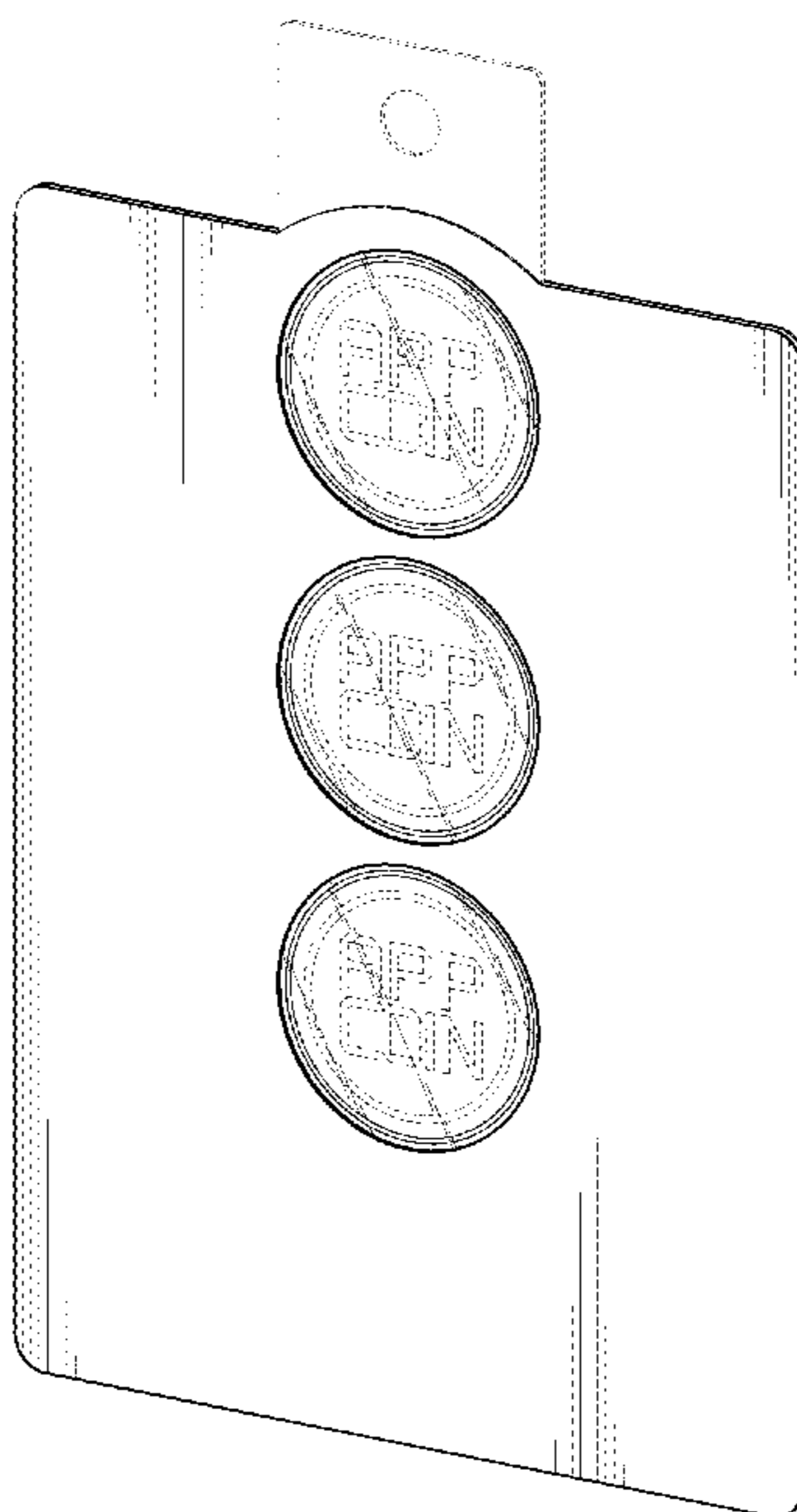
FIG. 5 is a top view of the combined game coin and package of FIGS. 1 and 2; and,

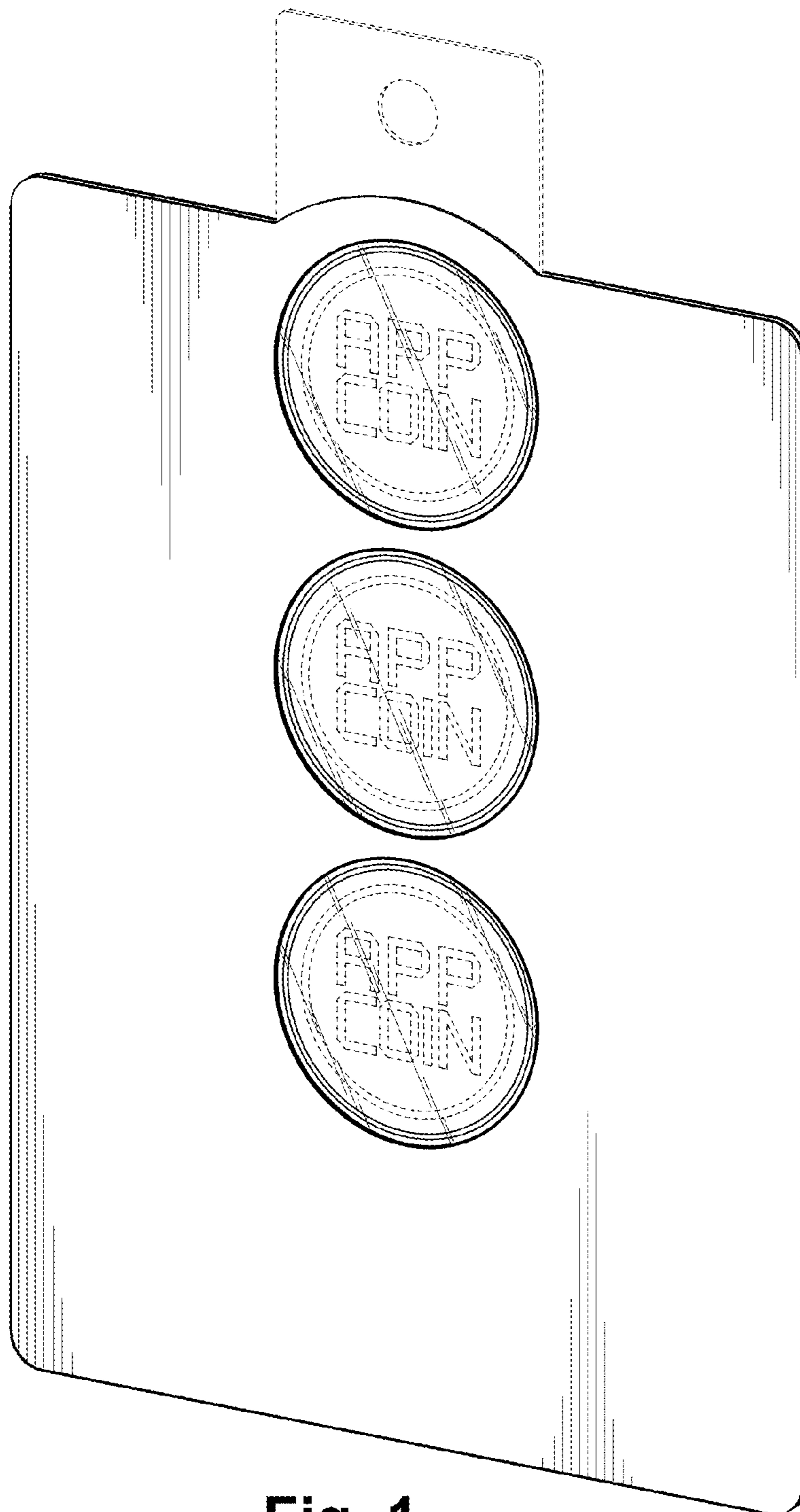

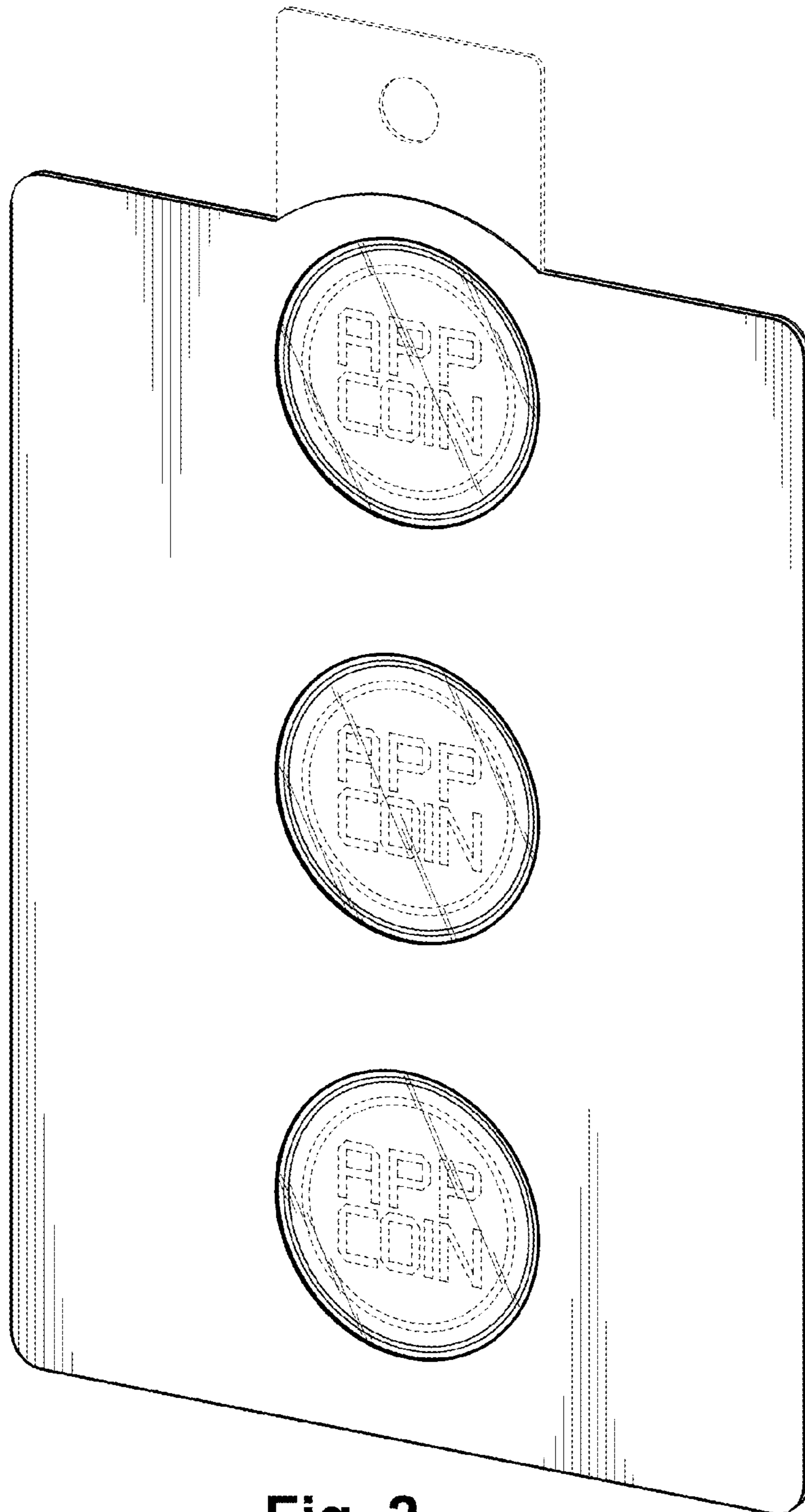

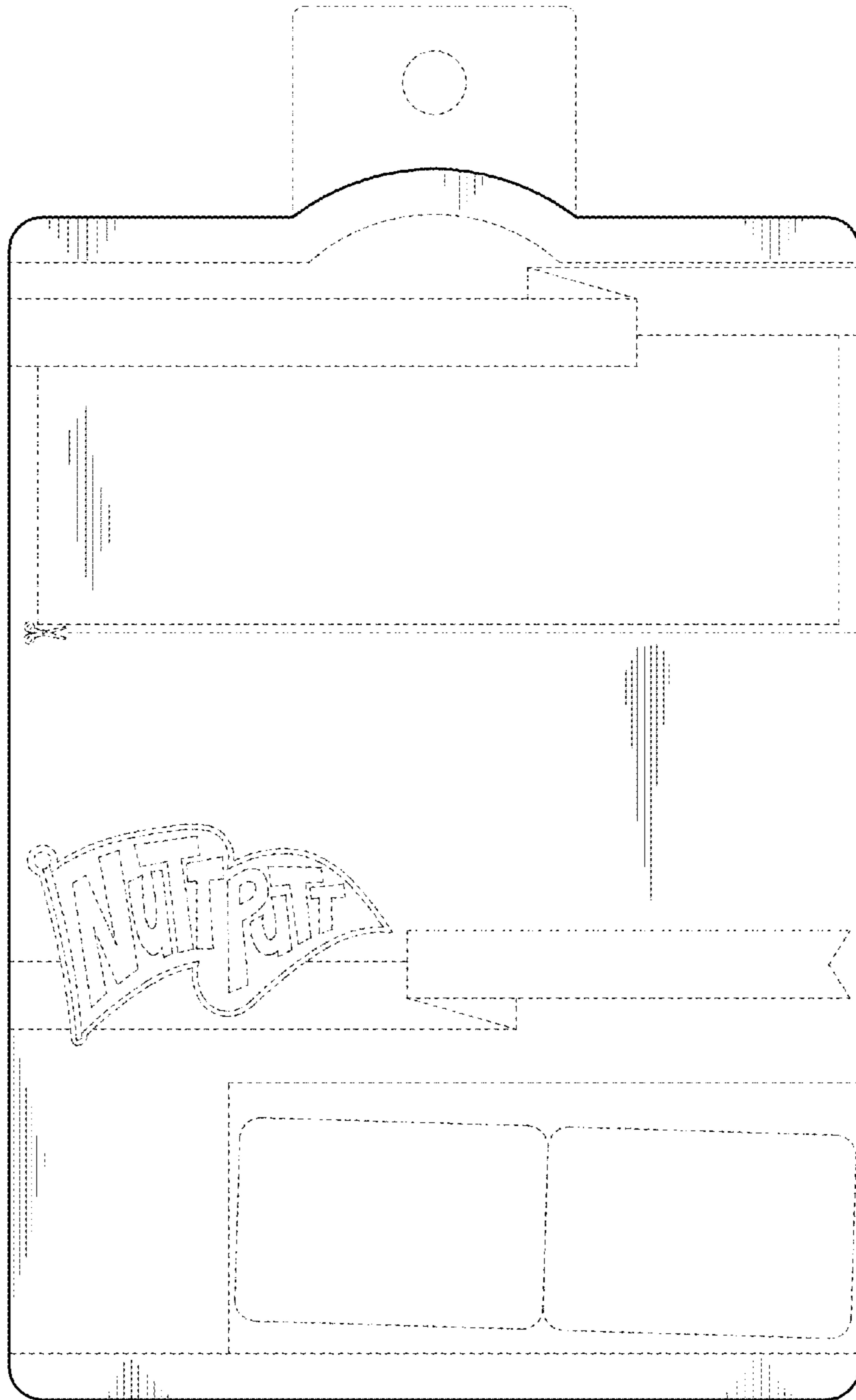

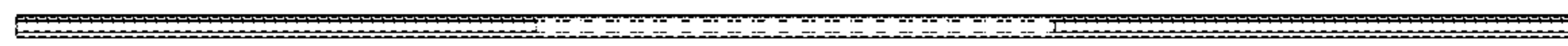

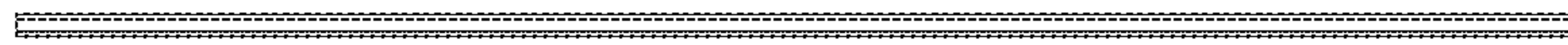
