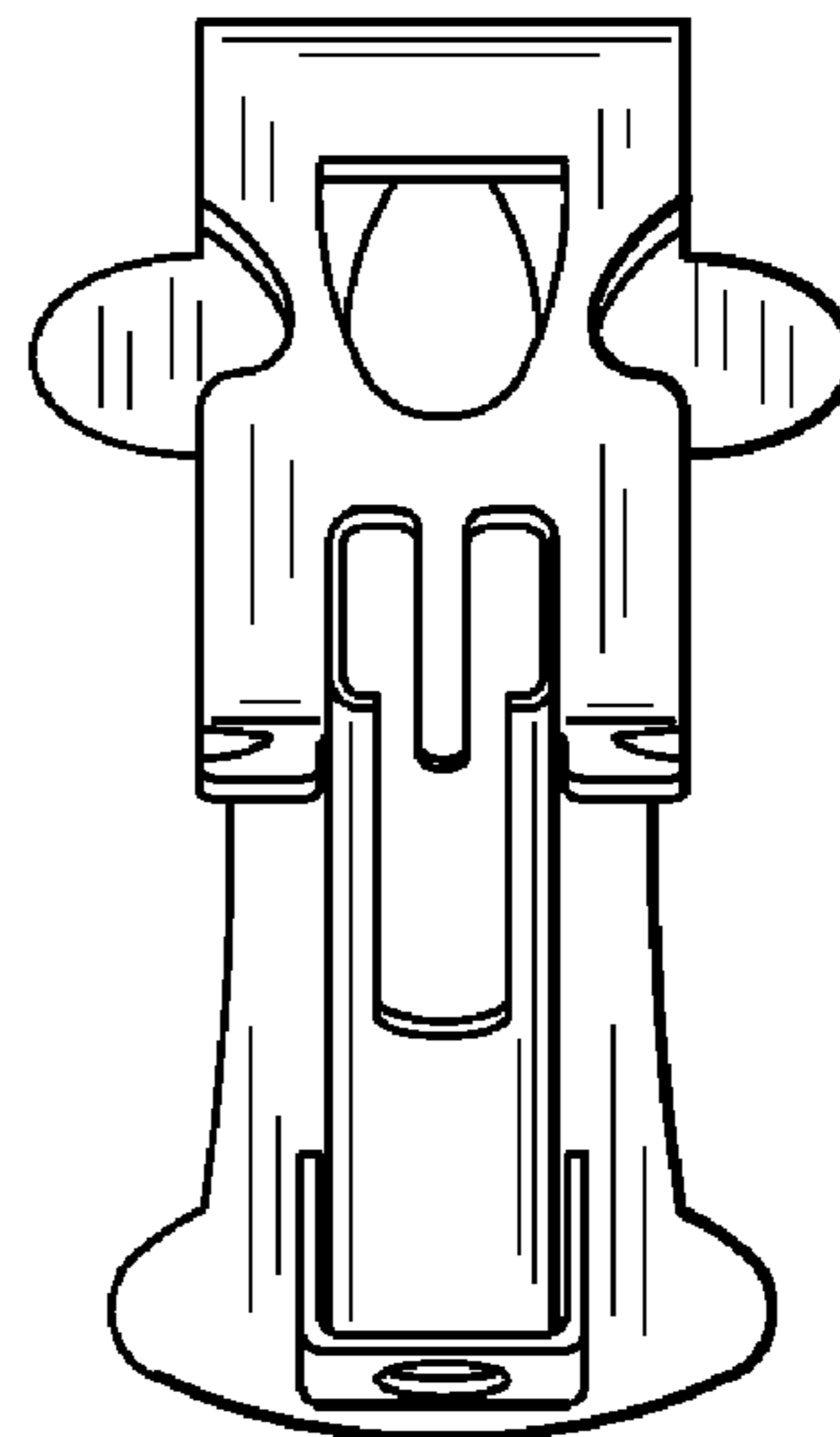
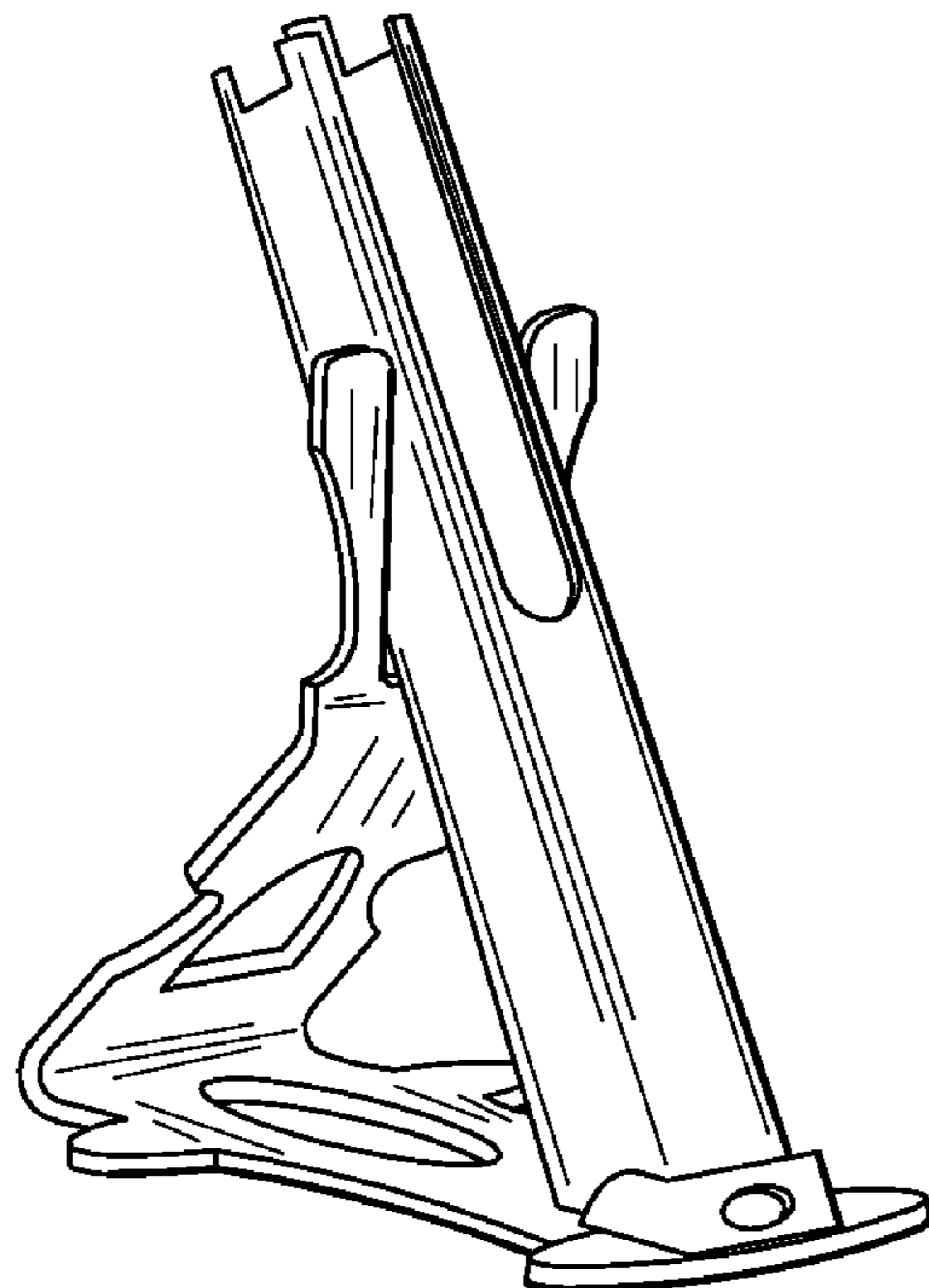
The ornamental design for a temporary instrument holder,

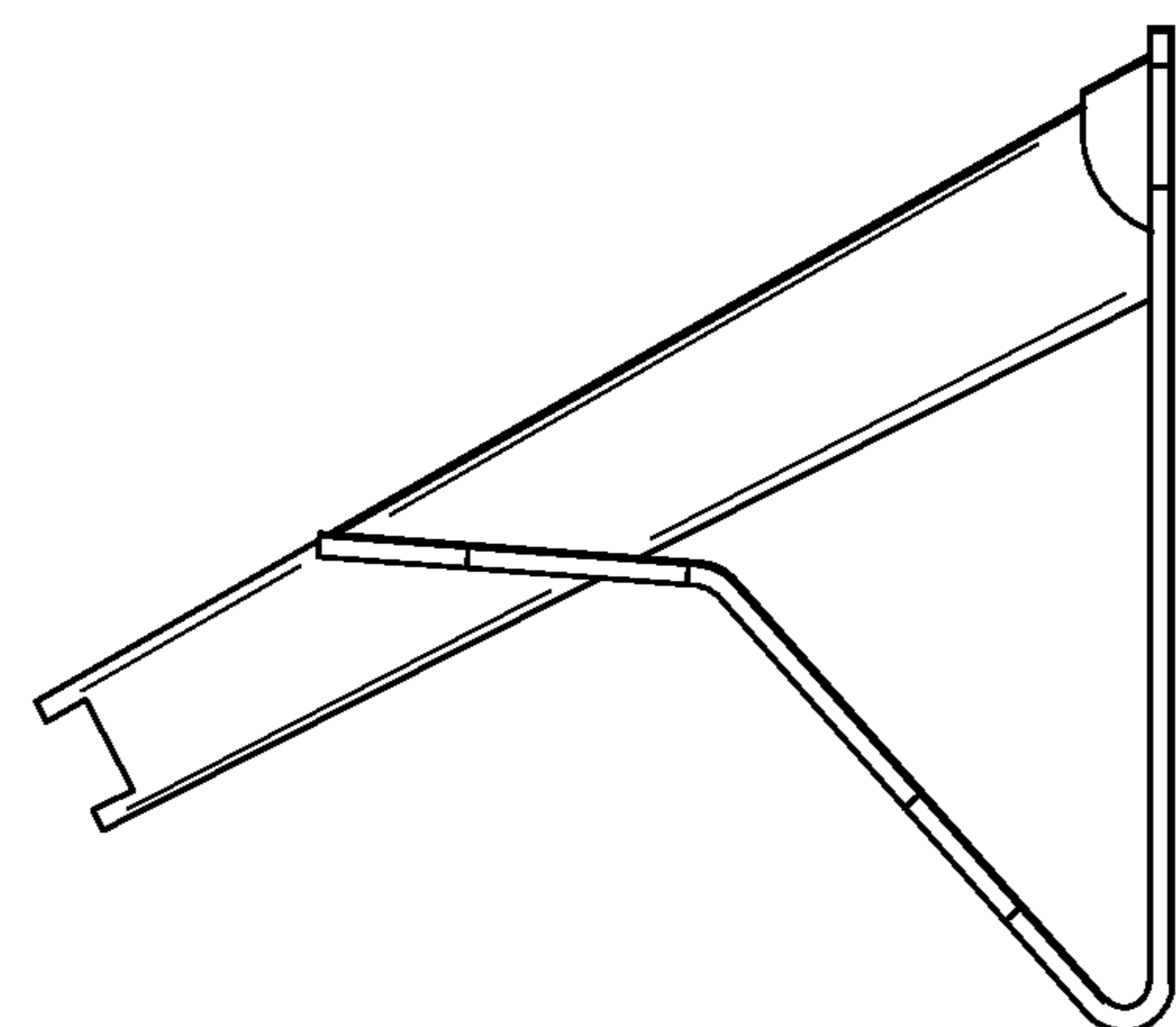

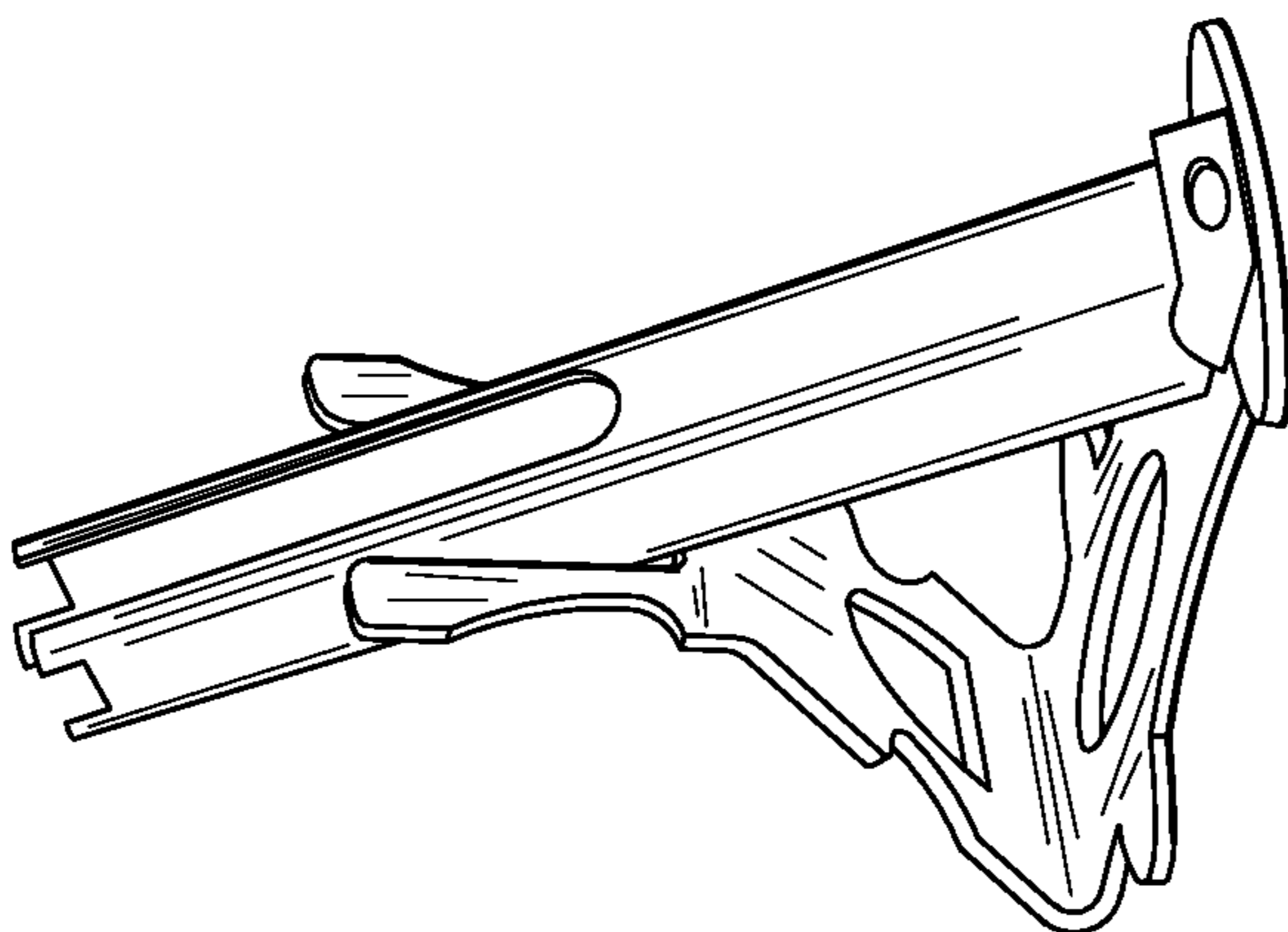

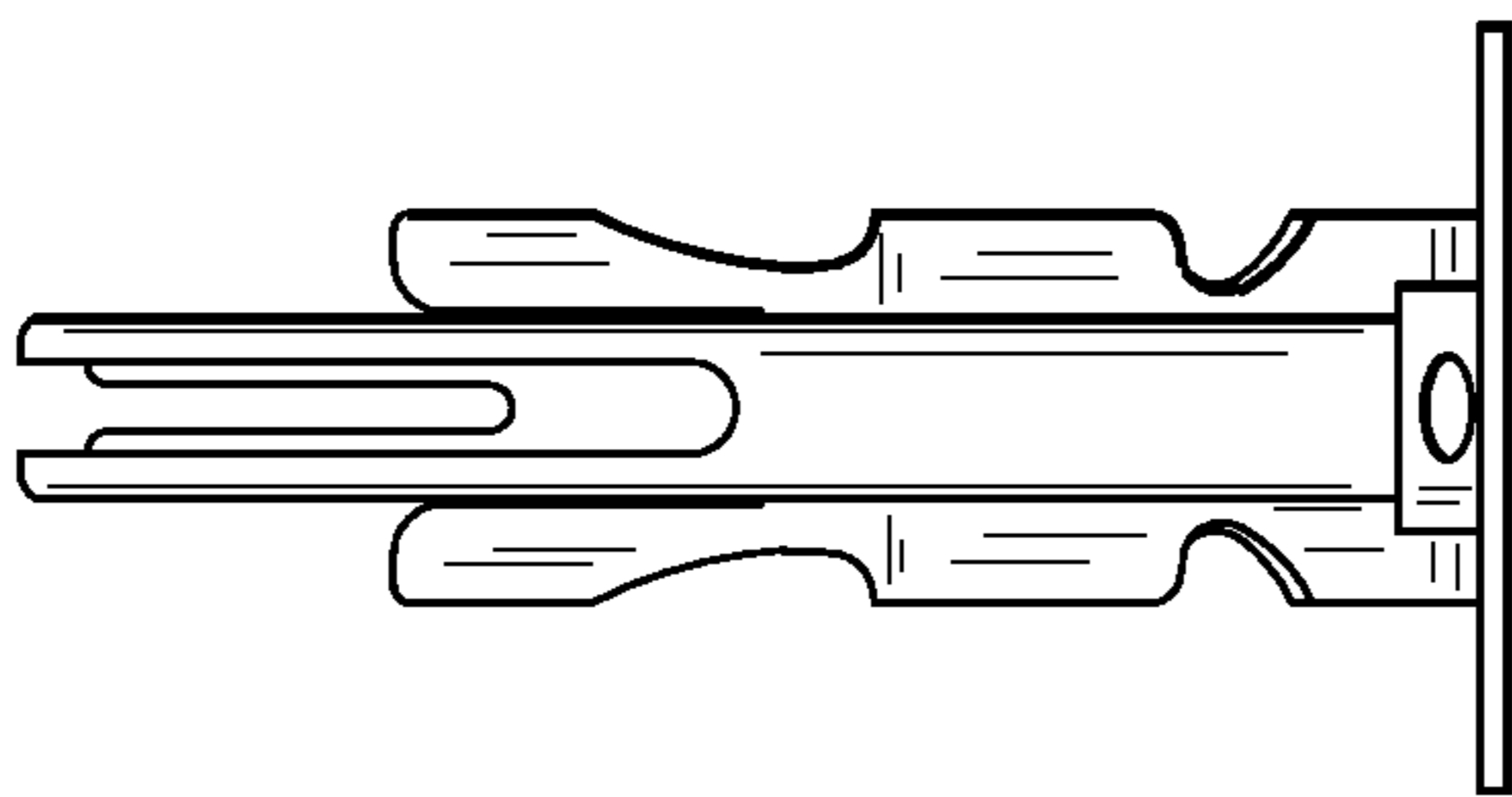

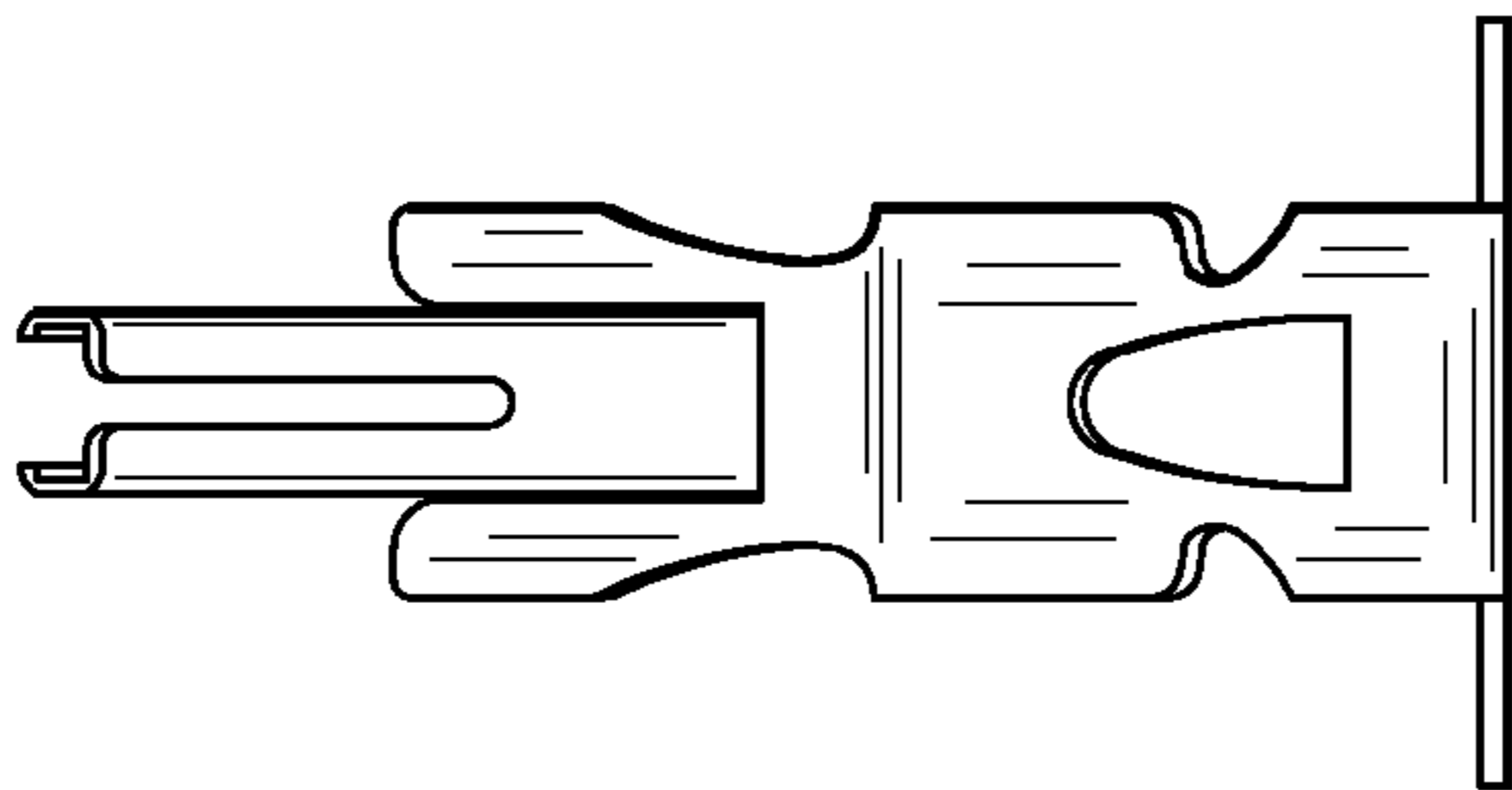

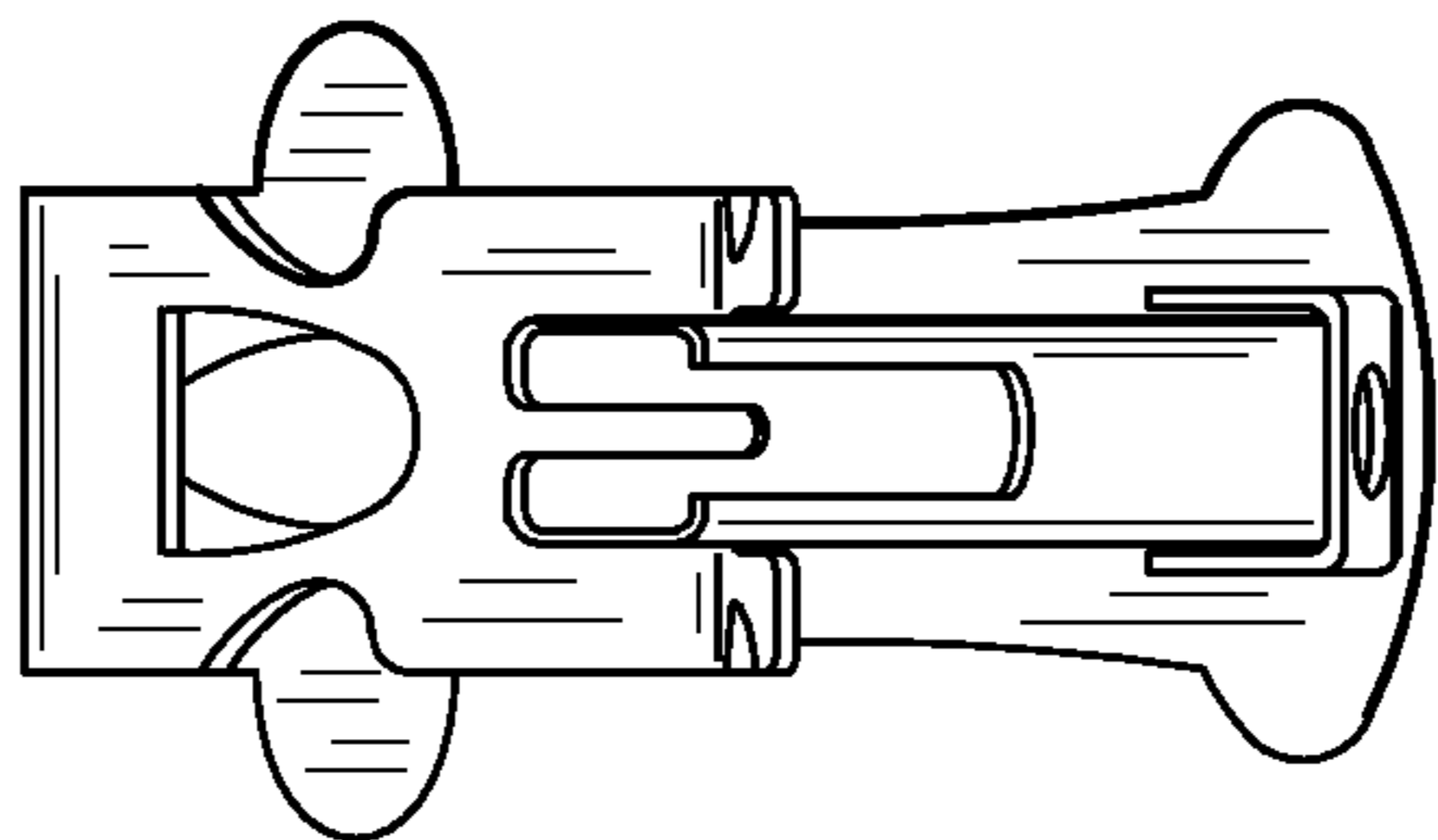

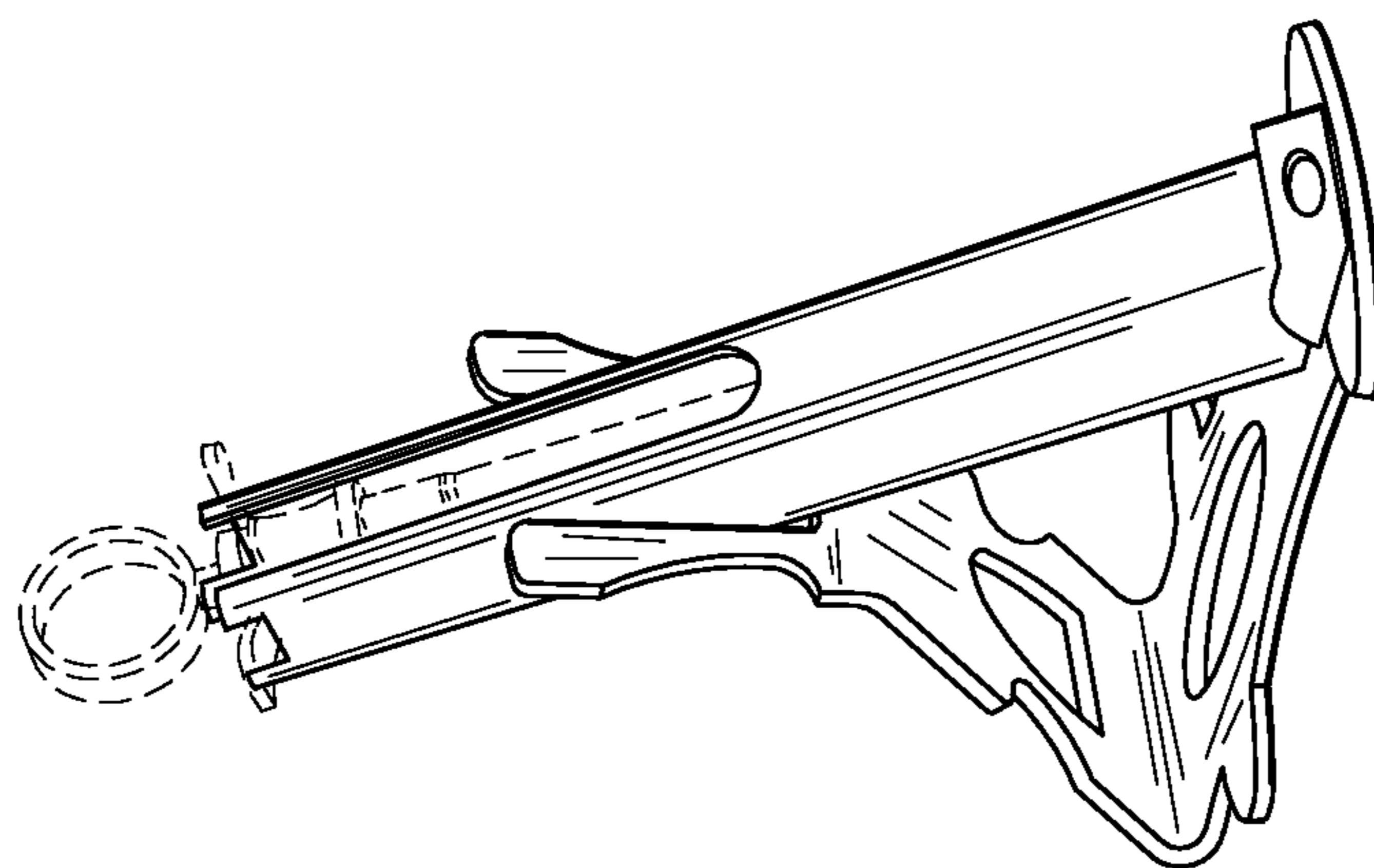

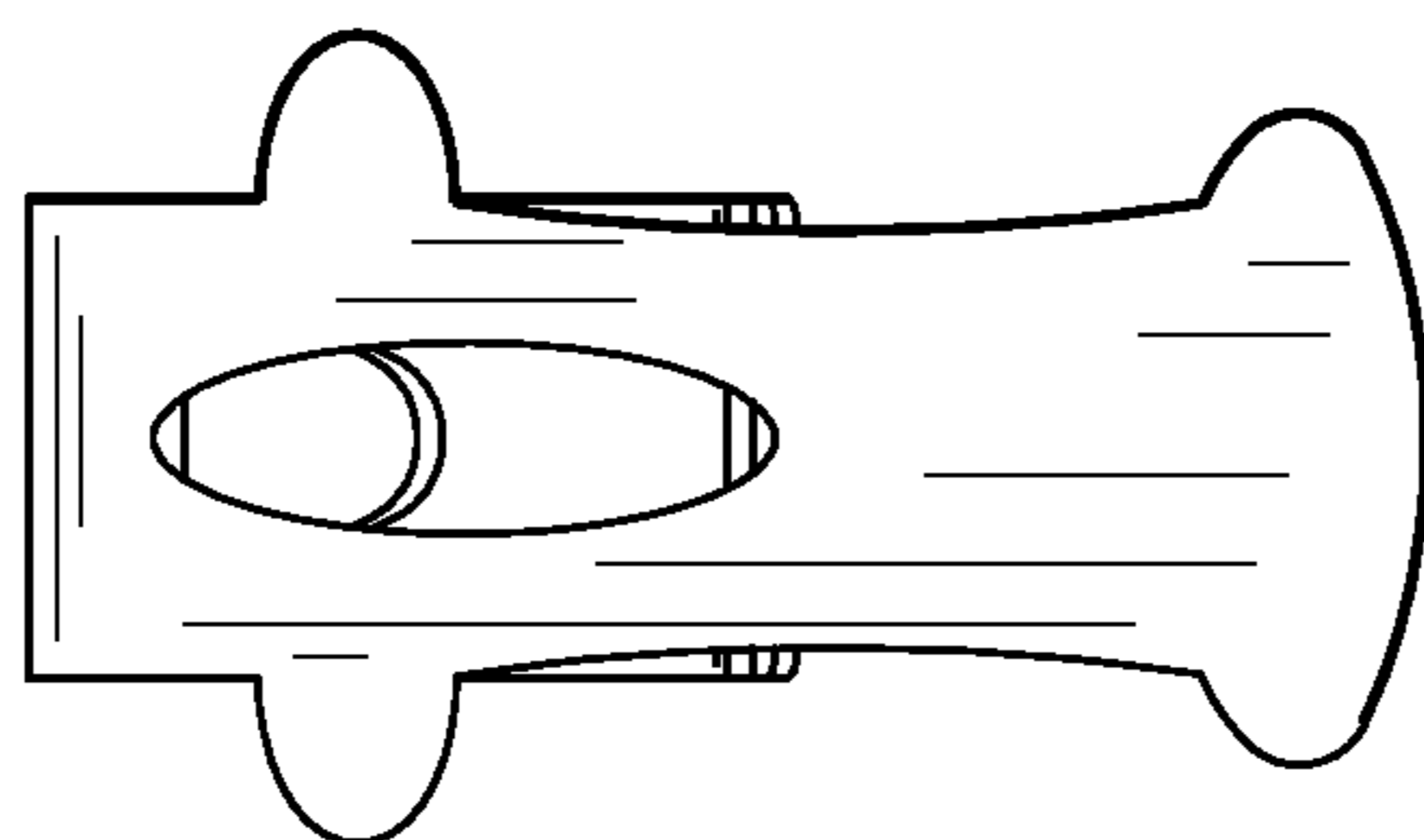
