DESCRIPTION

cushion in the second configuration;

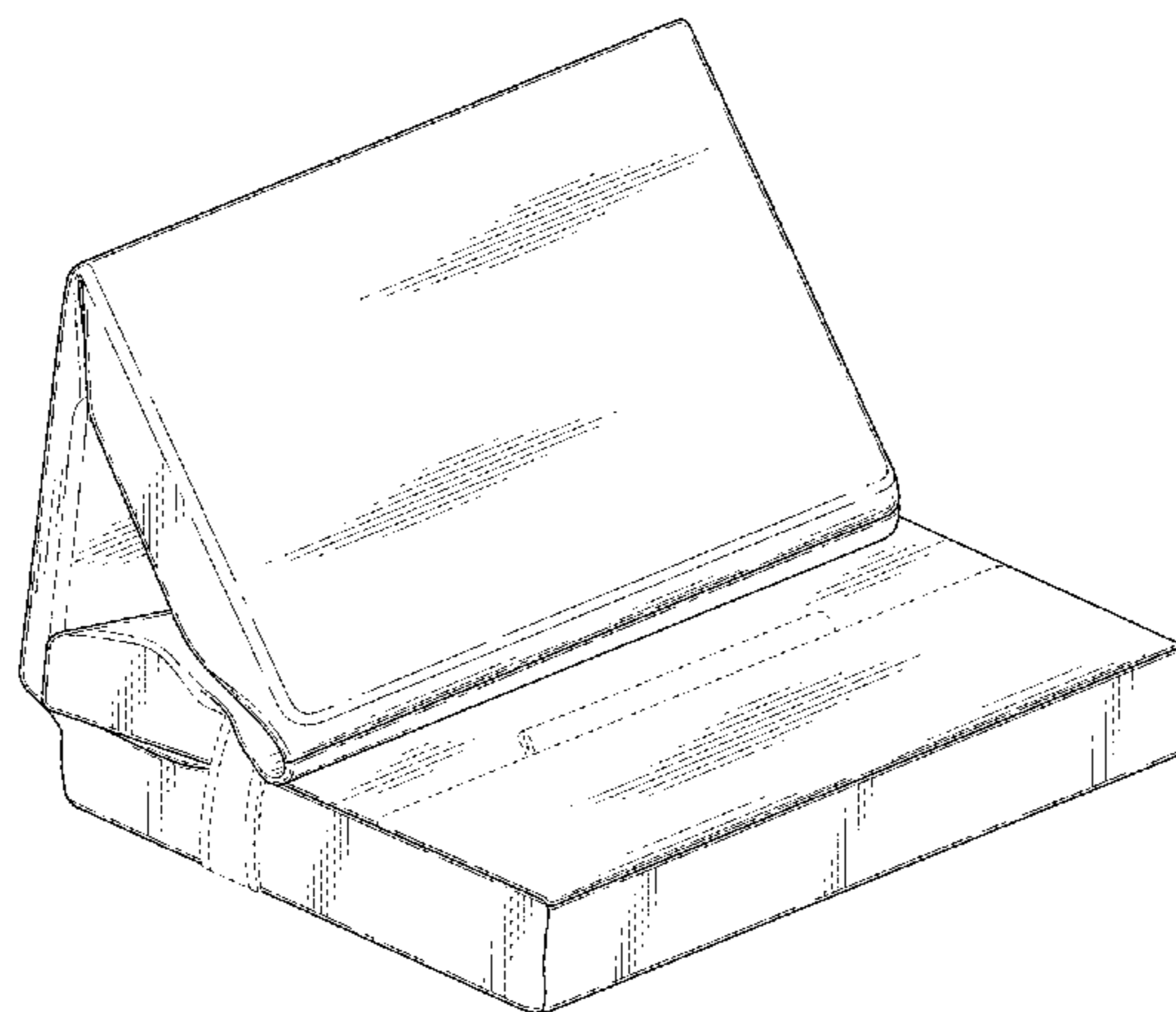
FIG. 14 is a top view of the tablet or laptop support cushion in

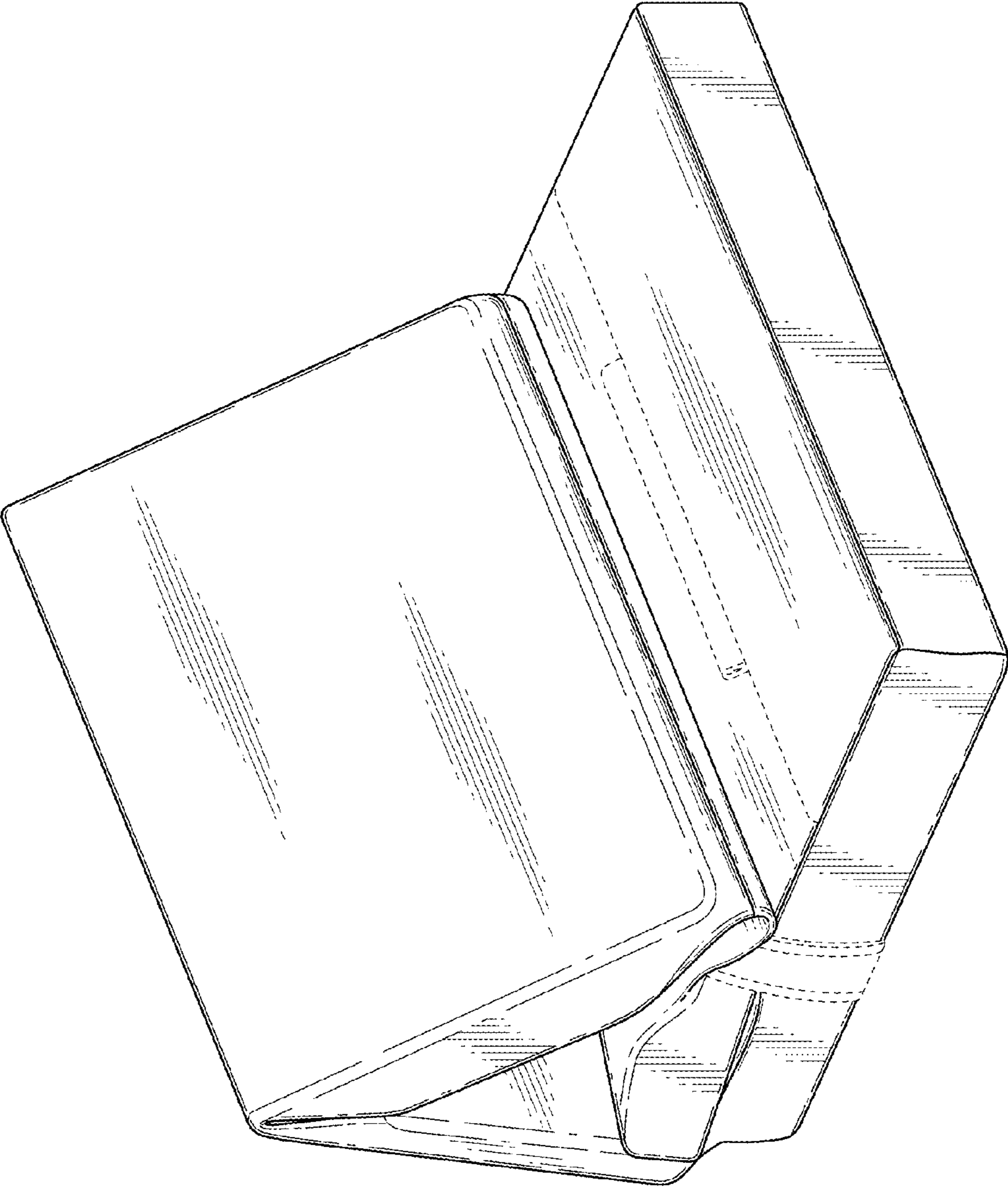

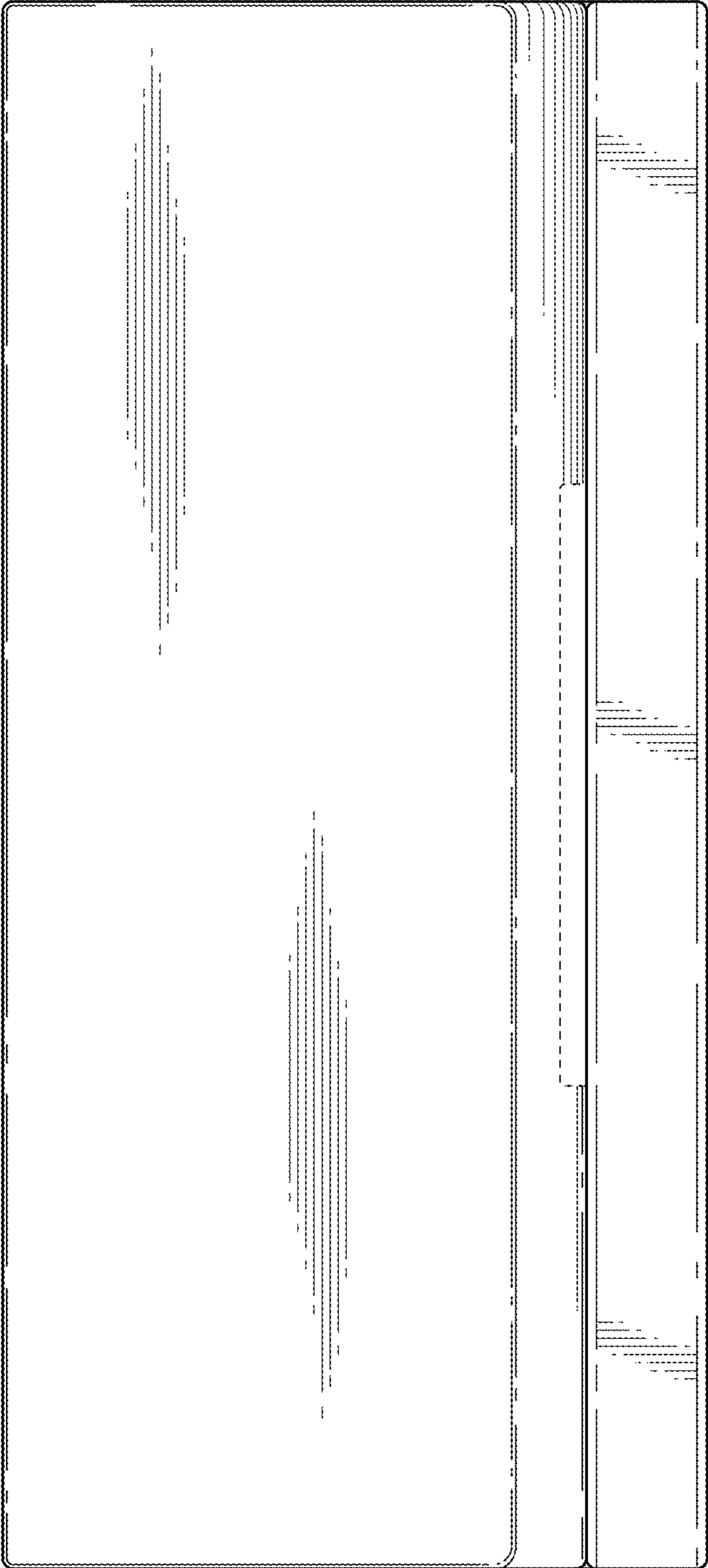

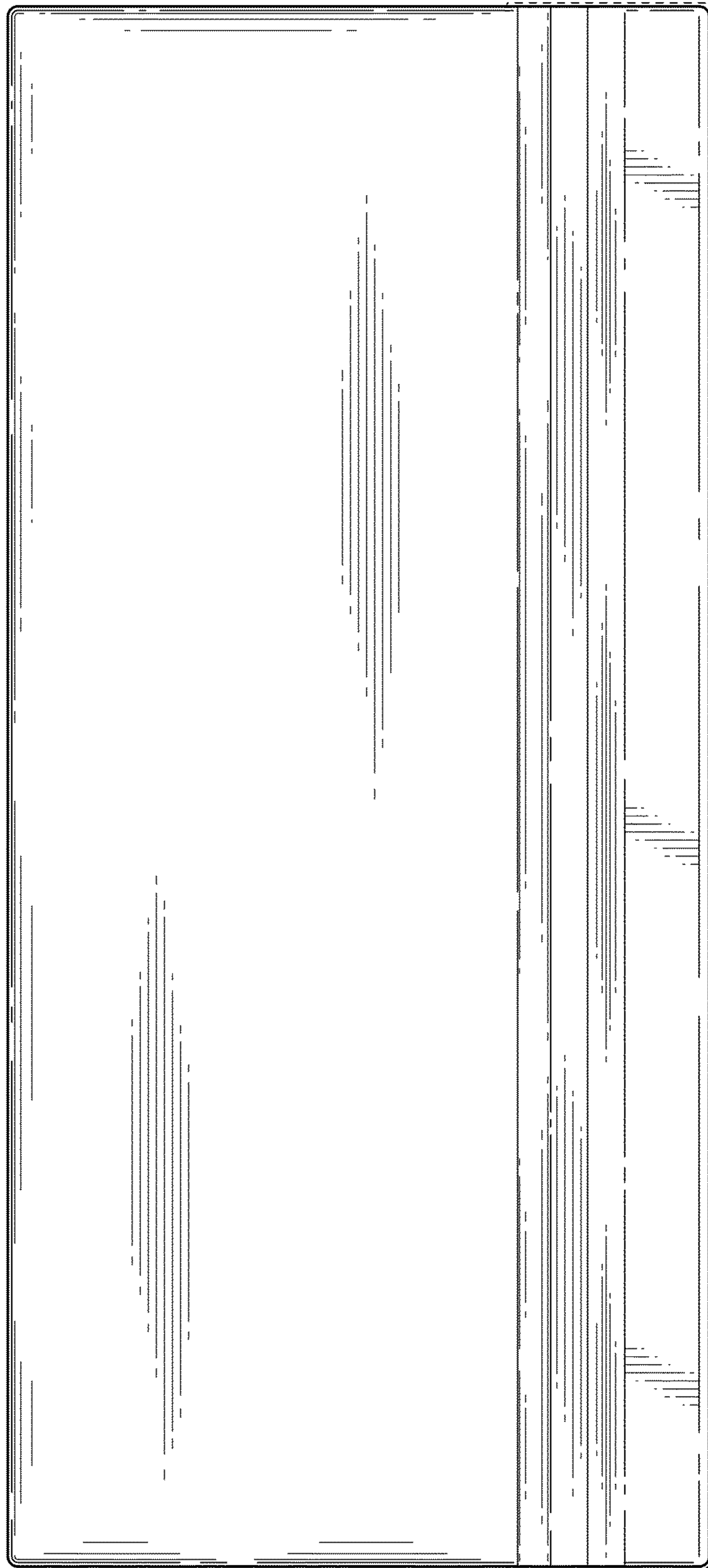

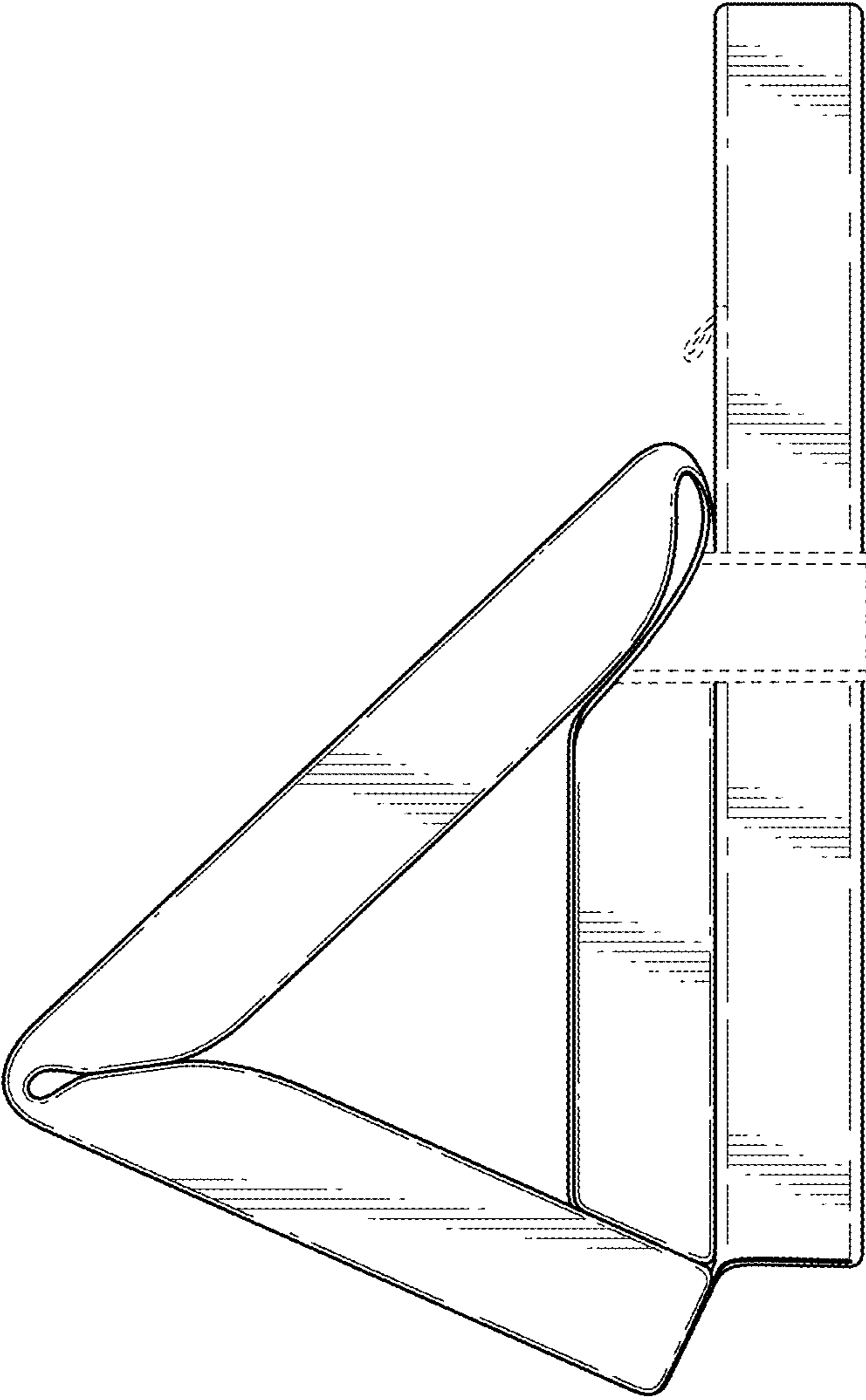

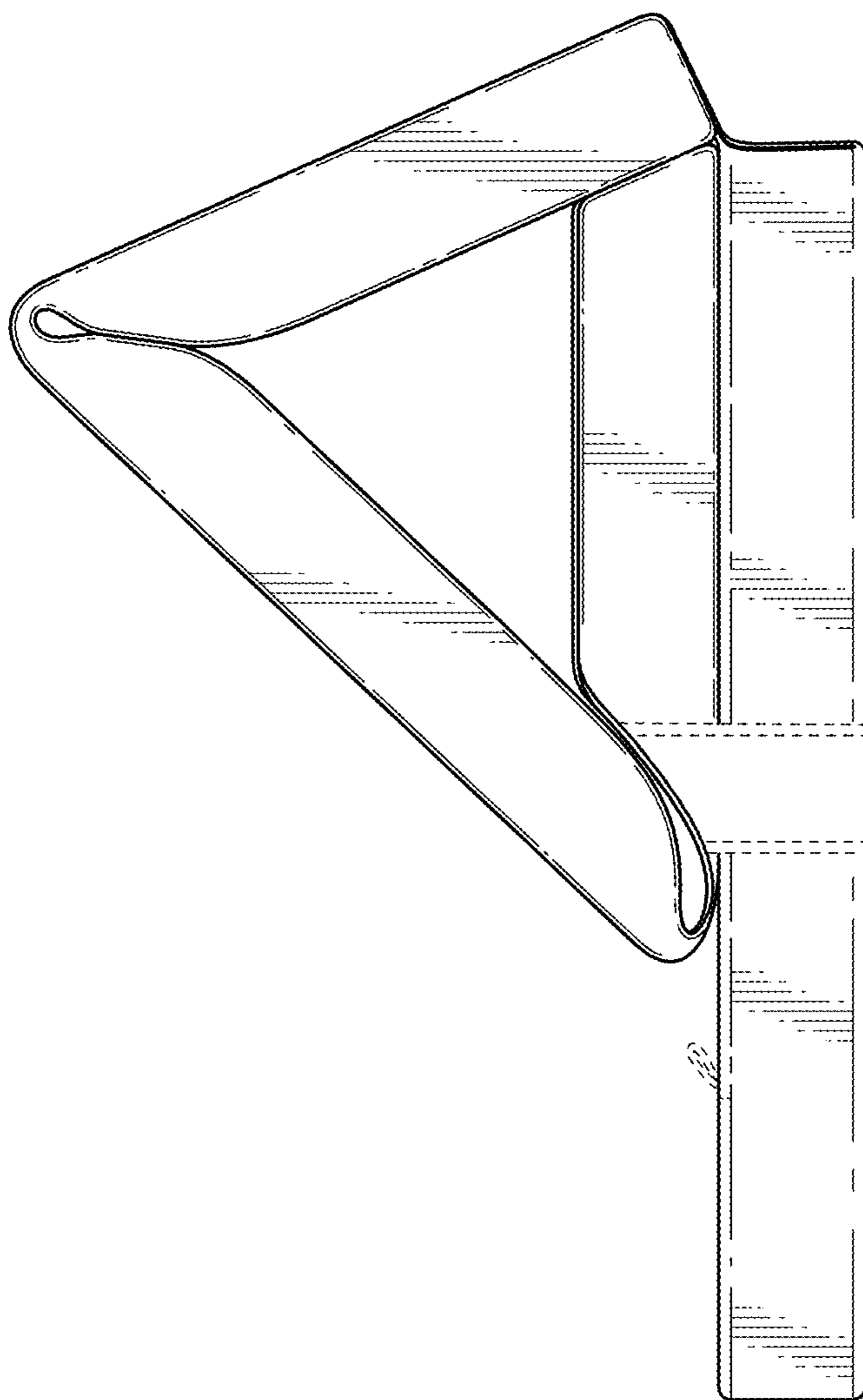

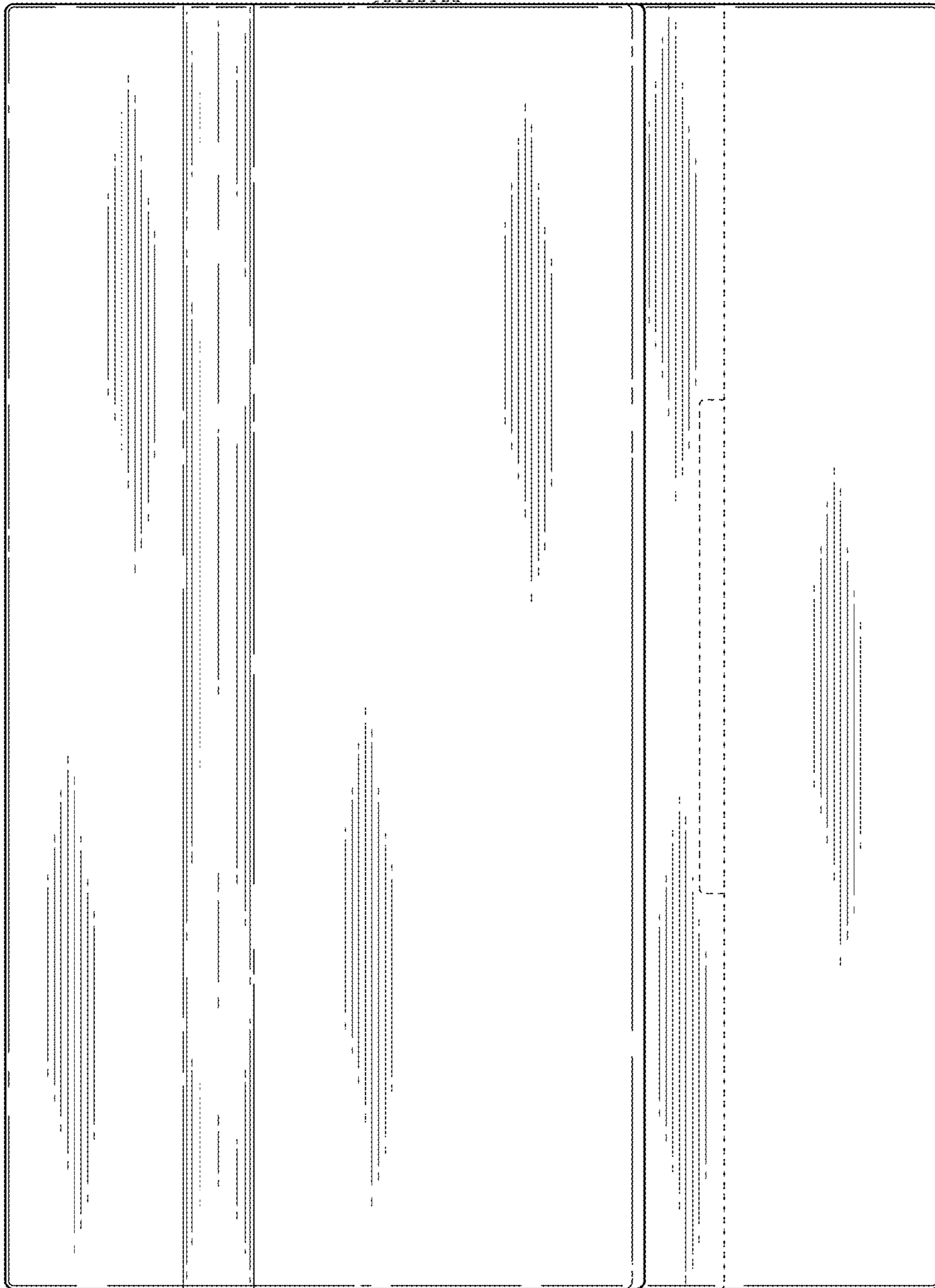

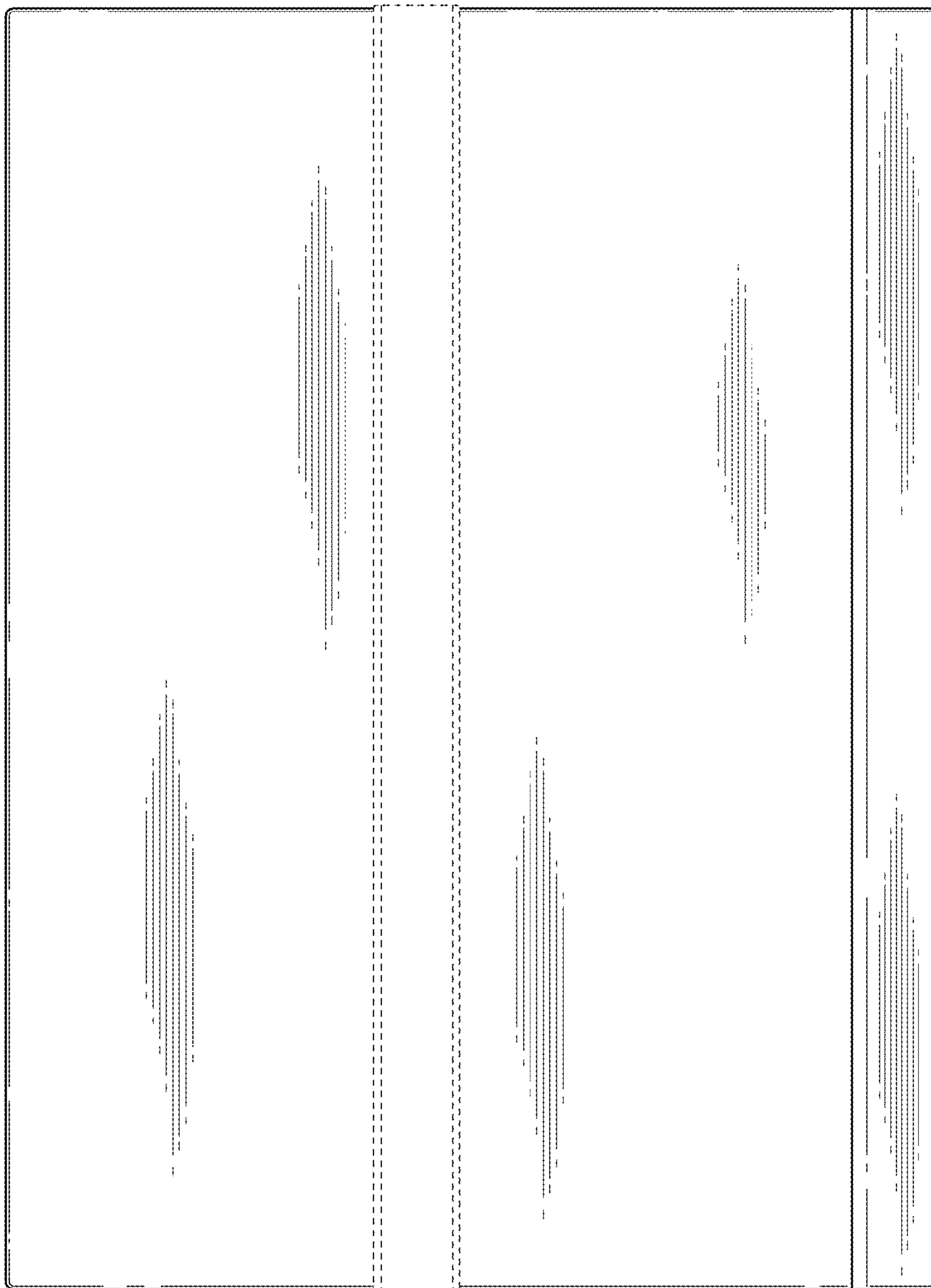

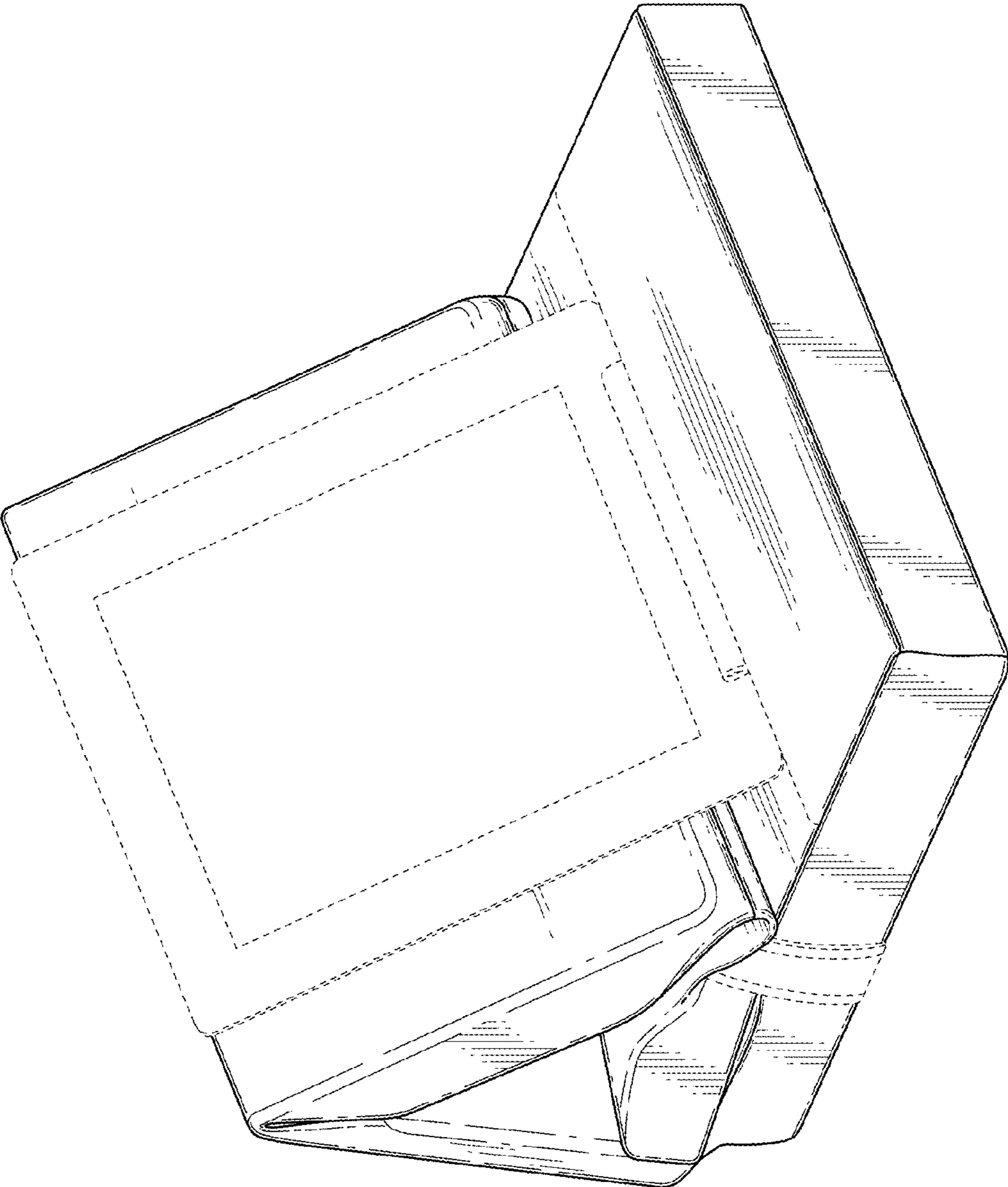

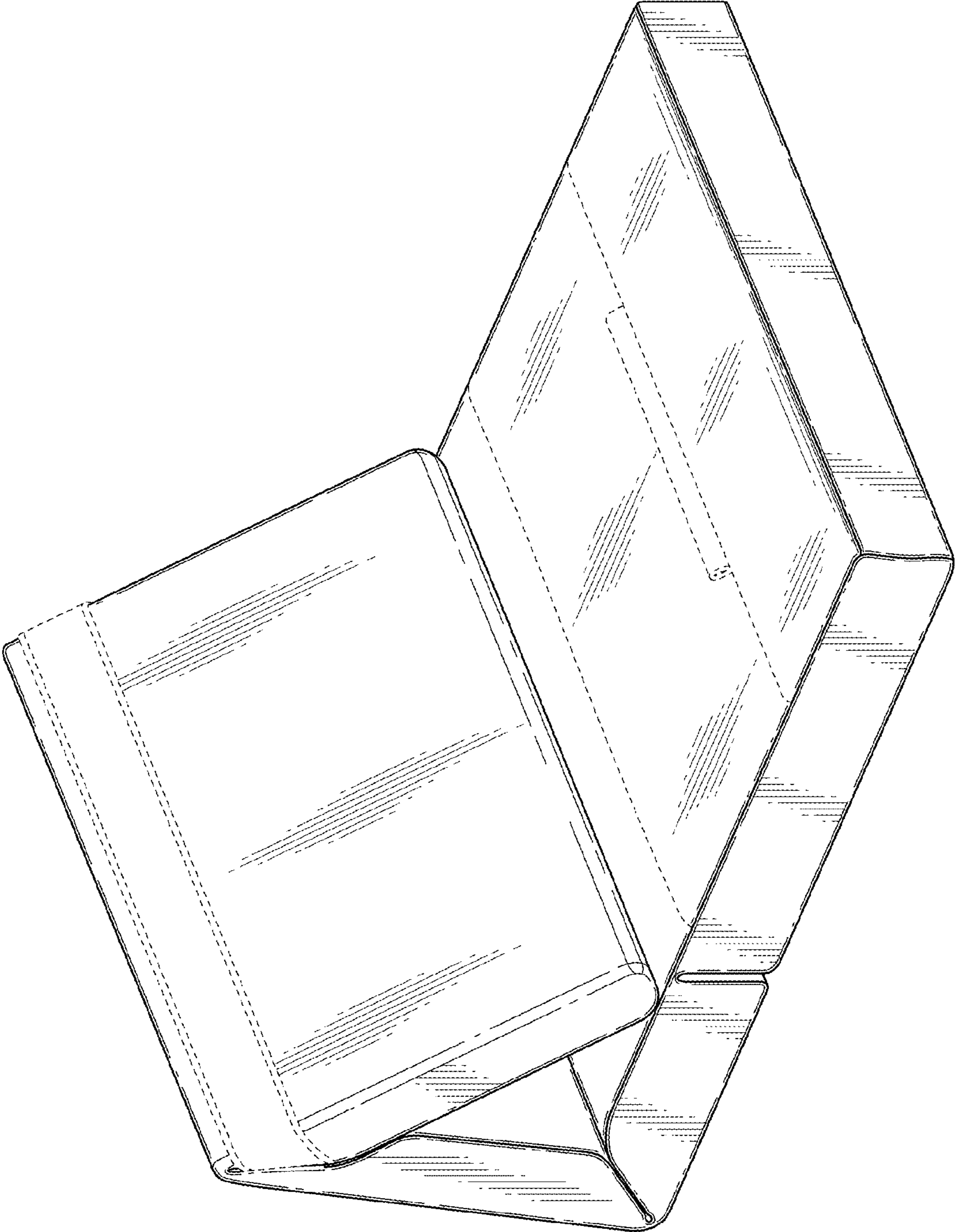

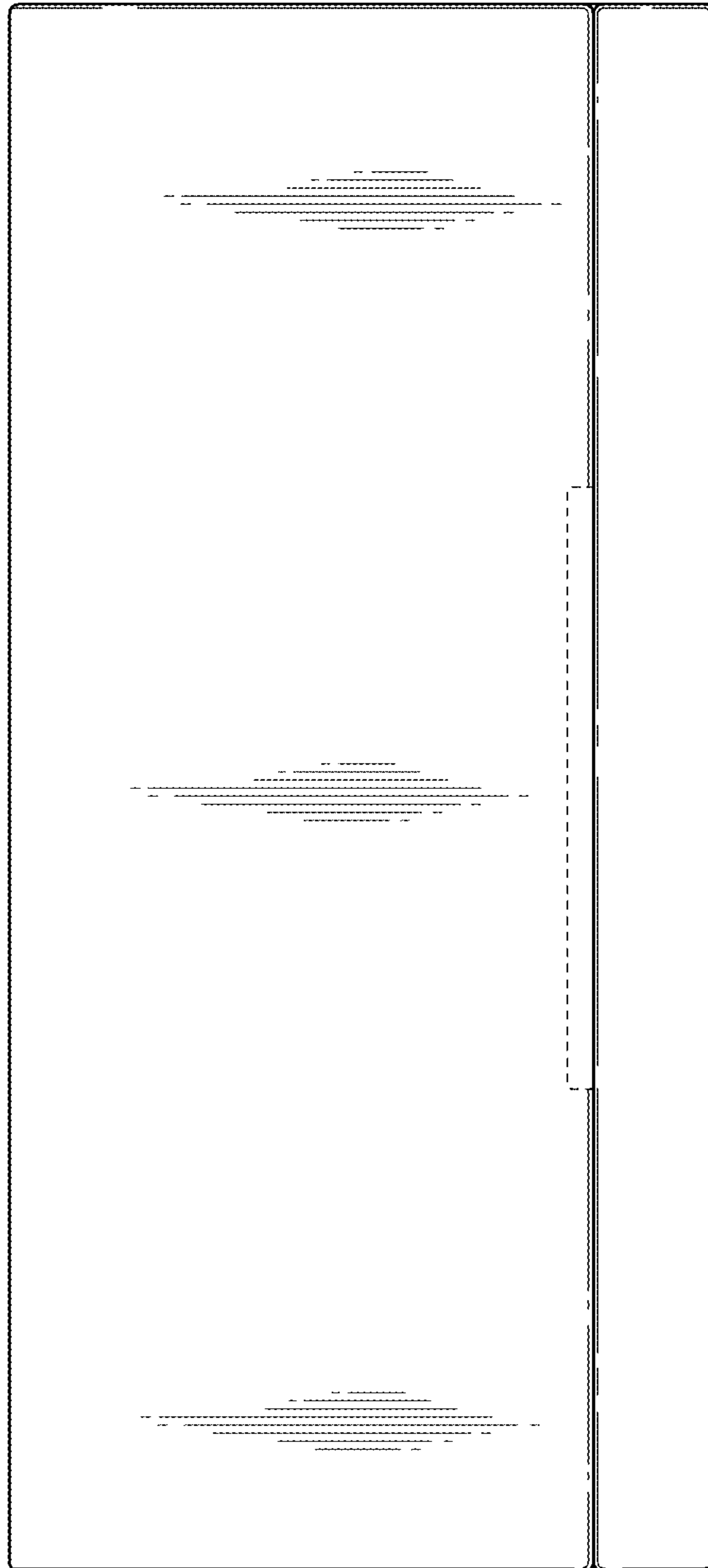

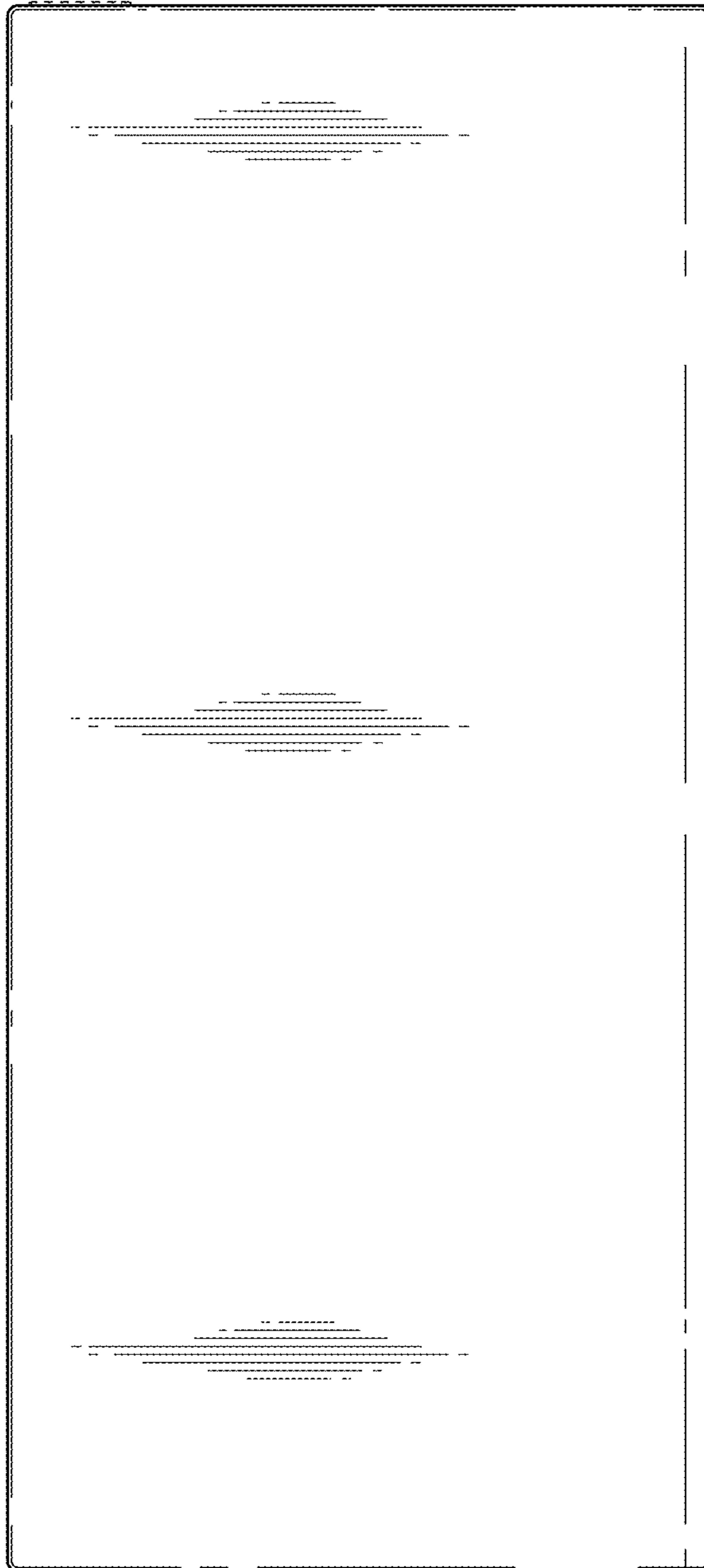

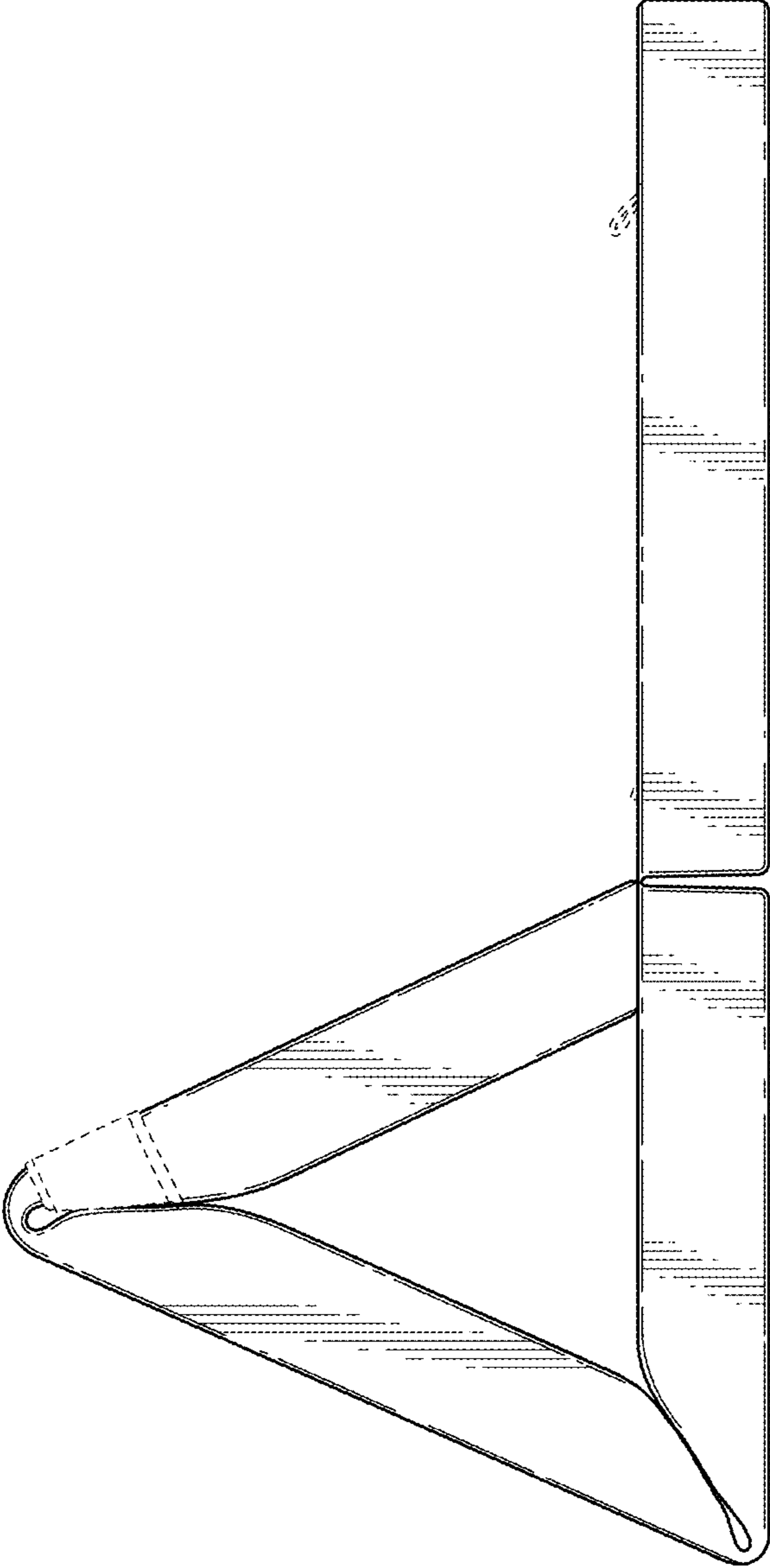

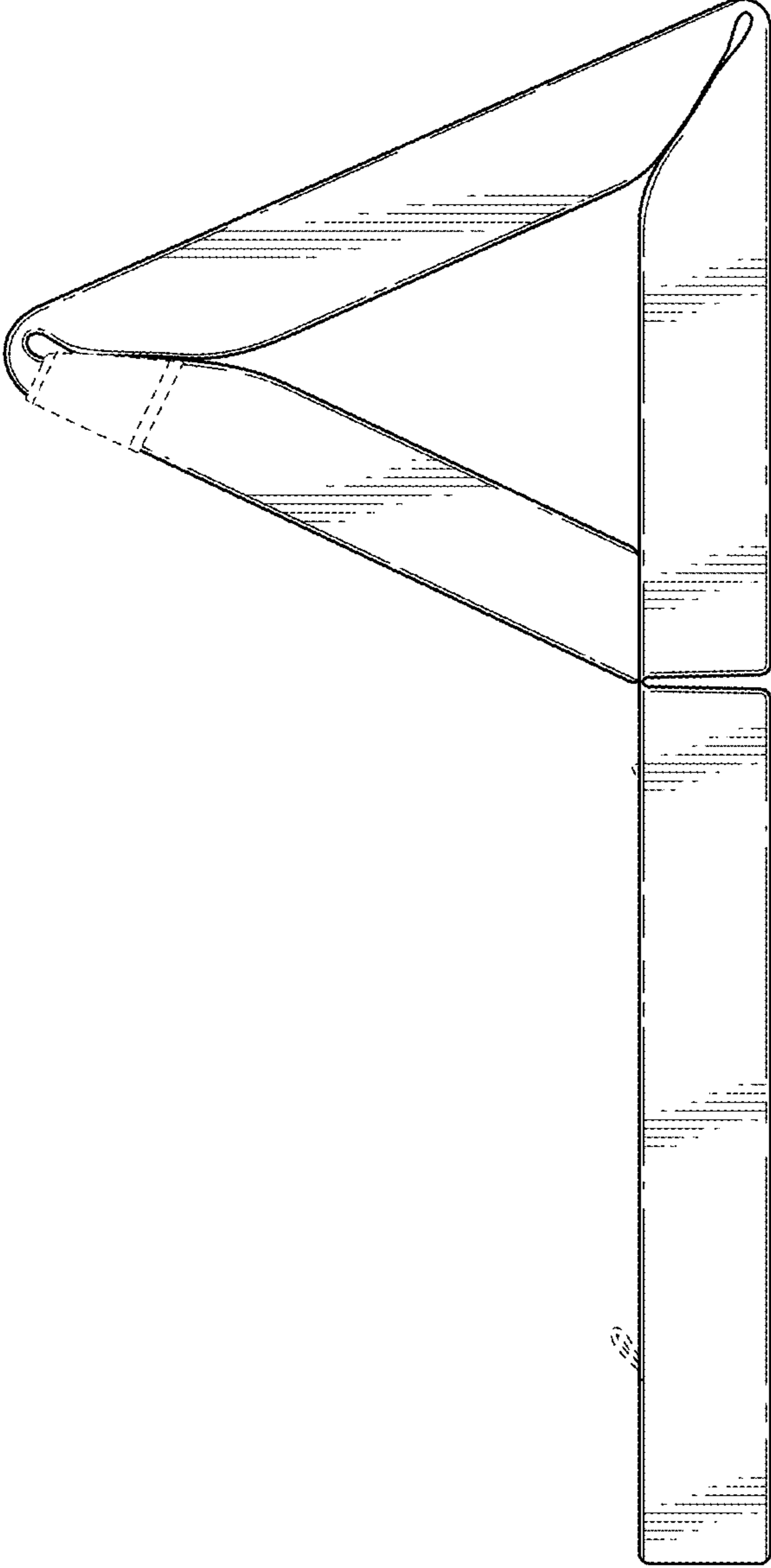

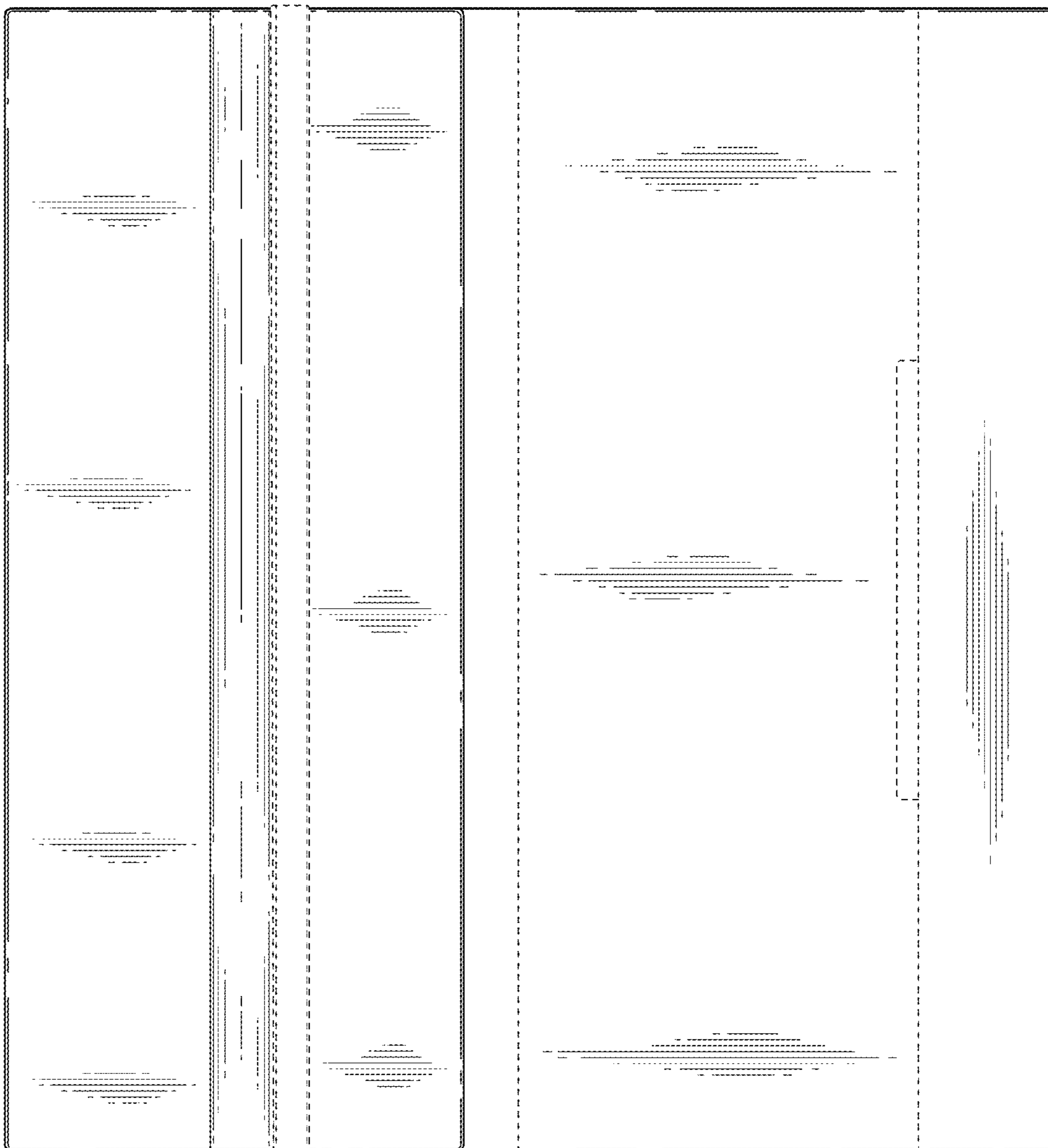

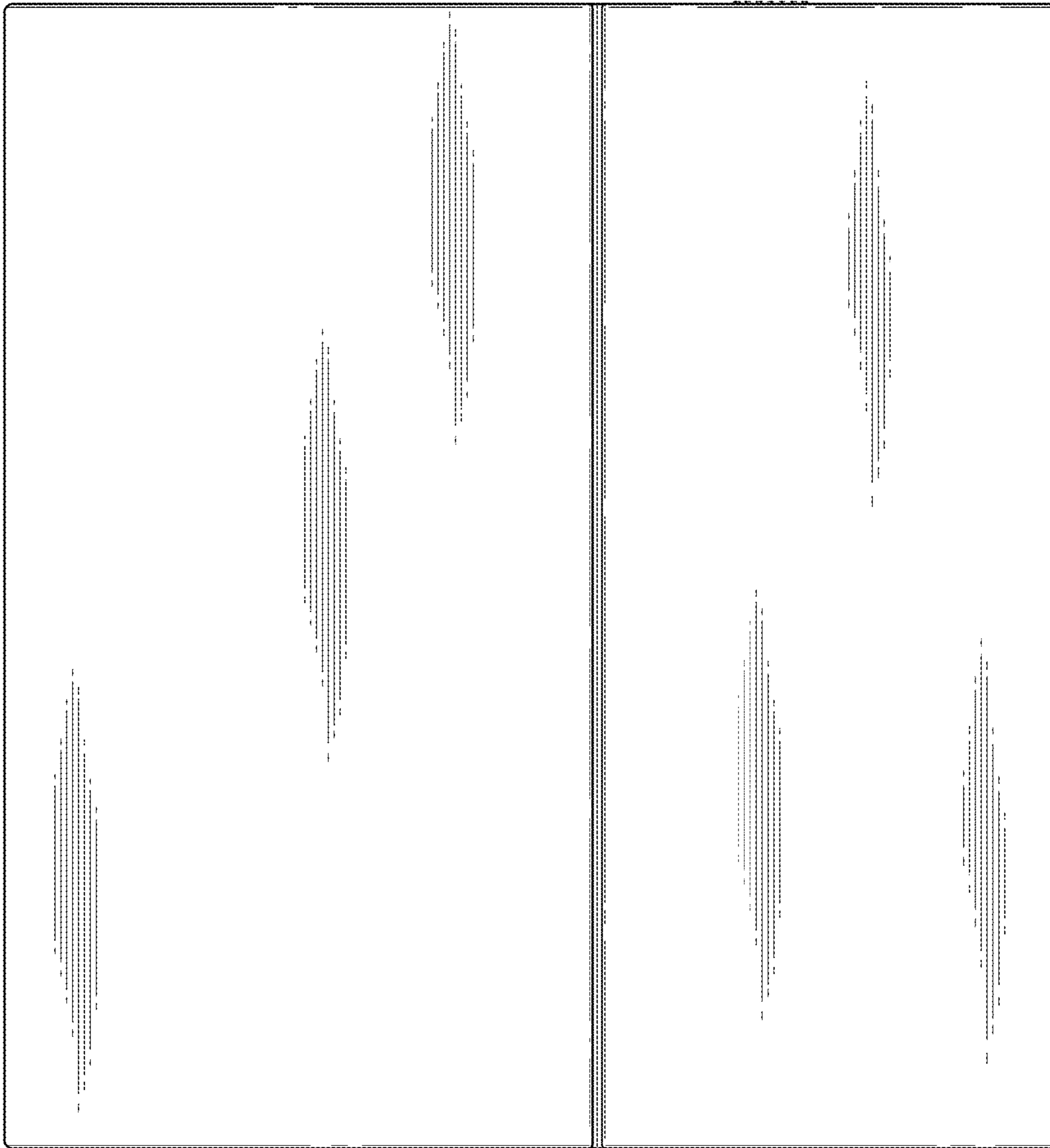

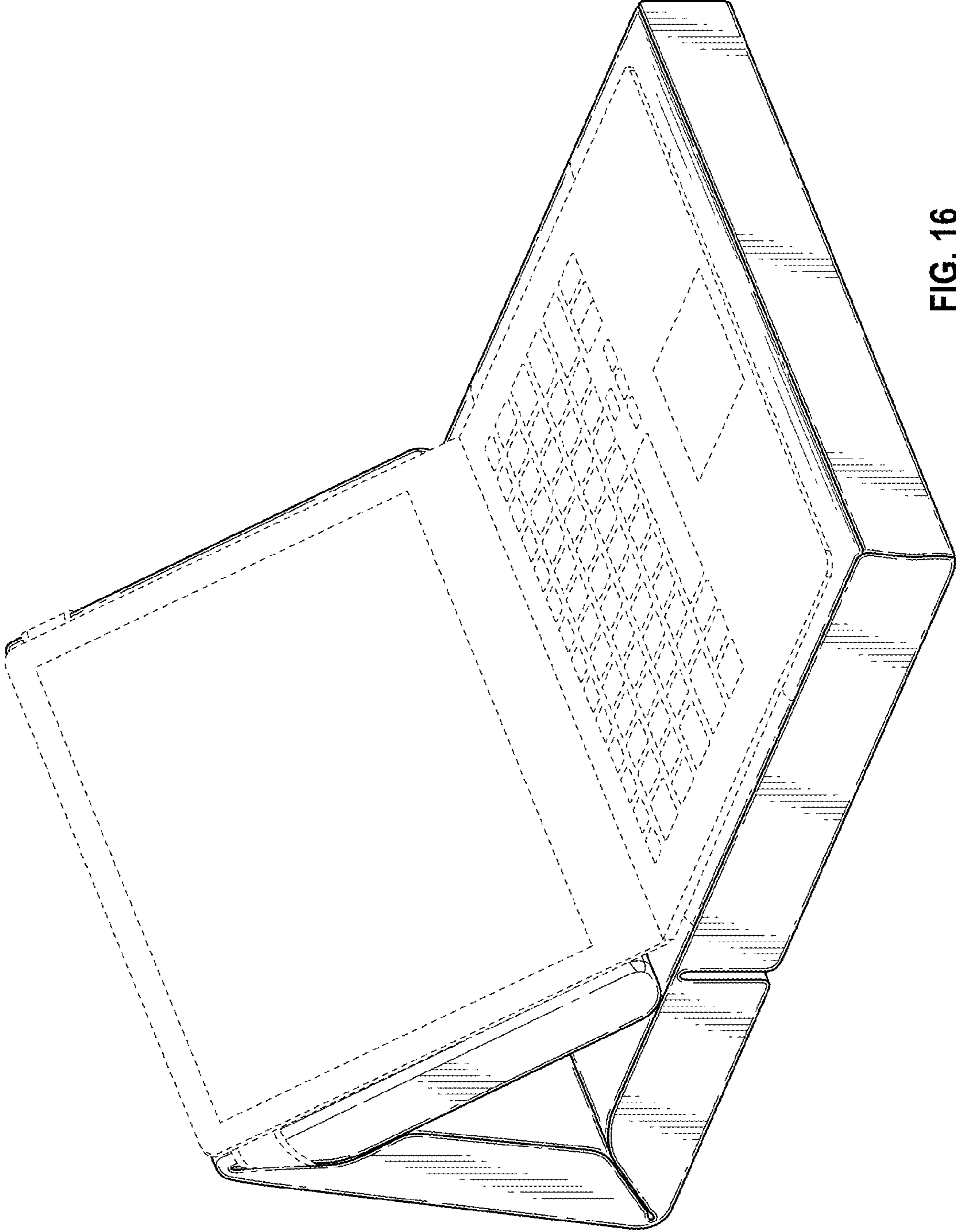
