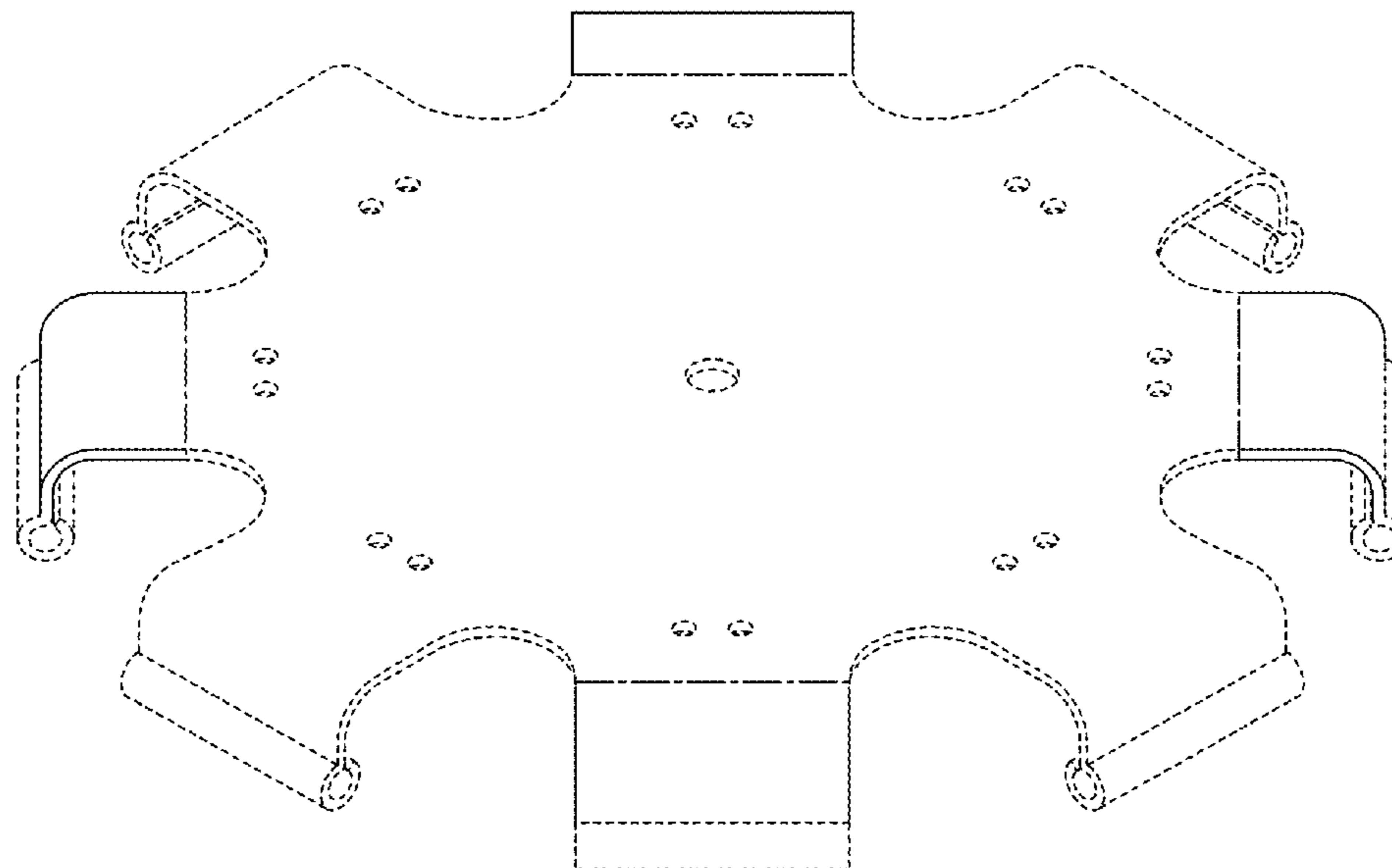
(57) **CLAIM**

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 shows a perspective view of a design for an umbrella cap;  
 FIG. 2 is a first side view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 shows a second side view of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 4 is a top view thereof; and,  
 FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof in use in an umbrella.

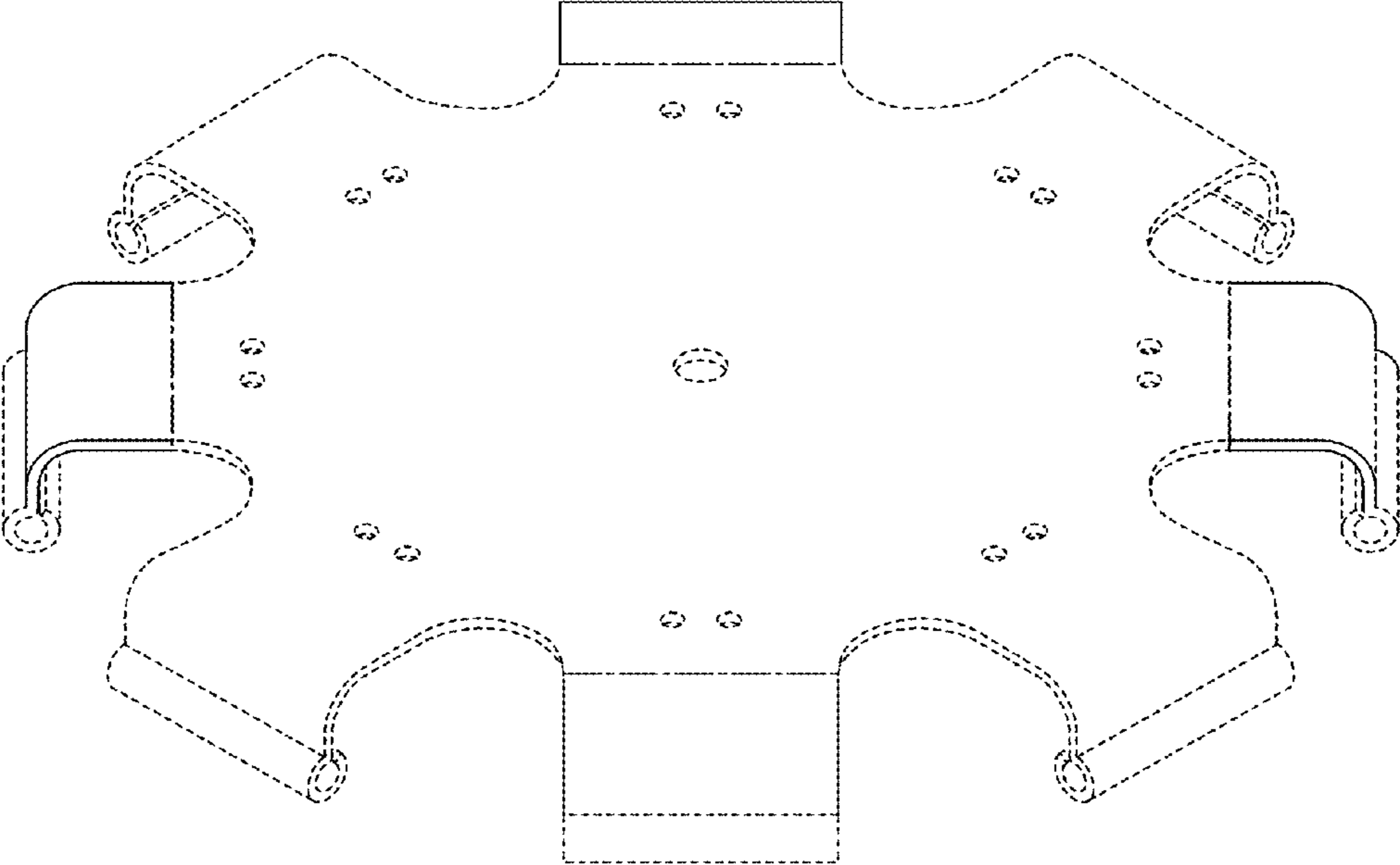

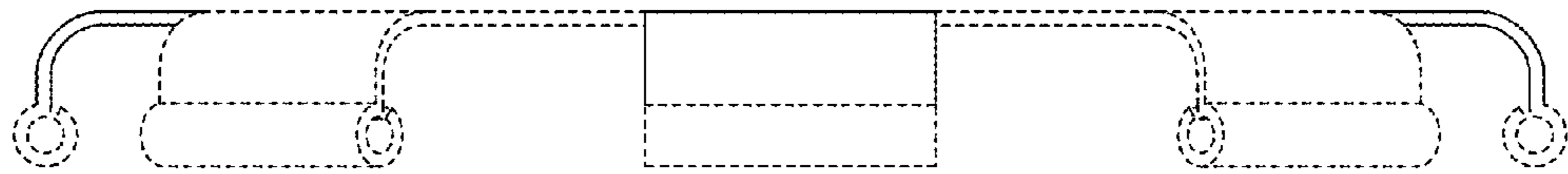

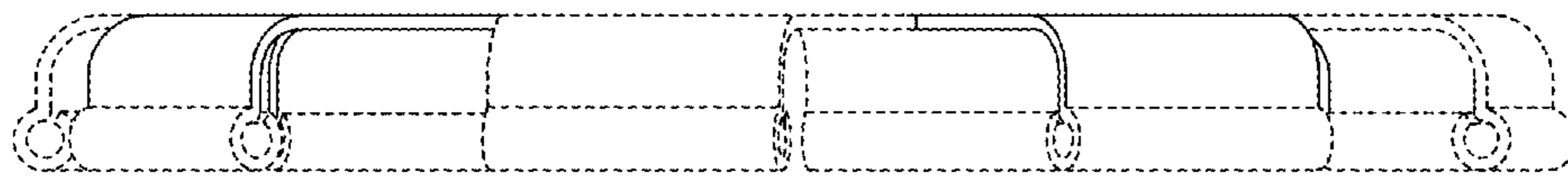

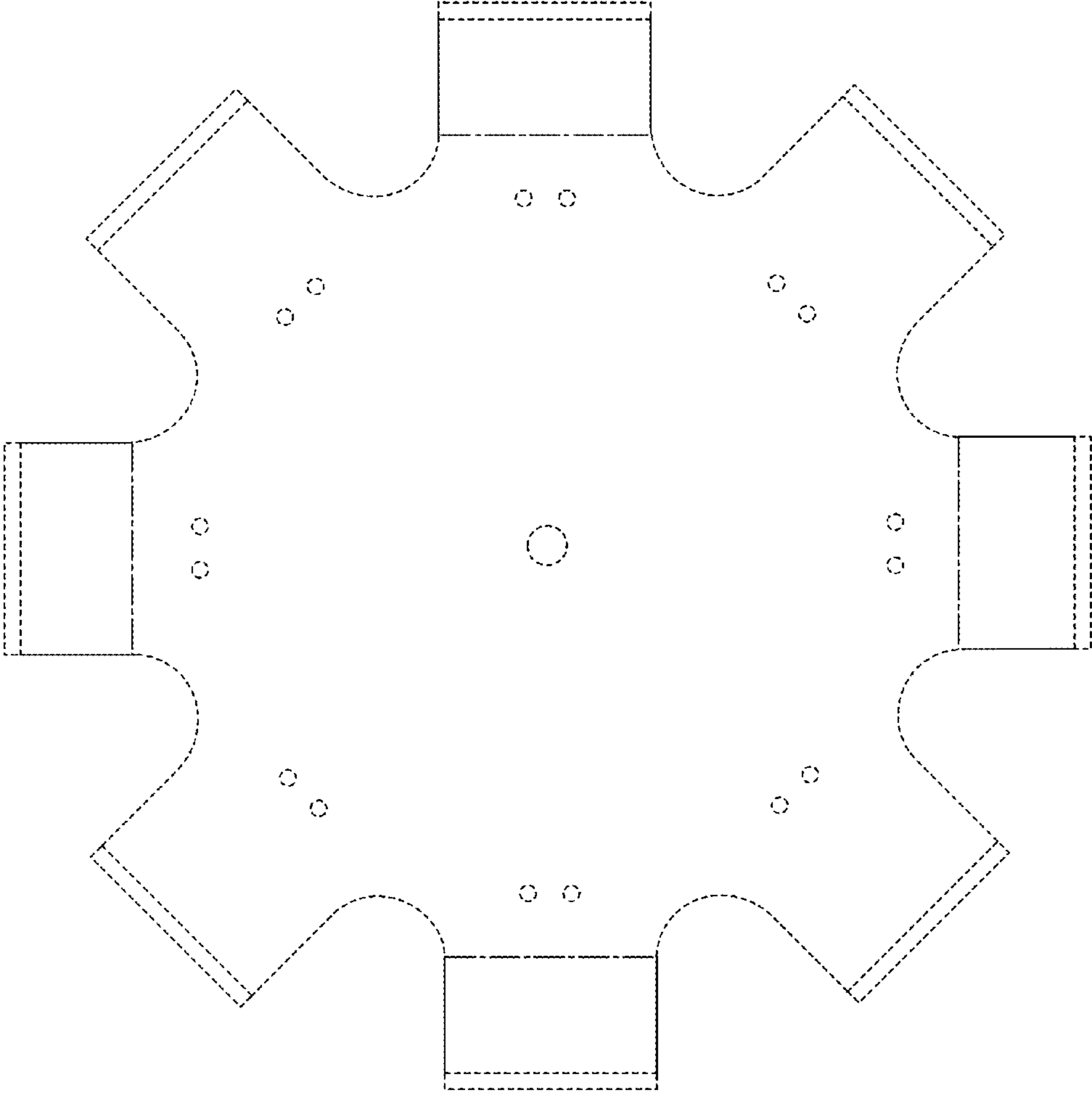

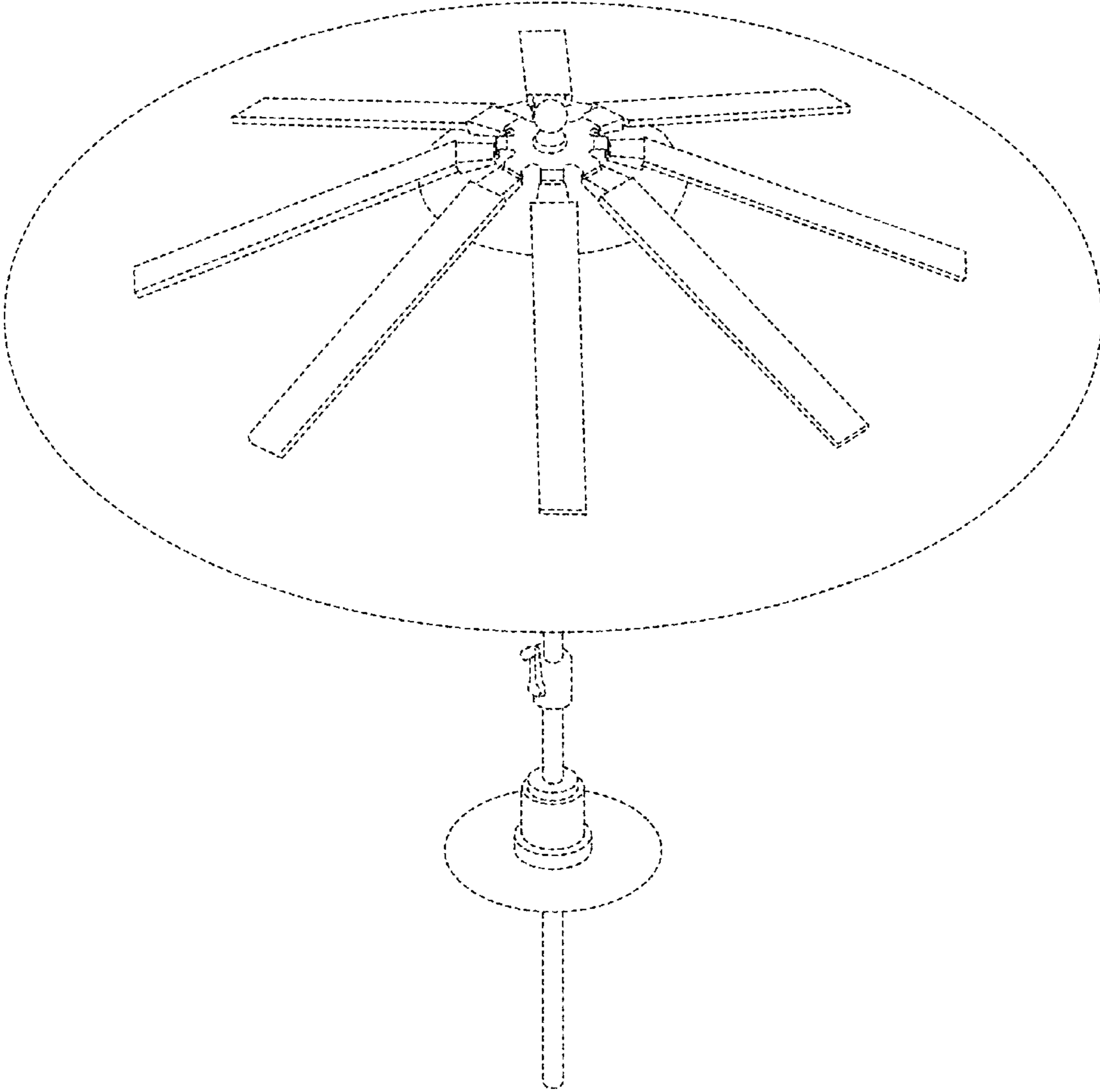
