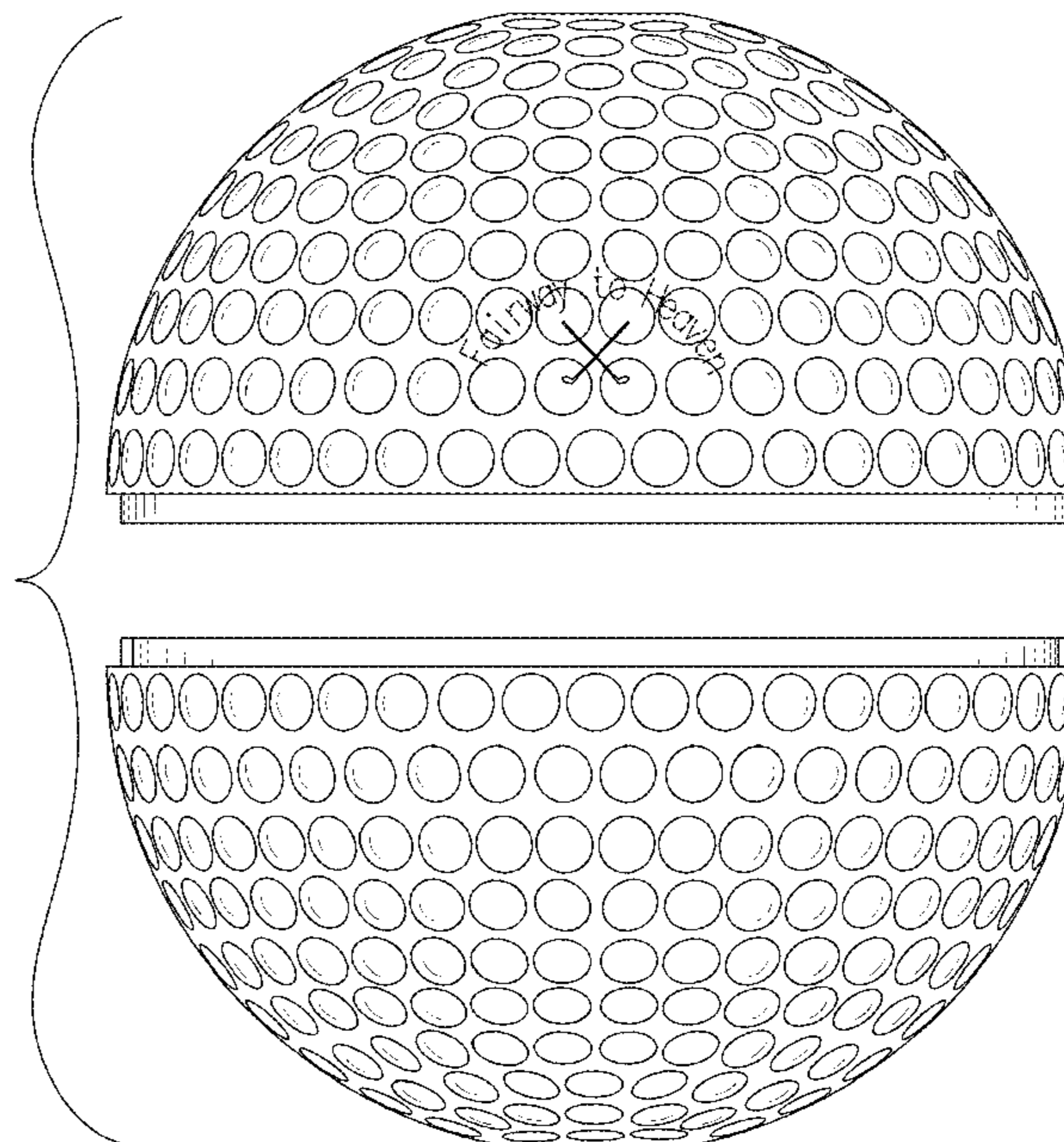
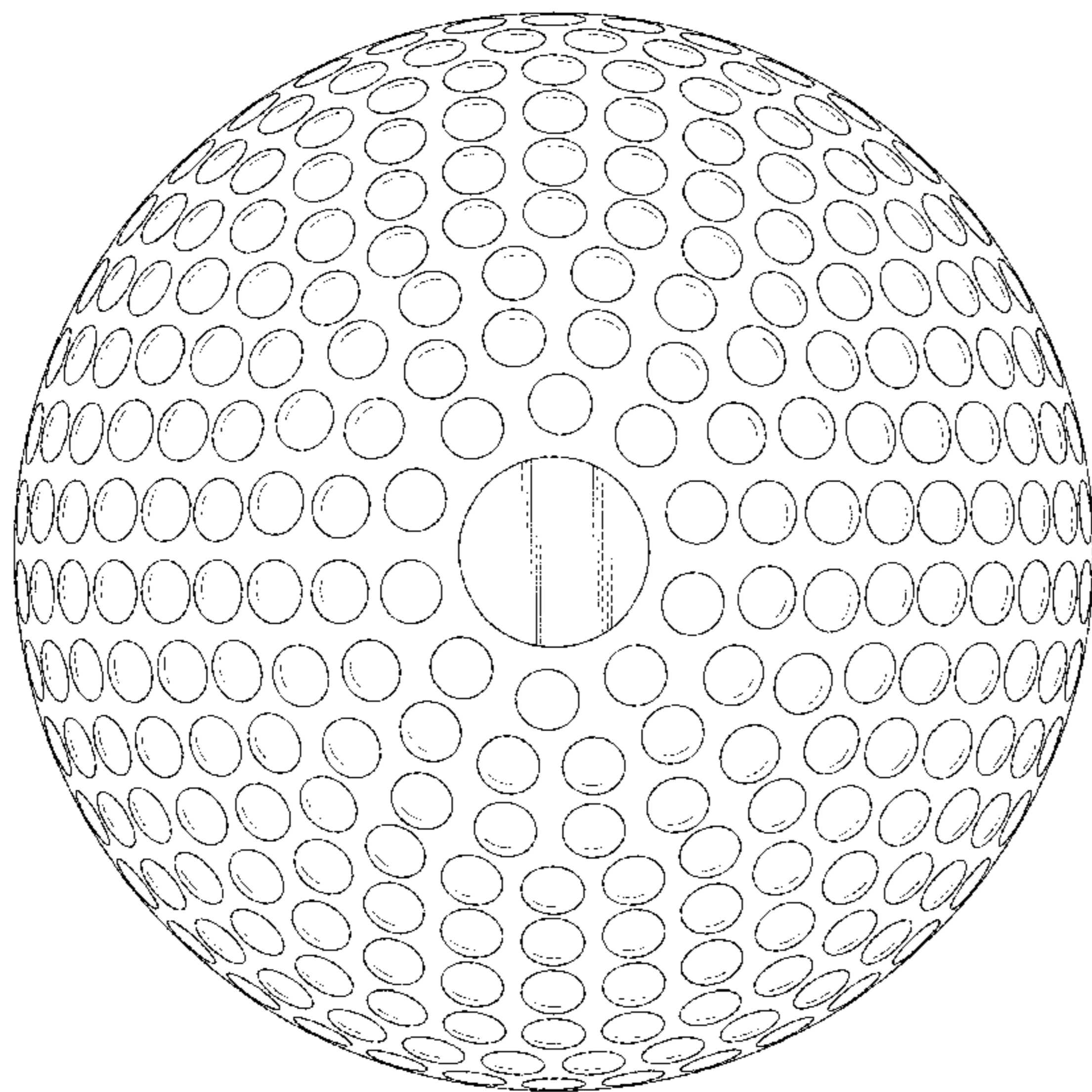
(57) **CLAIM**

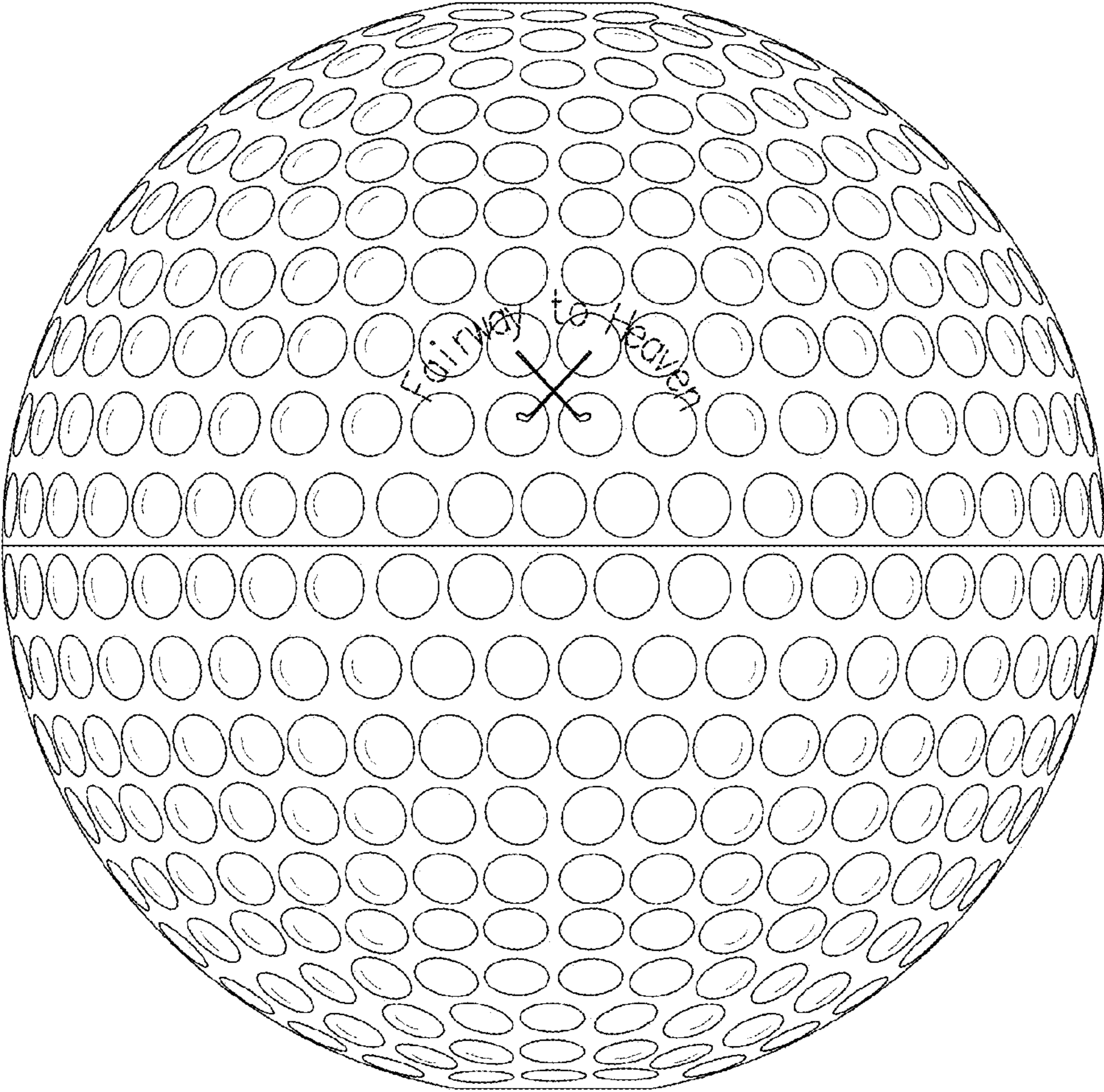
I claim the ornamental design for a golf ball shaped urn, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

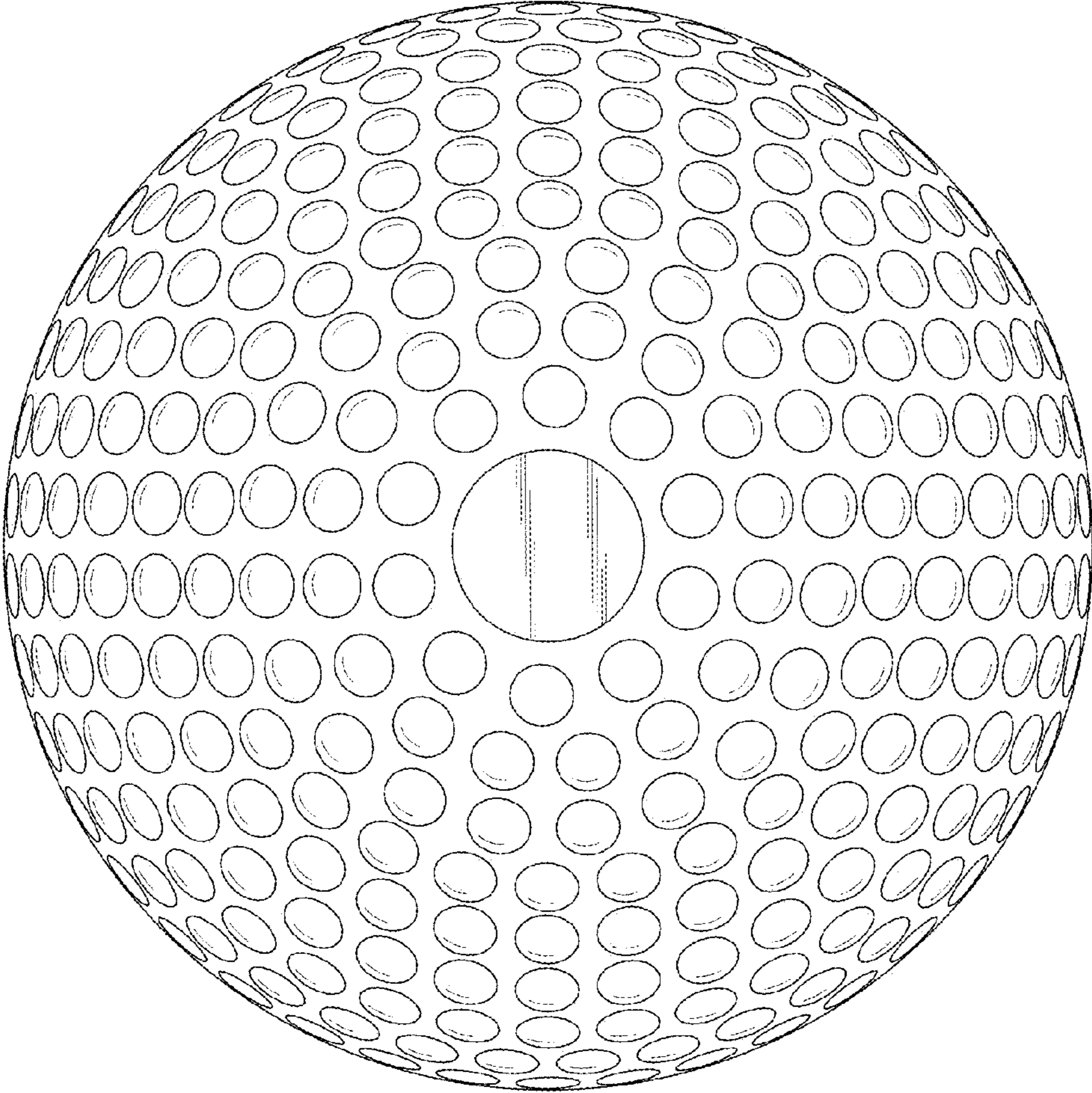
FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of the golf ball shaped urn. FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the golf ball shaped urn, the bottom of the golf ball shaped urn is a mirror image of the top; and, FIG. 3 is a front exploded view of the golf ball shaped urn. 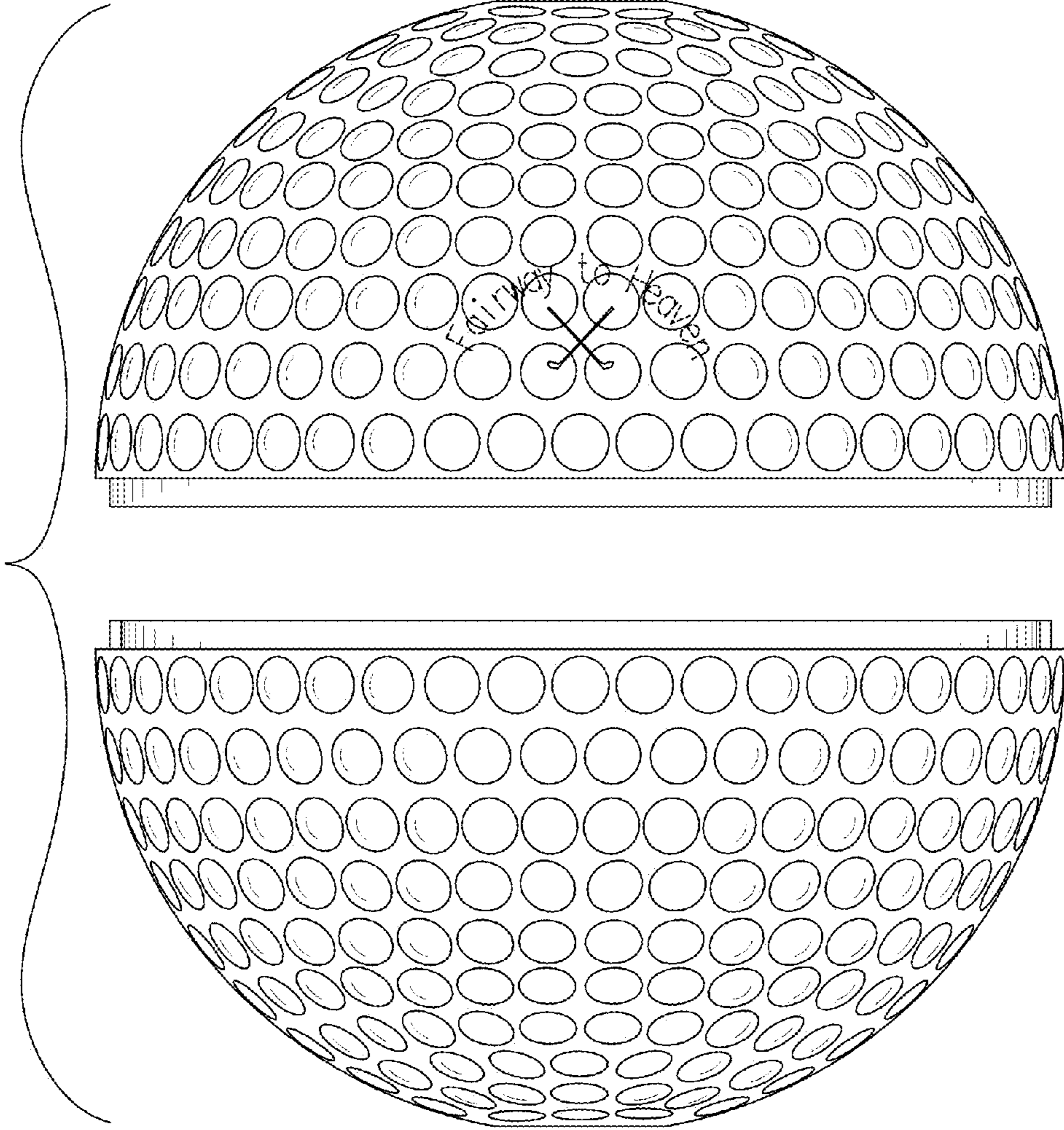
