FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

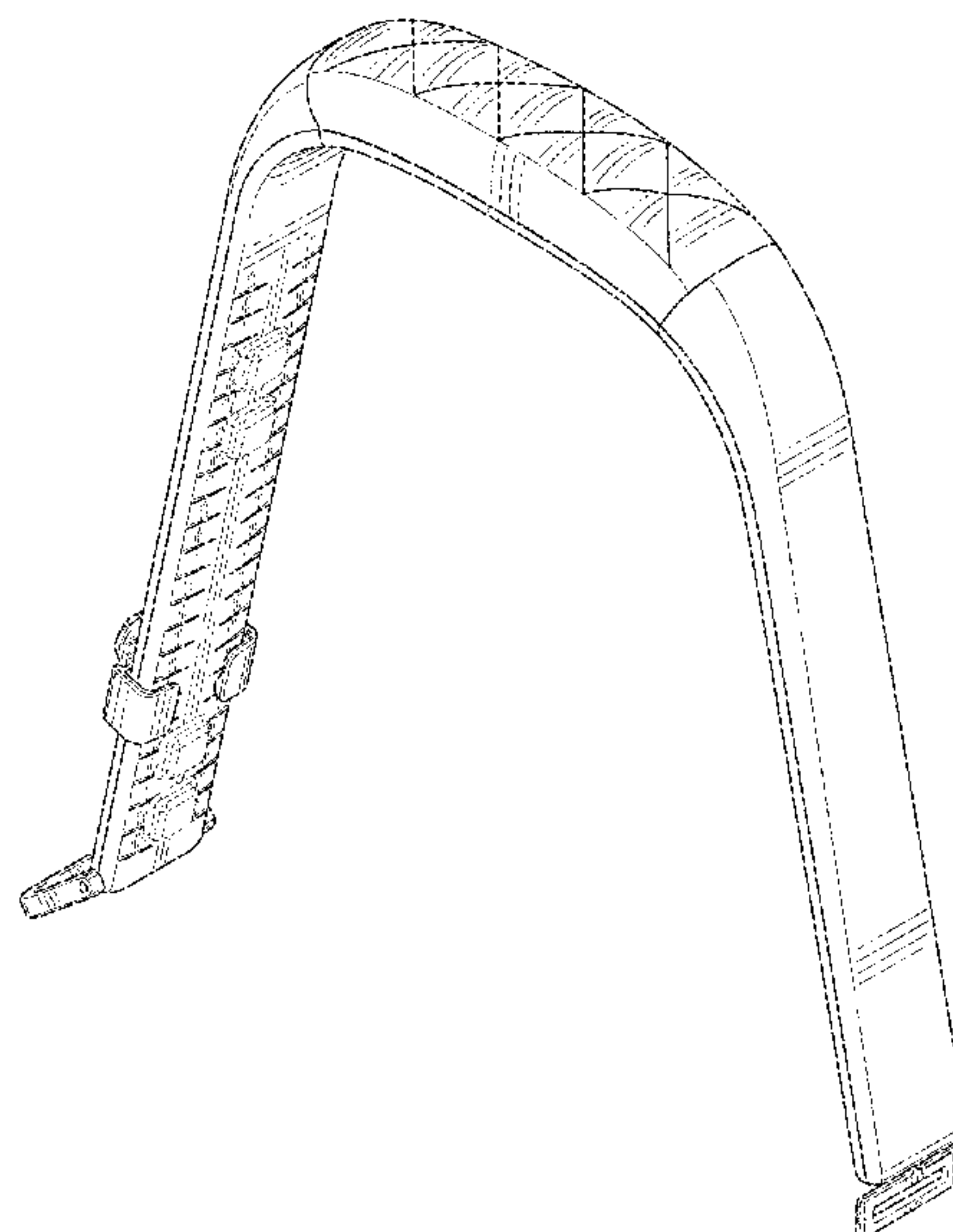
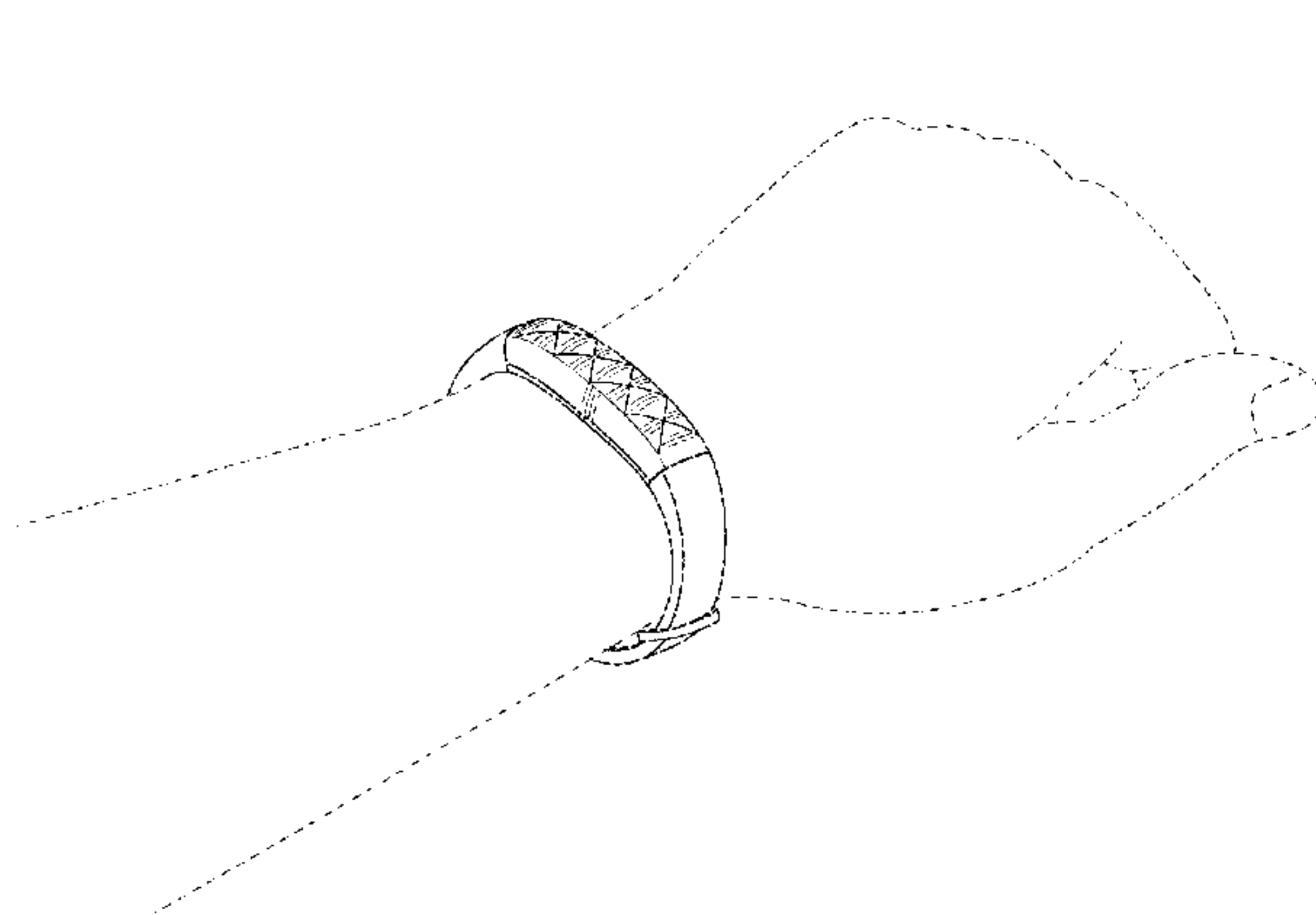
FIG. 7 is a close up section view of the portion of FIG. 6 shown;

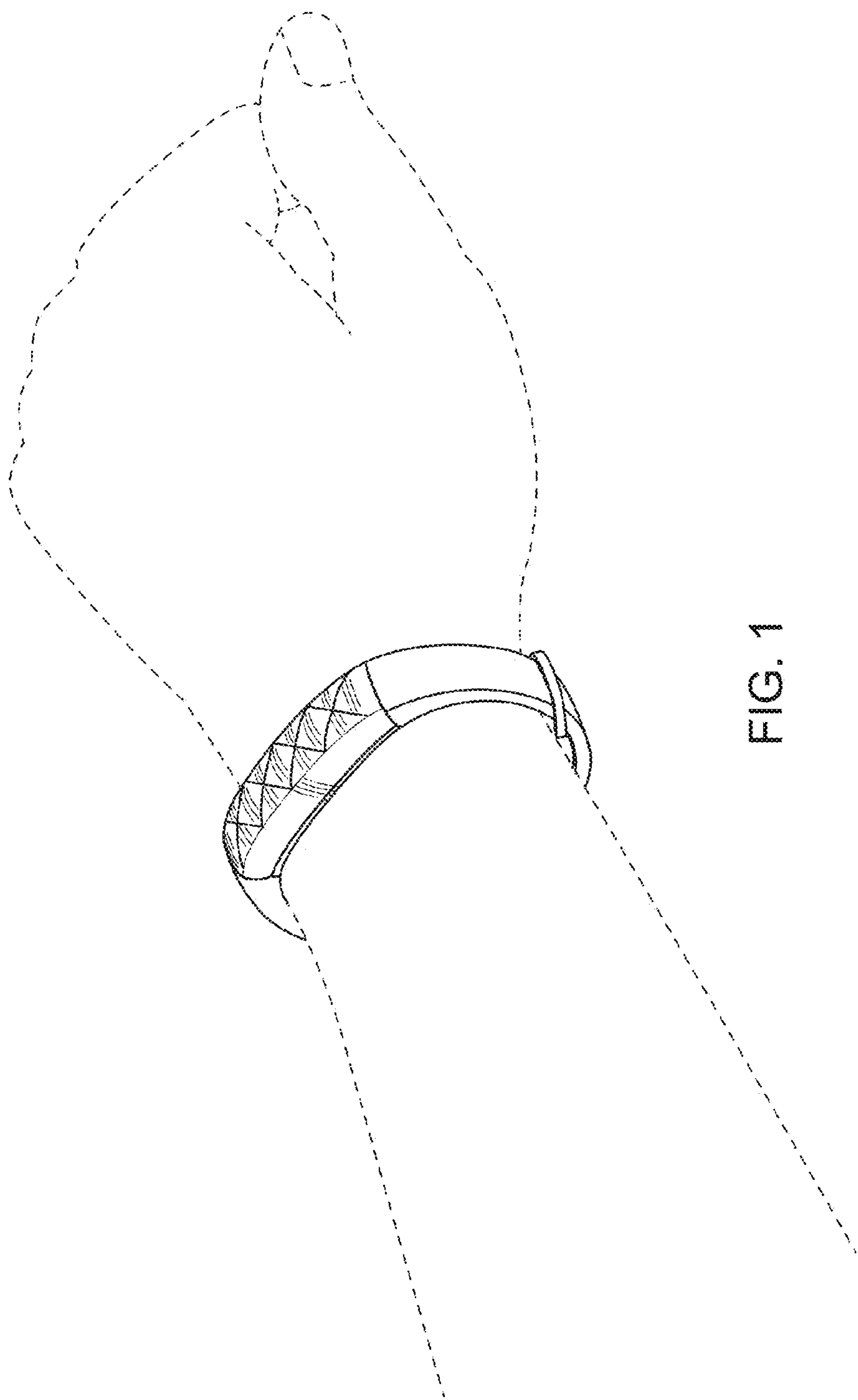

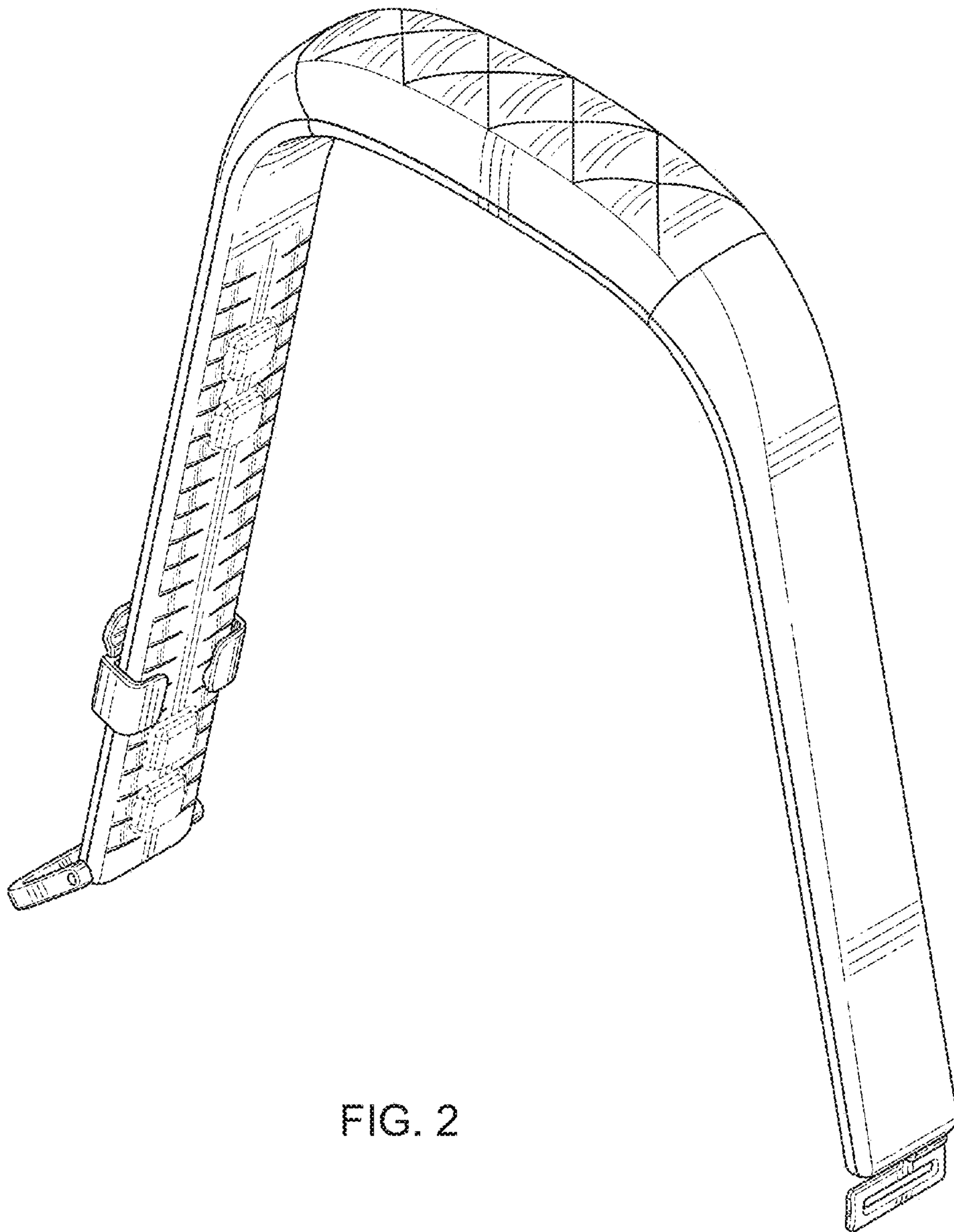

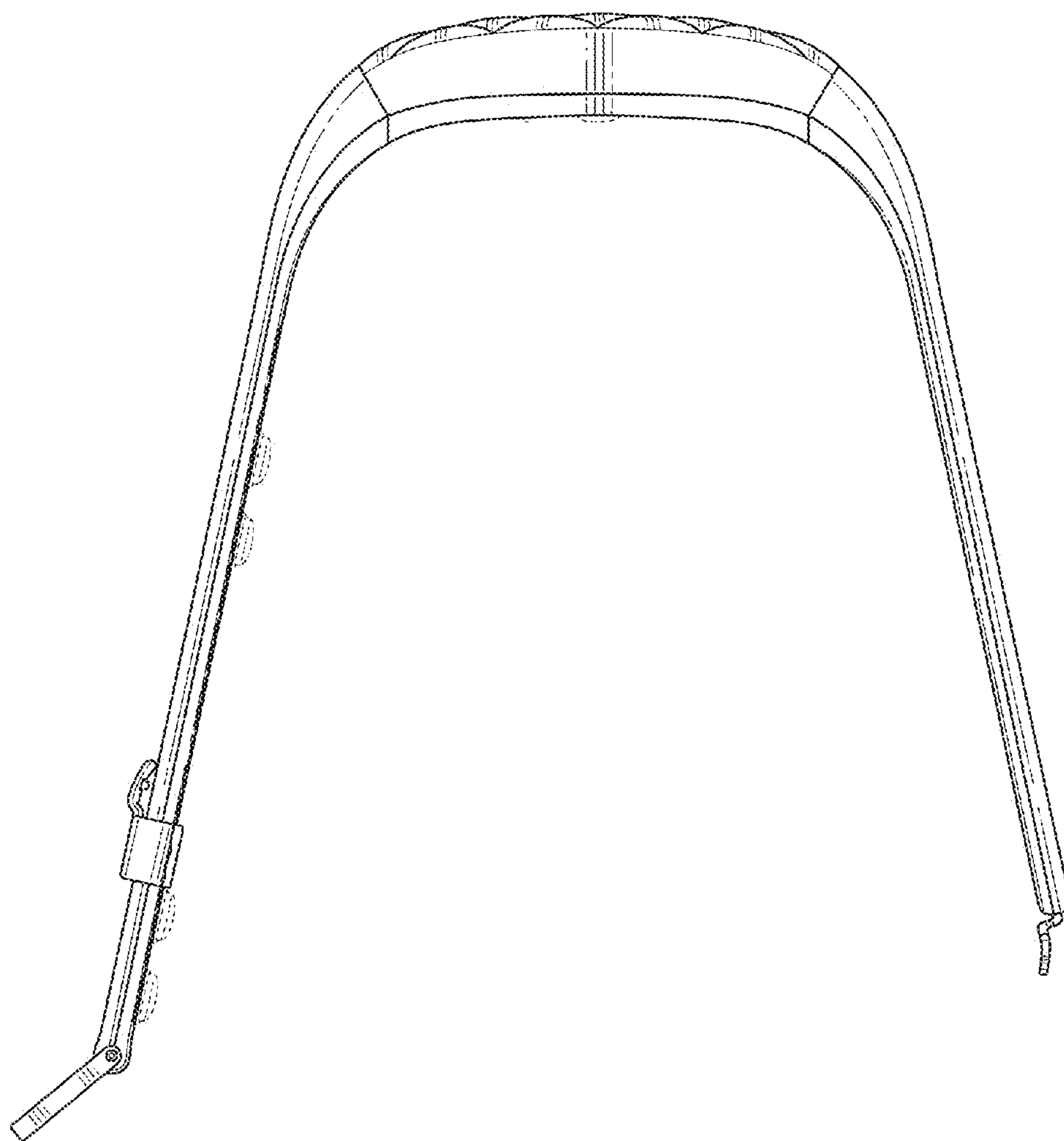

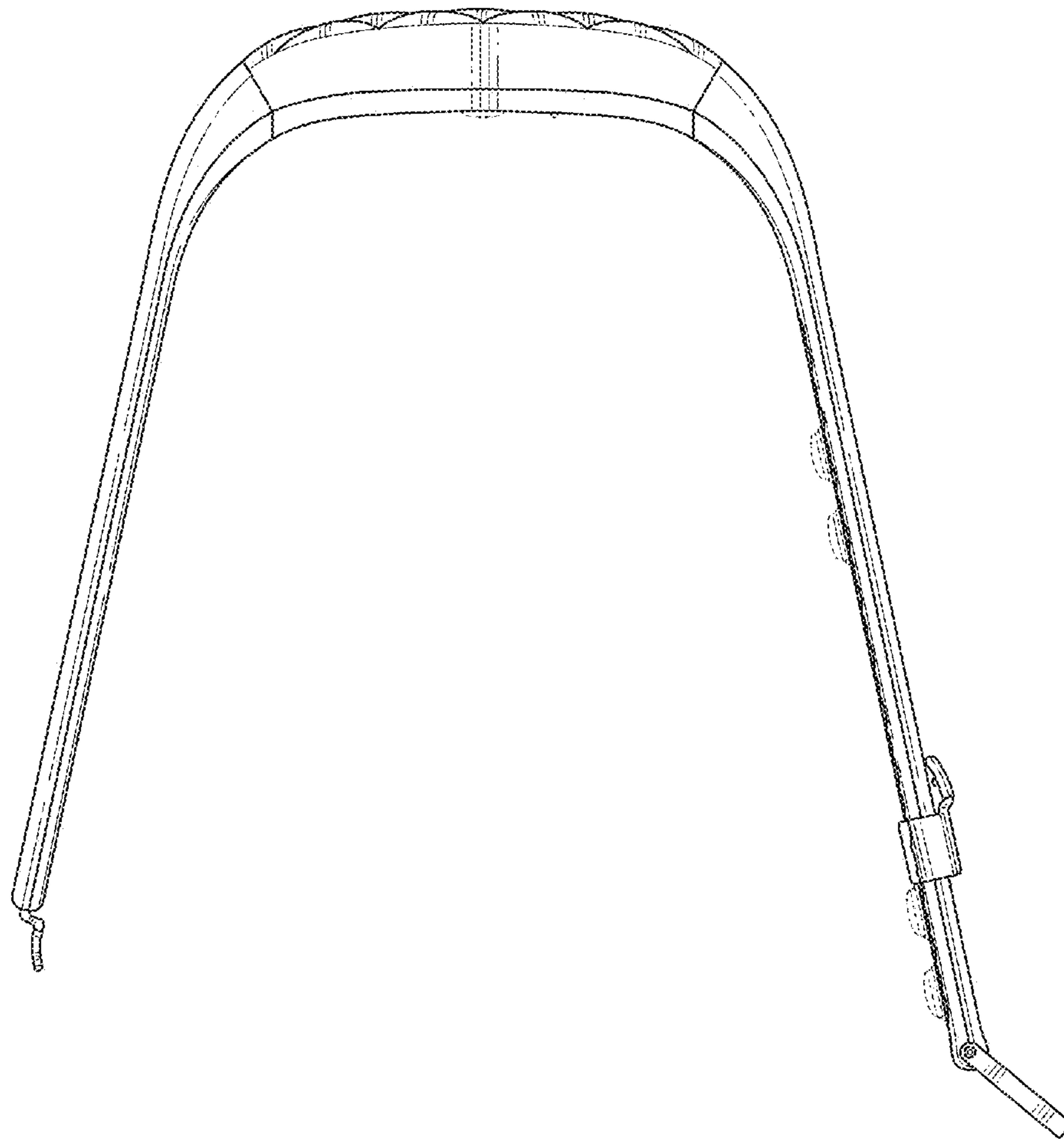

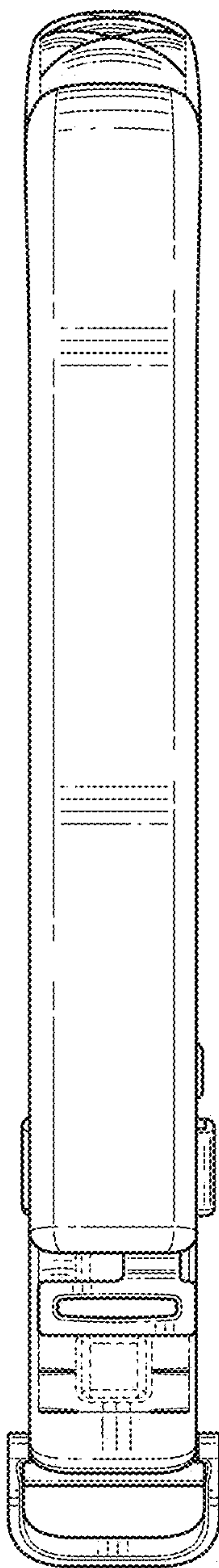

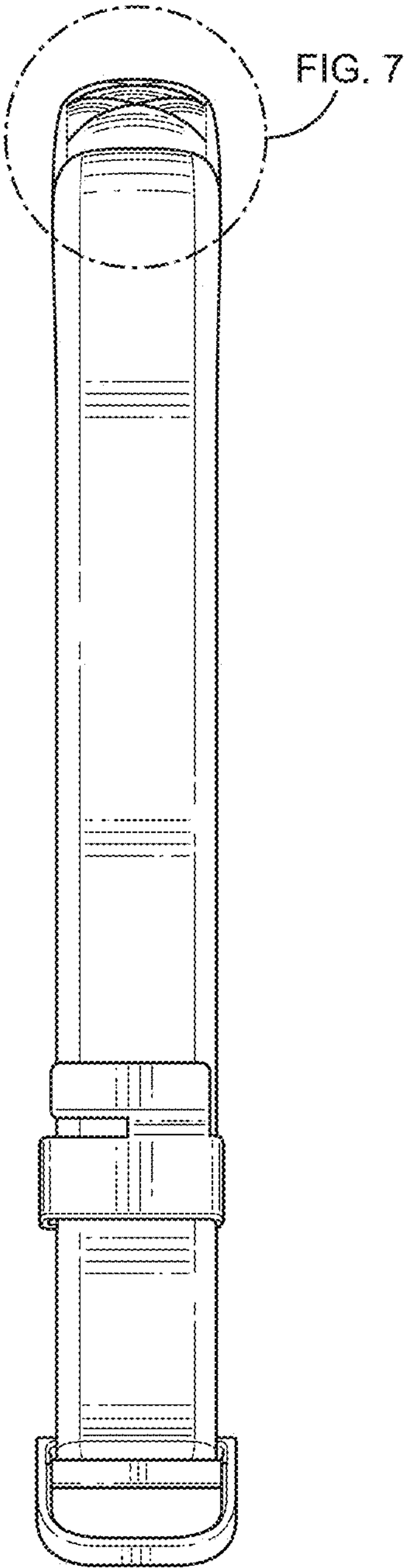

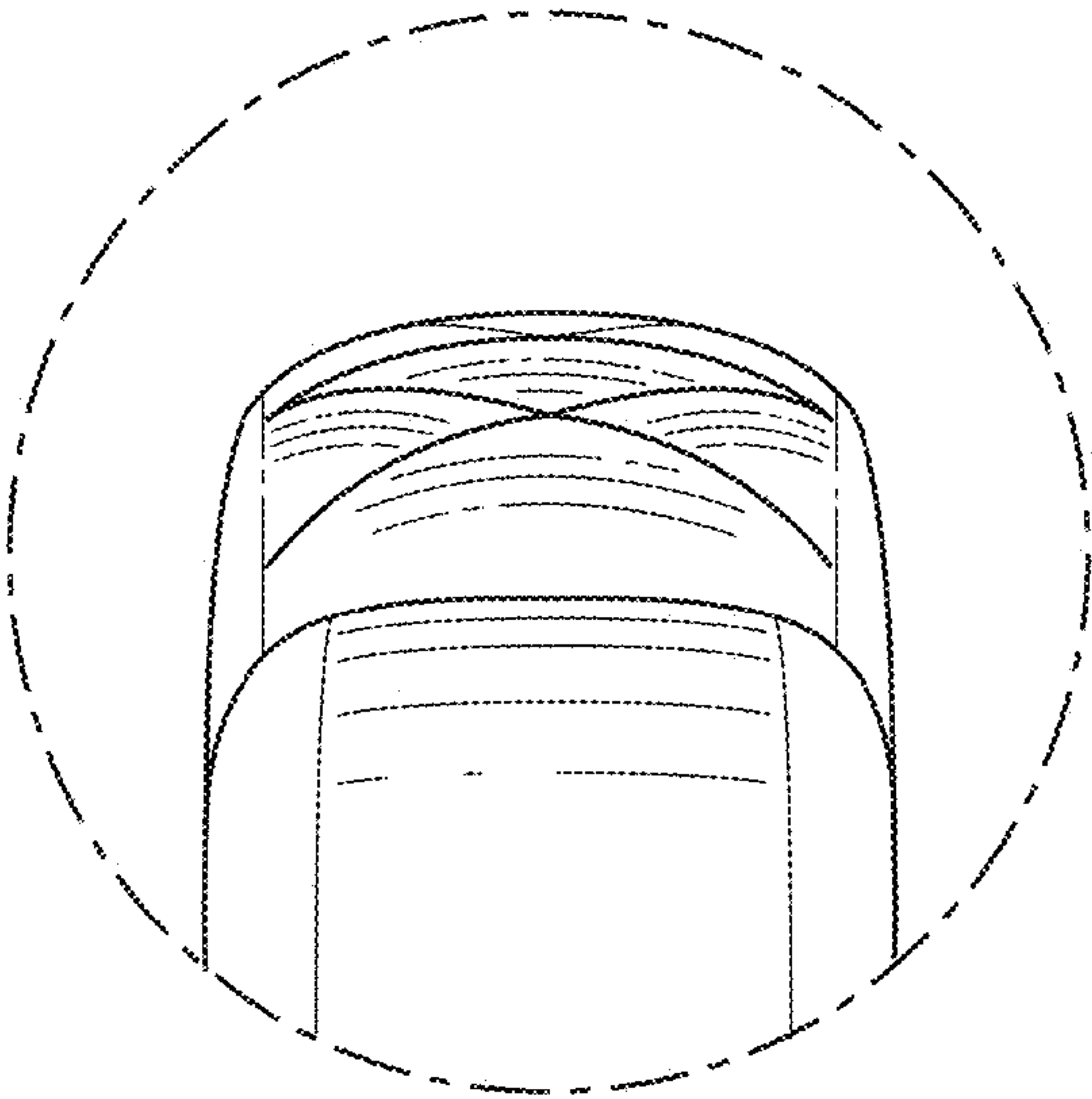

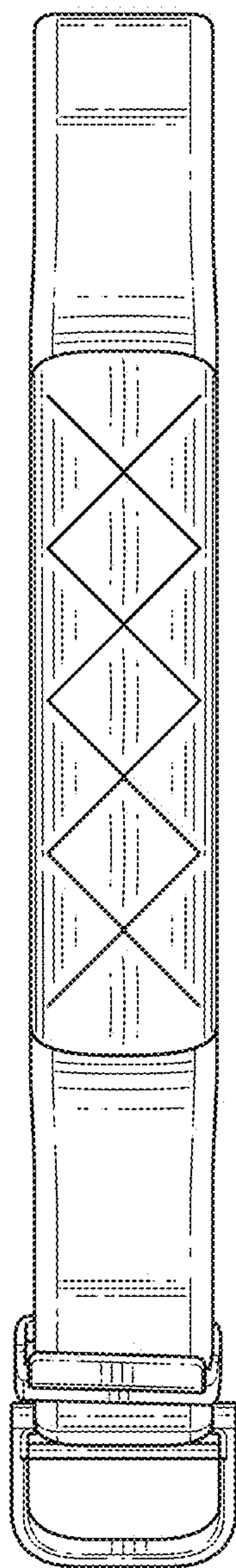

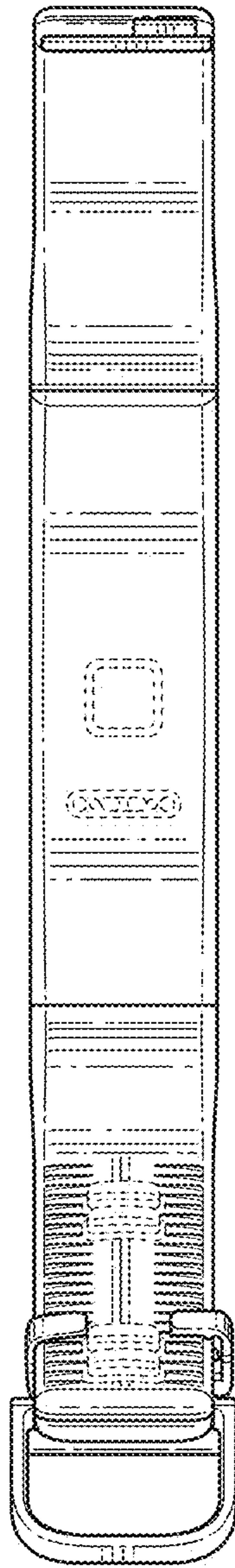
