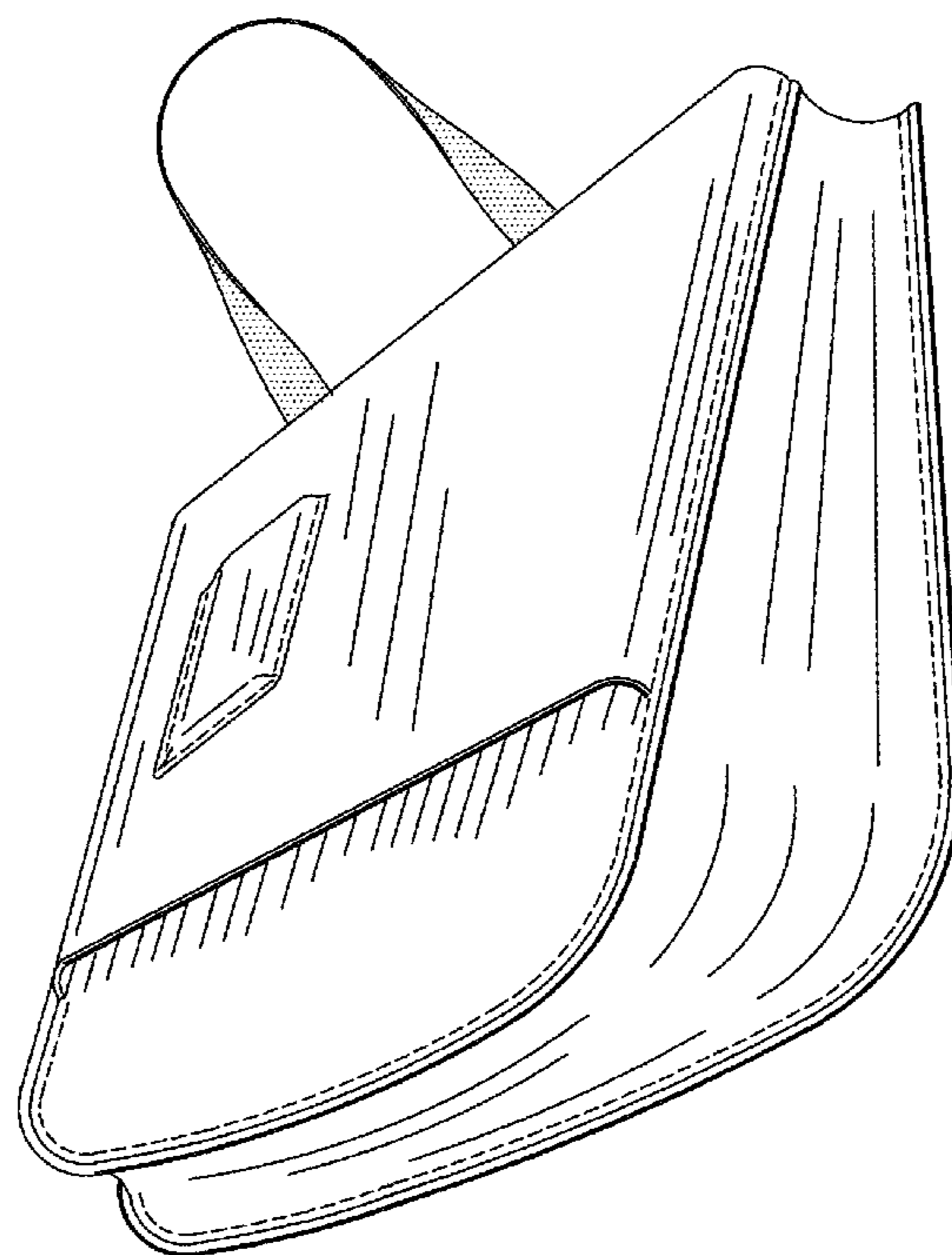

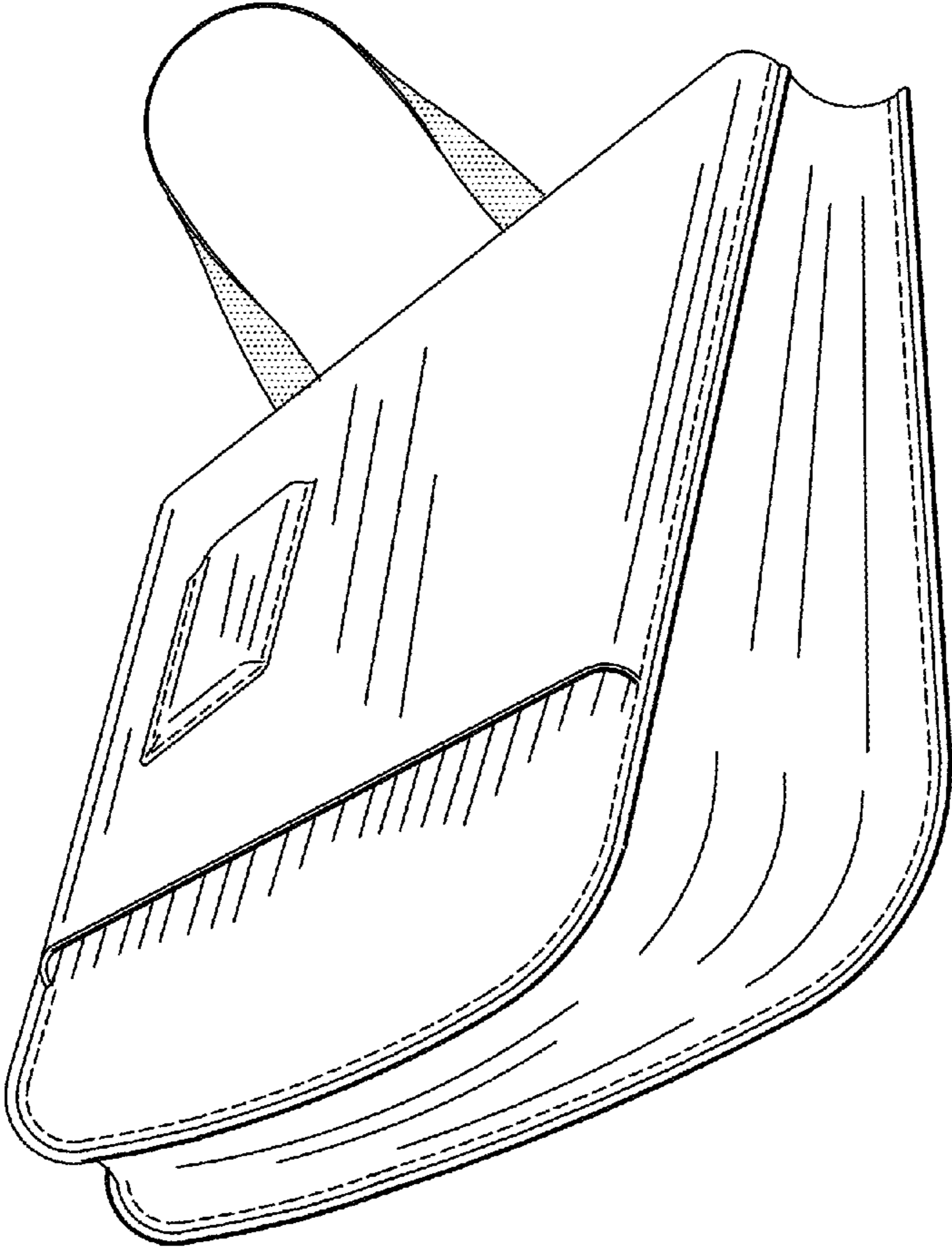

the claim design.

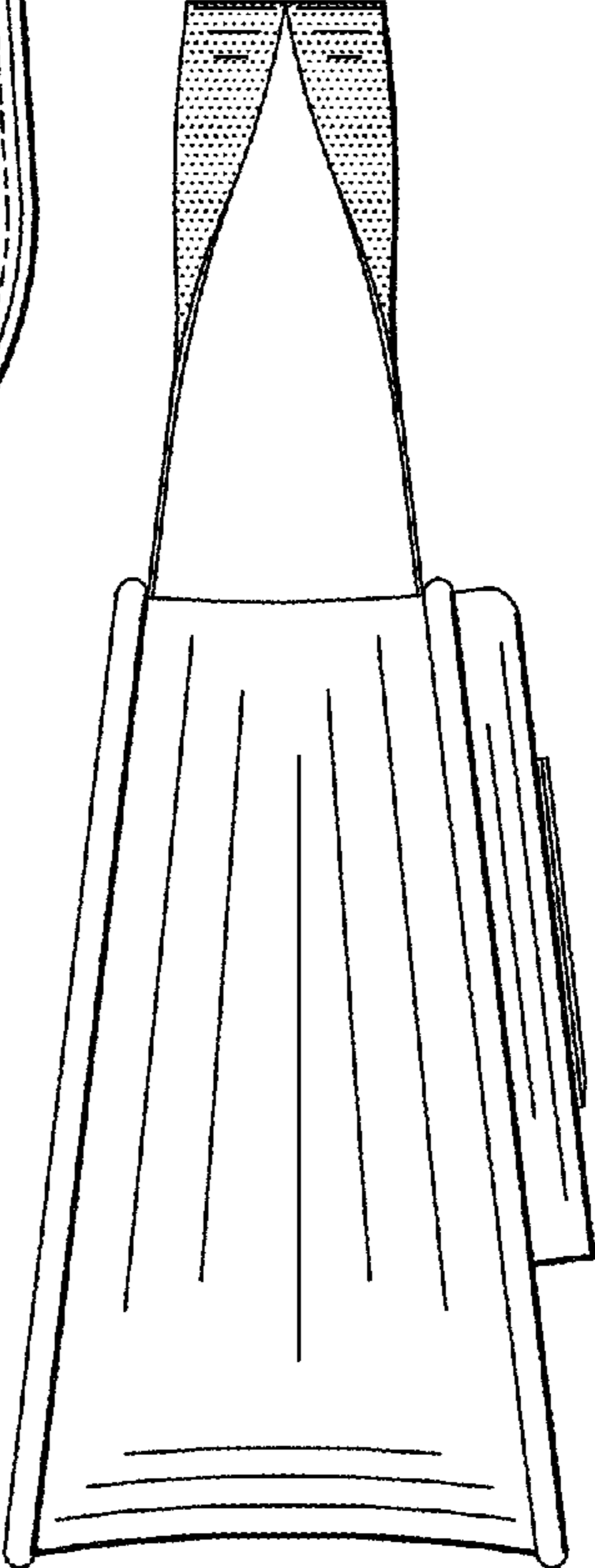

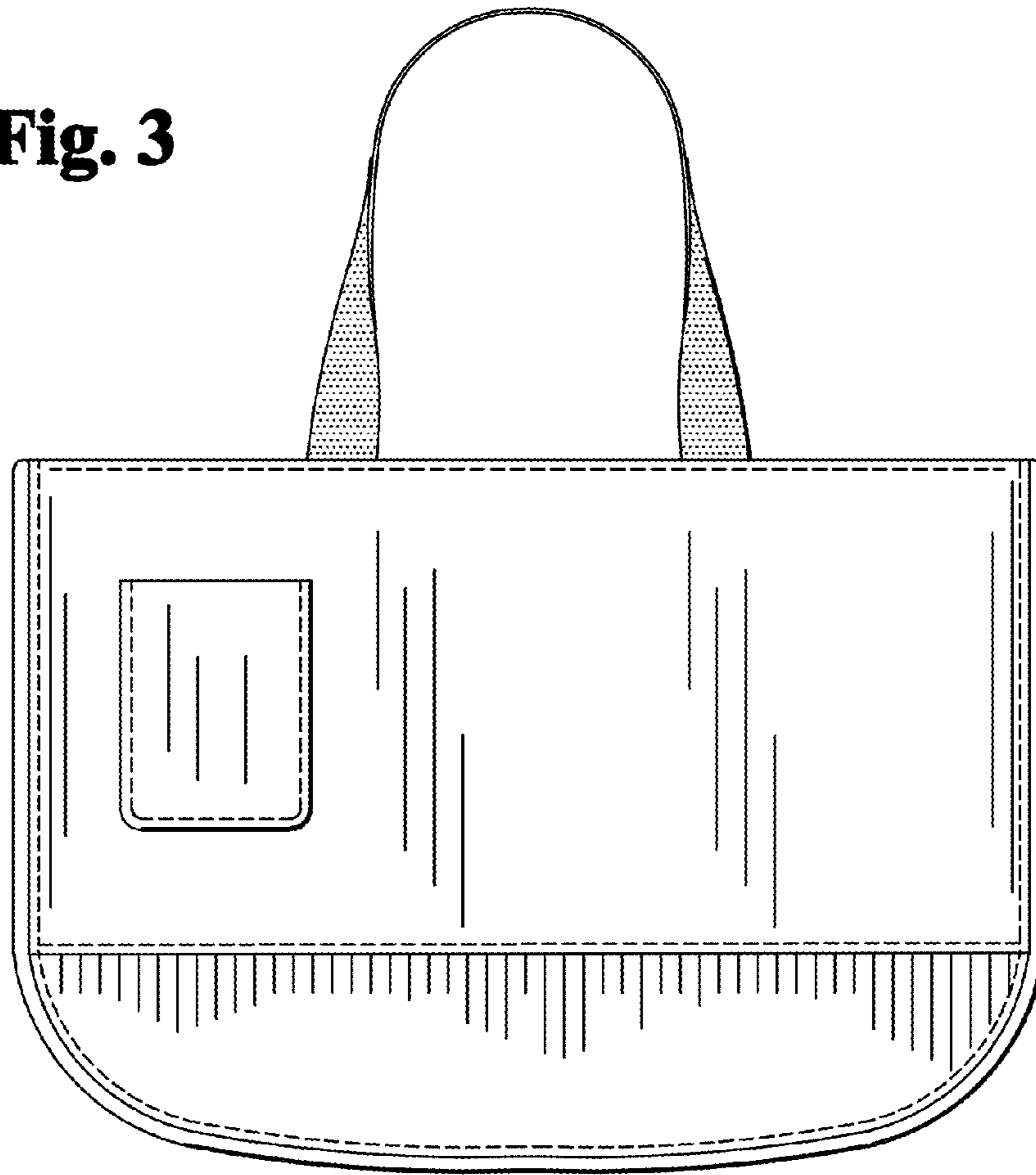

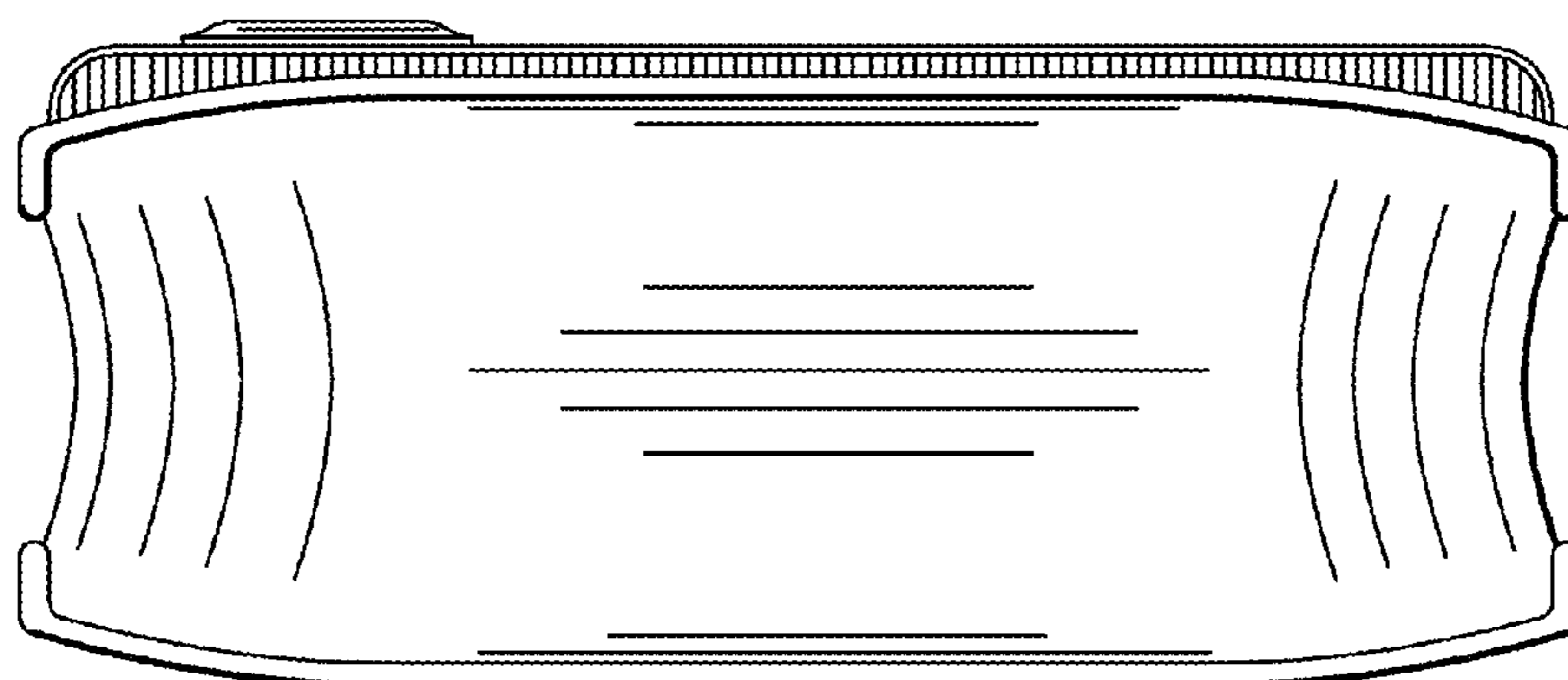

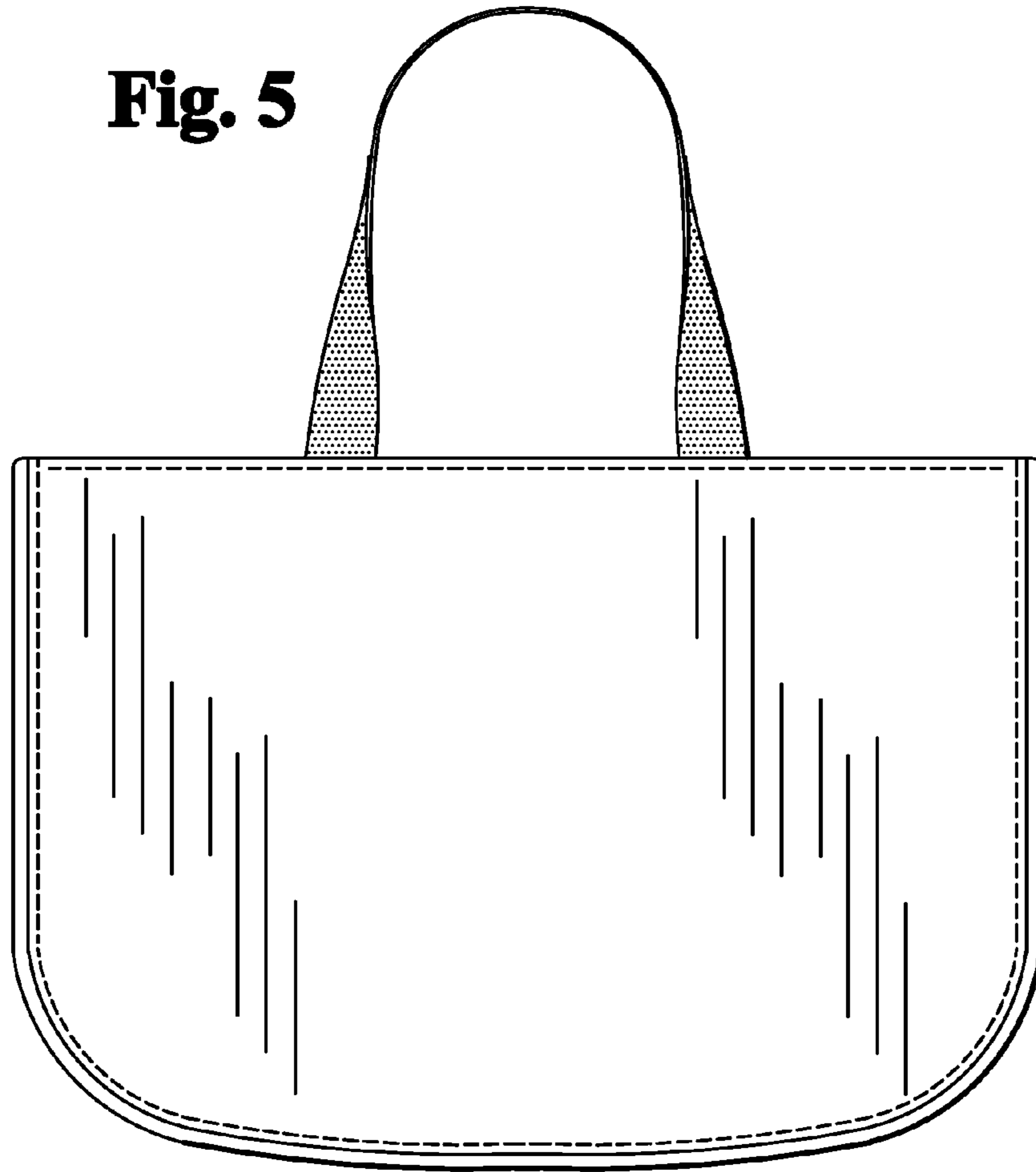

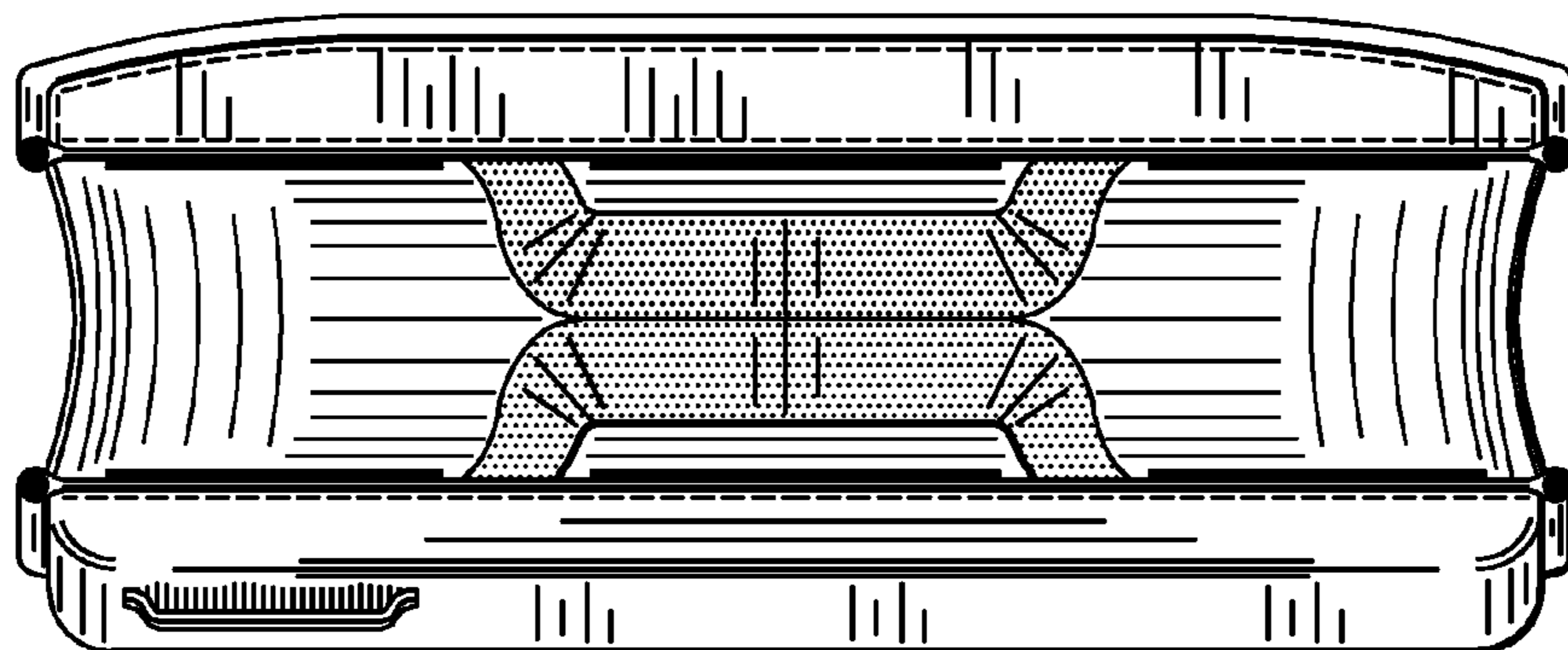

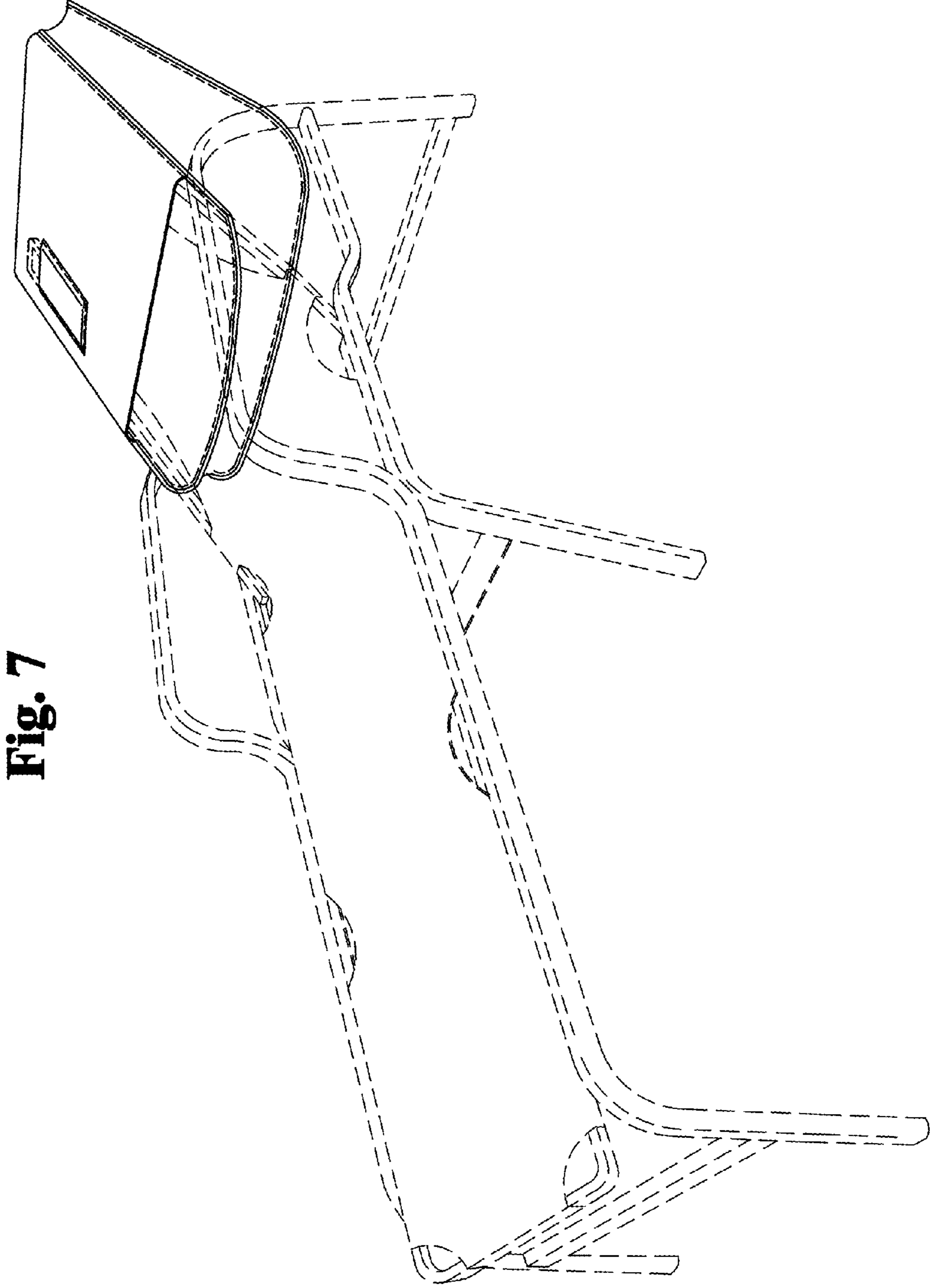
