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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an interior sleeve with end cap for
cleaning pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the interior sleeve with end cap
for cleaning pad;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the interior sleeve with end cap
for cleaning pad illustrated in FIG. 1 showing the placement
of the end cap;

FIG. 3 is an exploded perspective view of the interior sleeve
with end cap for cleaning pad illustrated in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the interior sleeve with end cap for
cleaning pad illustrated in FIG. 1 with the bottom plan view
being a mirror image of the top plan view;

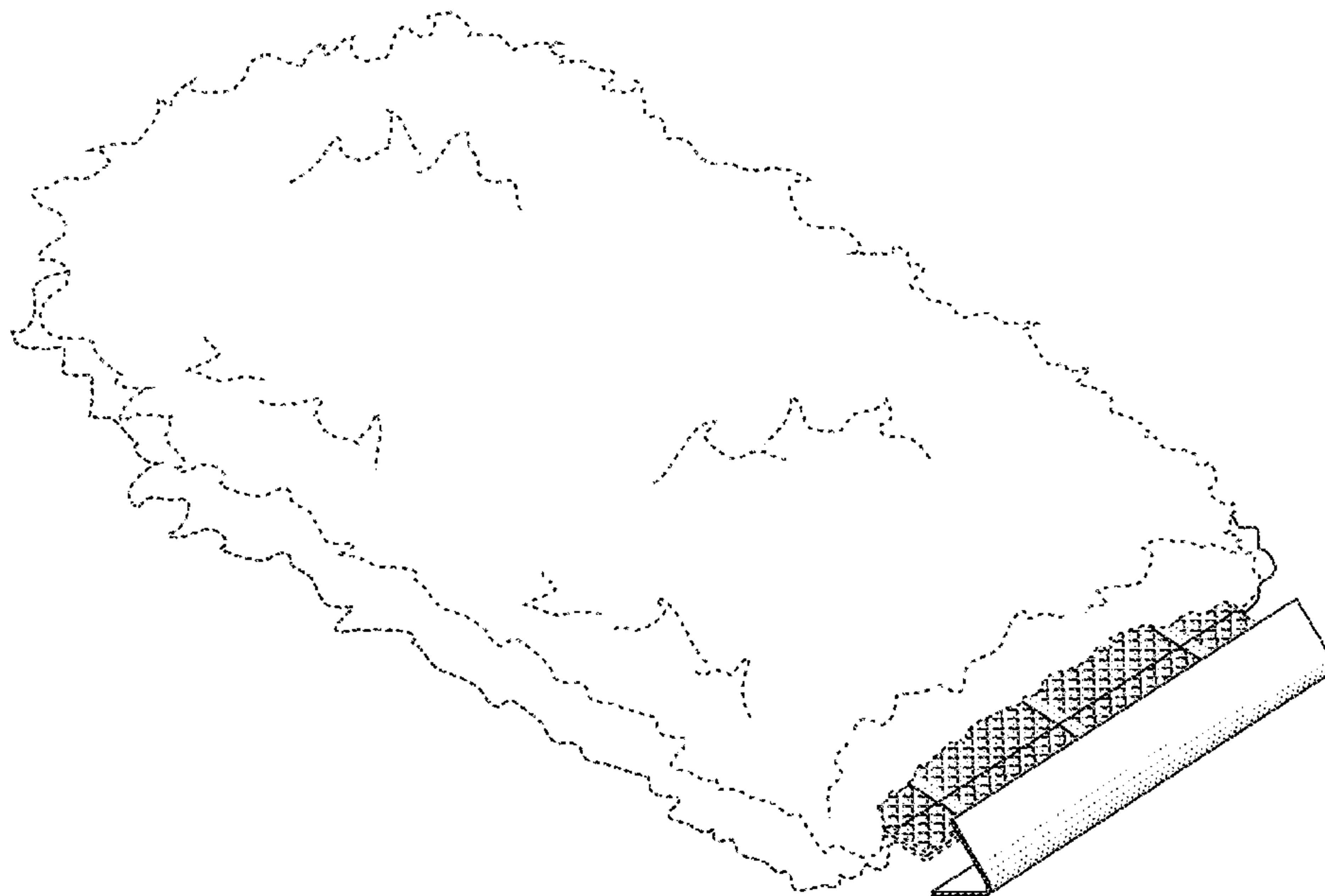
FIG. 5 is a first side view of the interior sleeve with end cap for
cleaning pad illustrated in FIG. 1, with the second side view
being a mirror image of the first side view;

FIG. 6 is a front end elevation view of the interior sleeve with
end cap for cleaning pad illustrated in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a back end elevation view of the interior sleeve with
end cap for cleaning pad illustrated in FIG. 1.

The illustrated embodiment includes two sheets forming a
pocket with an opening on the front end for receiving a
portion of a handle and the opposing end including an end
cap. The two internal sheets are shaded to show they are of a
different color than the end cap. The broken lines illustrated in
figures form no part of the claim.

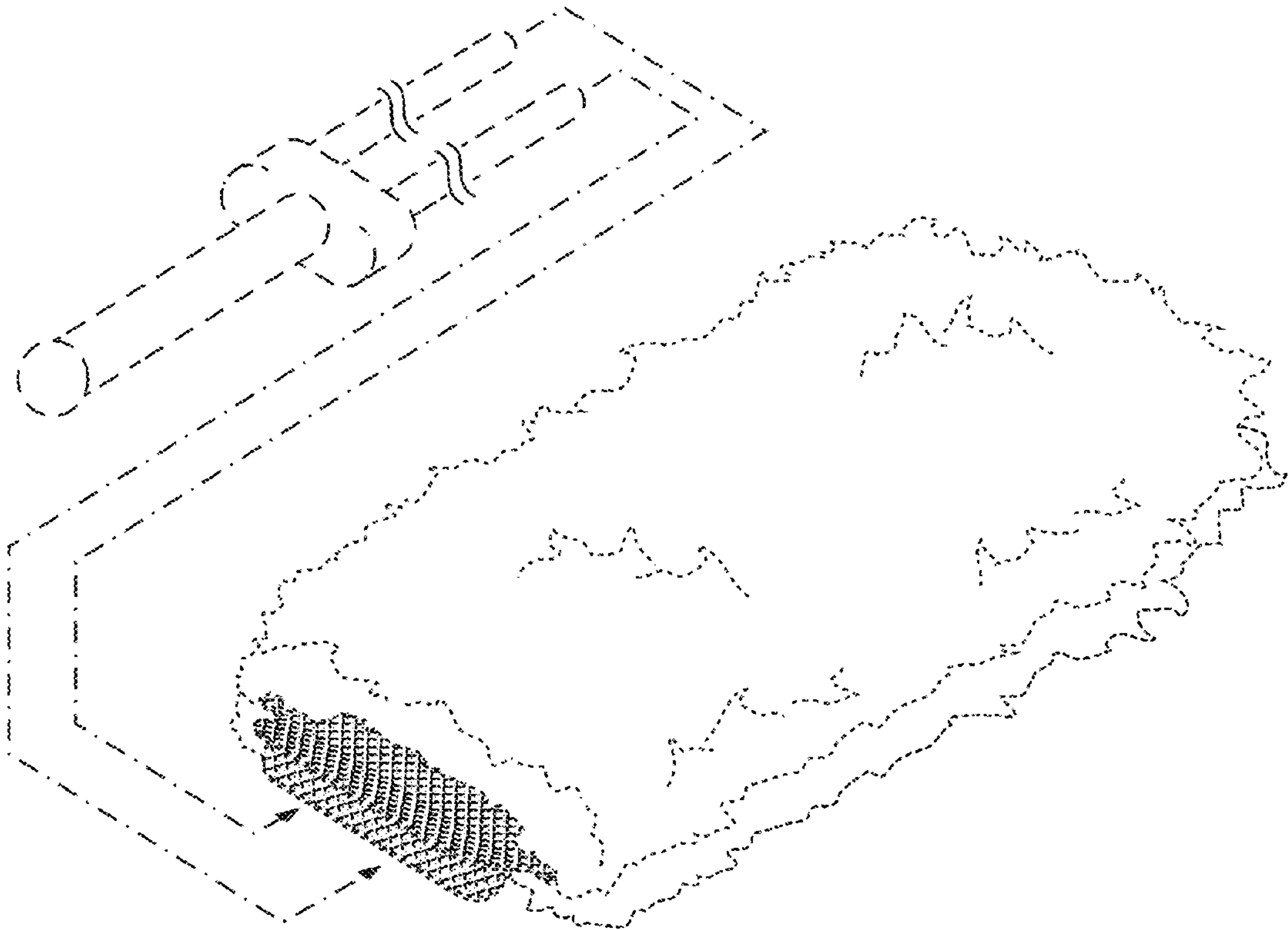

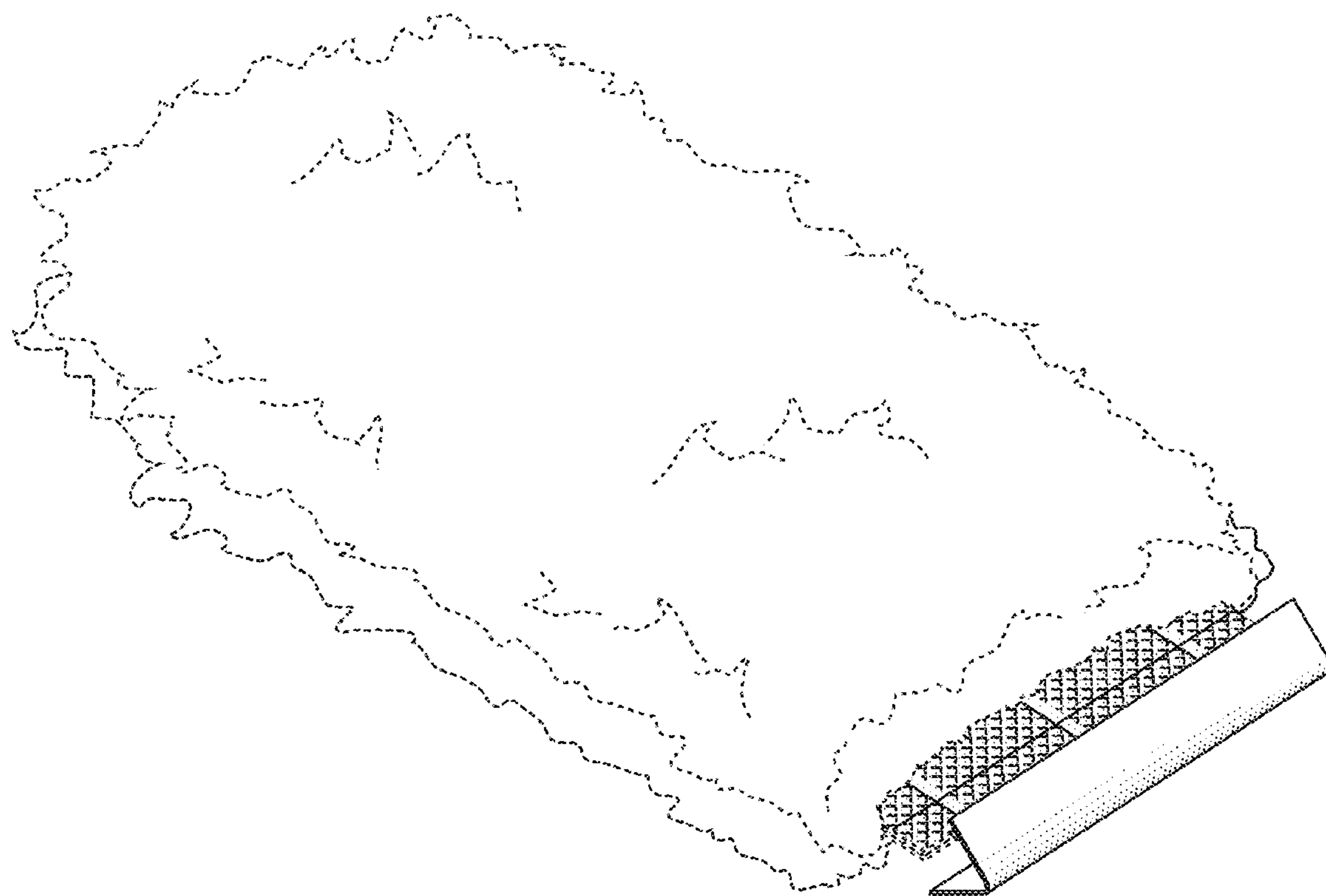

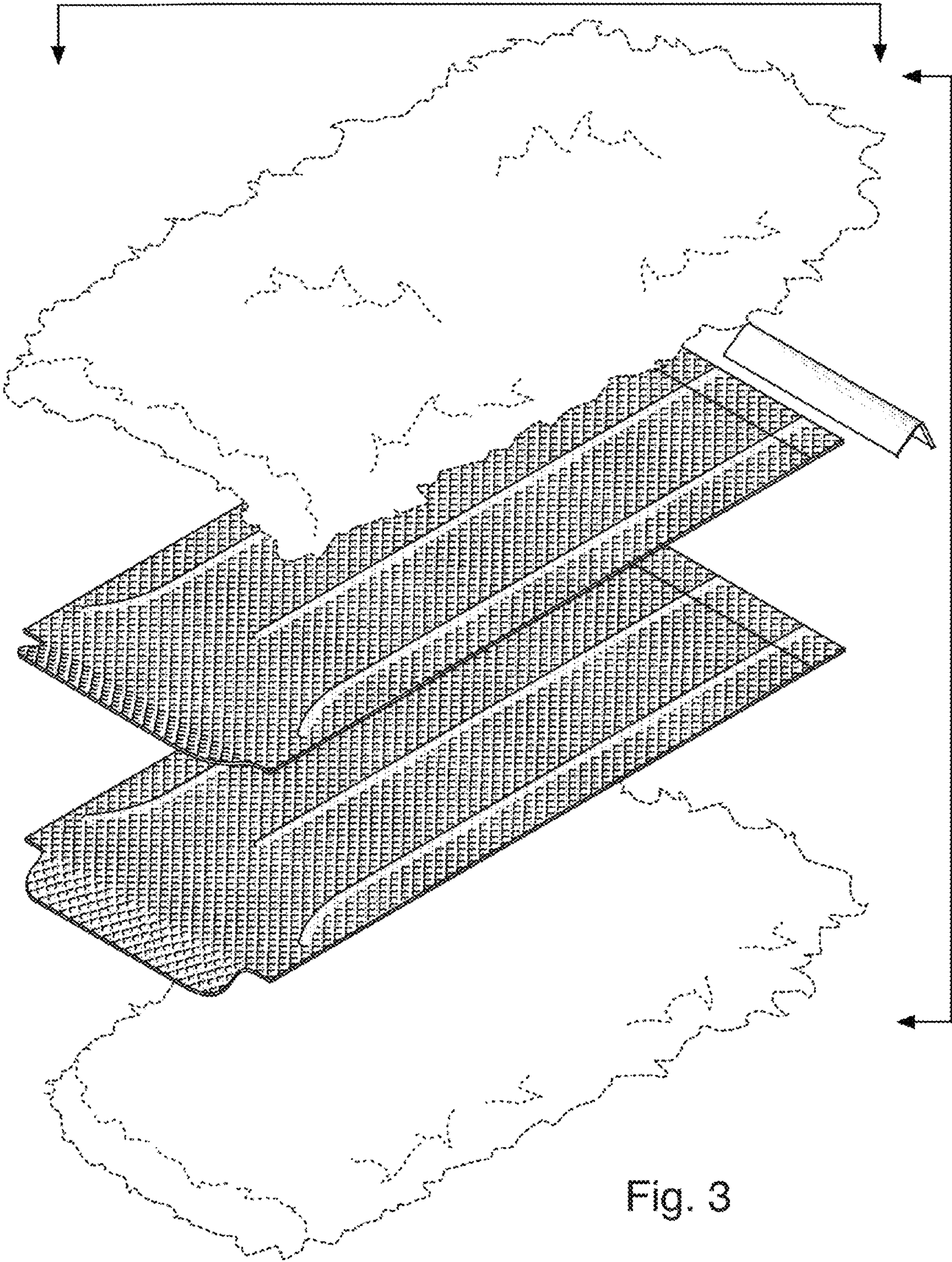

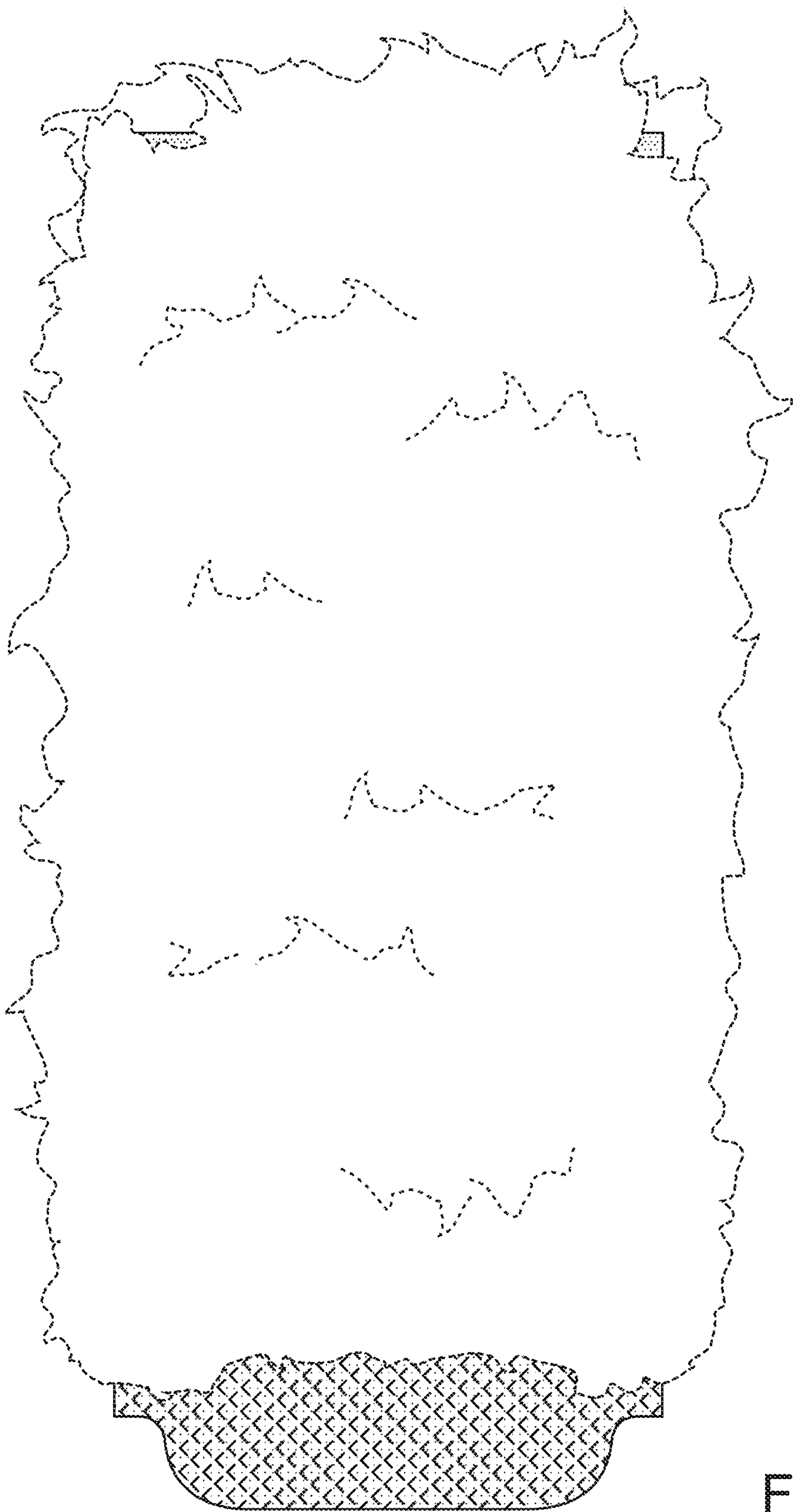

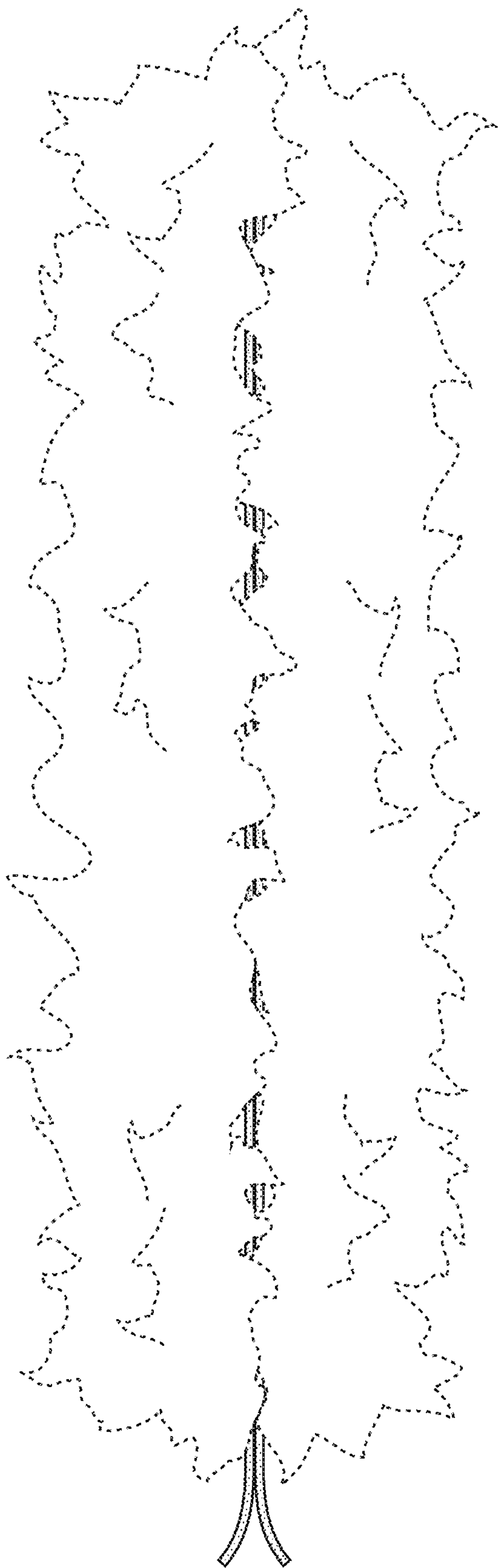

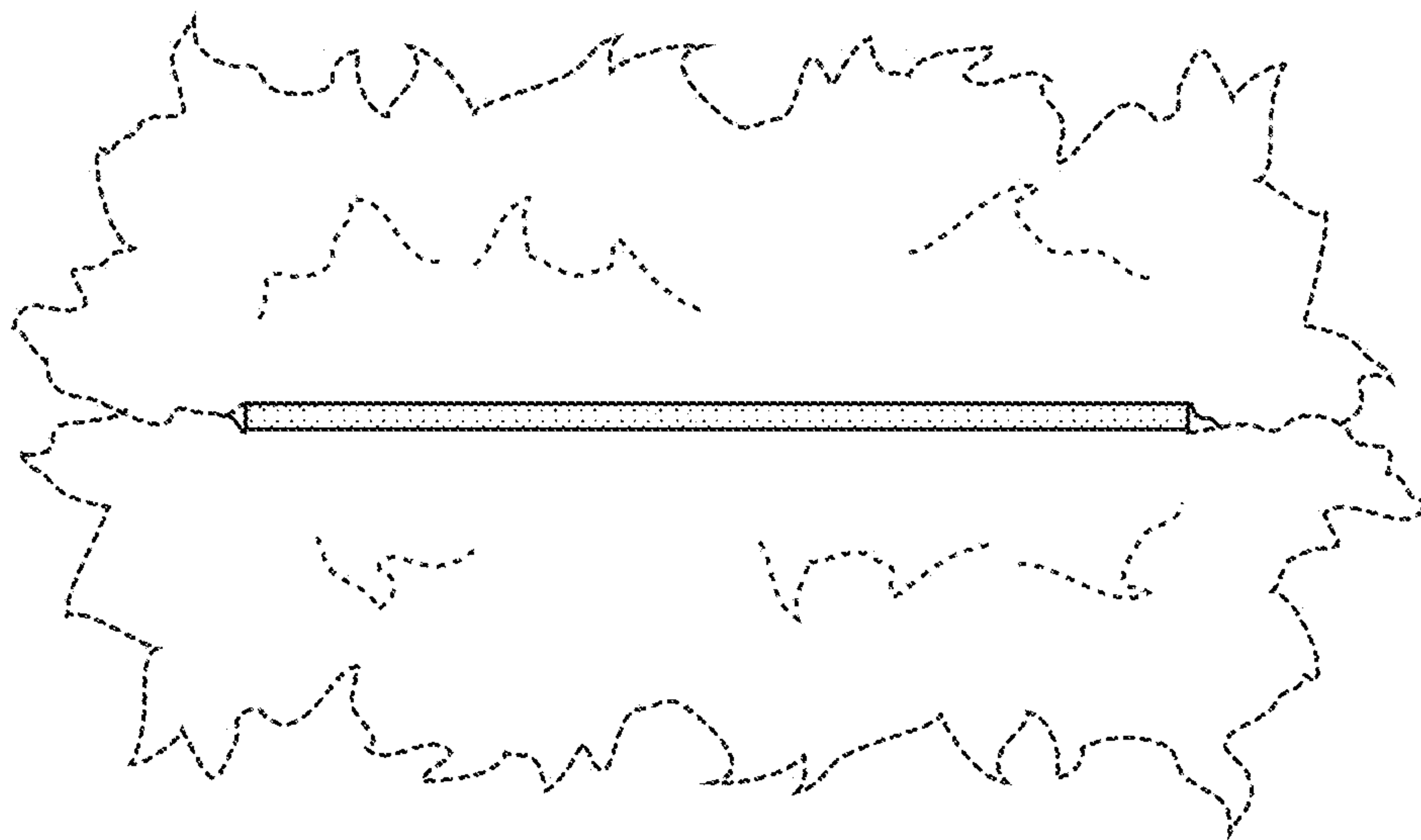

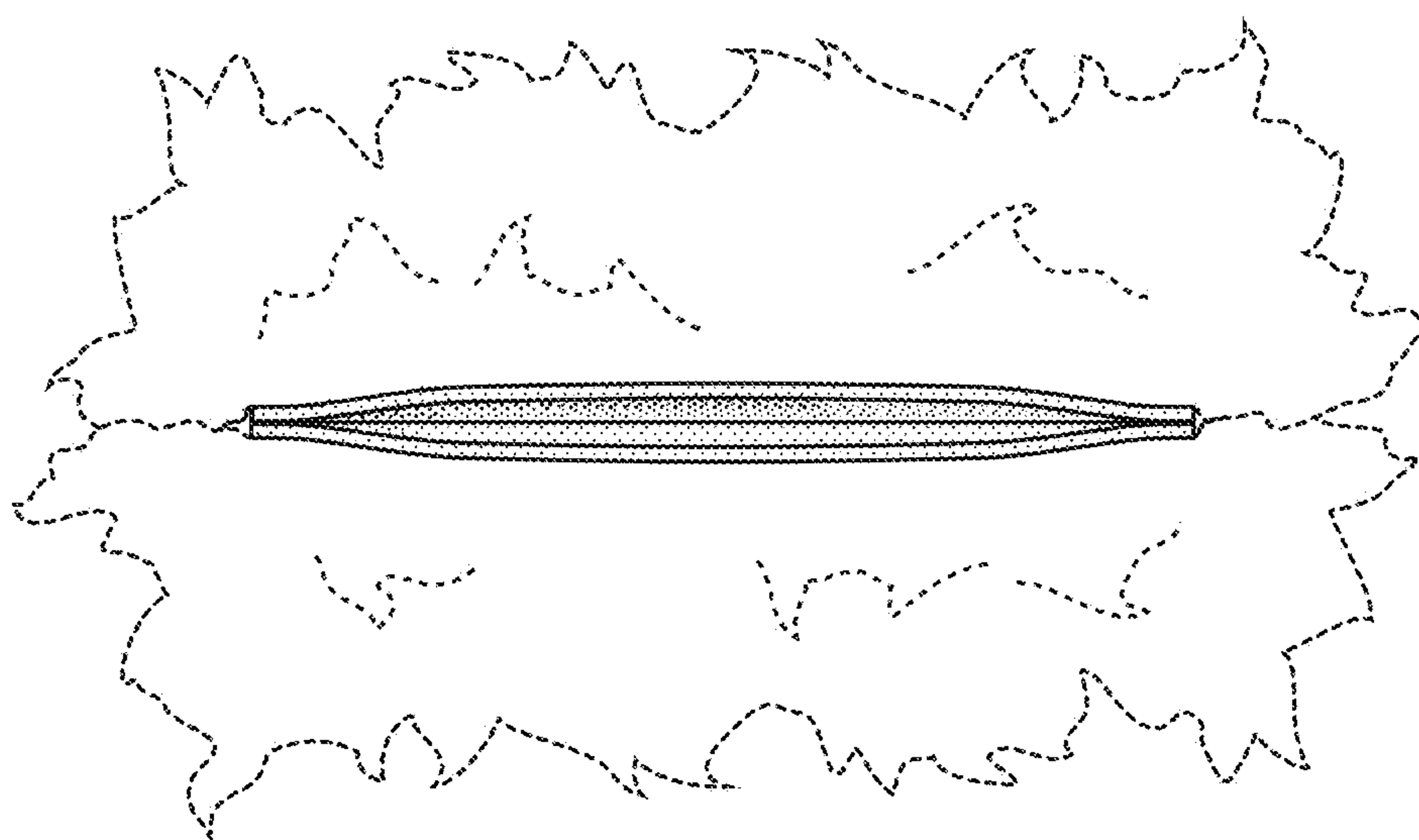
