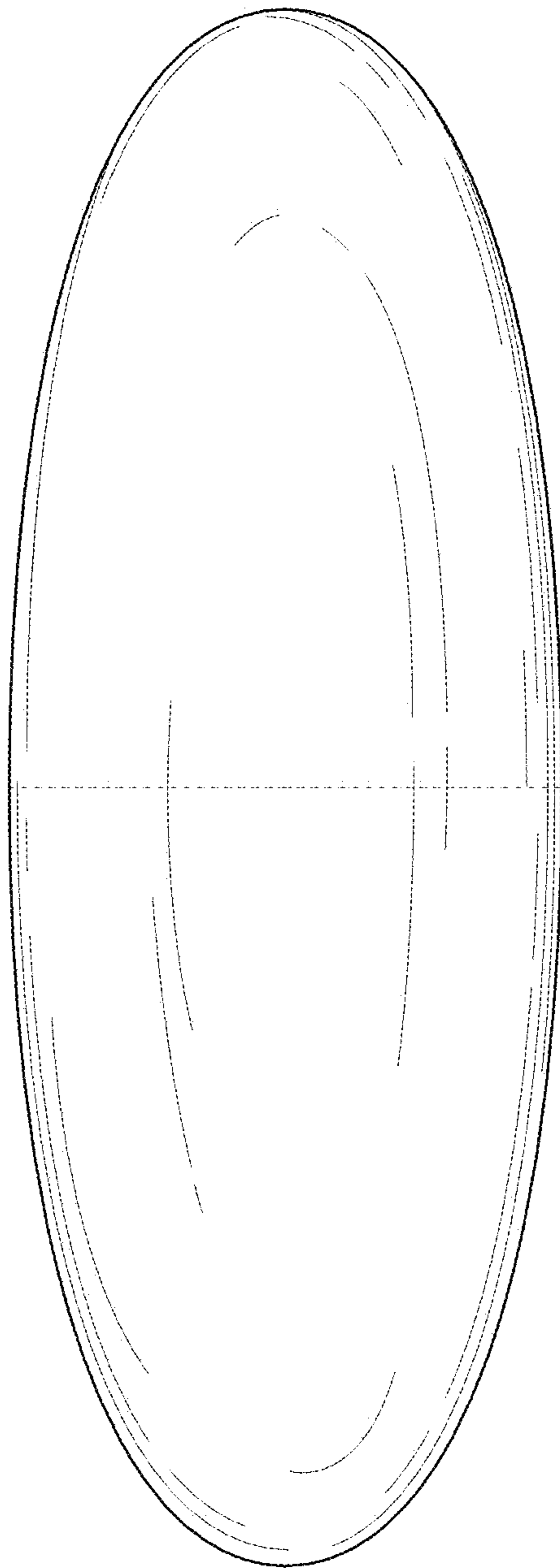

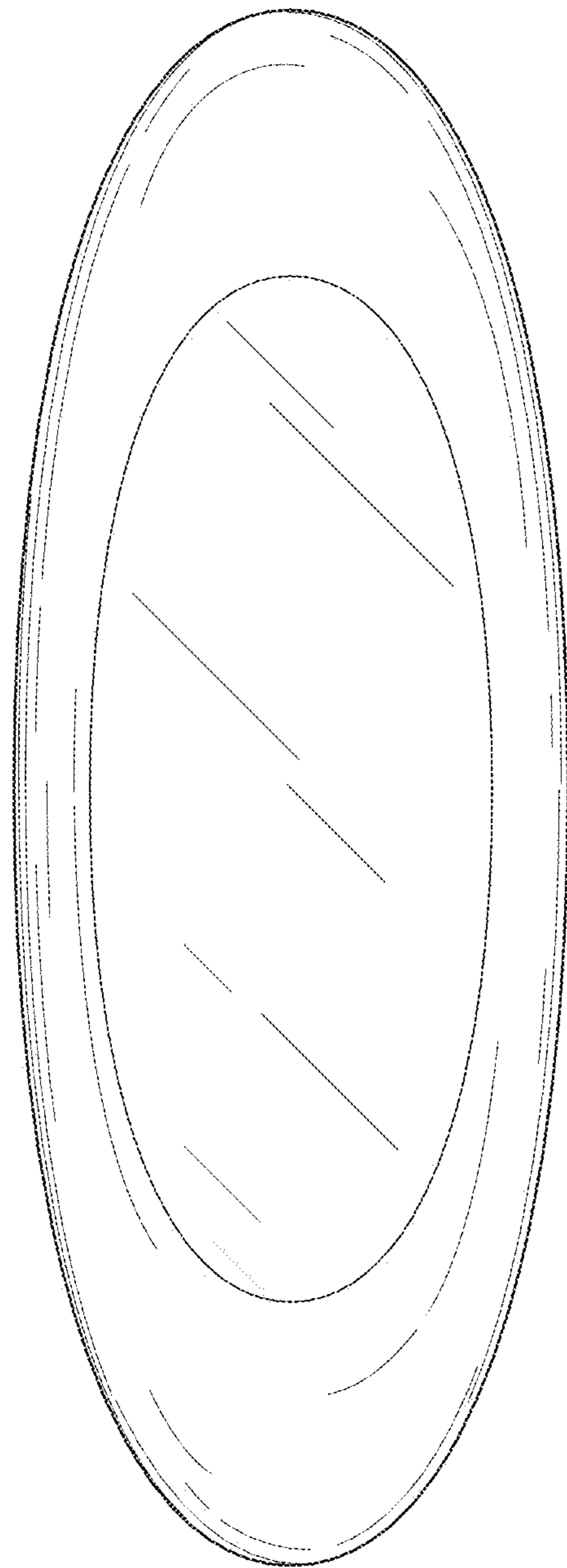

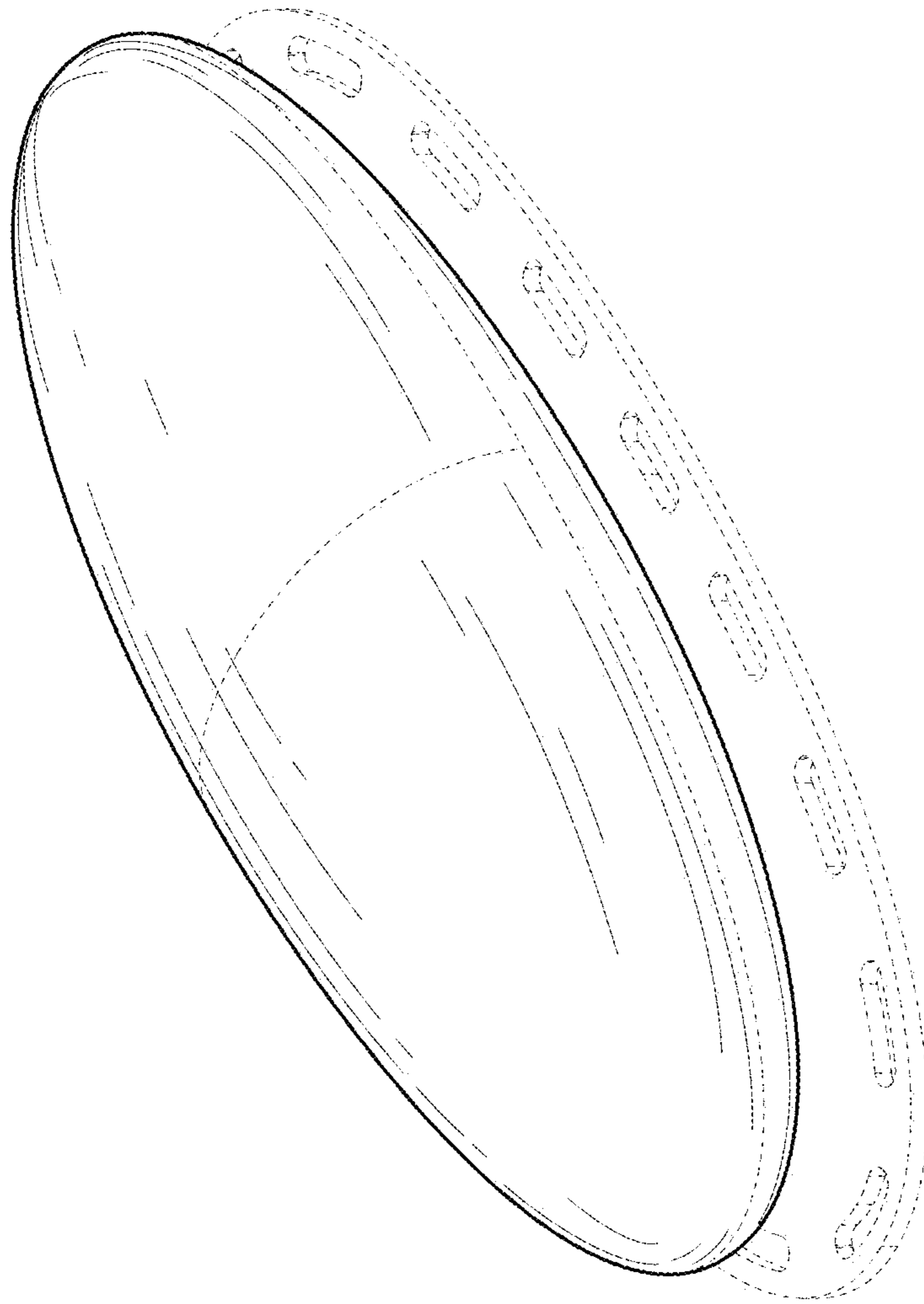

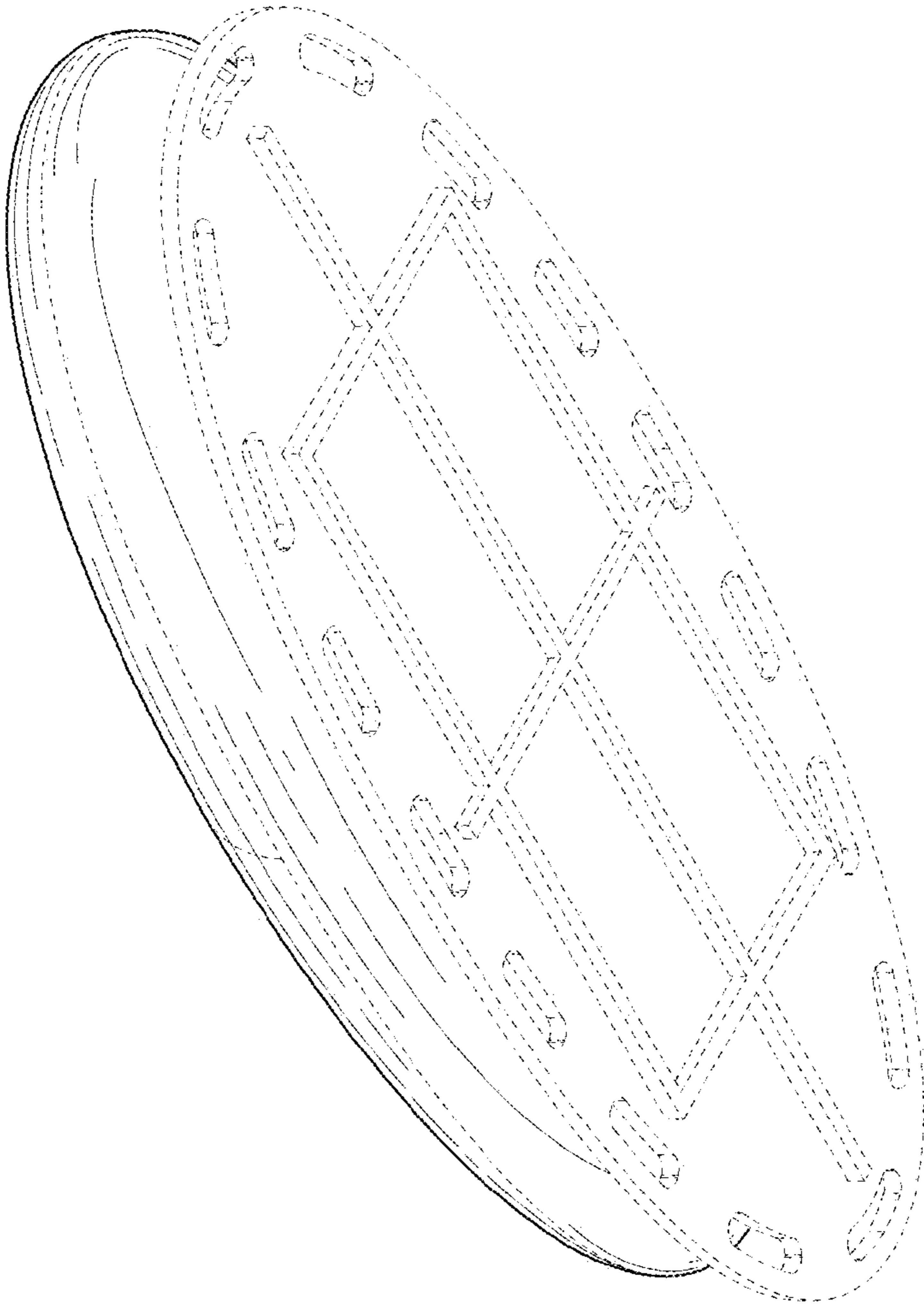

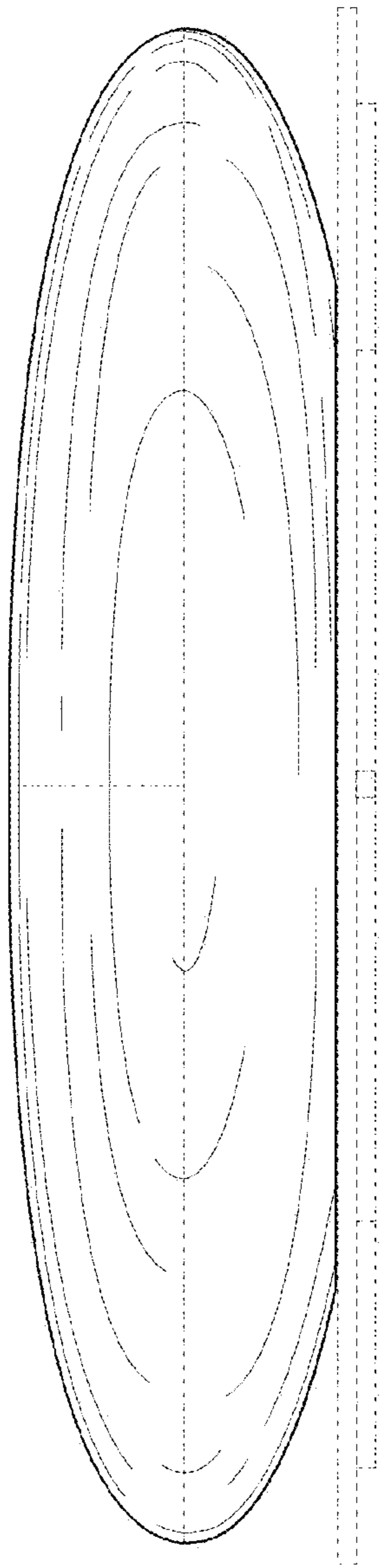

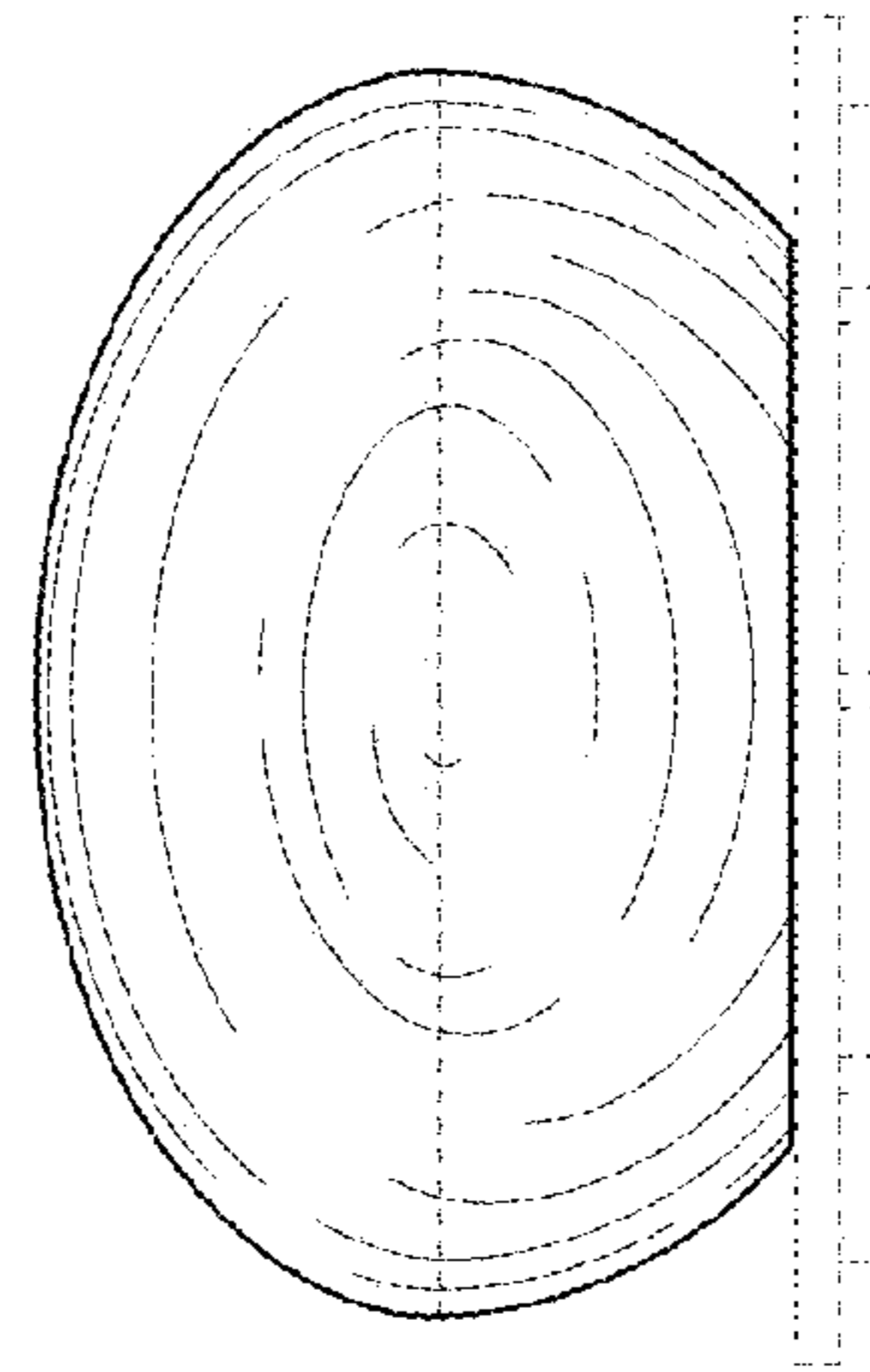

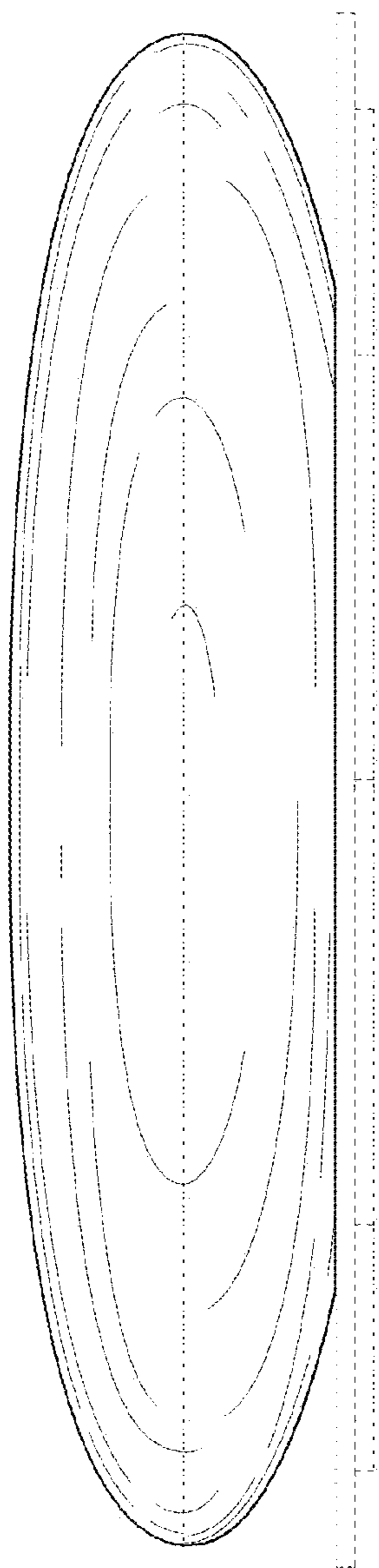

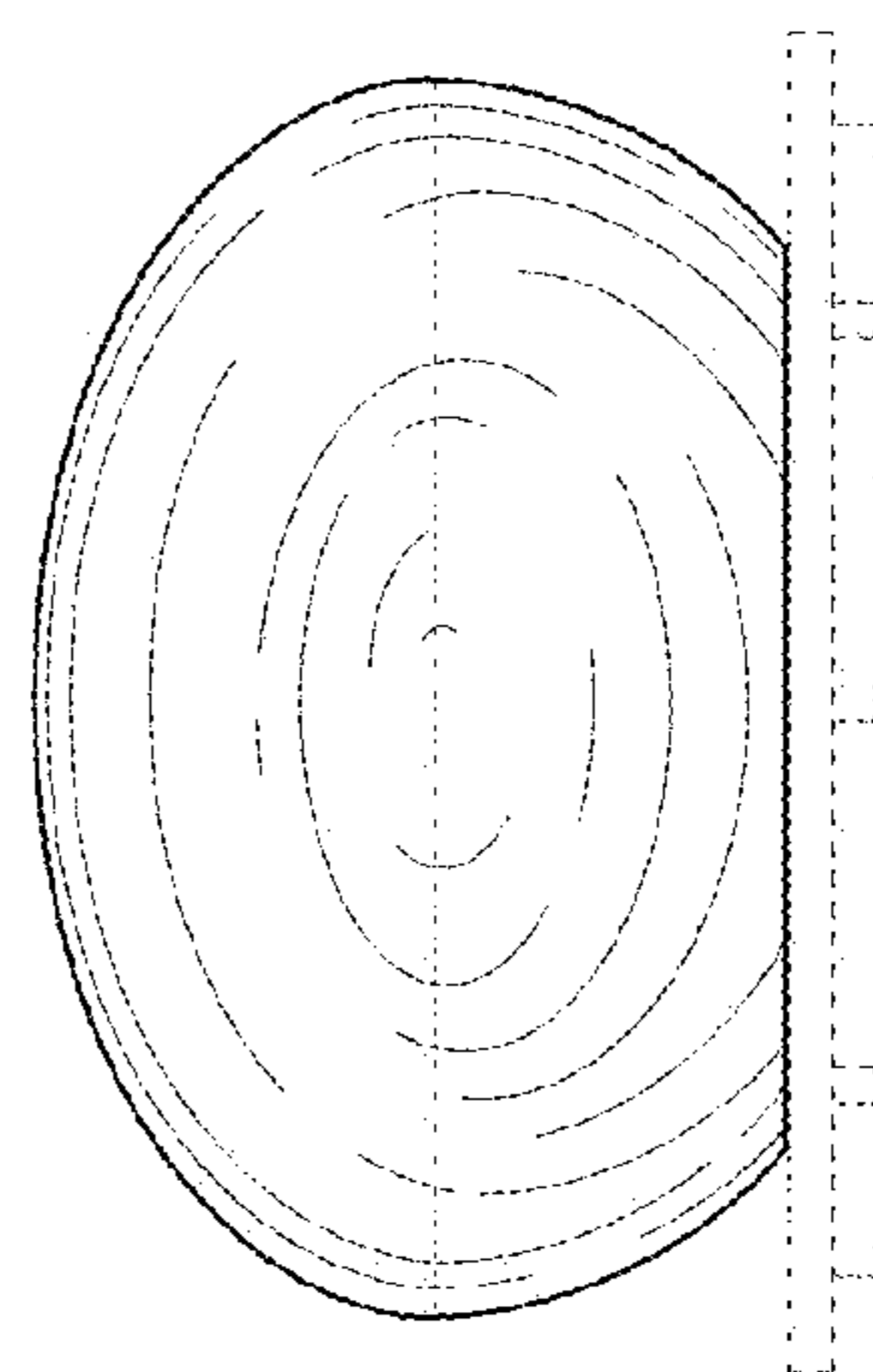

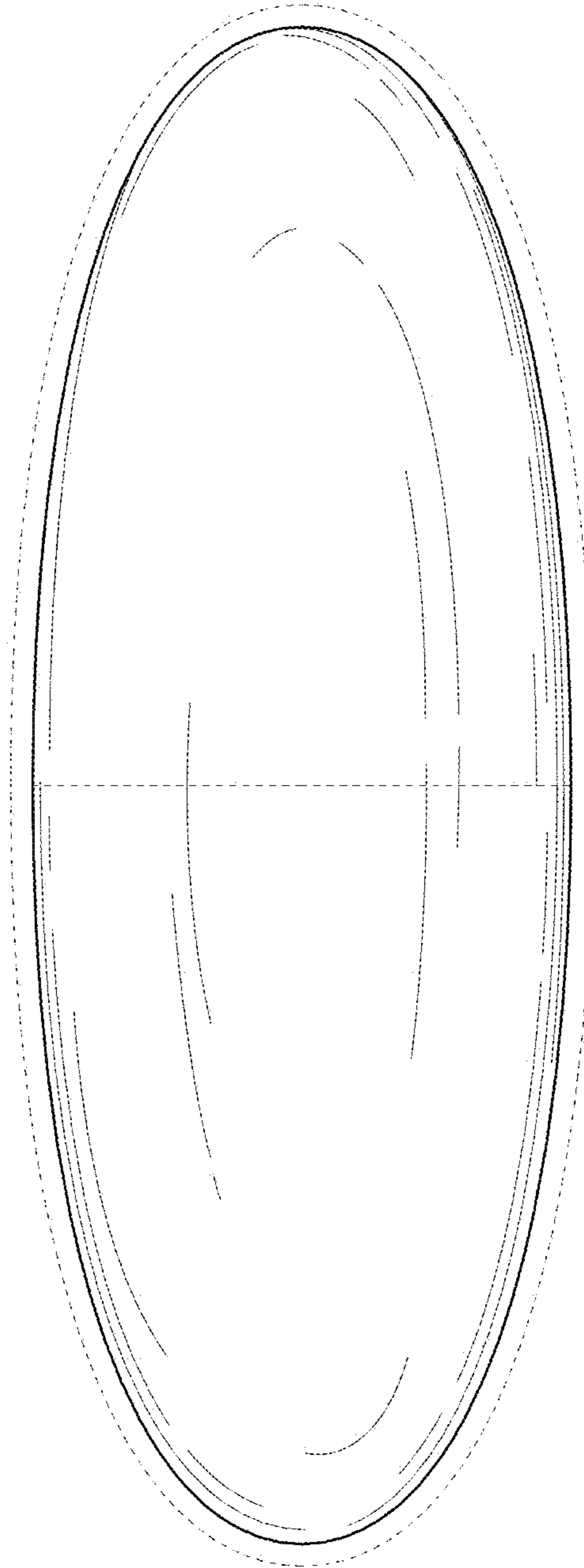

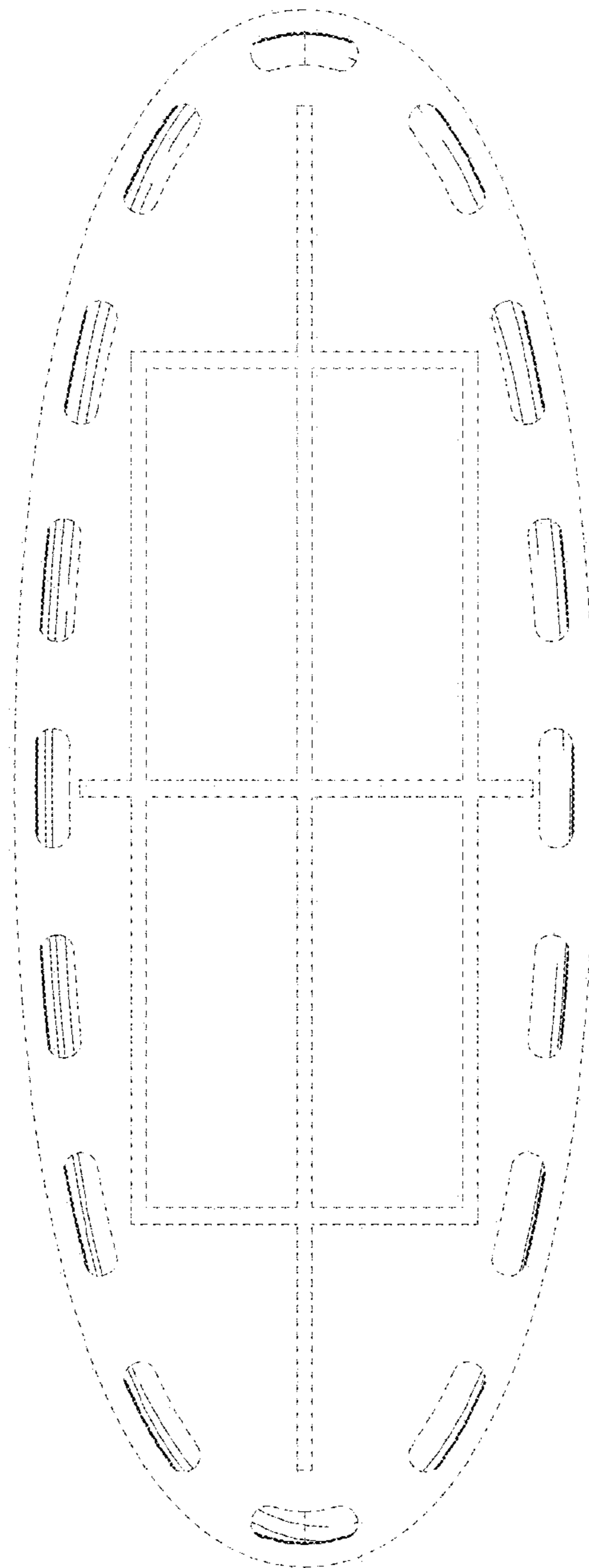
