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(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for pair of floor boards, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left perspective view of the pair of floor boards according to the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a right perspective view of the pair of floor boards thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the pair of floor boards thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the pair of floor boards thereof;

FIG. 5 is an outer side elevation view of the pair of floor boards thereof;

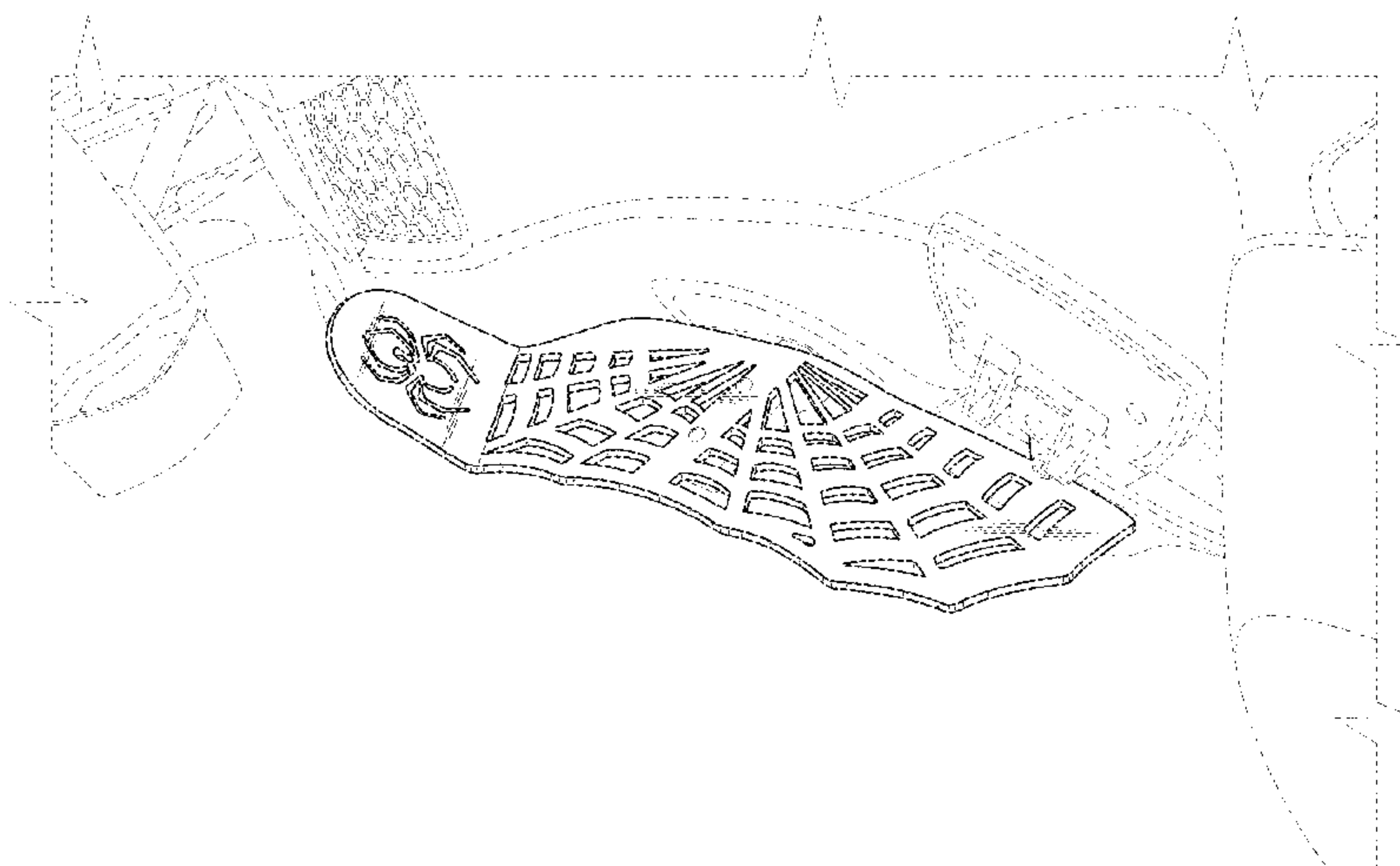
FIG. 6 is an outer side elevation view of the pair of floor boards thereof;

FIG. 7 is an inner side elevation view of the pair of floor boards thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is an inner side elevation view of the pair of floor boards thereof.

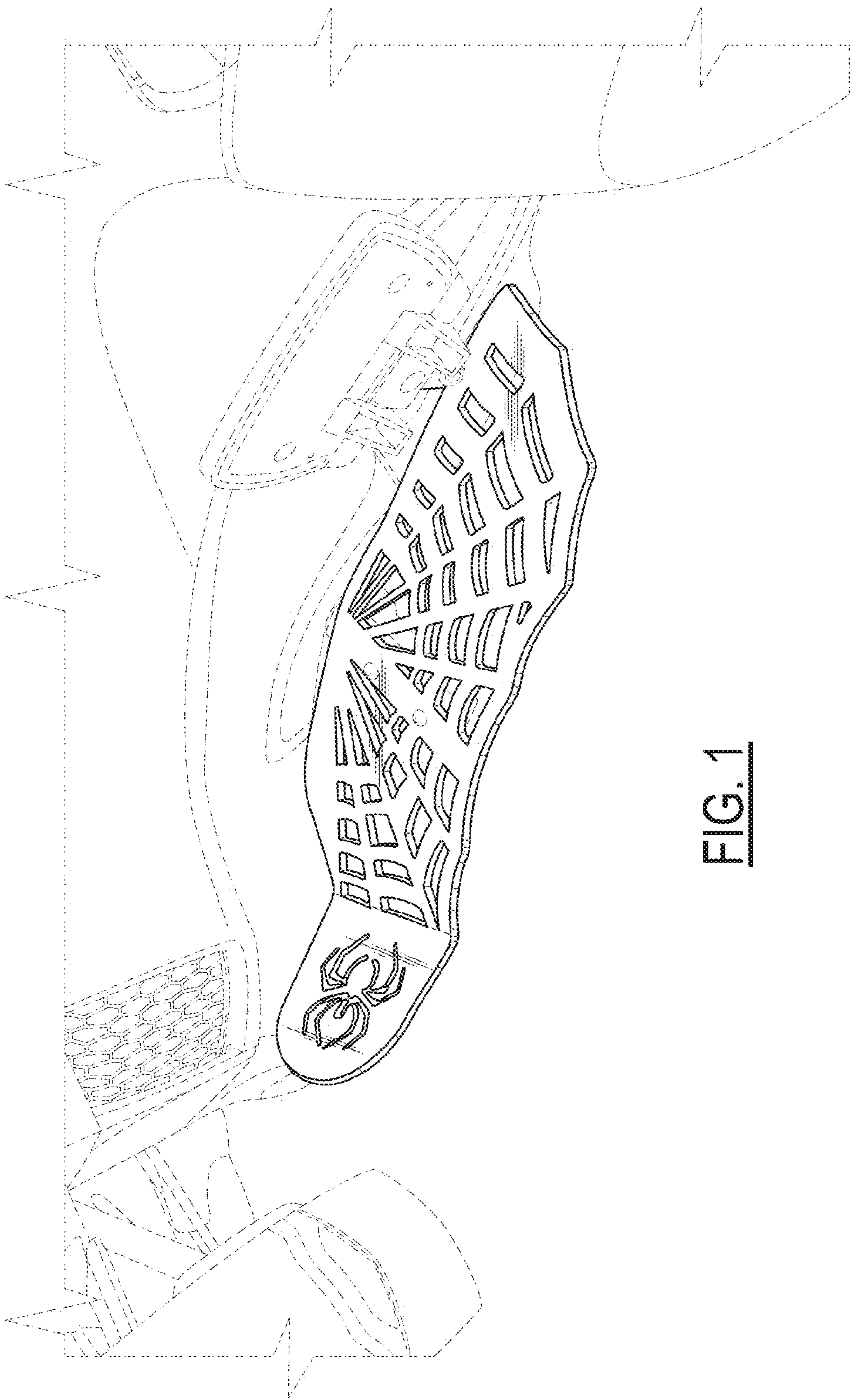

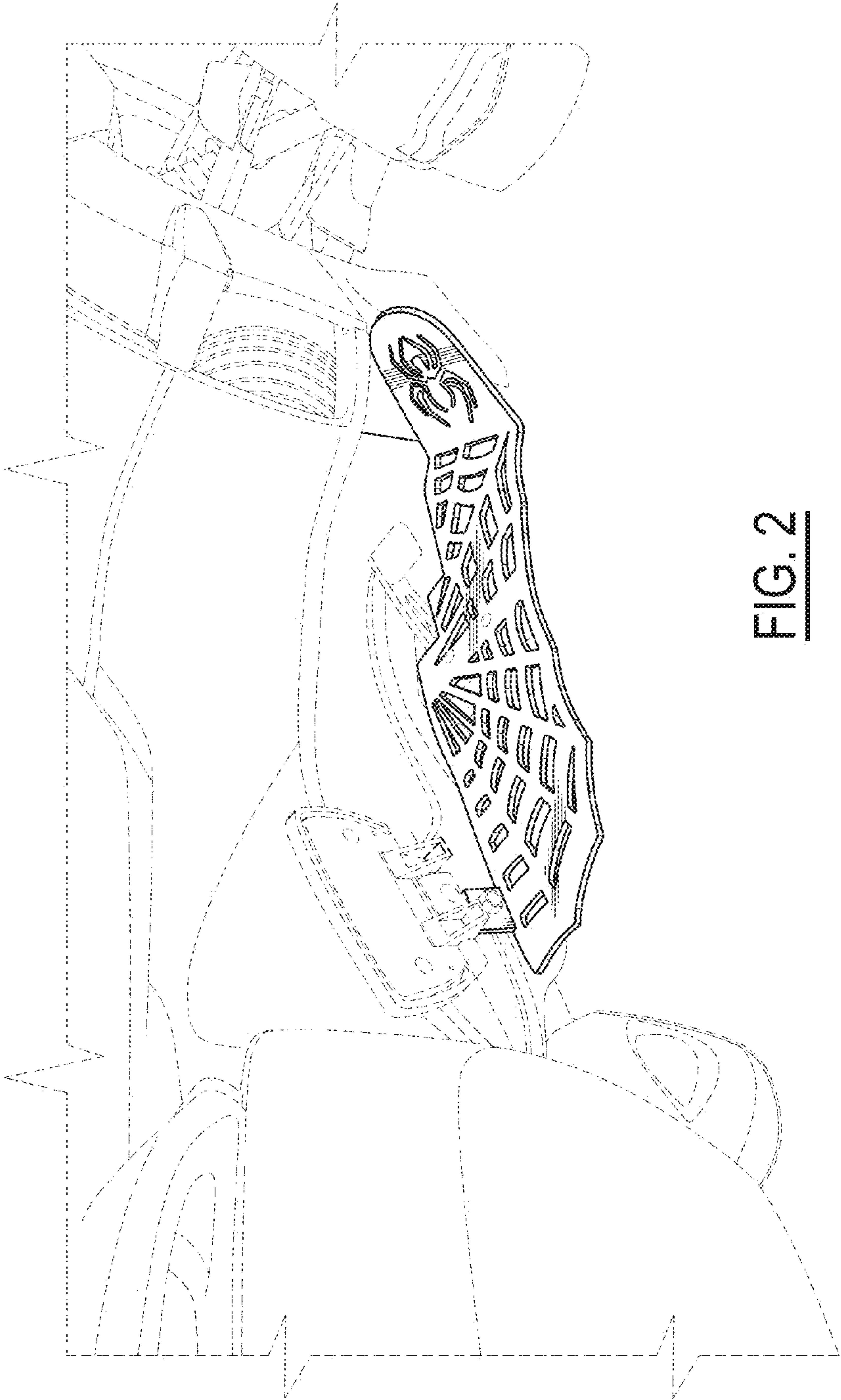

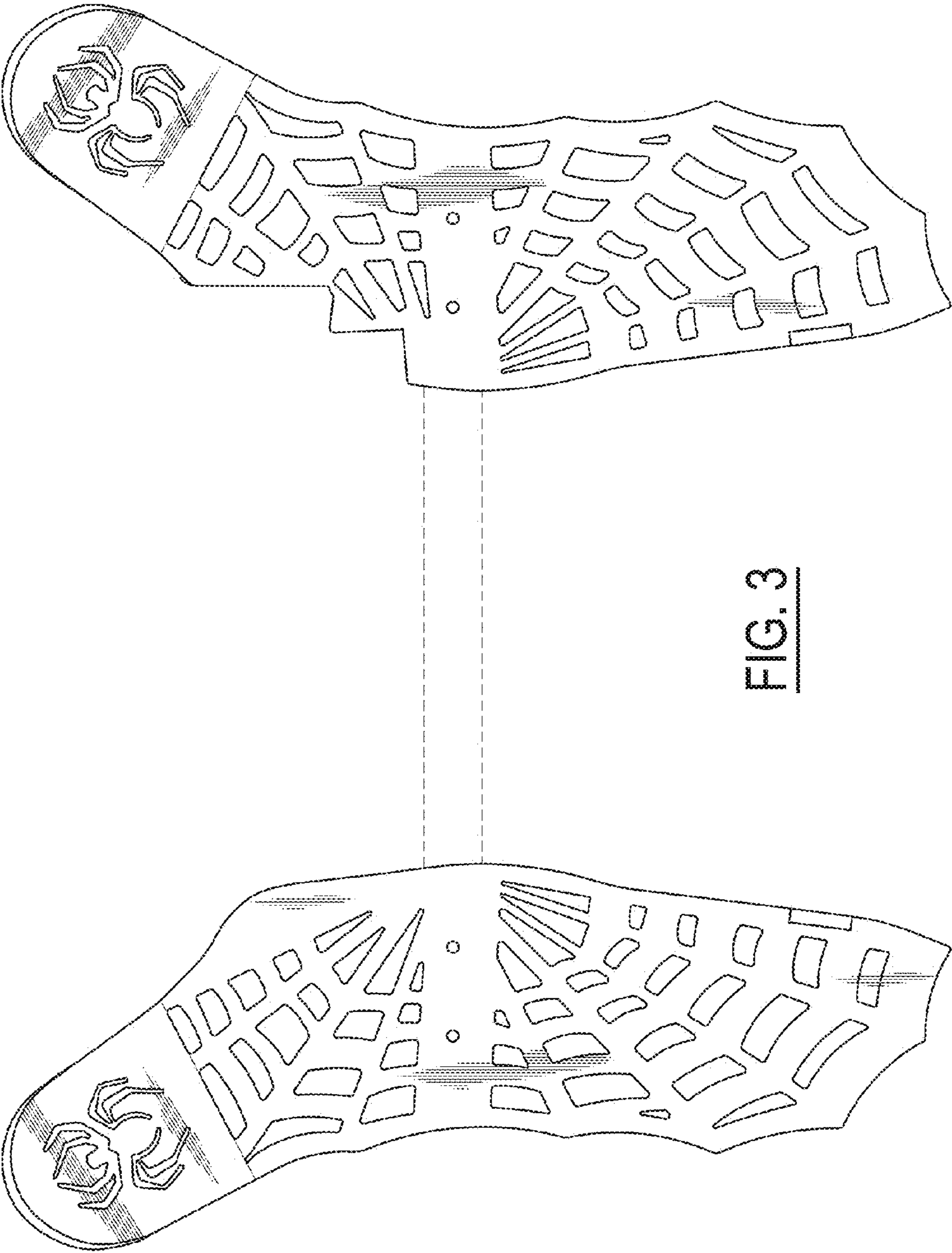

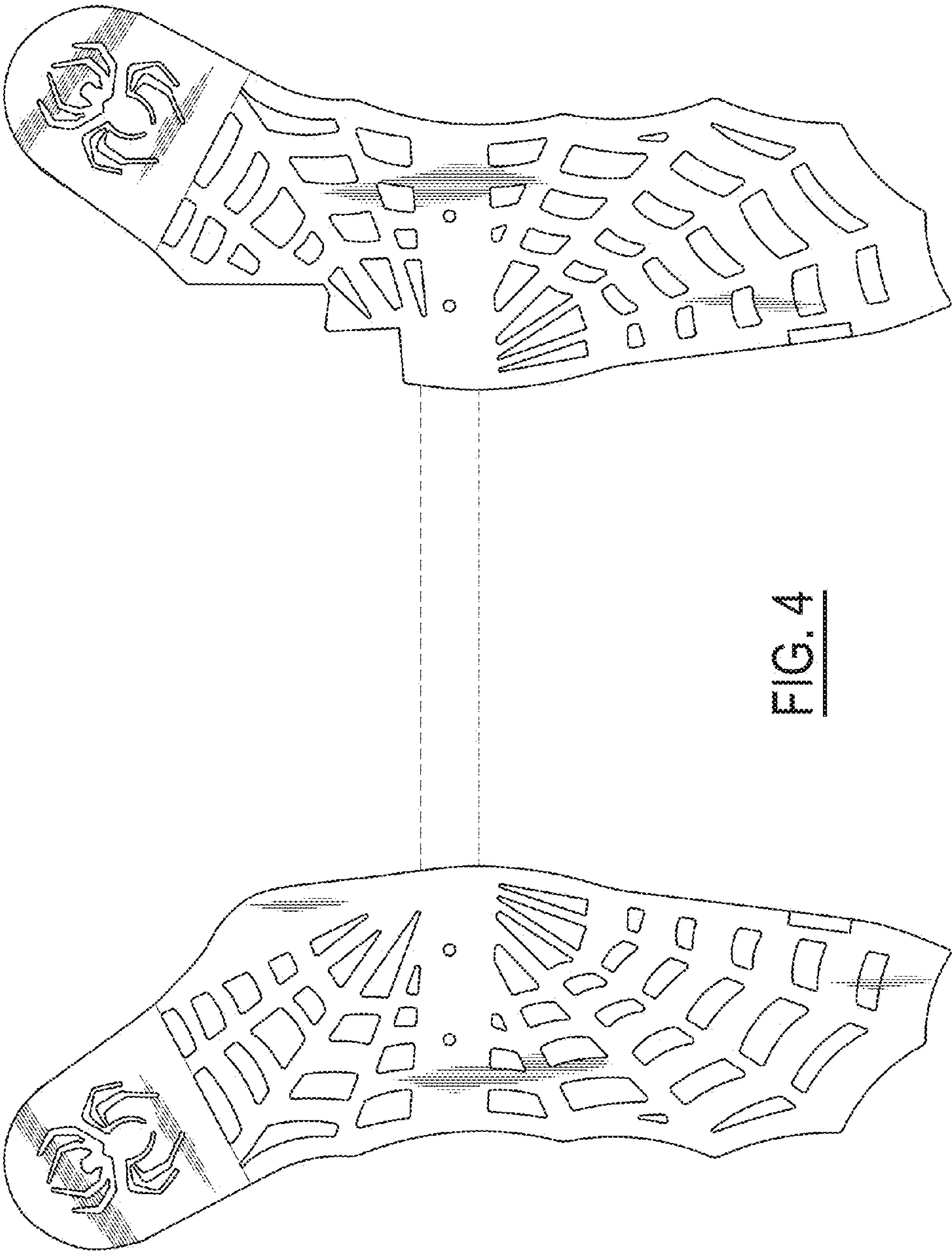

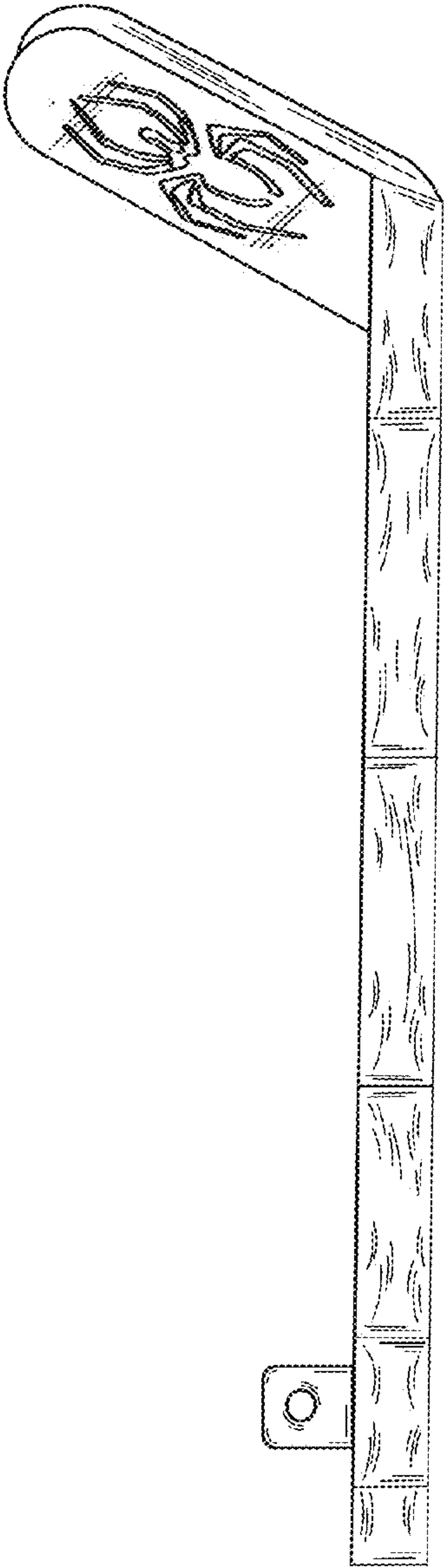

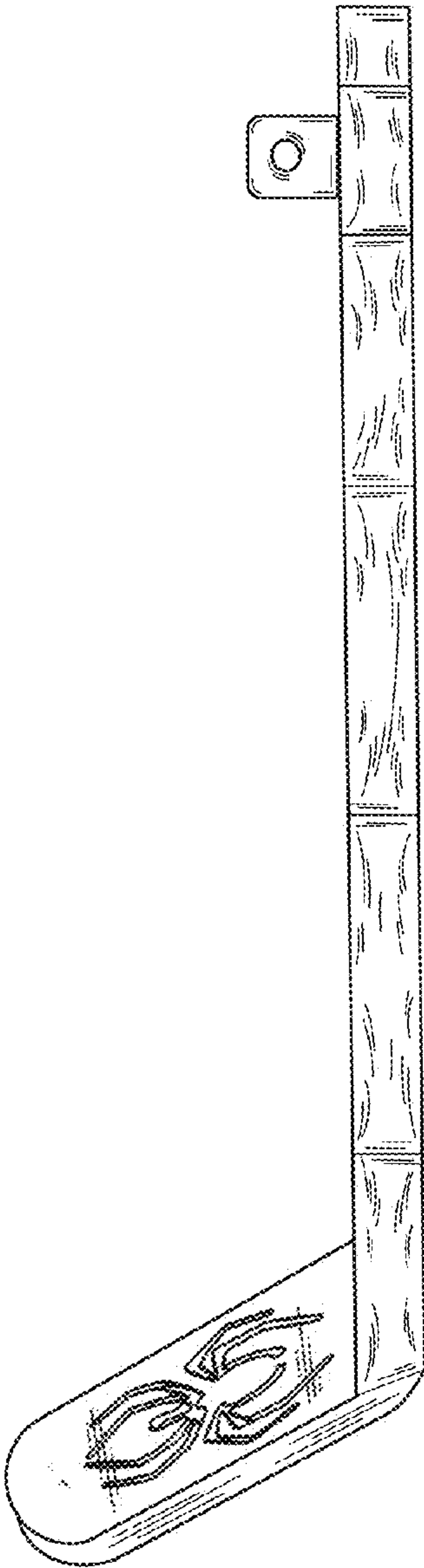

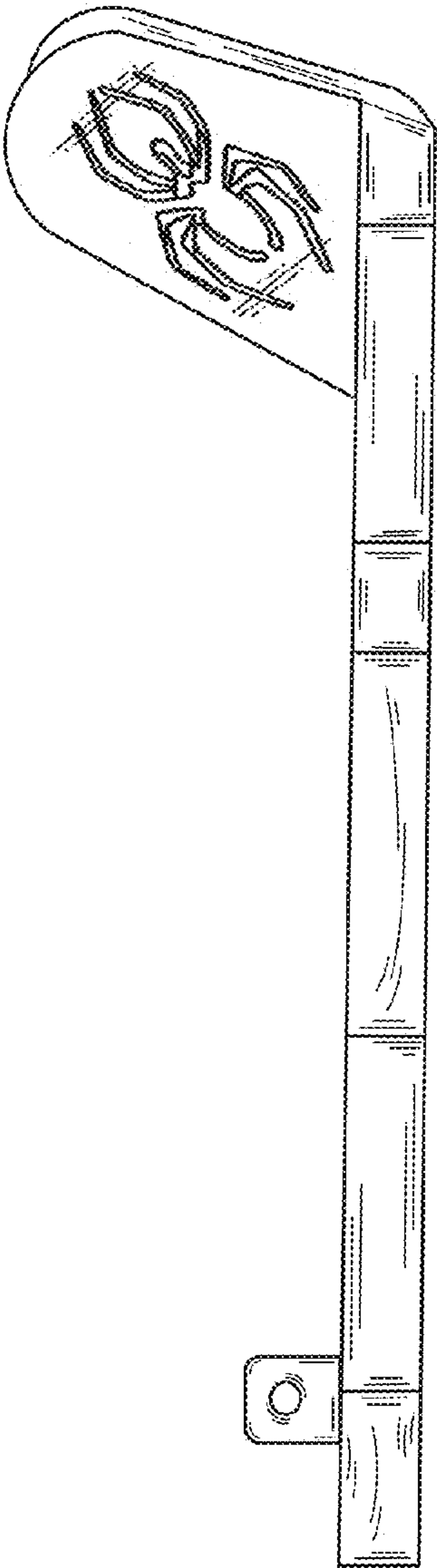

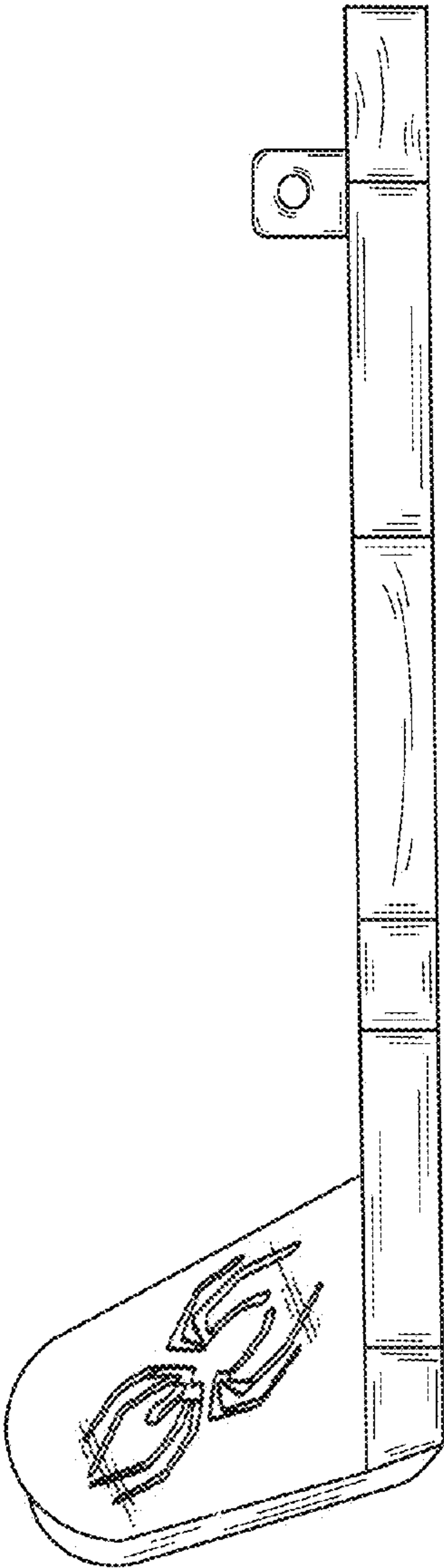
