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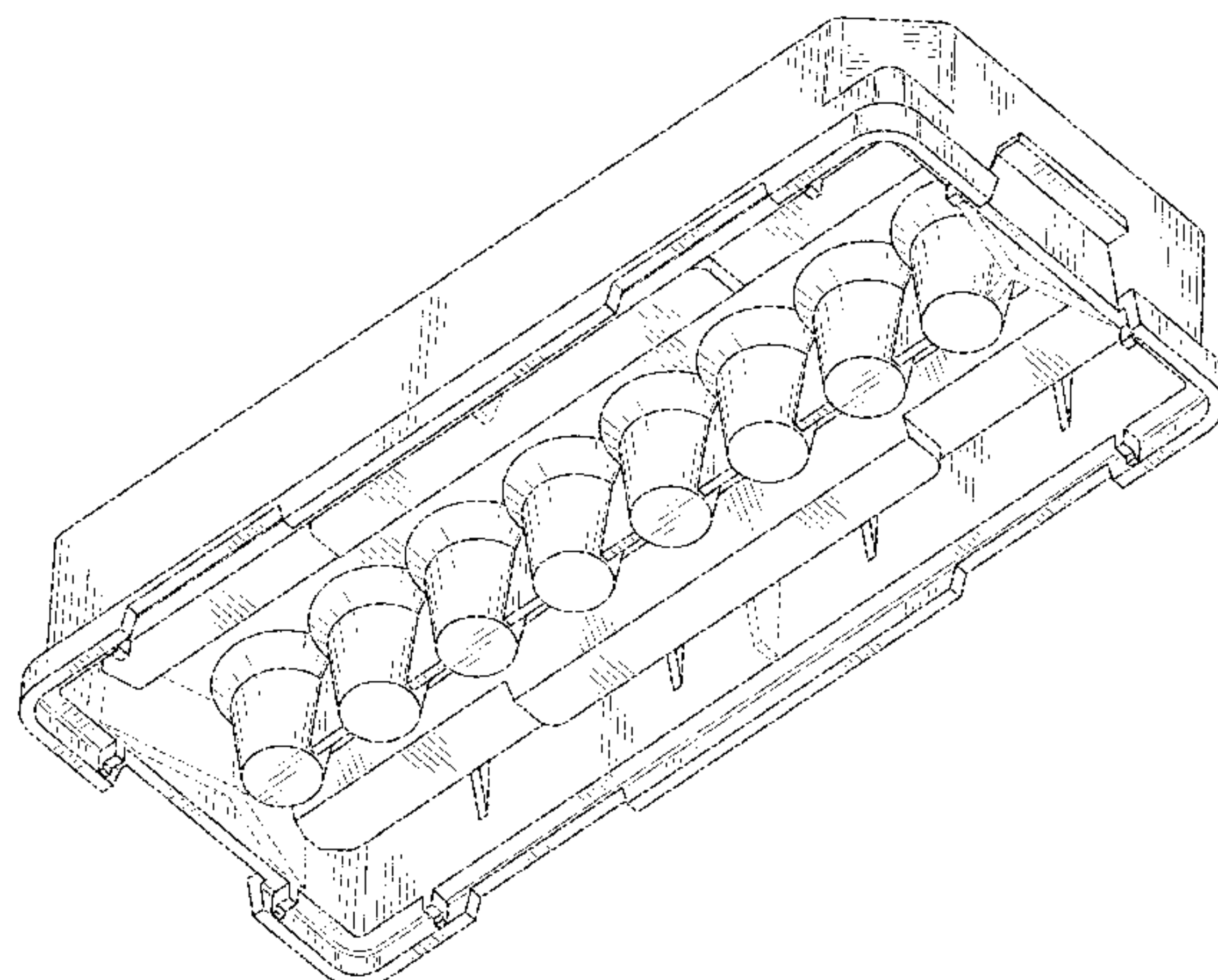
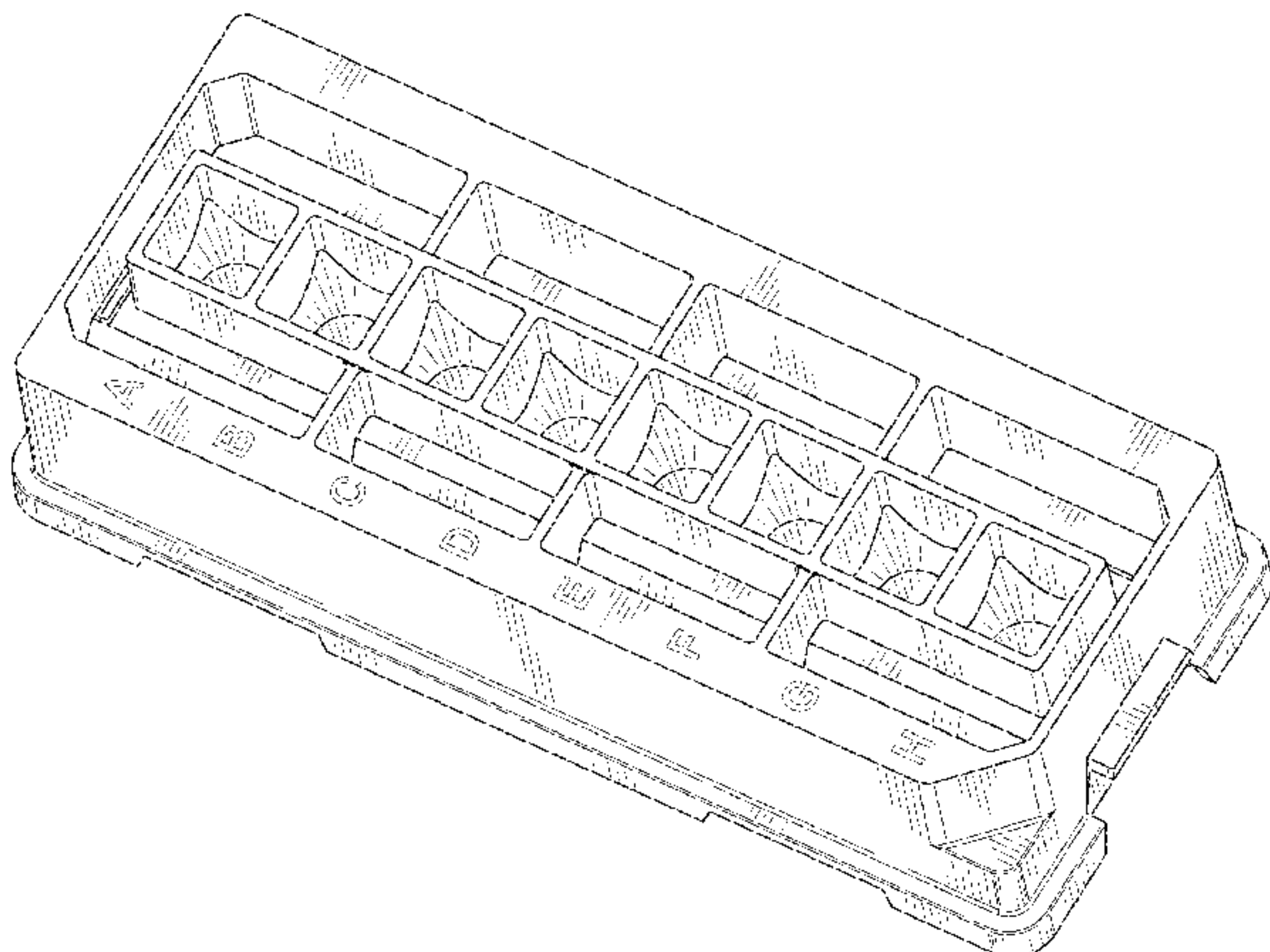

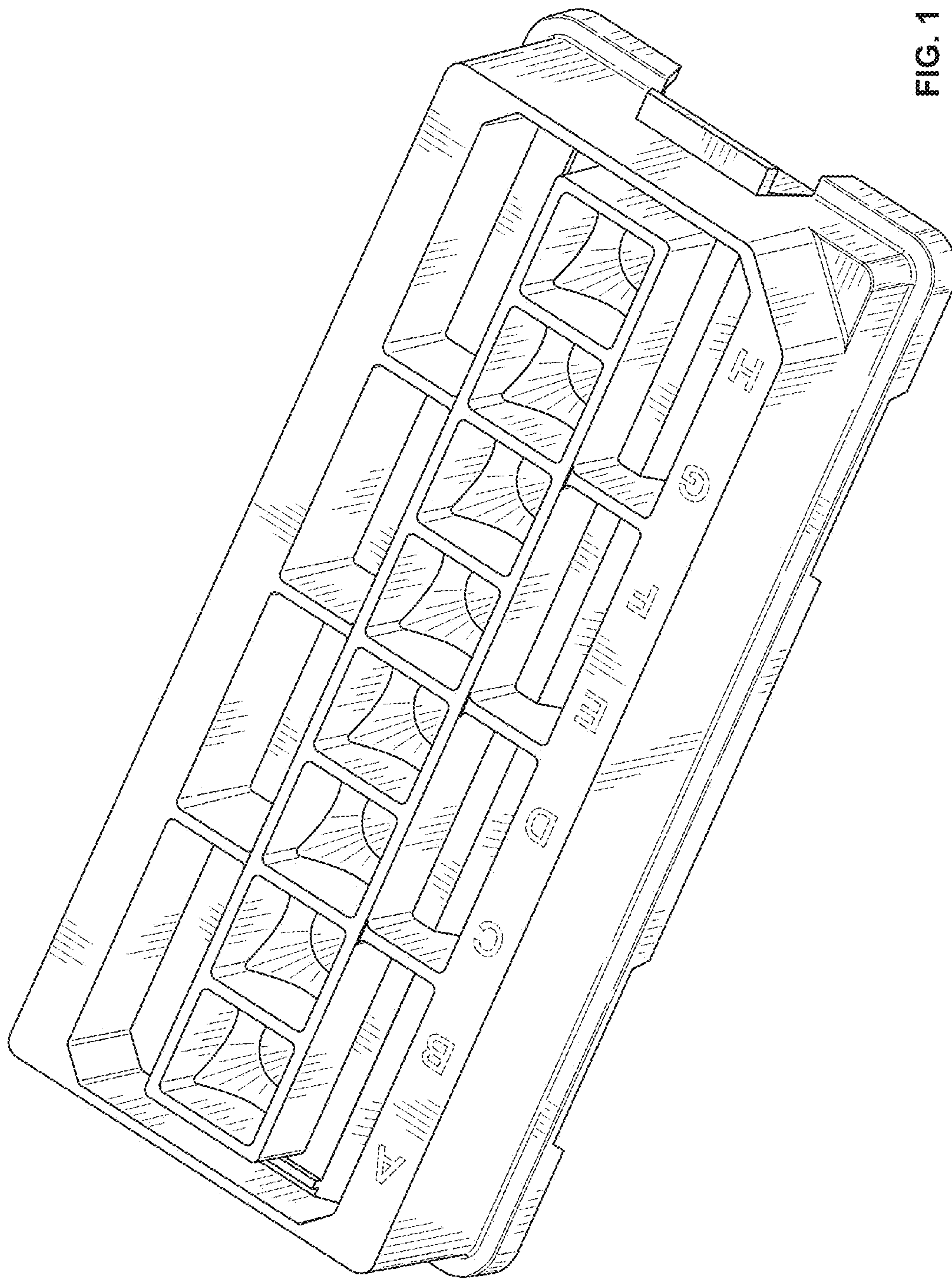
The ornamental design for a microplate, as shown and described.

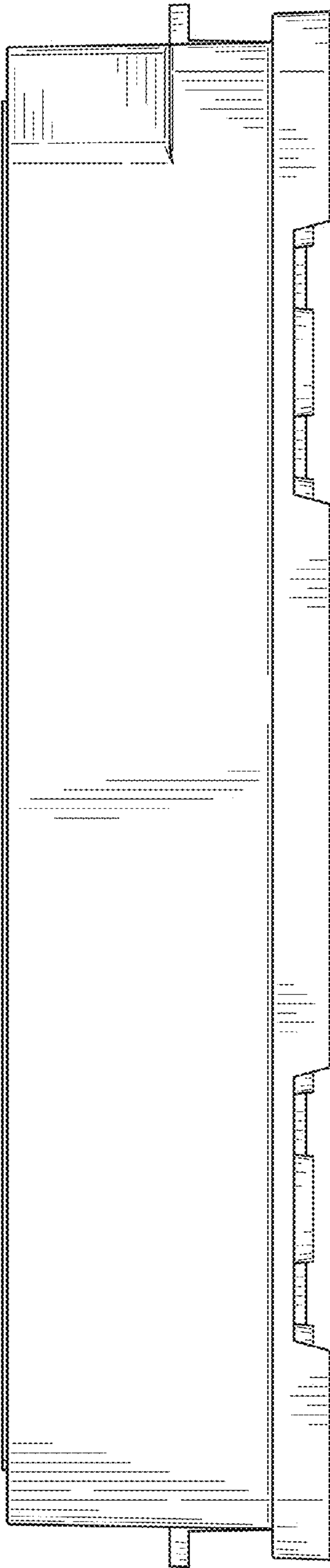

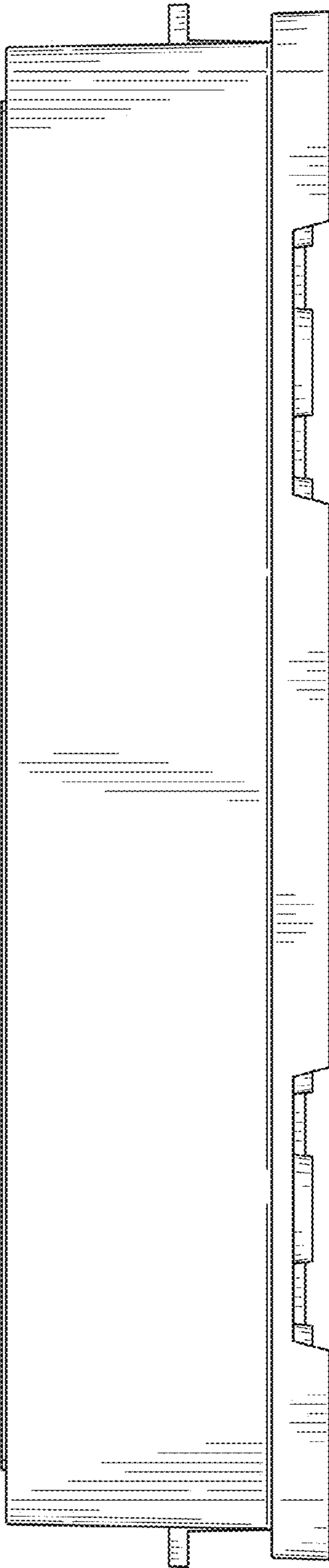

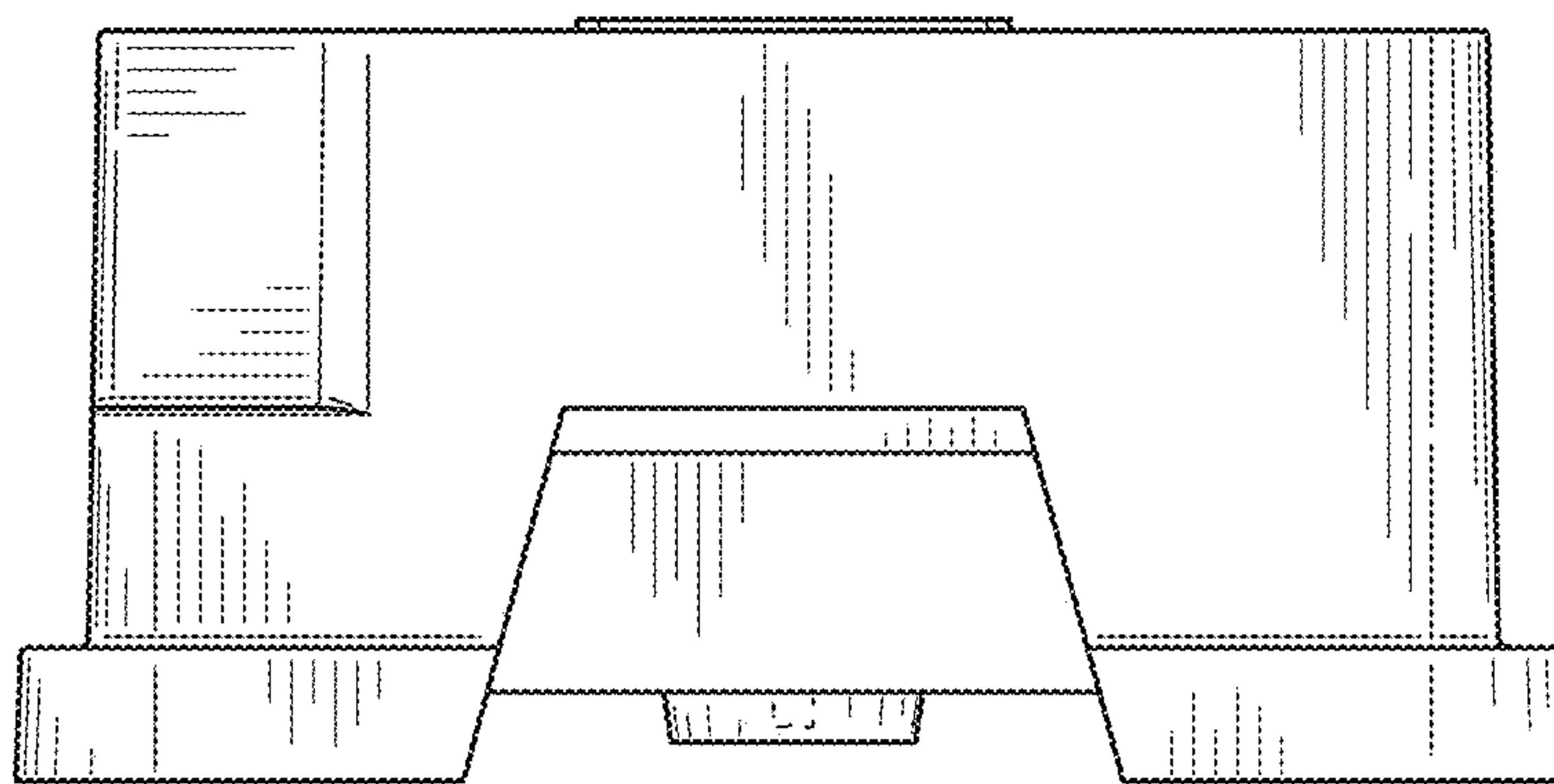

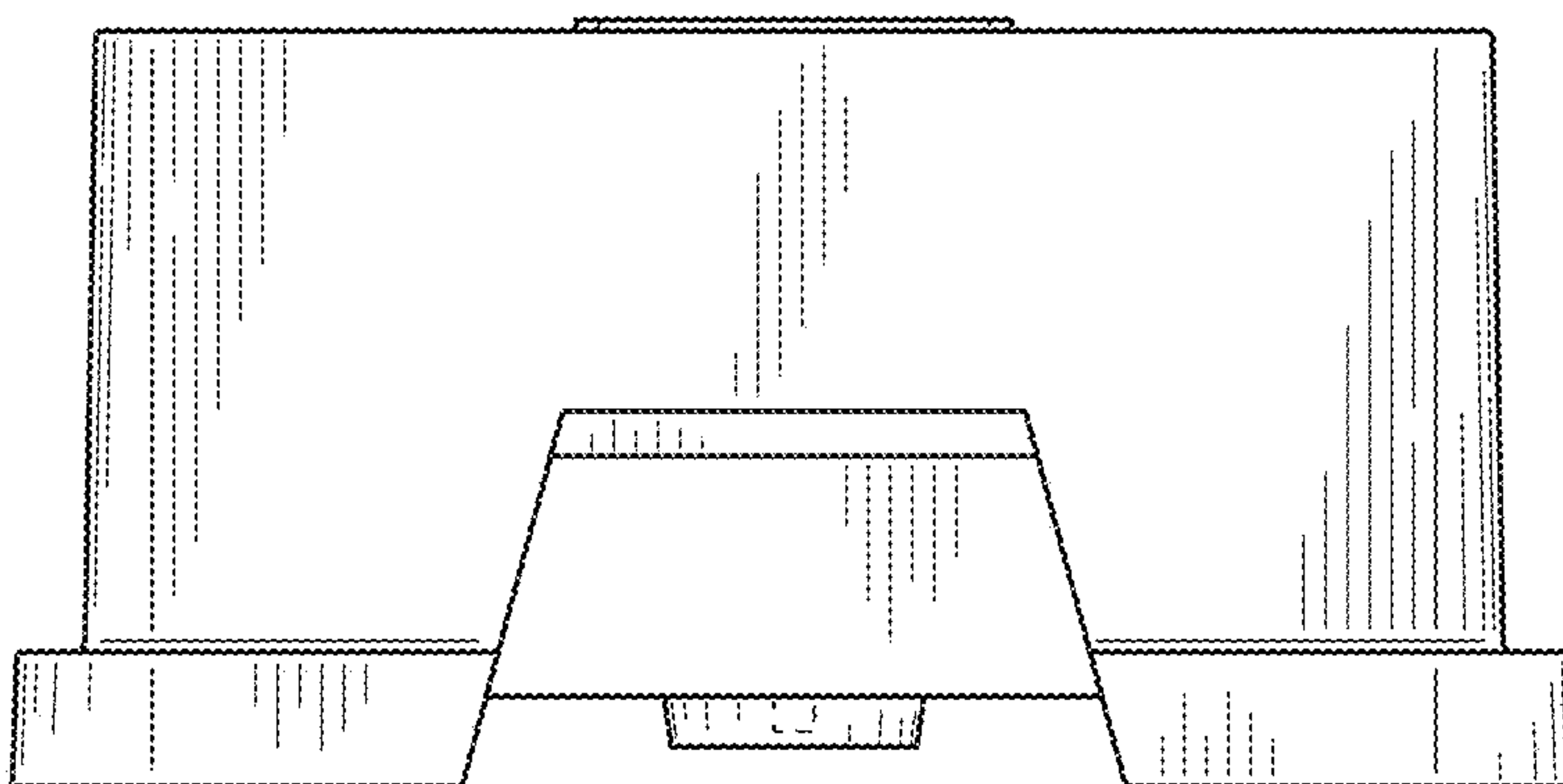

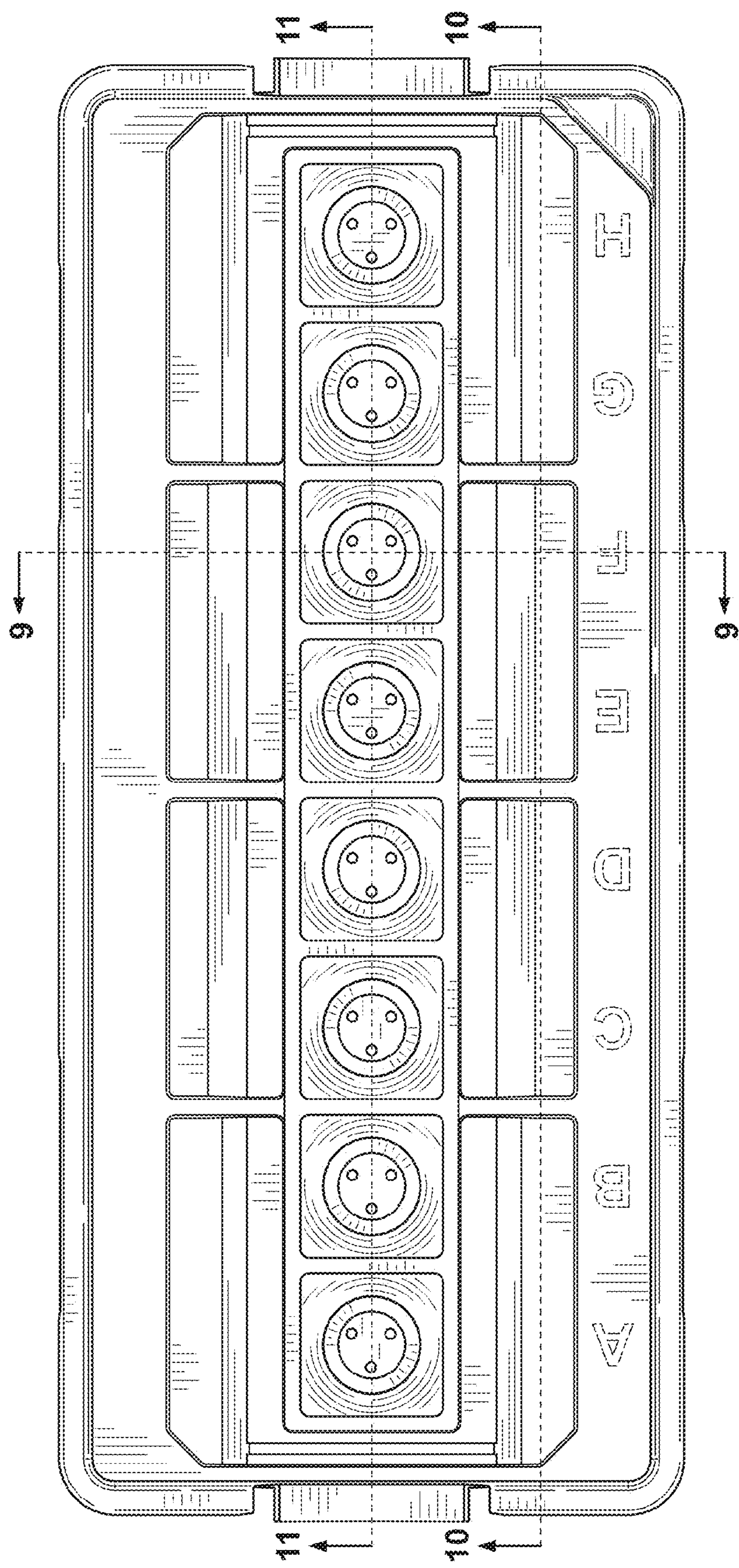

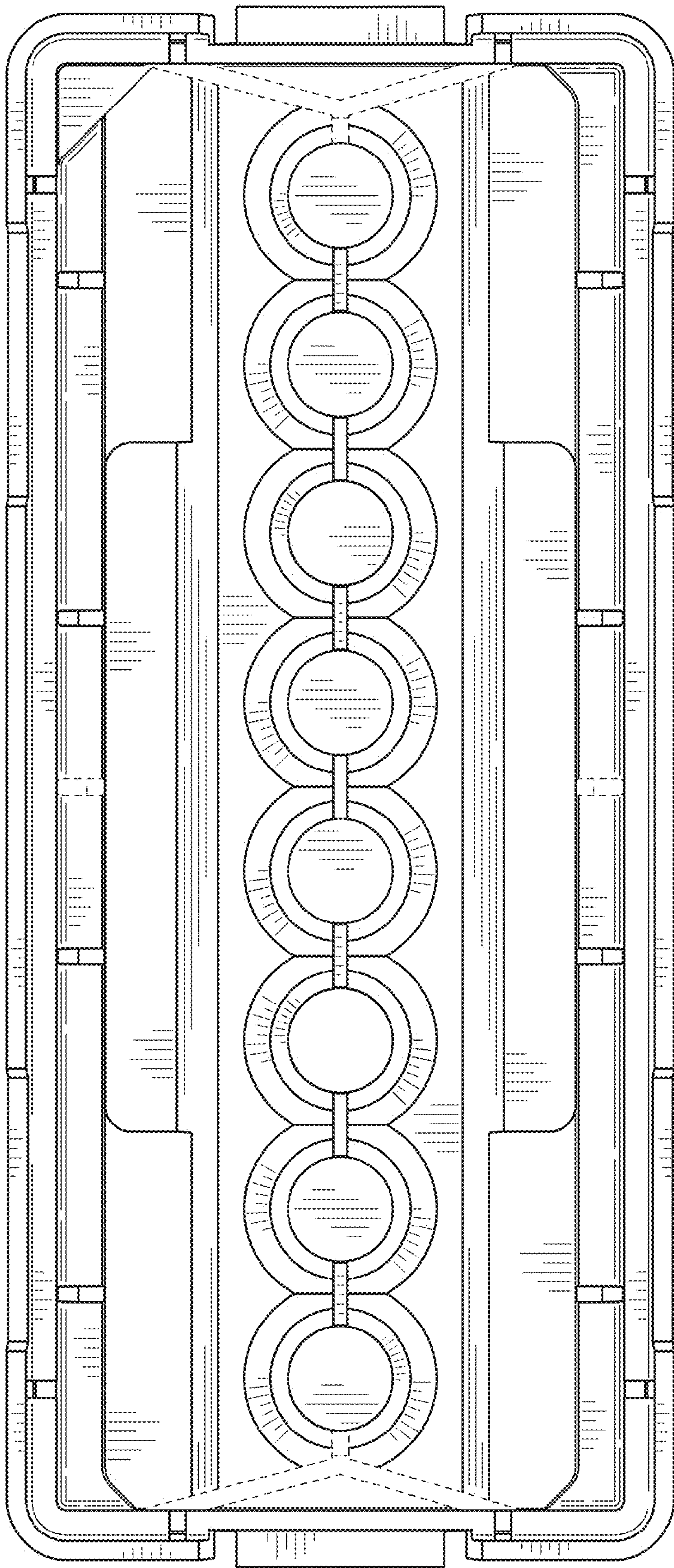

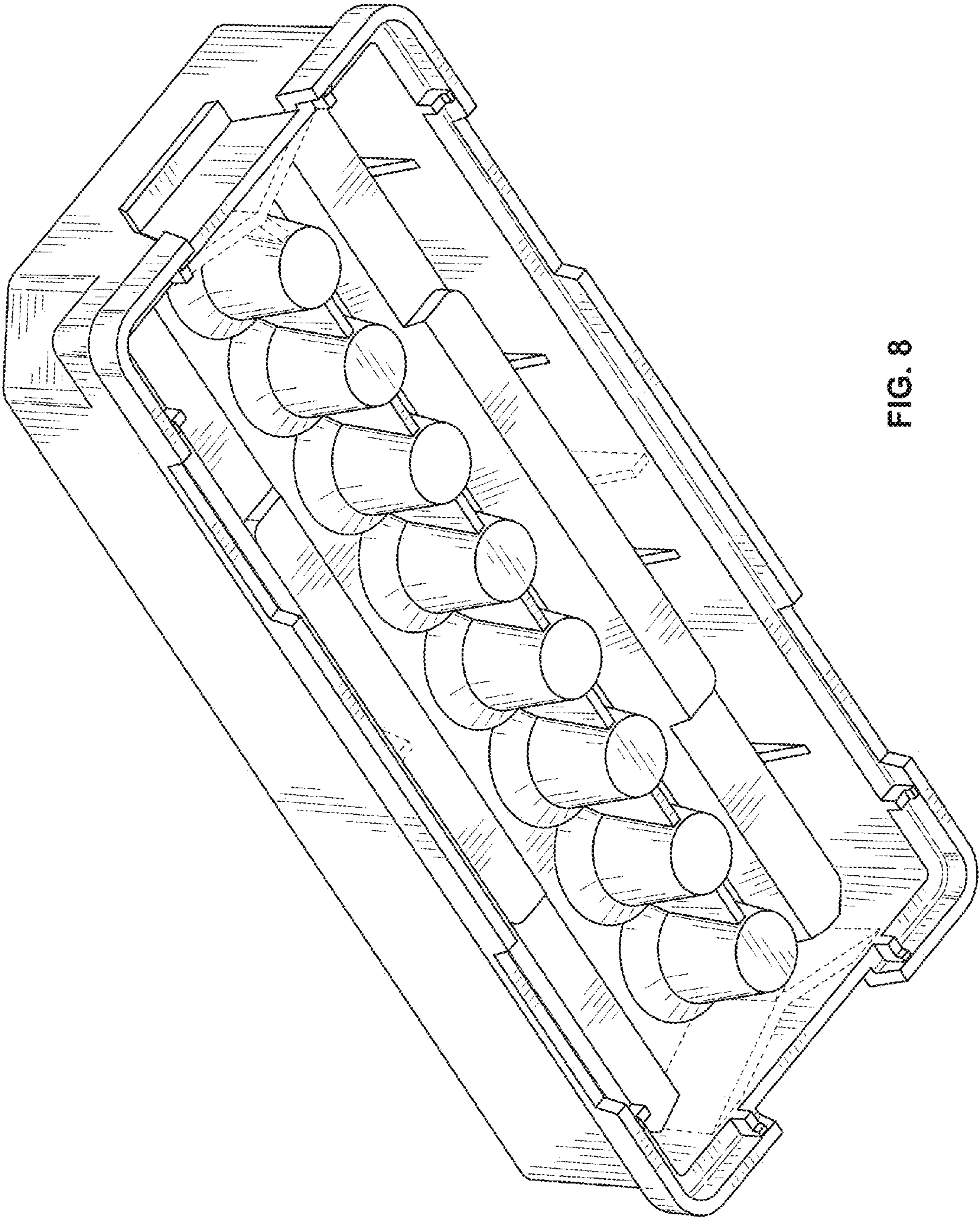

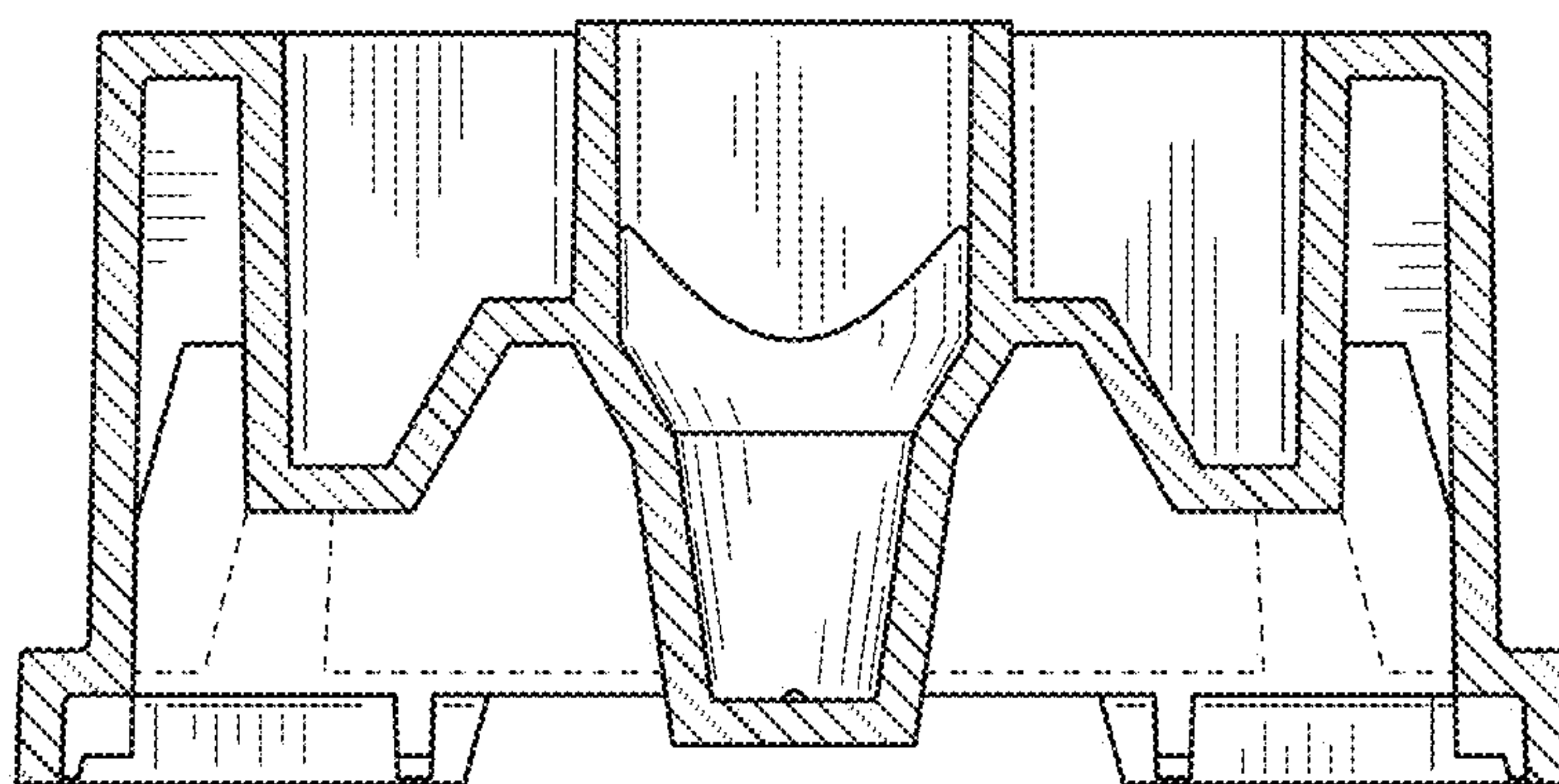

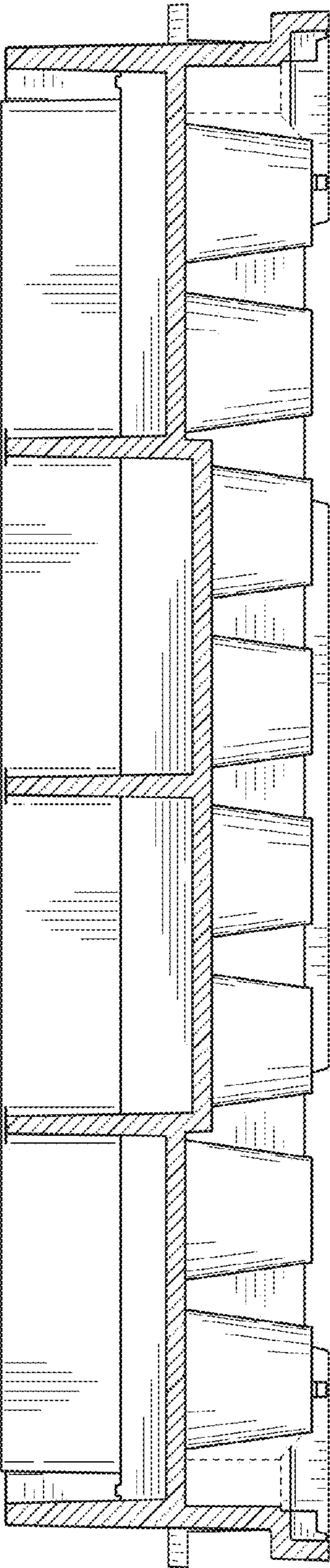

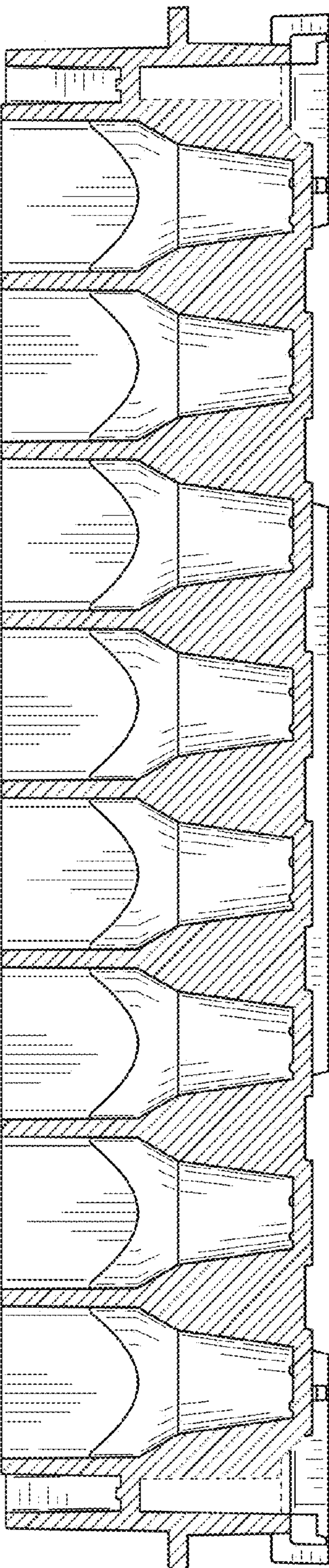
