FIG. 4 is a medial side elevation view of the golf shoe upper portion of this invention;

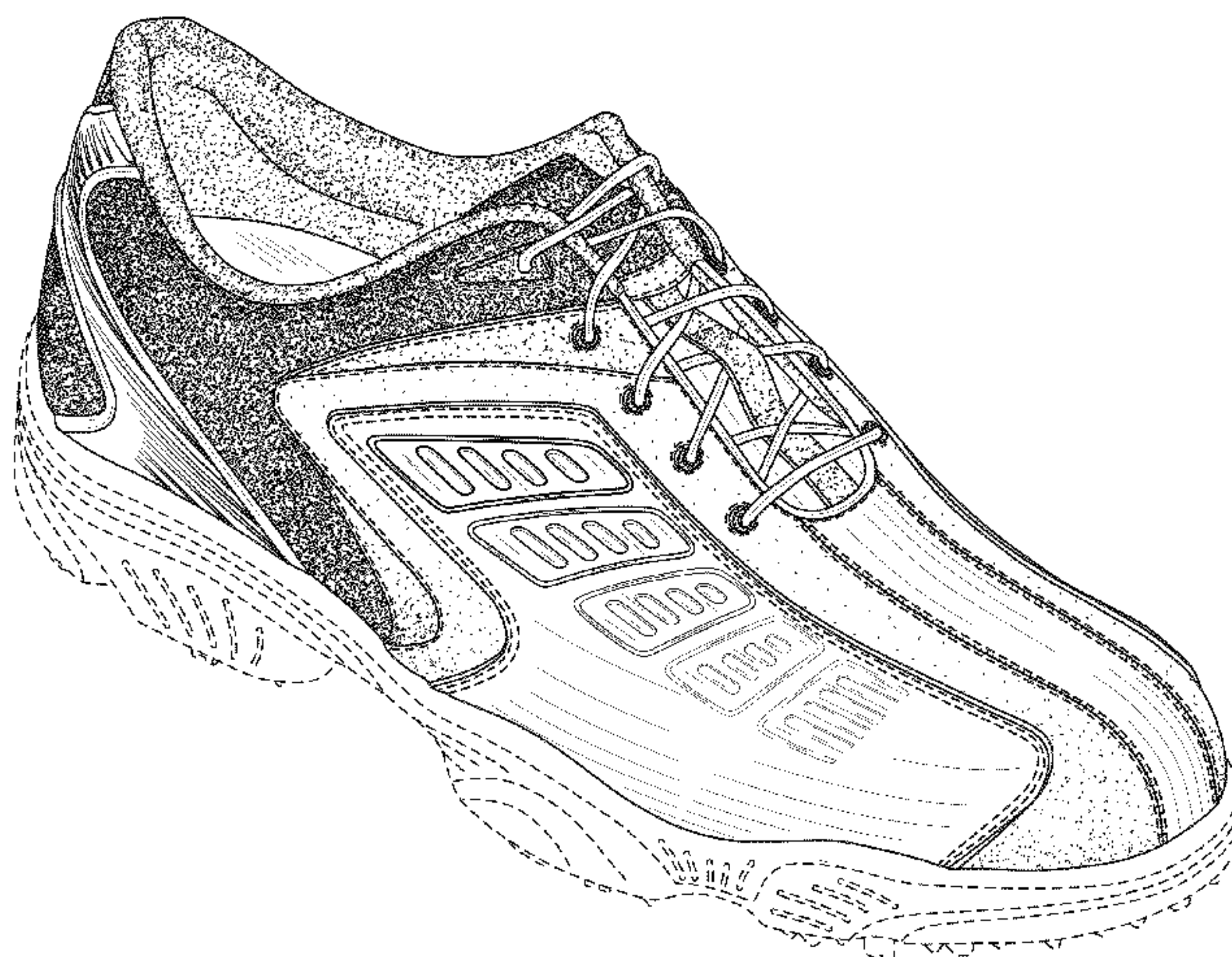
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the golf shoe upper portion of this invention;

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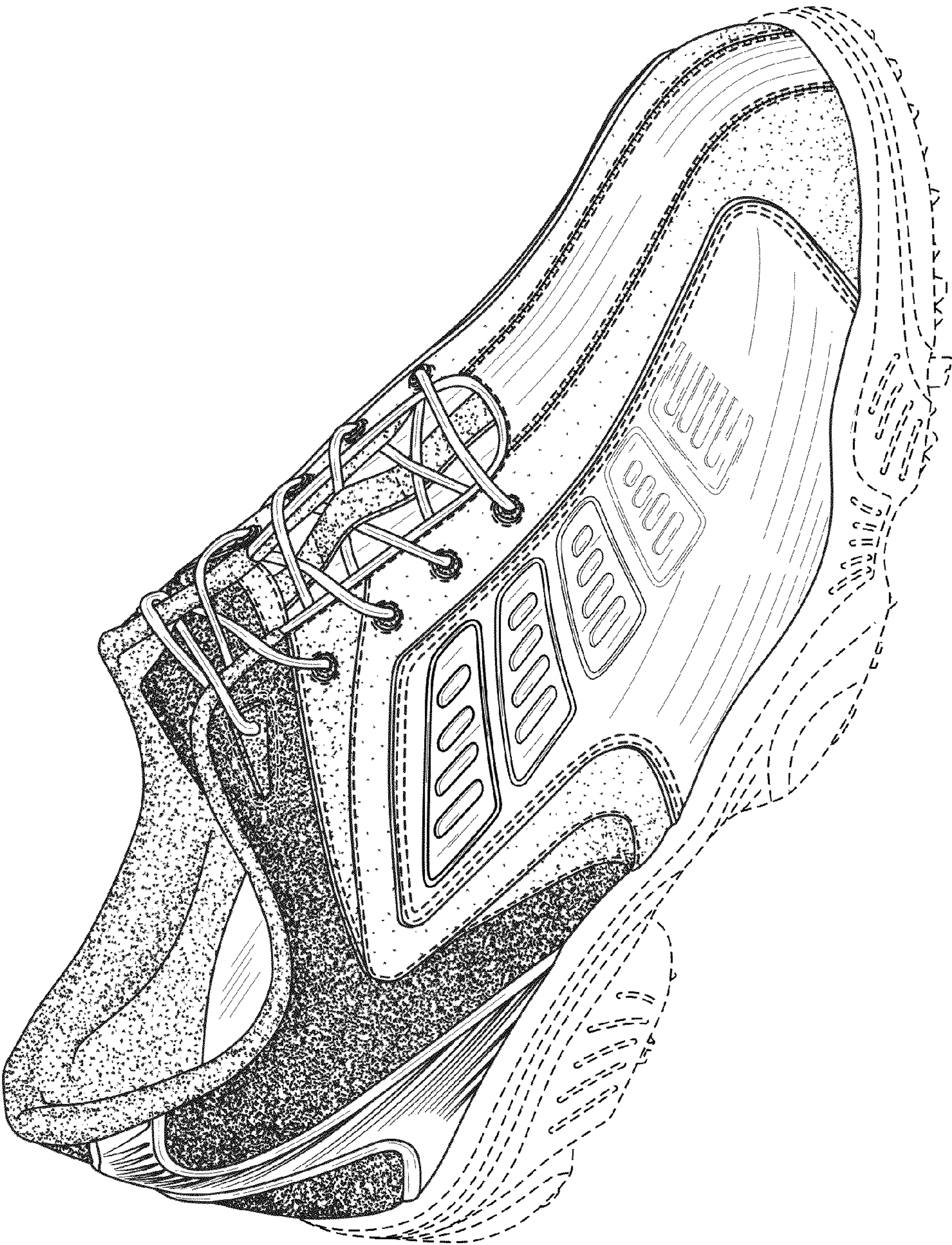

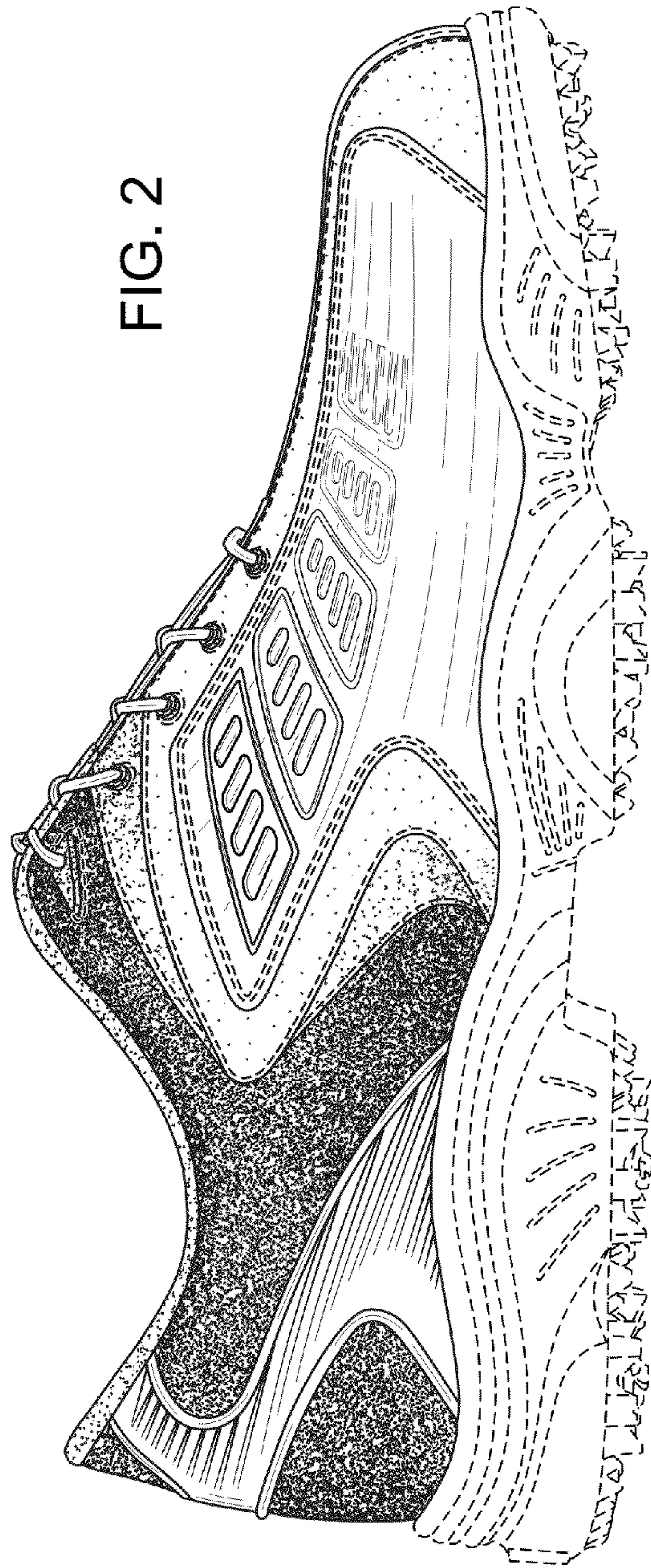
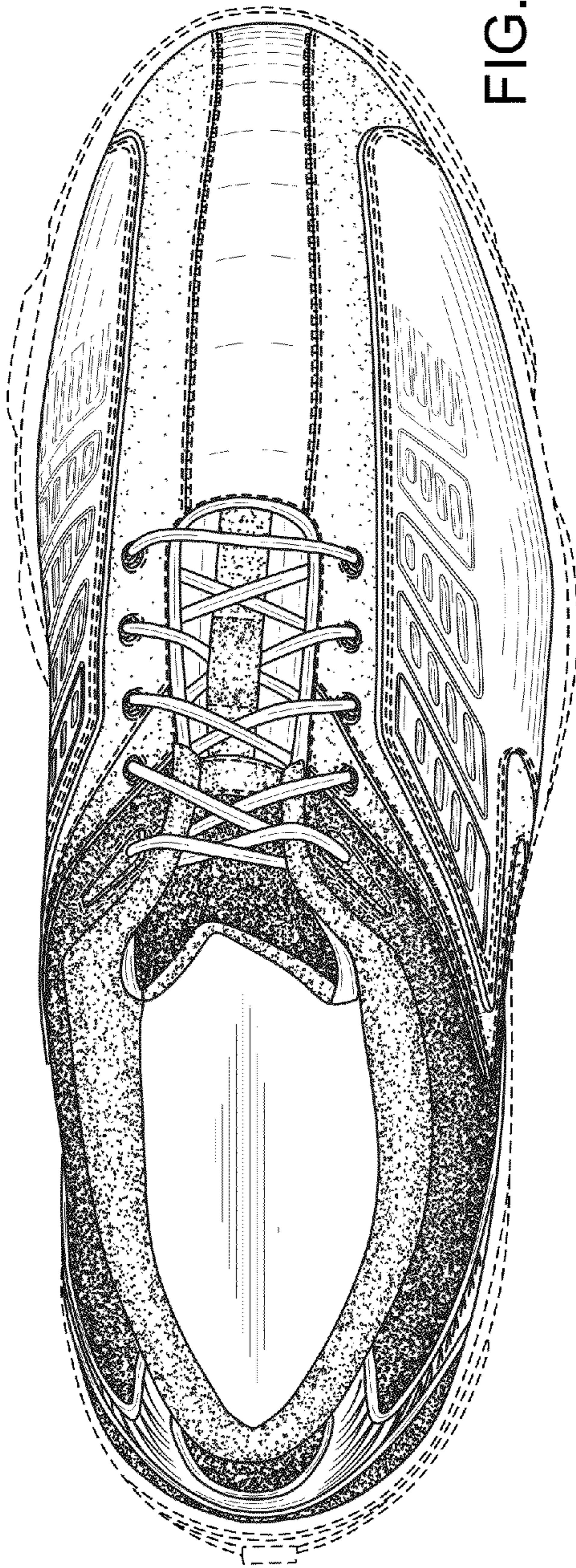

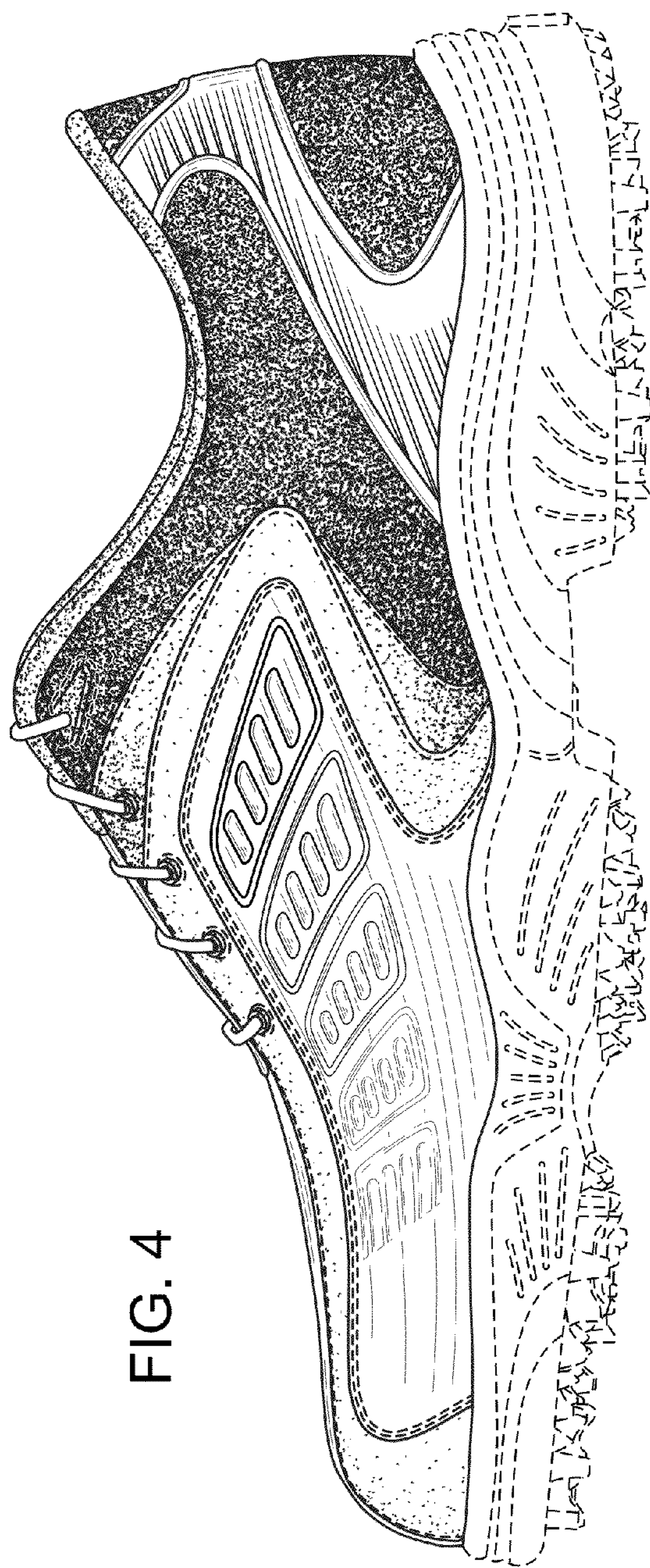

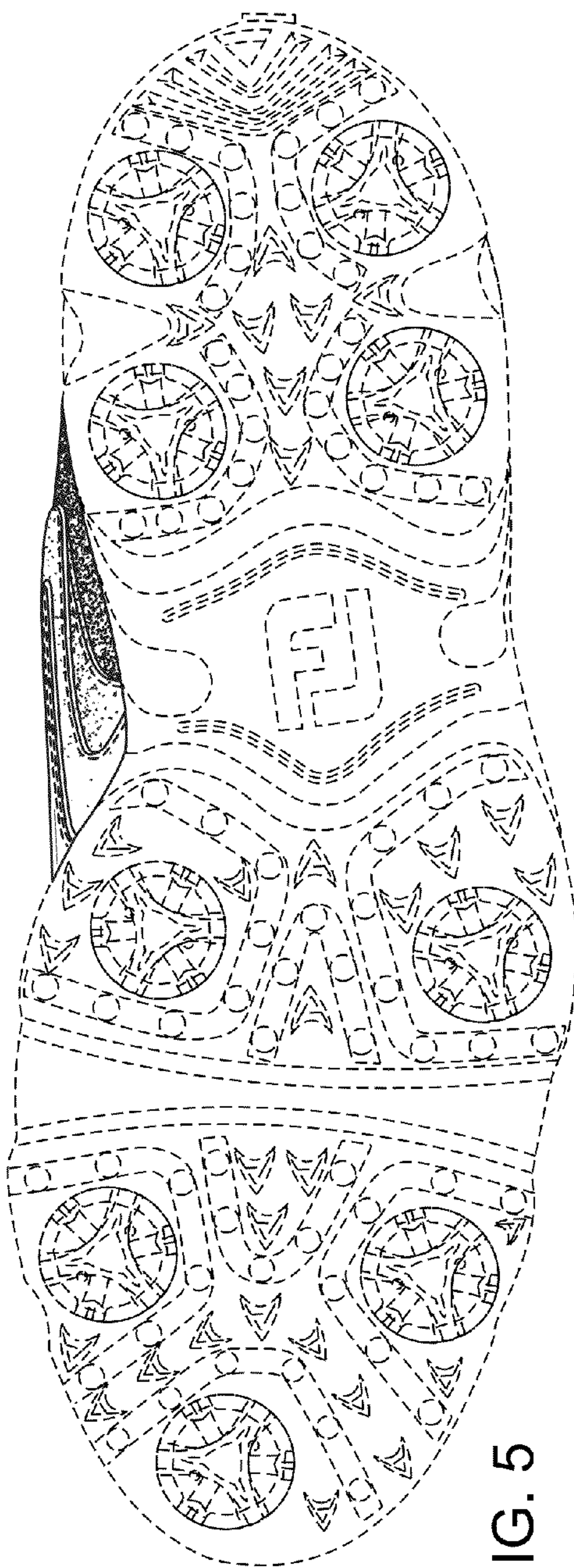

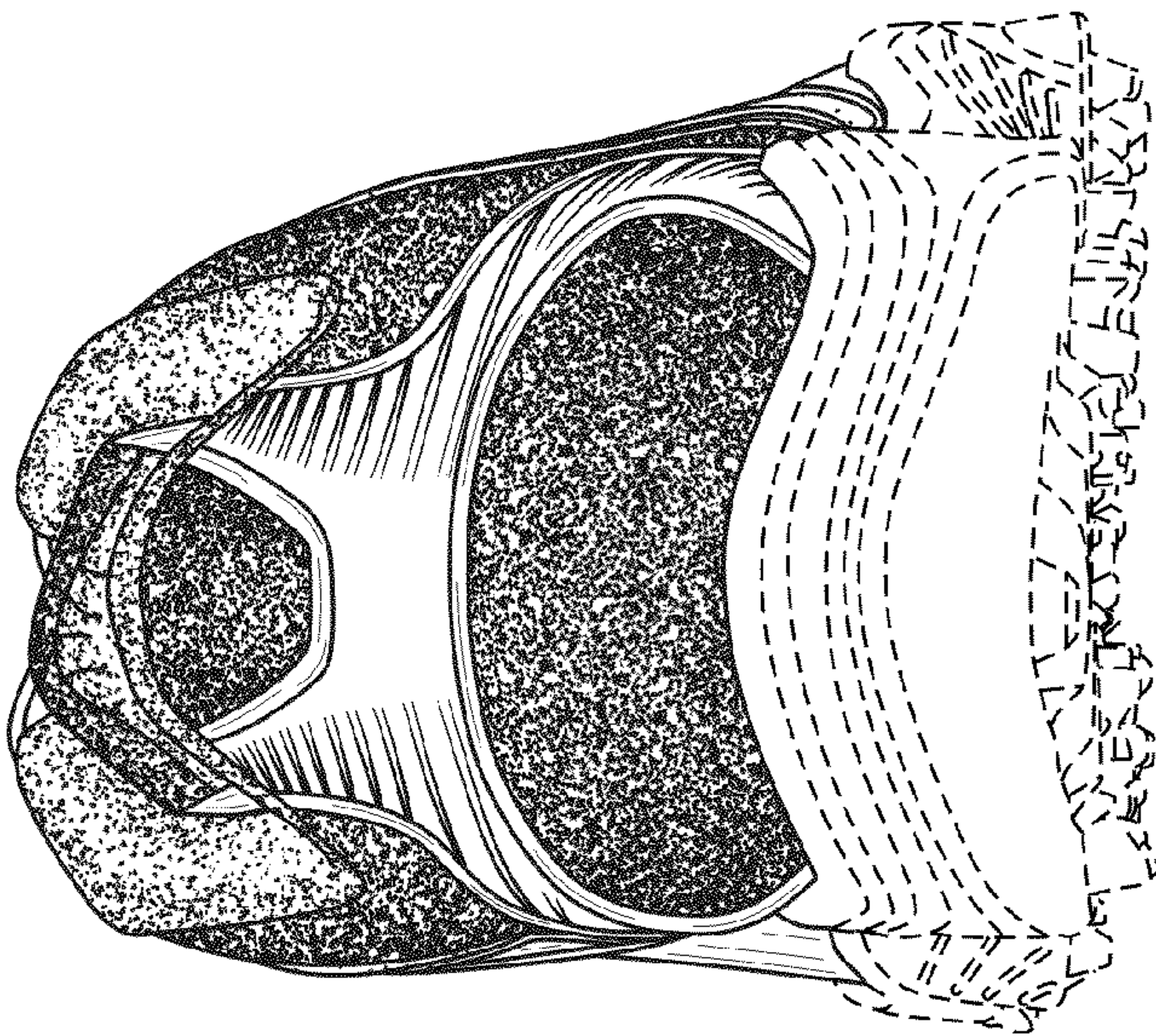

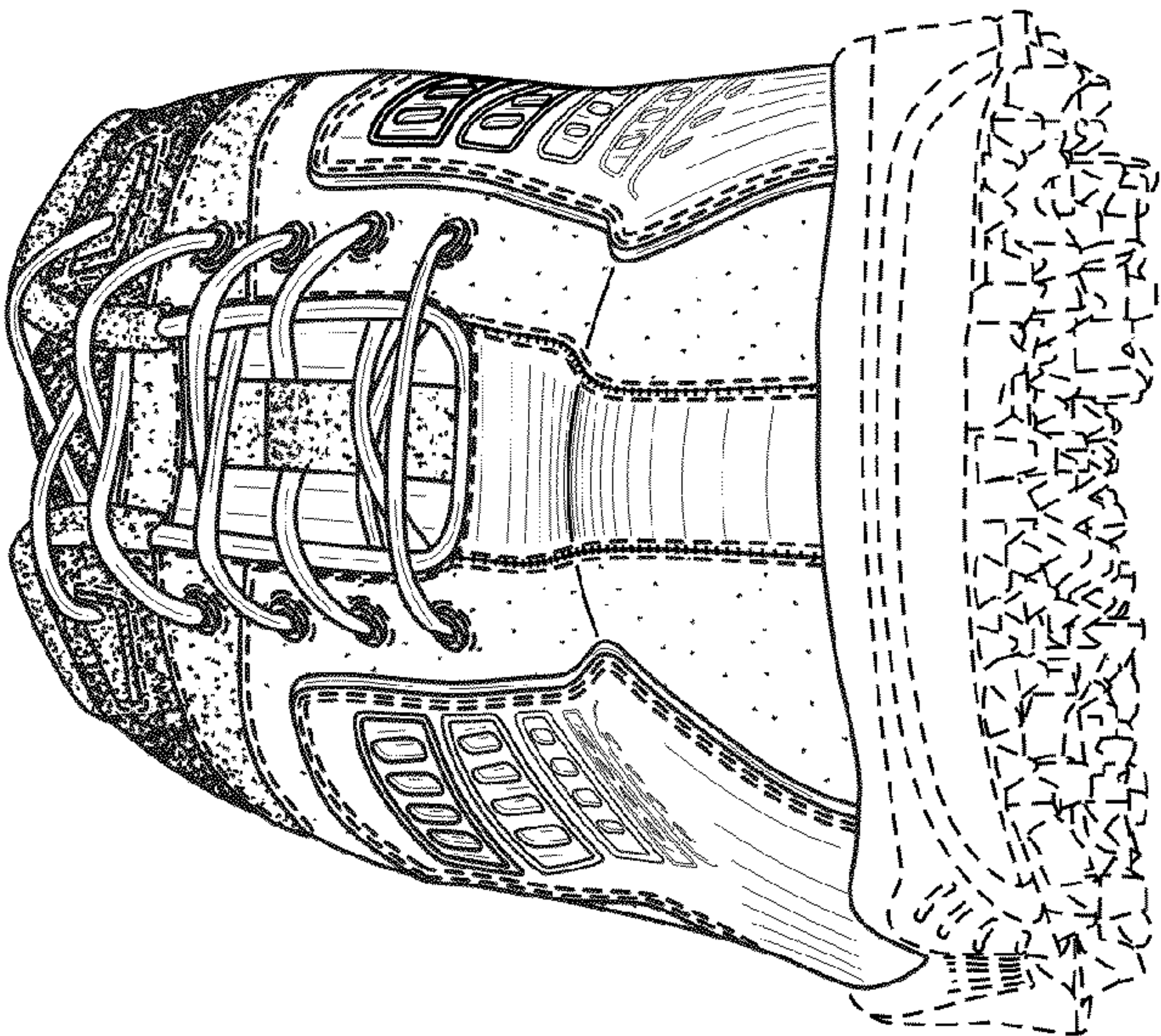
