# (57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a side handle for cookware, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of the side handle for cookware showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view of the first embodiment; the left side elevation view being the mirror image thereof,

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the side handle for cookware showing my new design:

FIG. 8 is a right side elevation view of the second embodiment; the left side elevation view being the mirror image thereof,


FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the second embodiment;


FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of the second embodiment;


FIG. 11 is a front elevation view of the second embodiment; and,

















