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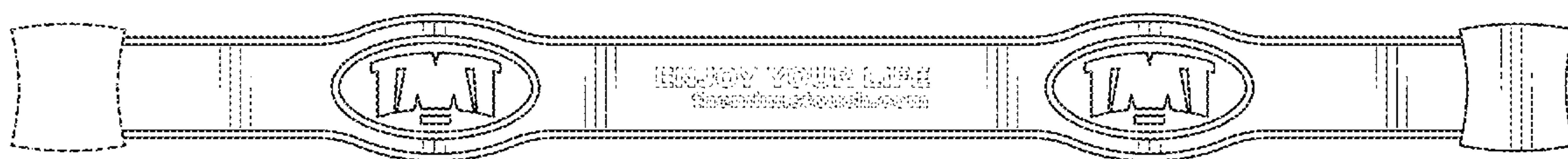
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a reversible energy bracelet showing the present invention in an unclapsed state; and, FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view of the reversible energy bracelet of FIG. 1 shown in a clapsed state. The broken lines shown in FIG. 1 illustrate portions of the reversible energy bracelet which form no part of the claimed design. The text shown in broken lines represent surface indicia which form no part of the claimed design.

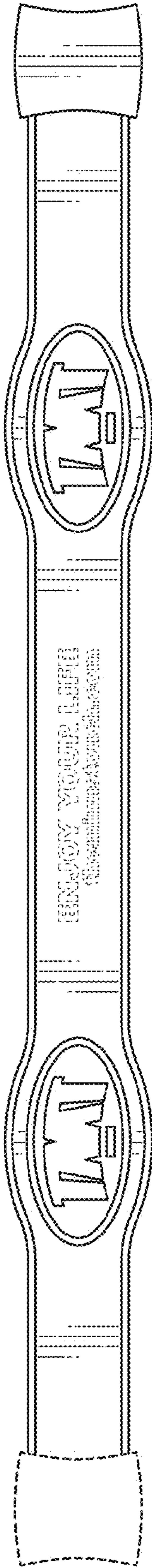

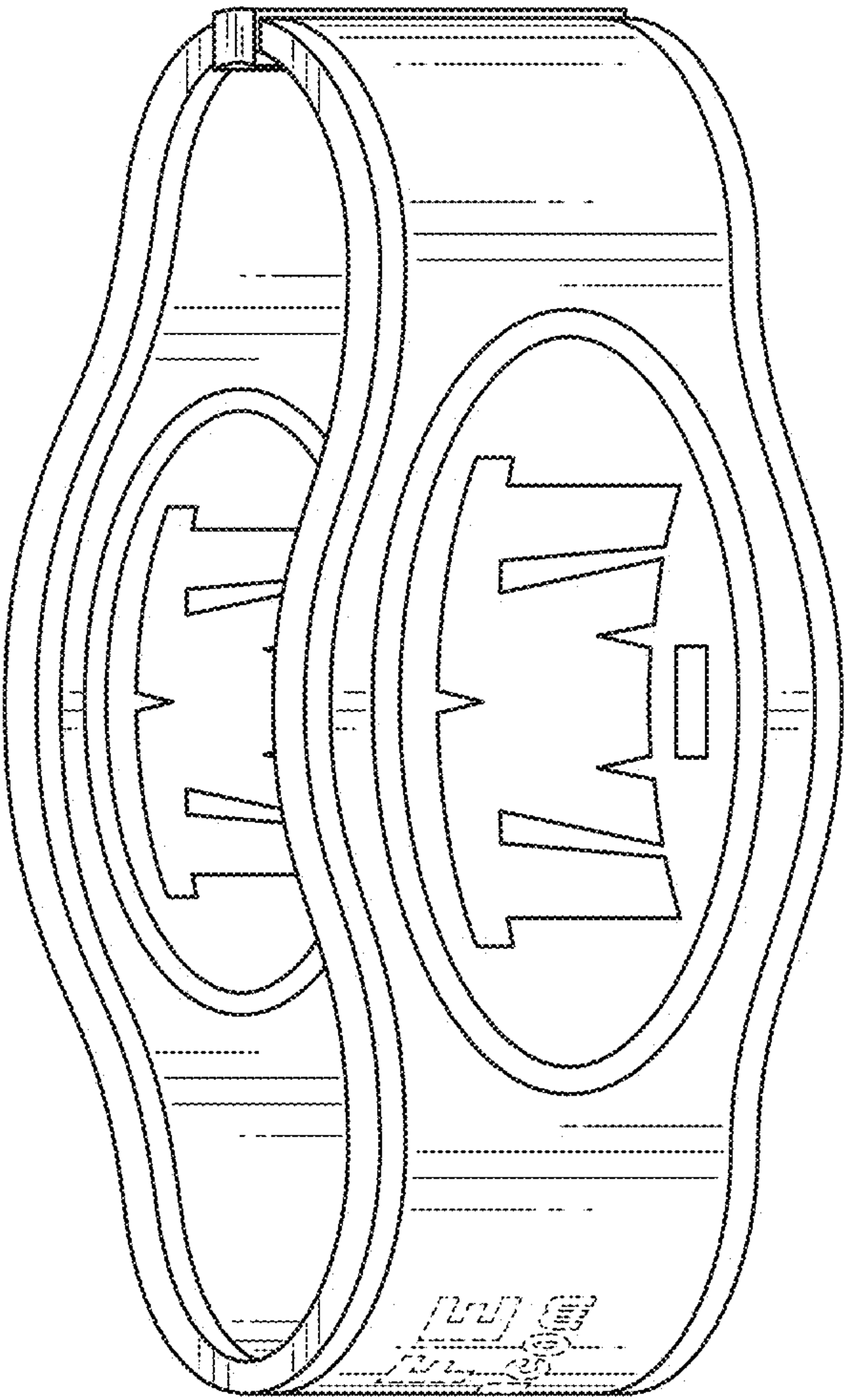
