The ornamental design for a novelty mustache for eyeglasses, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof;

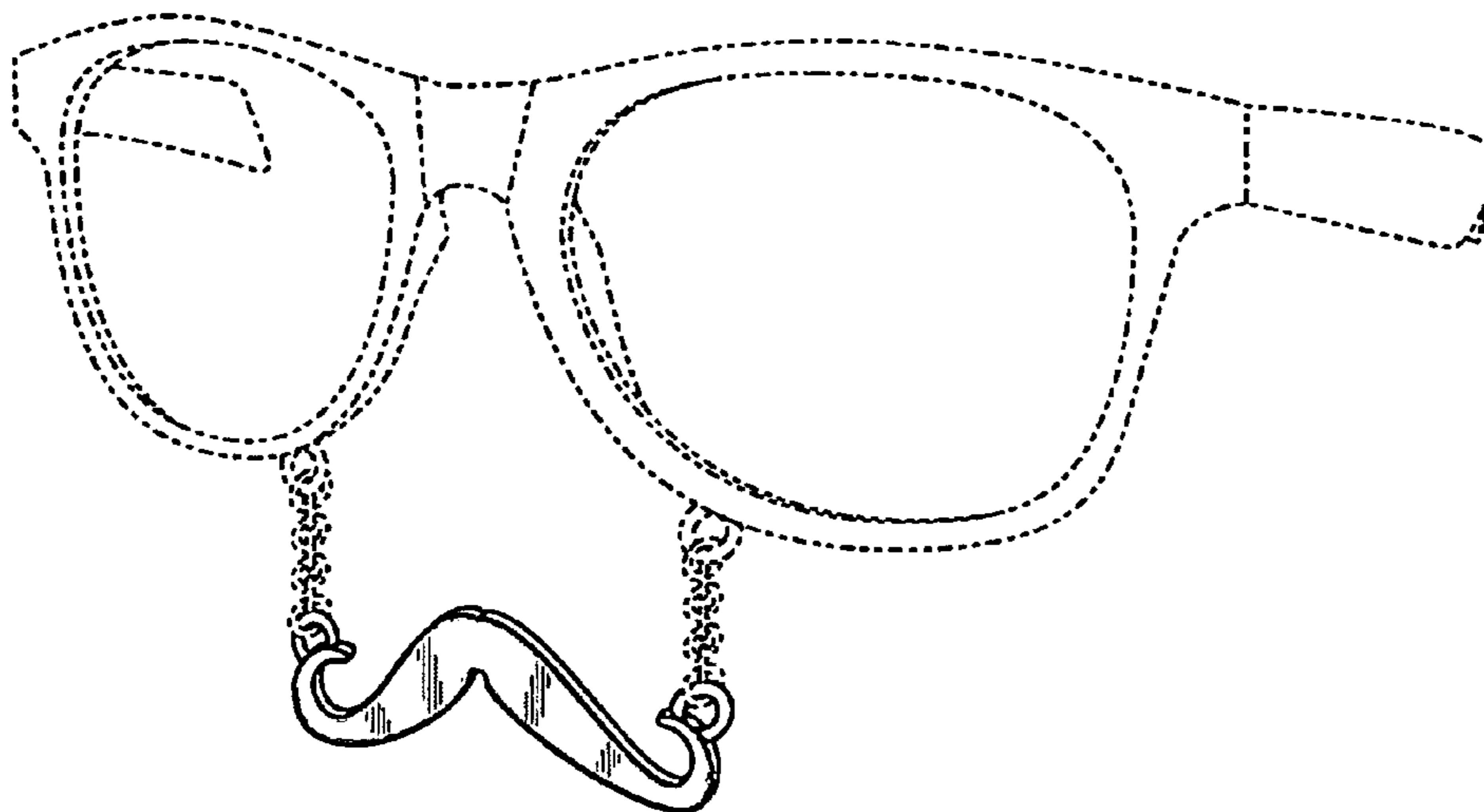
FIG. 9 is rear elevational view thereof;

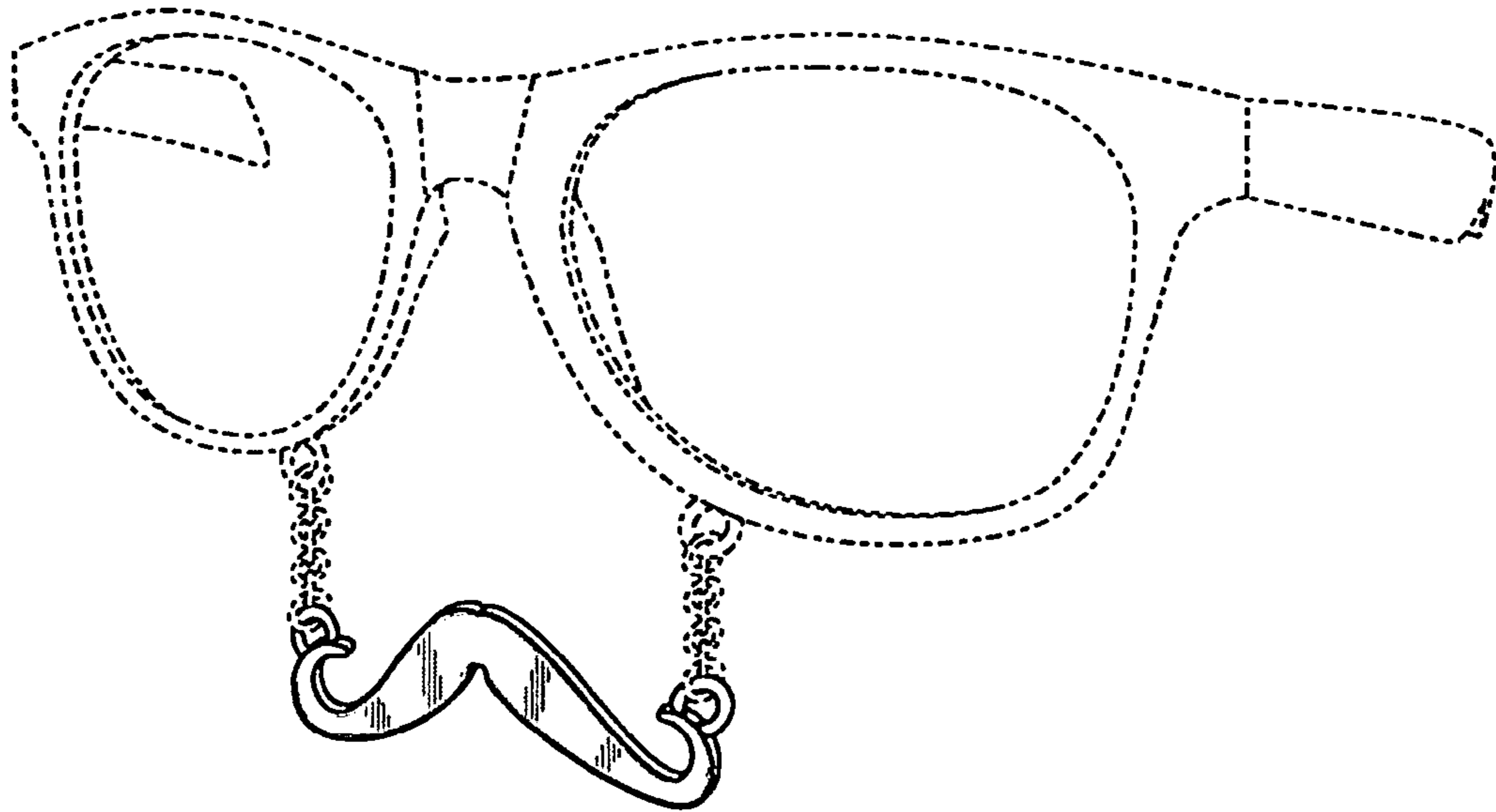

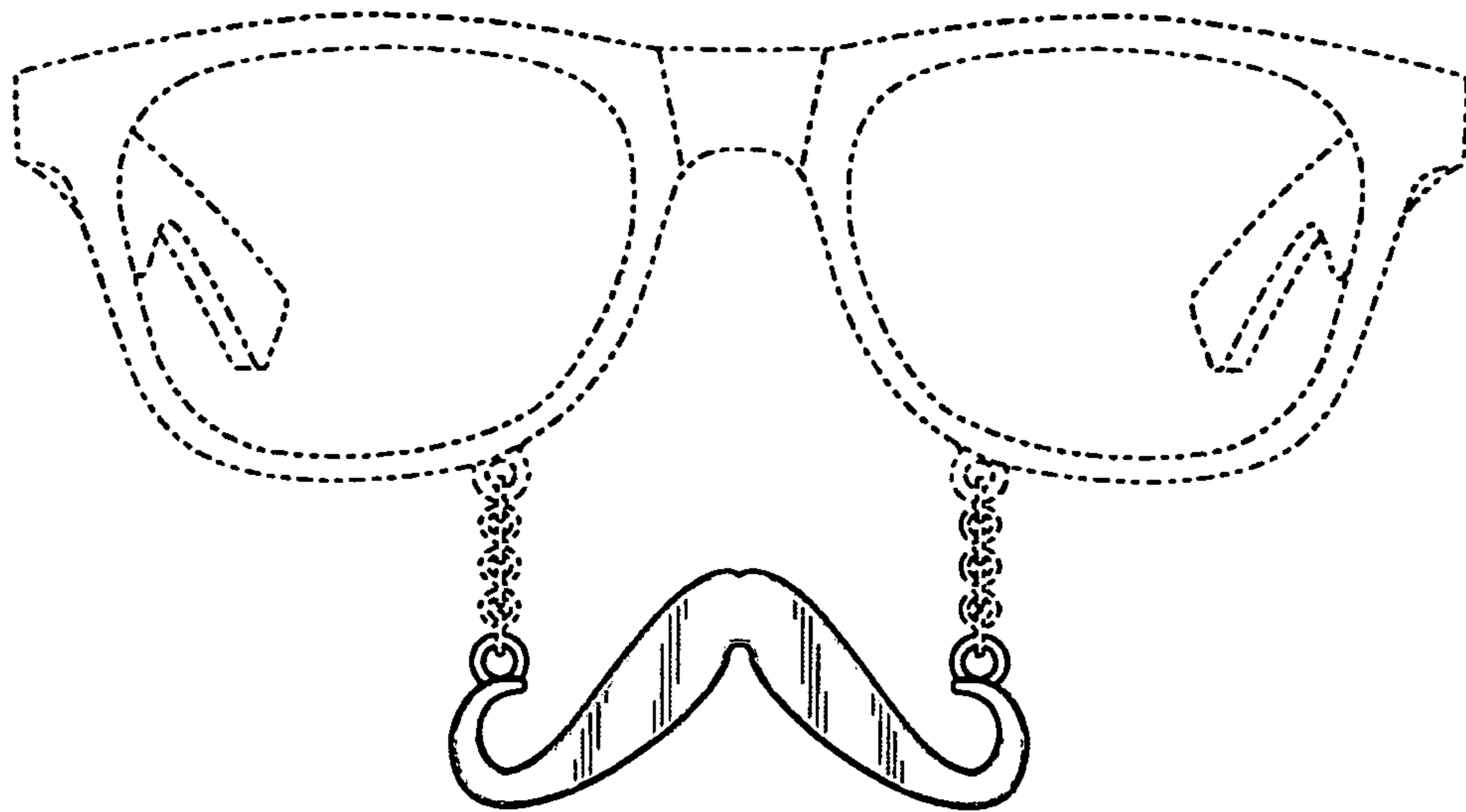

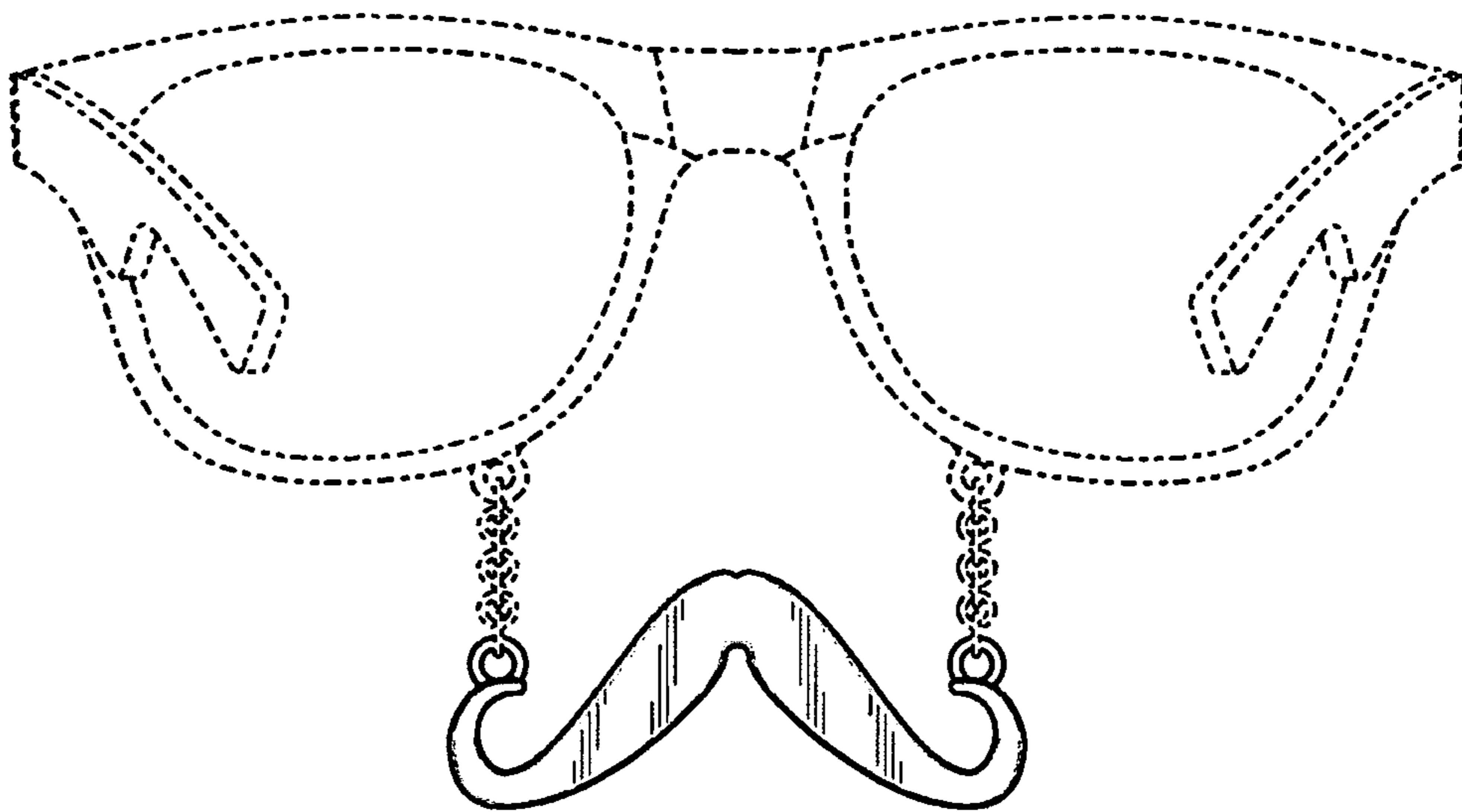

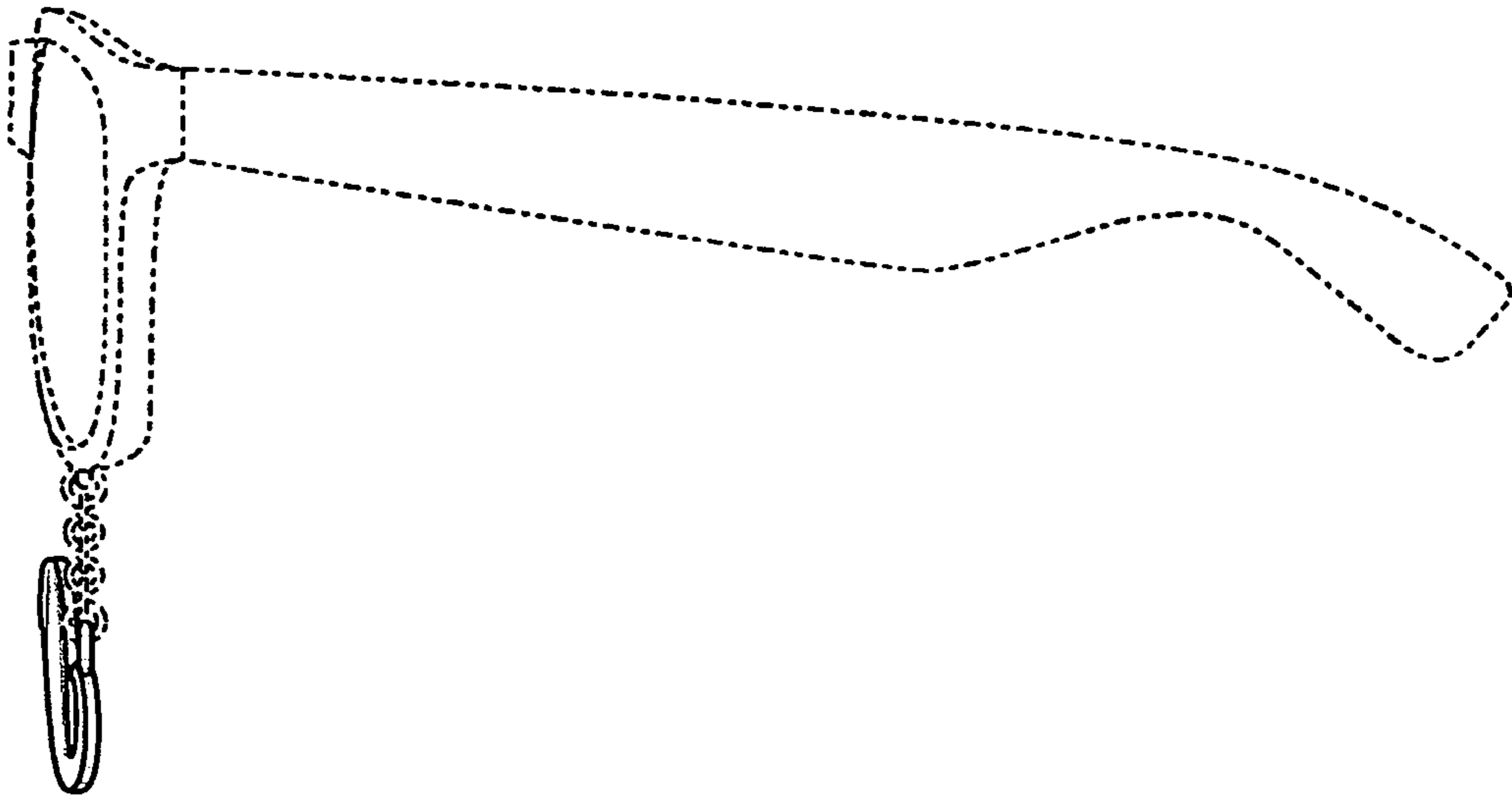

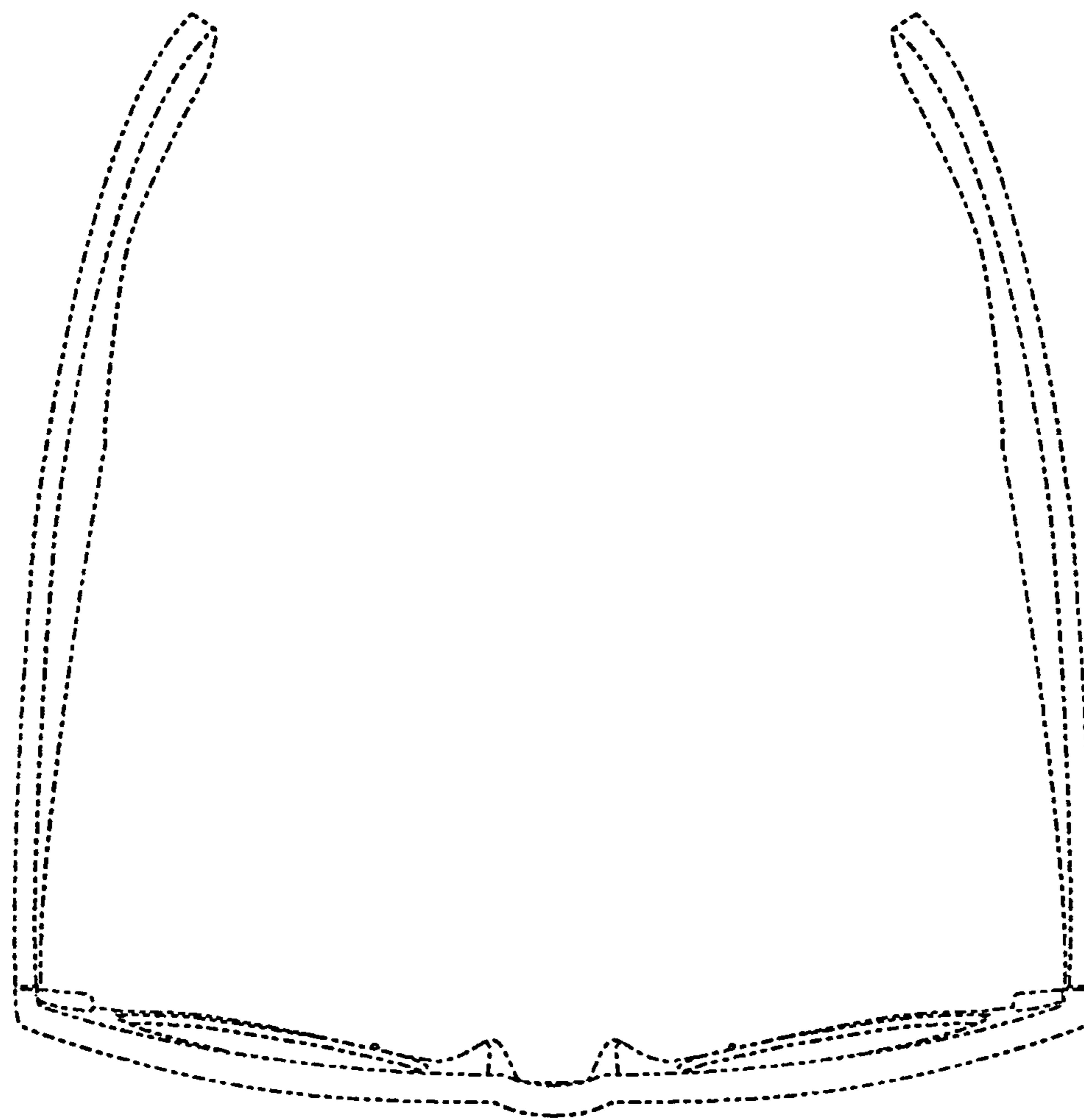

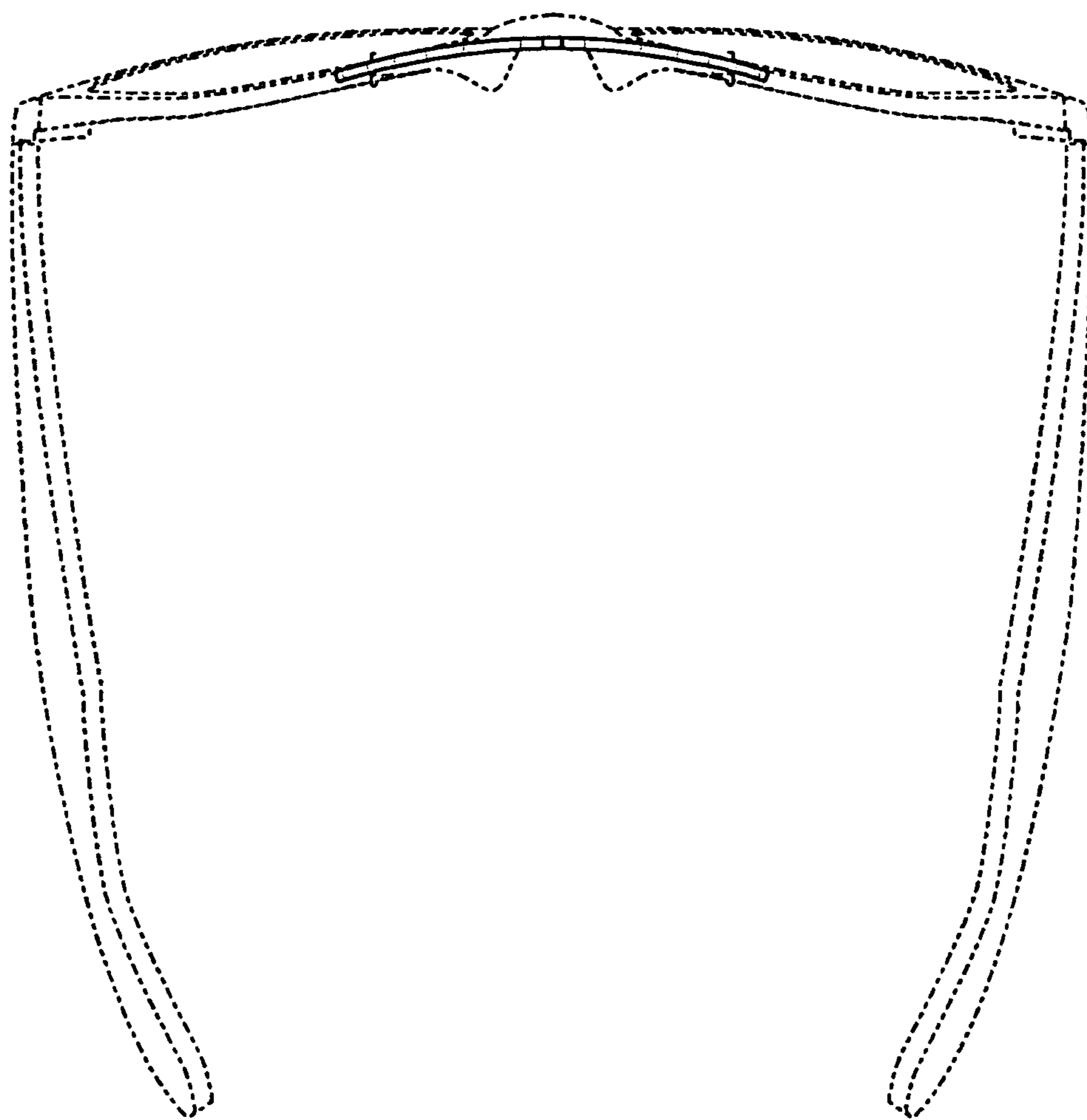

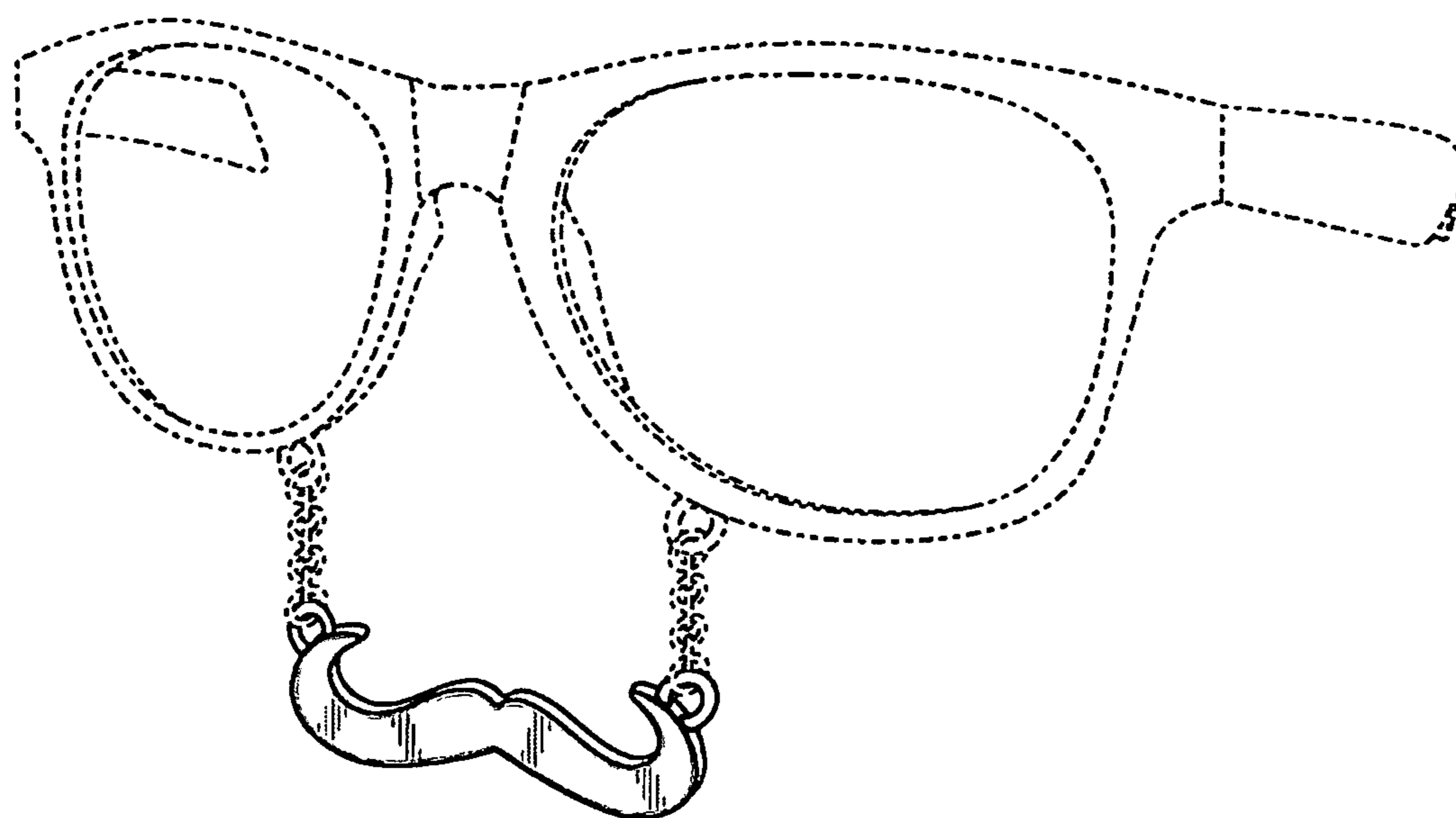

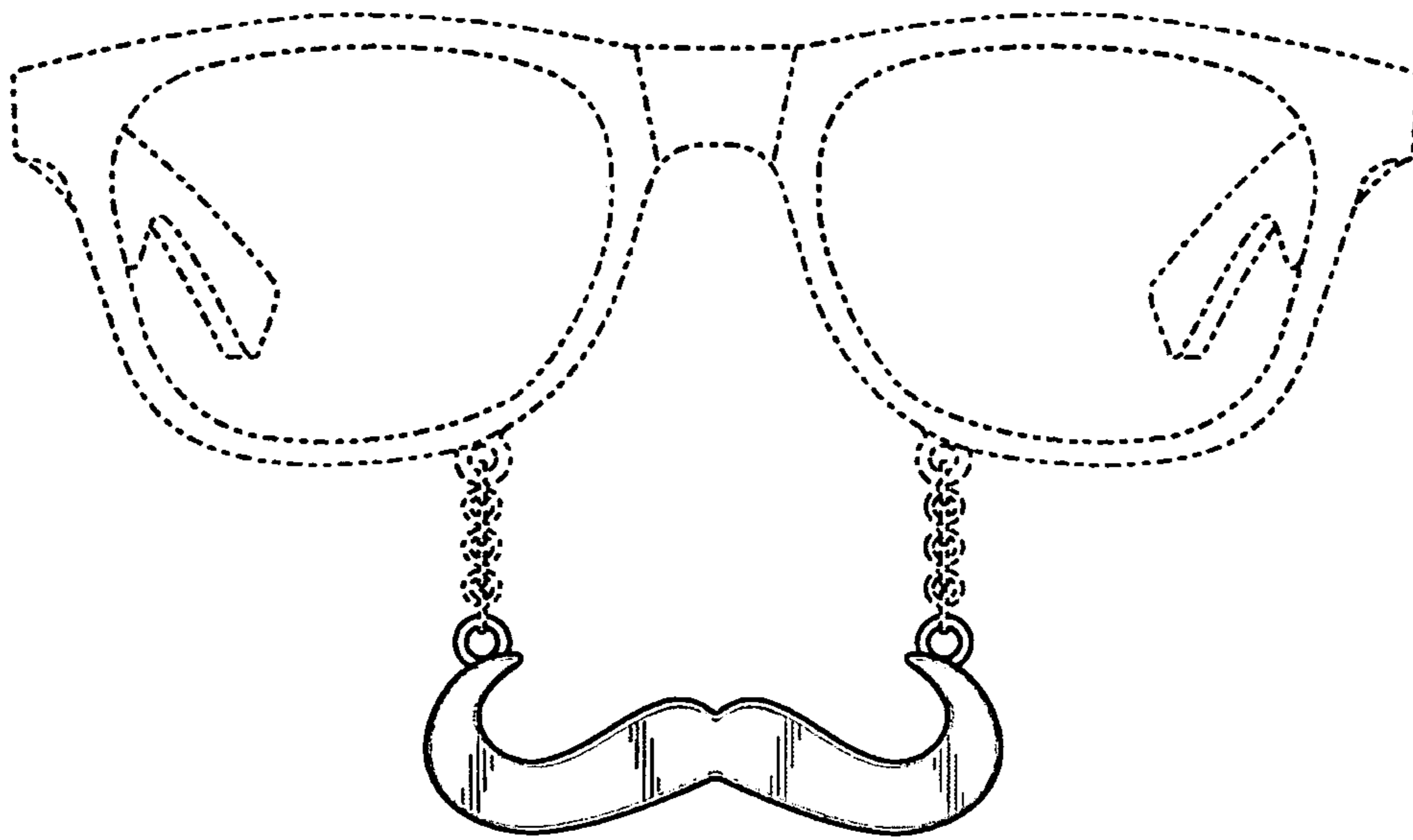

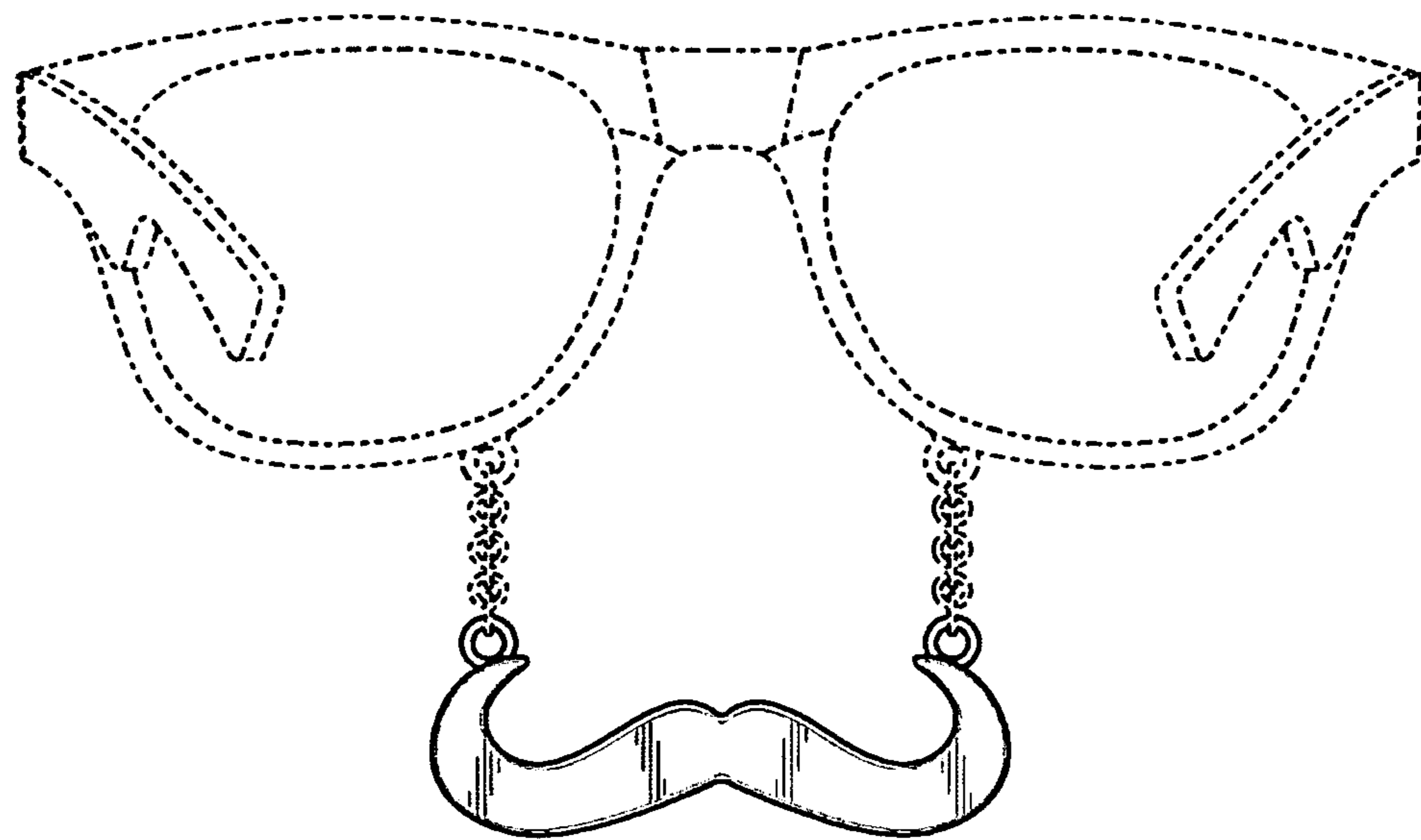

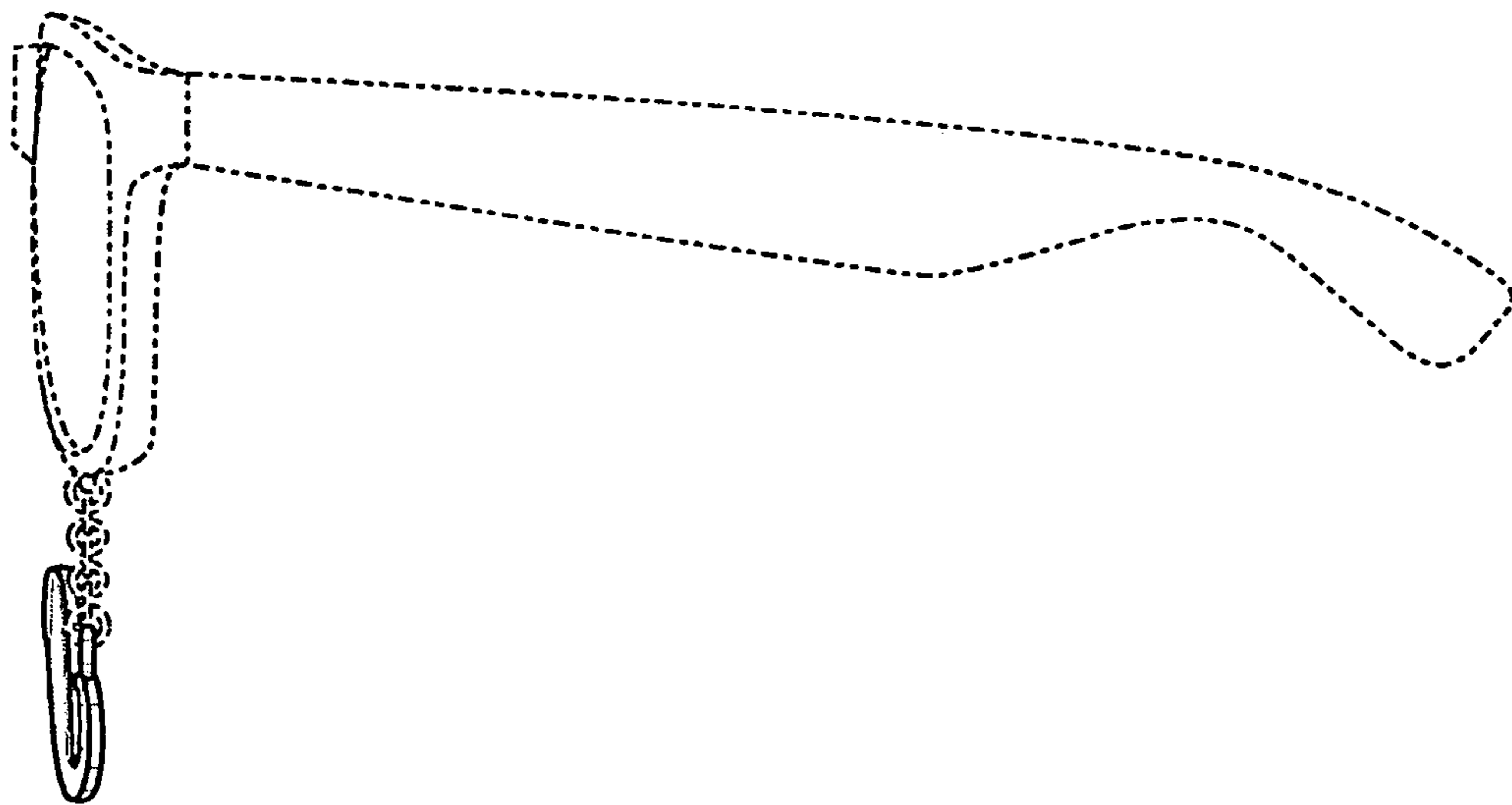

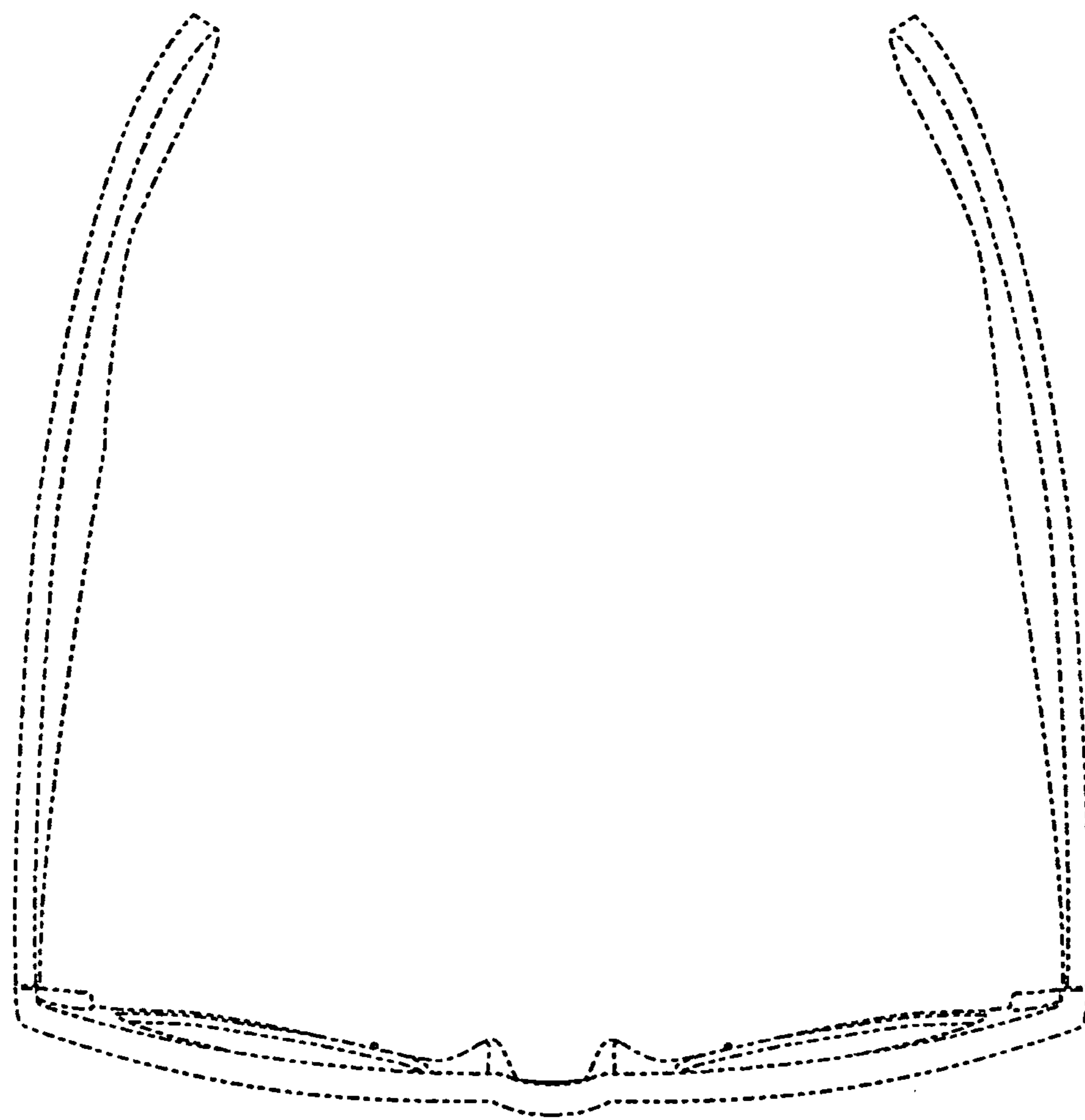

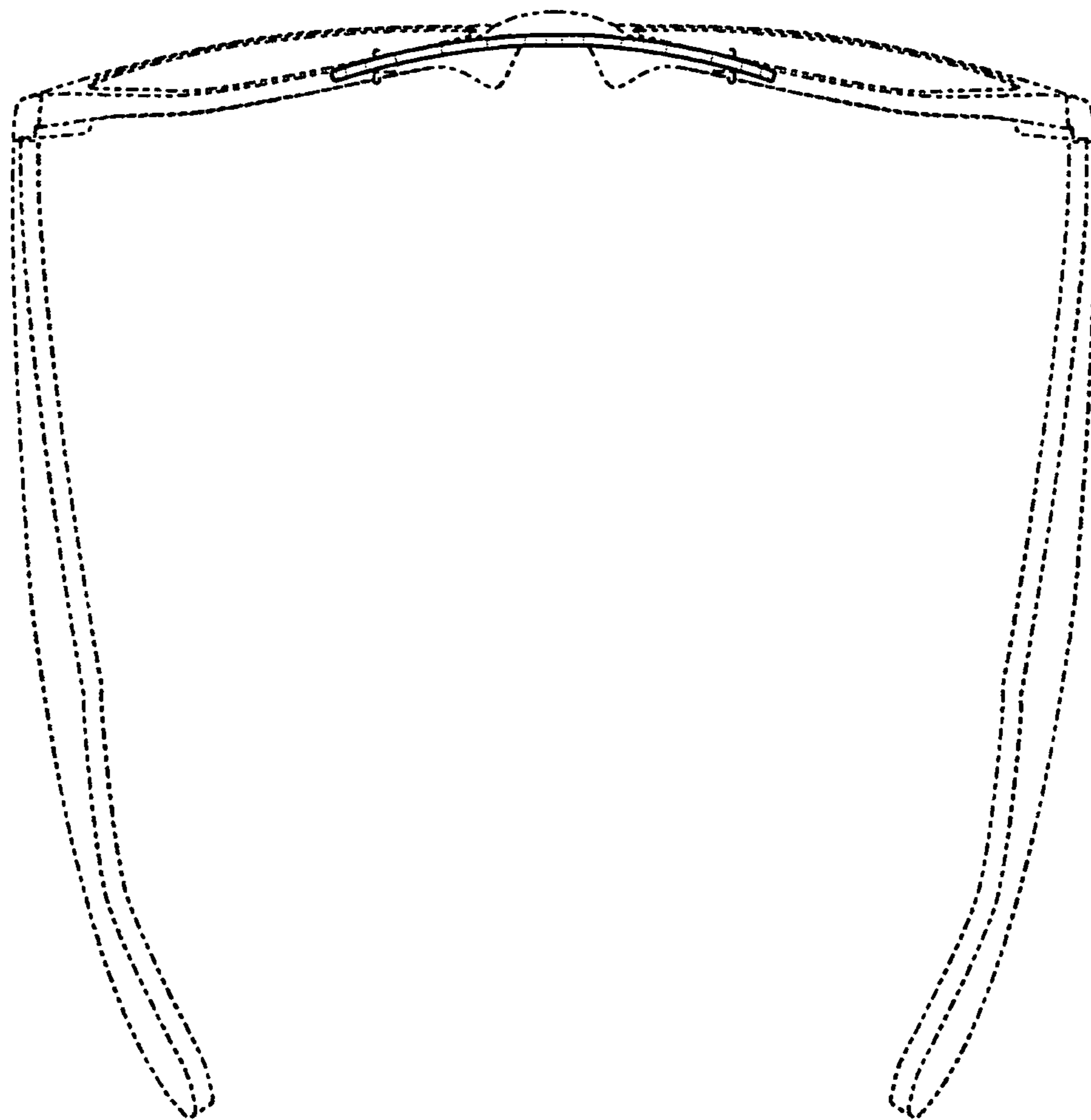
