DESCRIPTION

The broken line showings of FIGS. 1-5 are environmental only and not part of the claimed design.

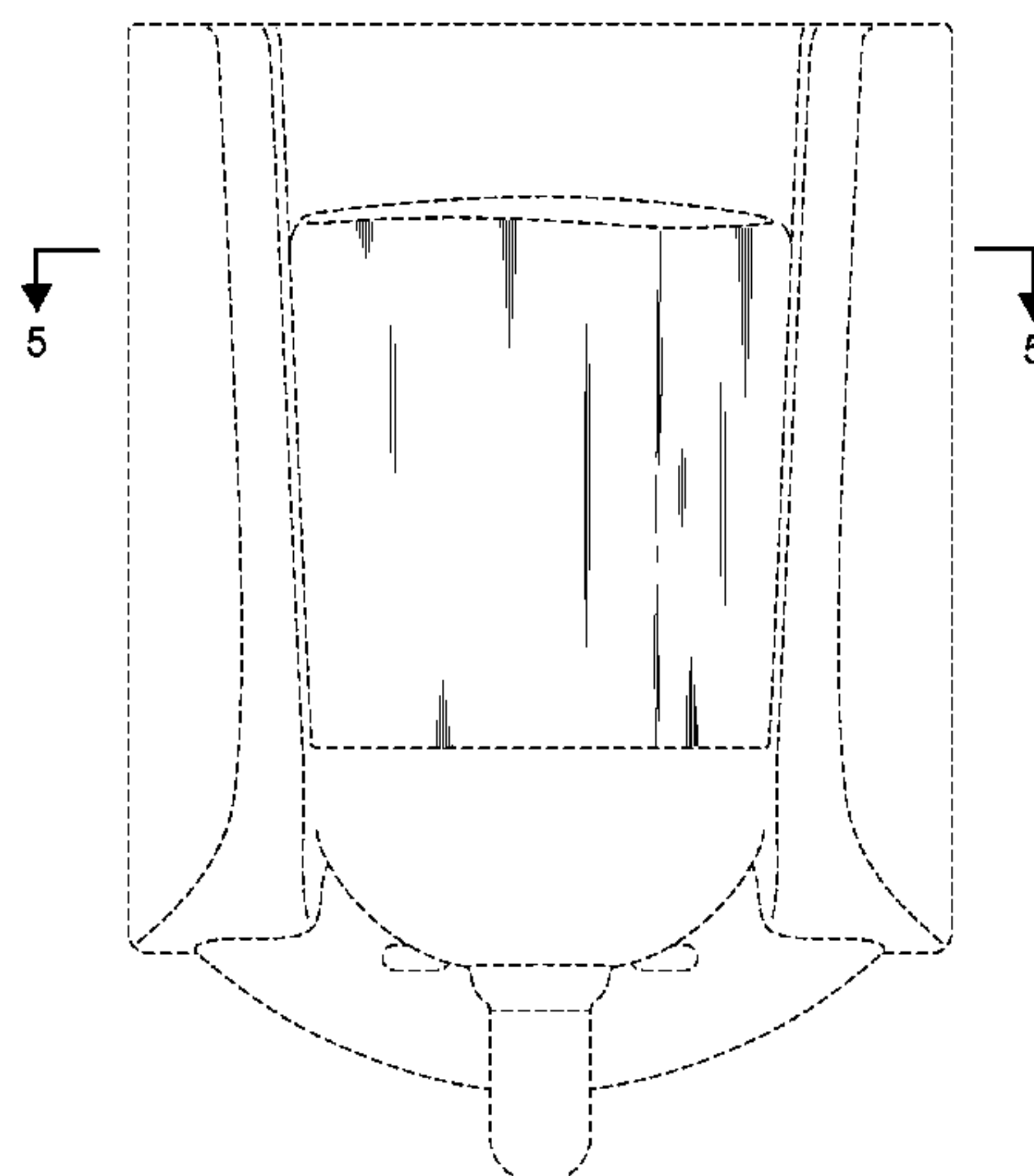
The dashed-dotted line showings of FIGS. 1-2 illustrate boundaries between the claimed design and environmental features.

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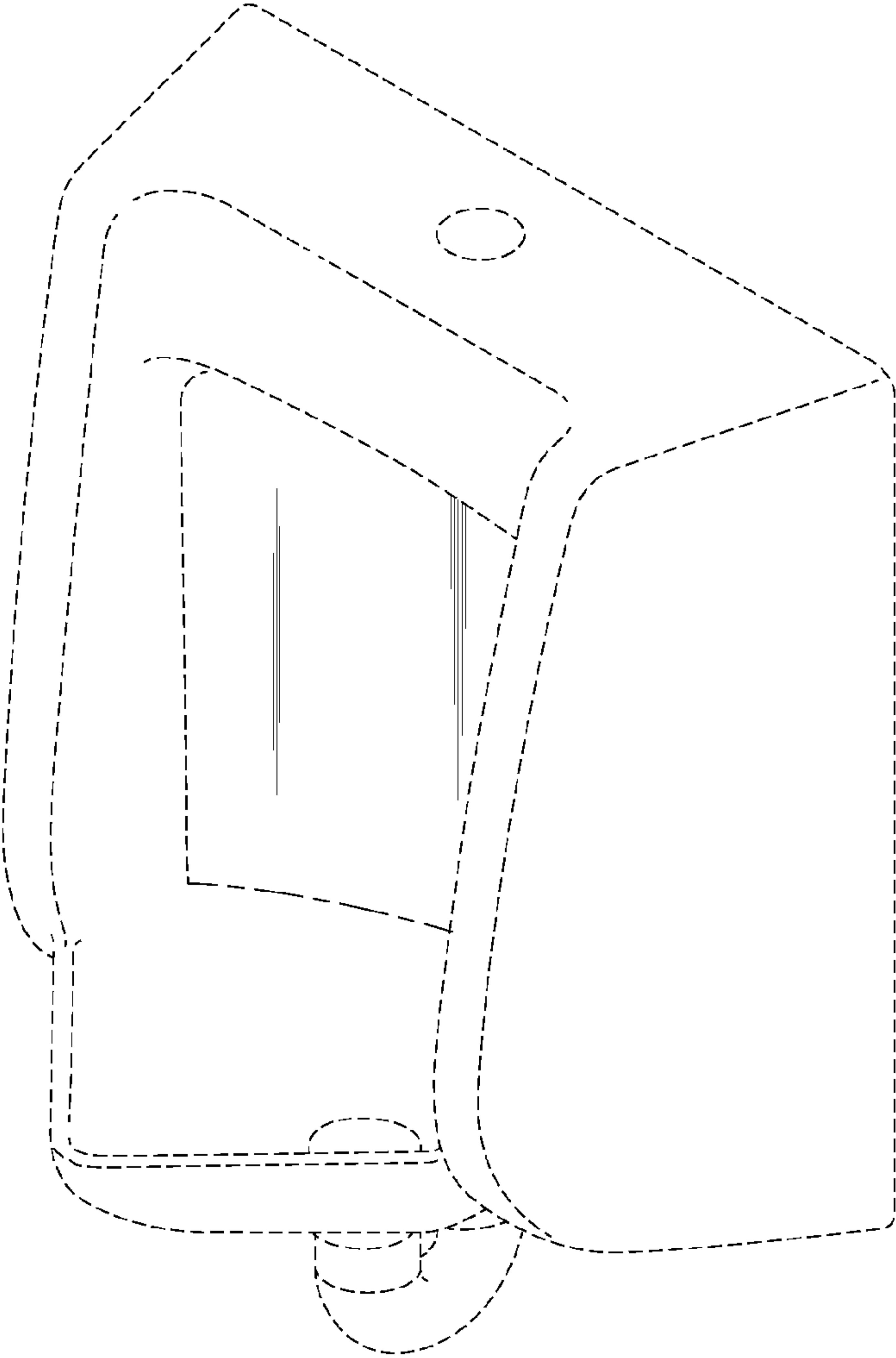

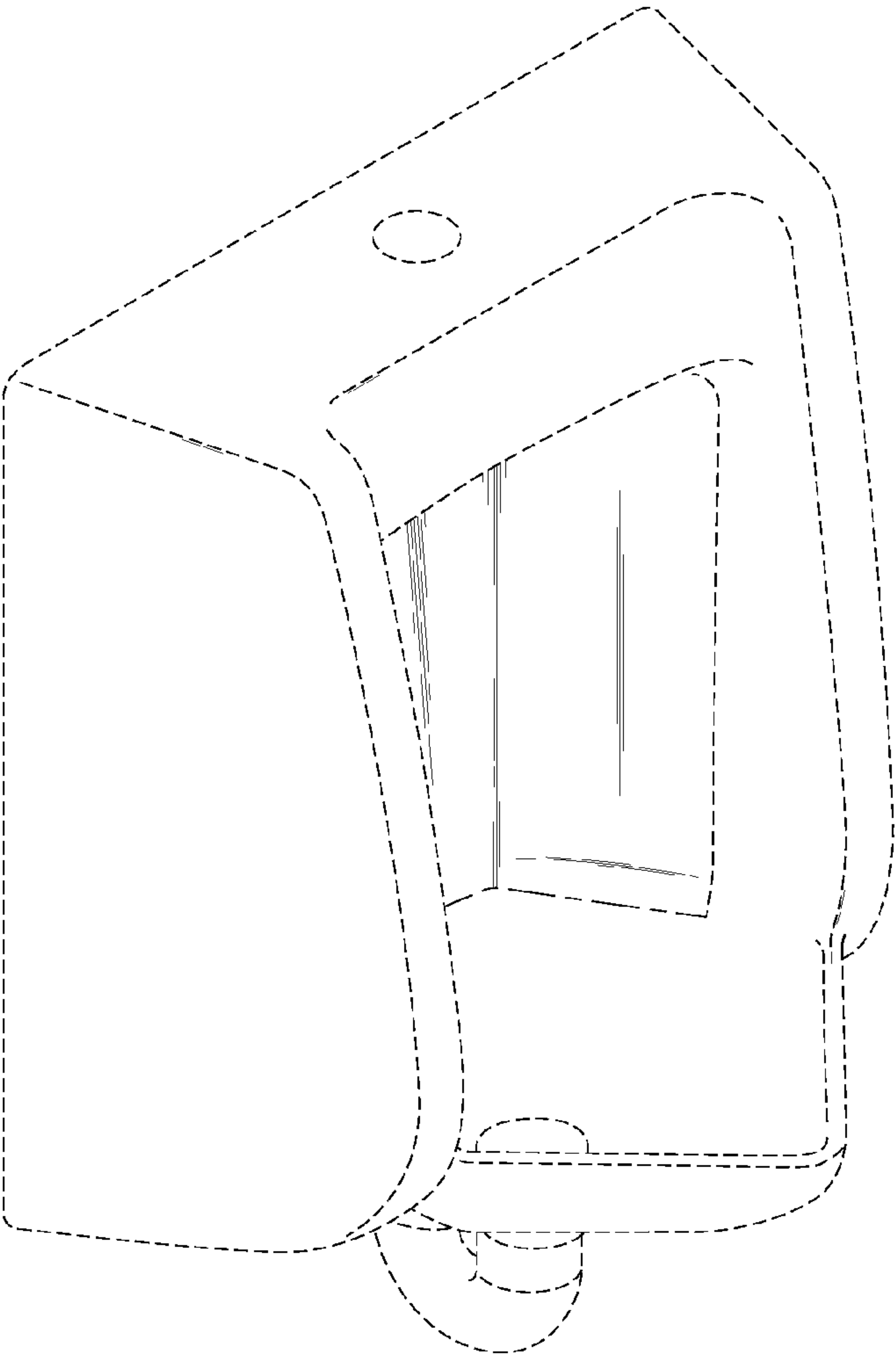

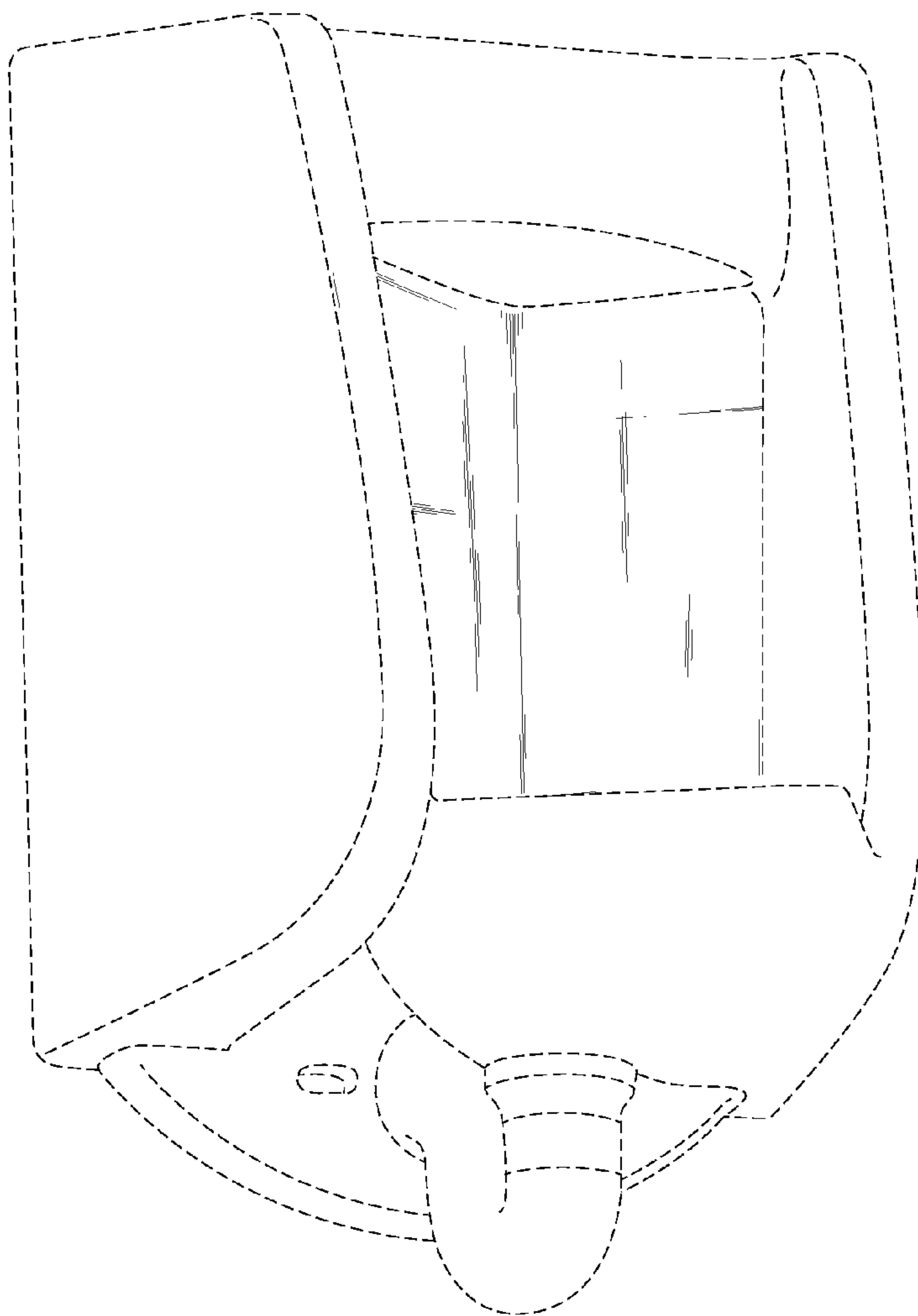

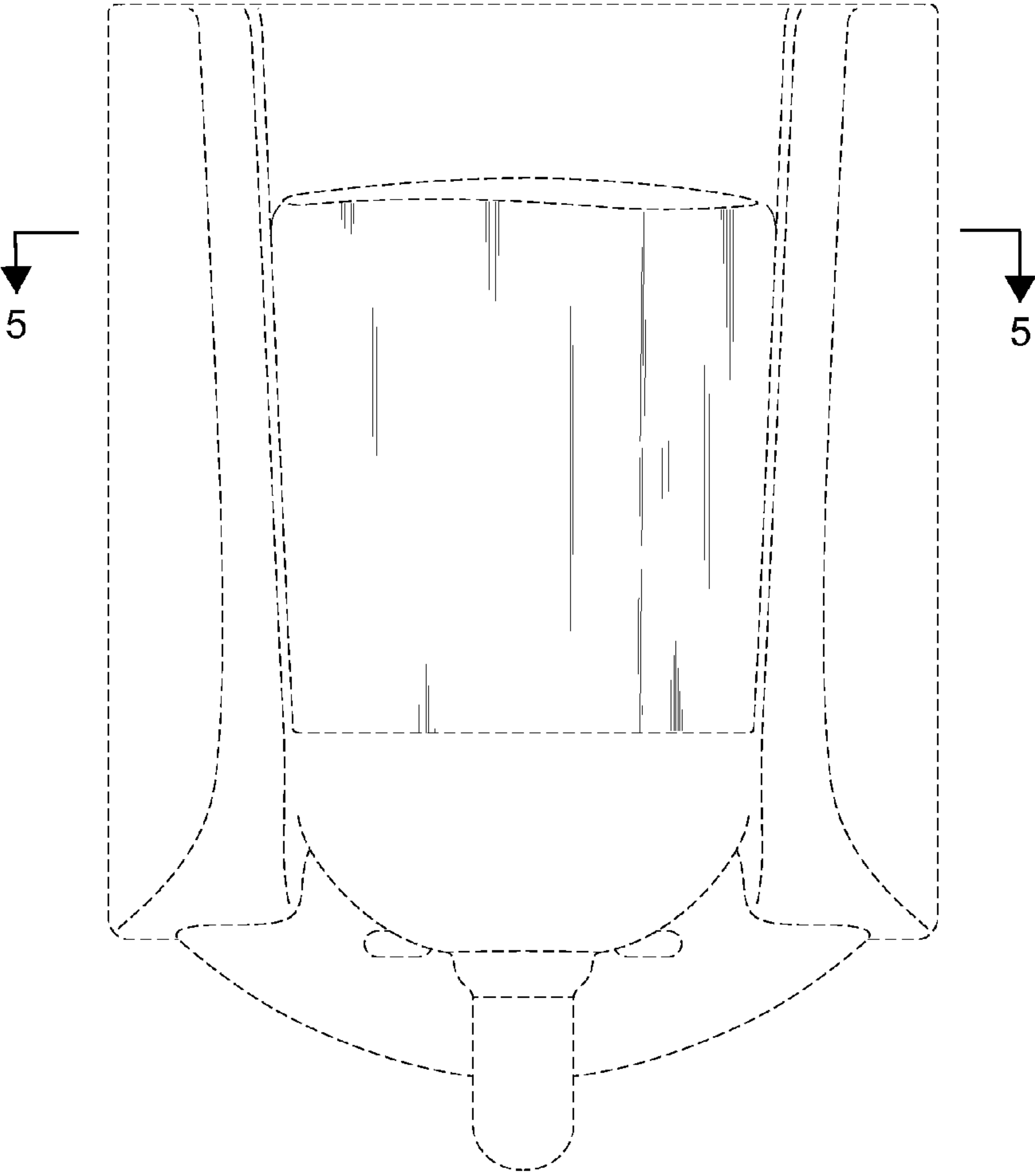

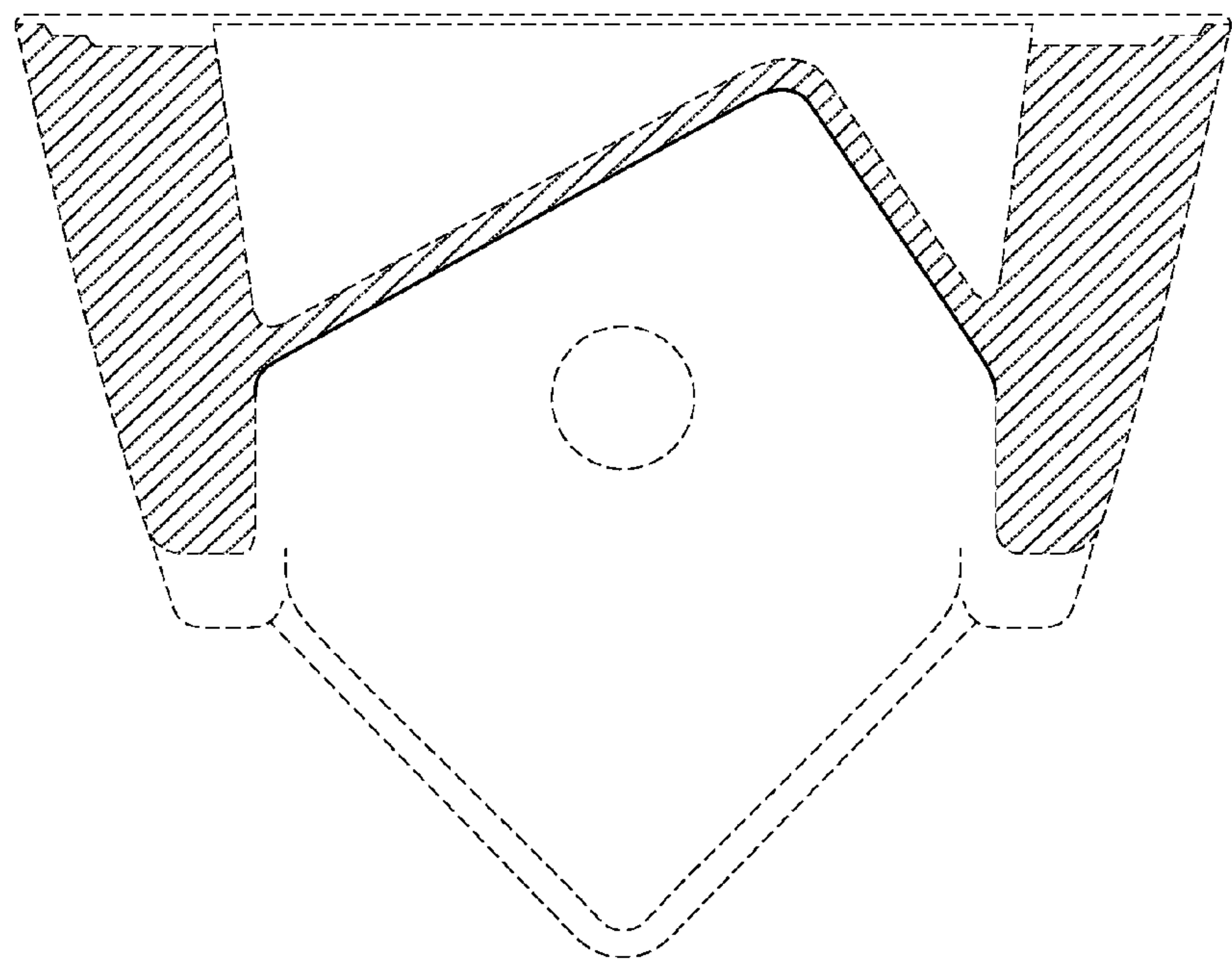
