FIG. 3 is a front view or rear view or left side view or right side view thereof.

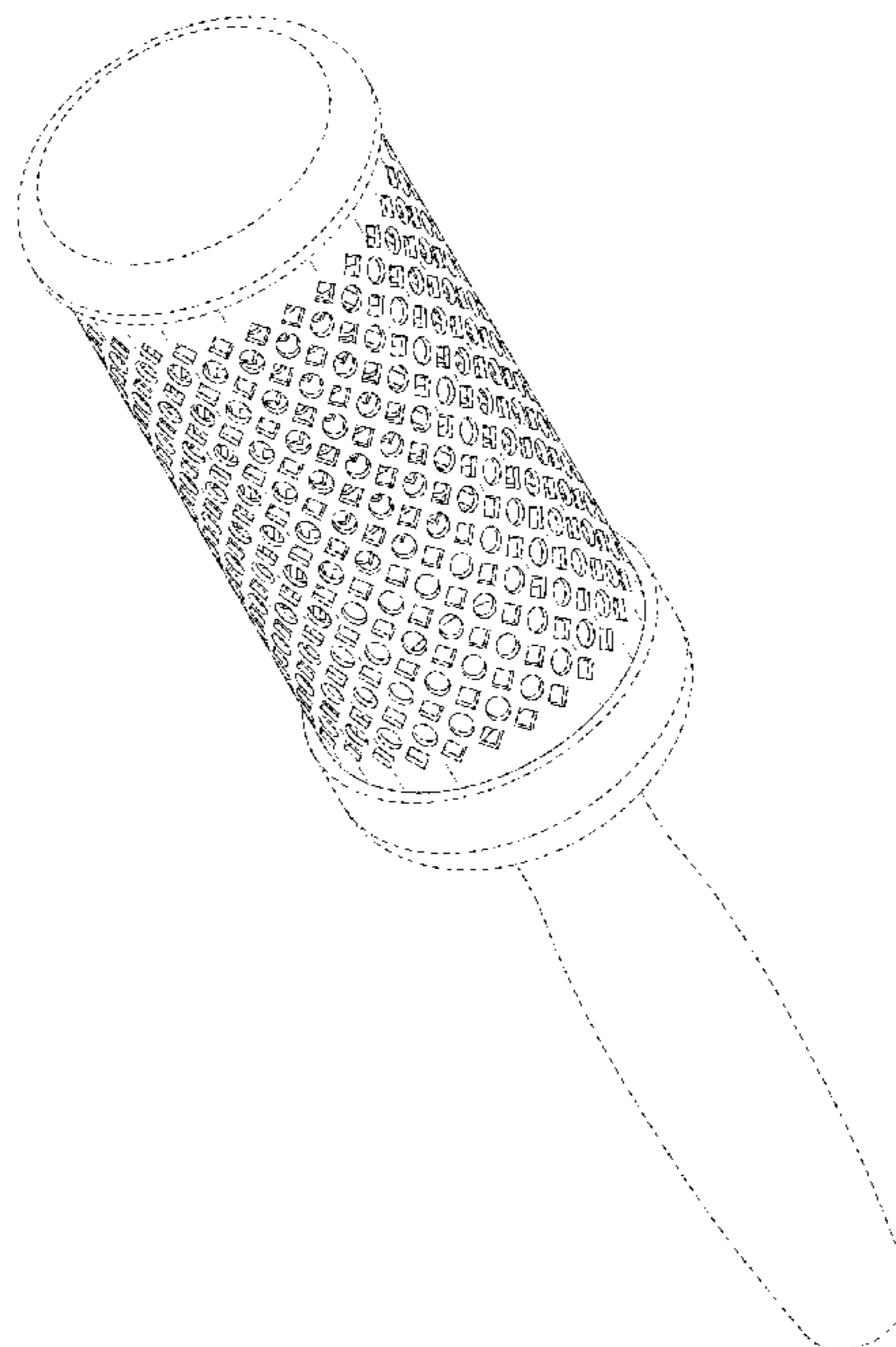
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof; and,

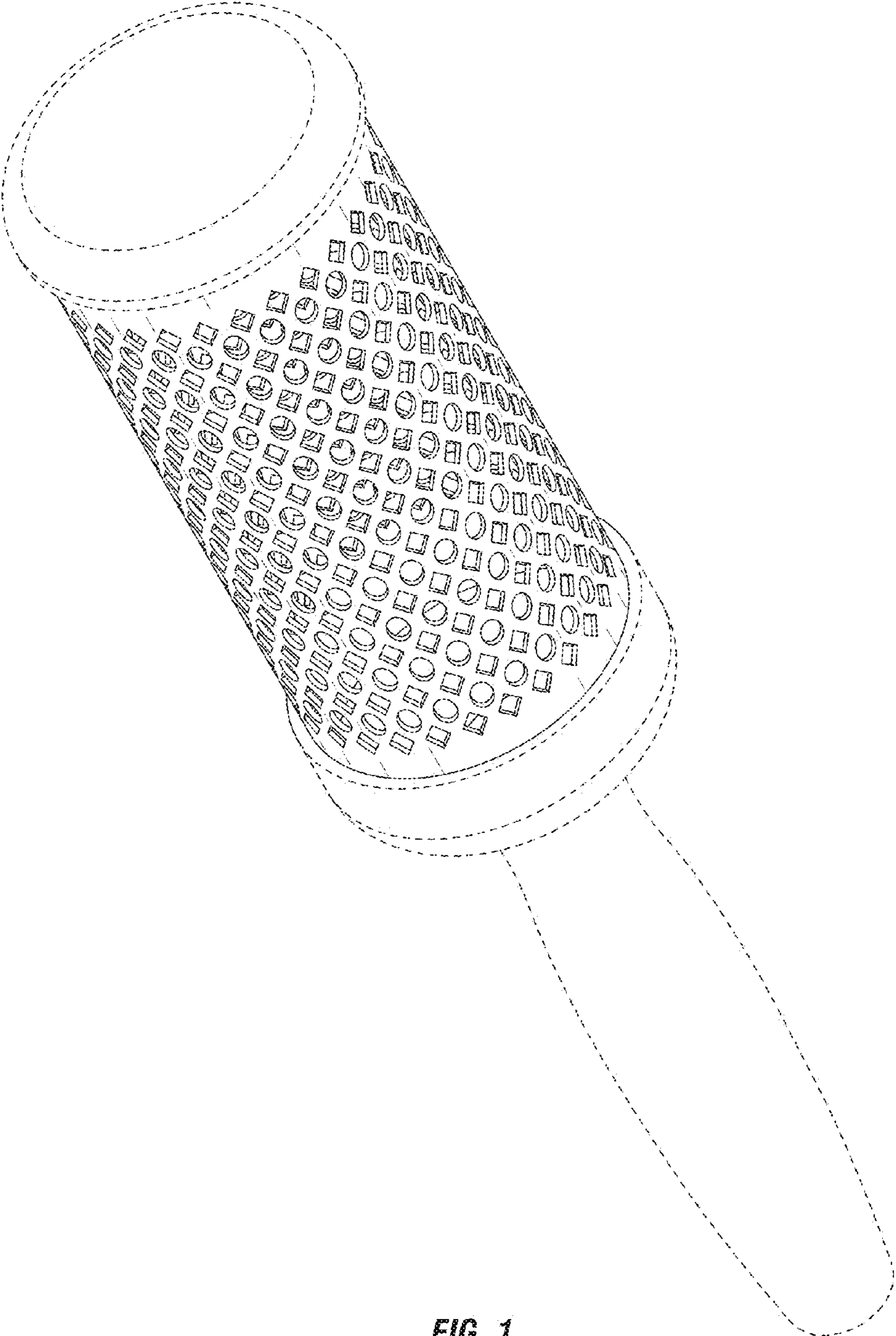

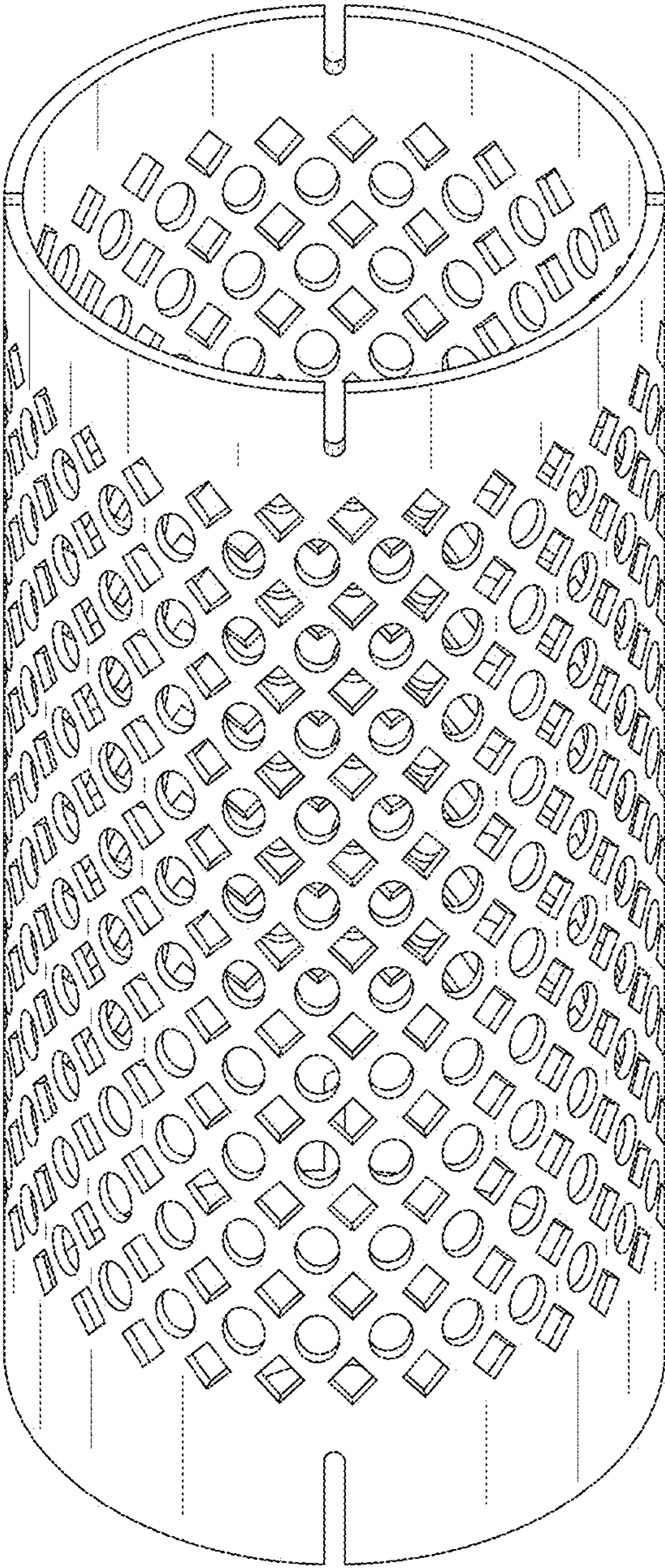

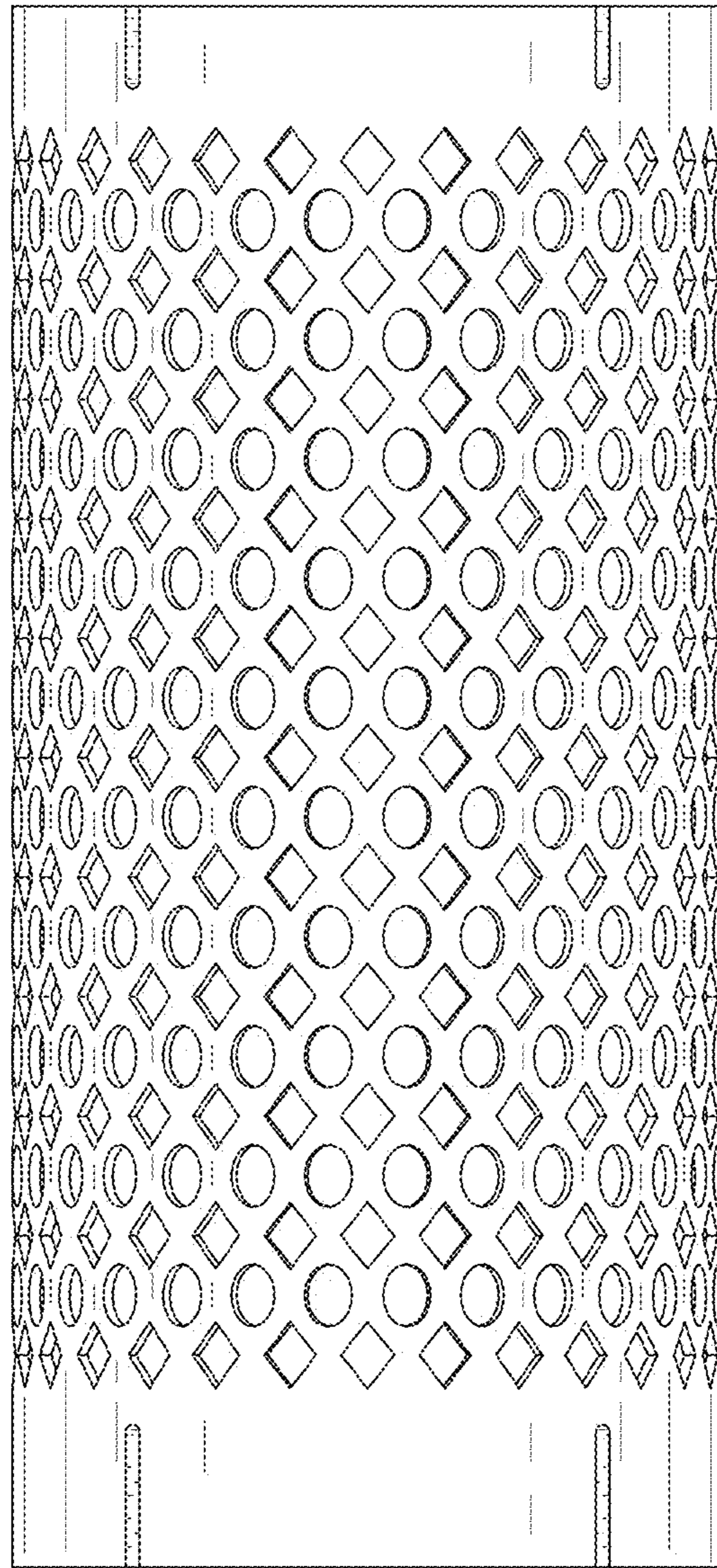

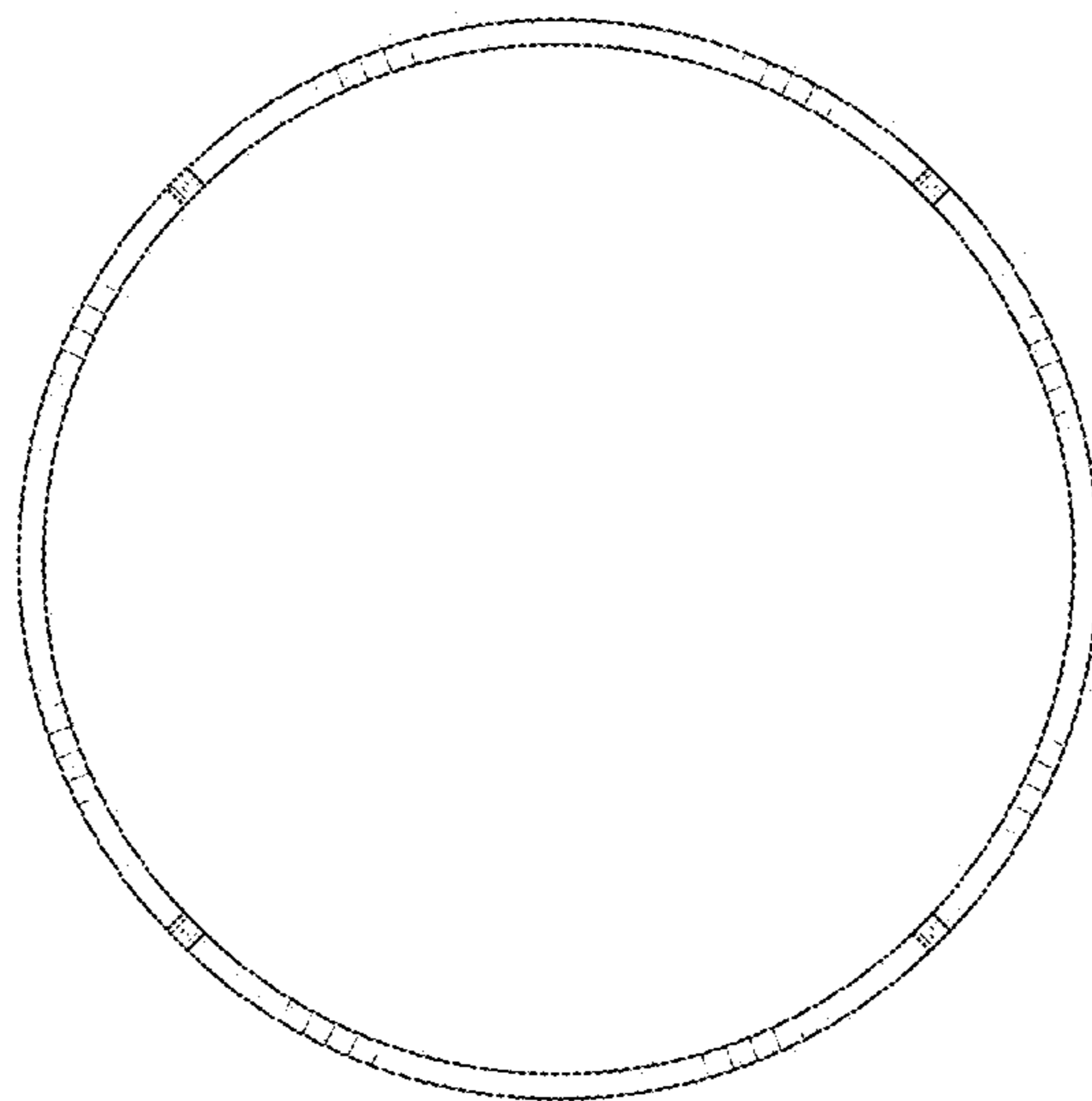

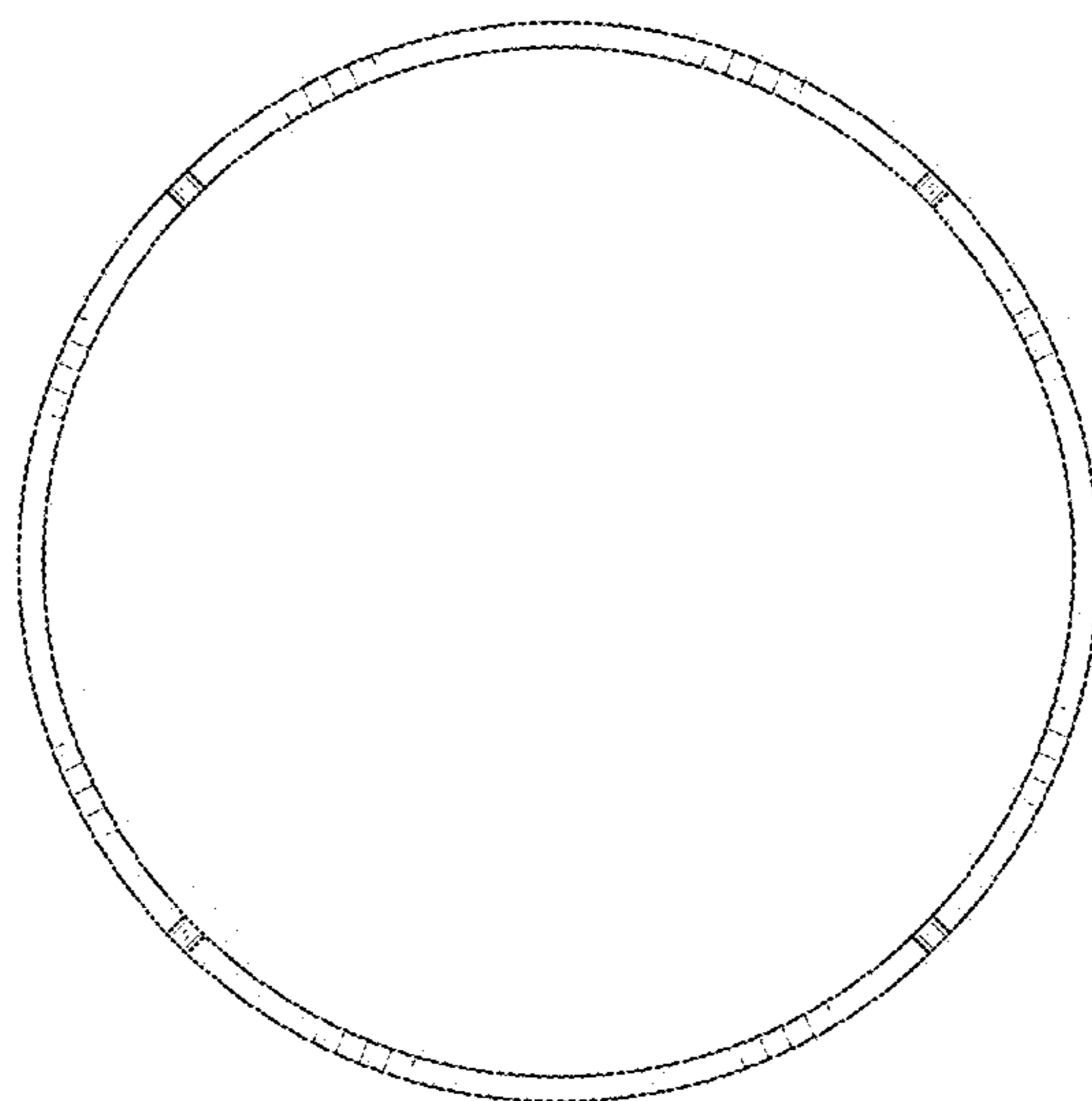
