(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for an electronic device with a transitional graphical user interface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the first image of an electronic device with a transitional graphical user interface showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front view of a second image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front view of a third image thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is a front view of a fourth image thereof.

The broken line showing of the electronic device and graphic features forms no part of the claimed design.

The appearance of the image transitions sequentially between the images shown in FIGS. 1-4. The process or period in which an image transitions to another forms no part of the claimed design.

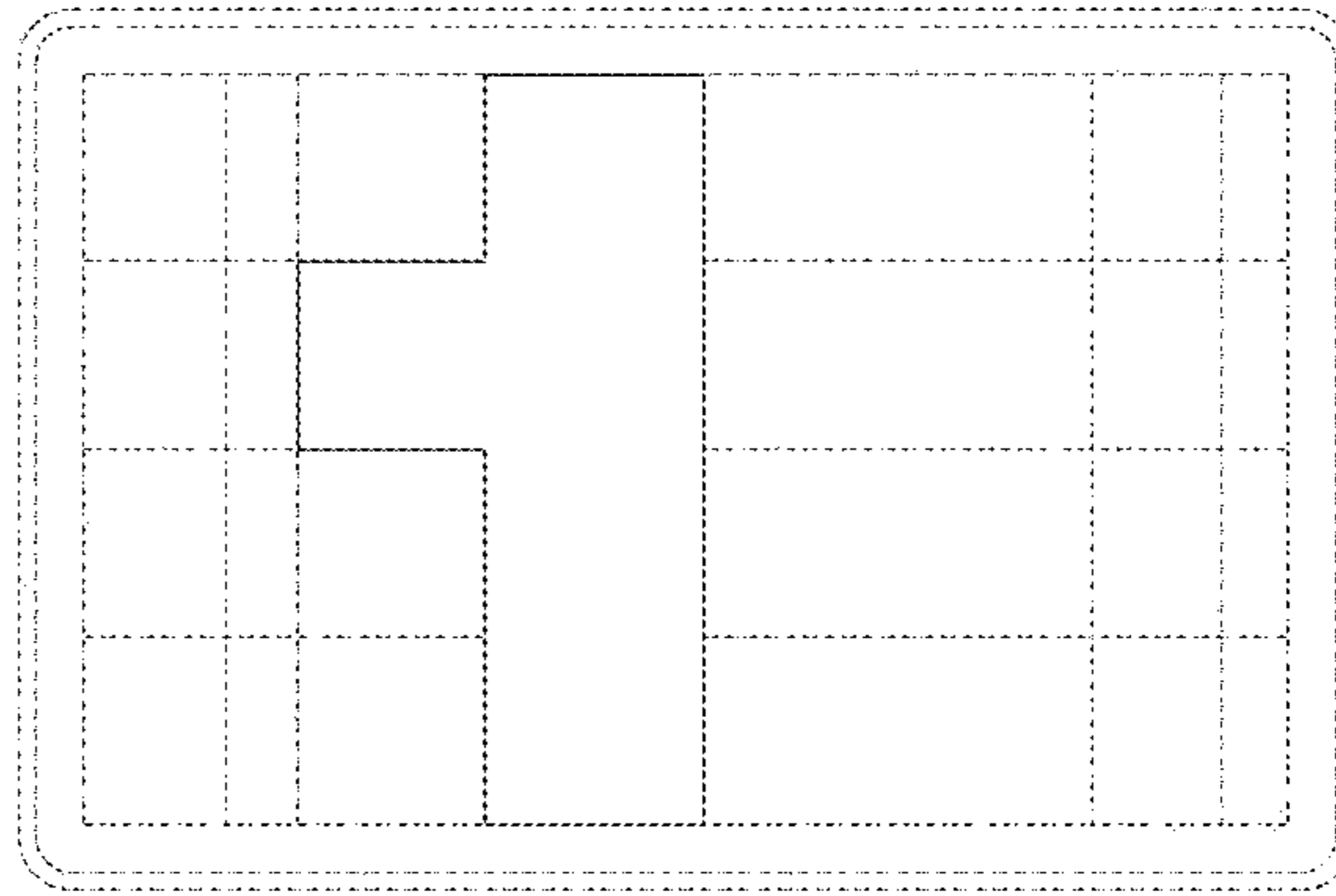
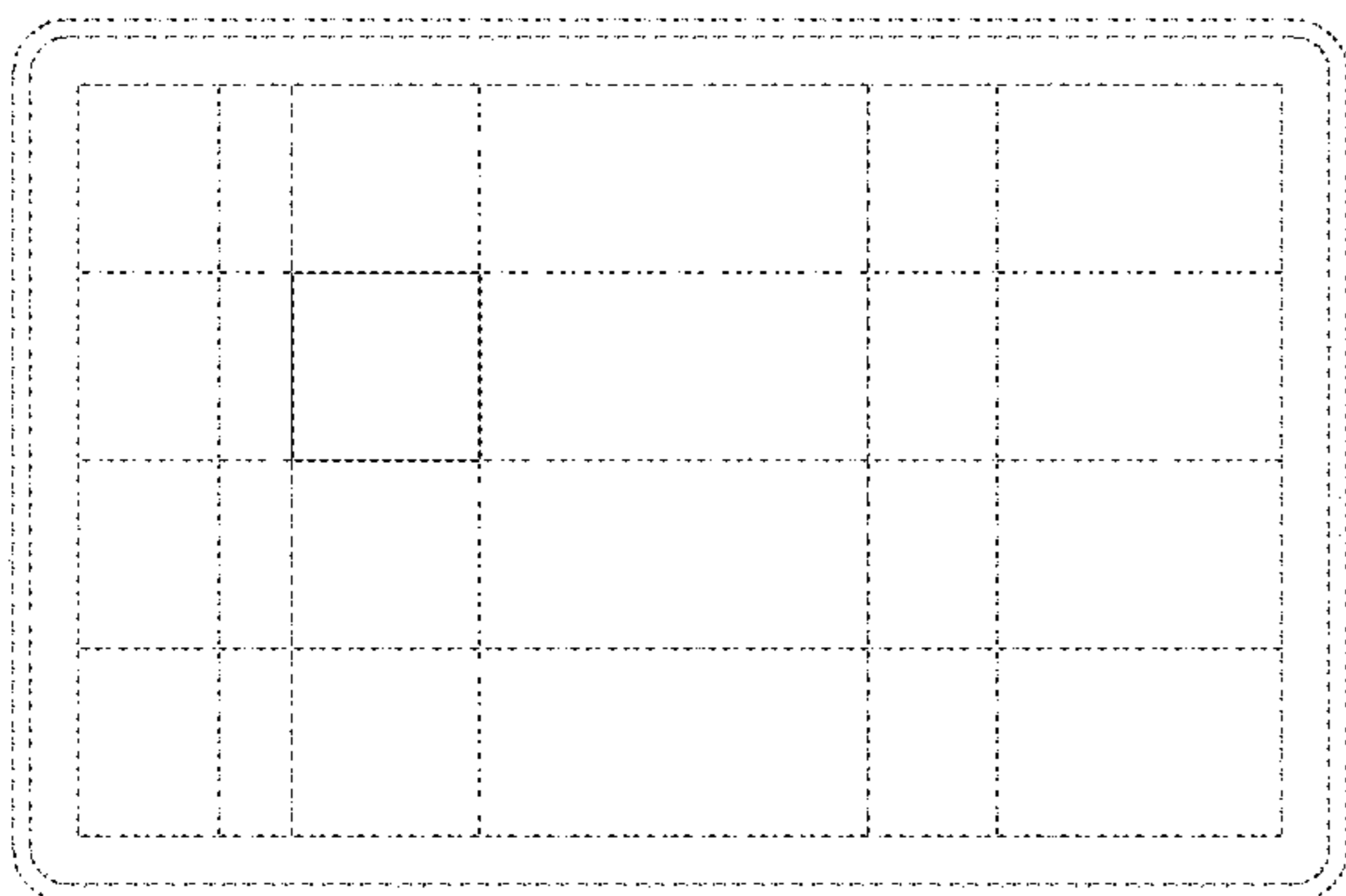

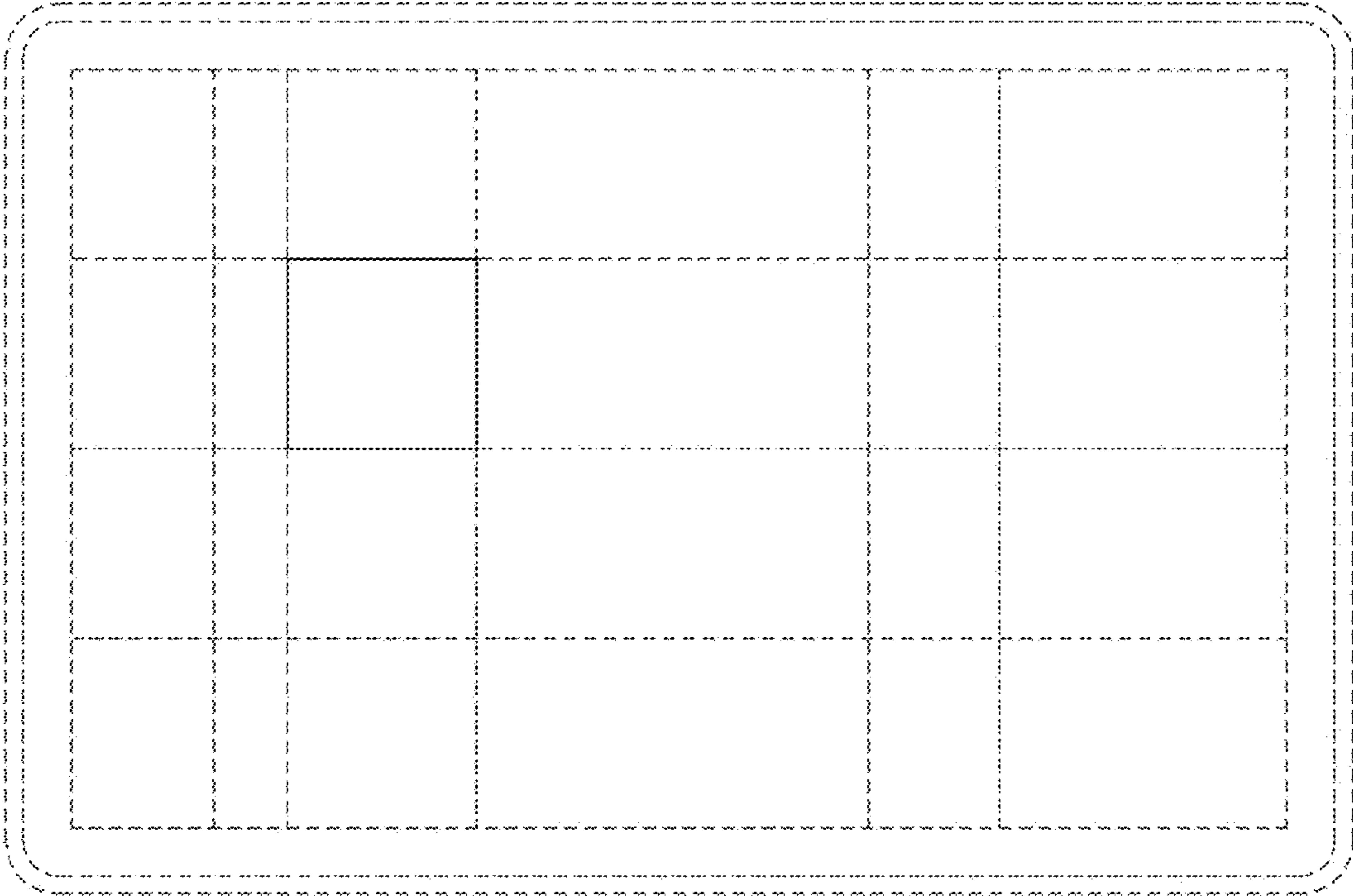

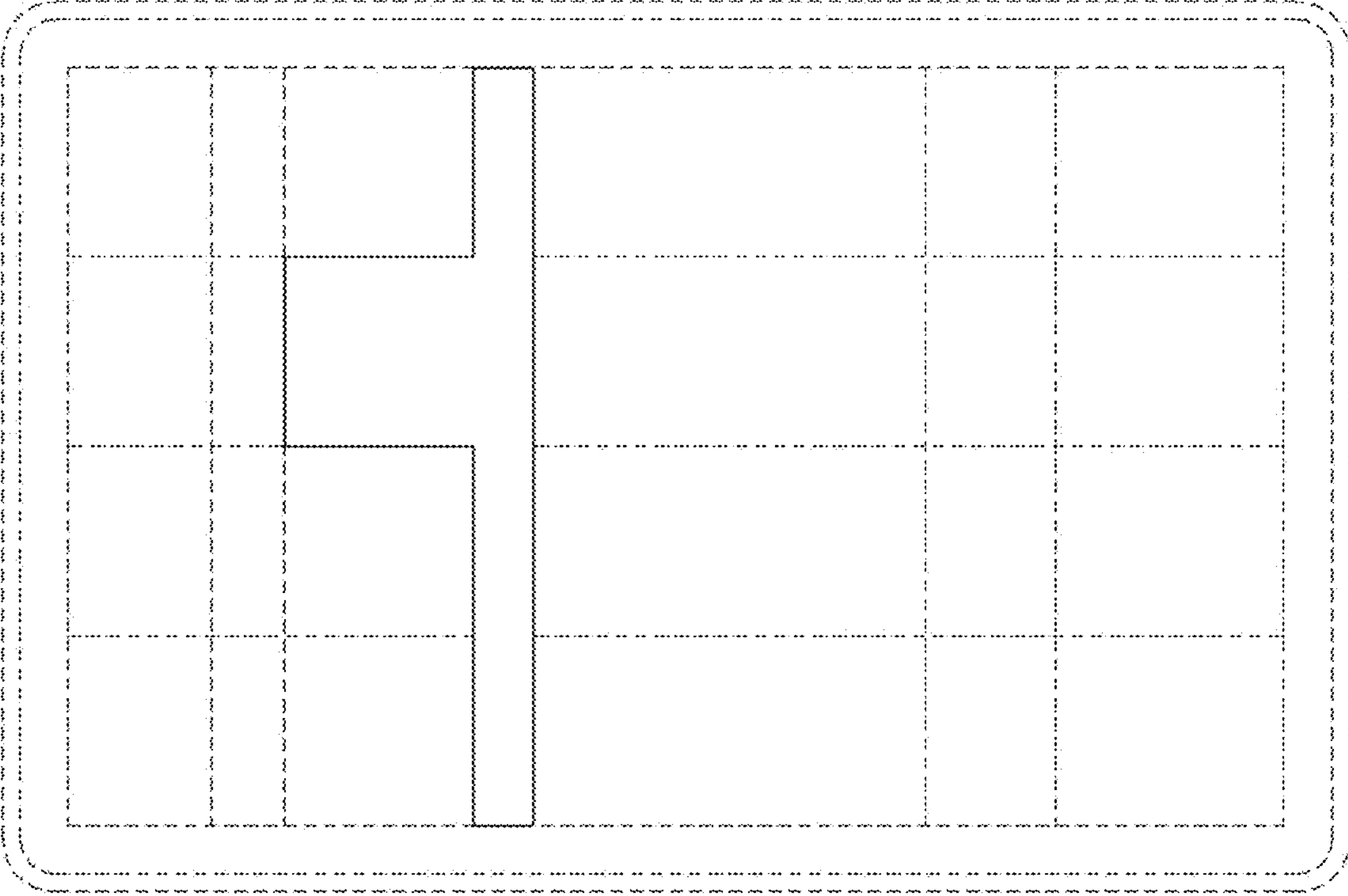

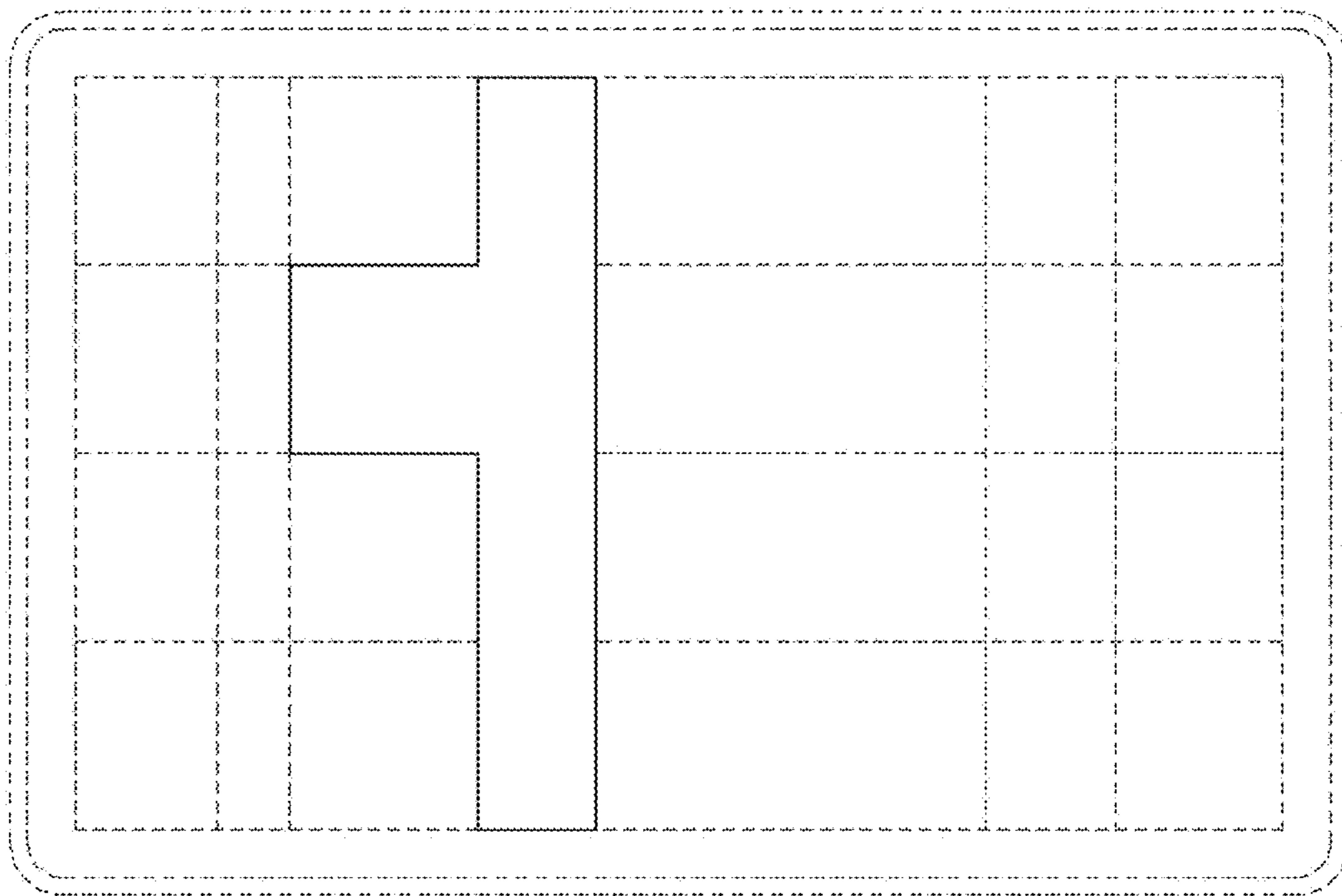
