FIG. 14 is a top plan view thereof;

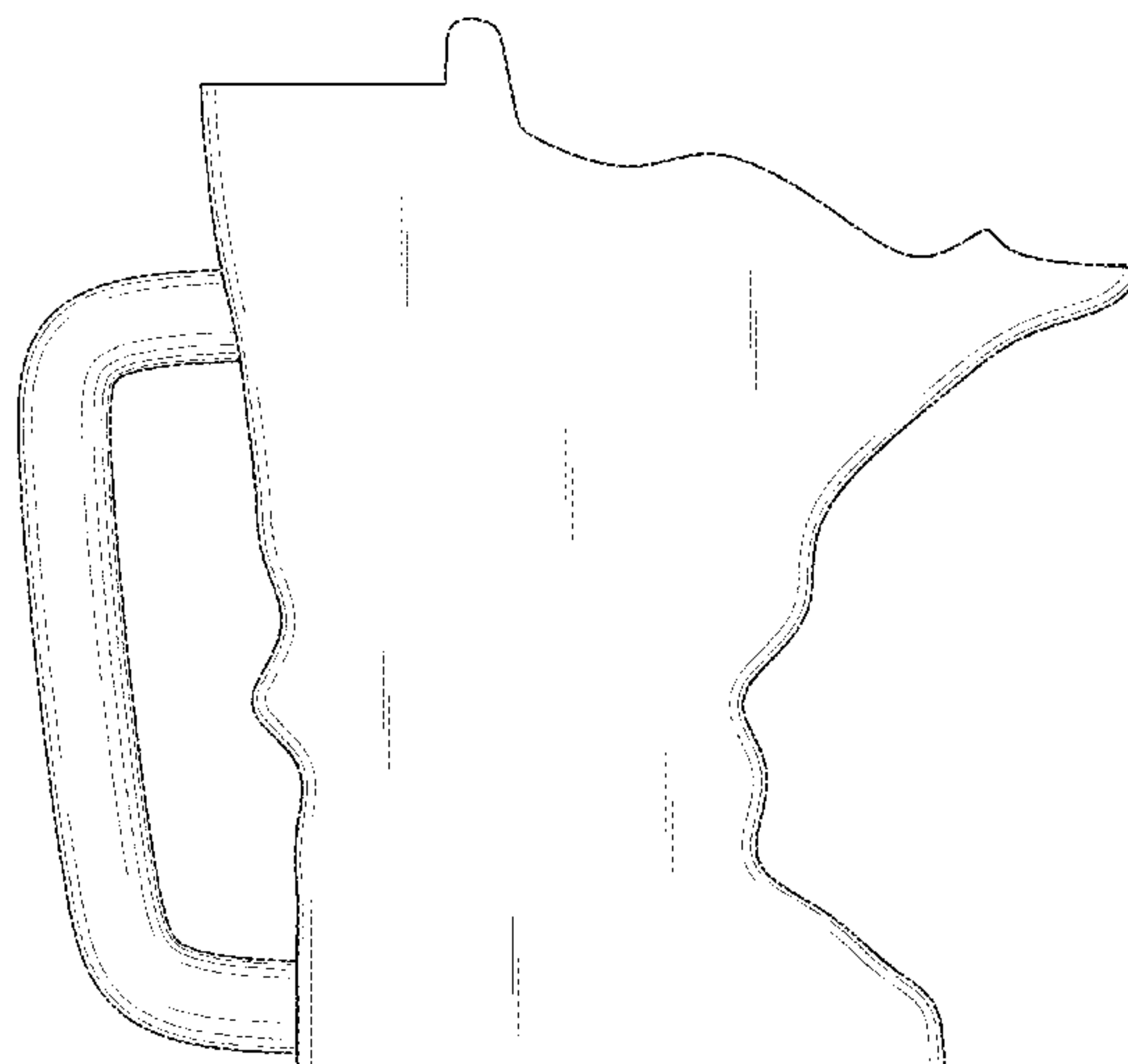
FIG. 15 is a perspective view of a fluid container showing a

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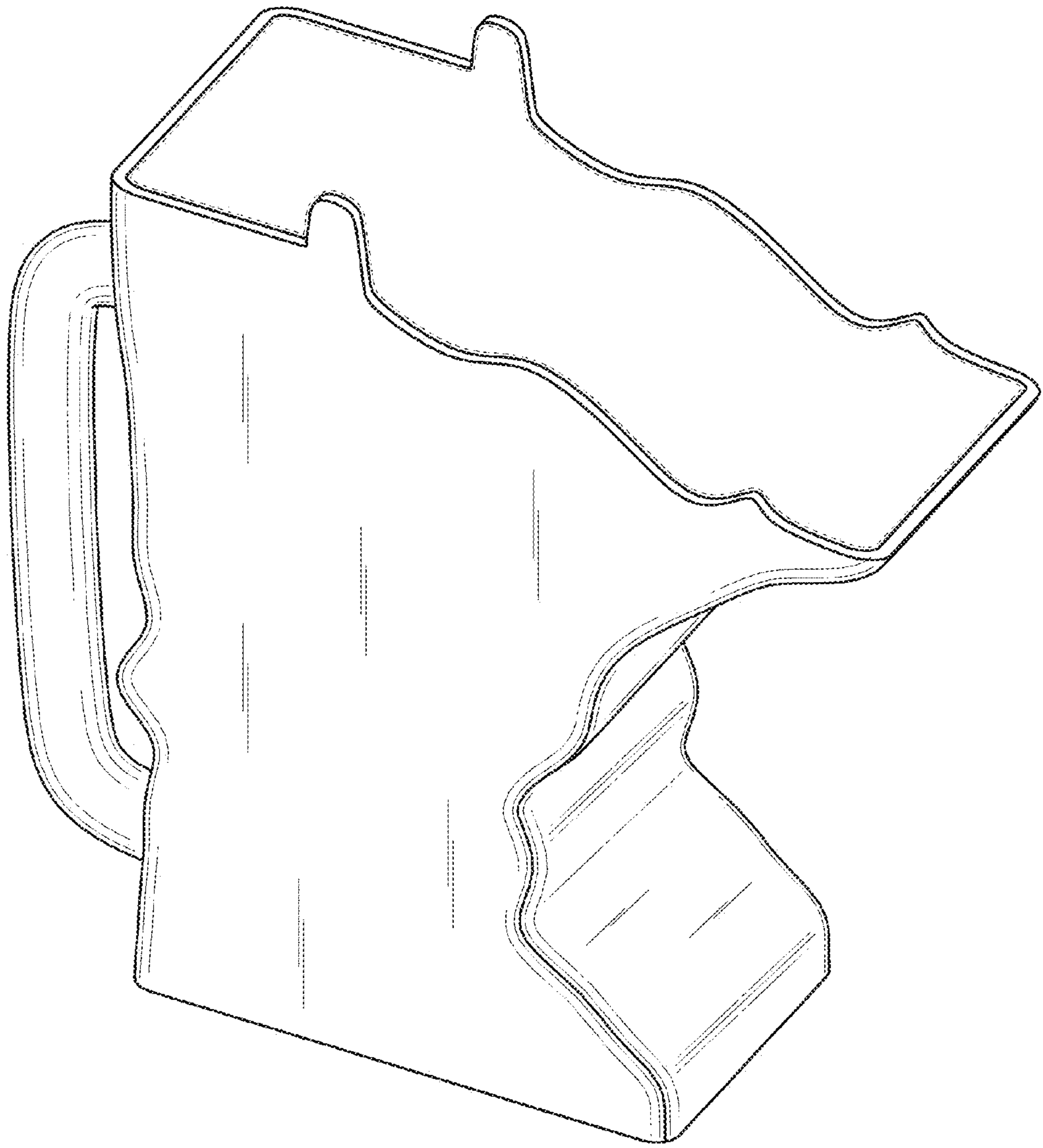

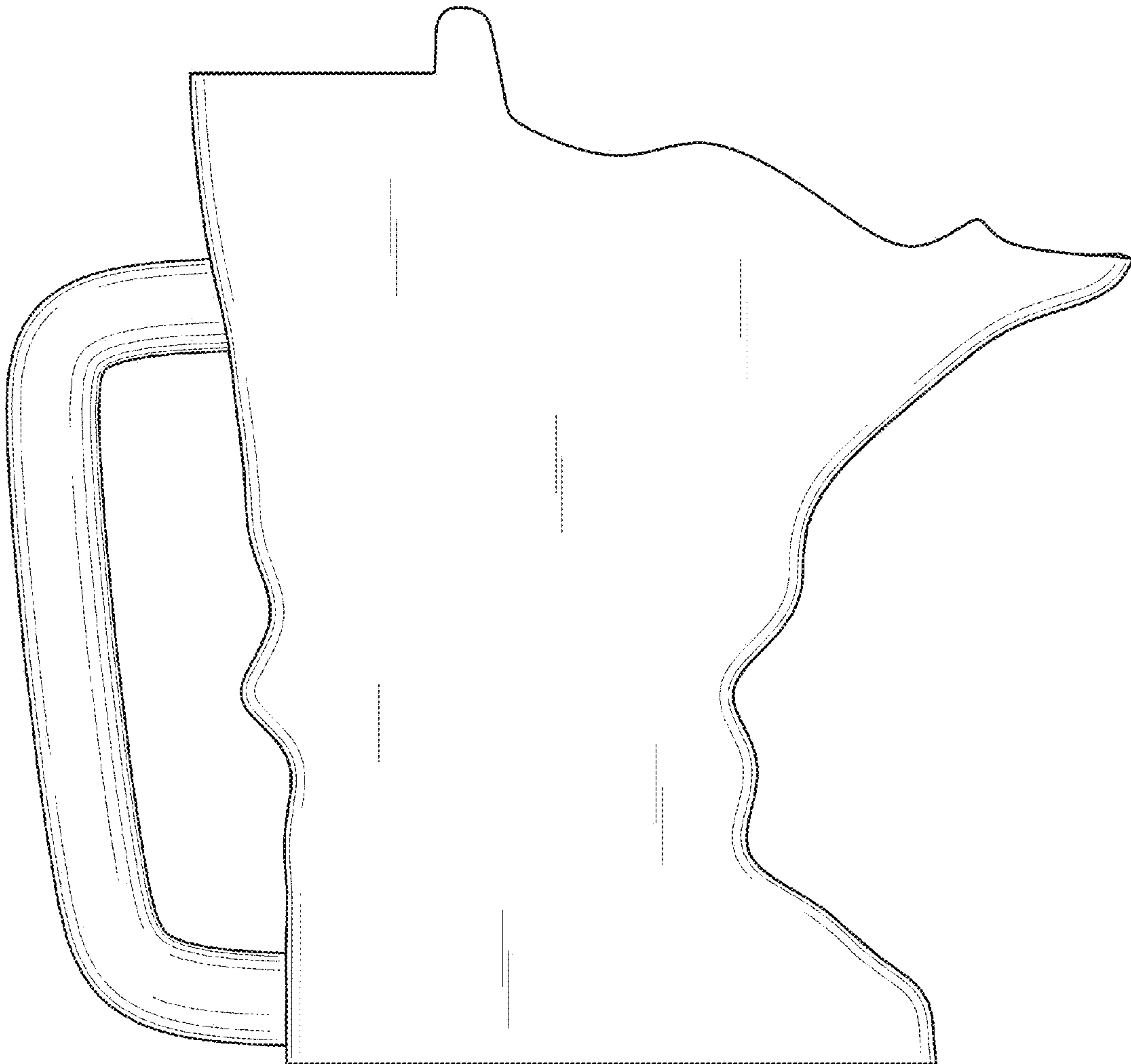

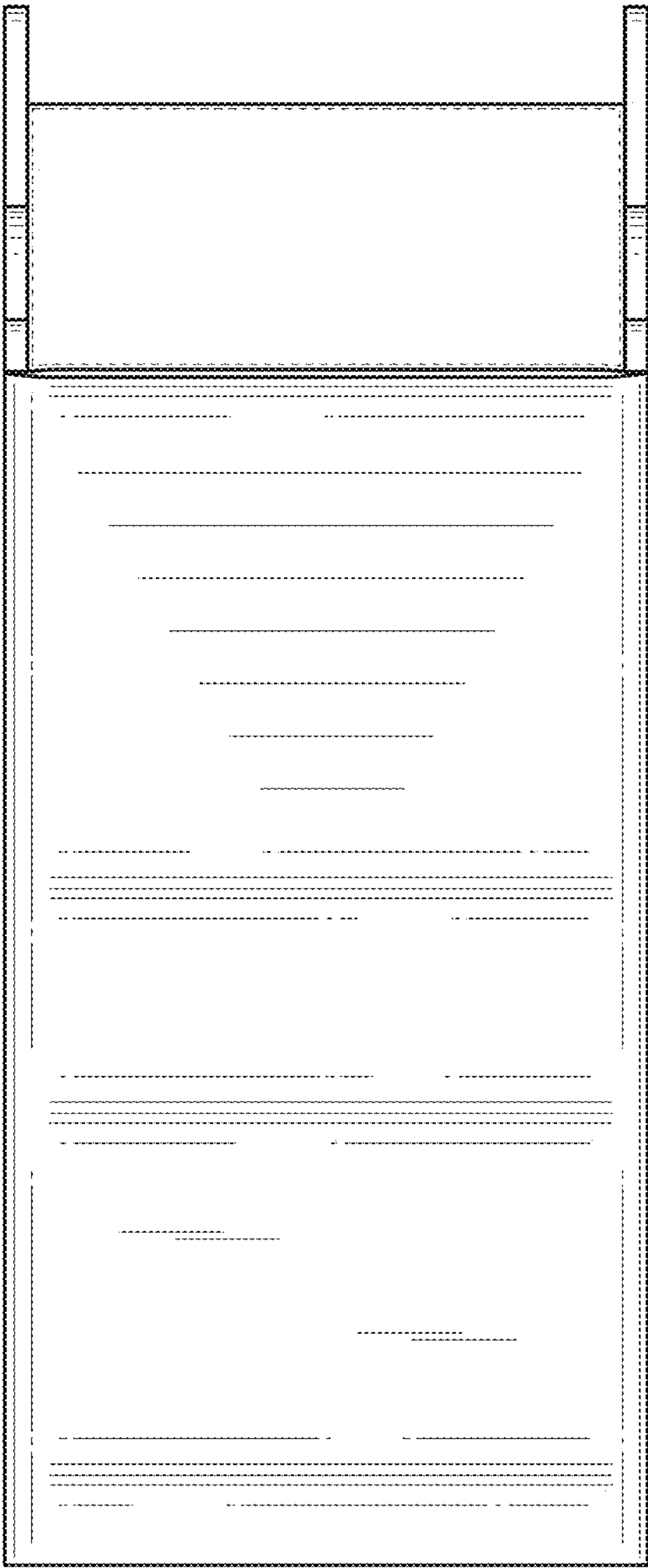

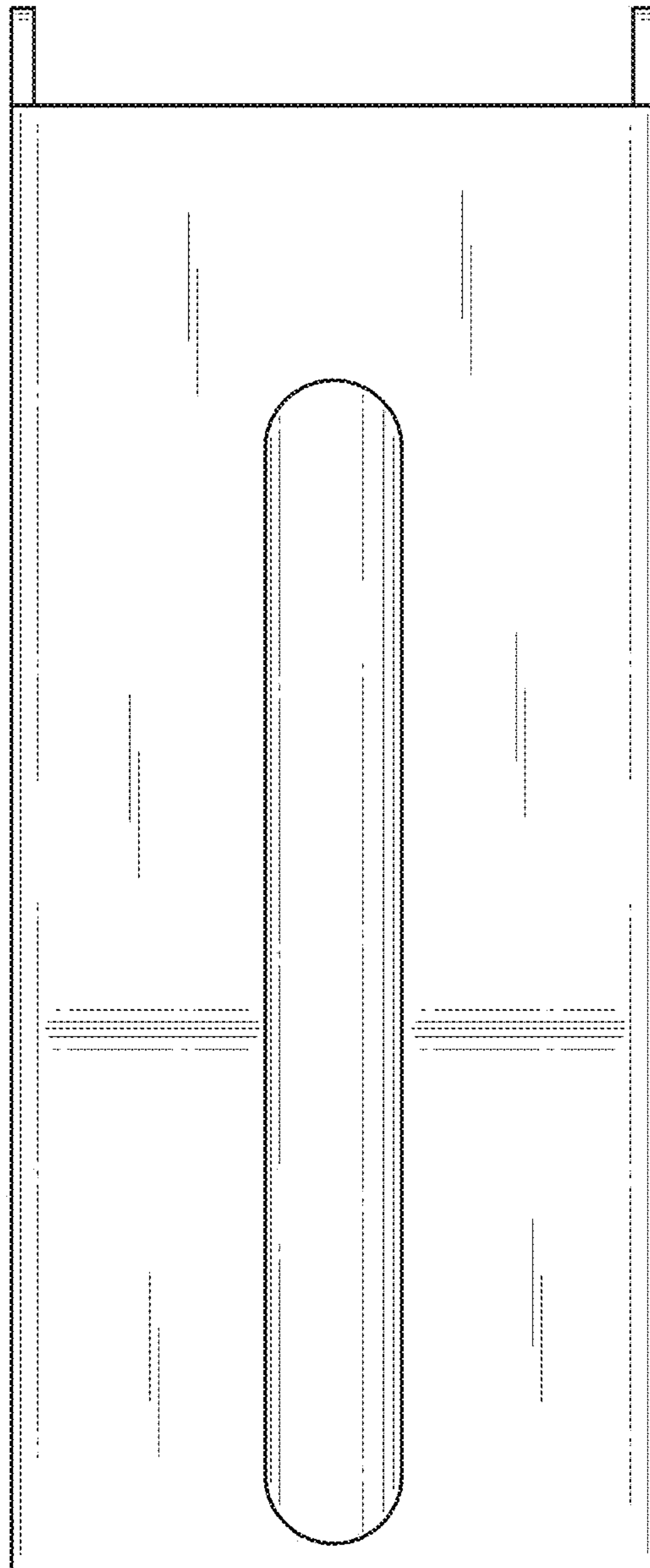

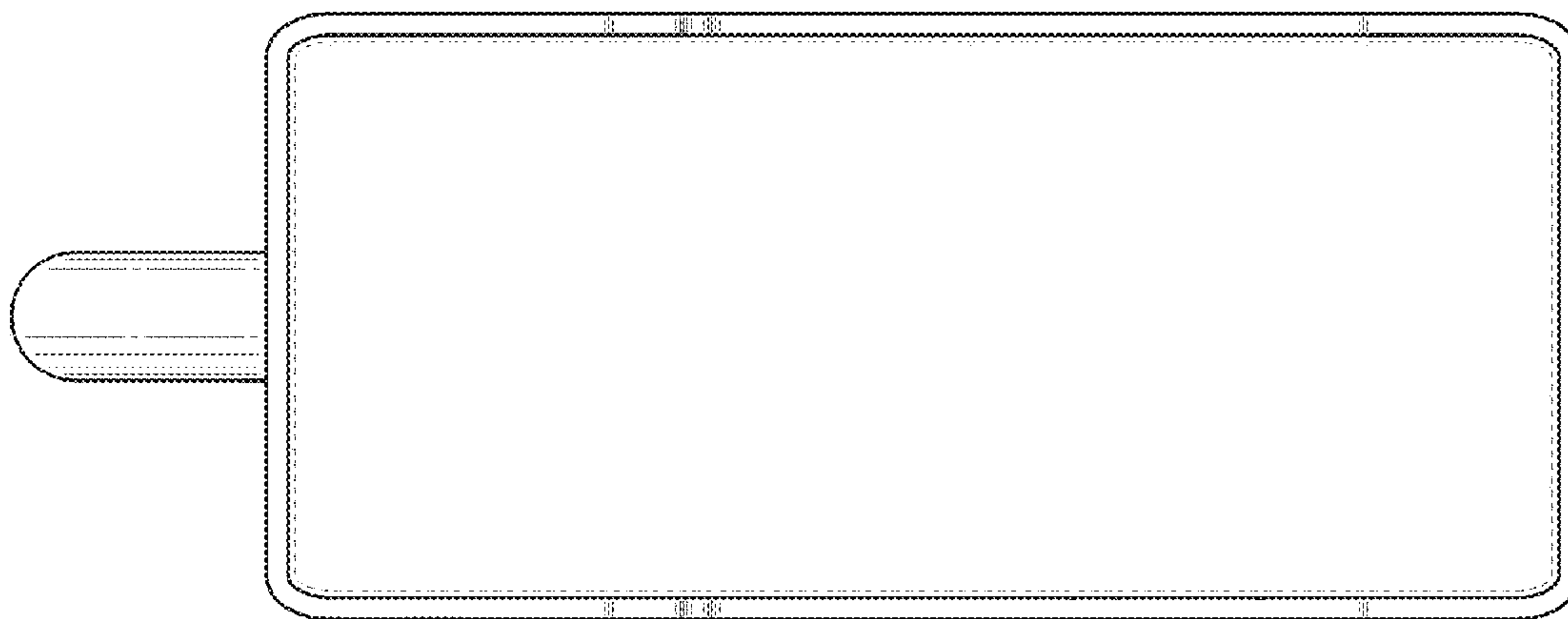

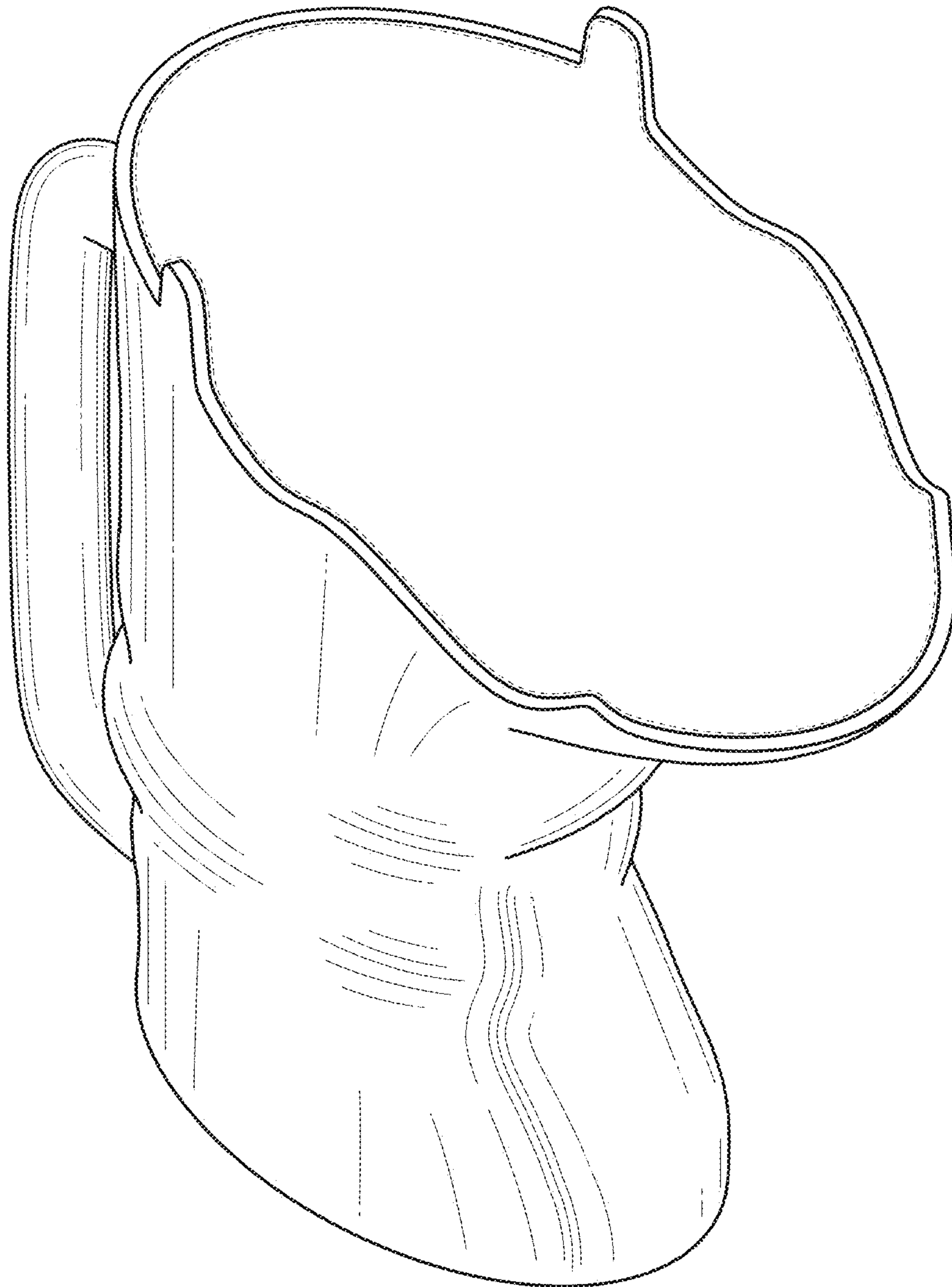

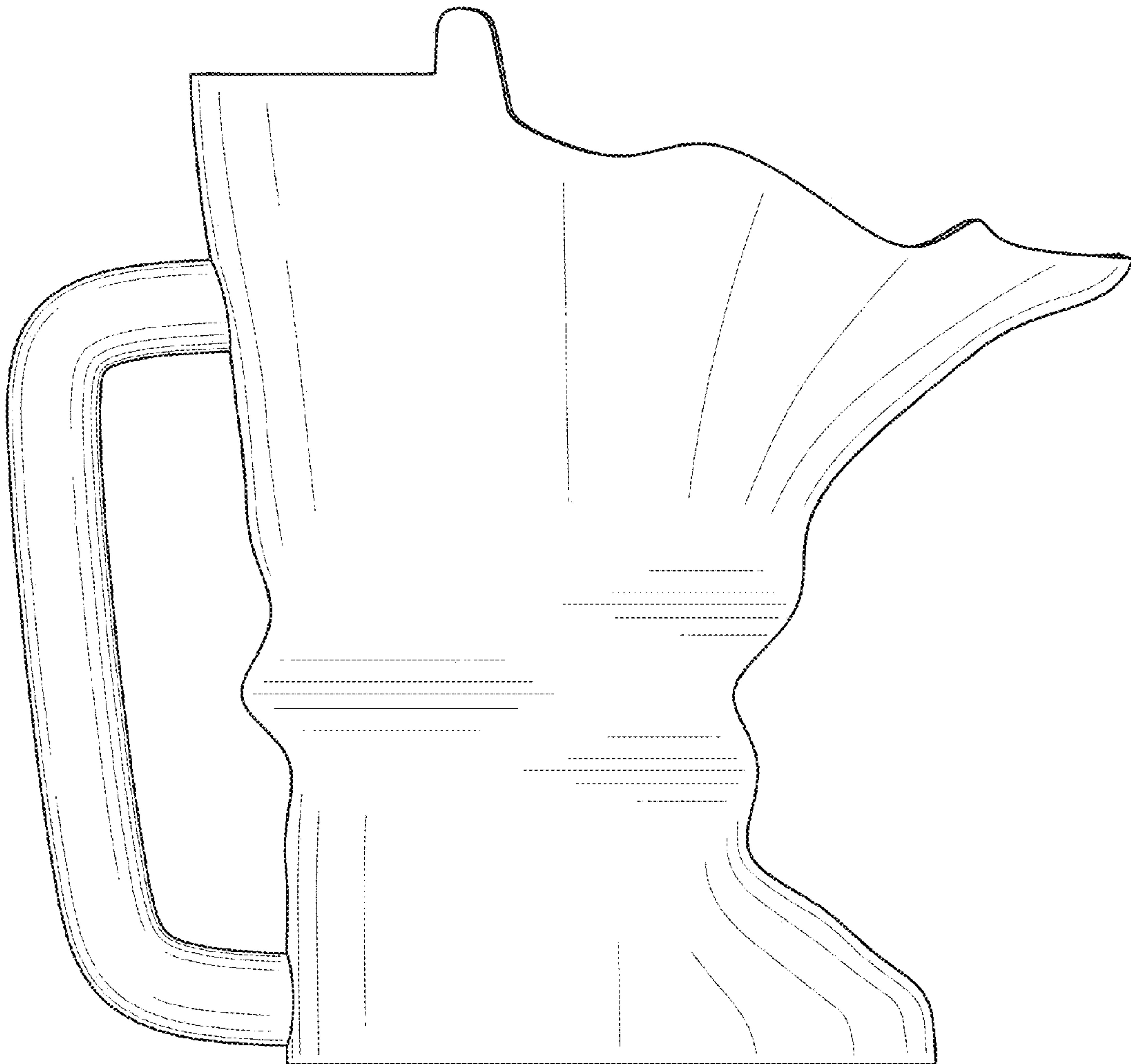

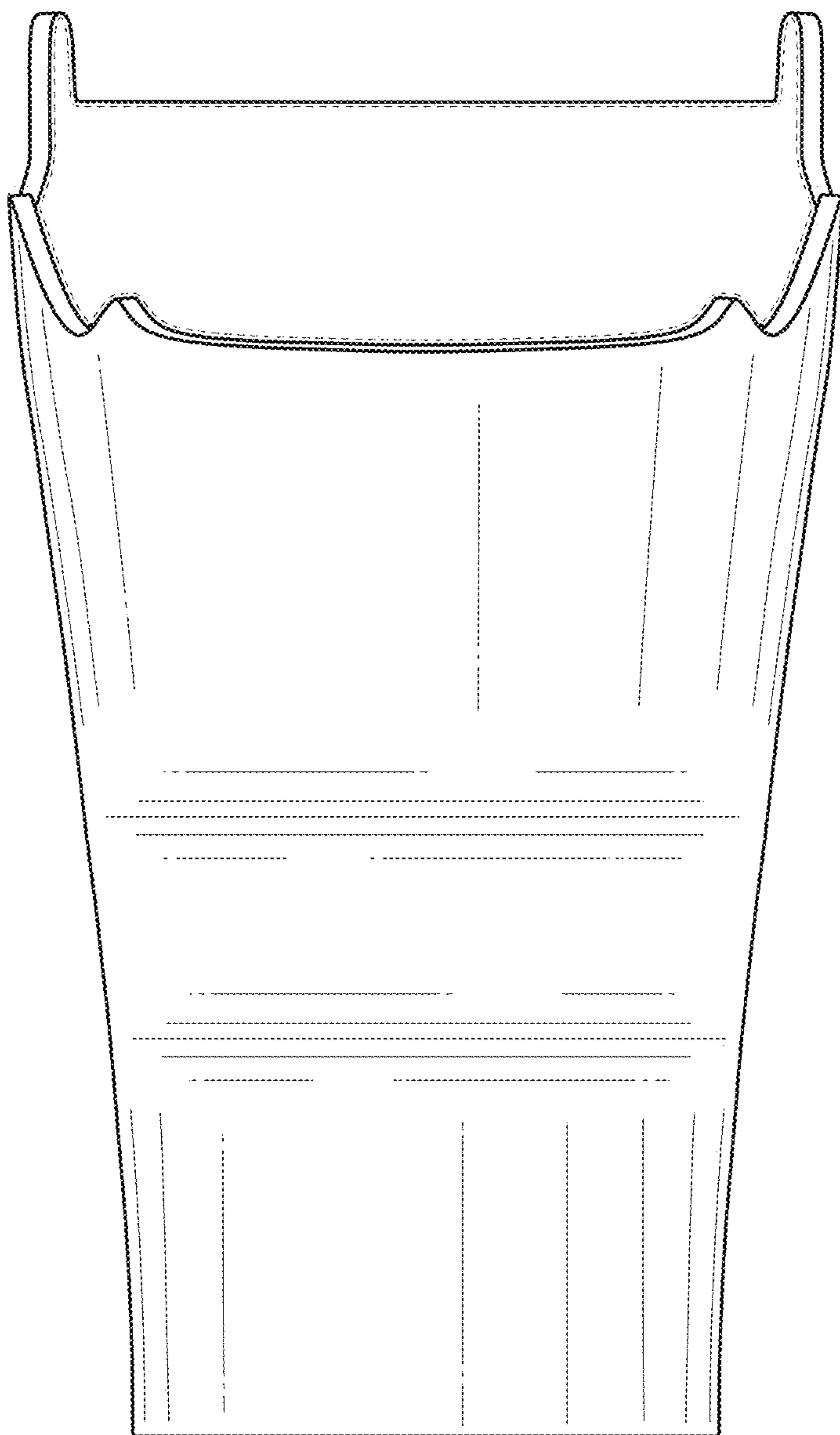

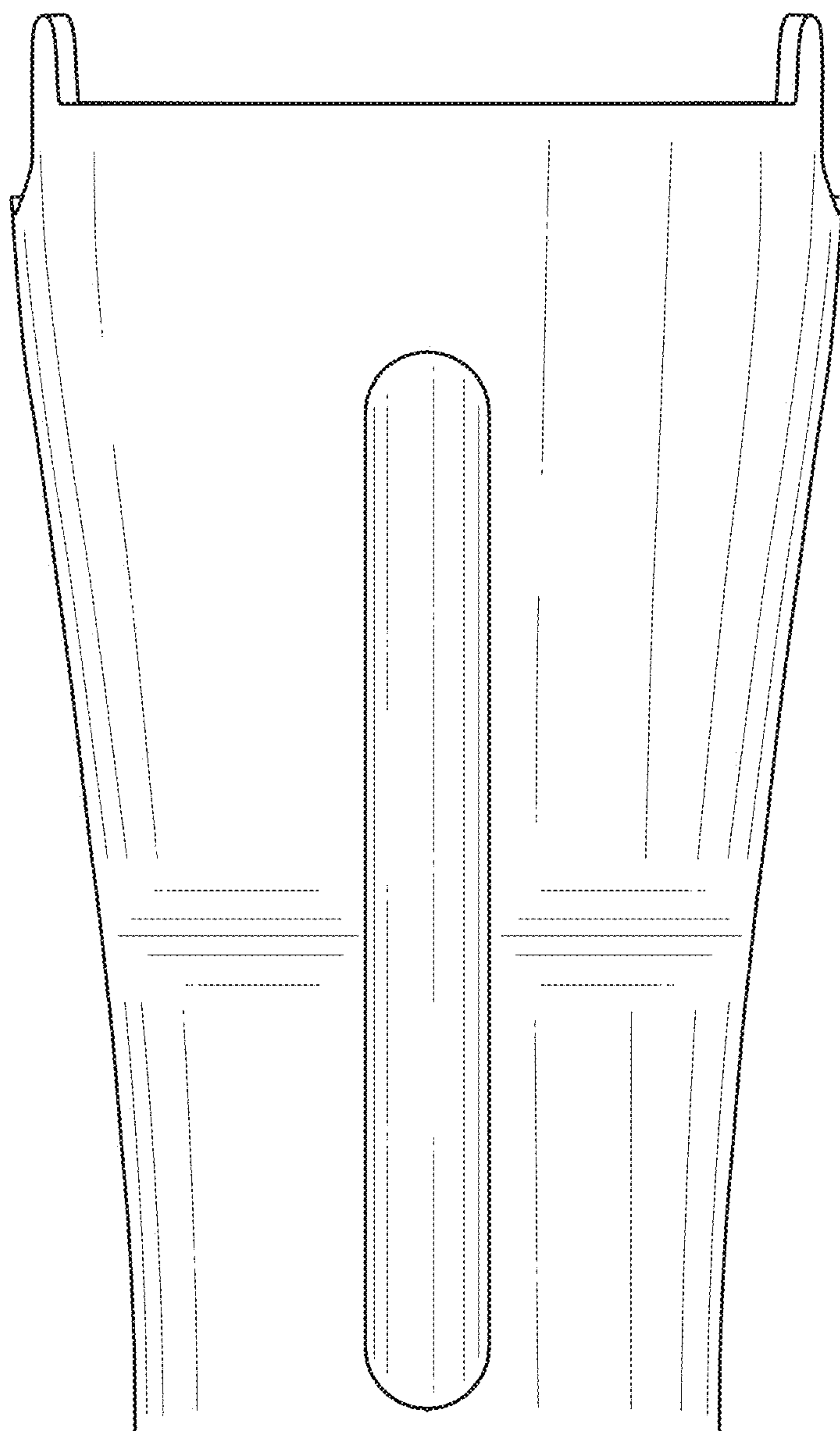

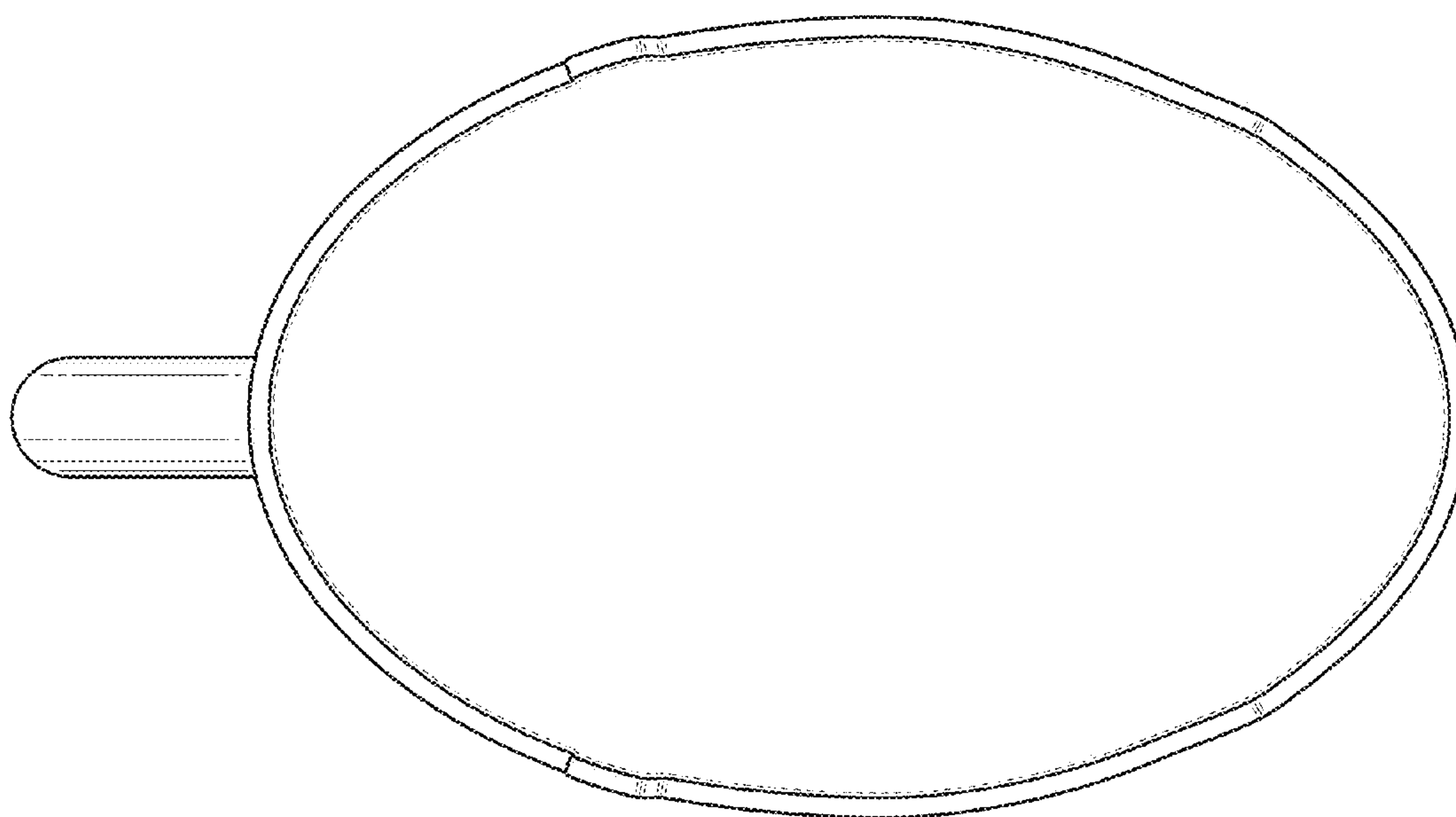

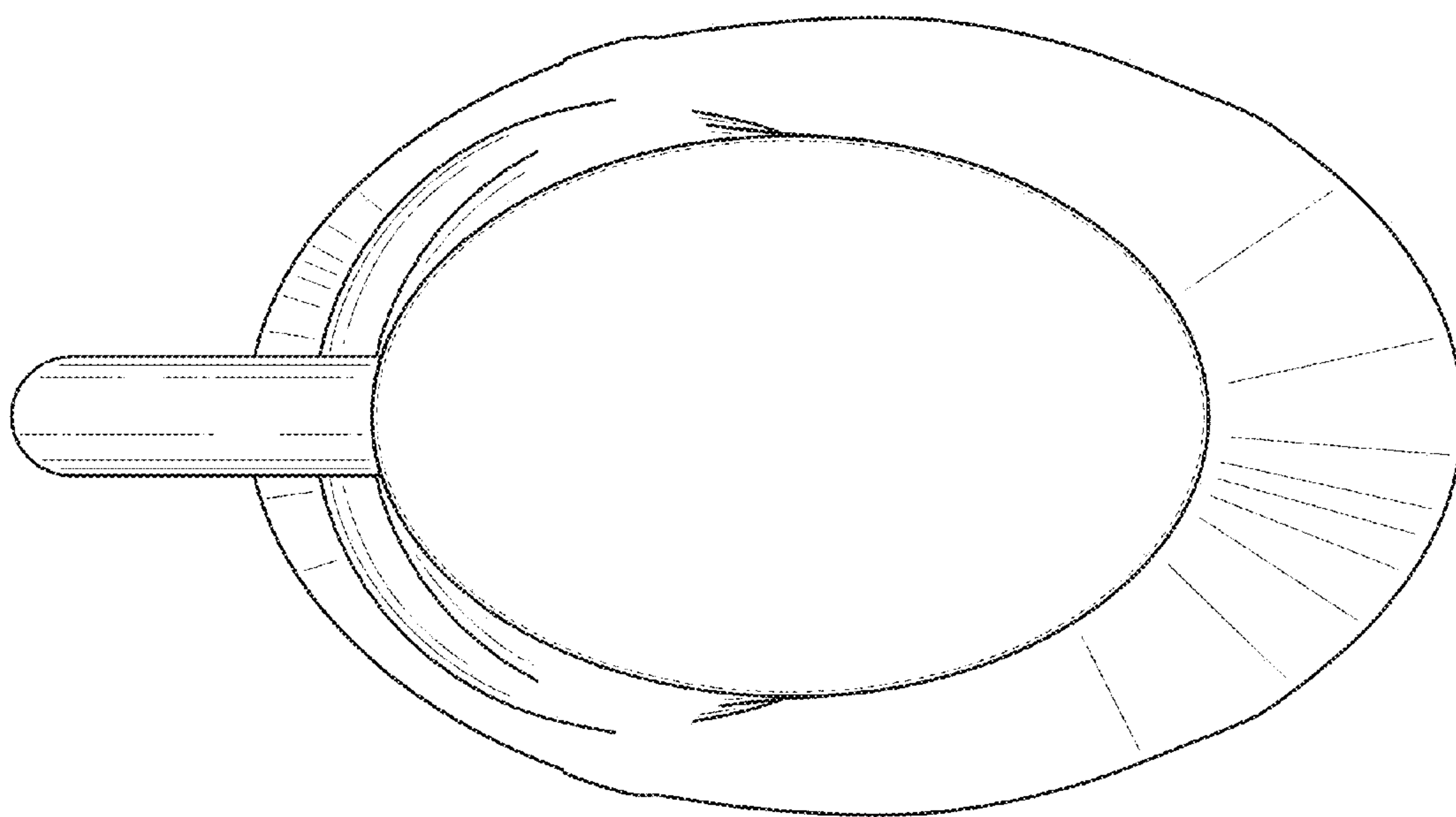

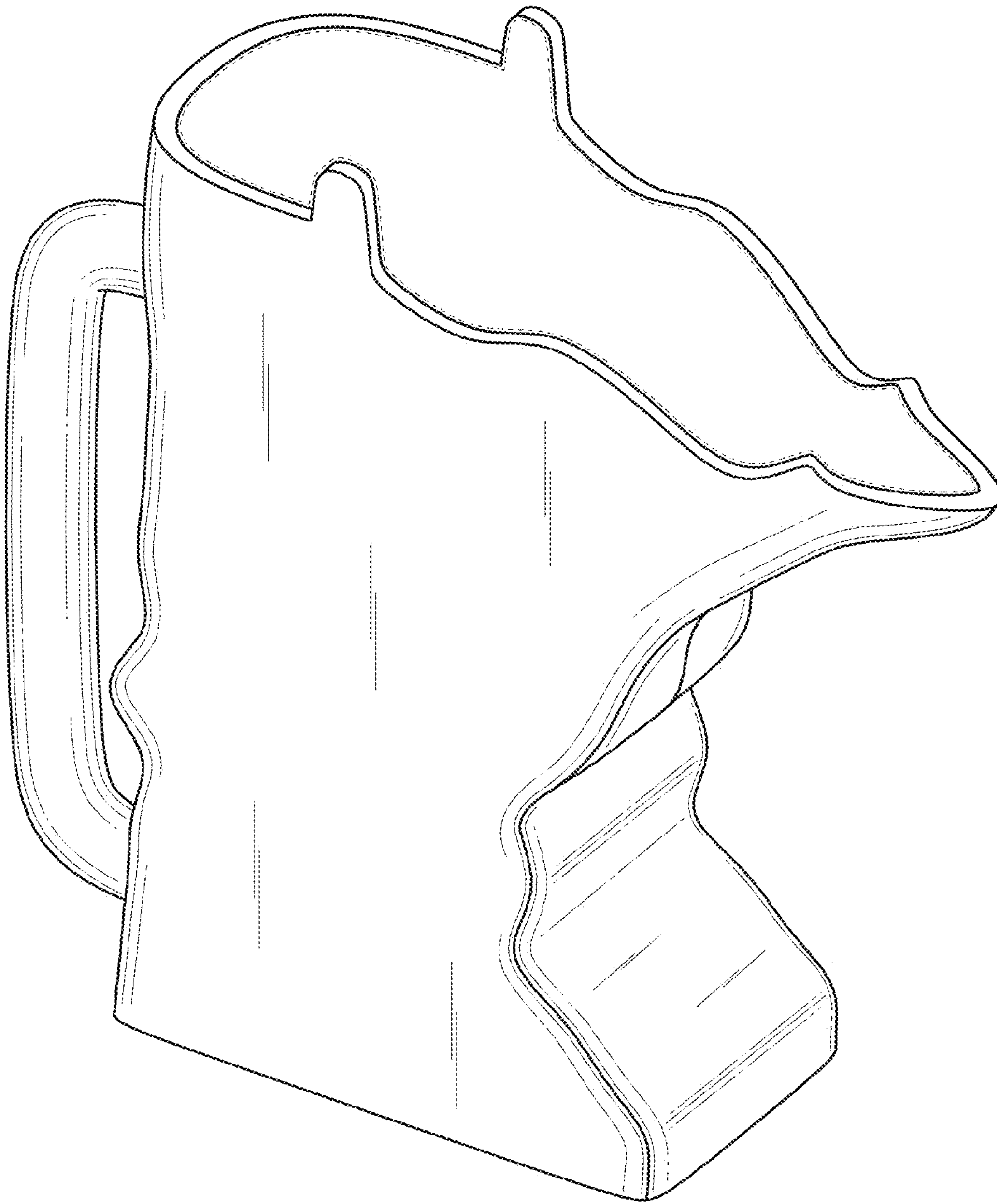

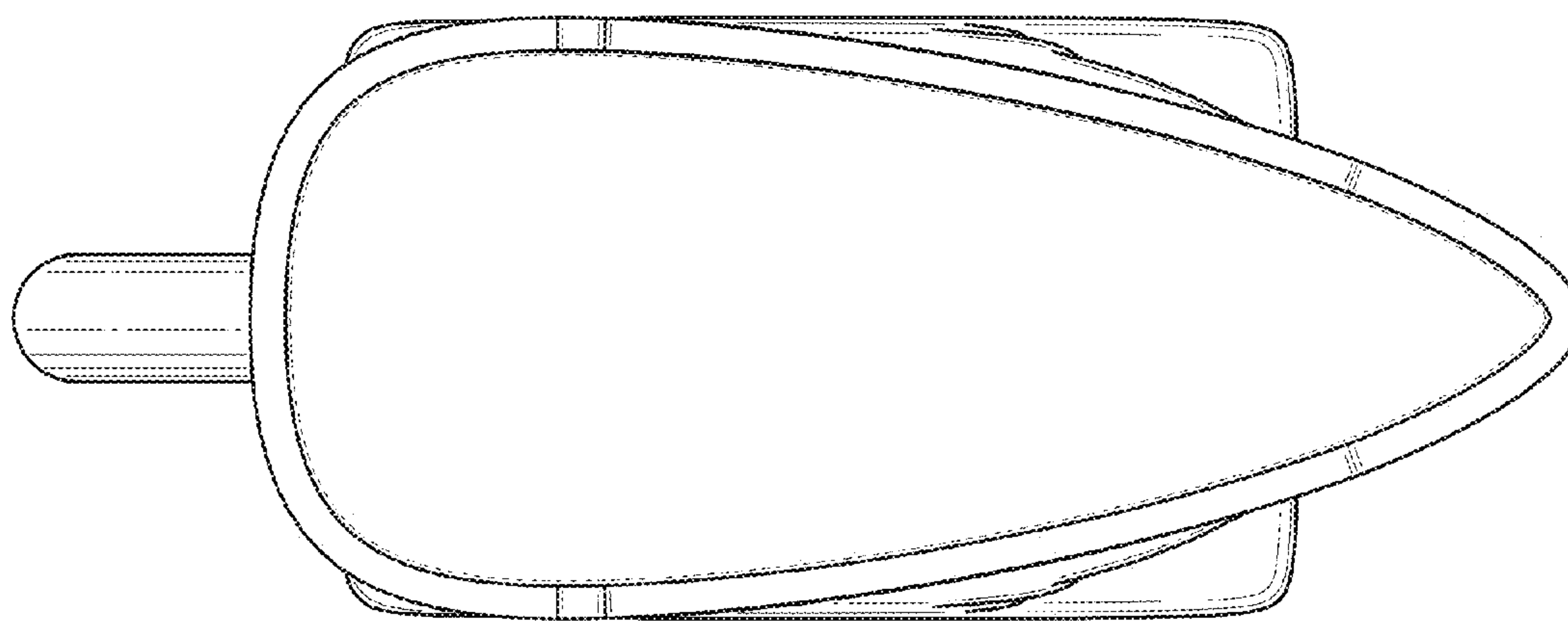

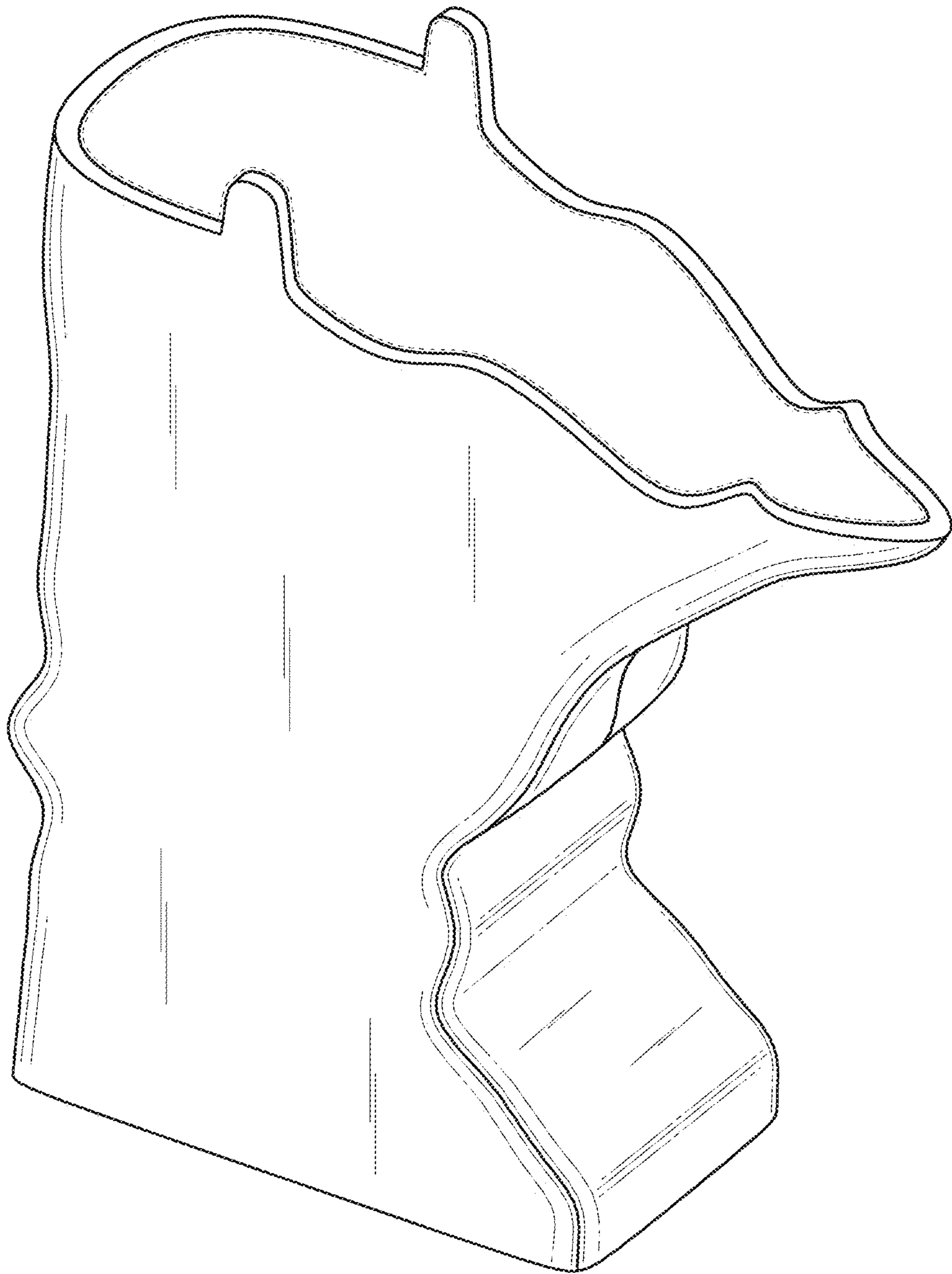

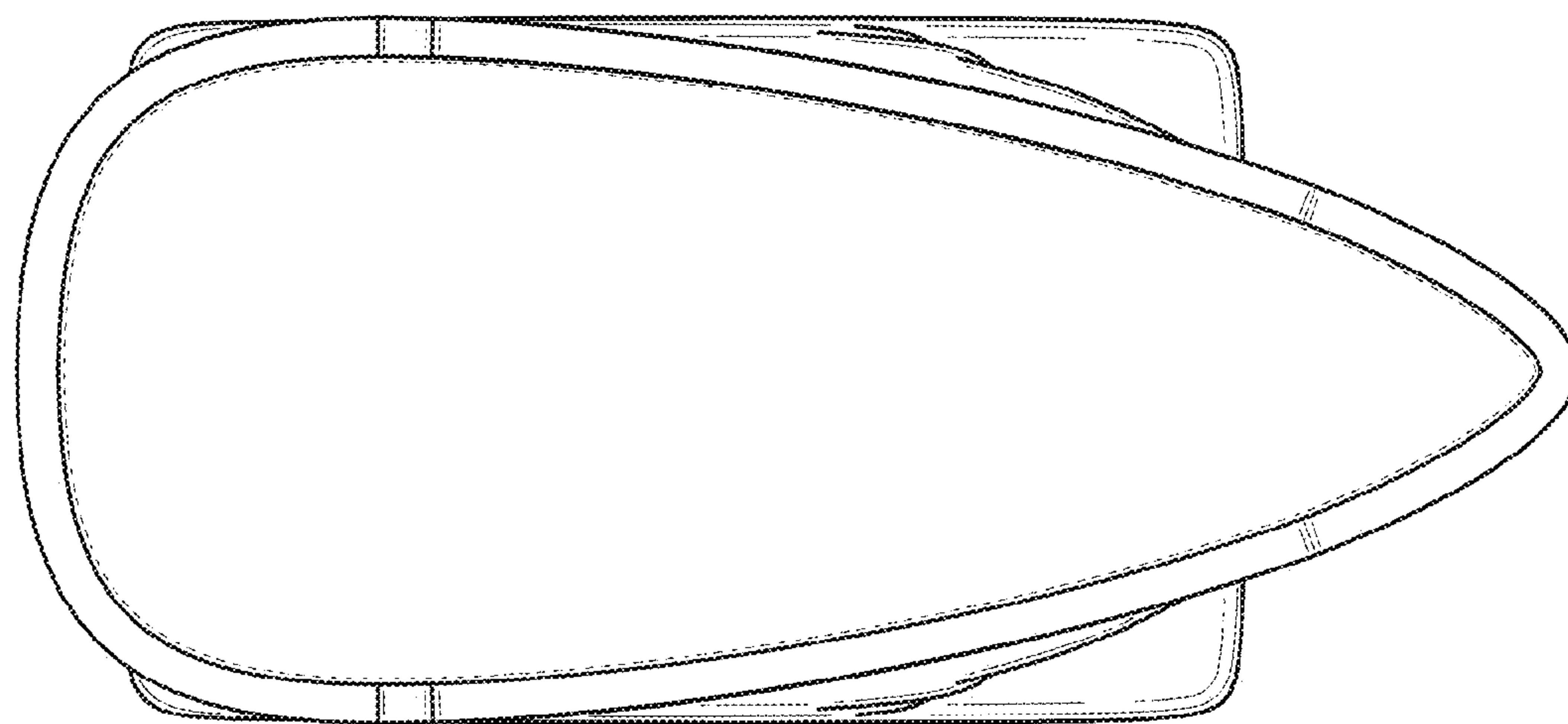

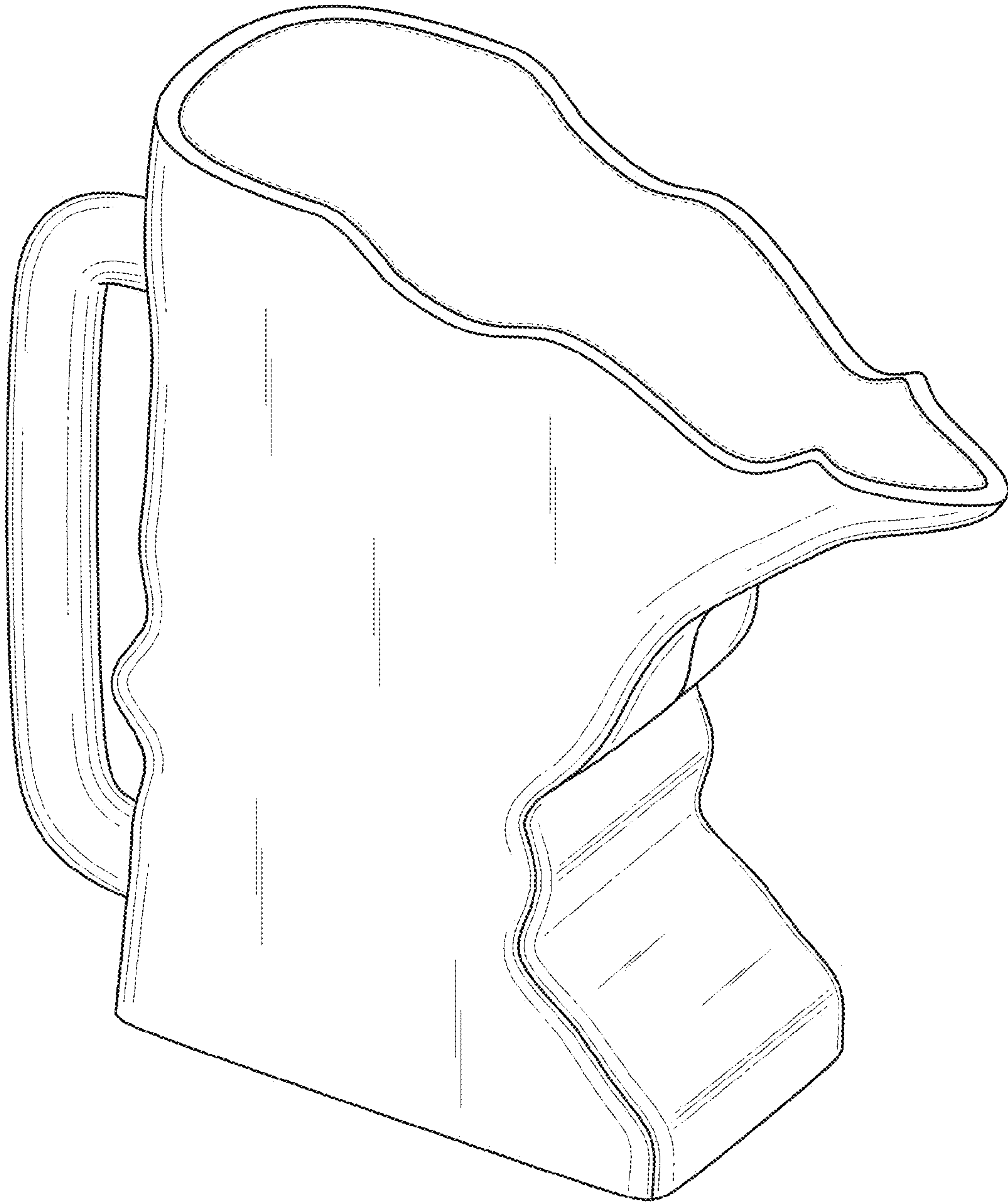

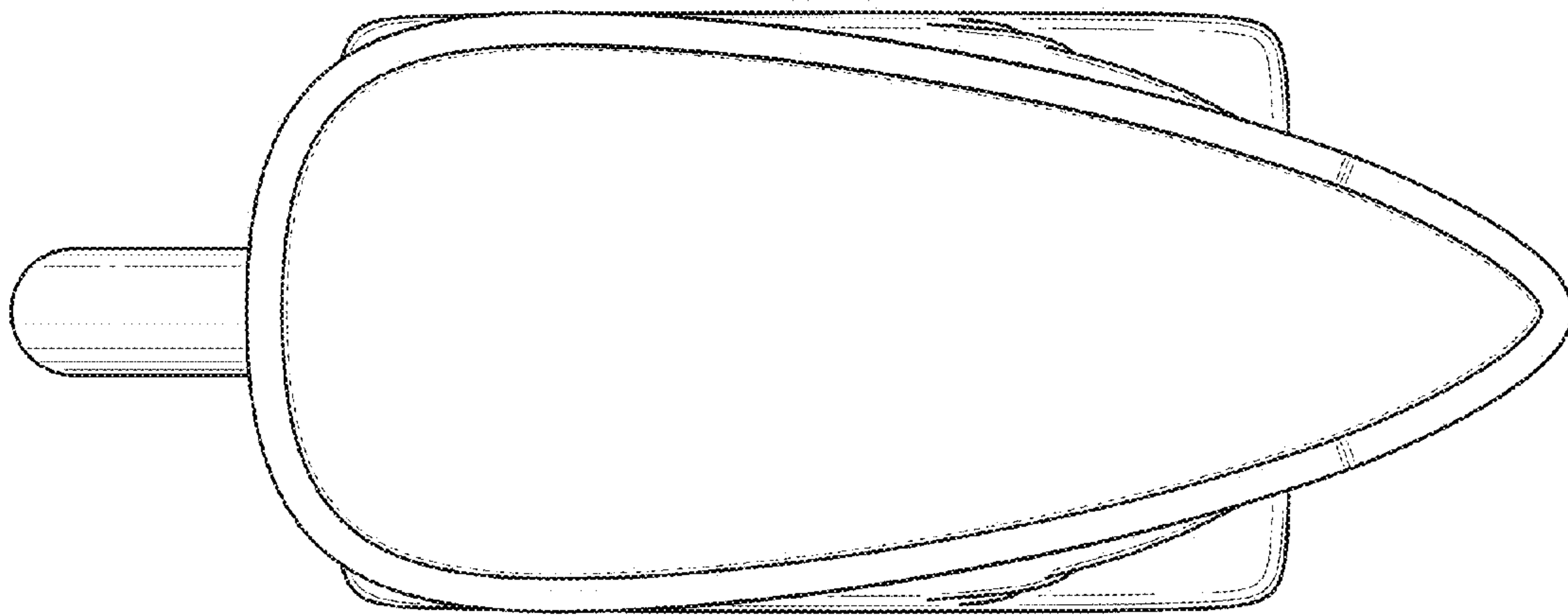
