FIG. 4 is a back view of the hand-held slicer.

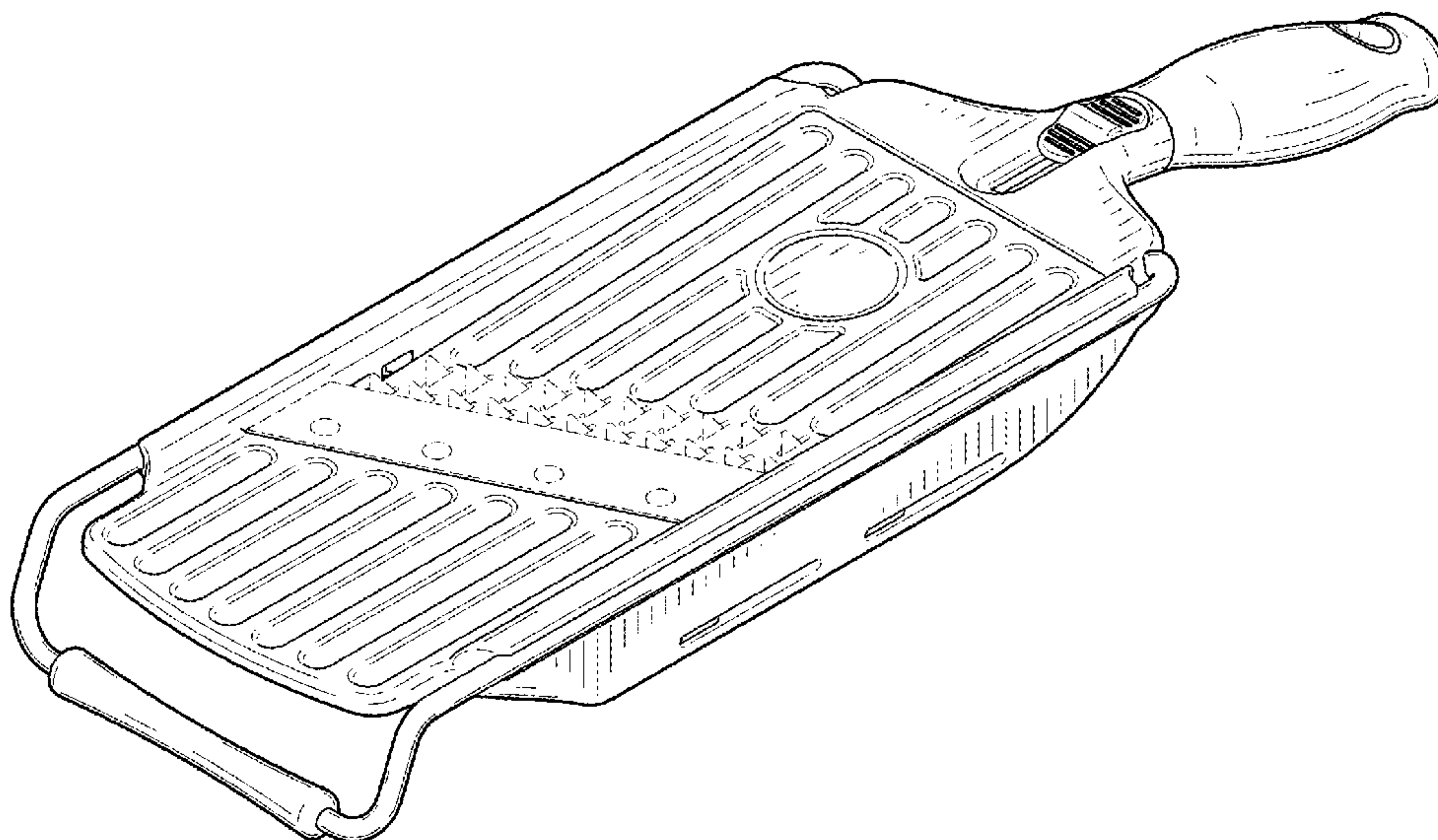
FIG. 5 is a left side view of the hand-held slicer.

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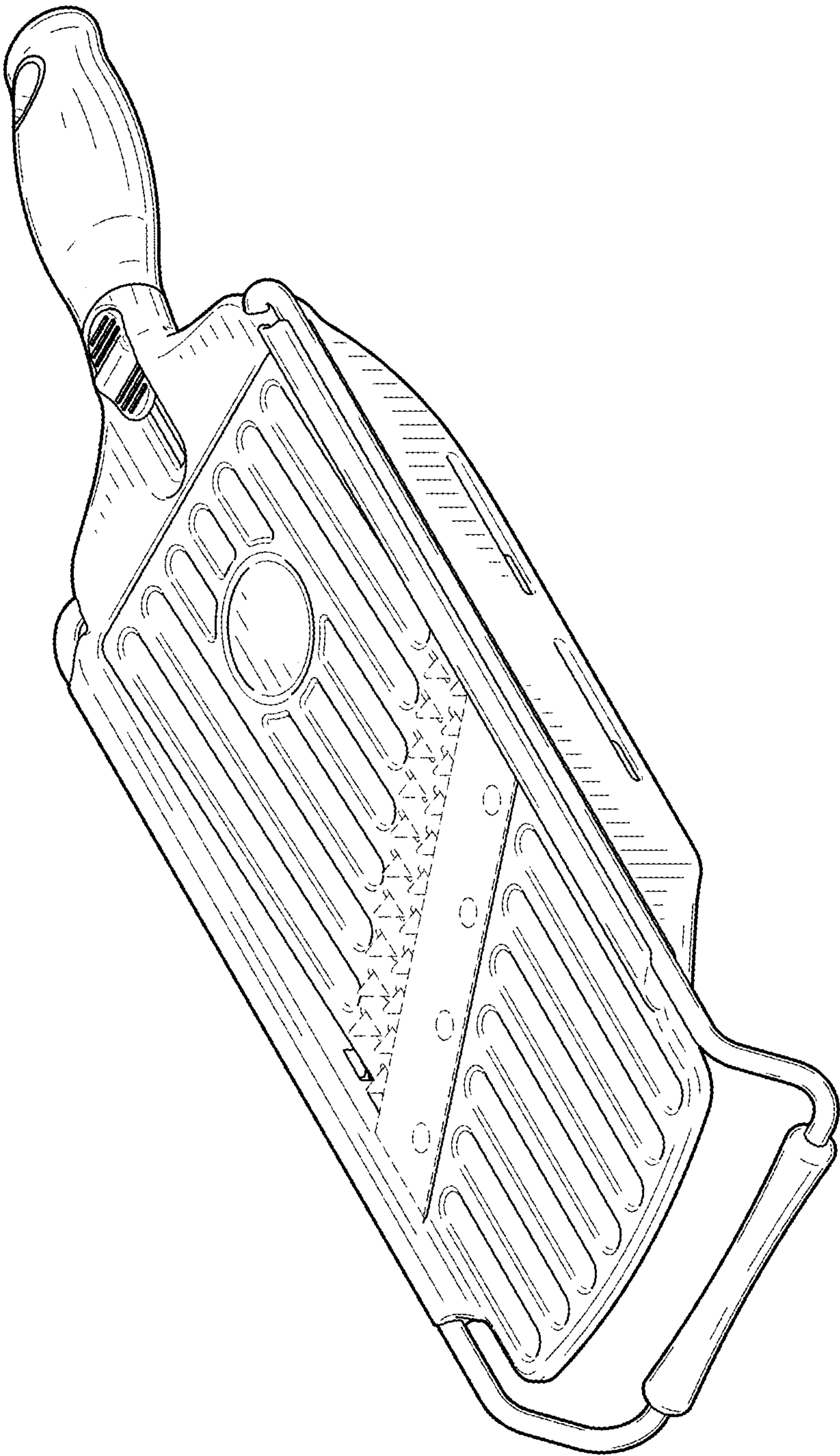

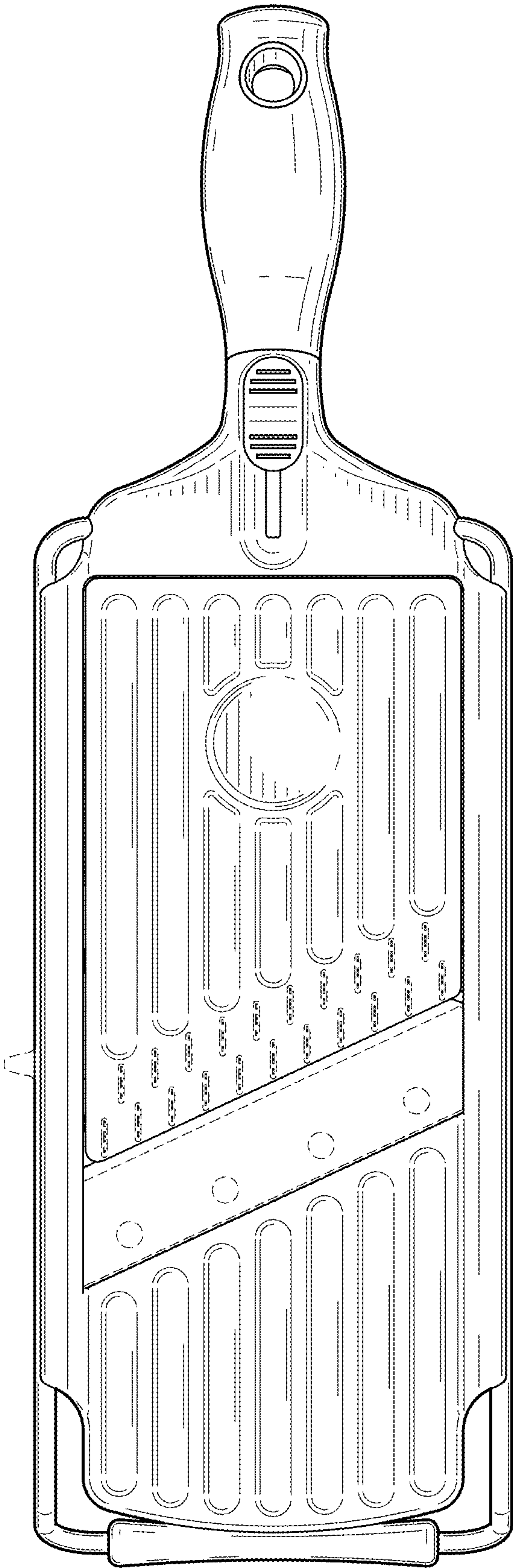

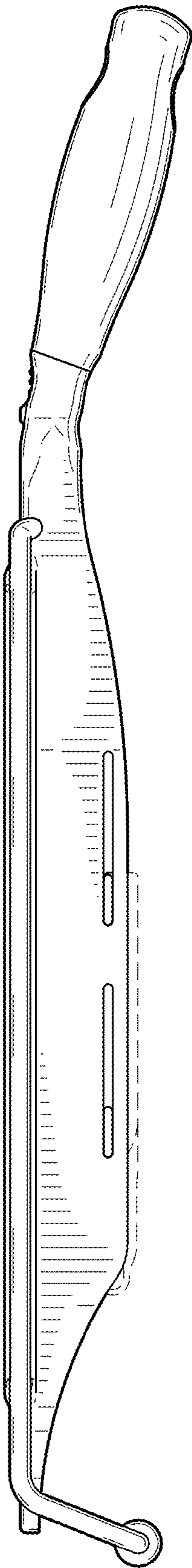

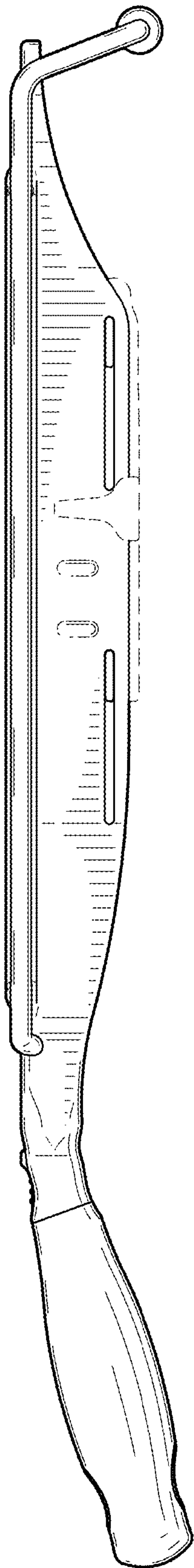

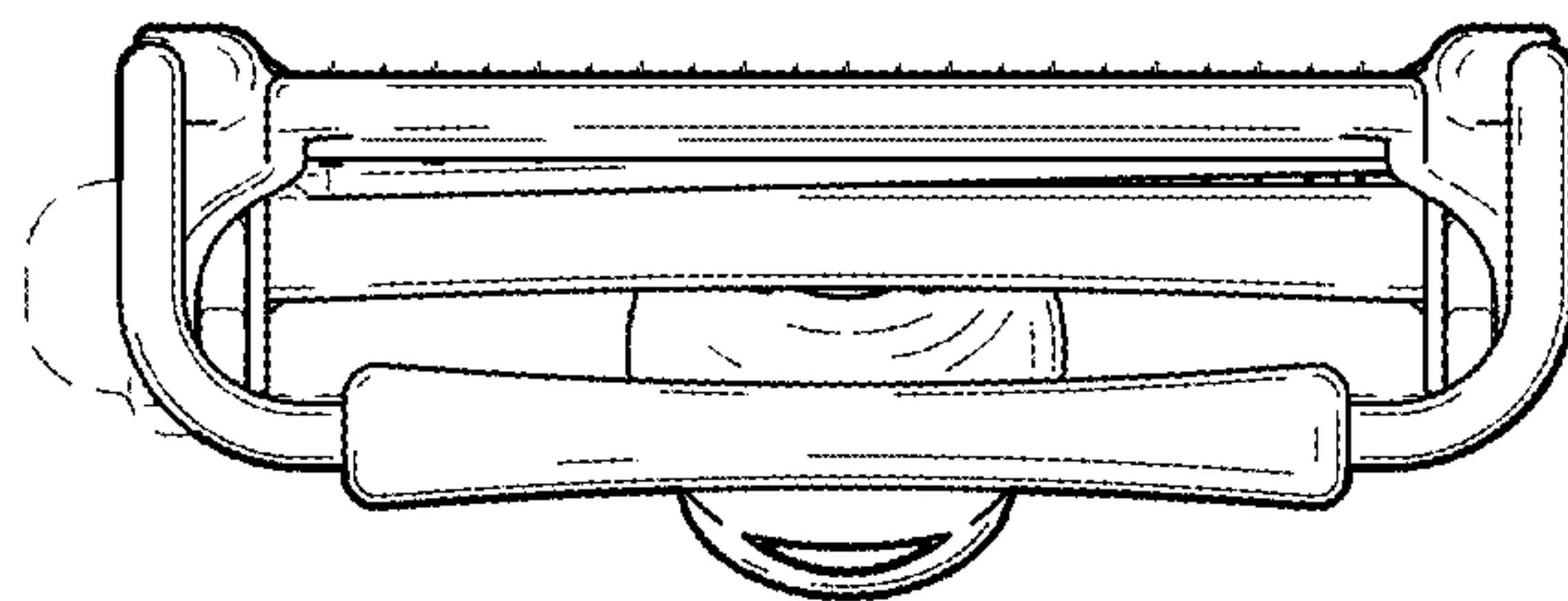

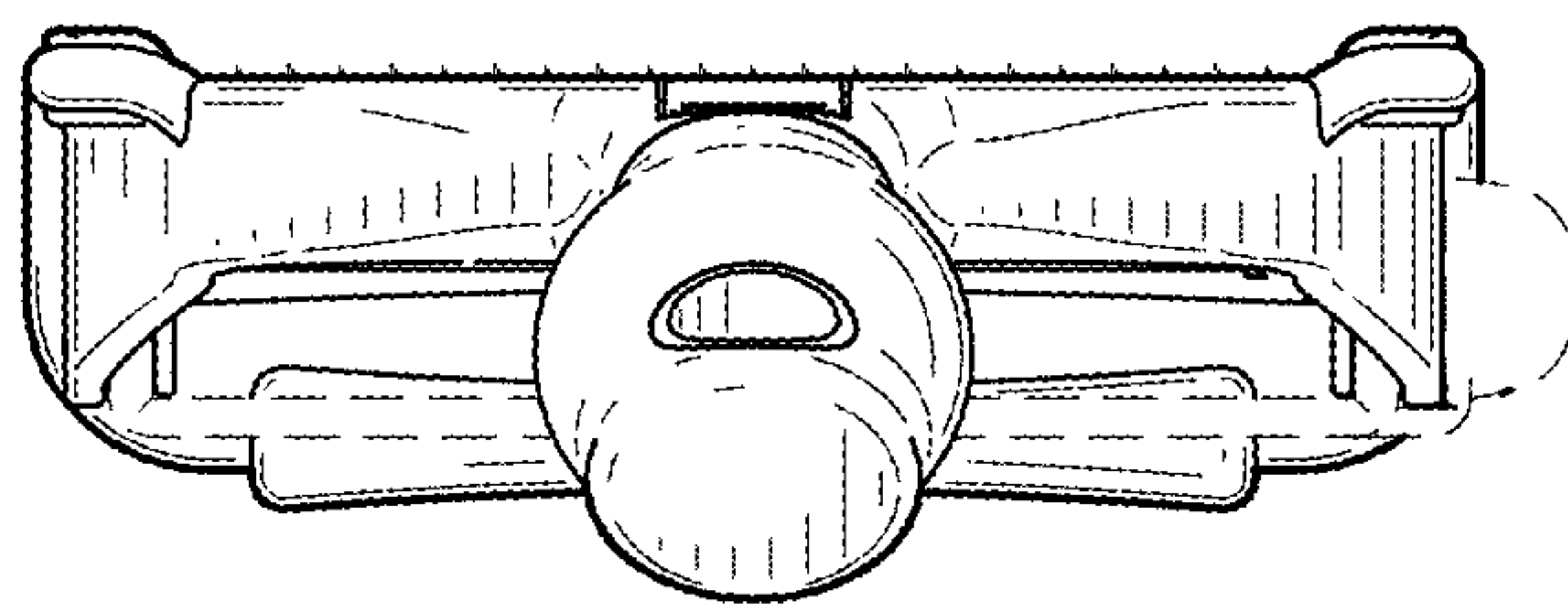

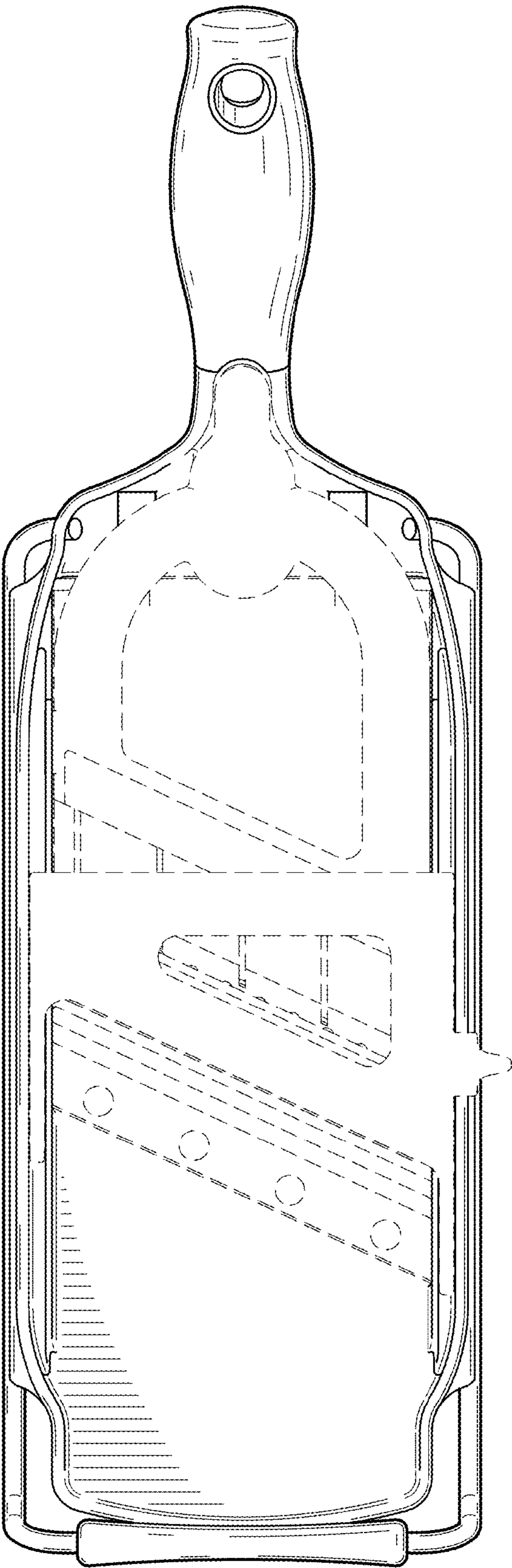
