FIG. 6 is a top side view thereof;

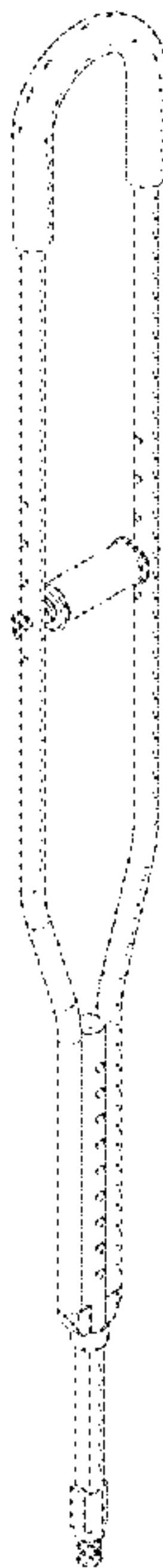
FIG. 7 is a bottom side view thereof;

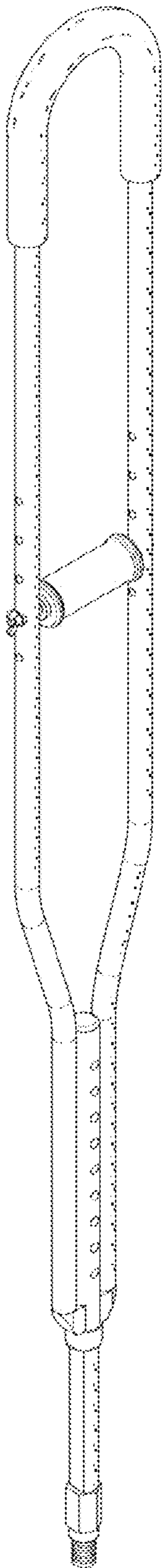

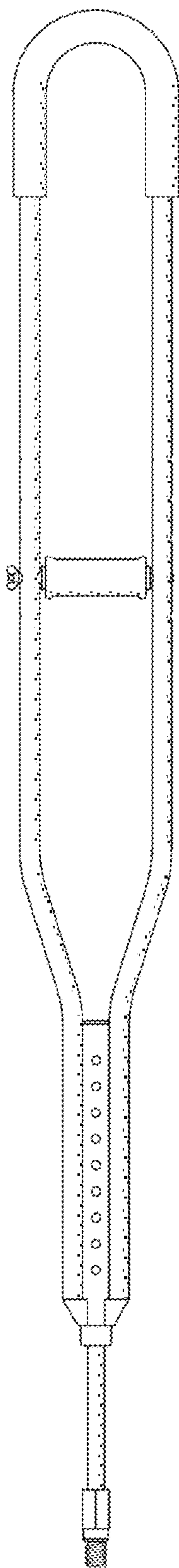

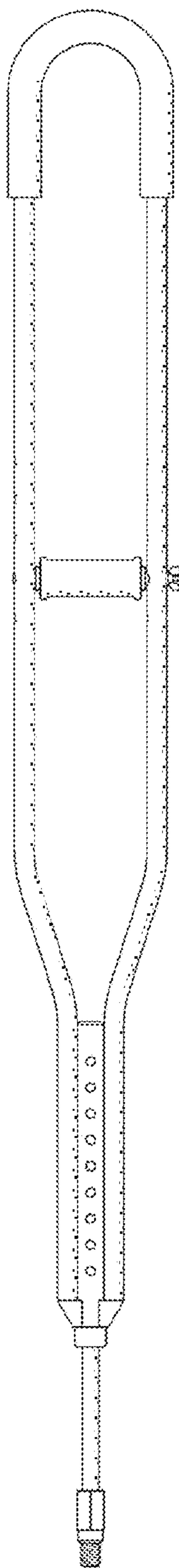

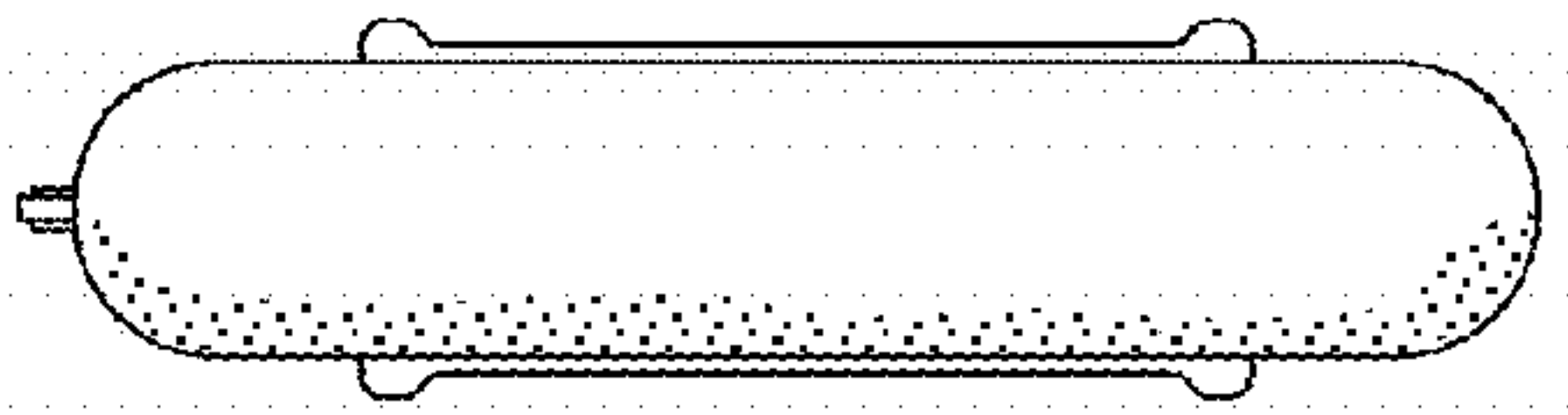

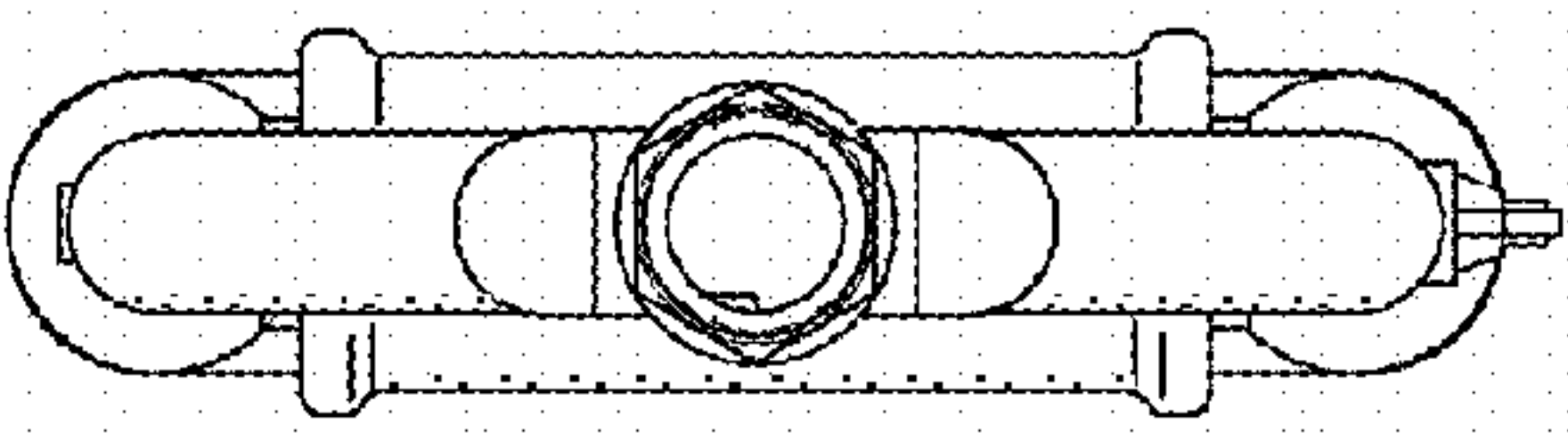

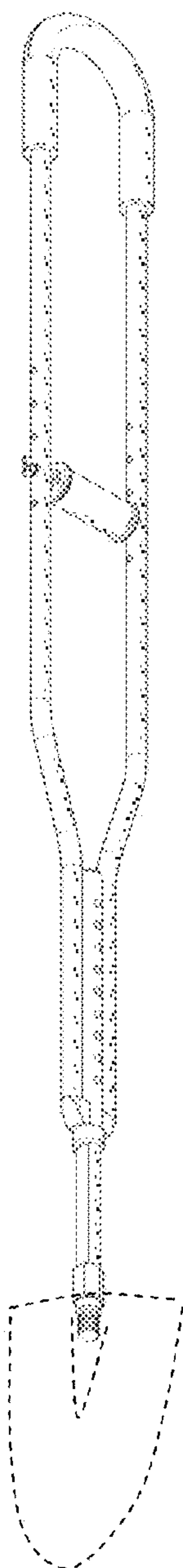

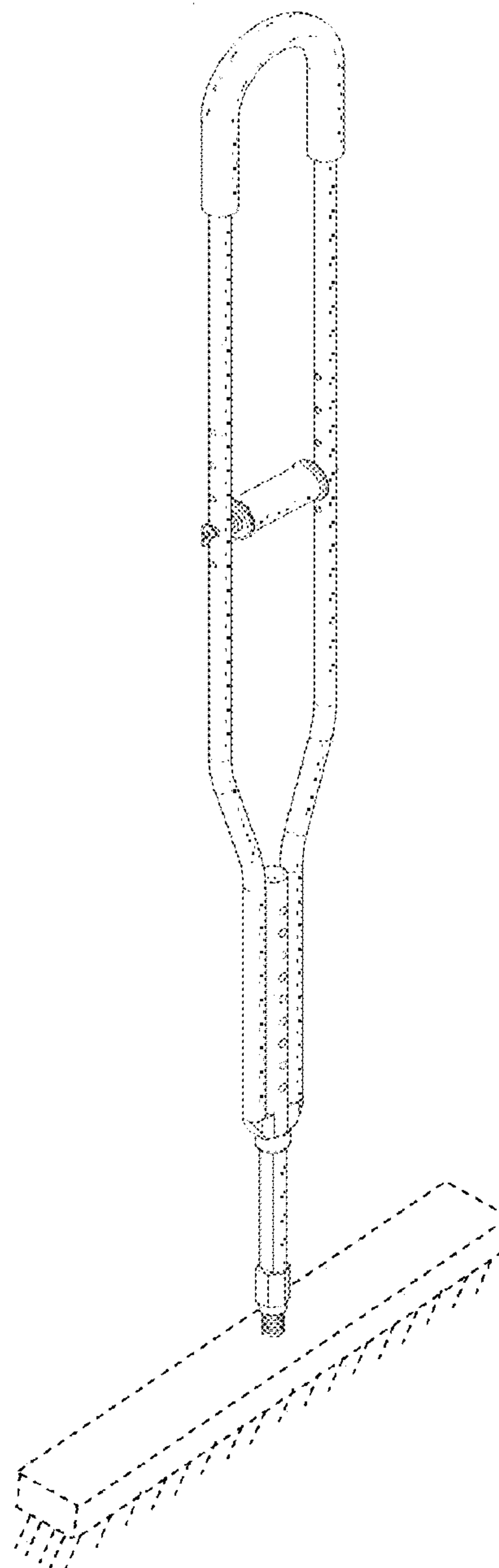
